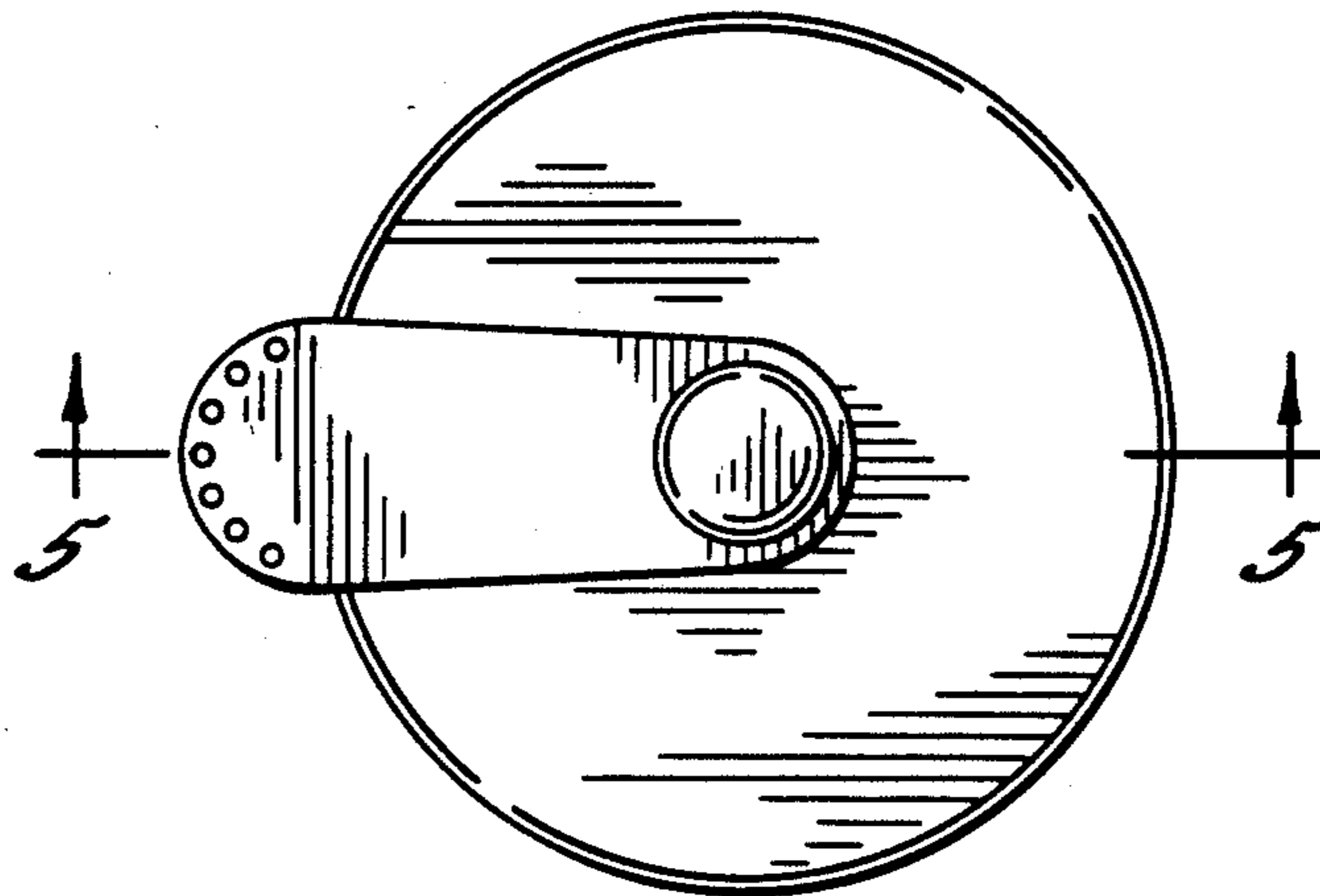

The ornamental design for beverage can cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a beverage can cover showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view of FIG. 1, taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5—5; the portion of a can shown in broken lines for environmental purposes only;
 FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view similar to FIG. 5, the closure shown in an open position.



