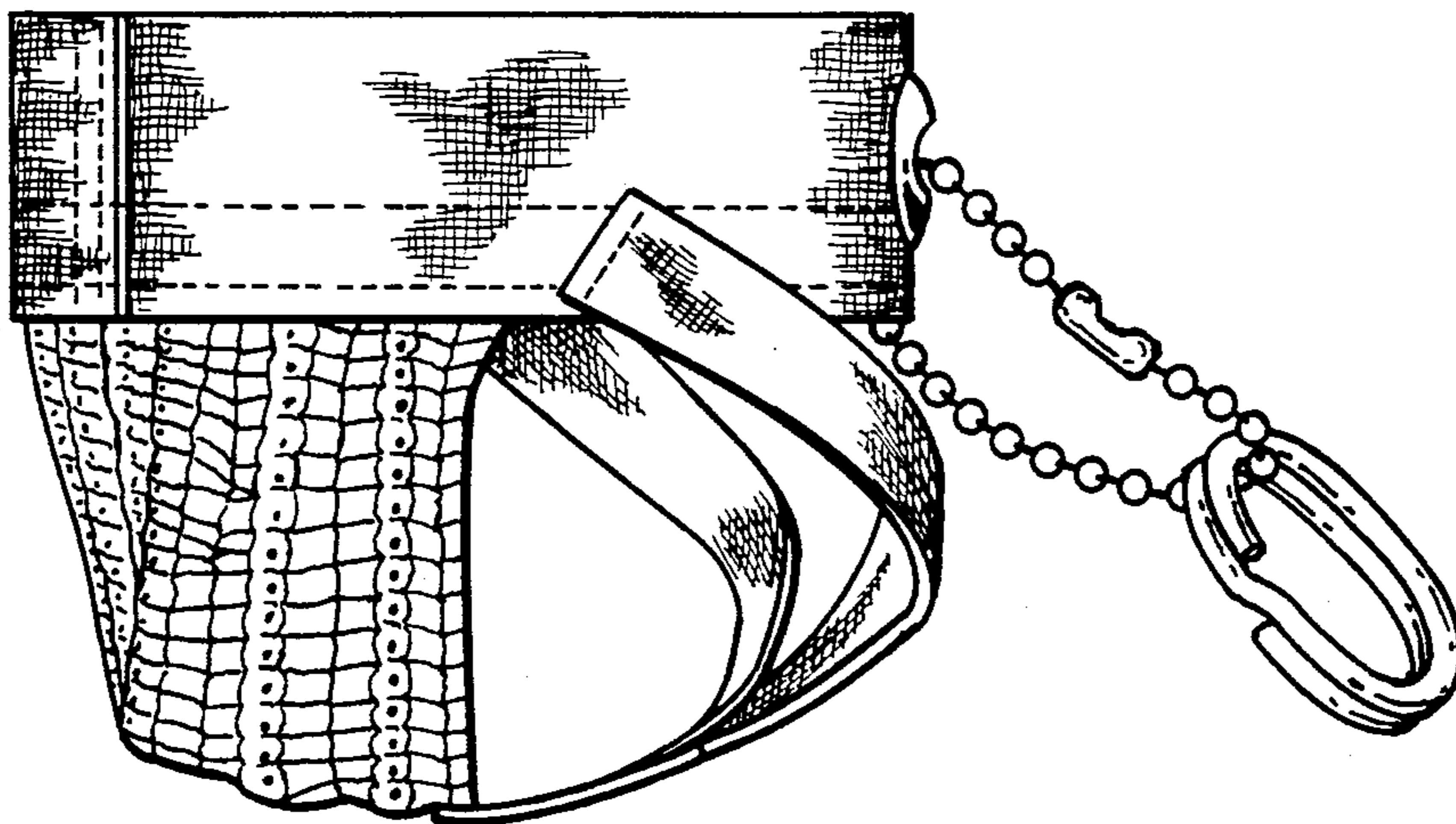

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