DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a tape recorder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.

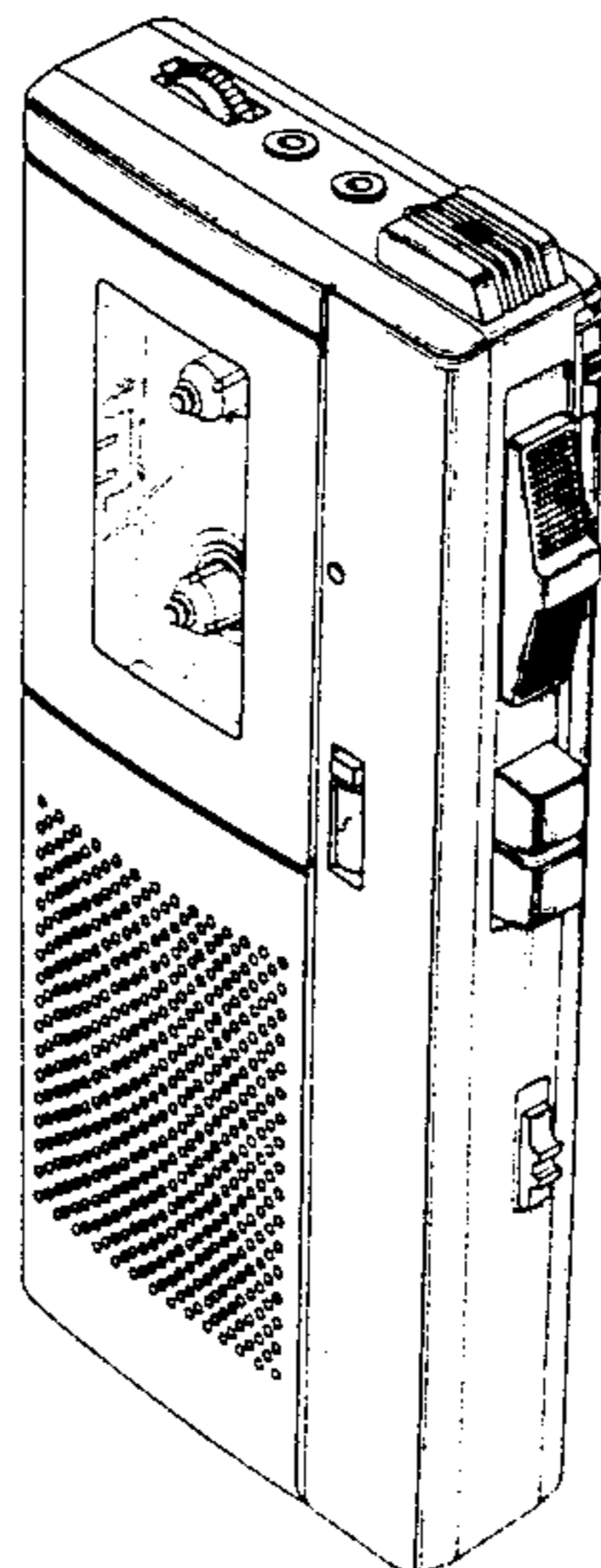

