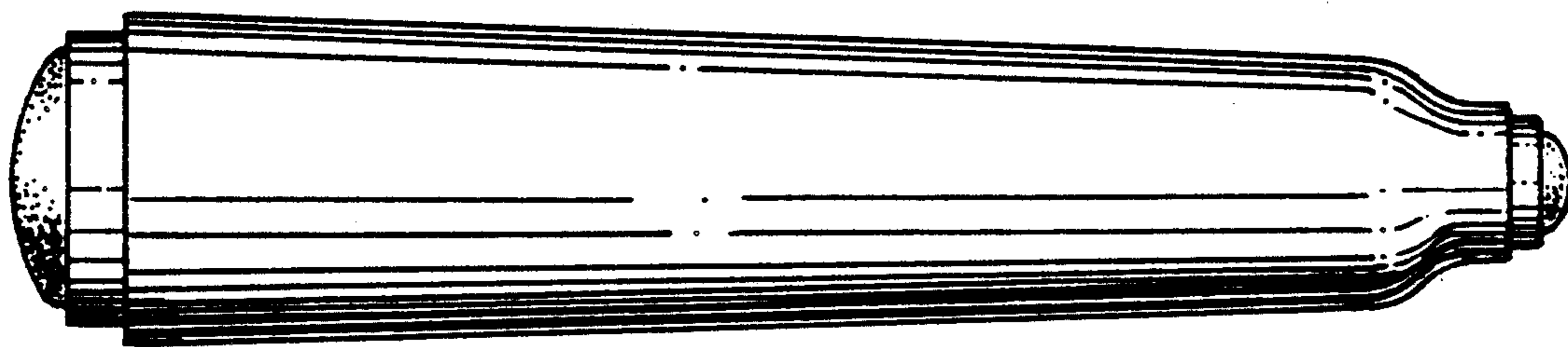

The ornamental design for a bingo card marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a bingo card marker showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation of a modified form of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation of FIG. 4; and
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation of FIG. 4.