a novelty key chain showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view, the broken line showing of a football fob is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



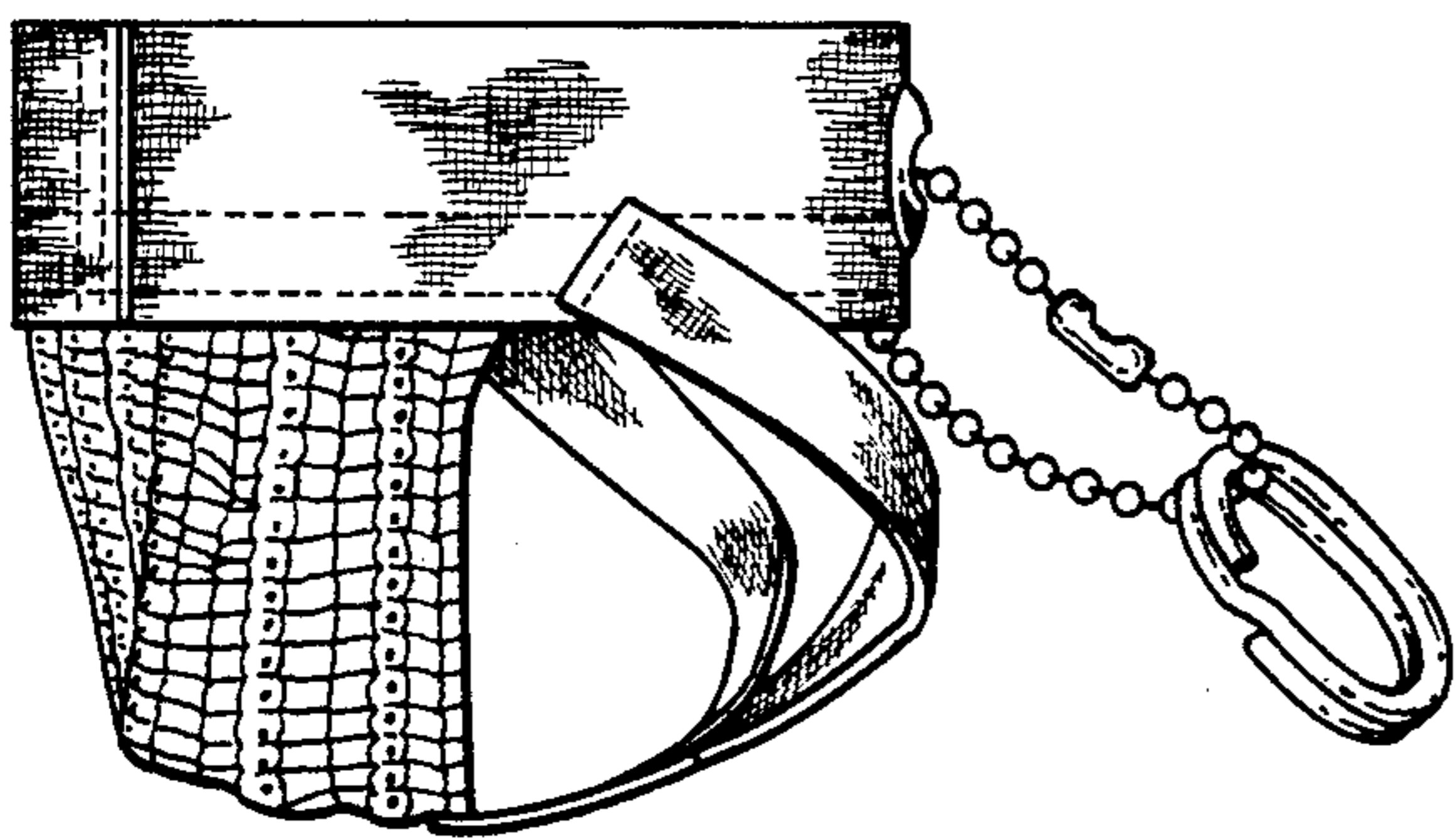

