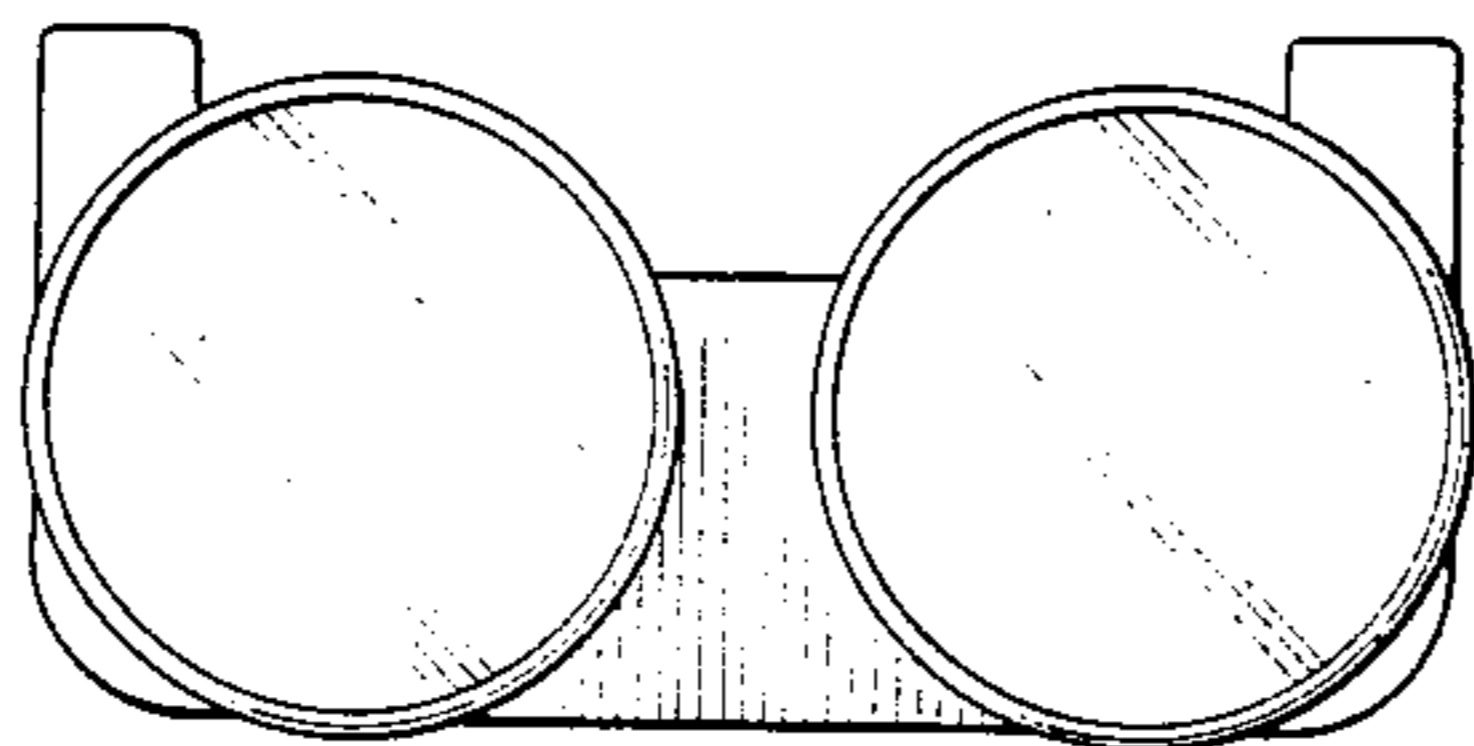
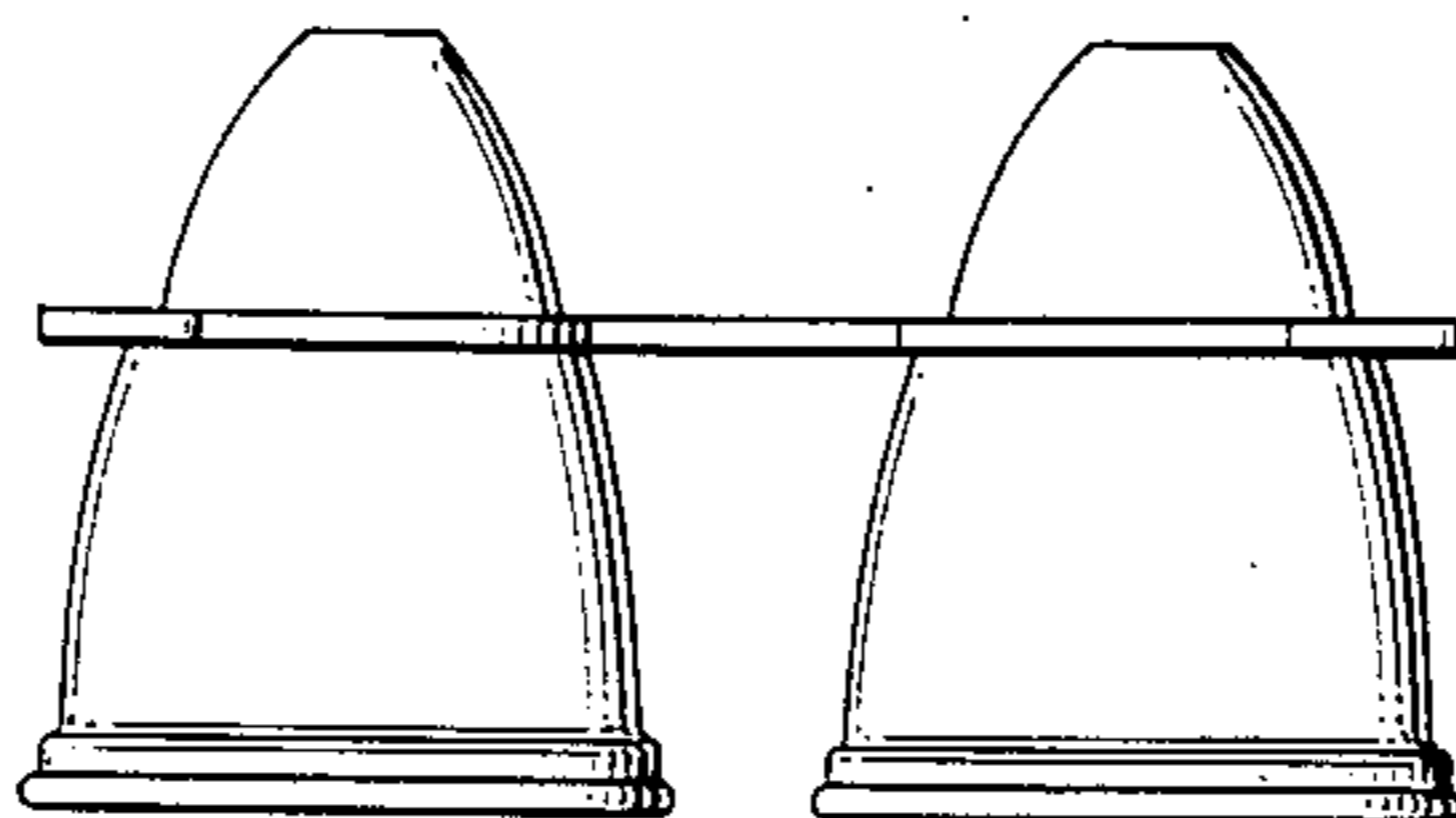