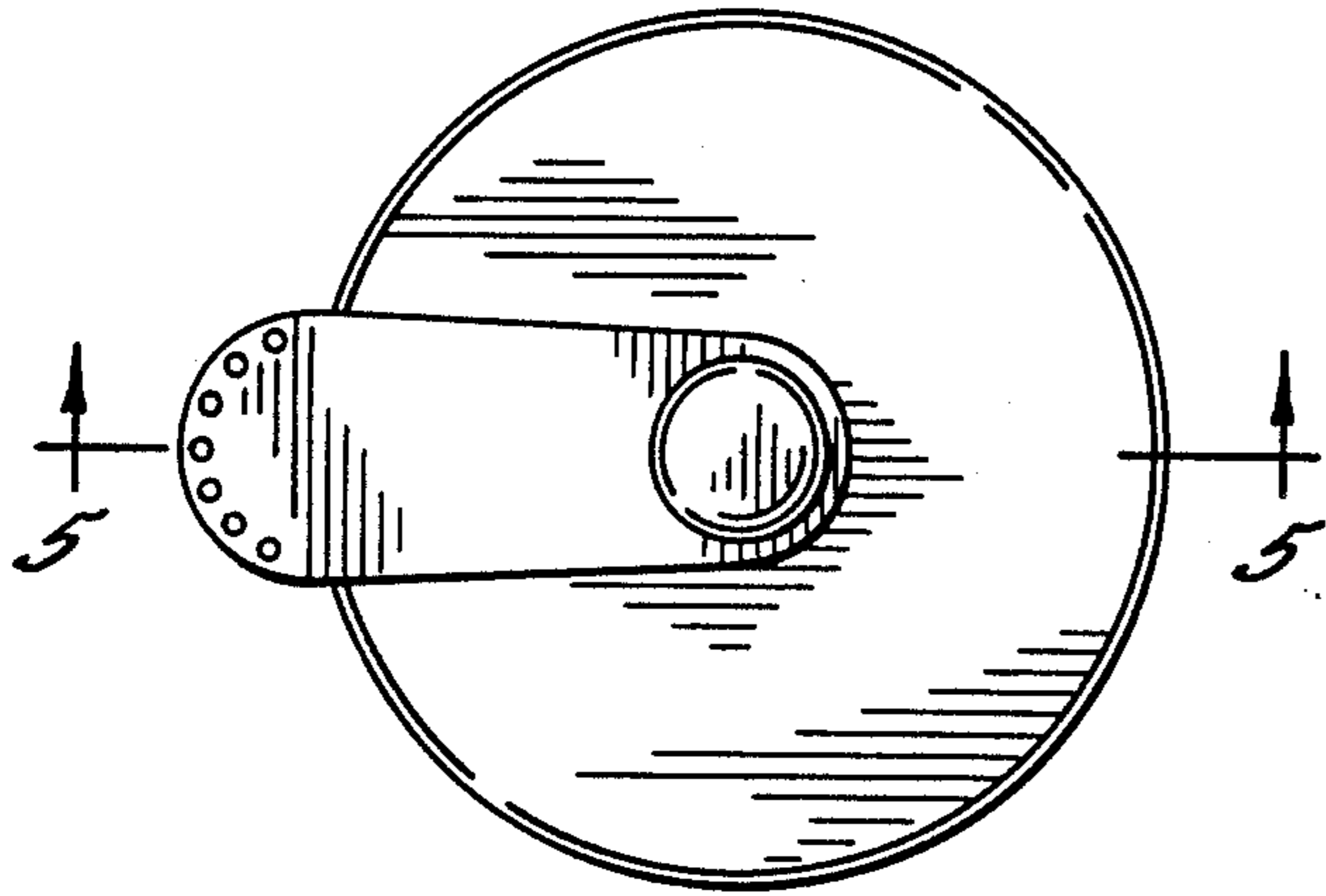