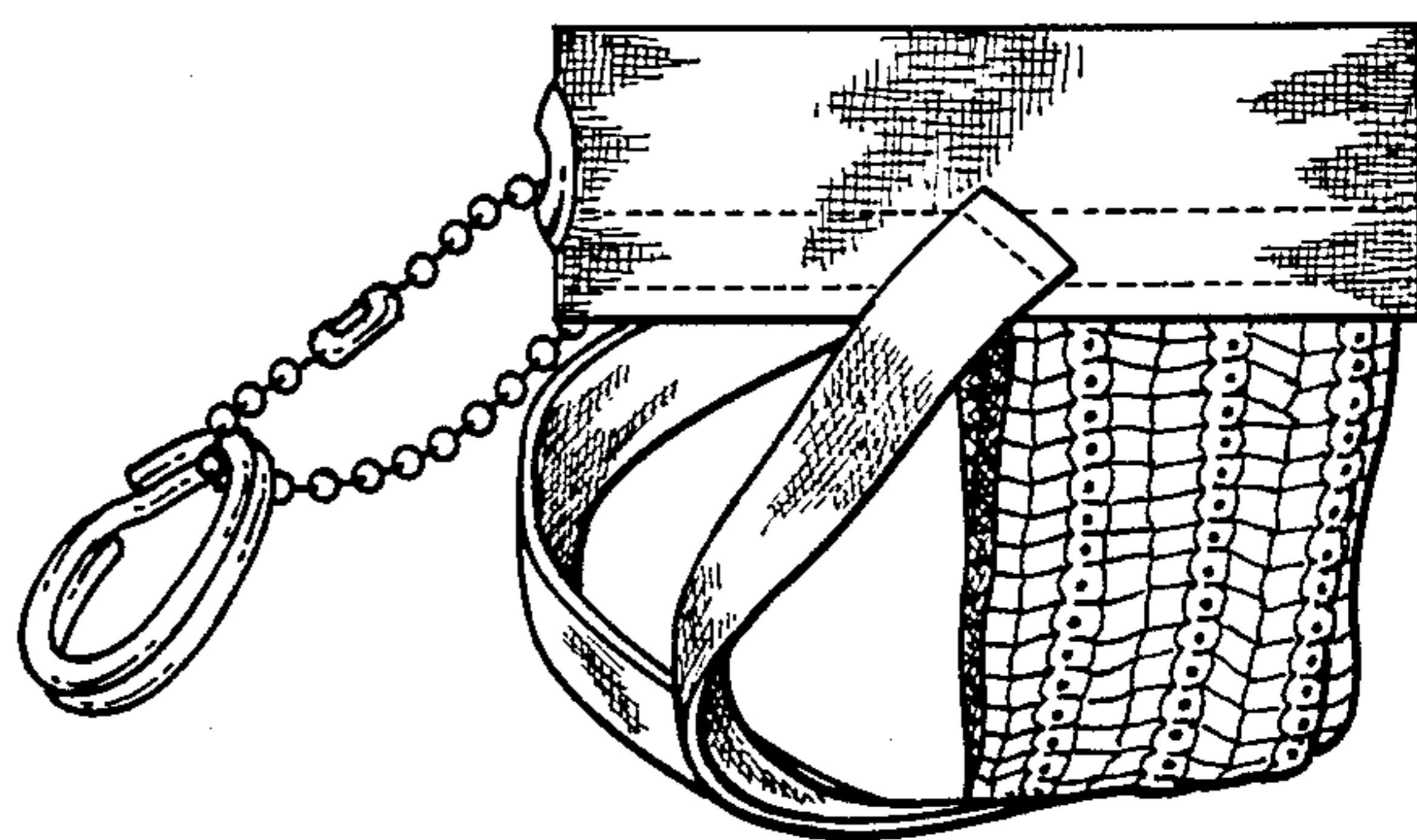

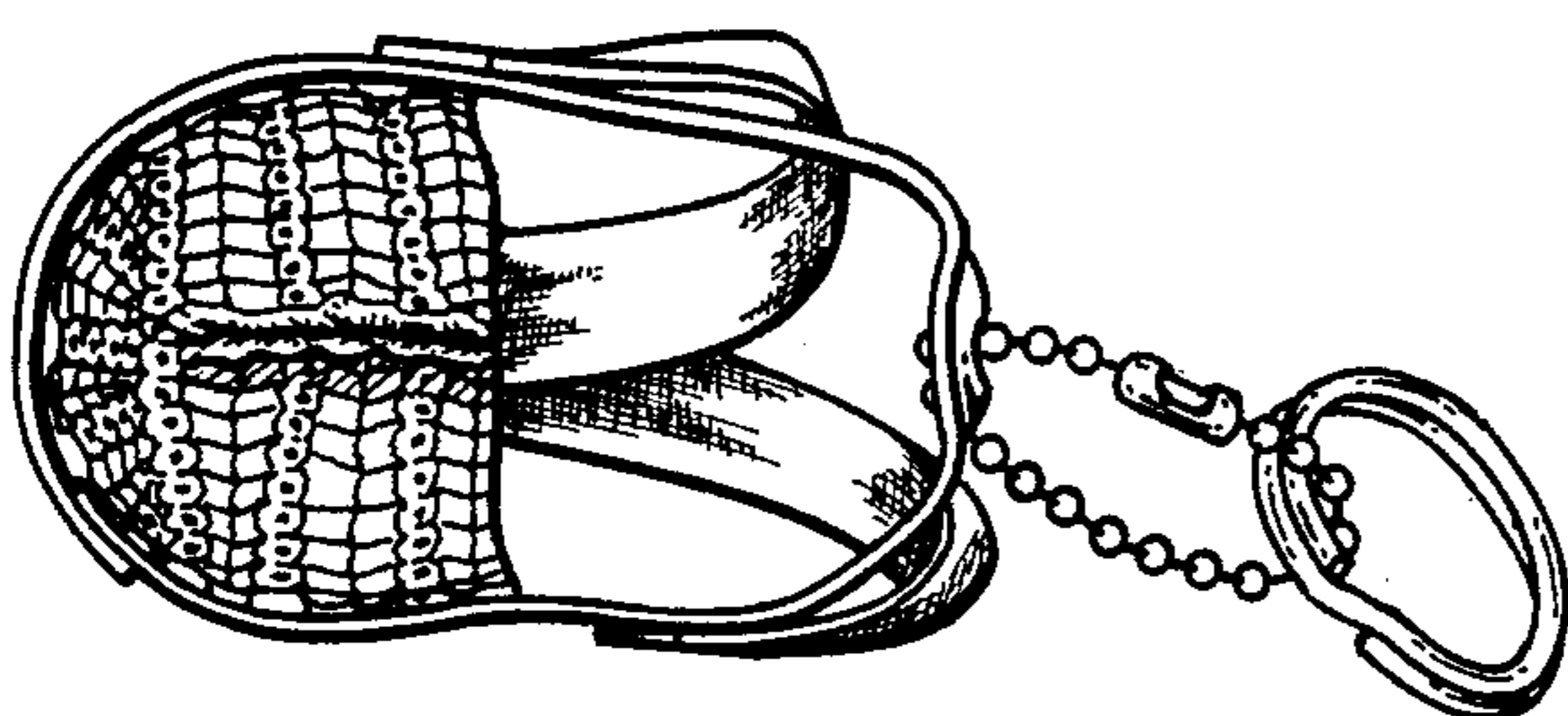

