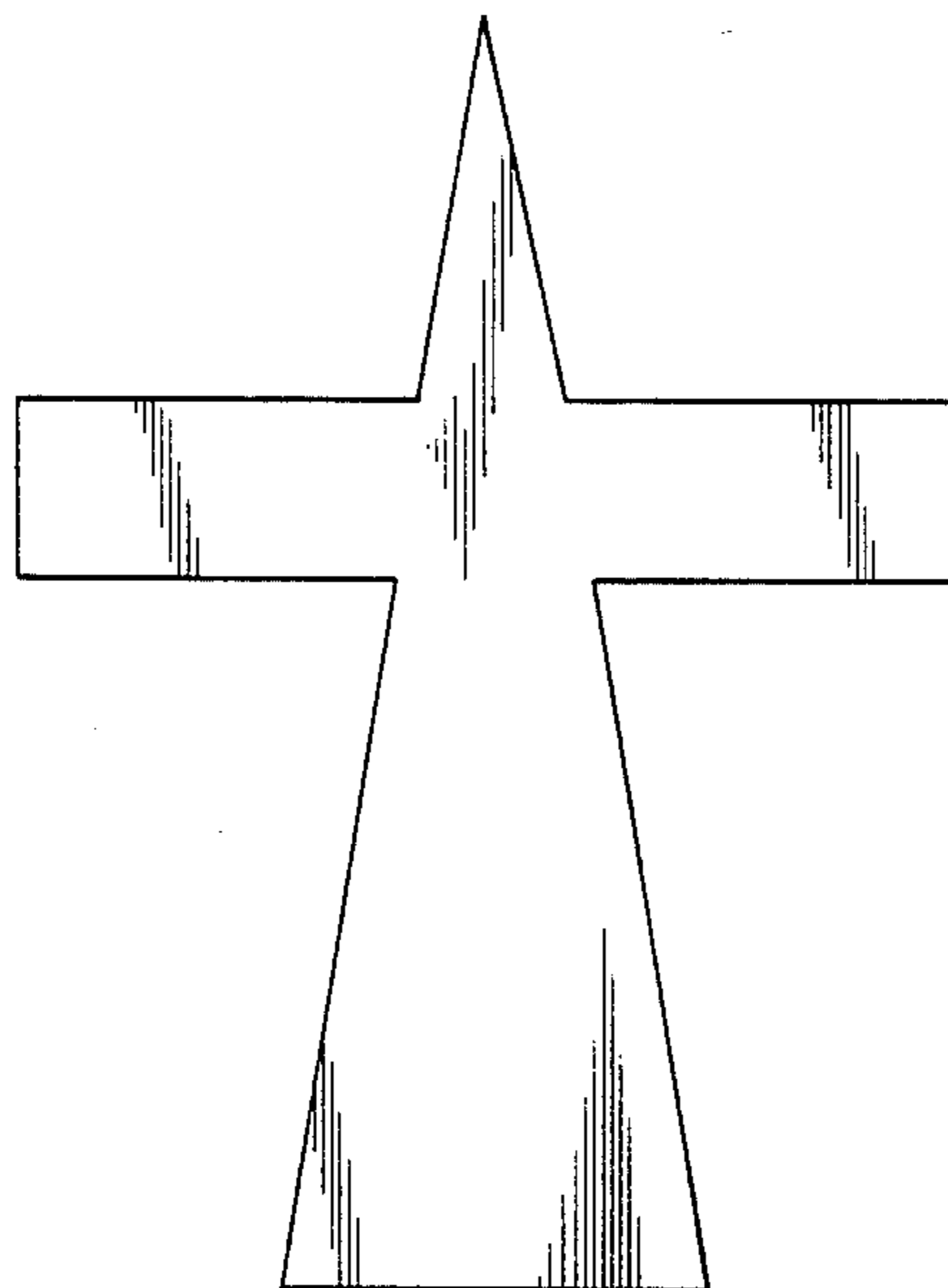

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cross showing my new design, the back being identical; and FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, both sides being identical.



