The ornamental design for a bag, as shown and de-  
 scribed.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, left perspective view of a bag showing  
 our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side view  
 being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a left, bottom perspective view of a second  
 embodiment of FIG. 1, the only difference being an  
 opening at the bottom;  
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 7, the  
 right side being a mirror image;



**FIG. 11** is a bottom plan view of **FIG. 7**, the top plan being the same as that of **FIG. 1**;

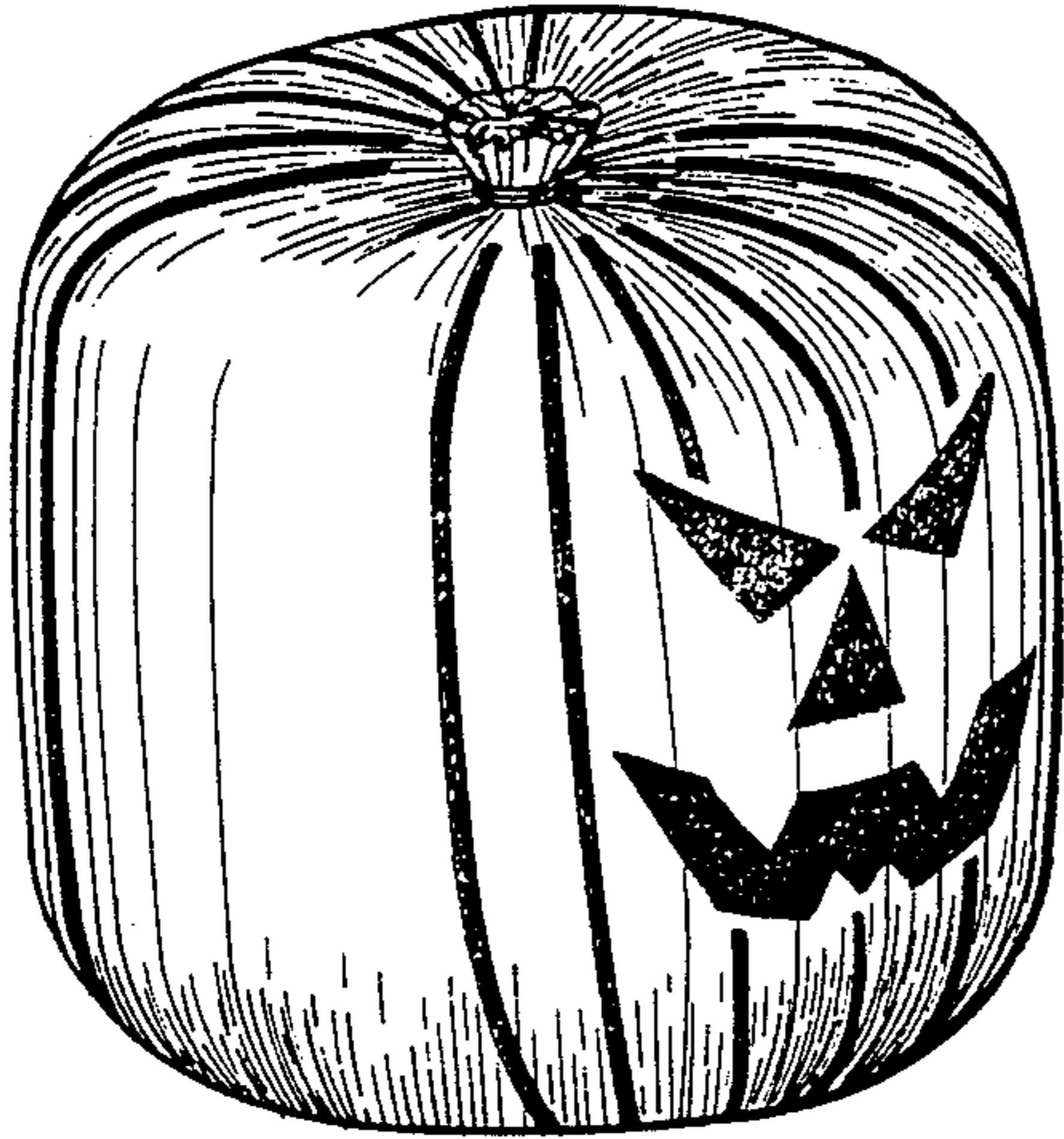
**FIG. 12** is a front elevational view of a third embodi-

