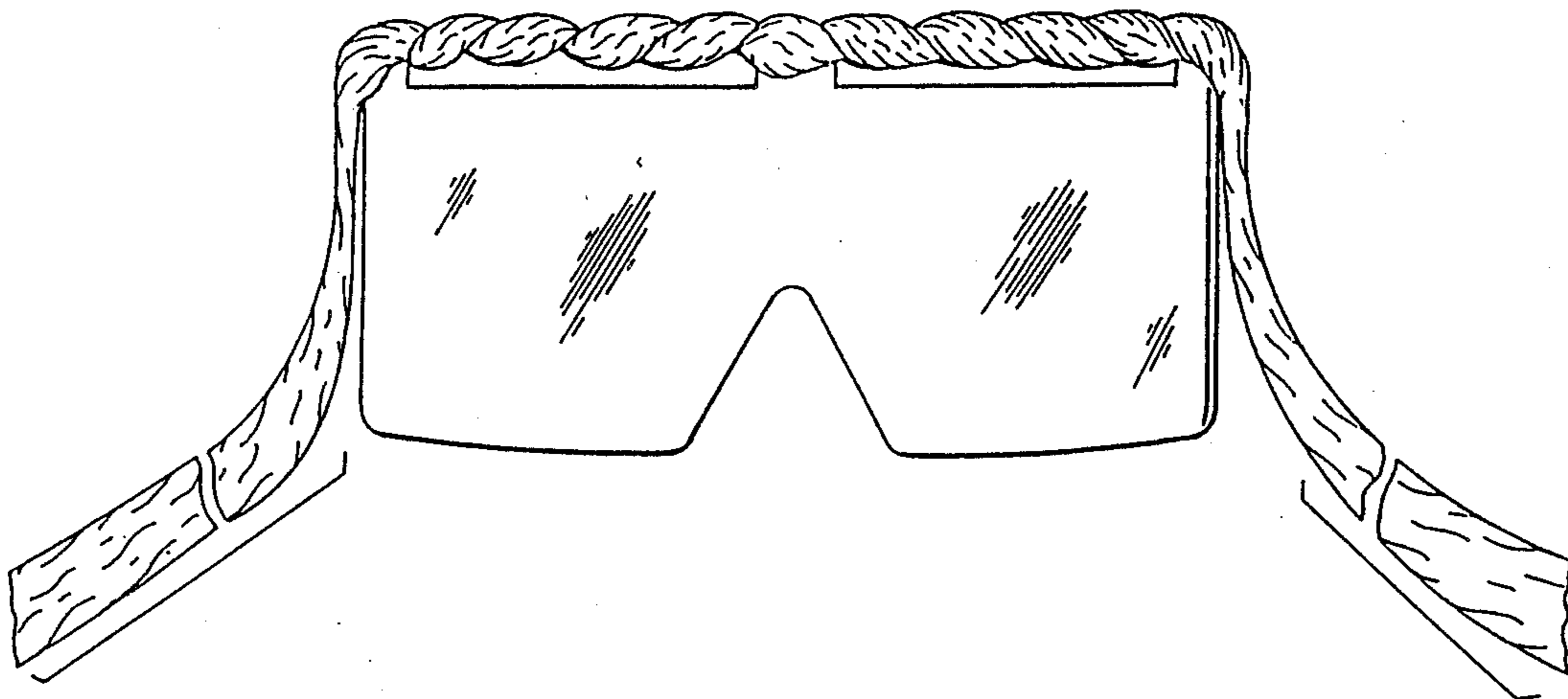

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the eyeglasses showing a first embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the eyeglasses showing a second embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 9 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
The head band straps are shown broken away for illustrative purposes only.



