DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a luggage case showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, showing the side shown in FIG. 1;

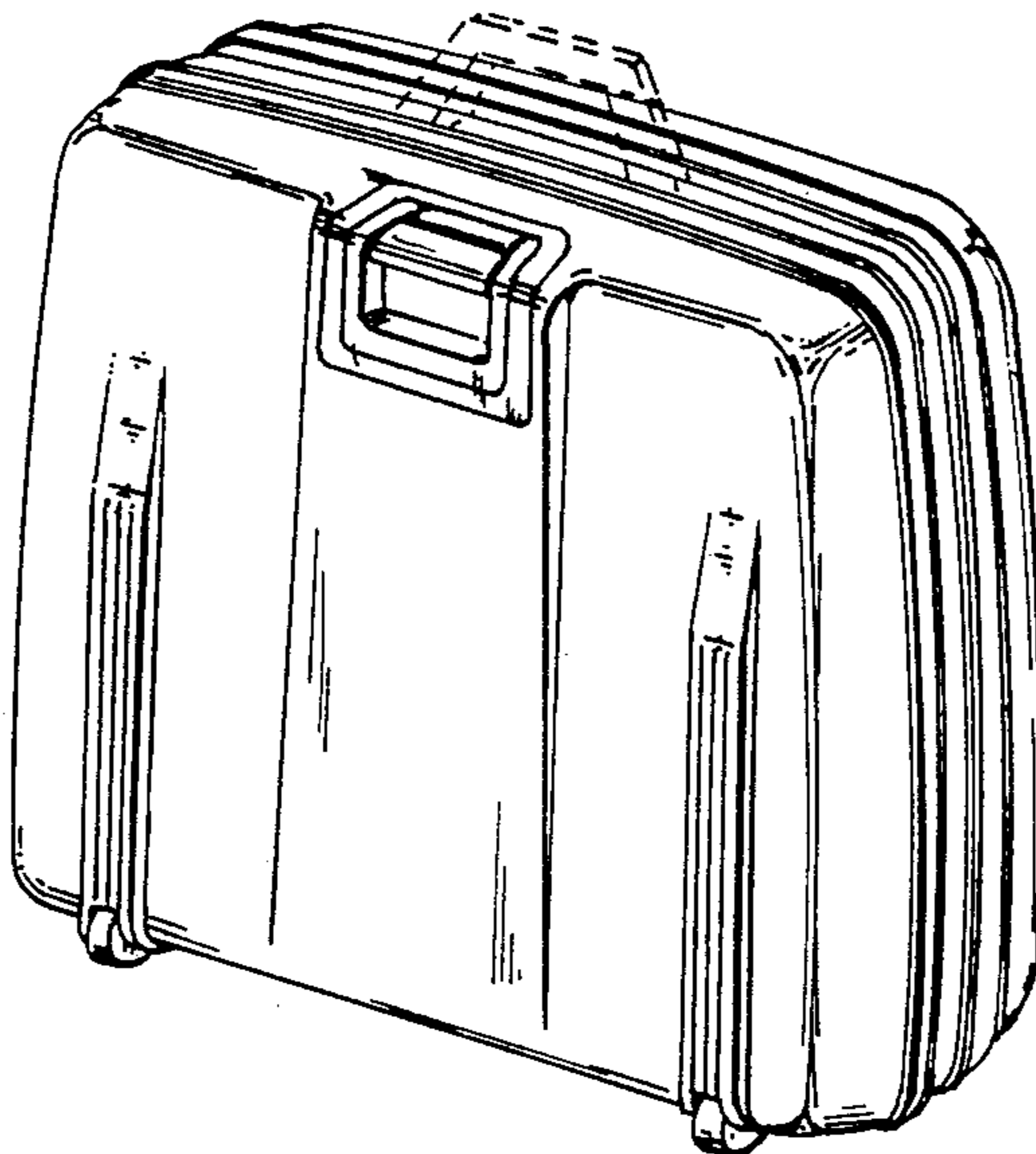
