The ornamental design for a calendar pad holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a calendar pad holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

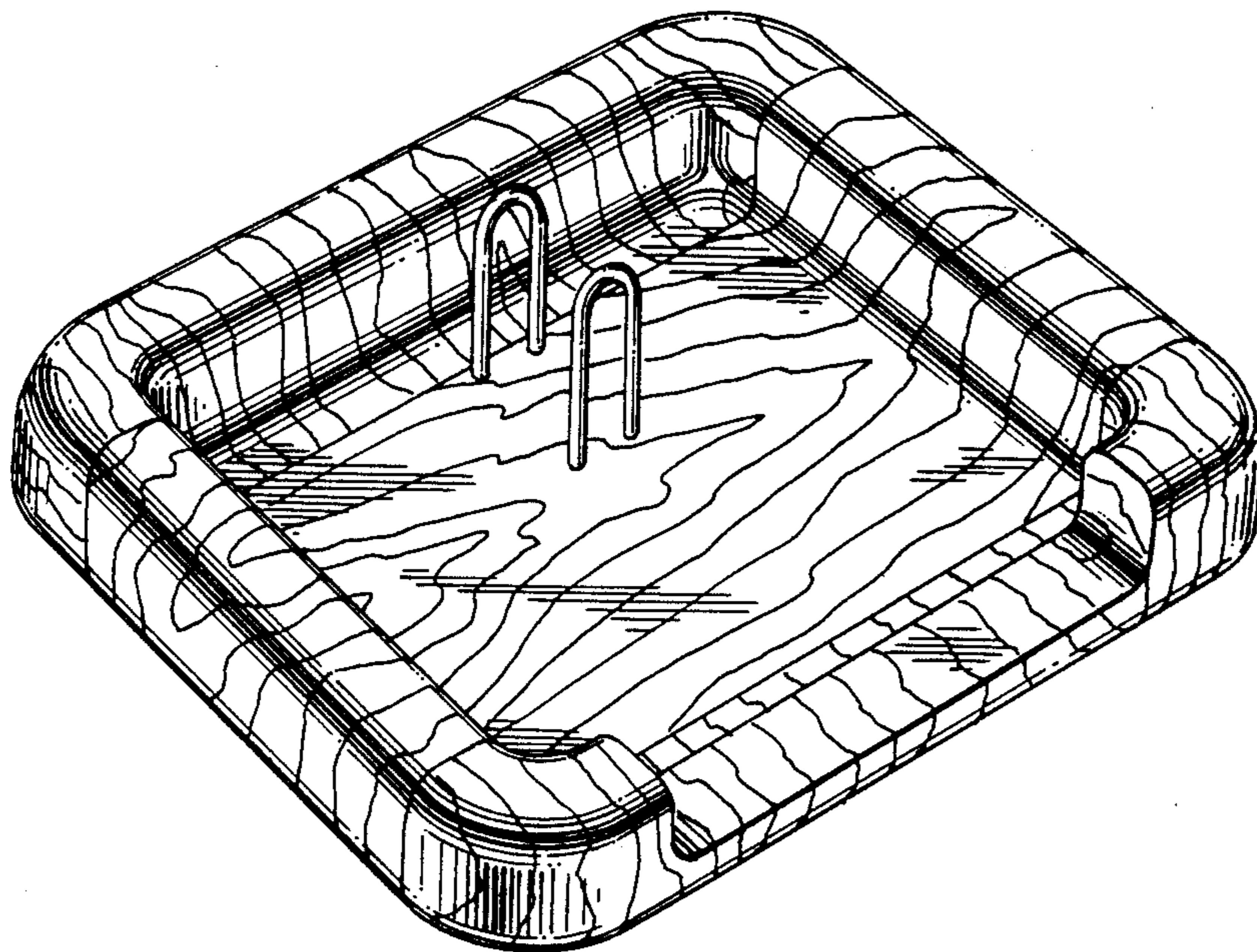