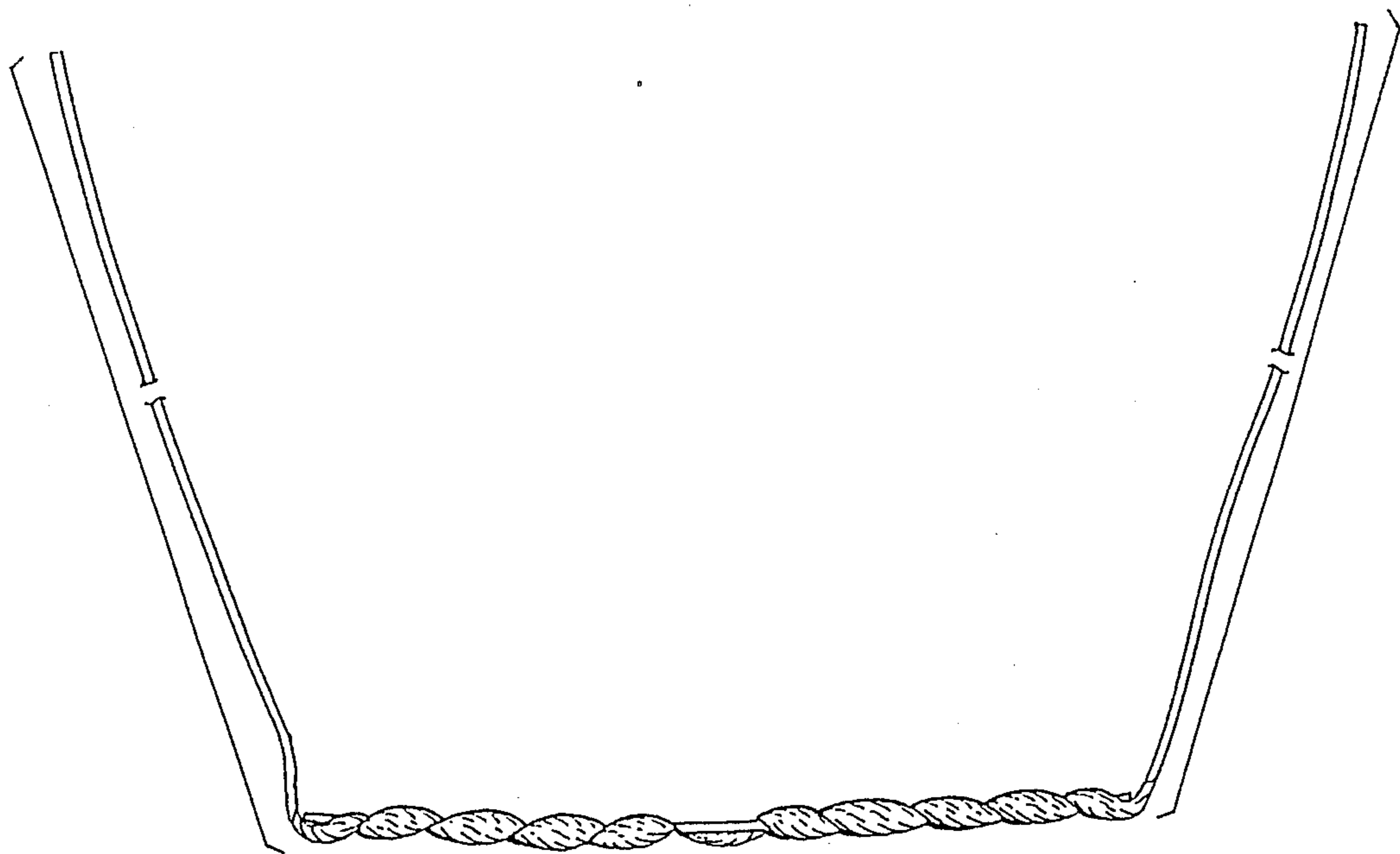