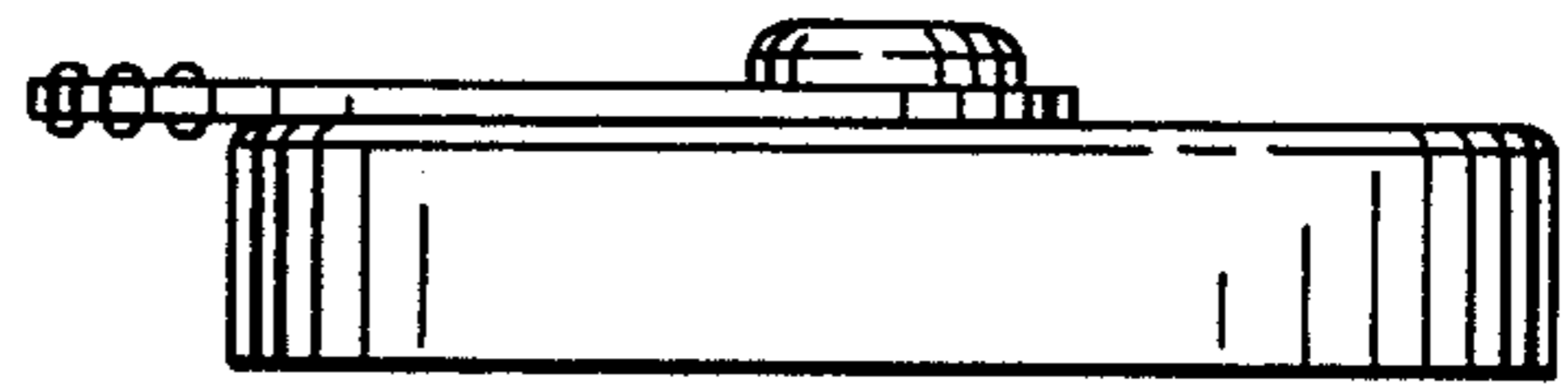