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of a handle and glides is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



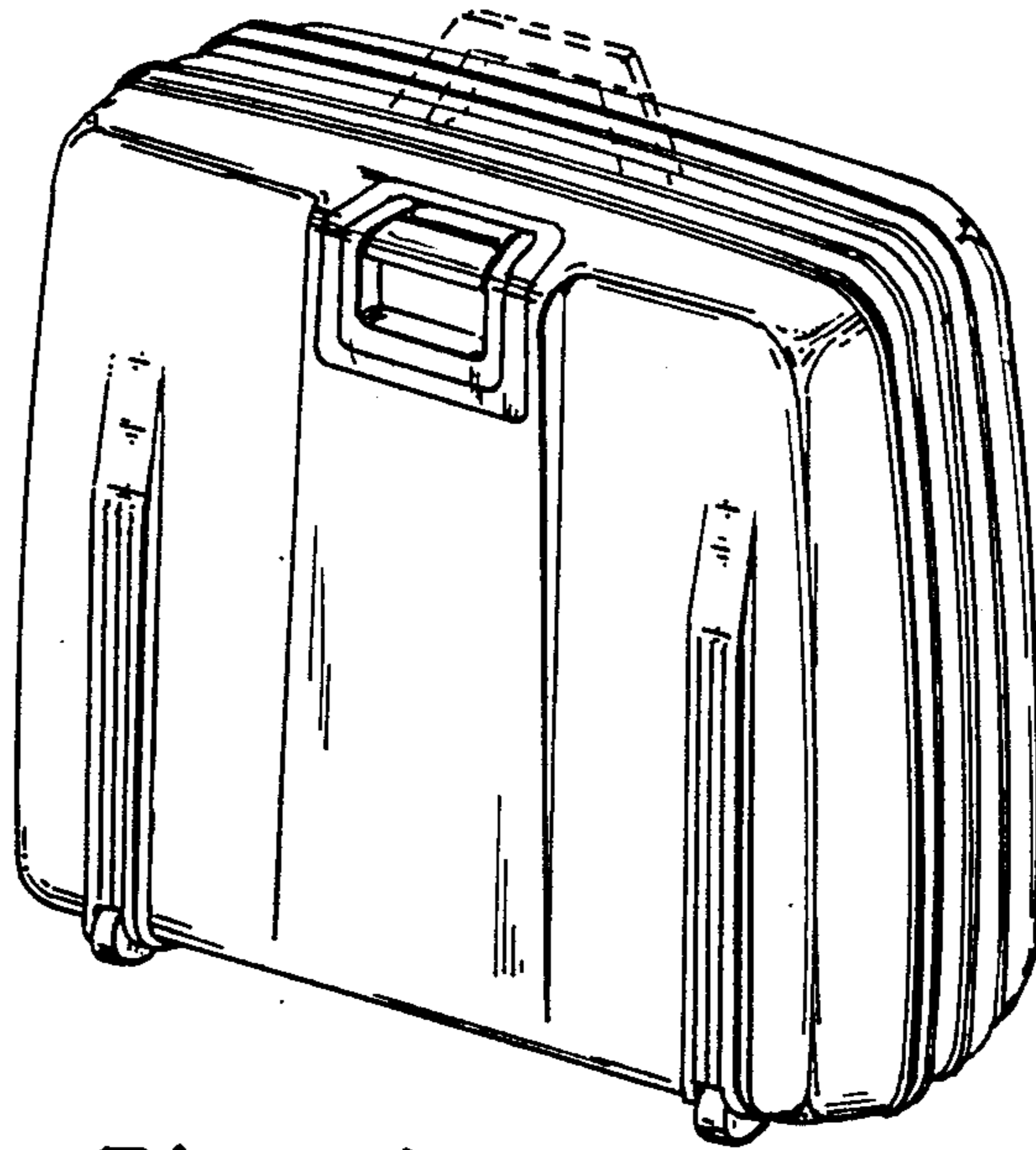