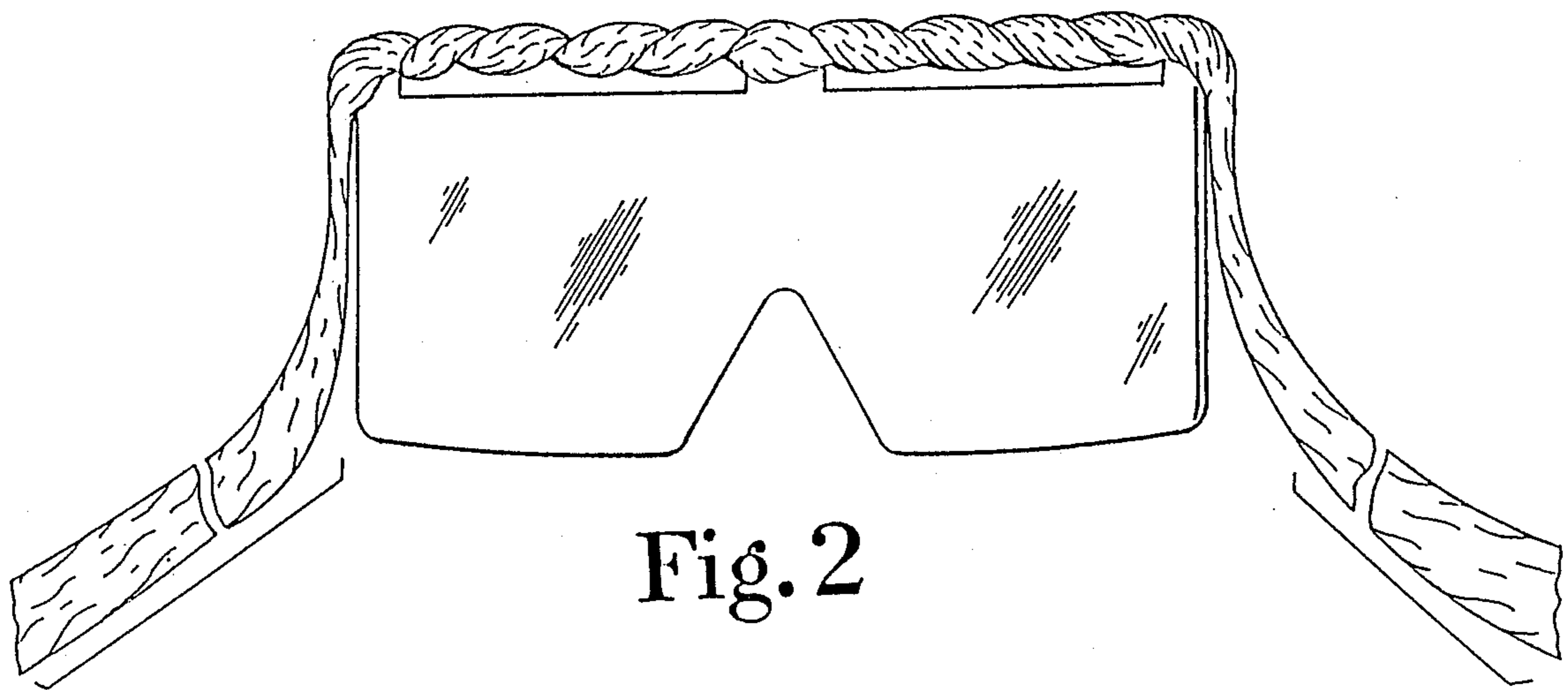

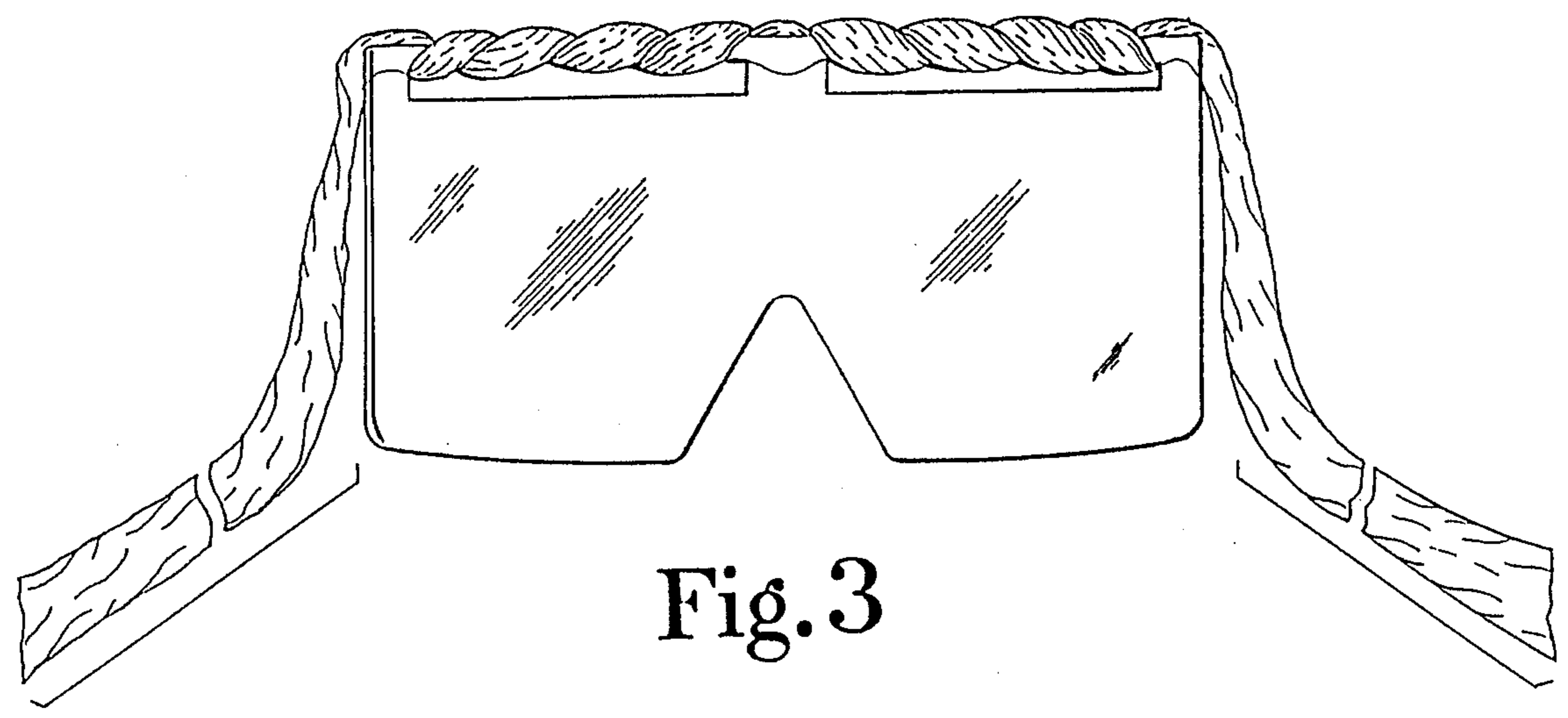