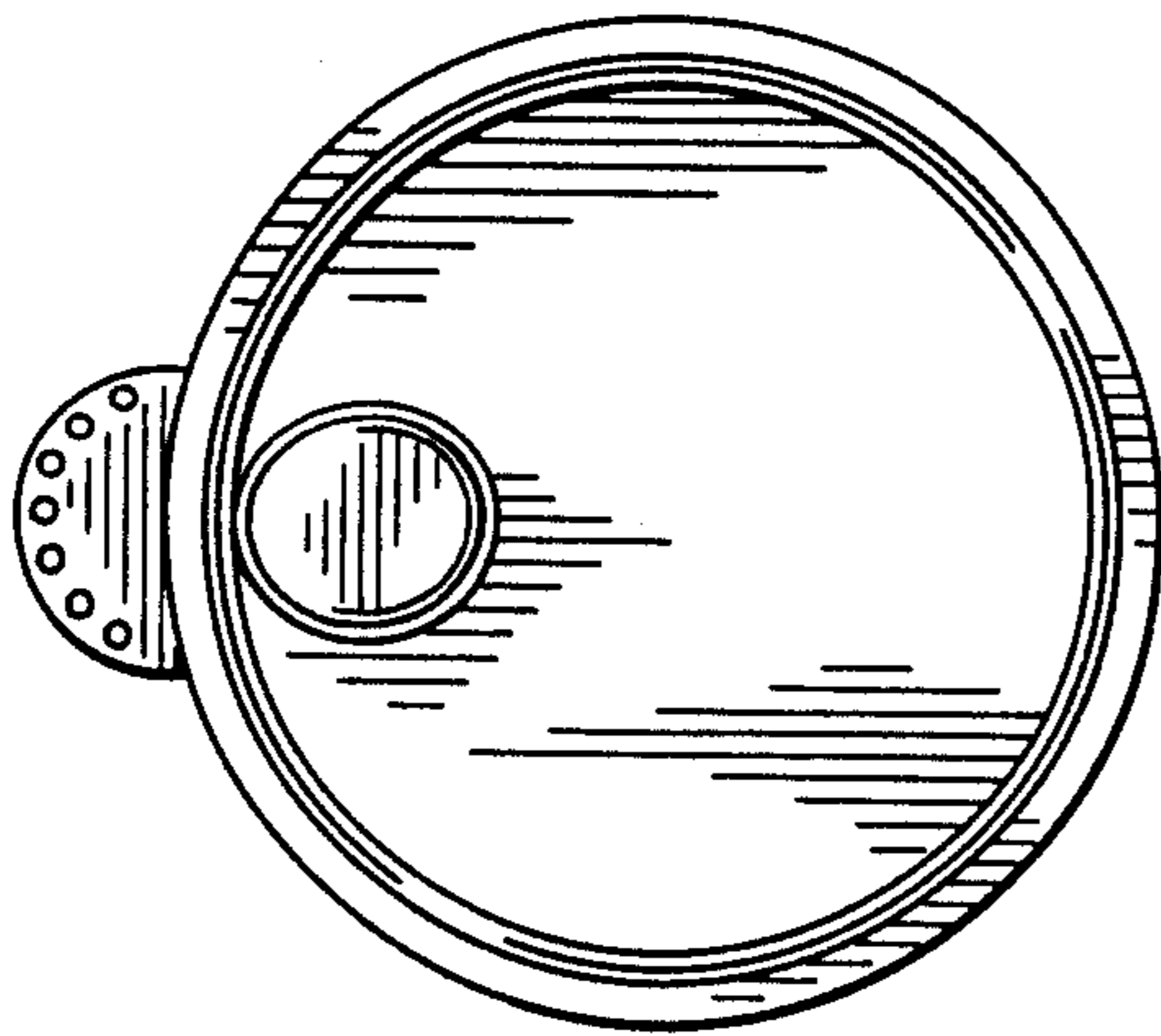

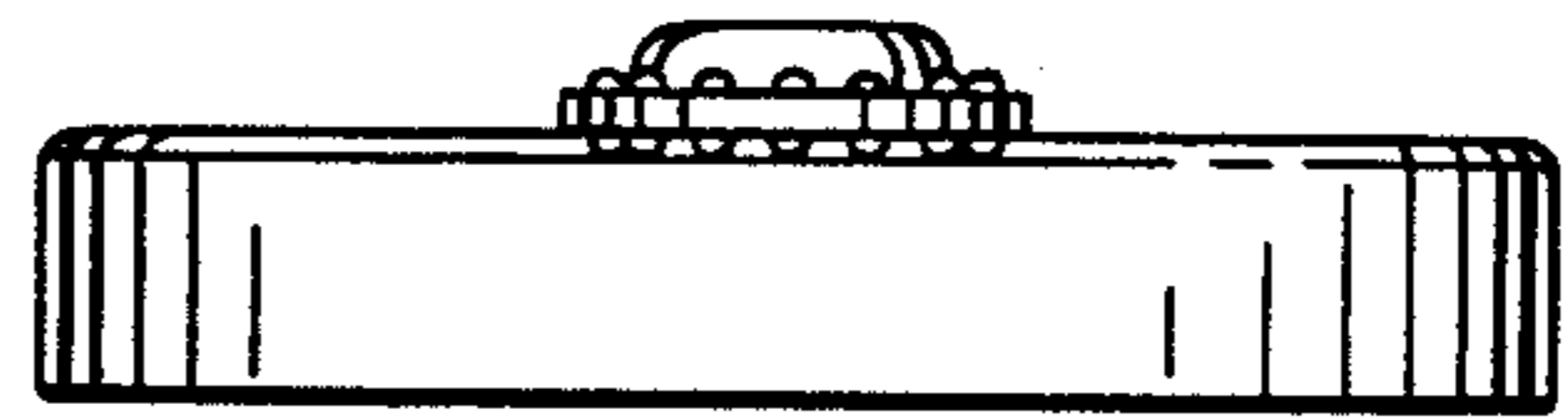

