DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left side and rear perspective view of a seat belt microphone showing our new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

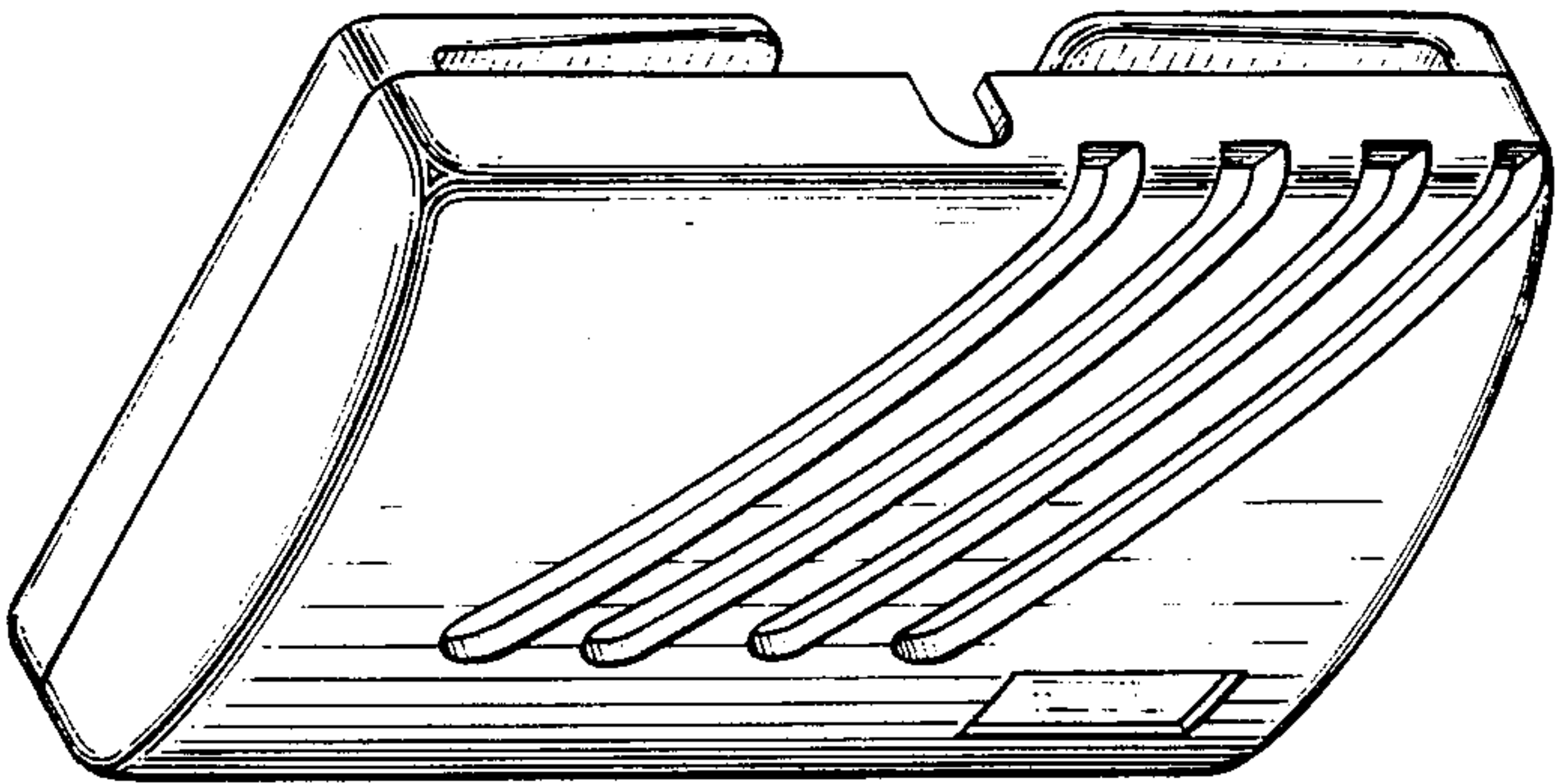