**FIG. 15** is a bottom plan view of **FIG. 12**.



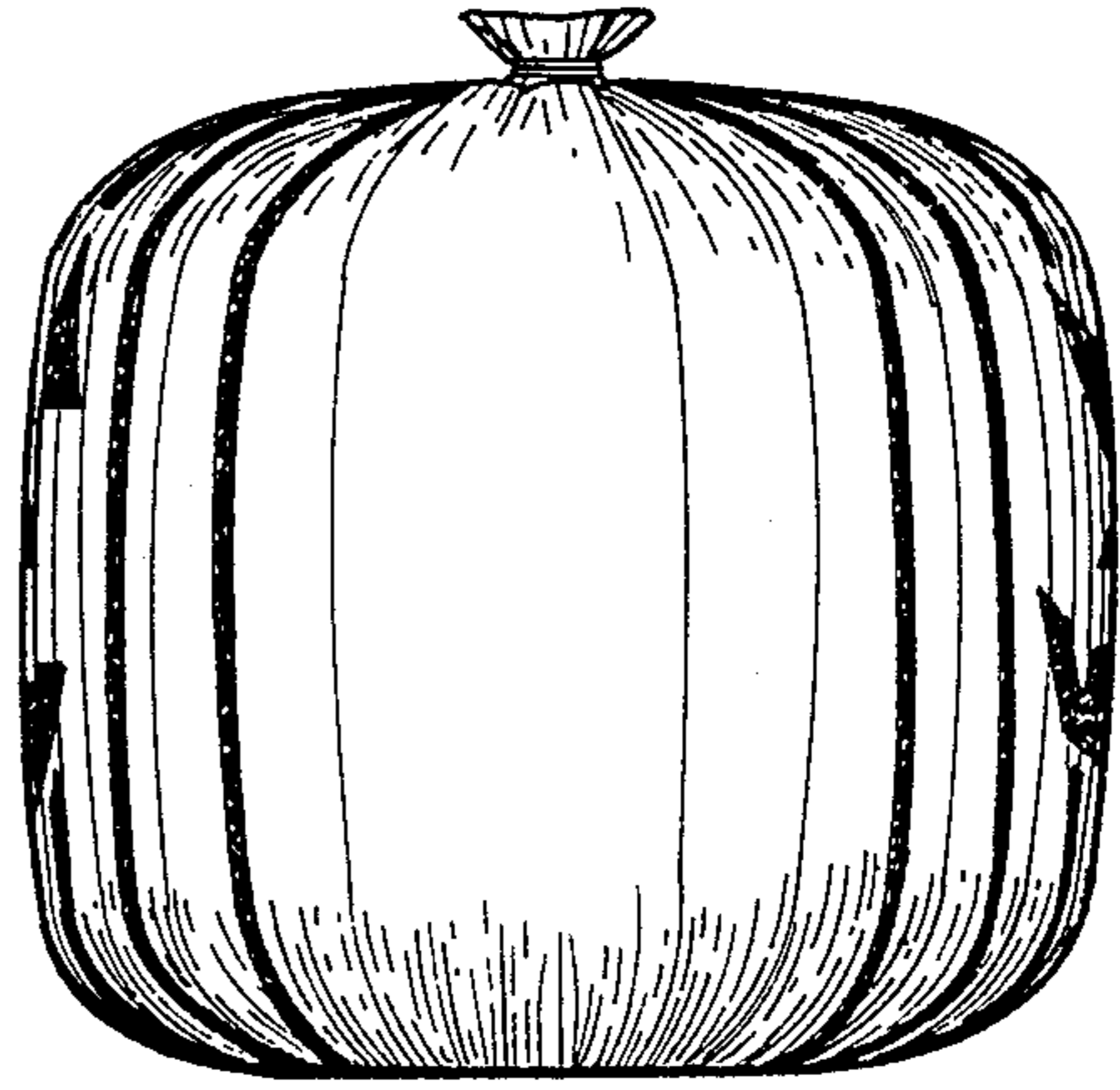

