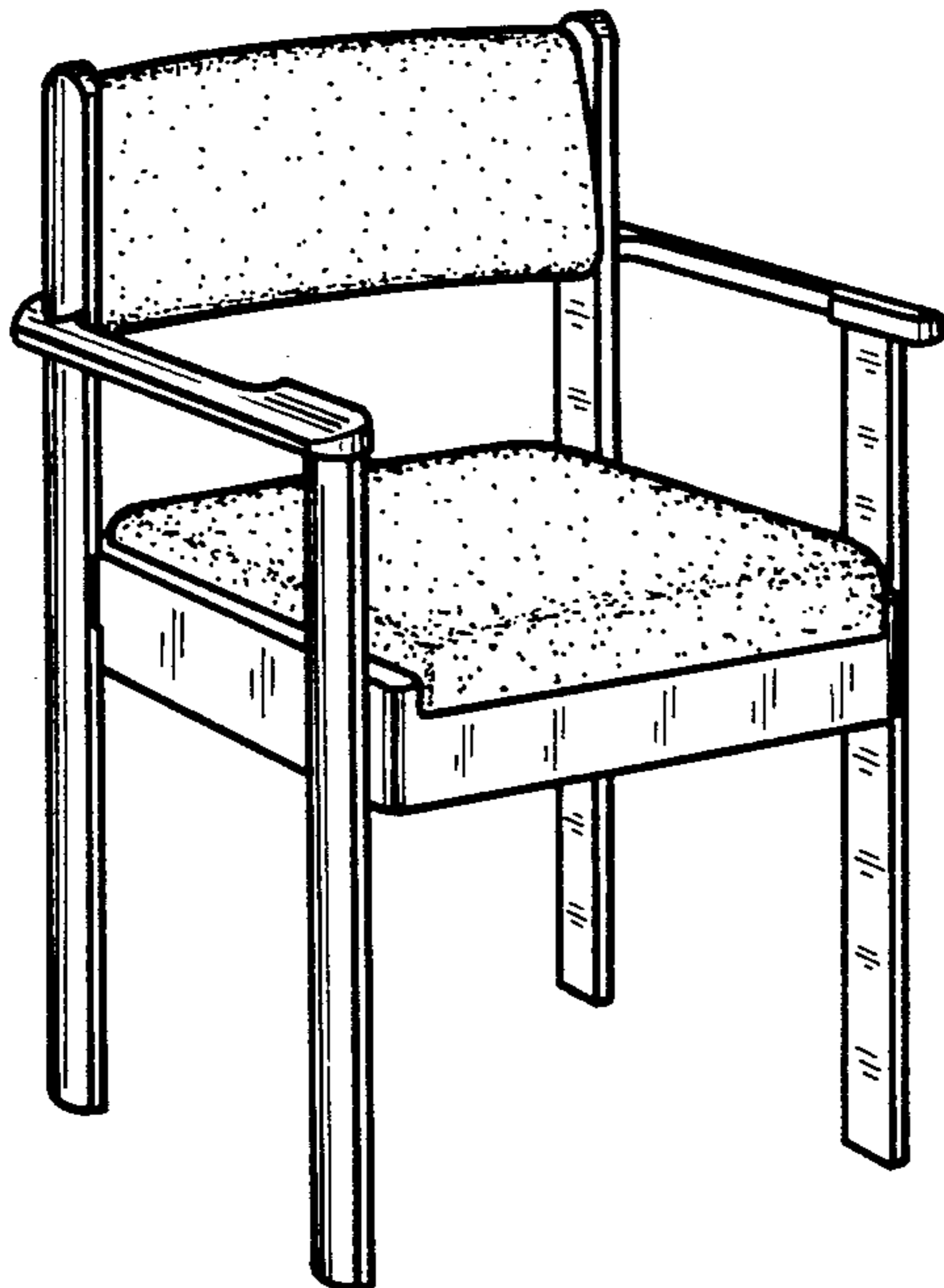

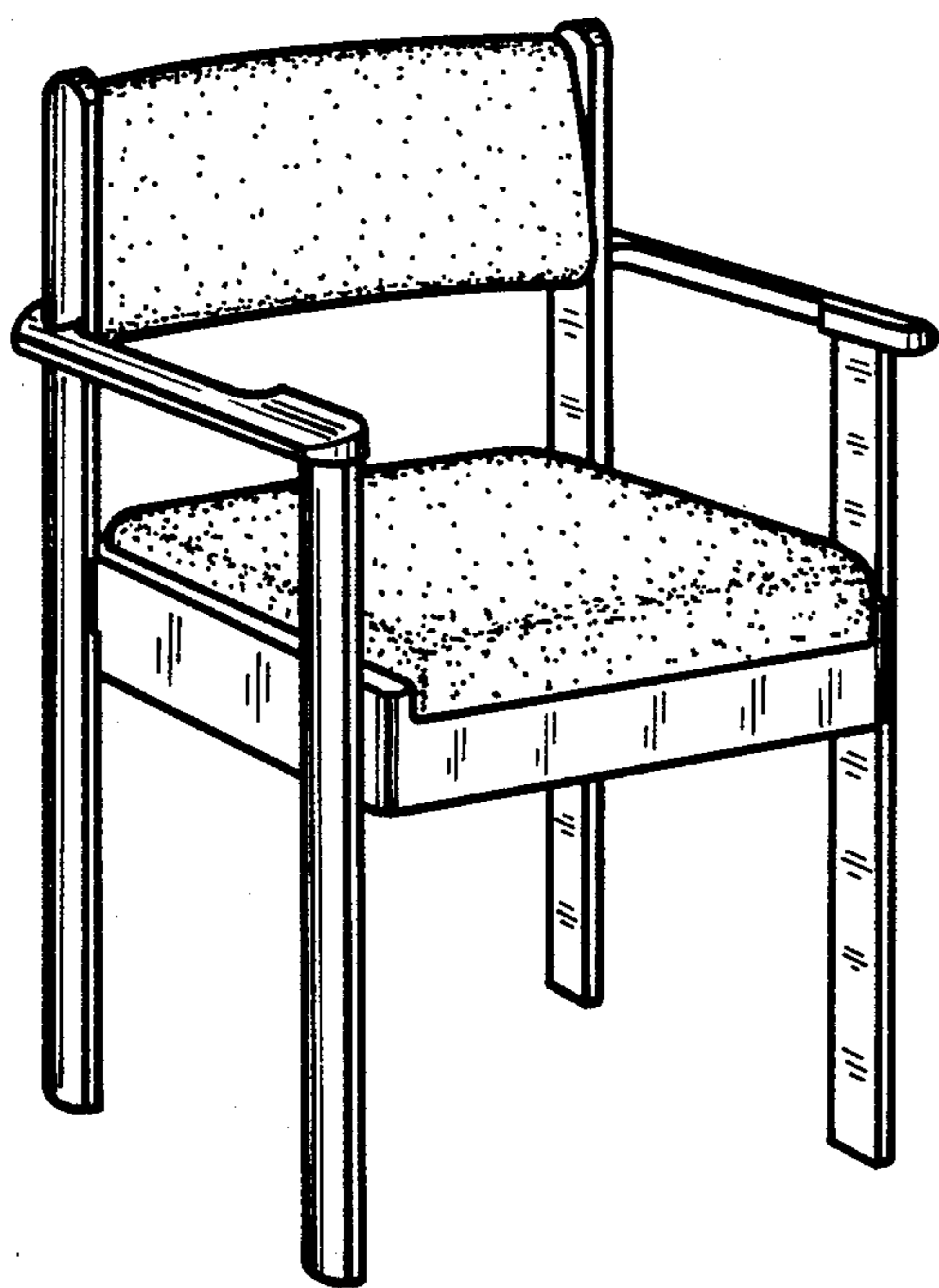

The ornamental design for an arm chair, as shown and described.