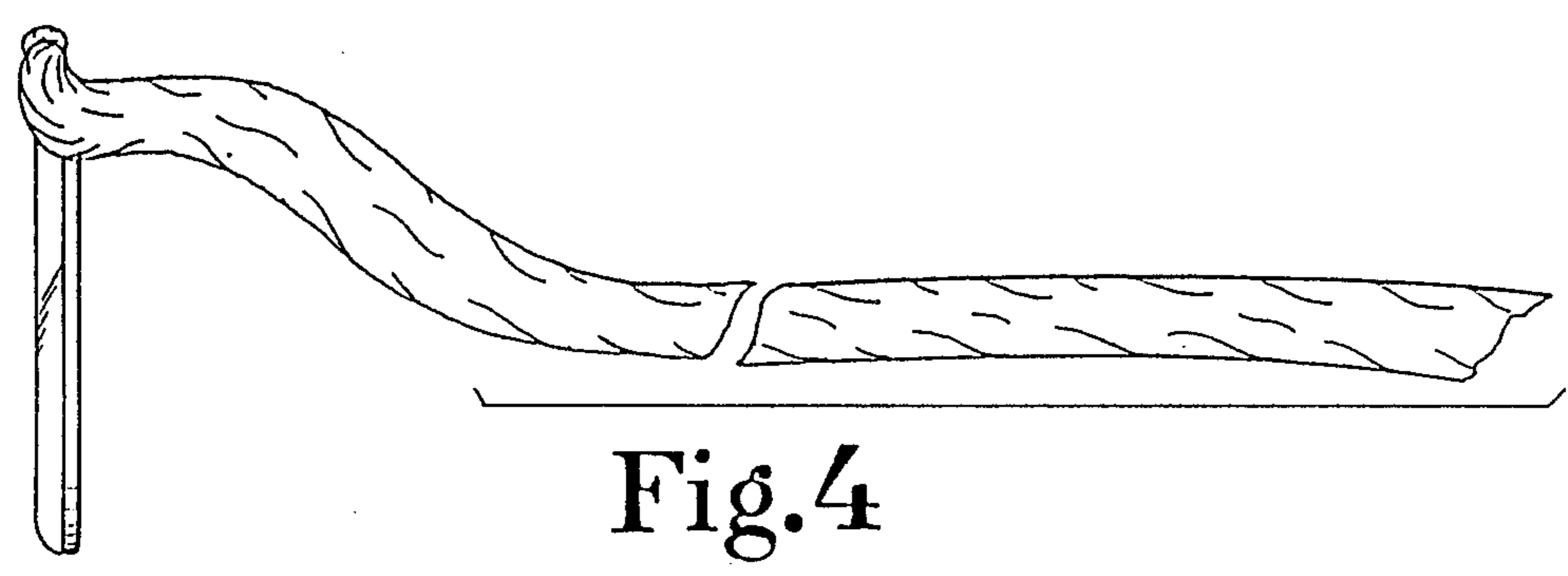