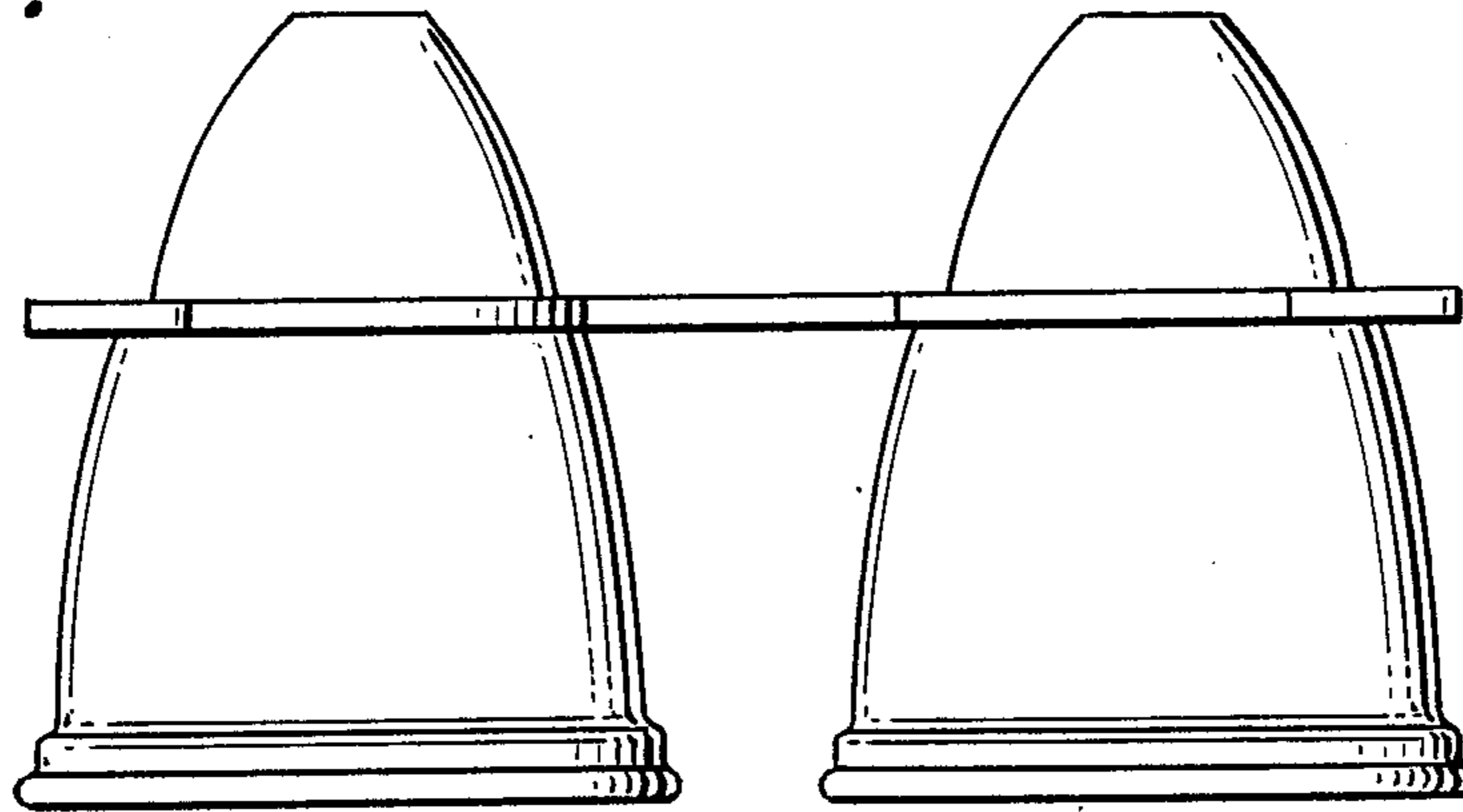
The ornamental design for a dual beam