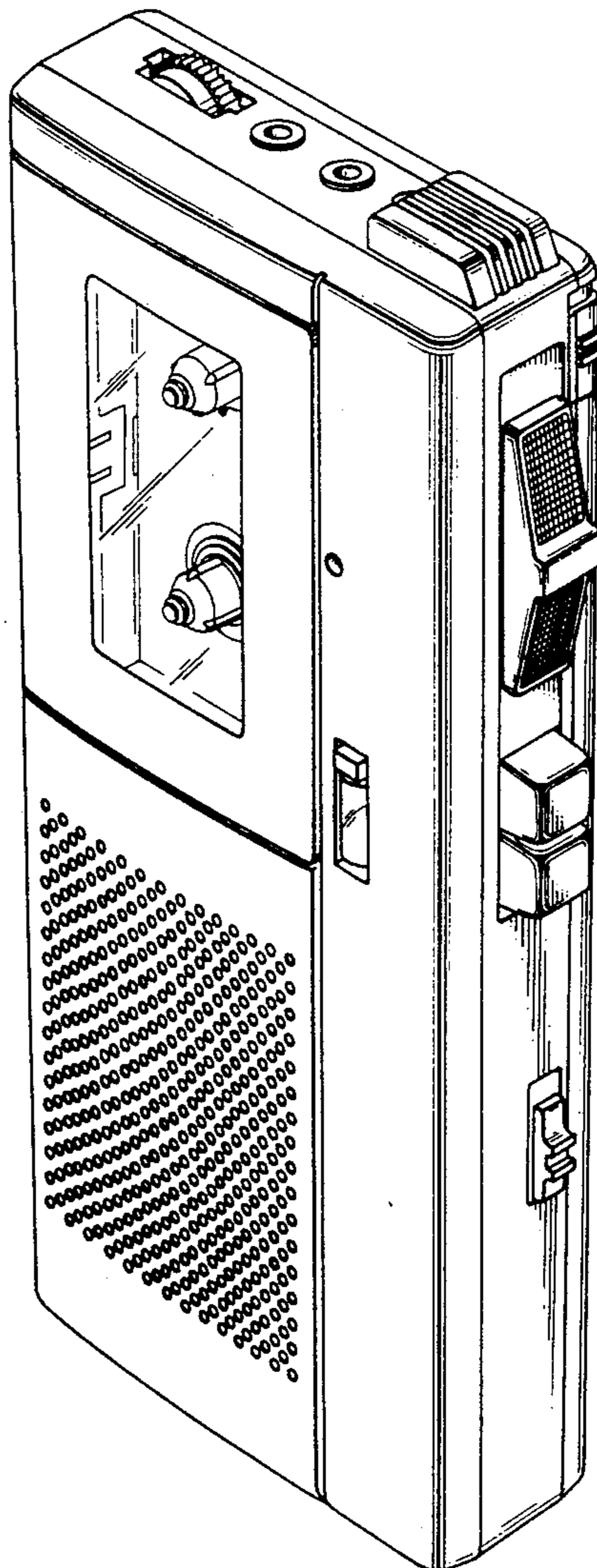

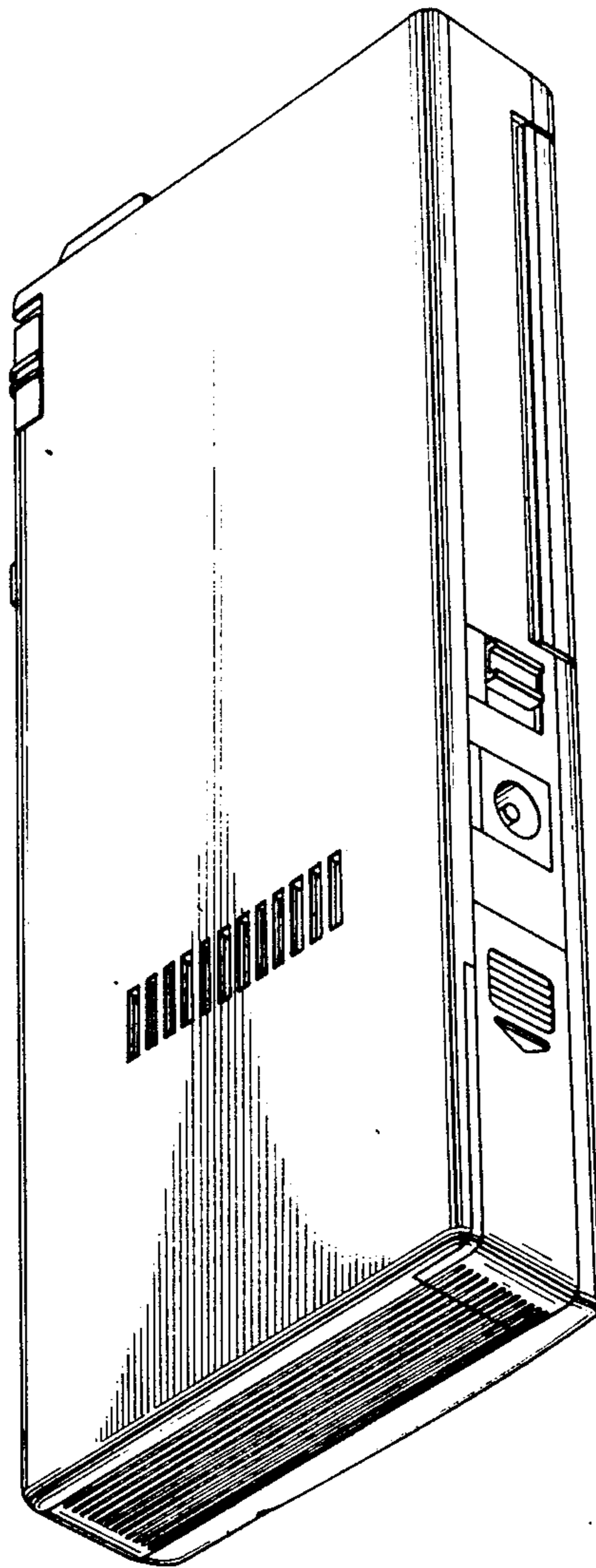