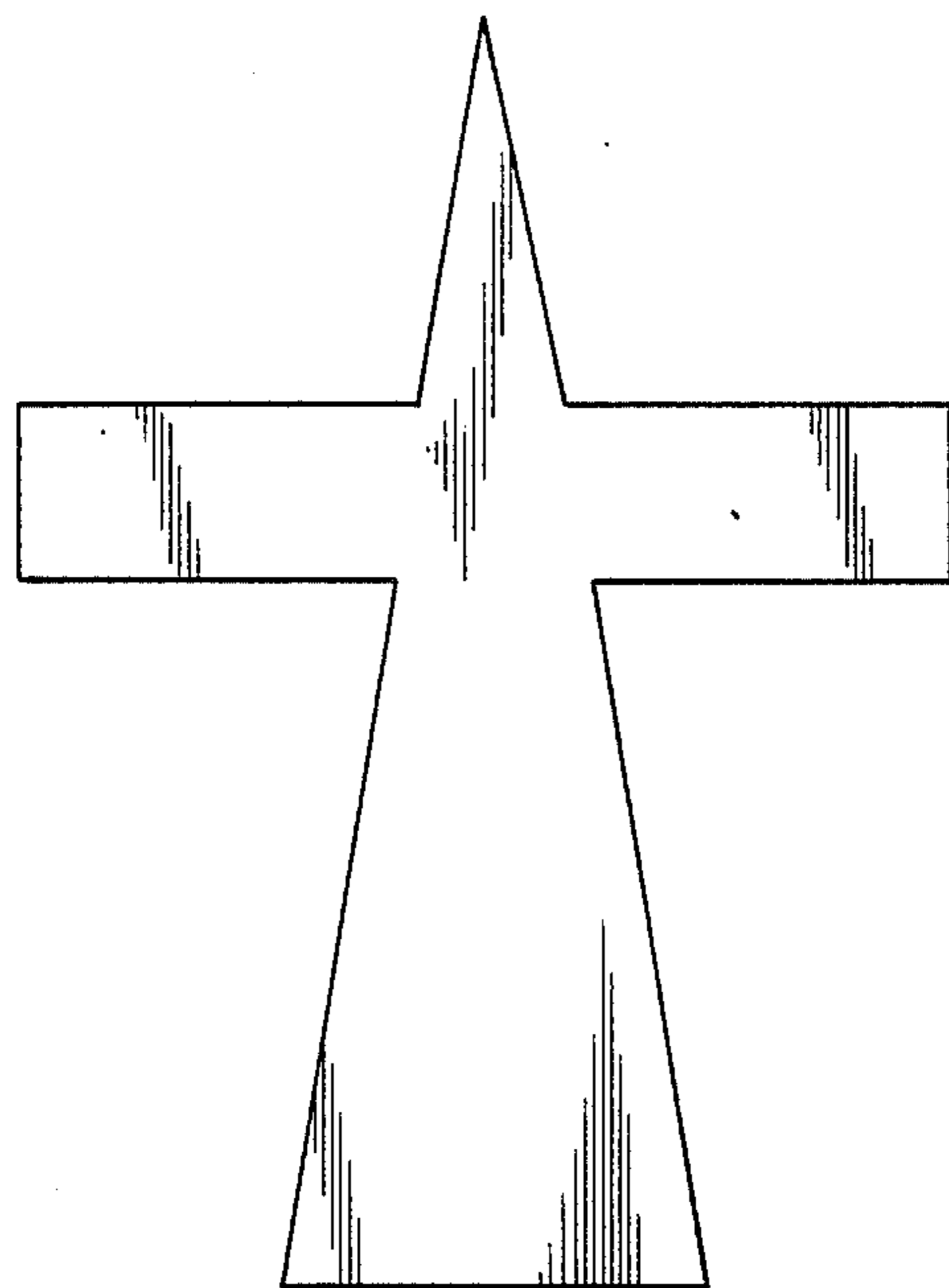