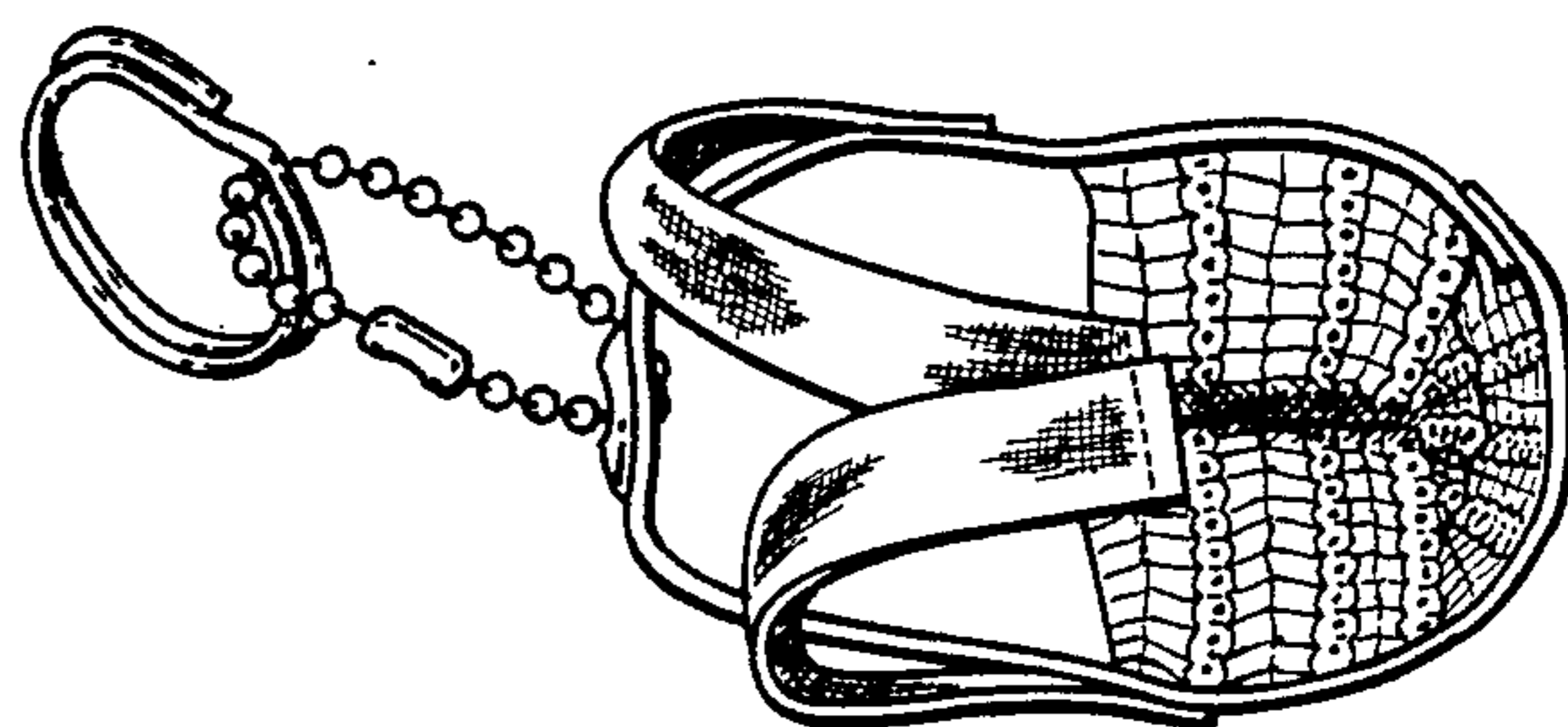

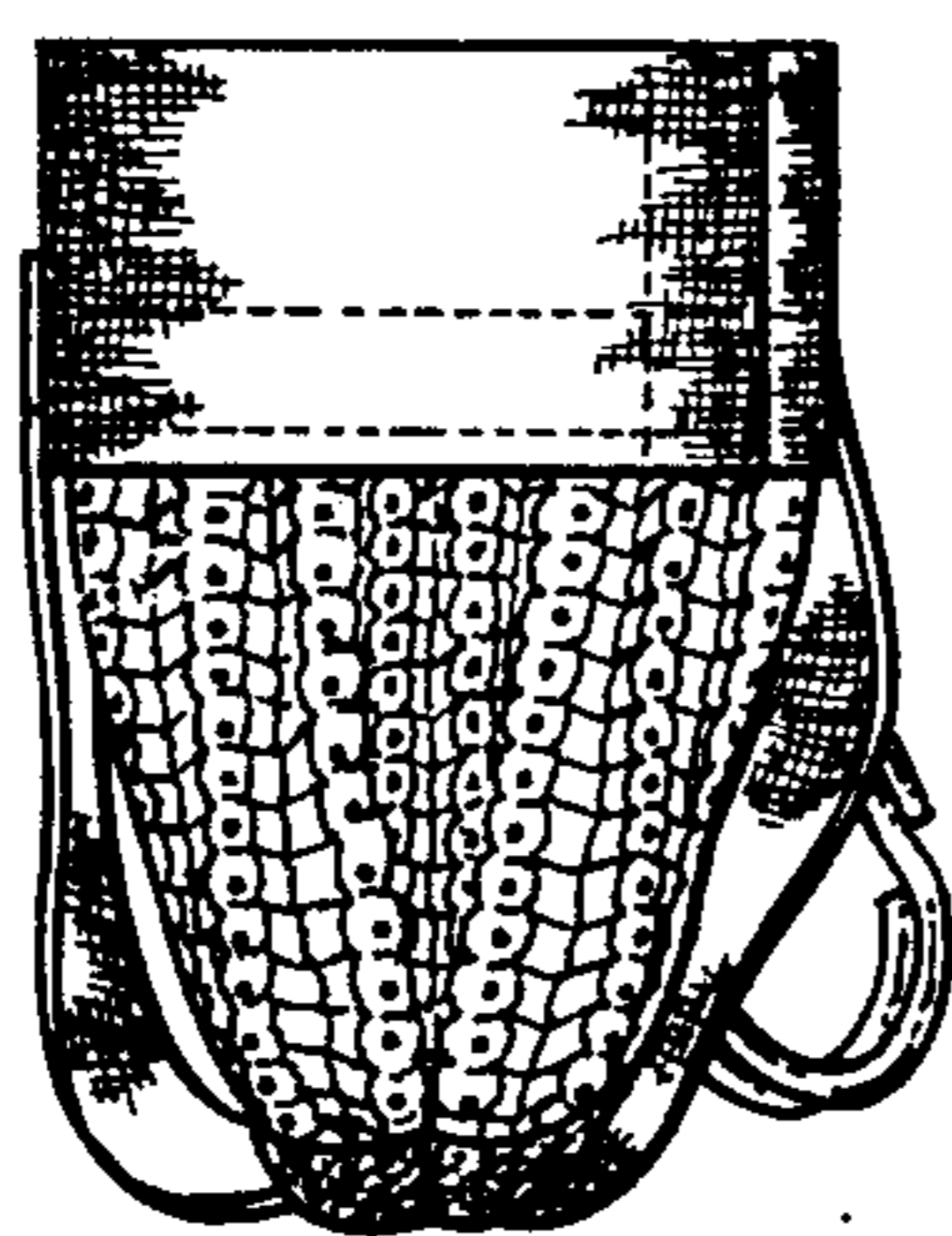