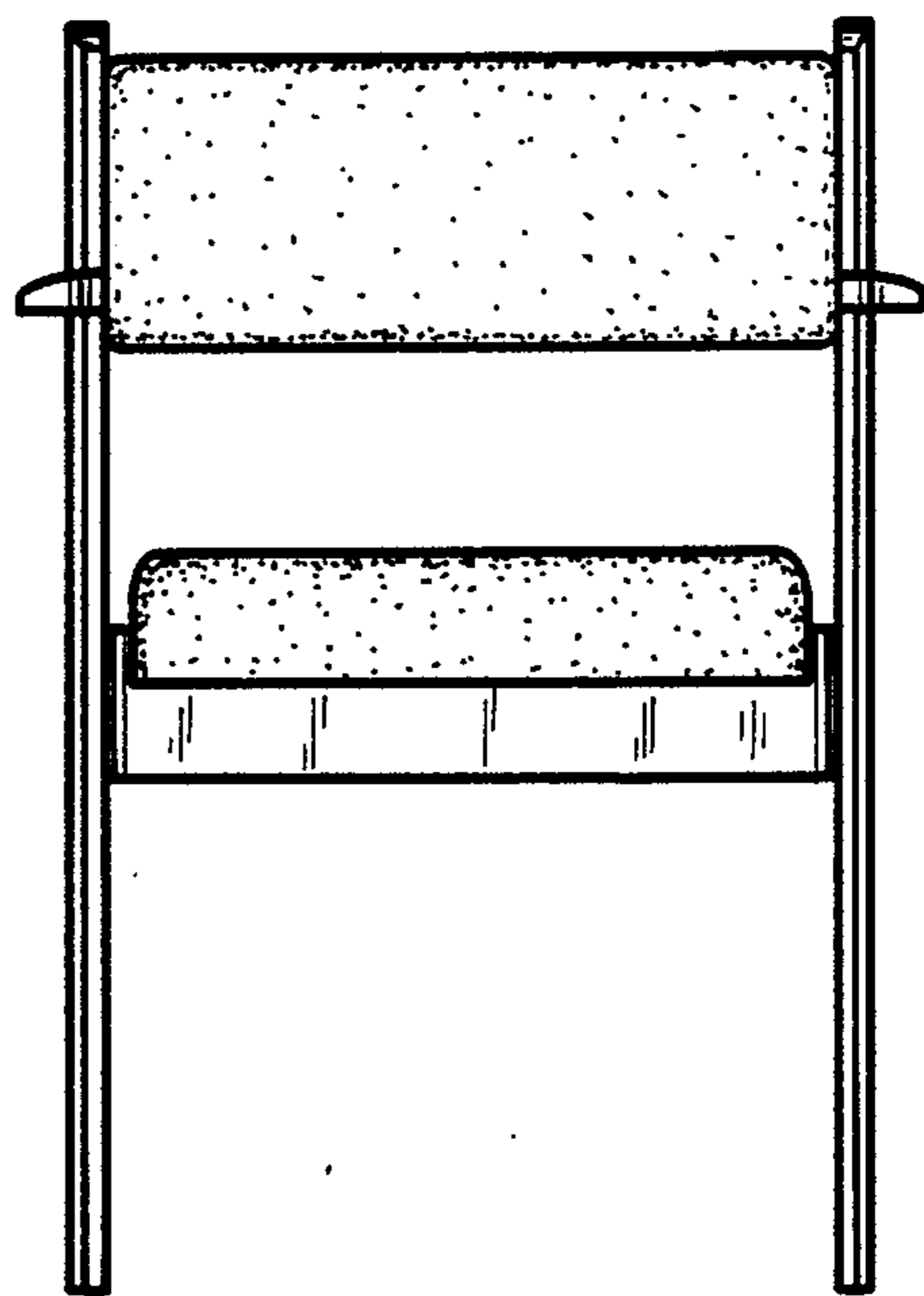
DESCRIPTION