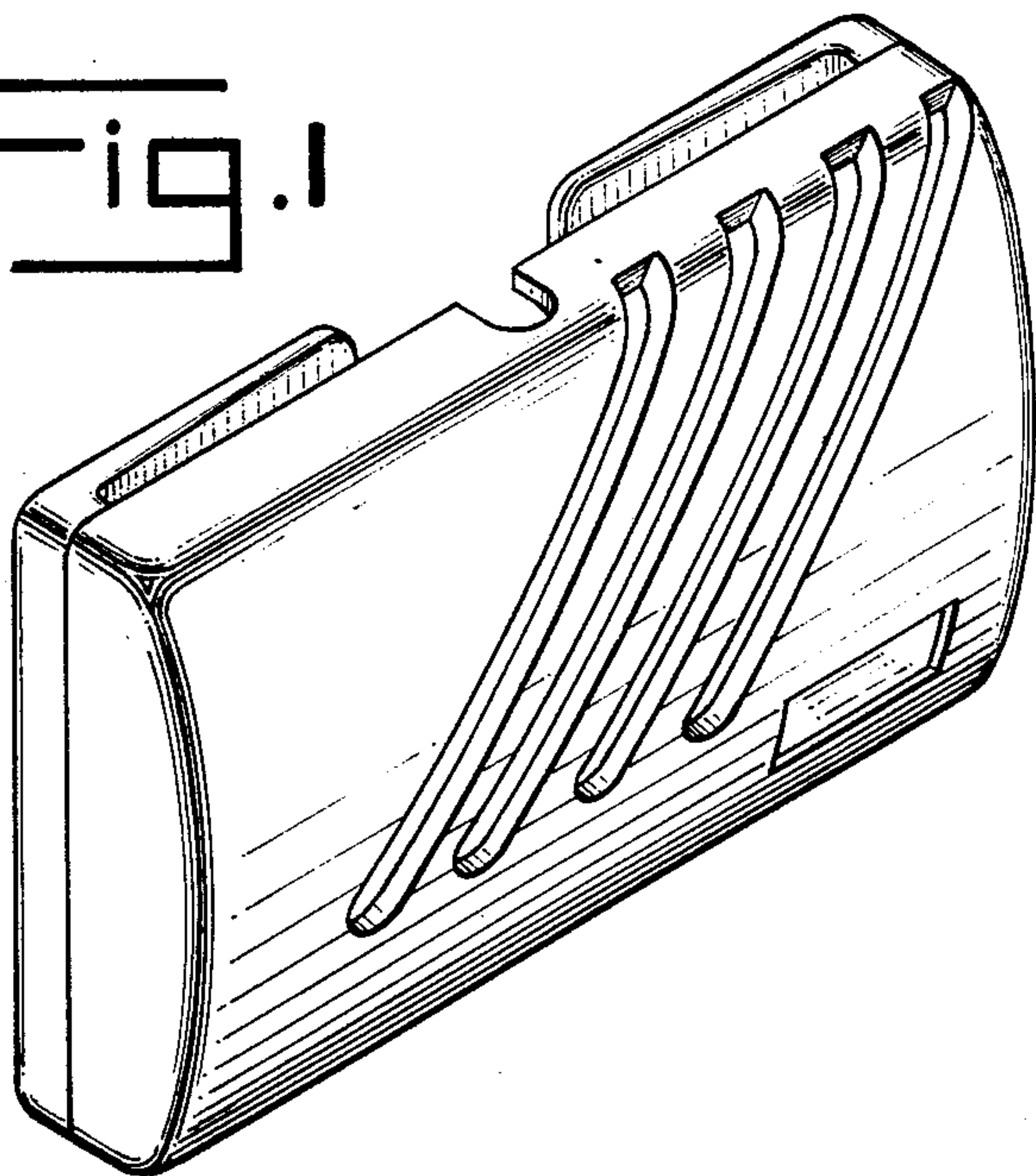

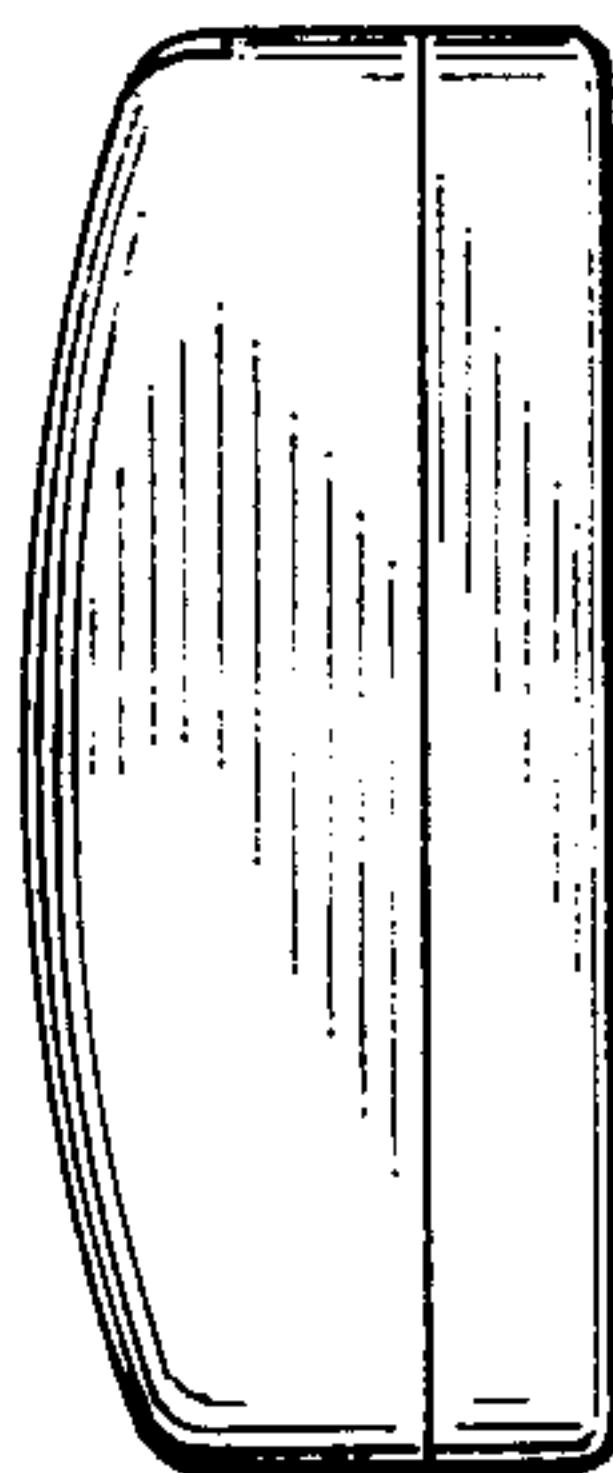