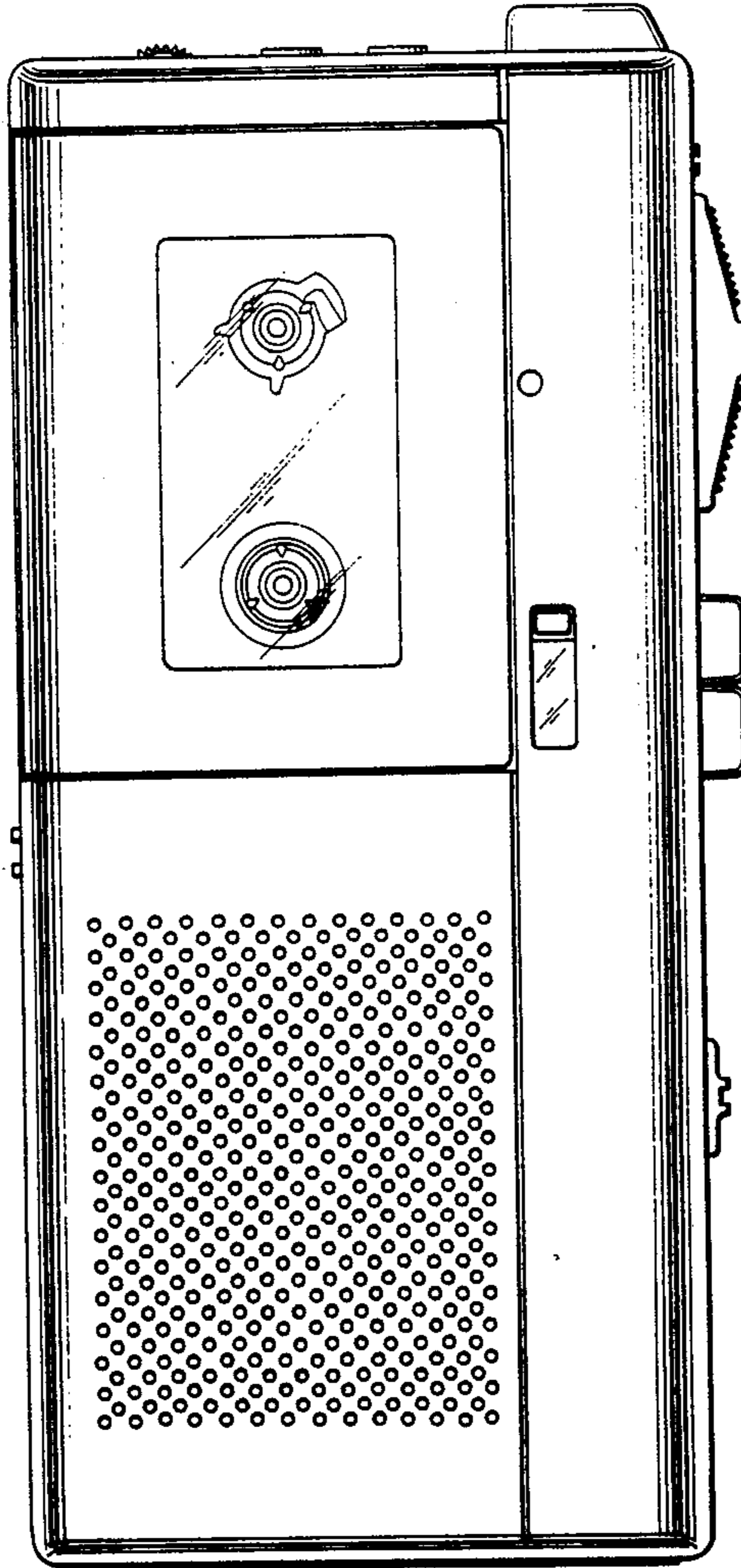