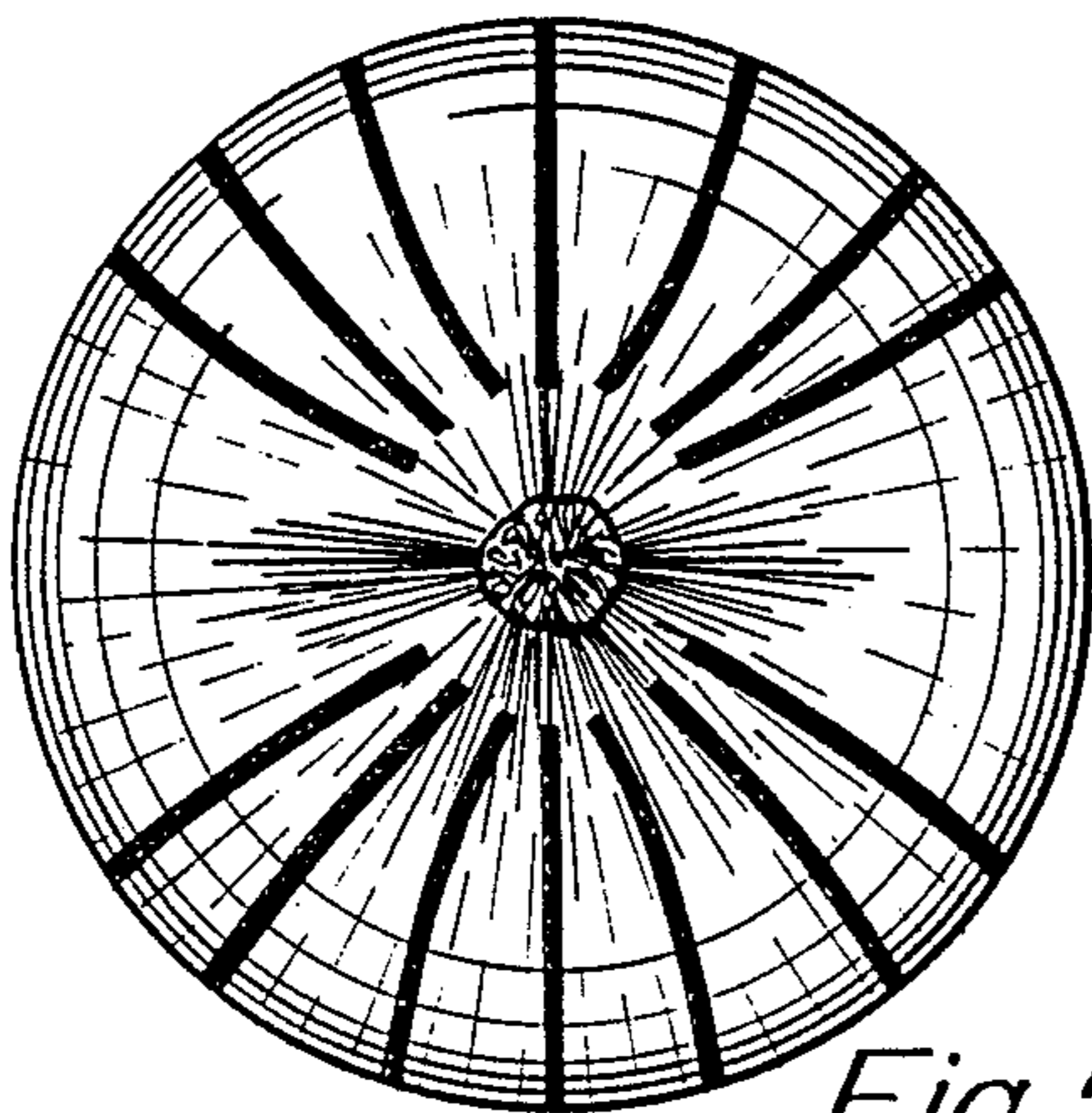

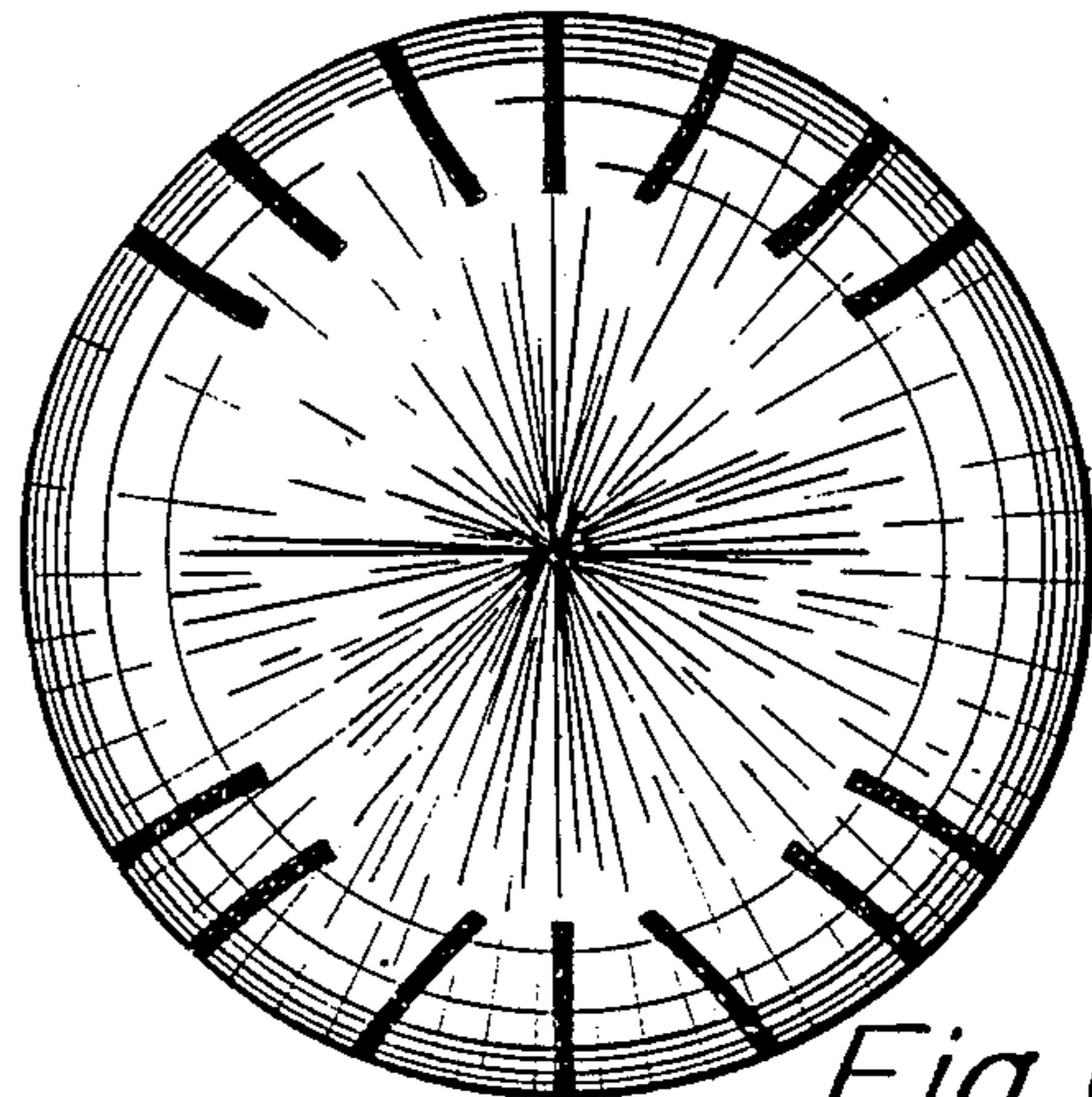

