The ornamental design for a crutch cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a crutch cover showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof, illustrating the second embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 13 is a left side elevational view thereof.