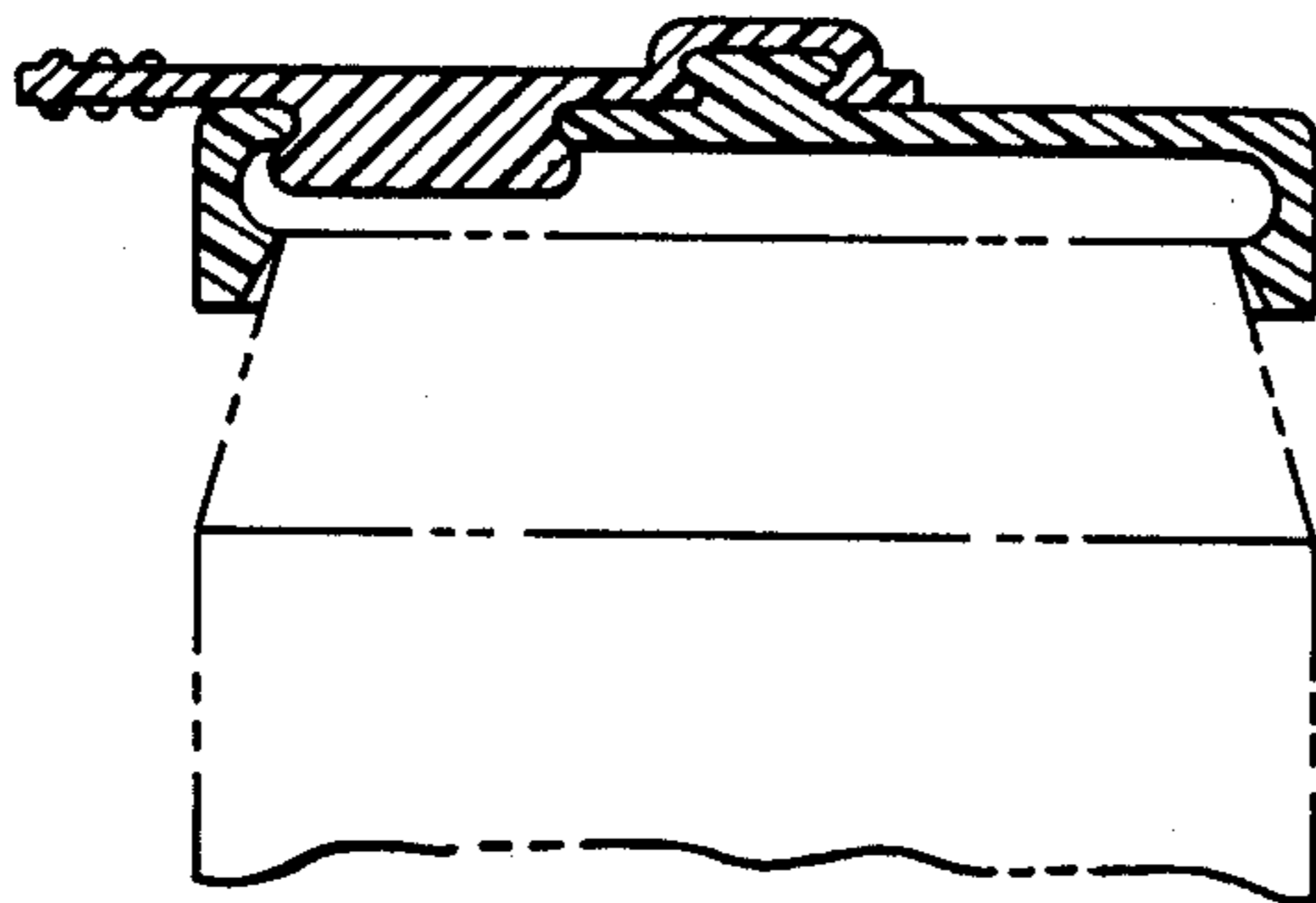