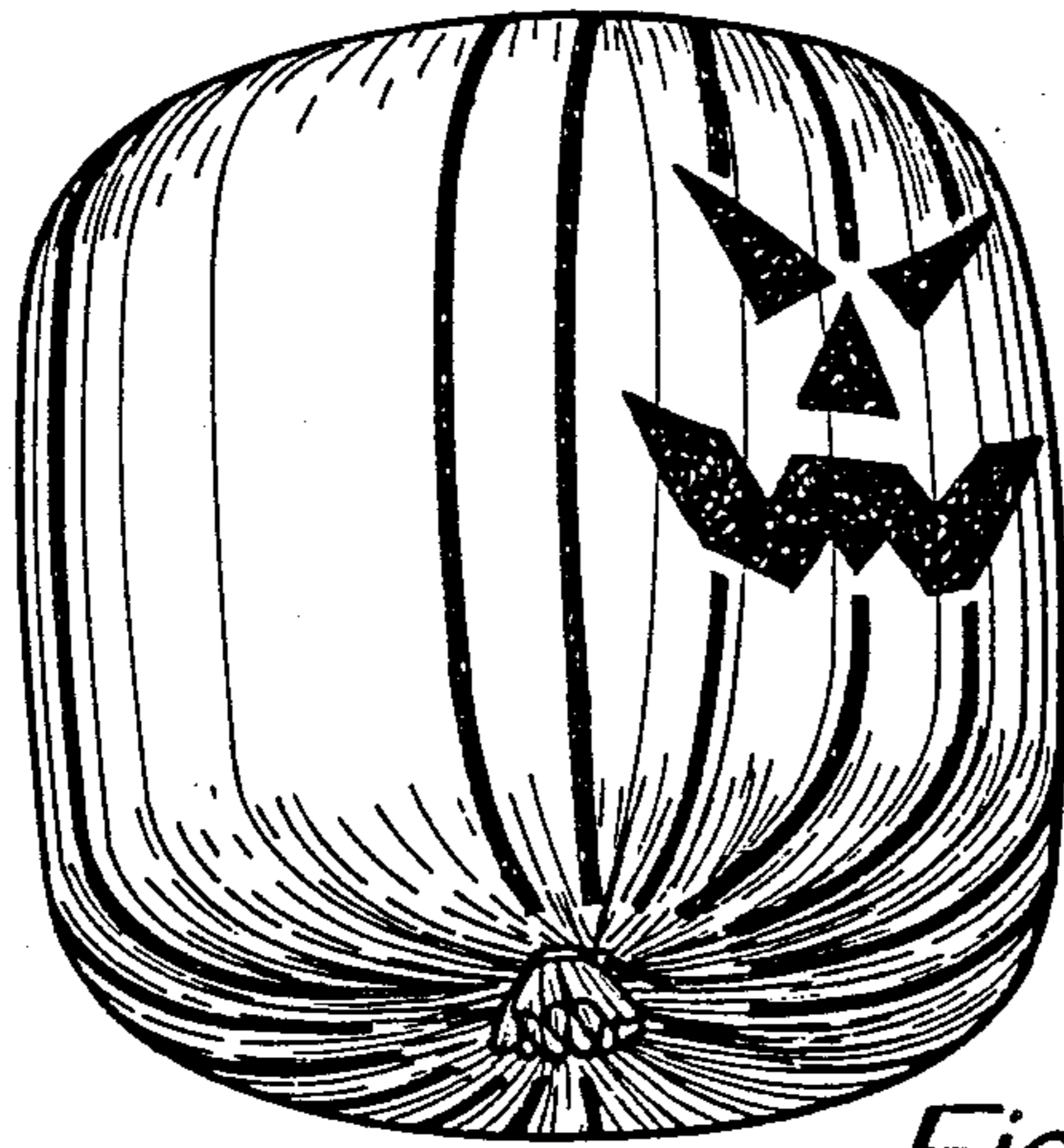

