DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an combined sheet
feeder and editing device for a copying machine show-
ing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

broken line showing of a photocopier is environmental
only and forms no part of the claimed design.

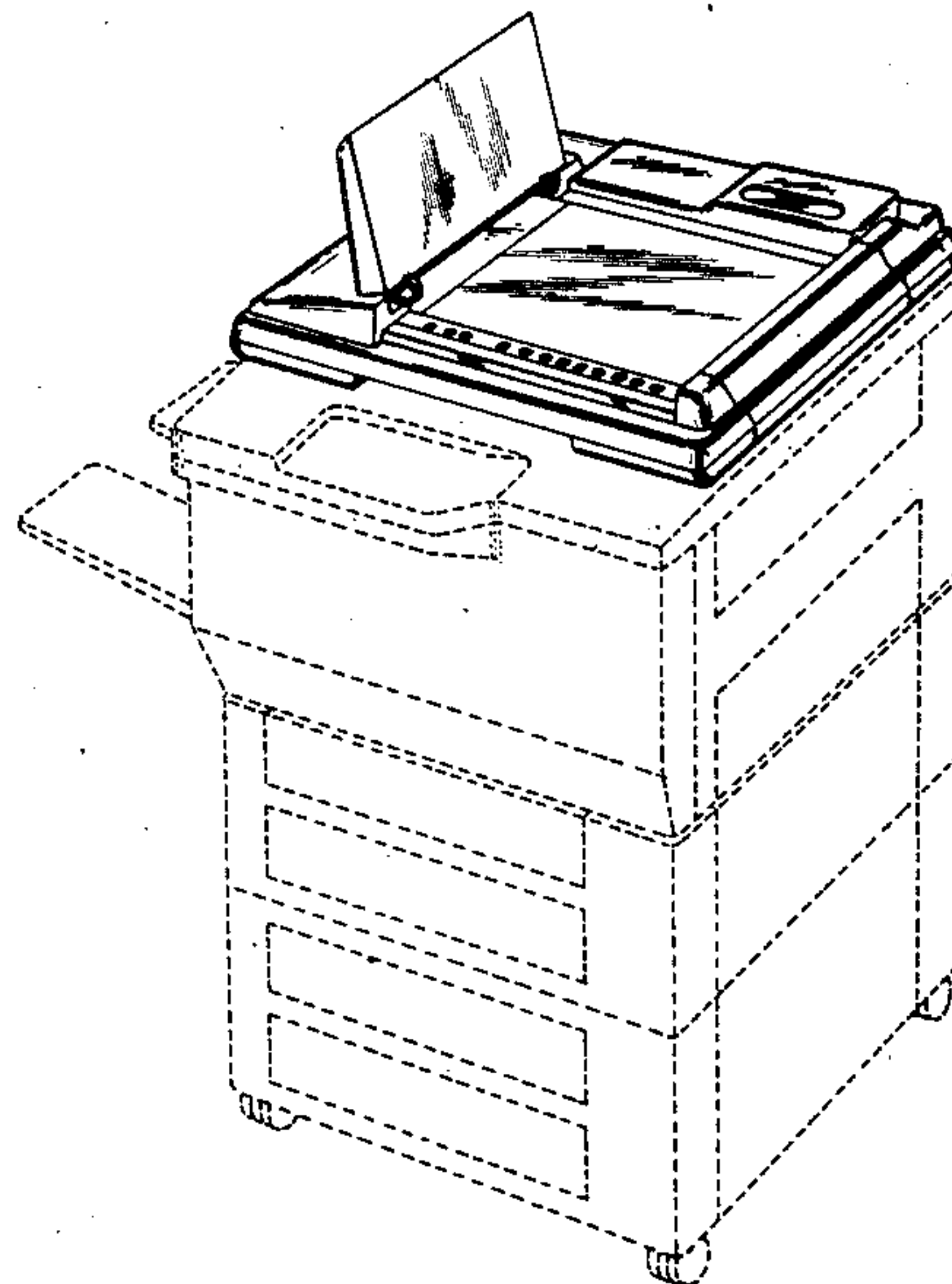