 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

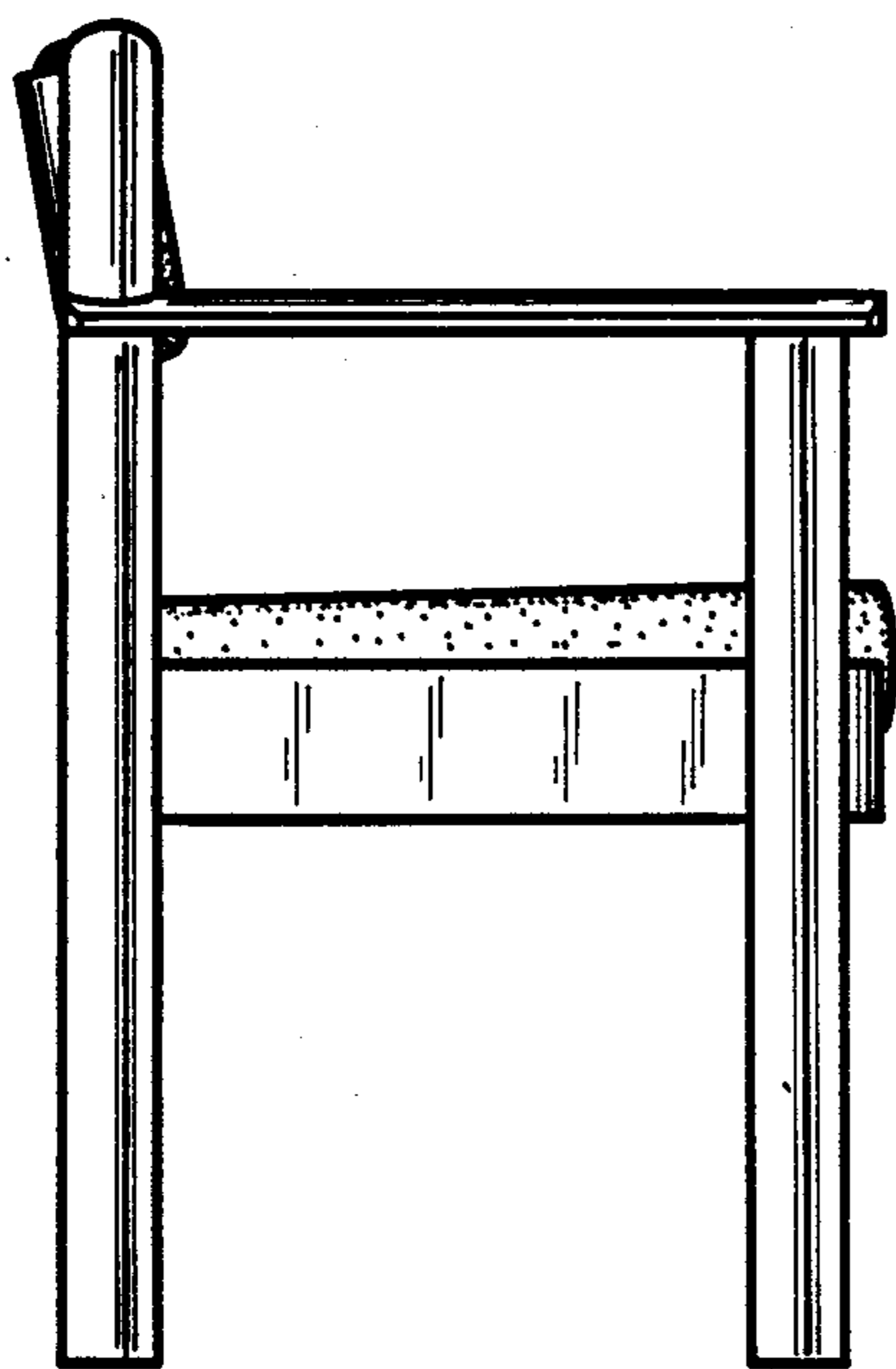