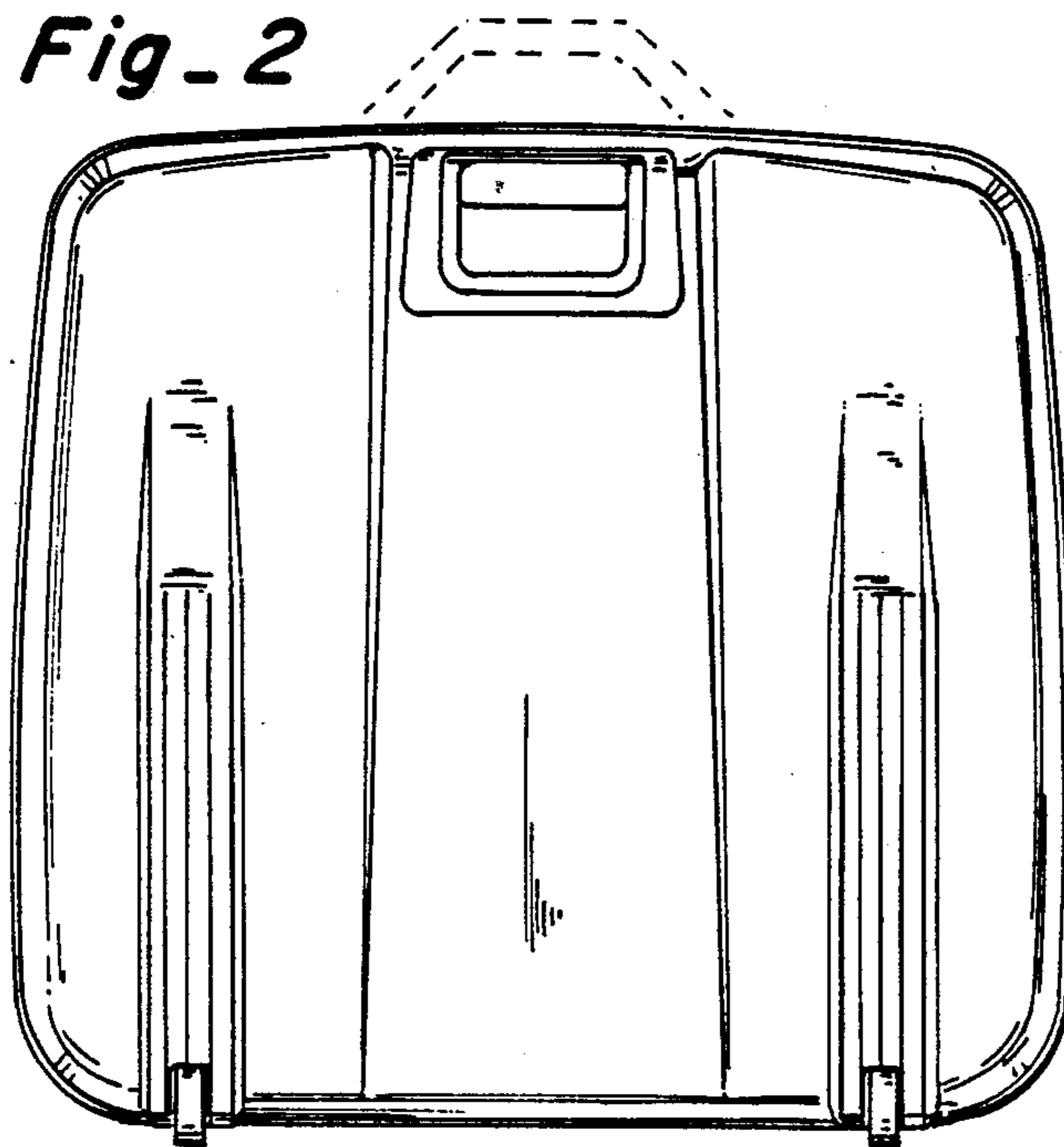

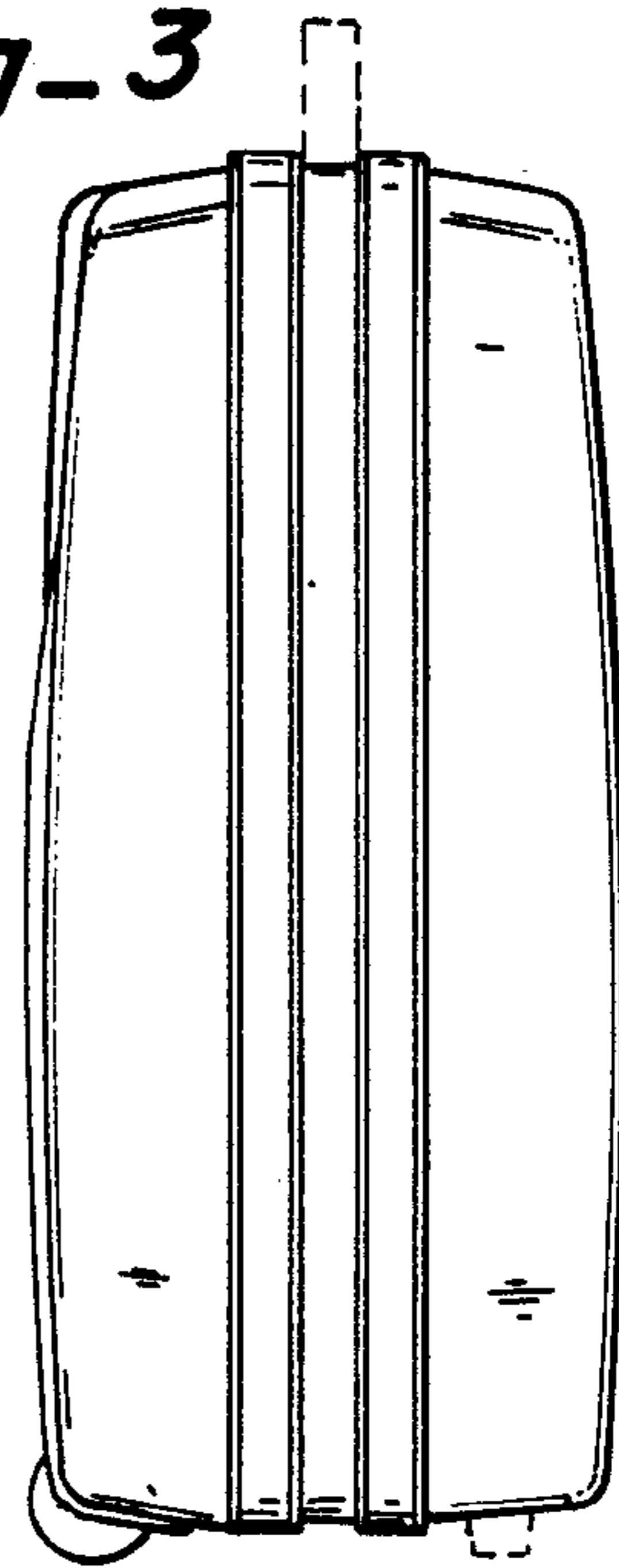

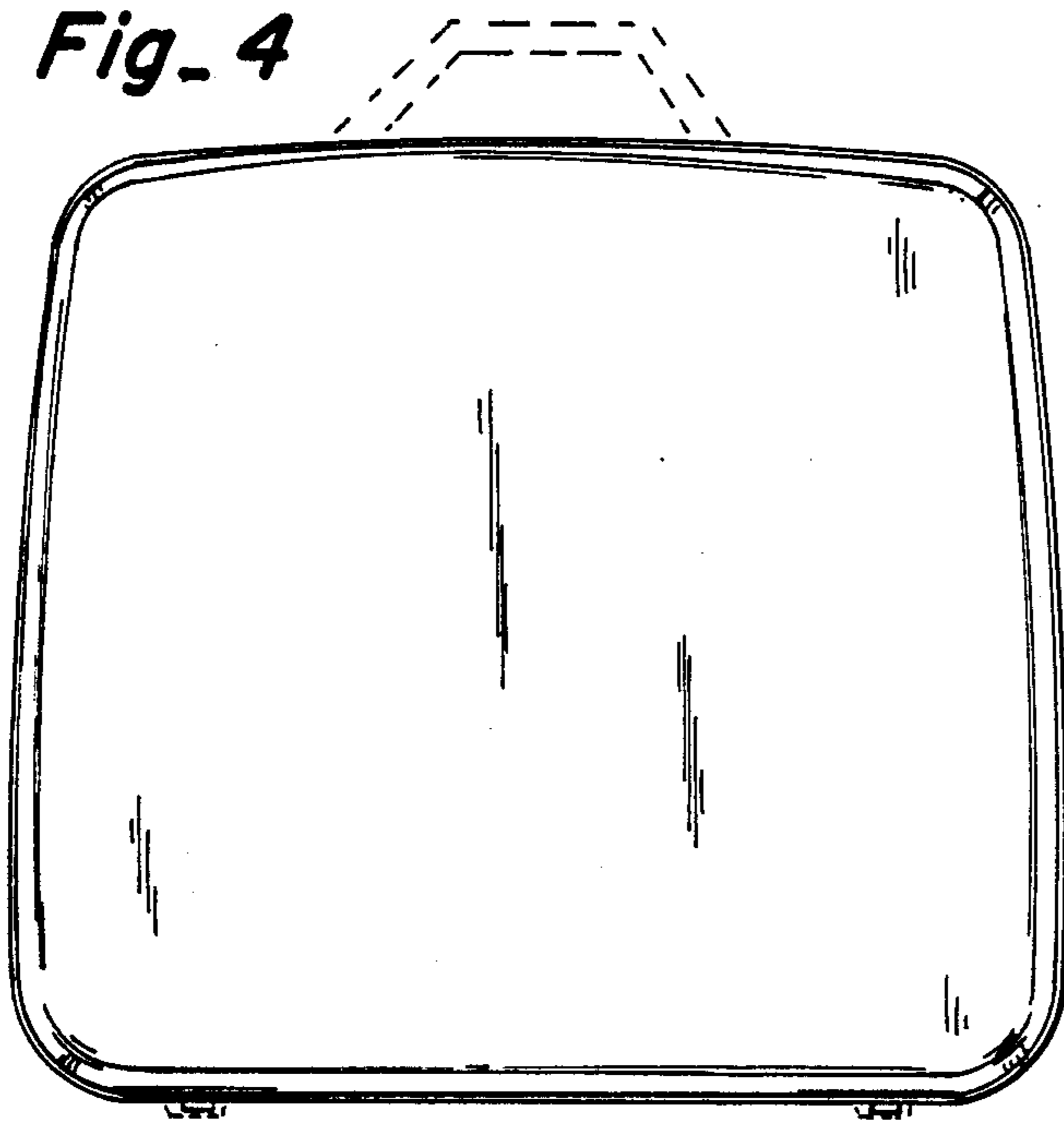