headlight for bicycles or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

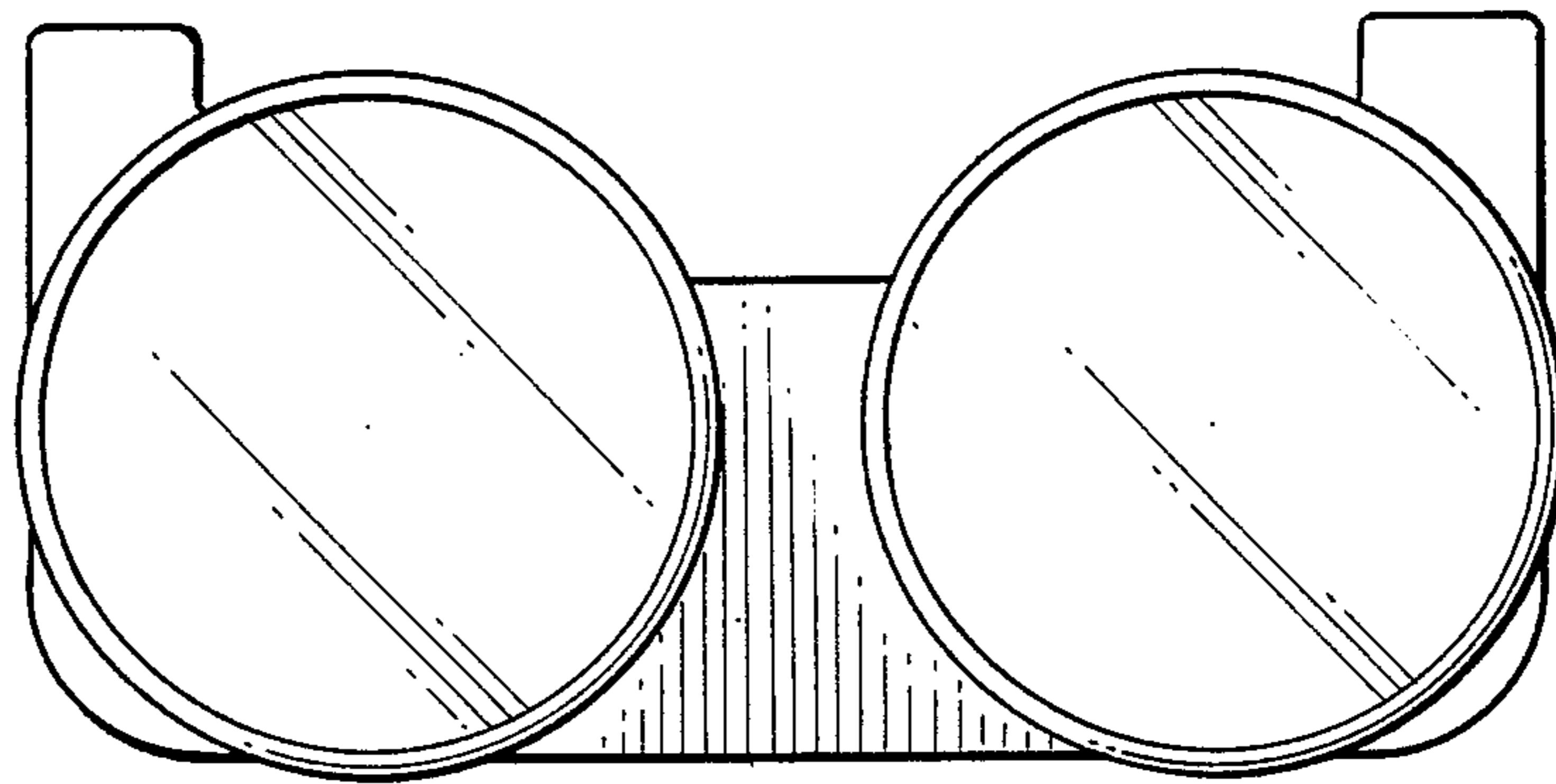
FIG. 1 is a top view of a dual beam