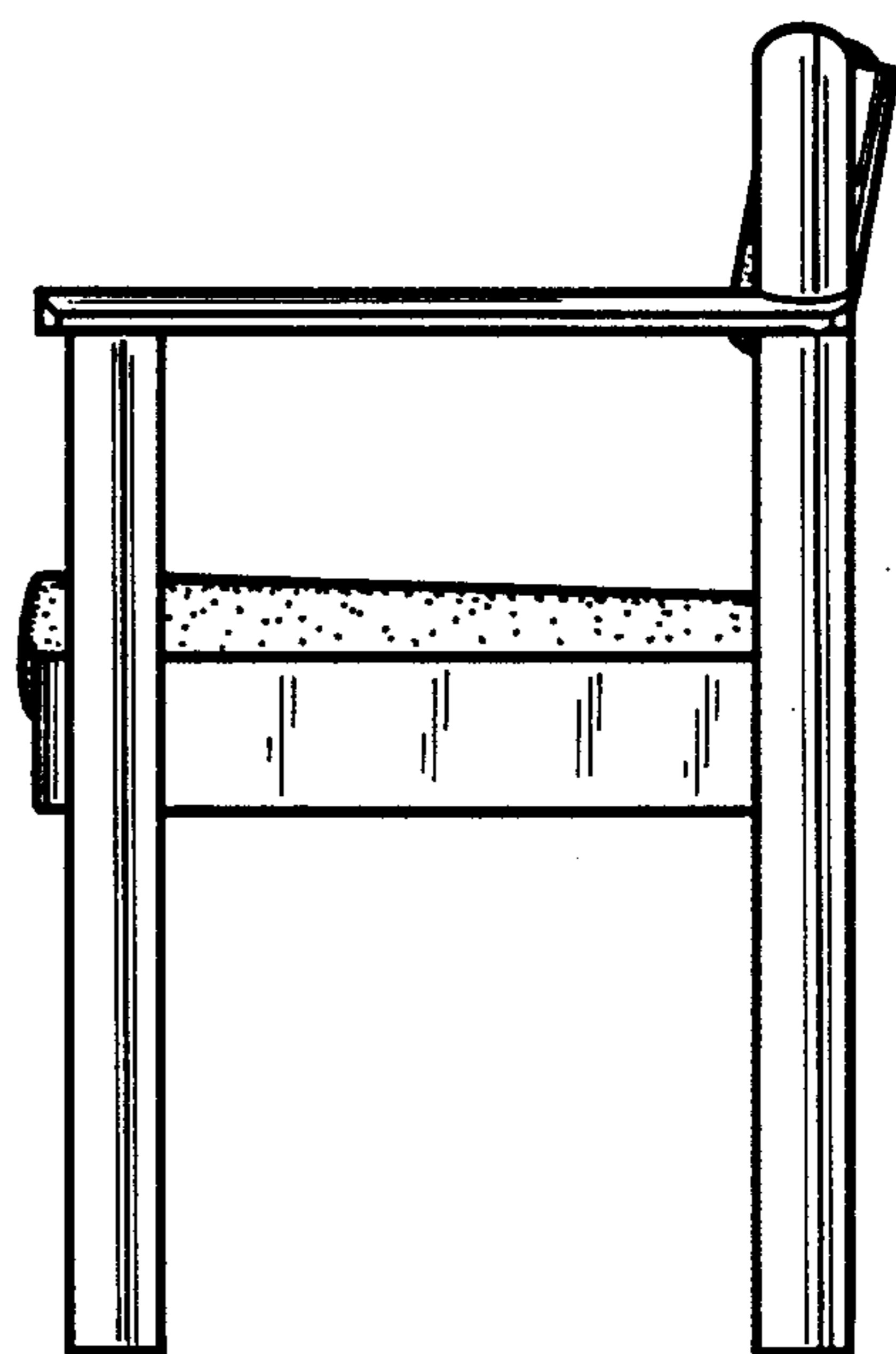

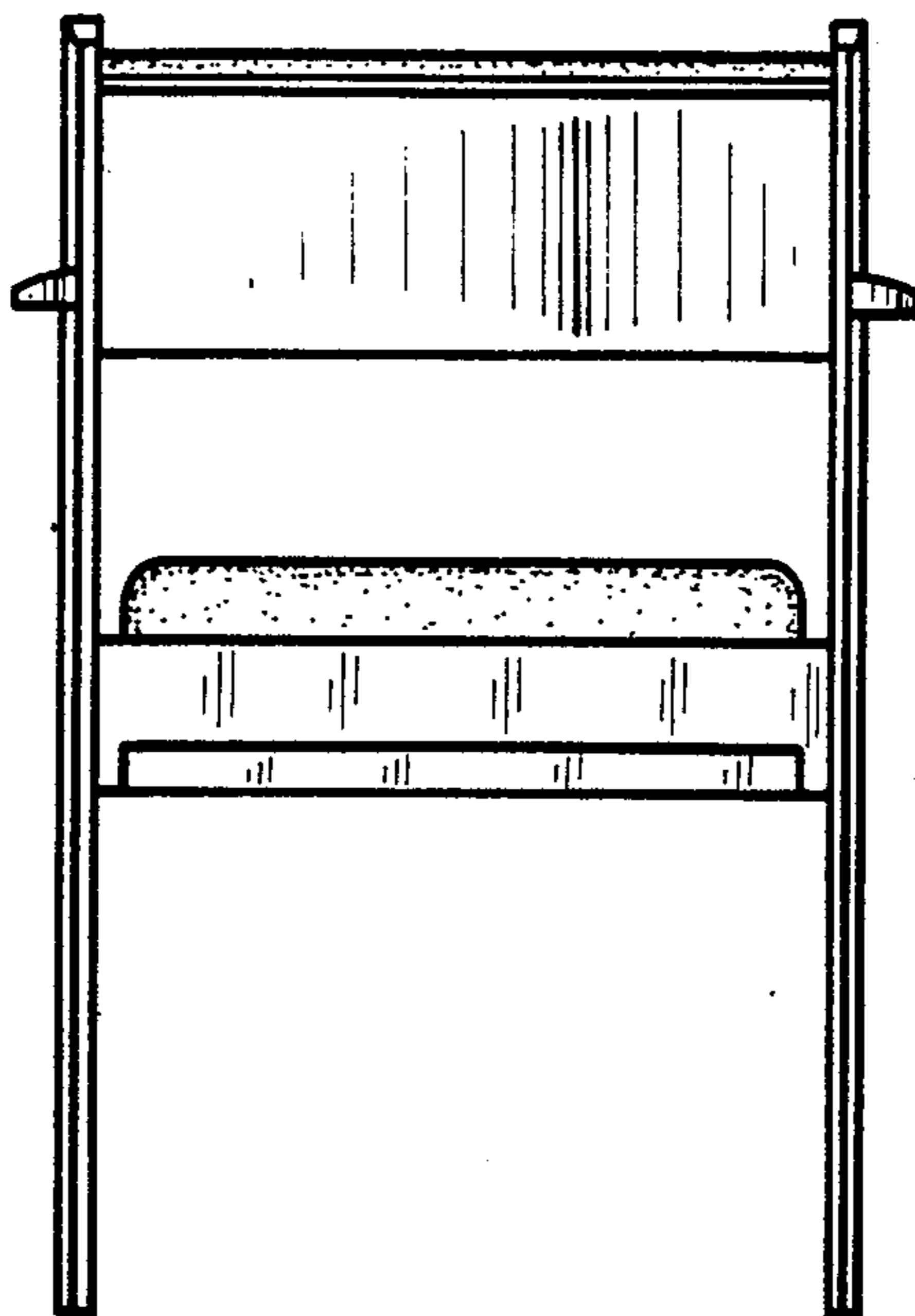

