[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a digital audio tape recorder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a digital audio tape recorder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, rotated 180 degrees from FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof.

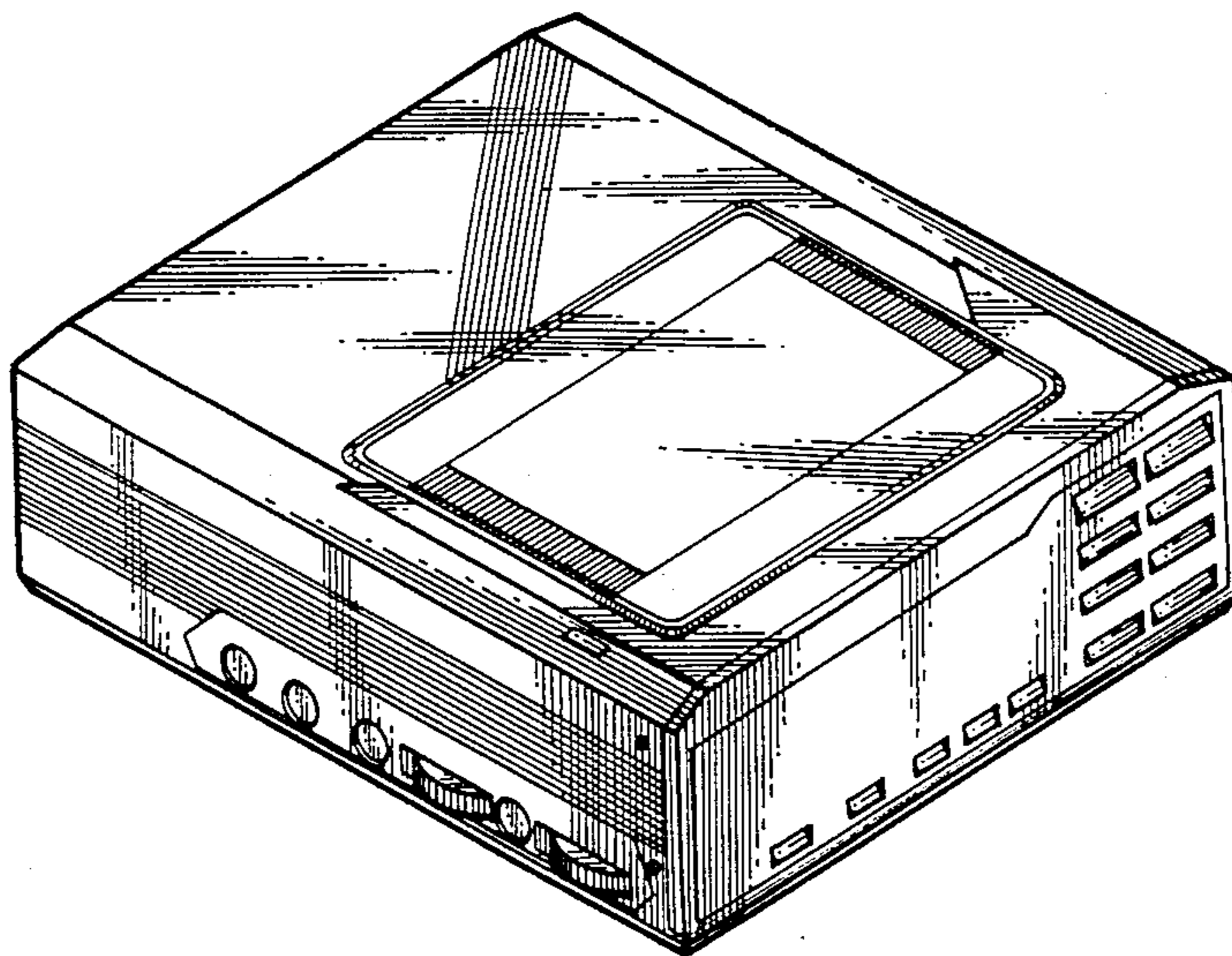

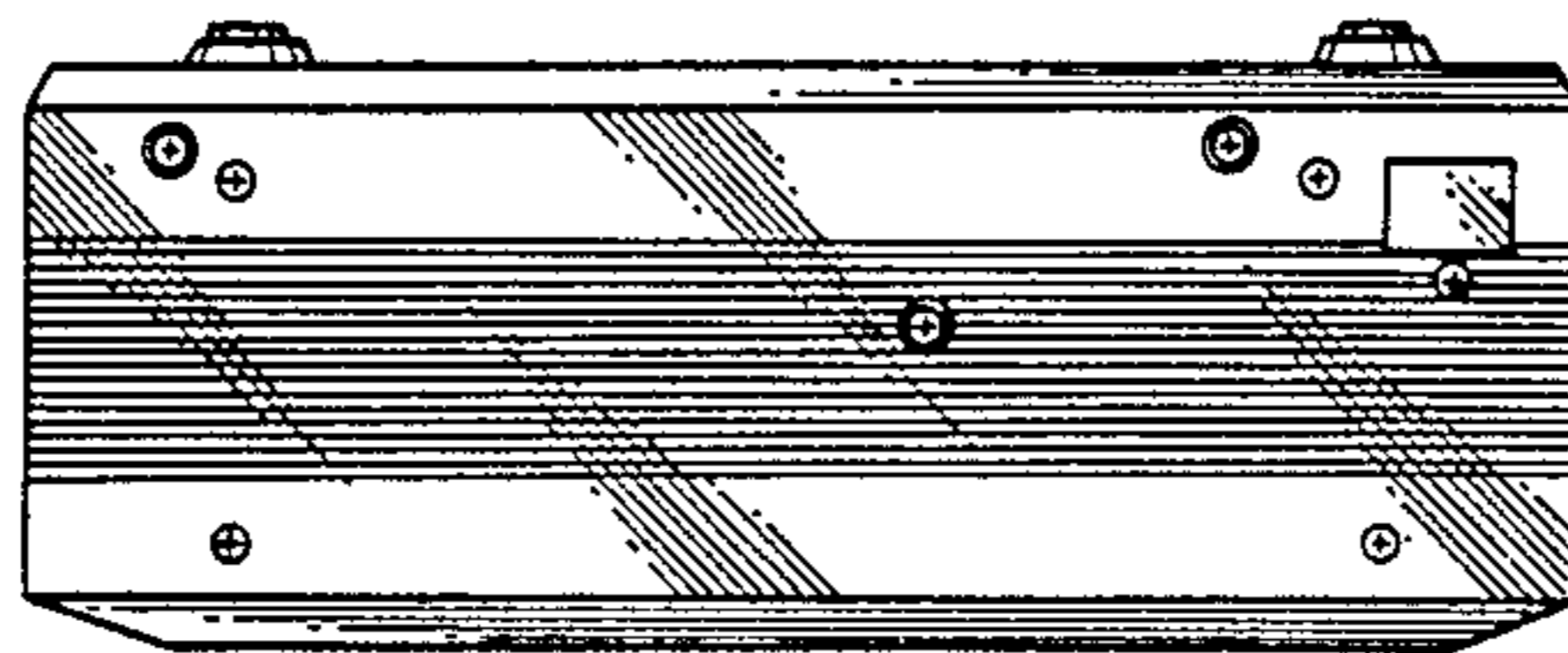