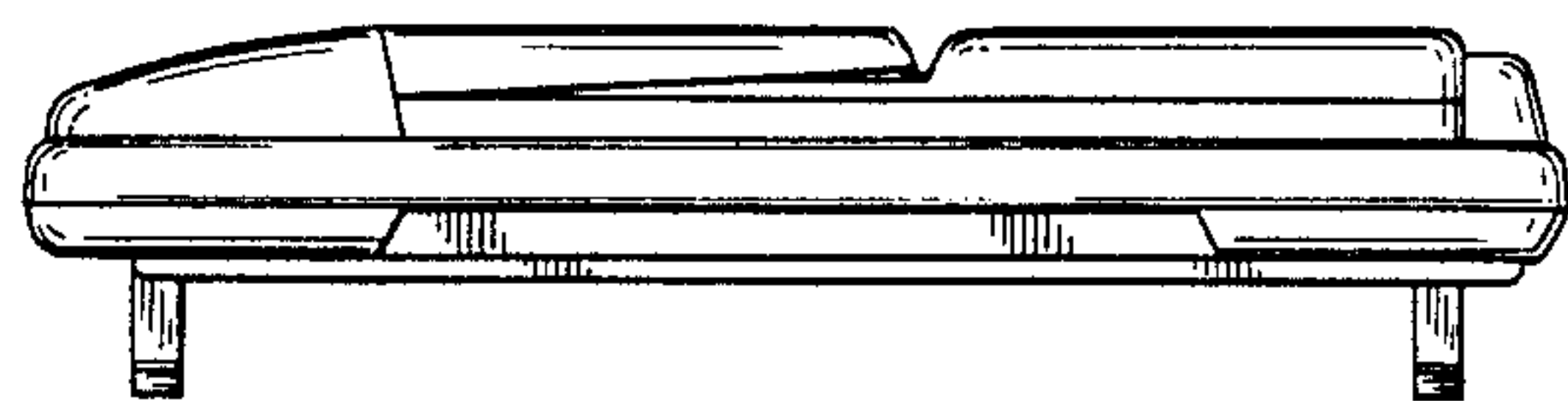

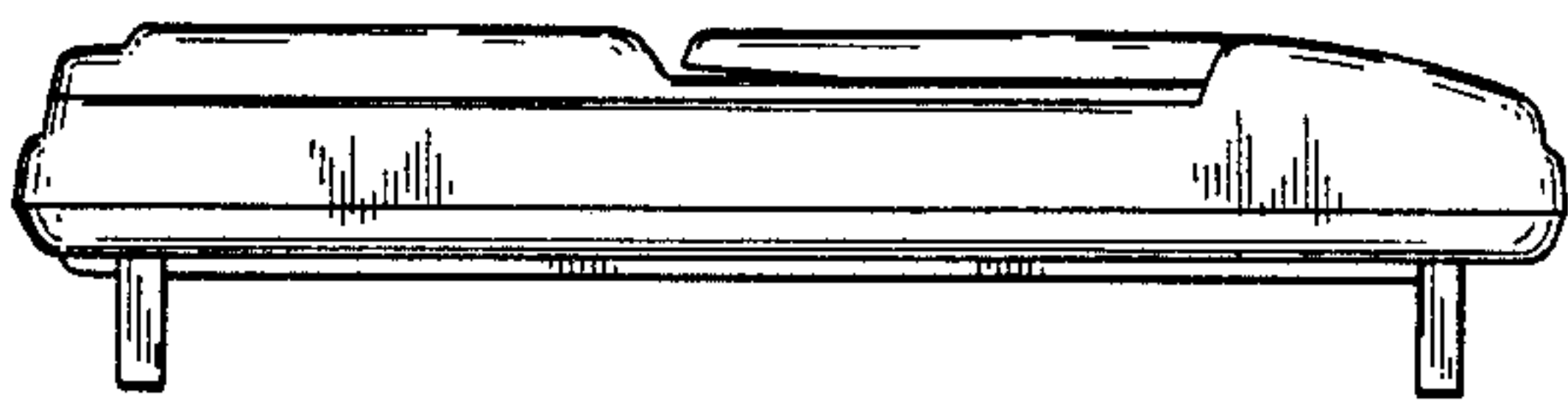

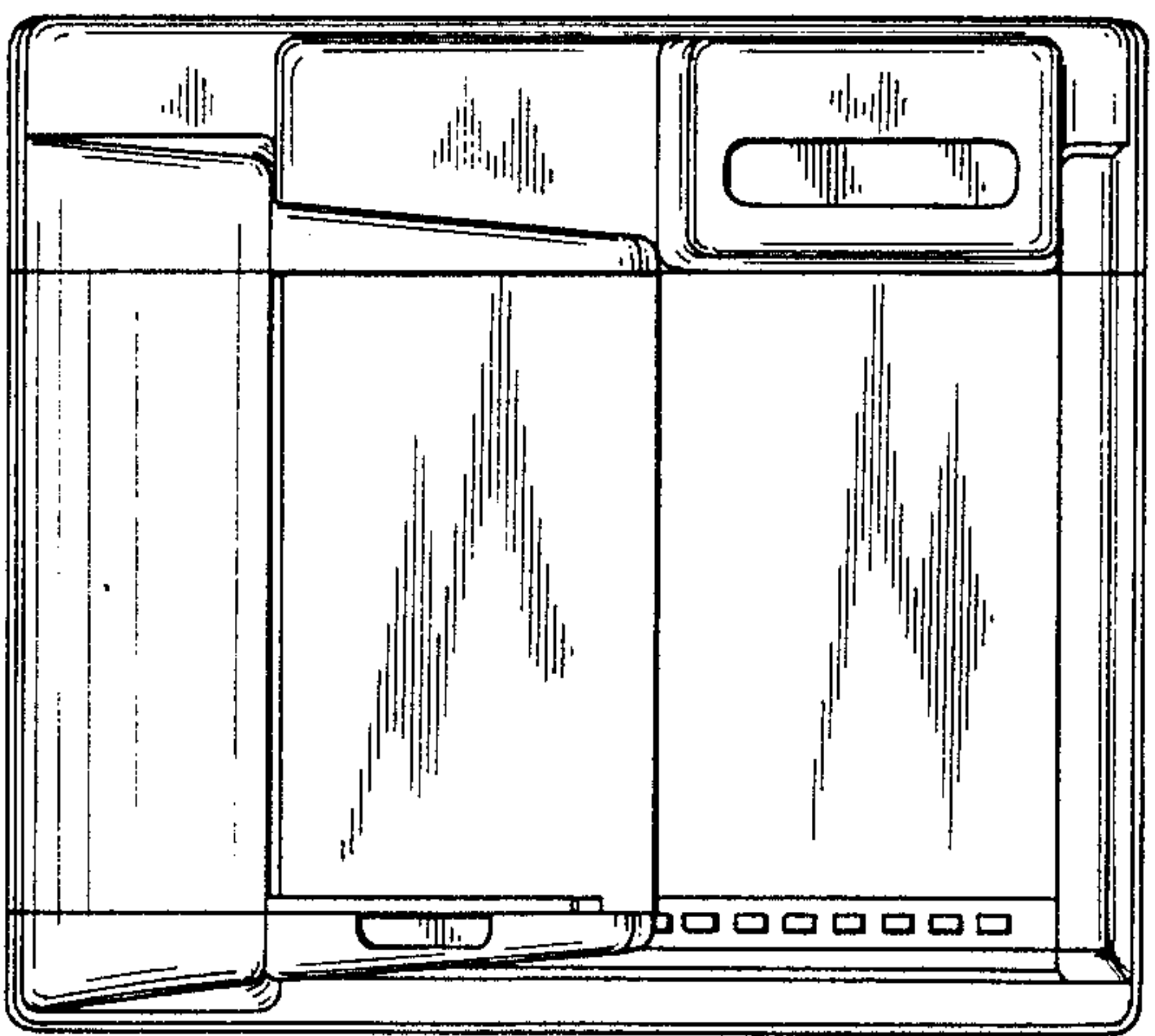