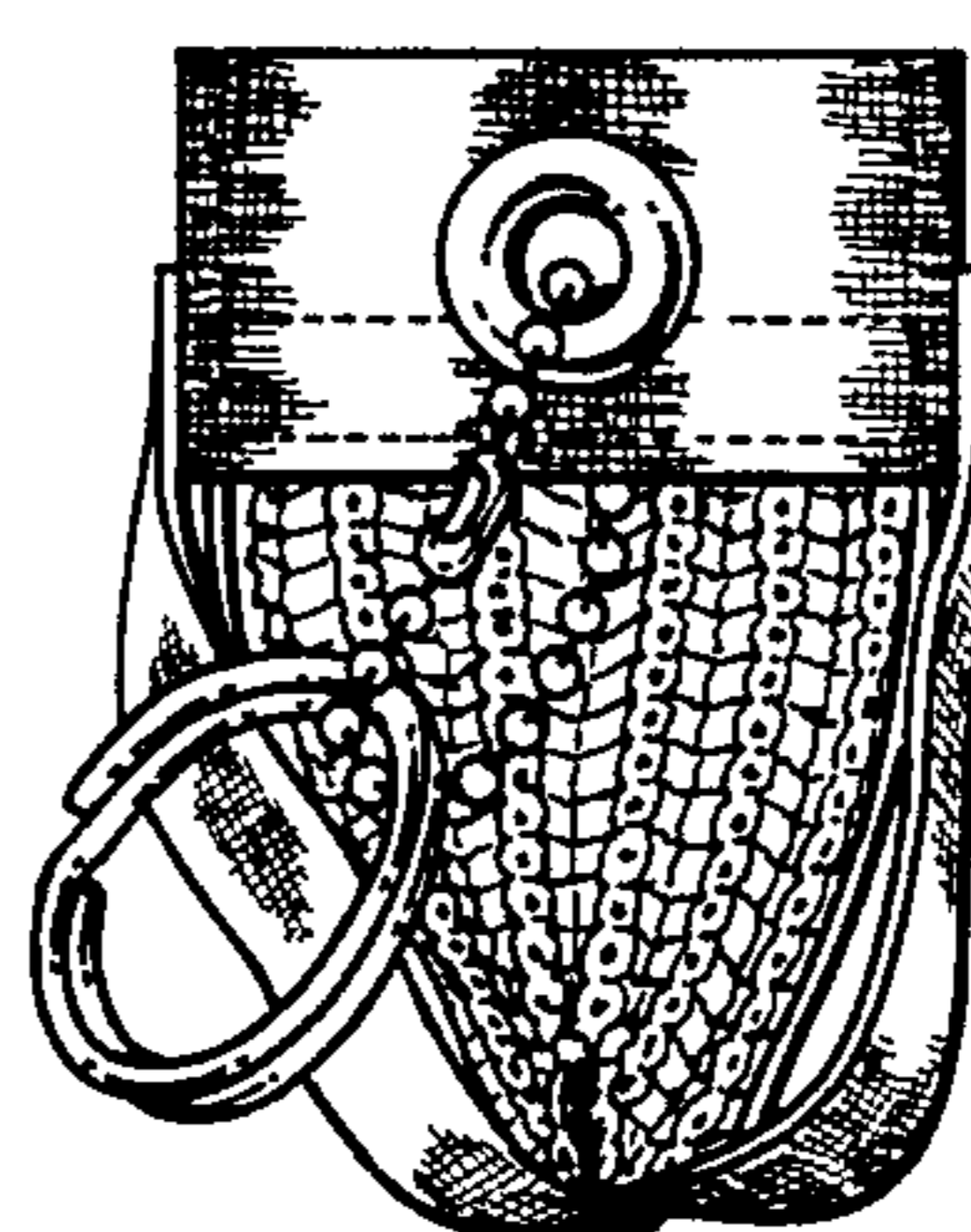

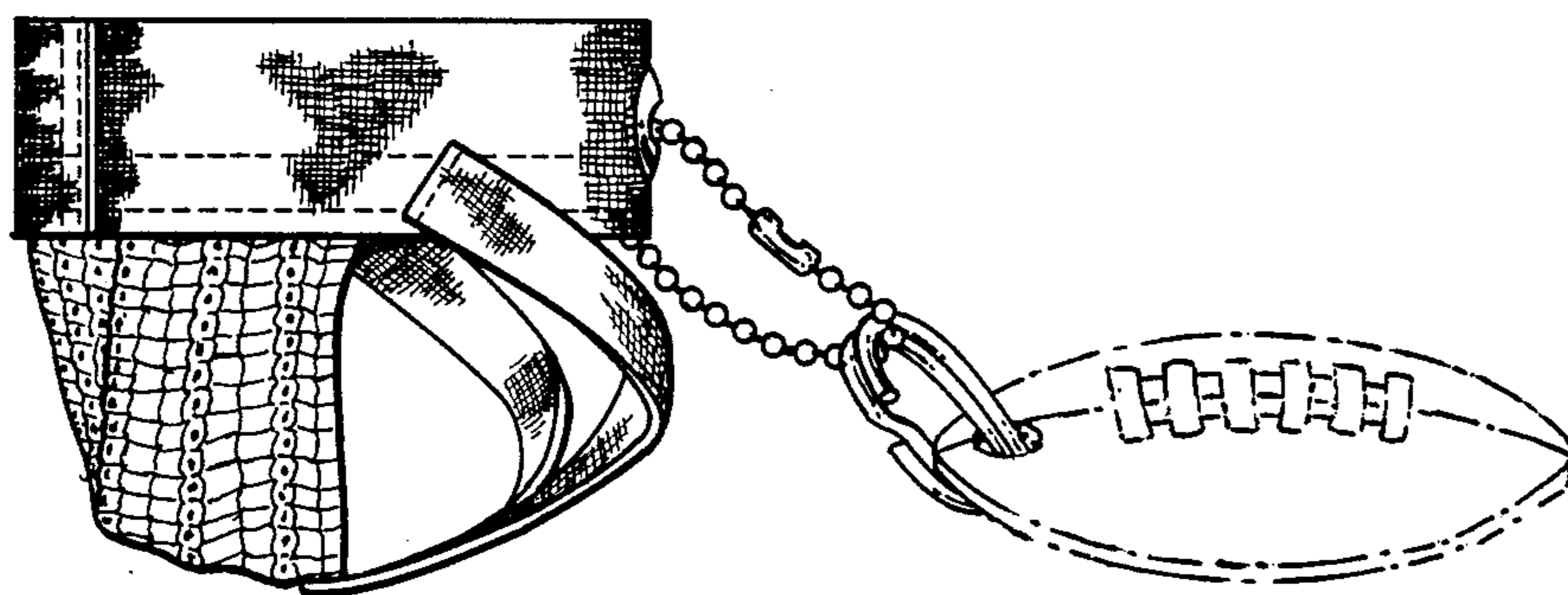