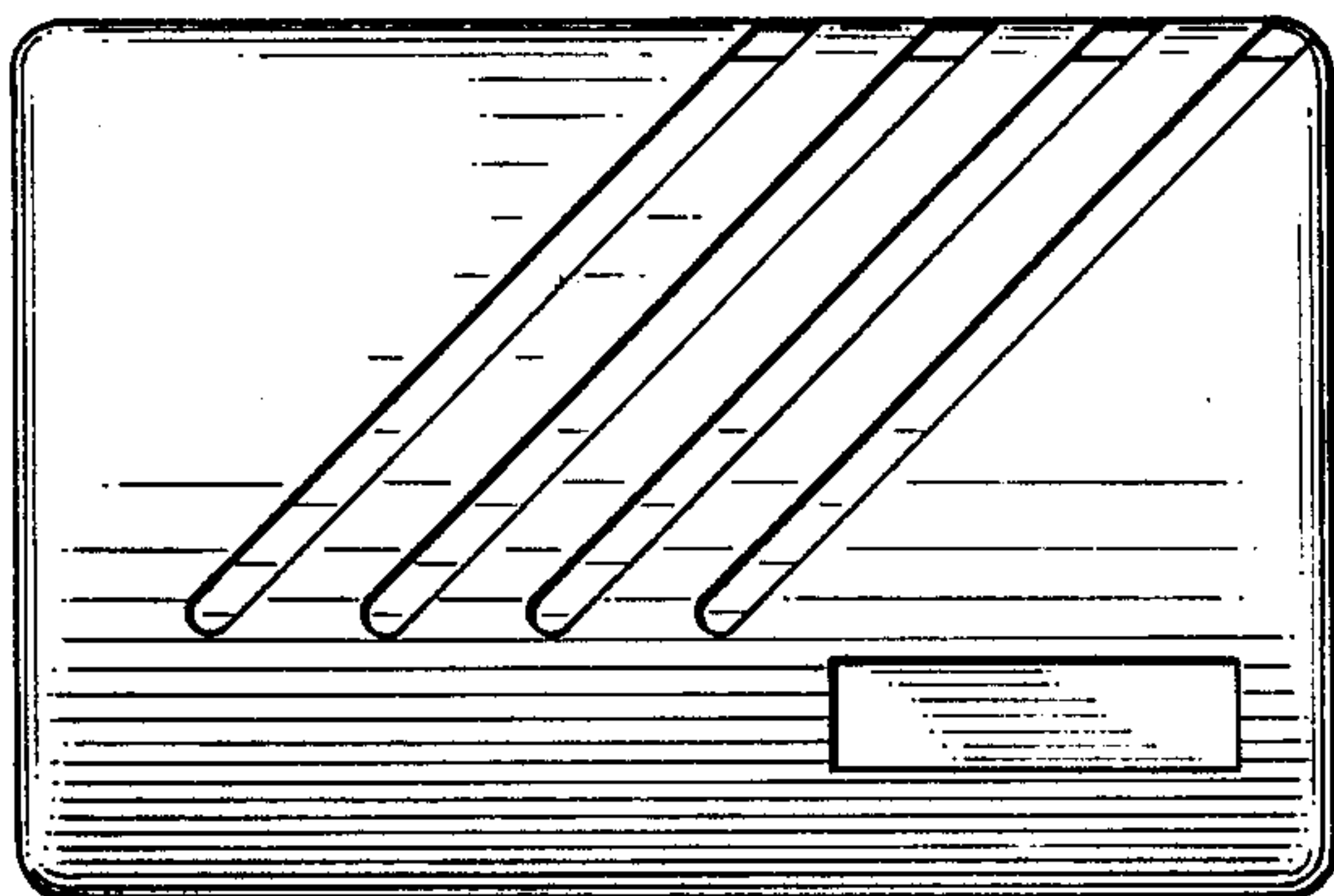

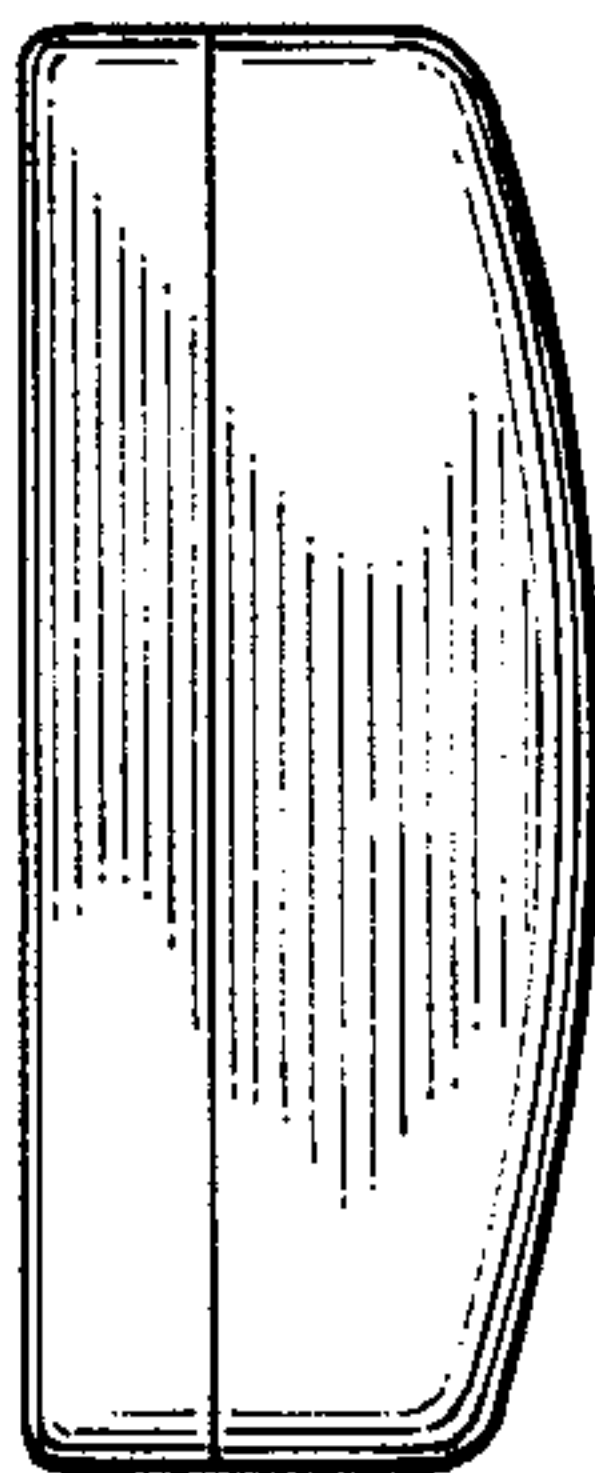