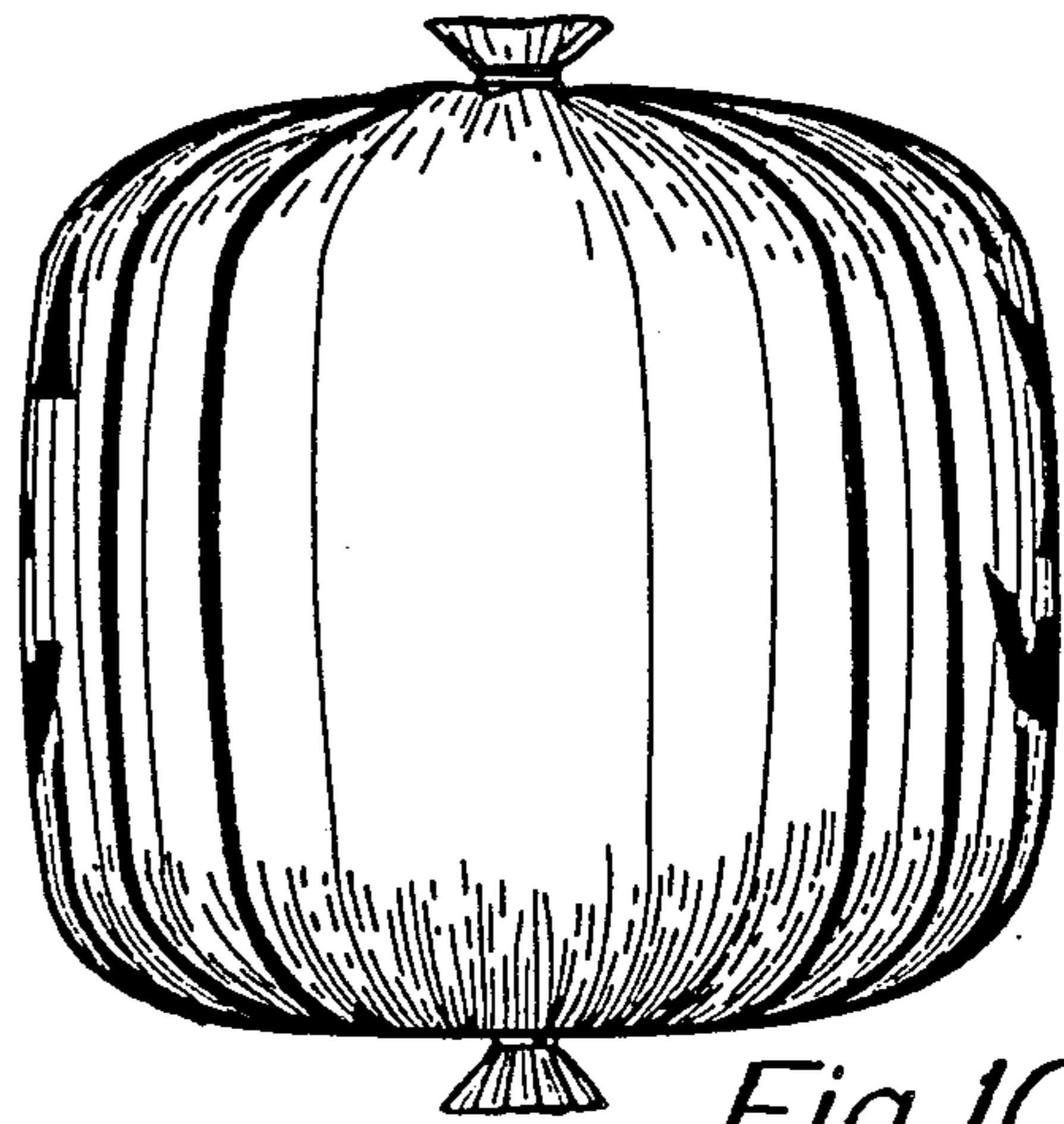