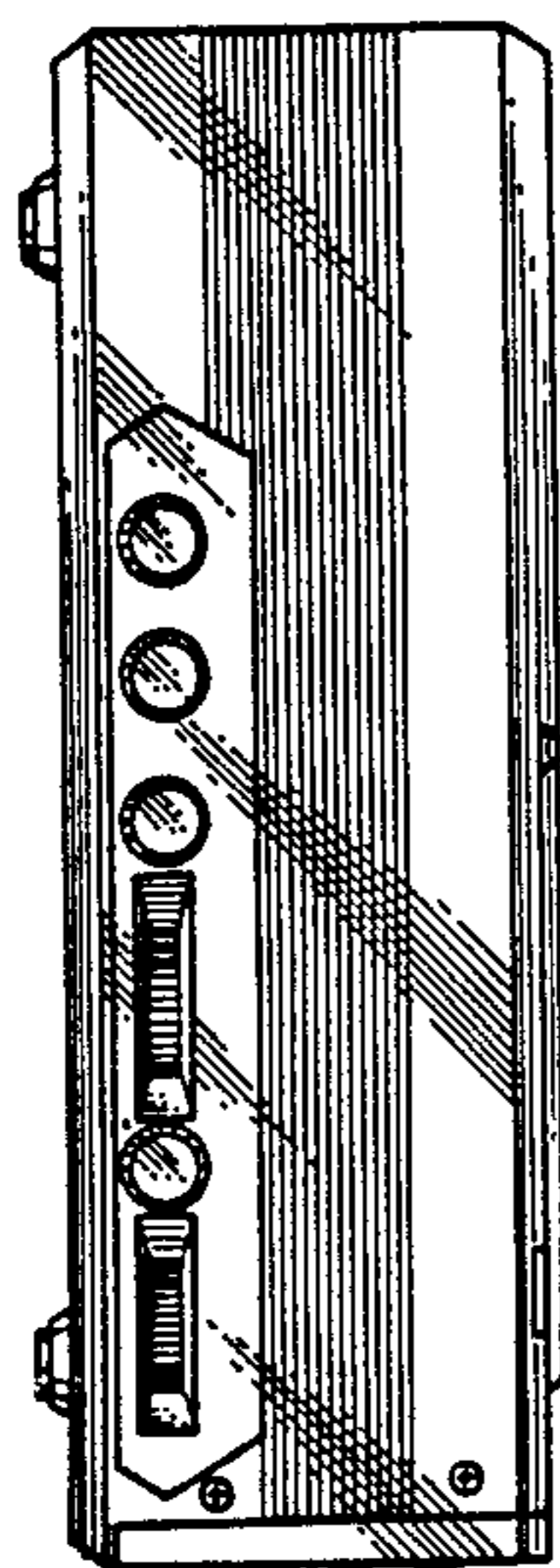

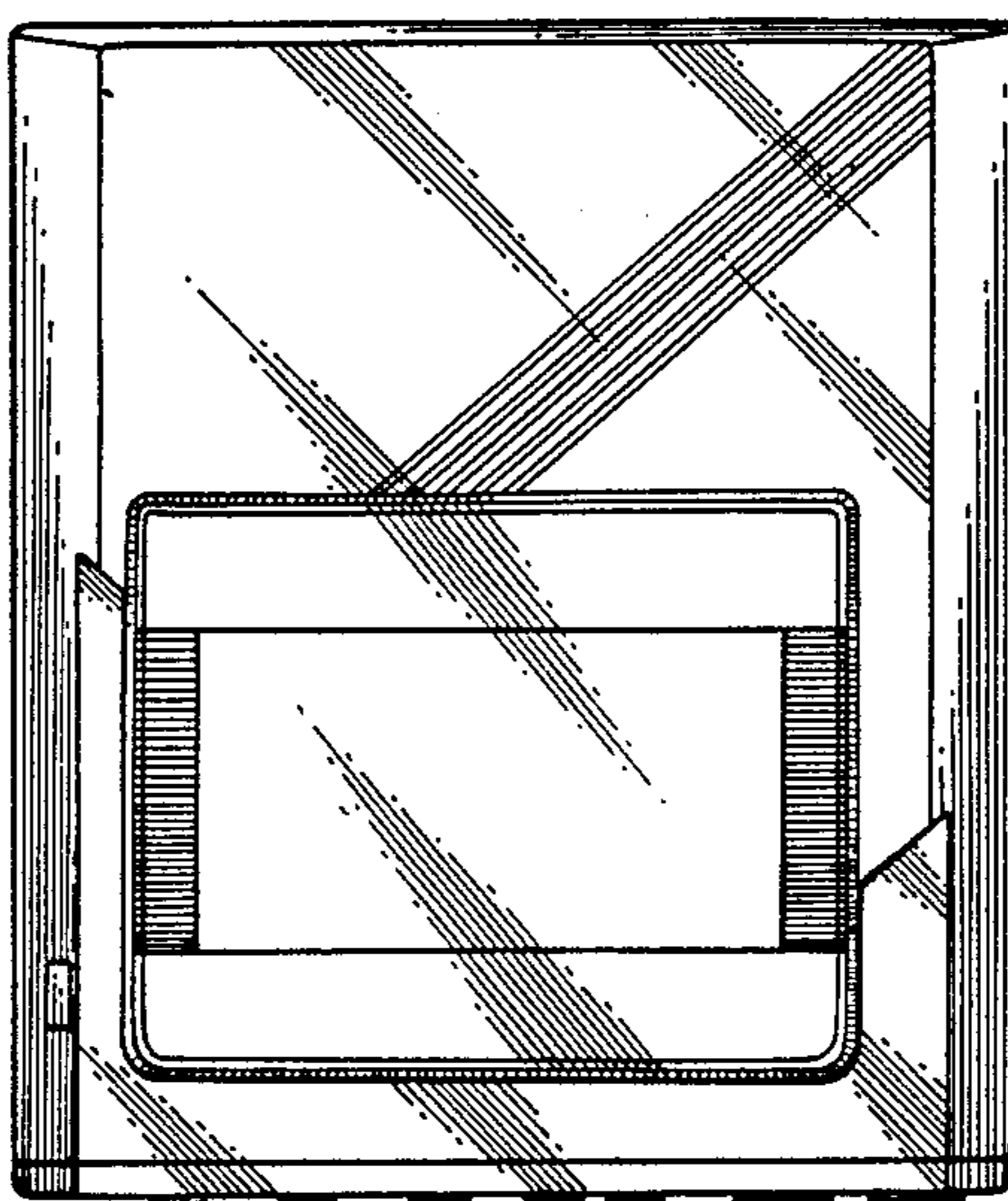

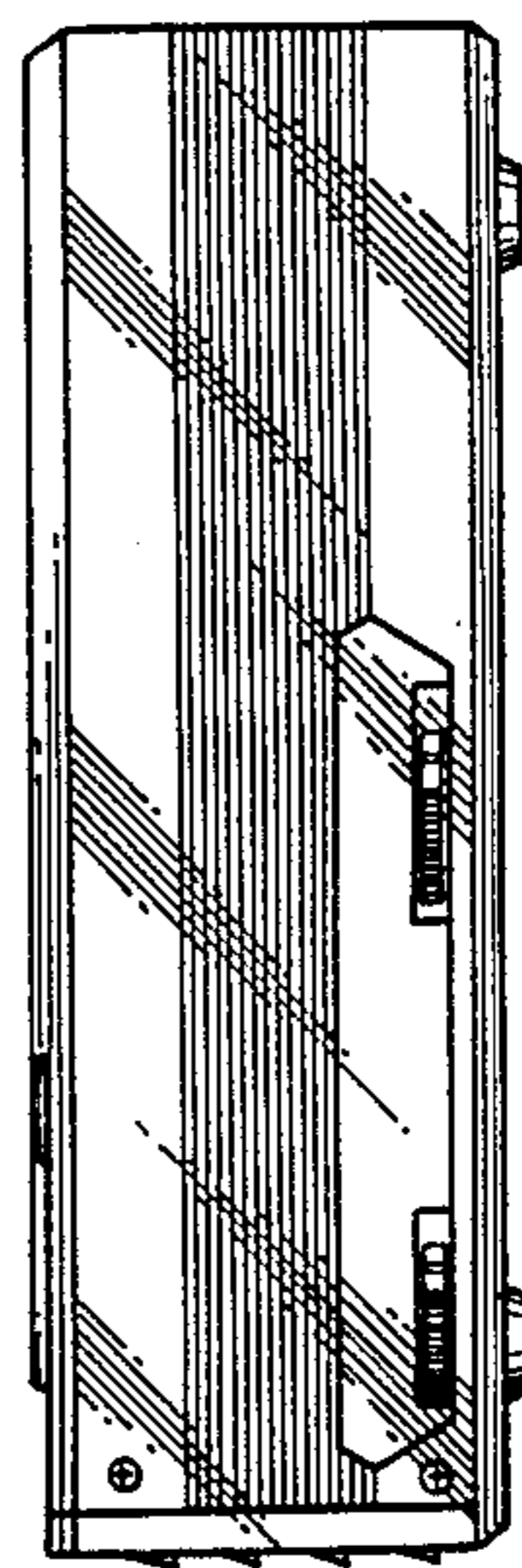