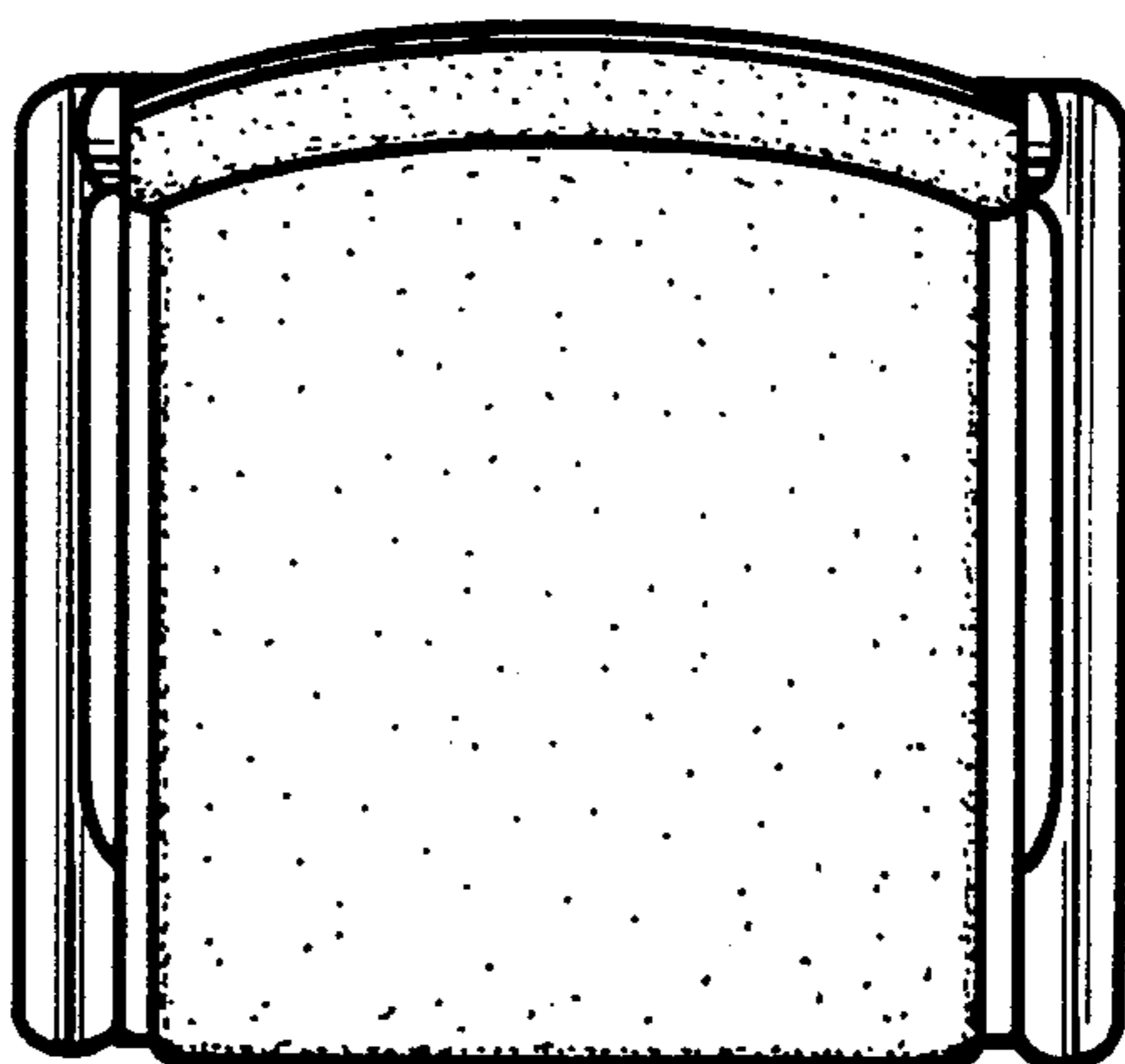