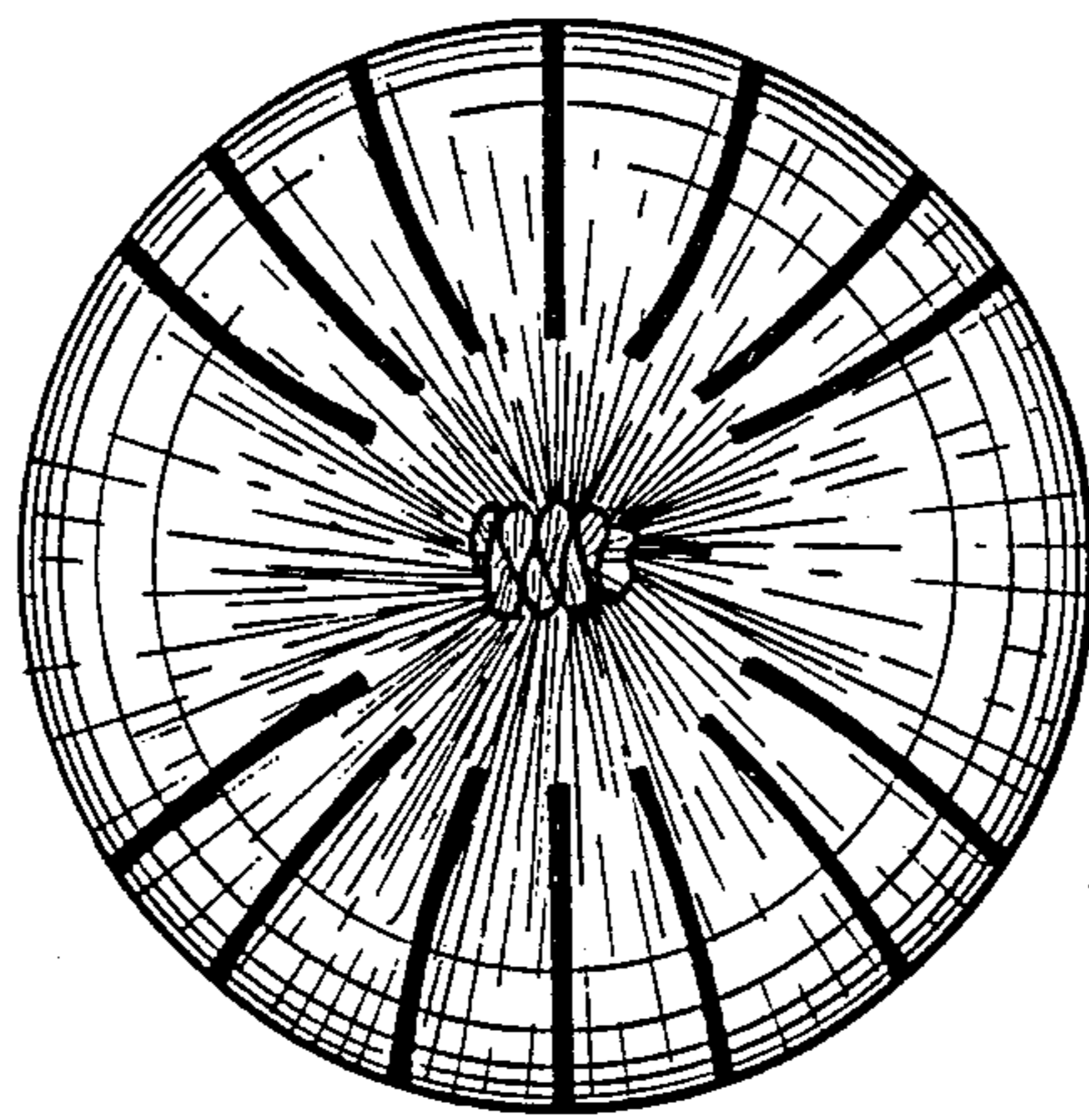

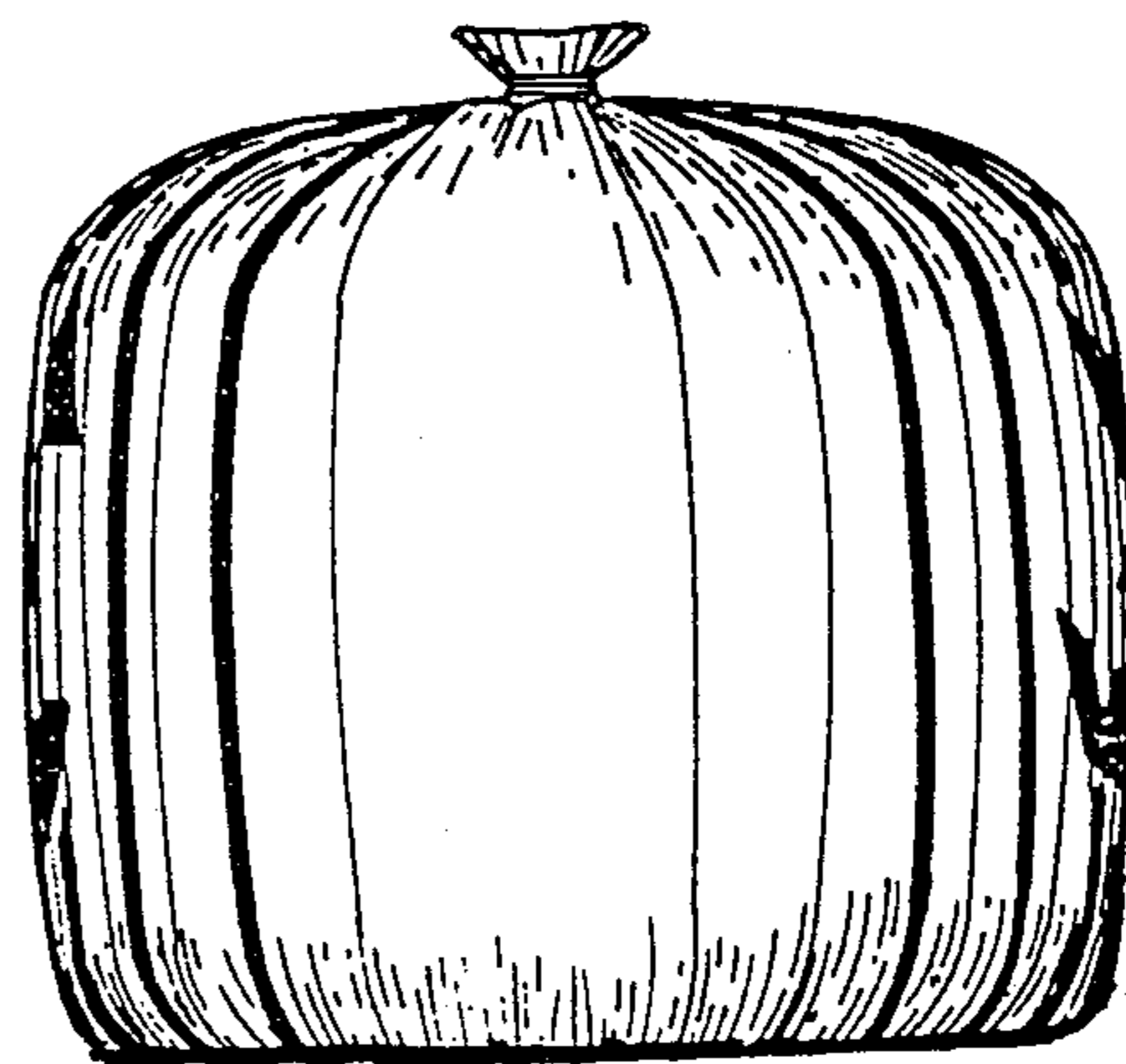