headlight for bicycles or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



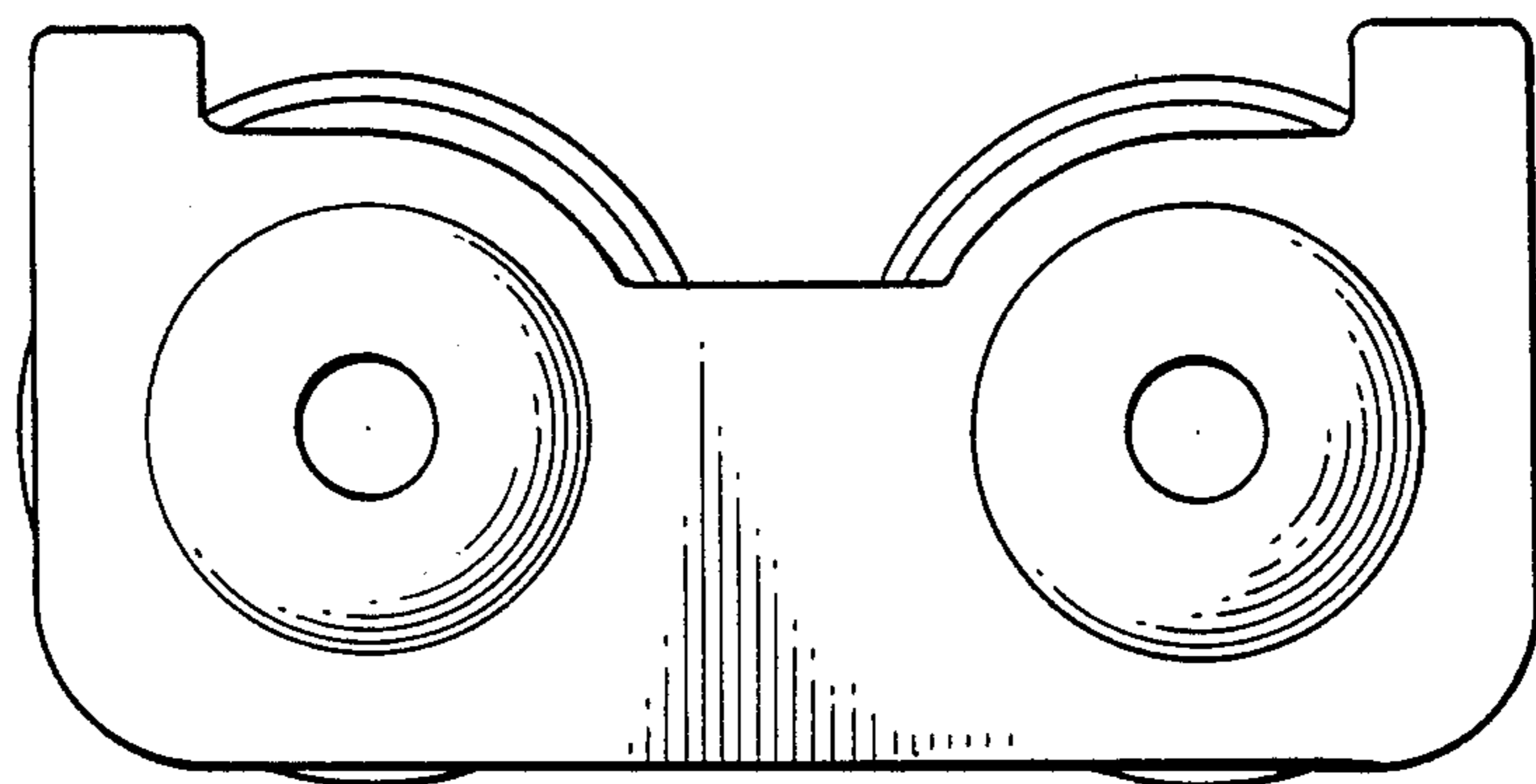

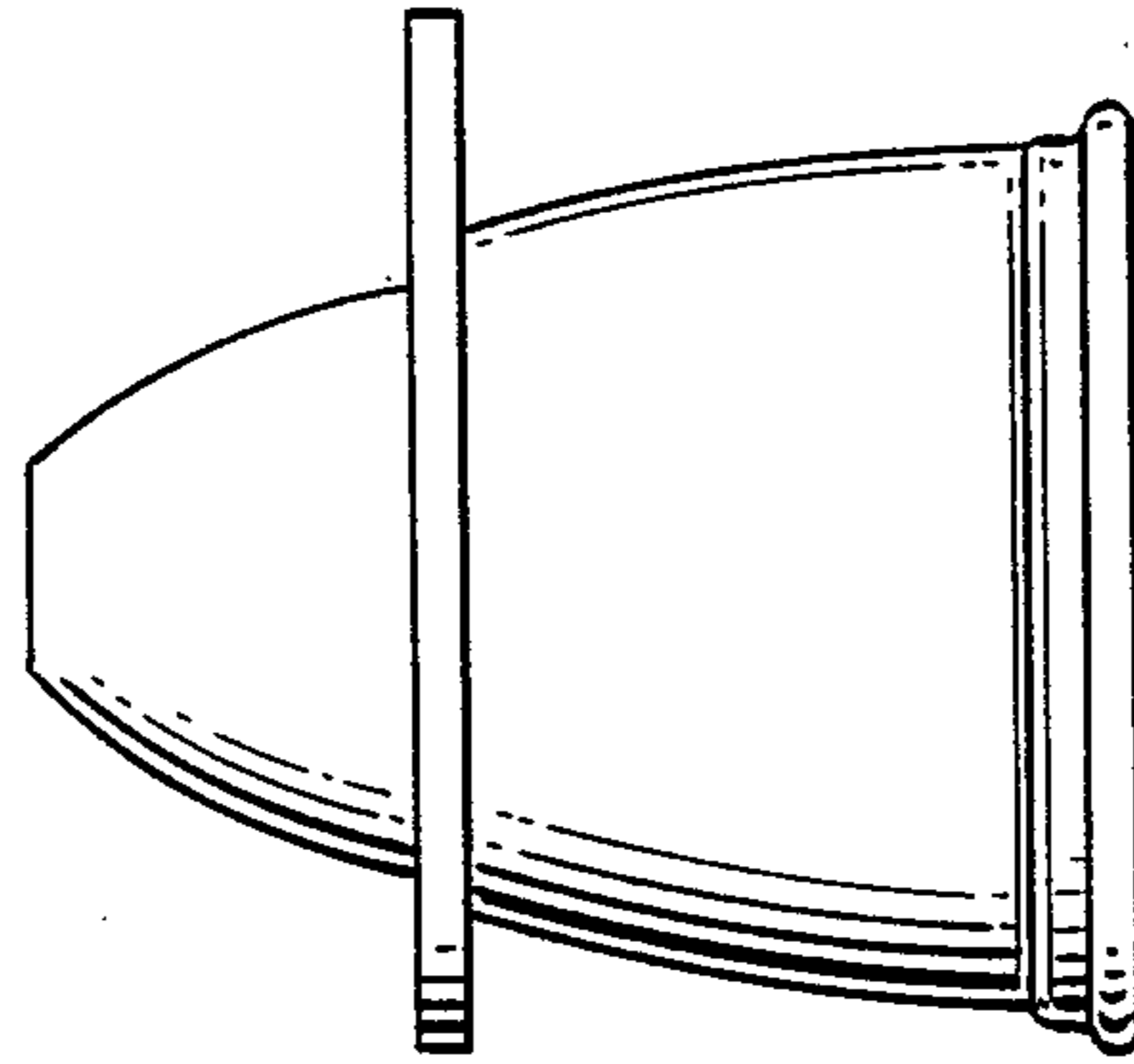