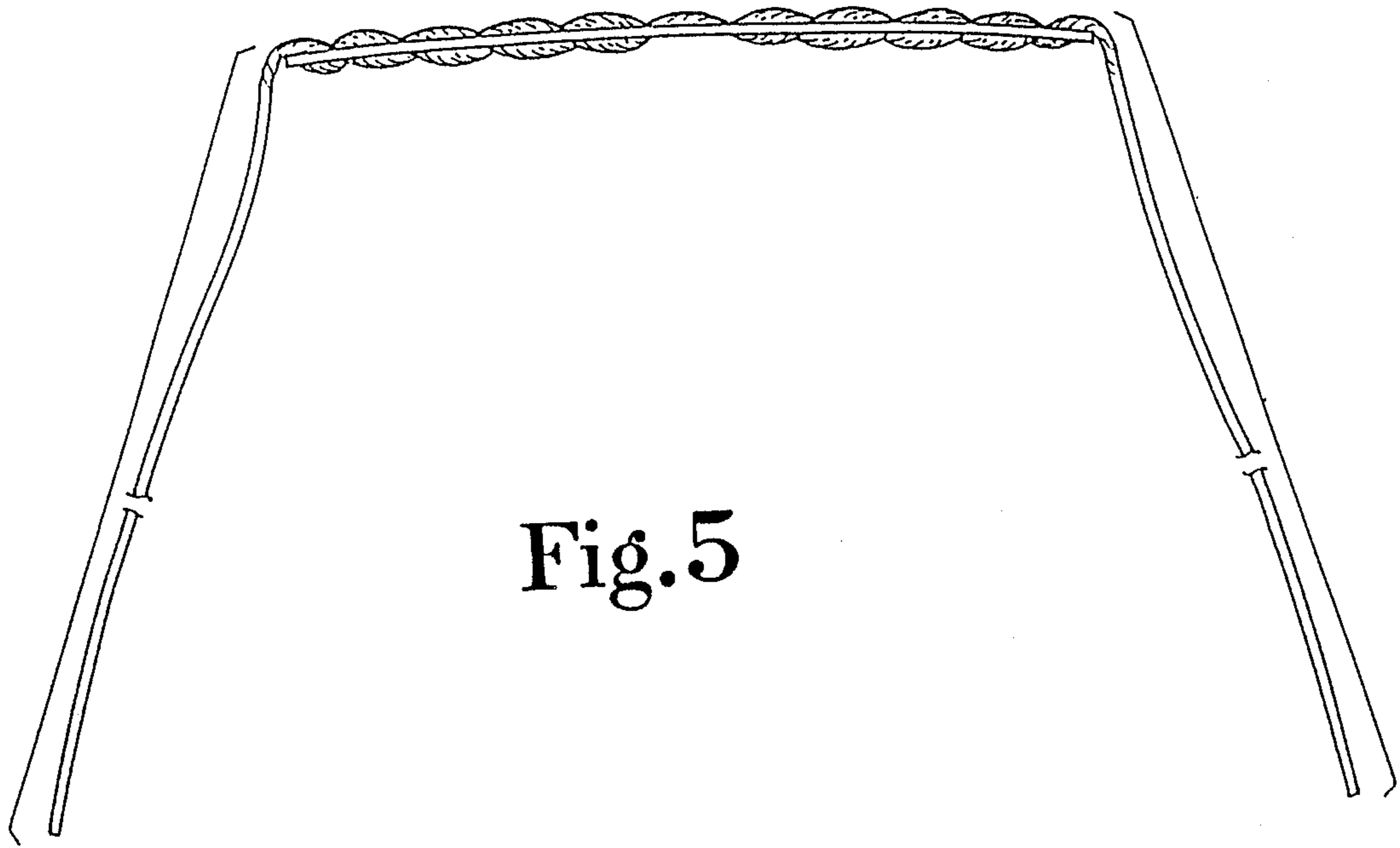

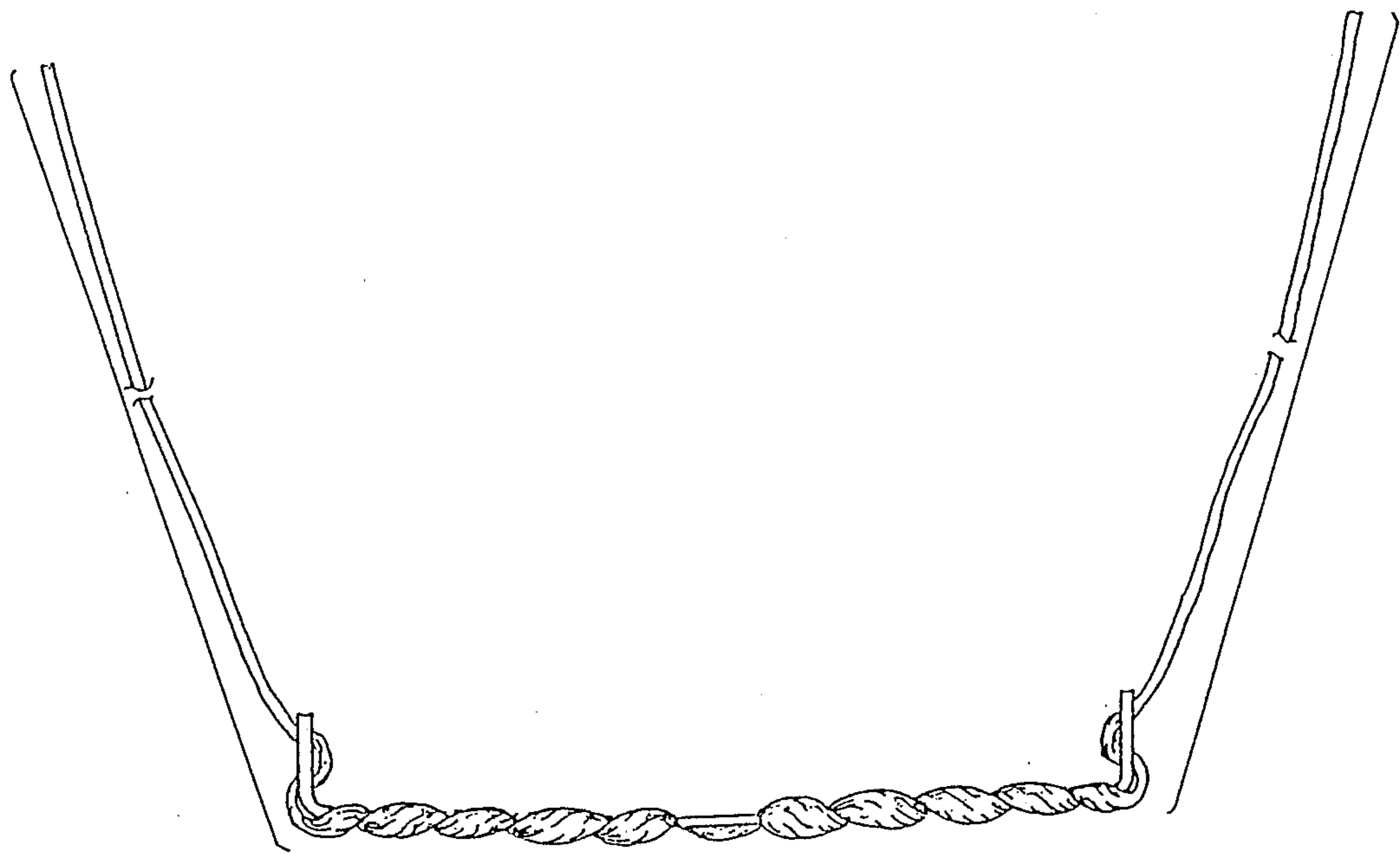