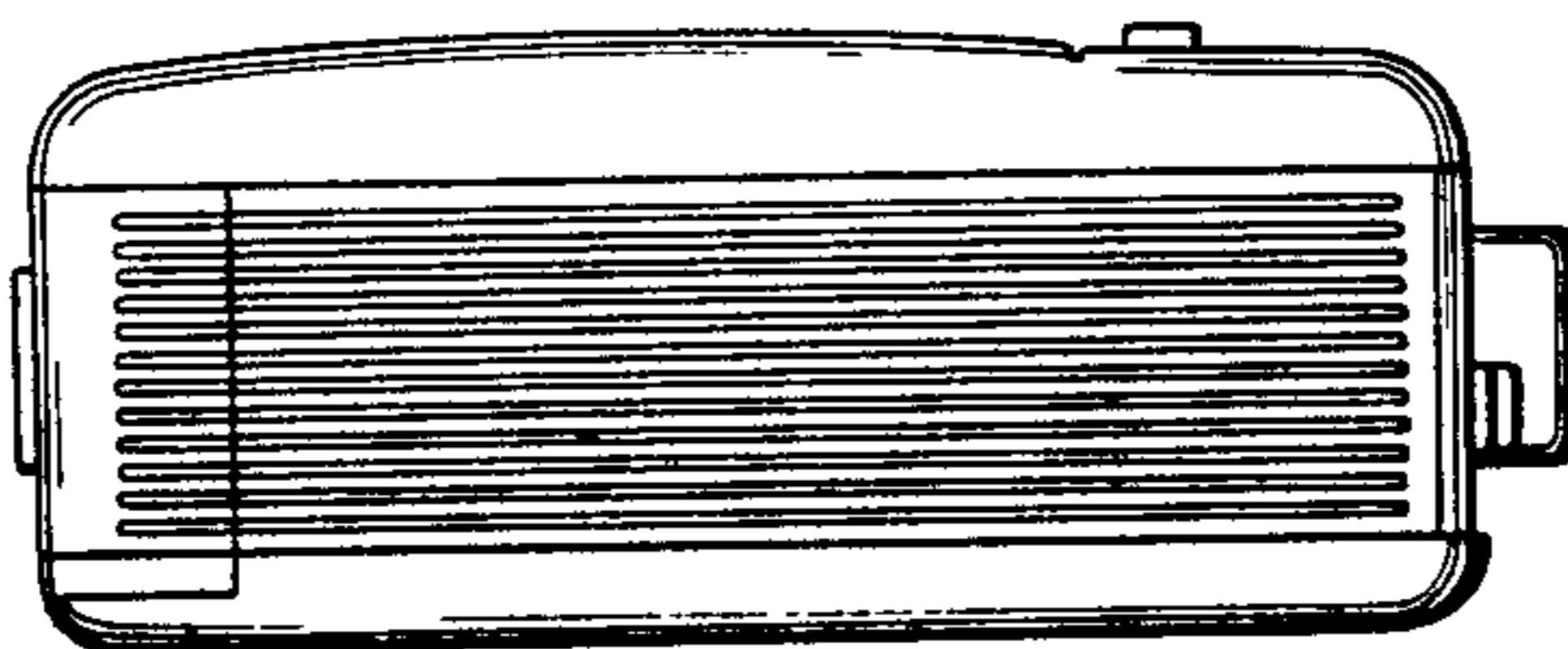

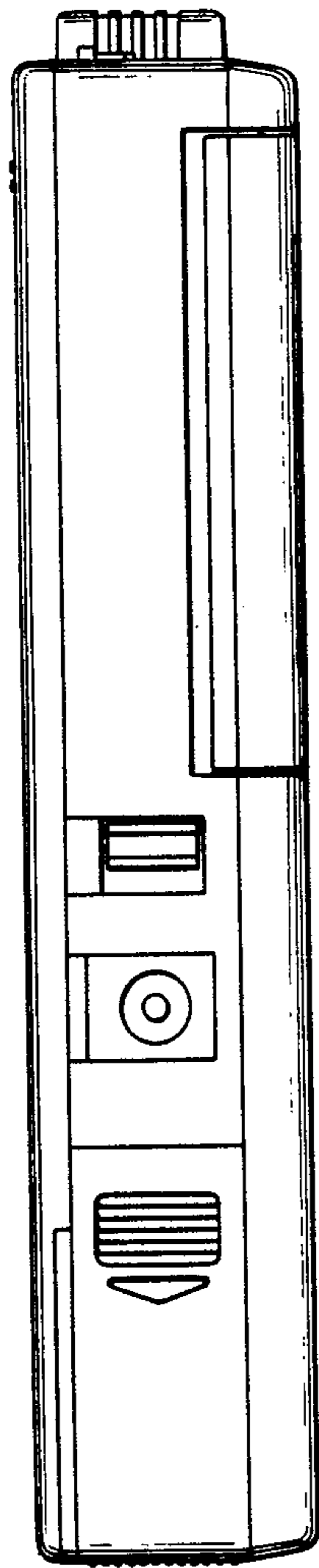