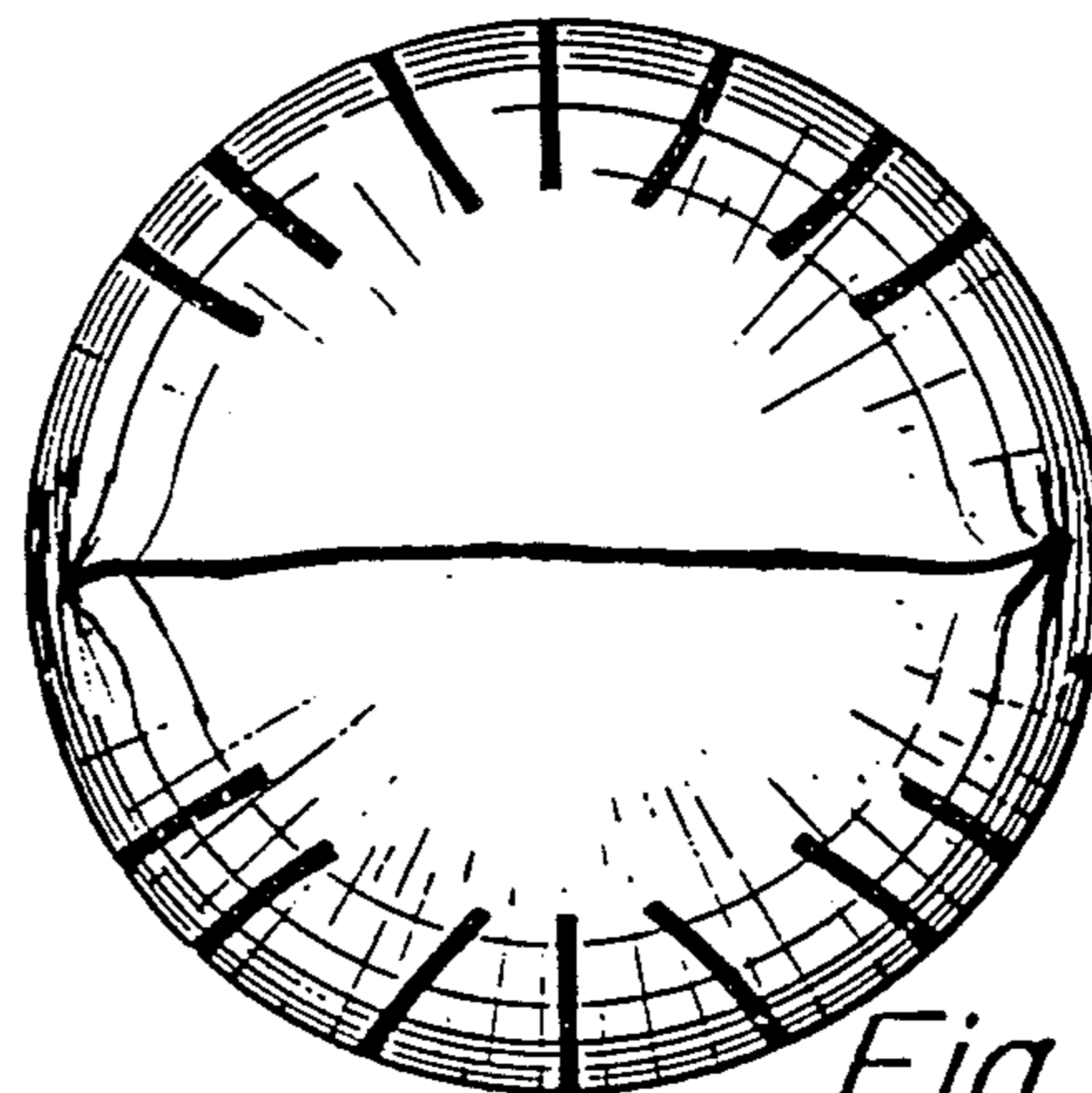