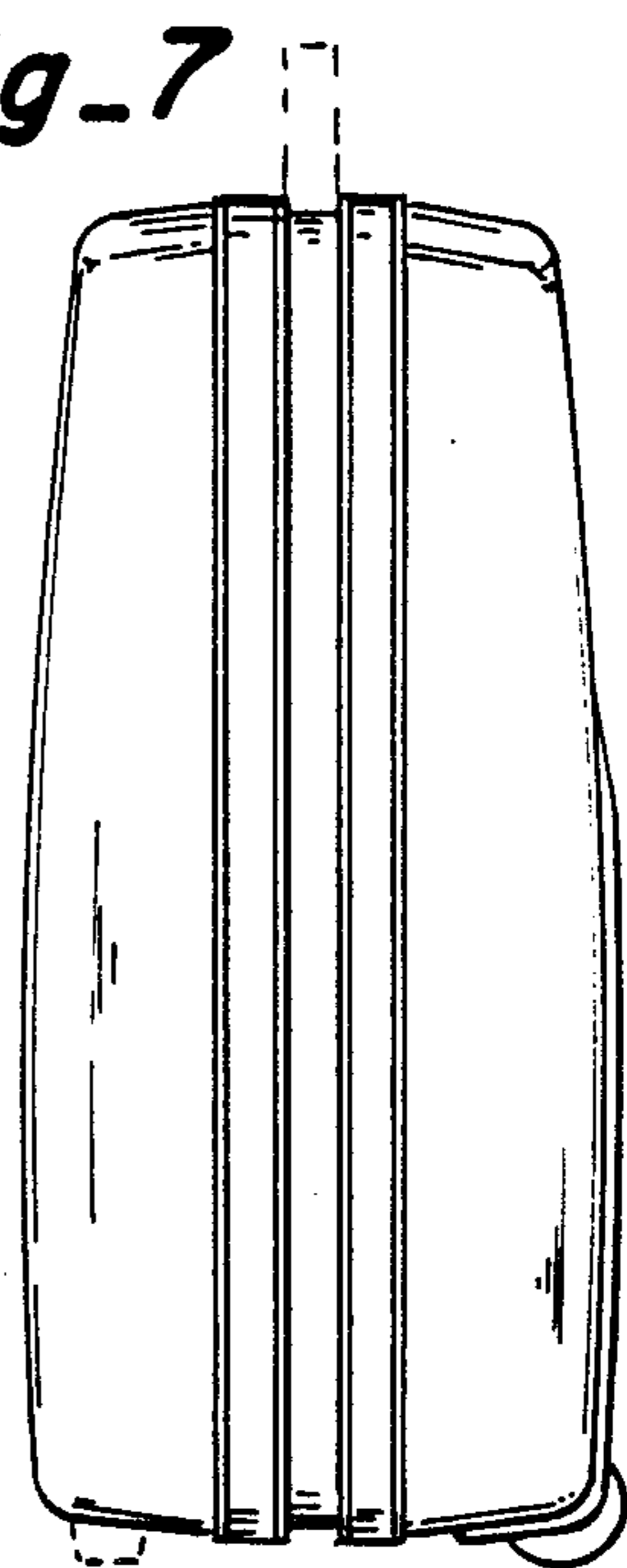

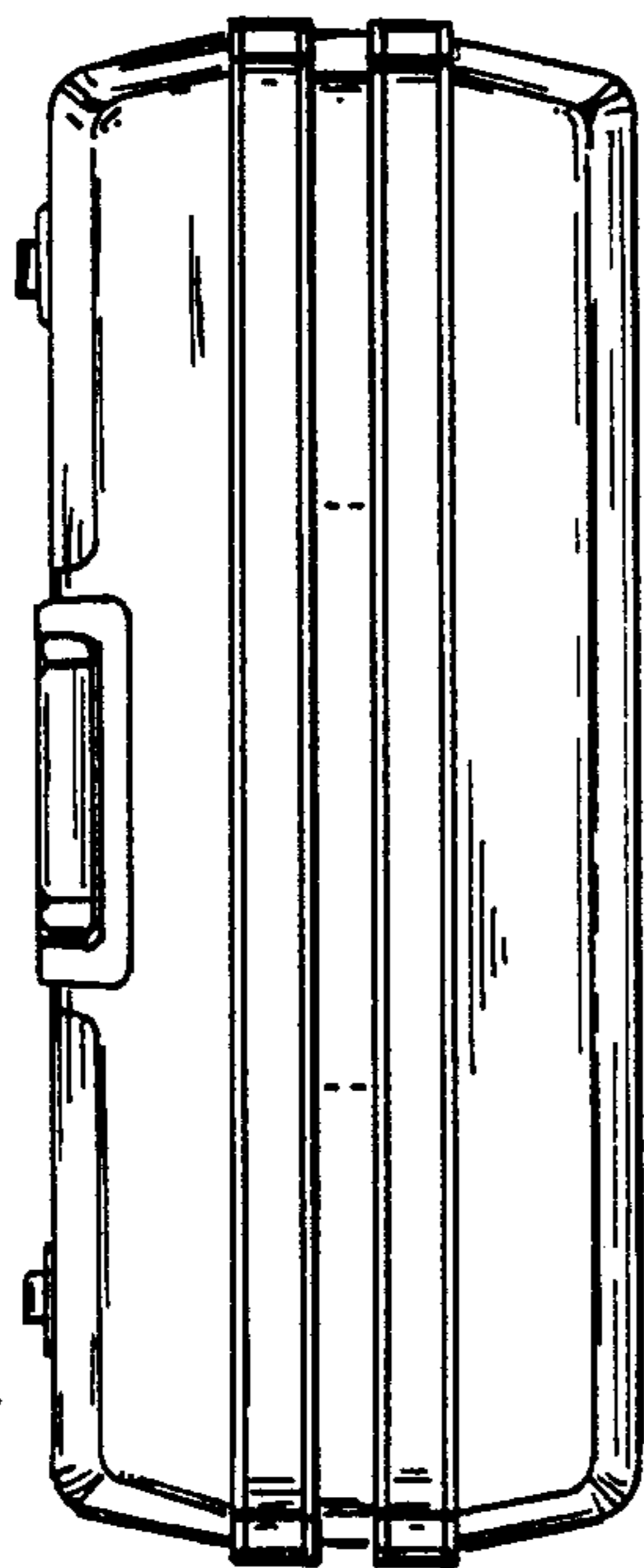