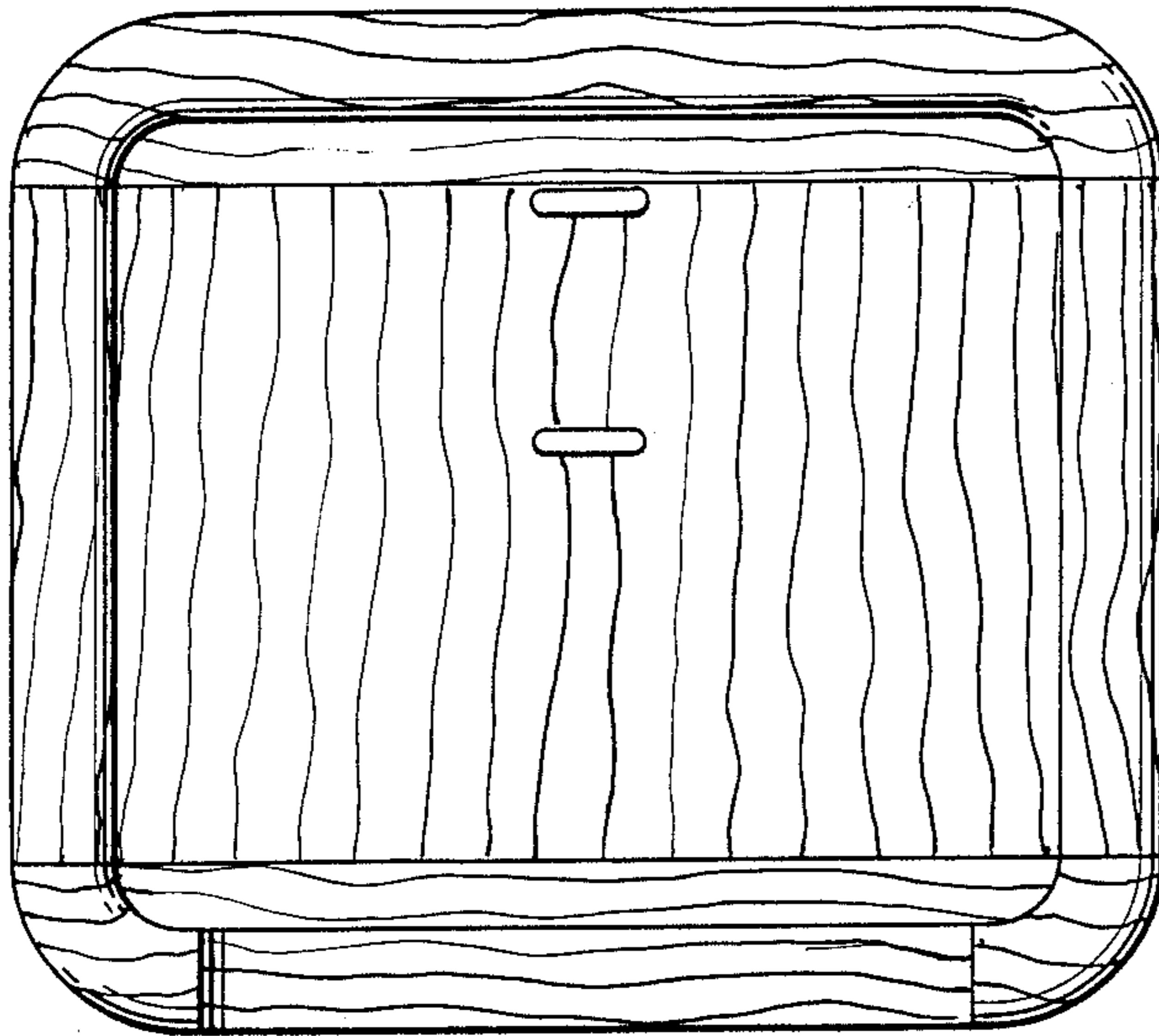

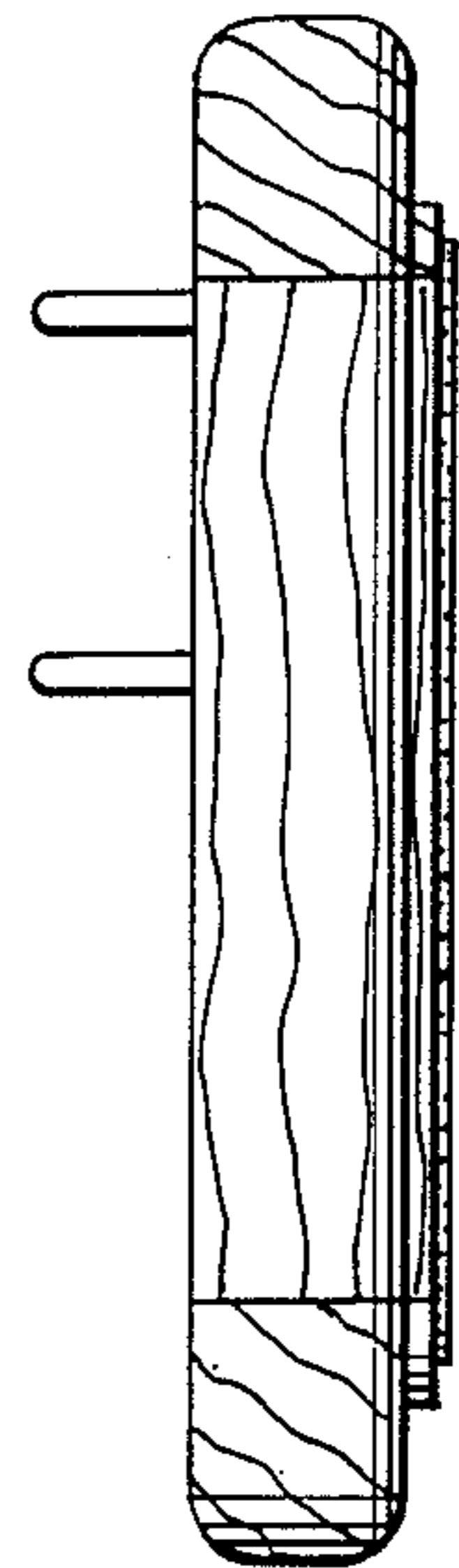