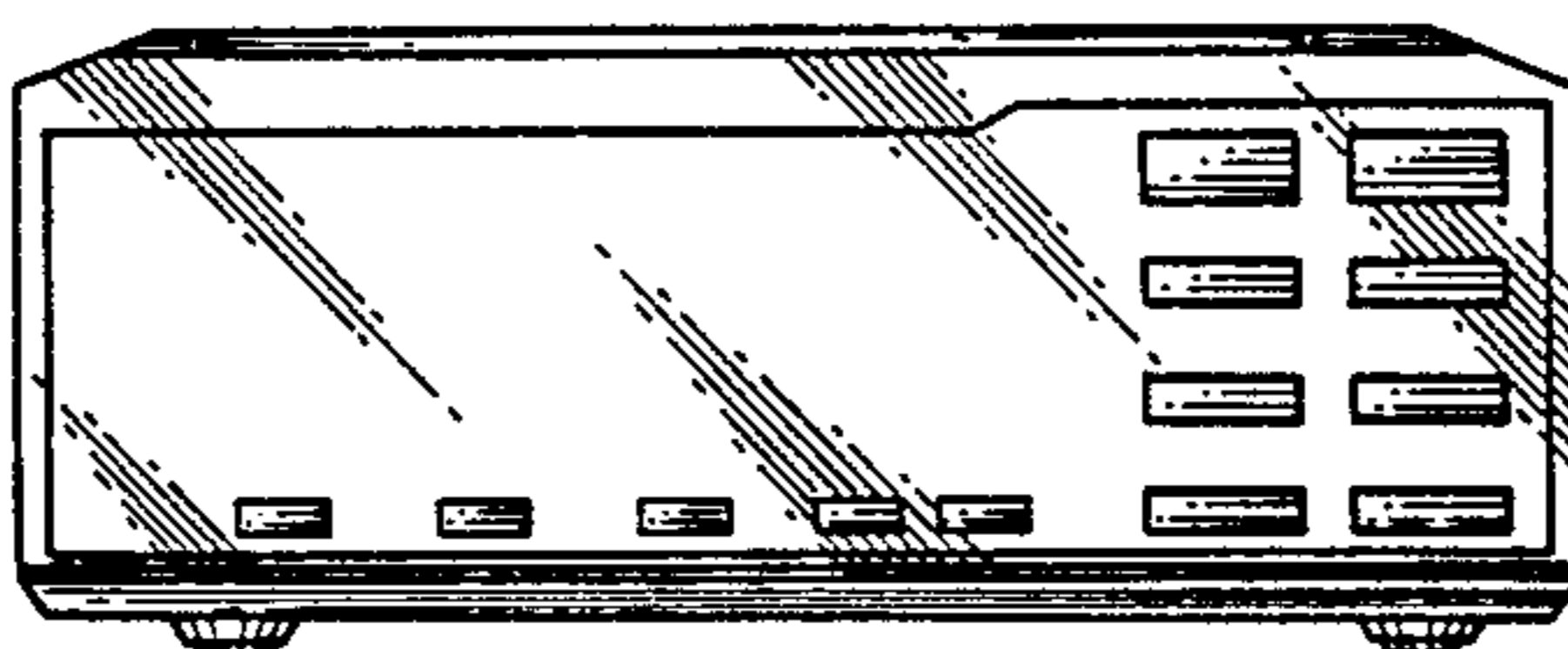

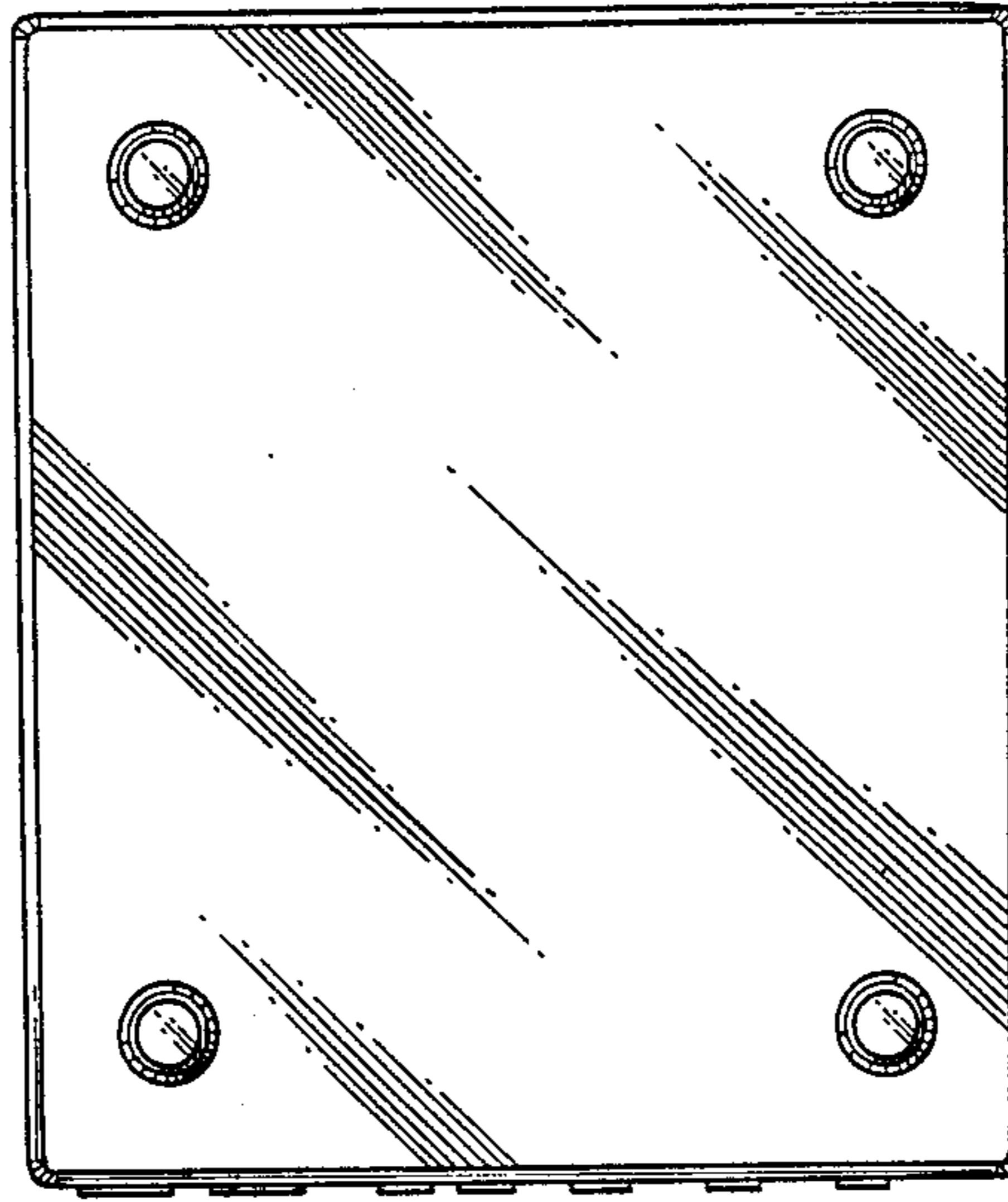