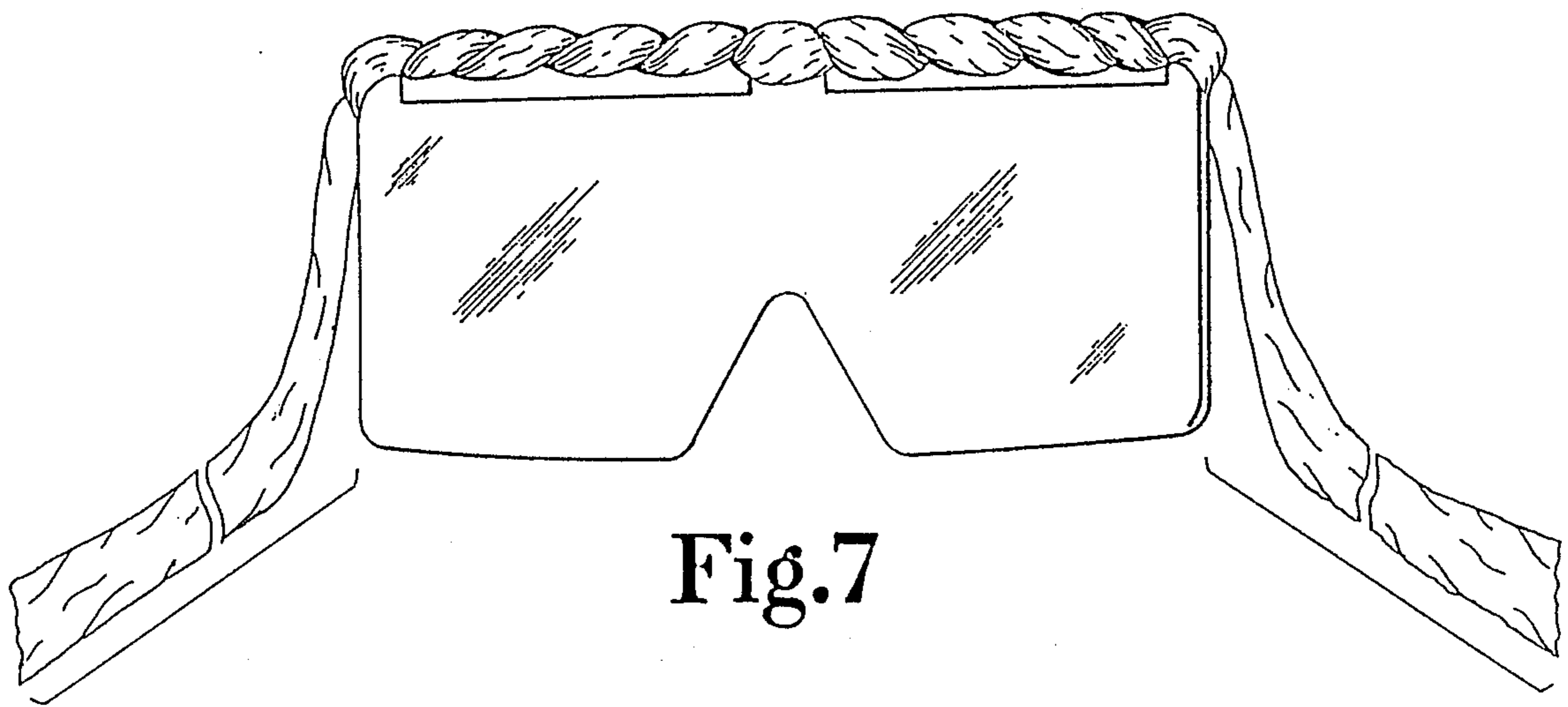