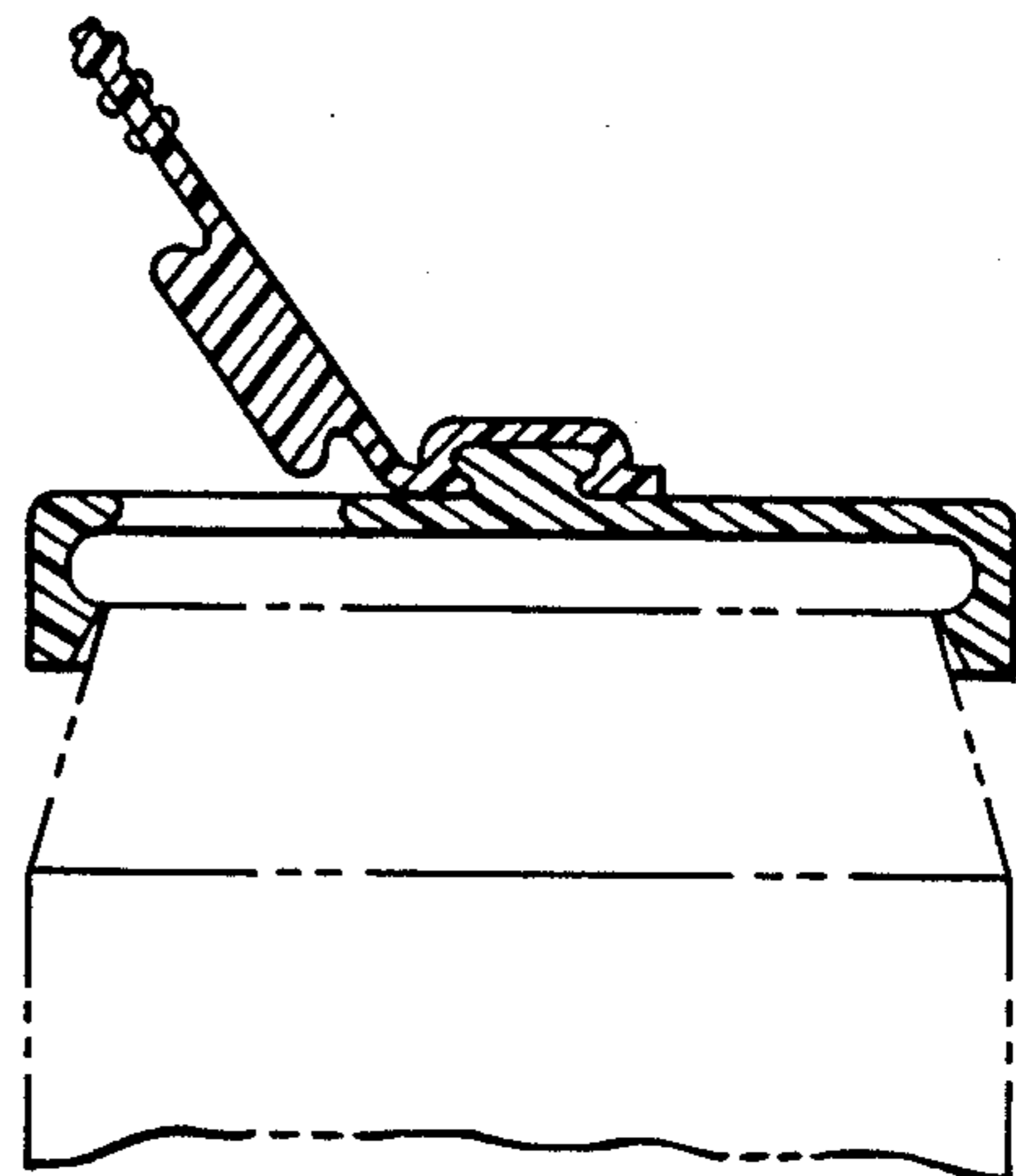
