[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fishing tackle float, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing tackle float, showing my new design, the broken lines shown are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