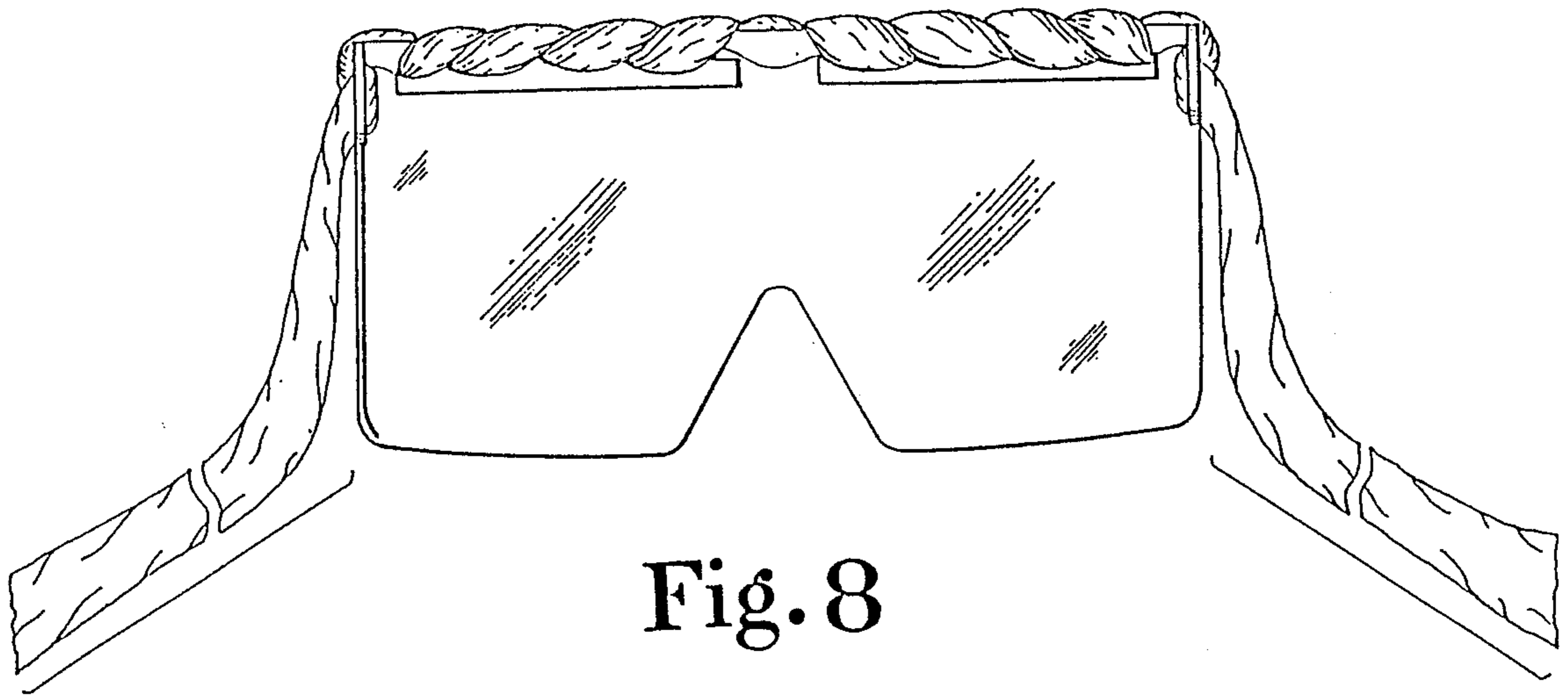

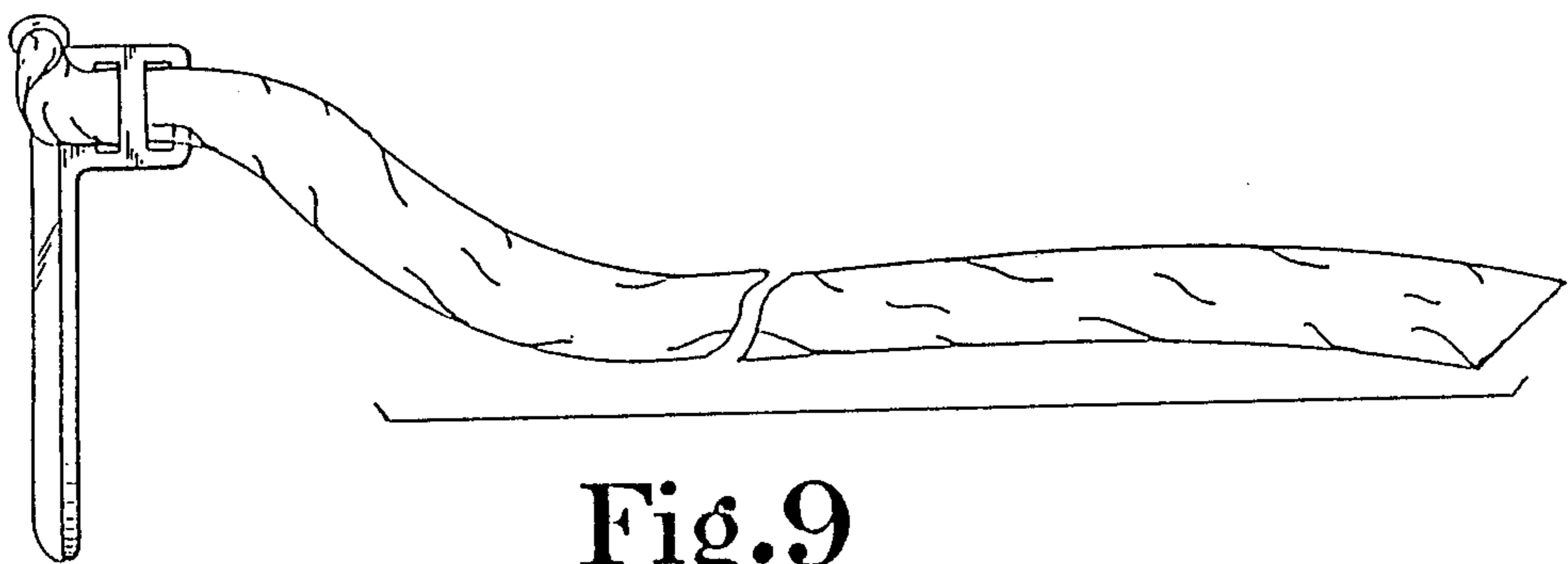