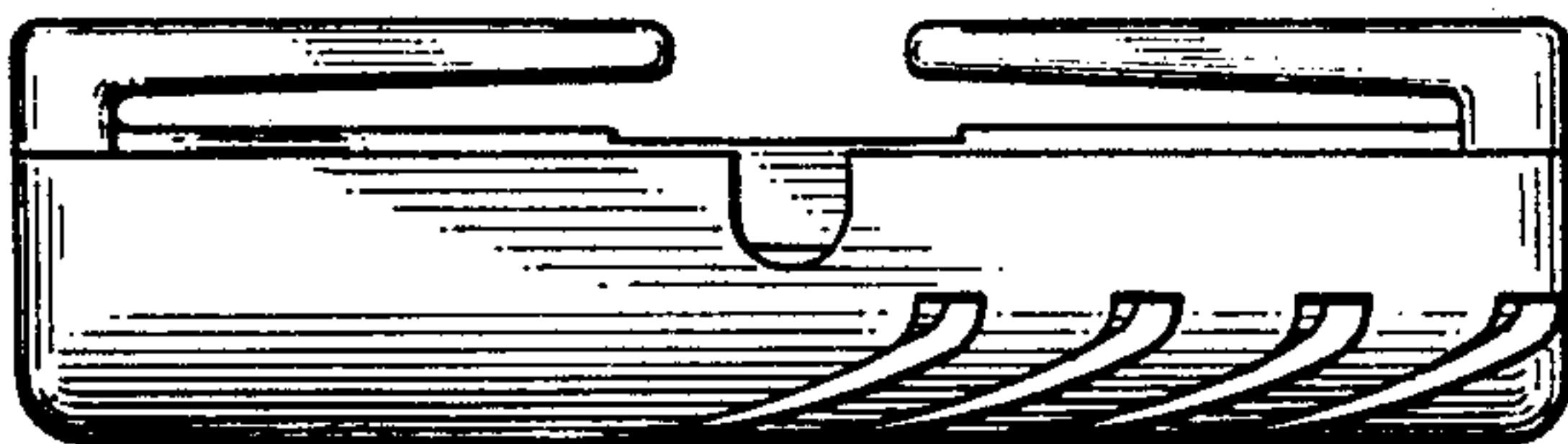

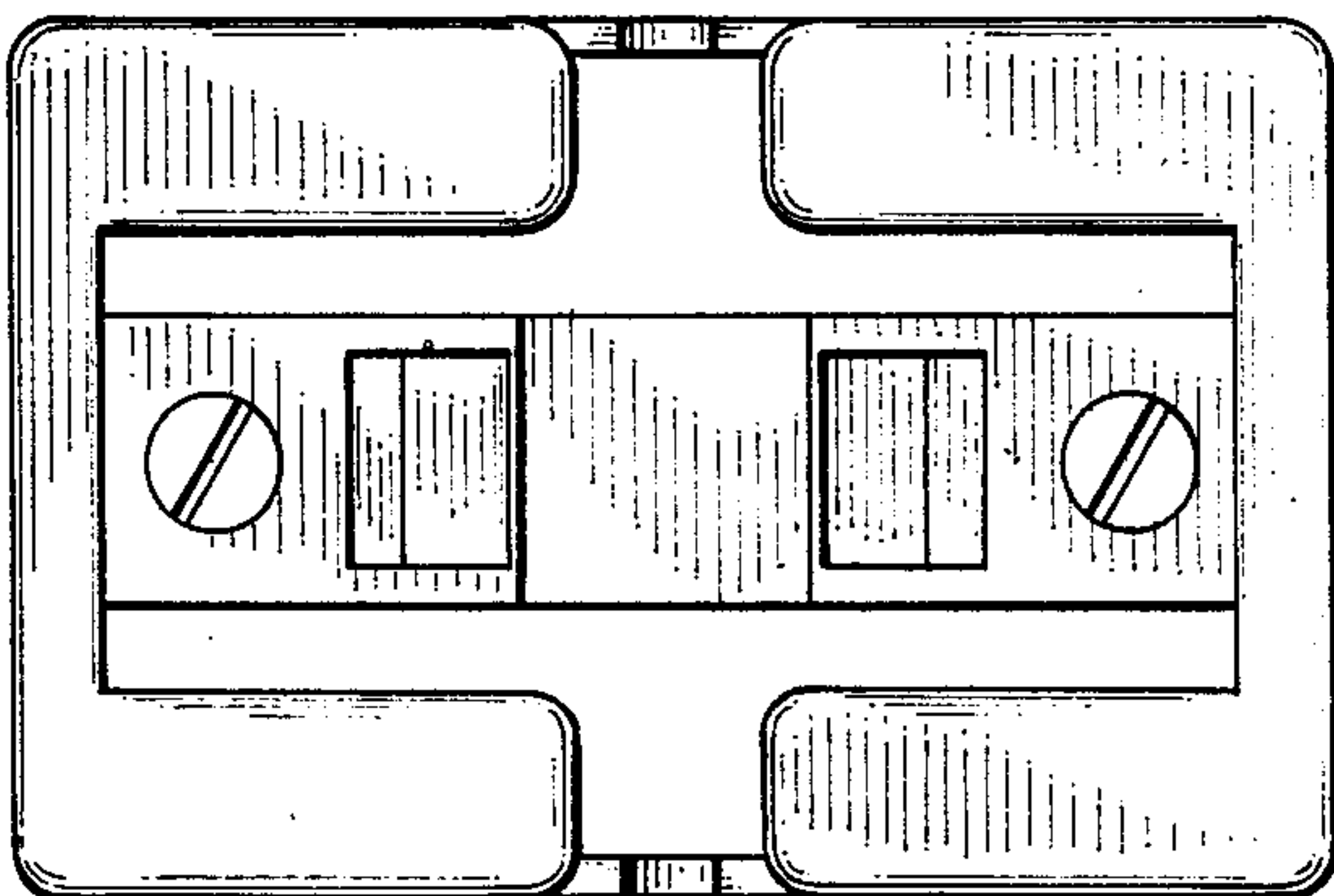