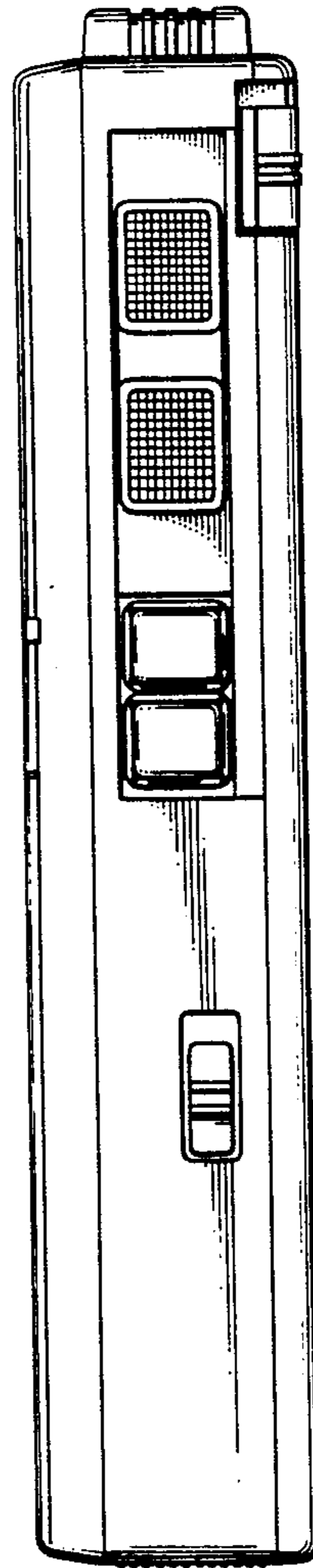

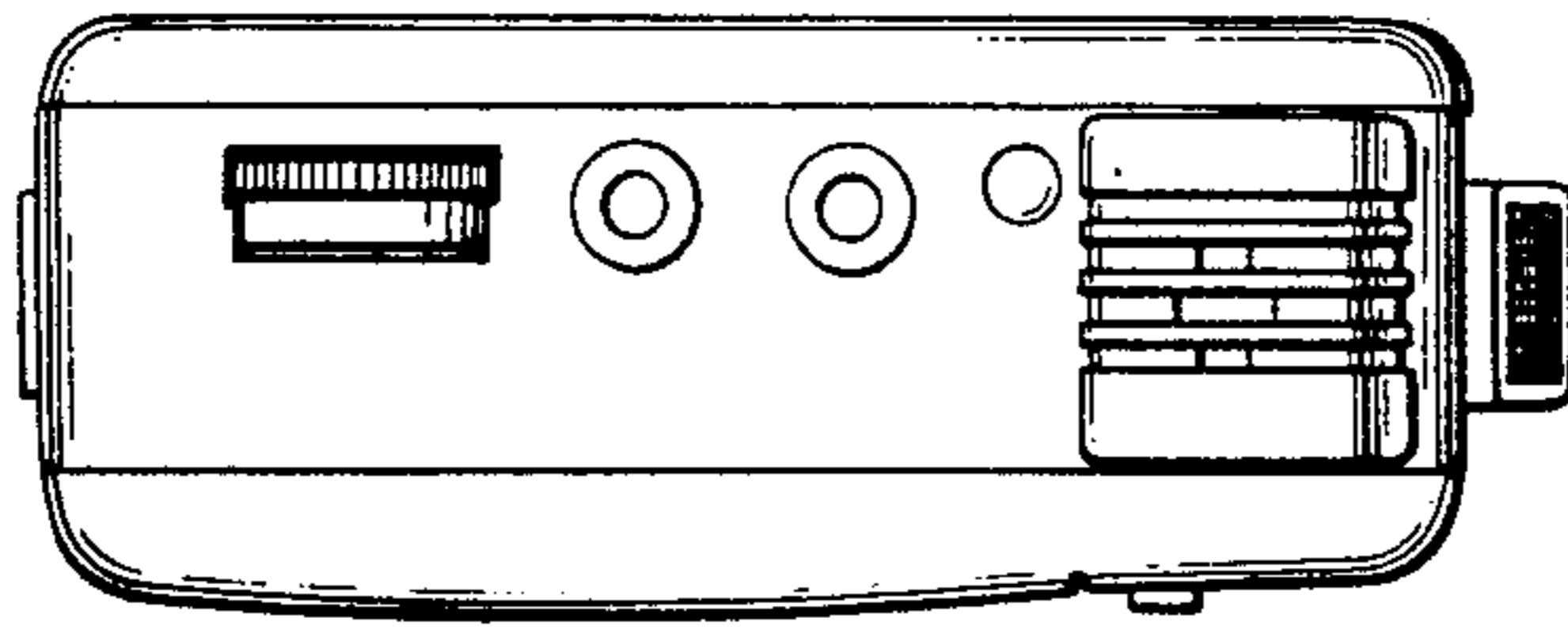