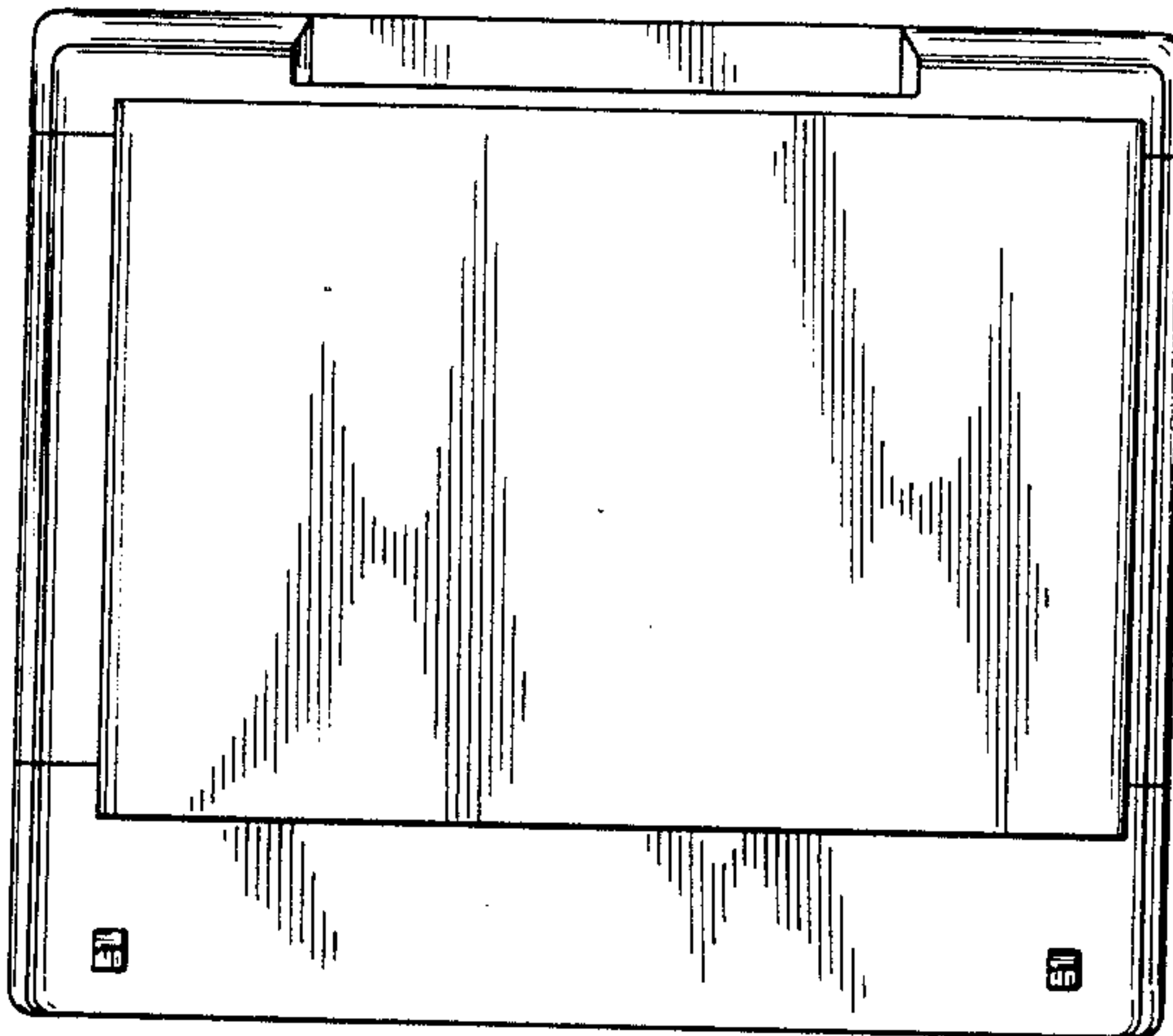

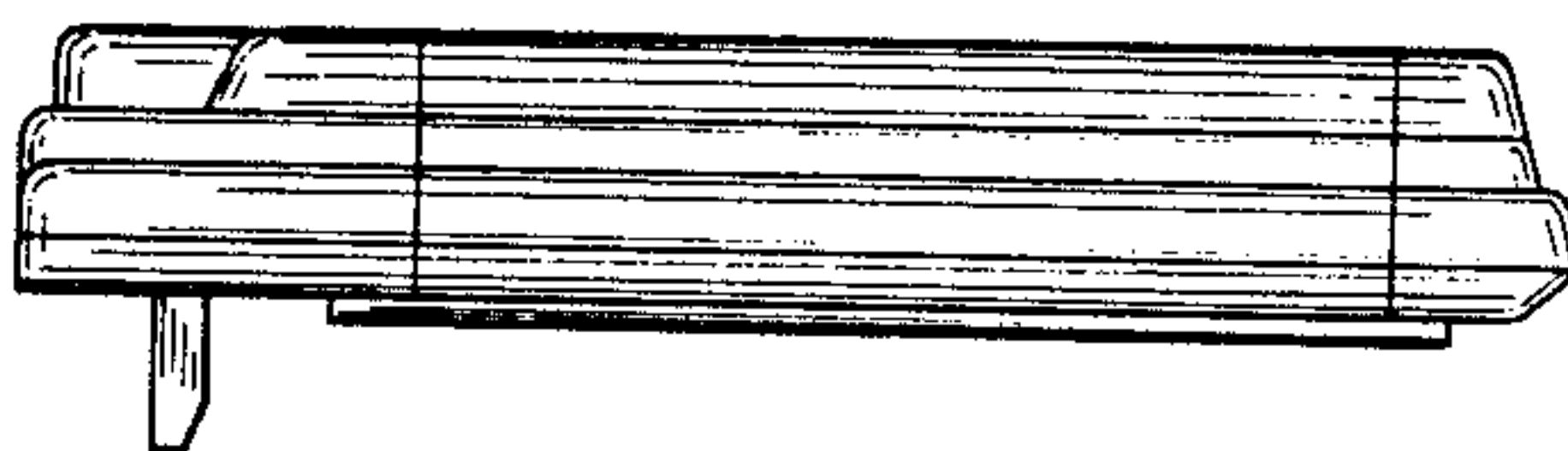

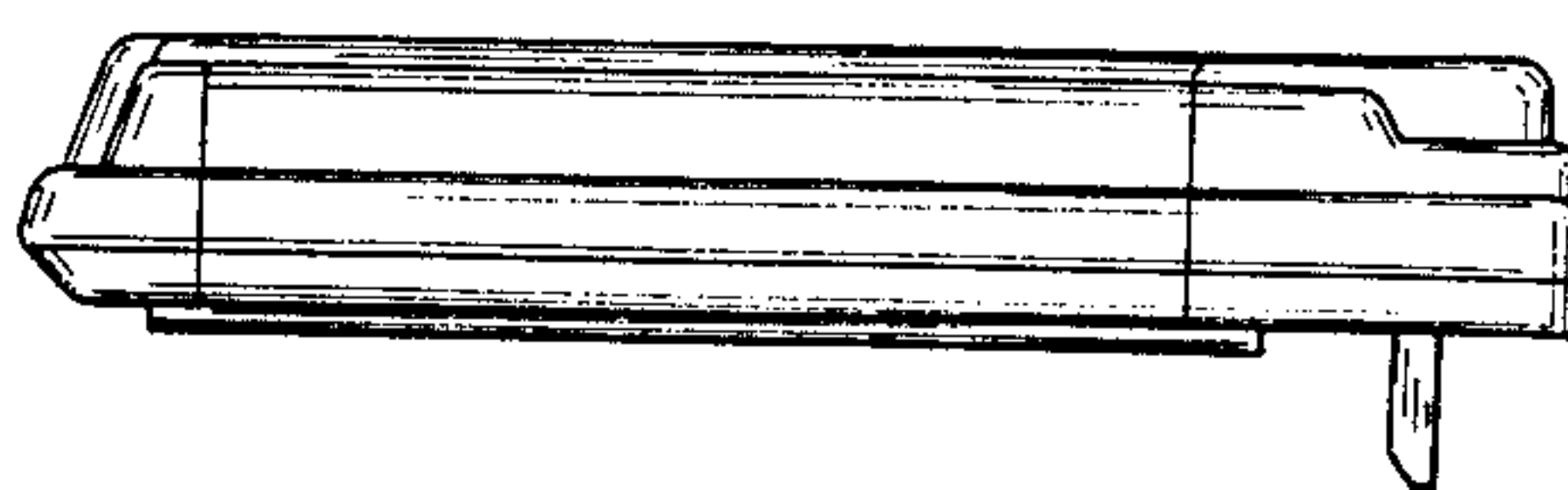