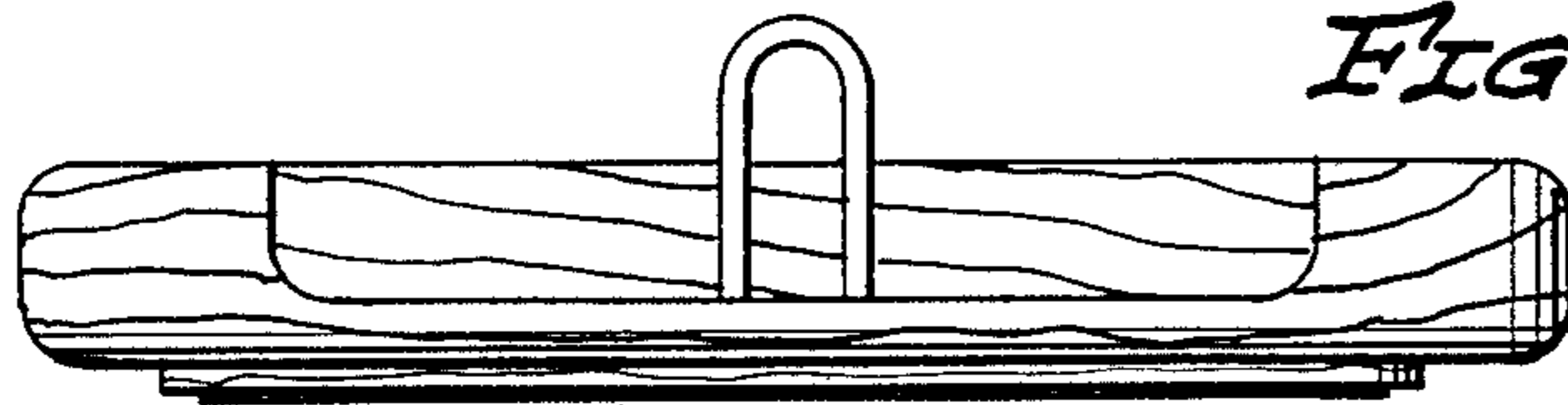

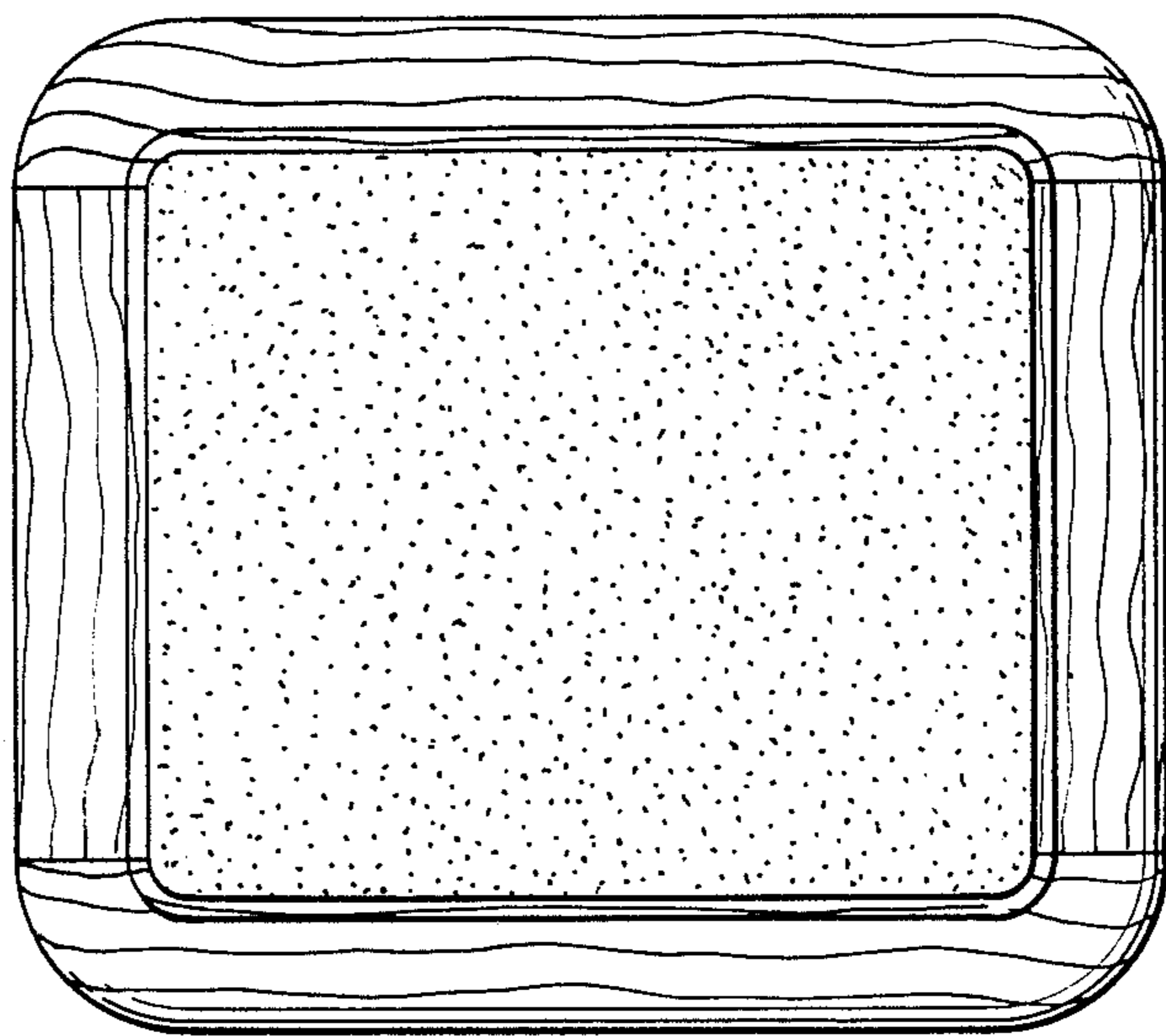

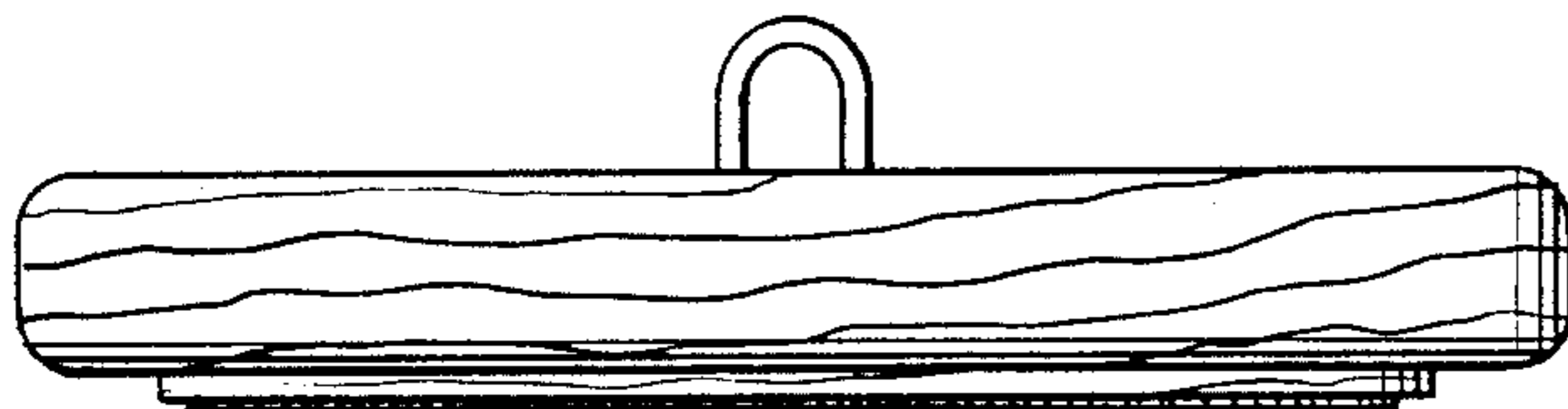