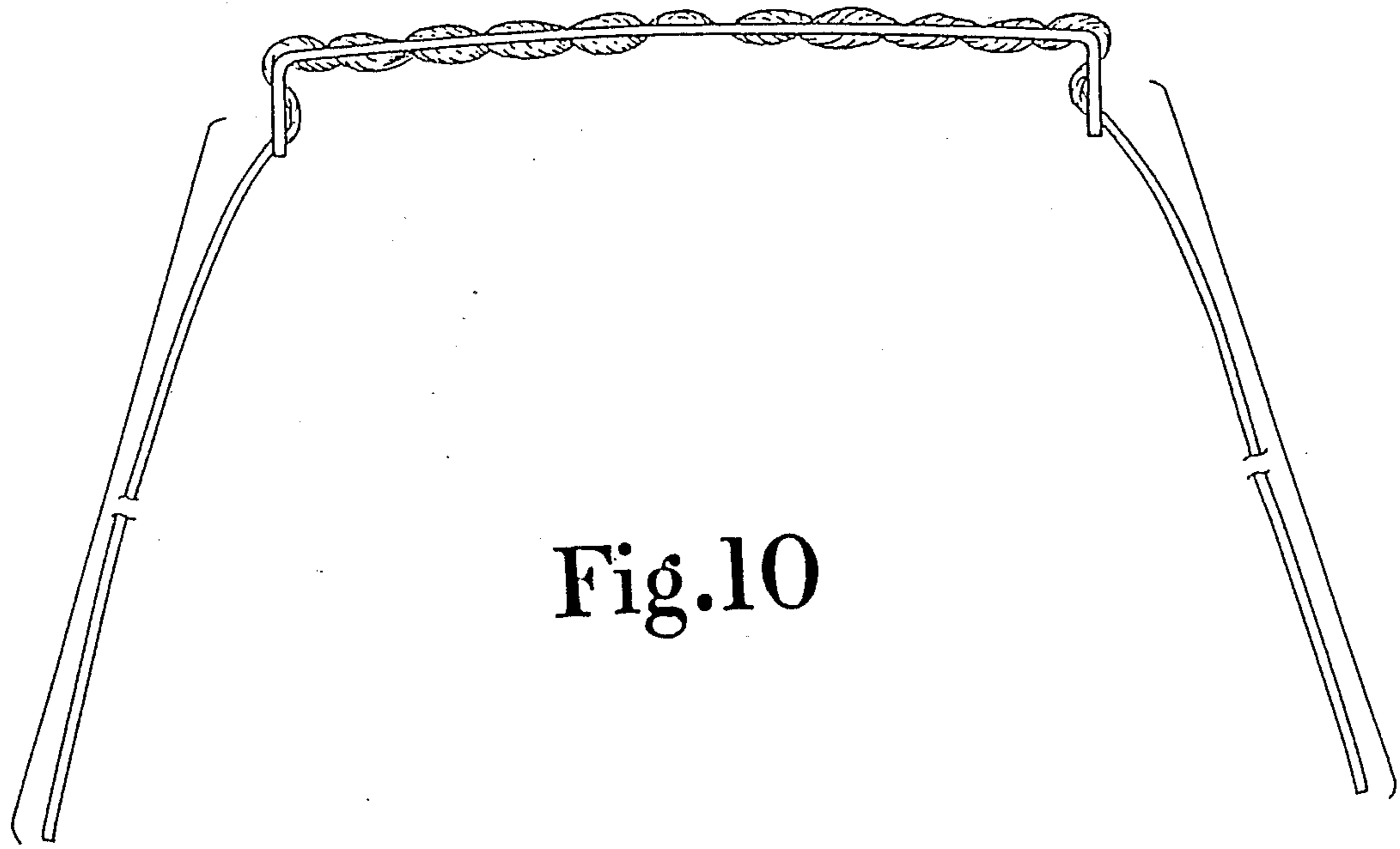