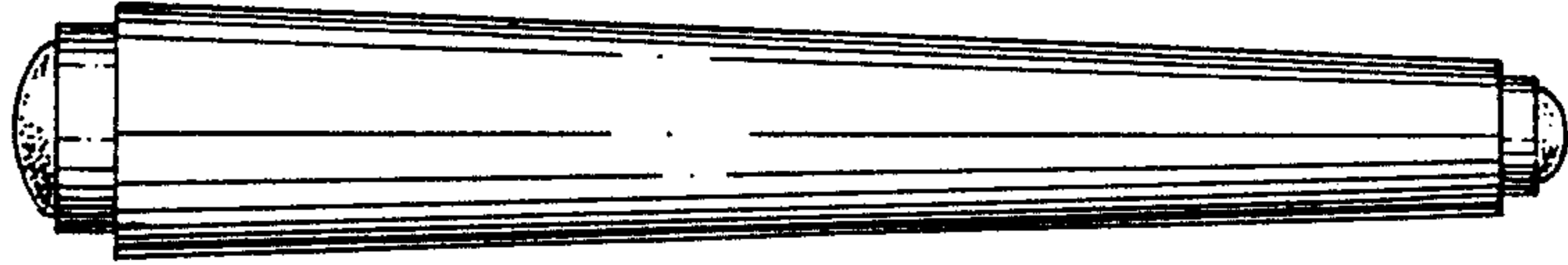

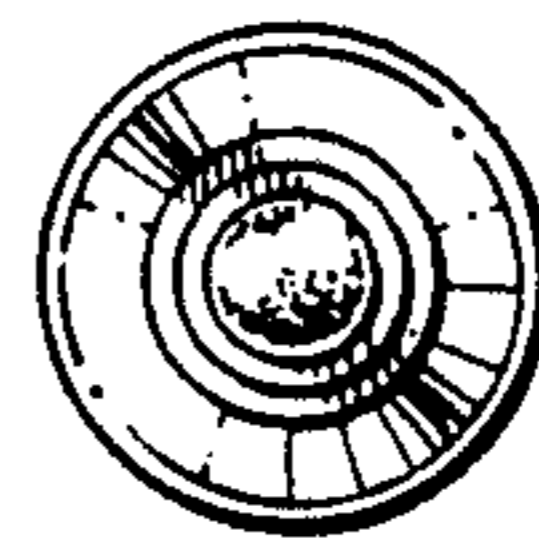

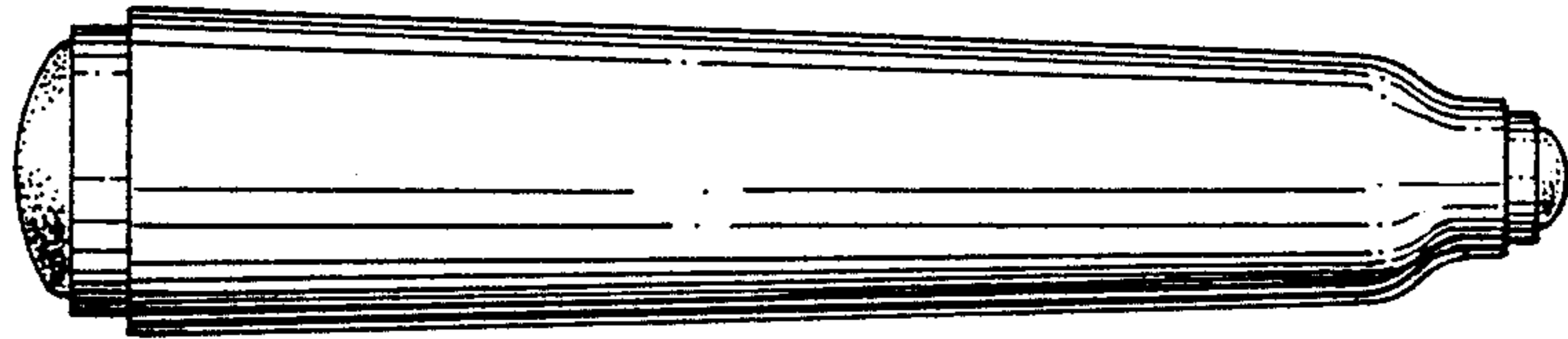

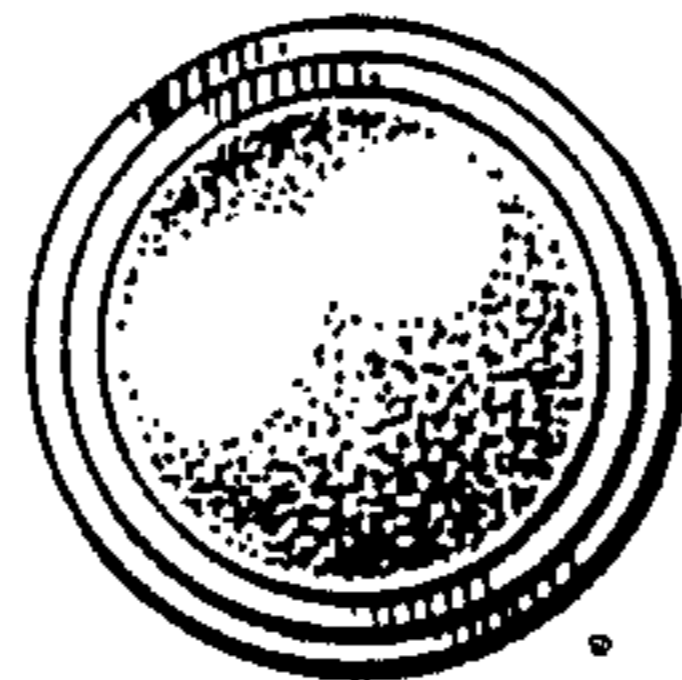

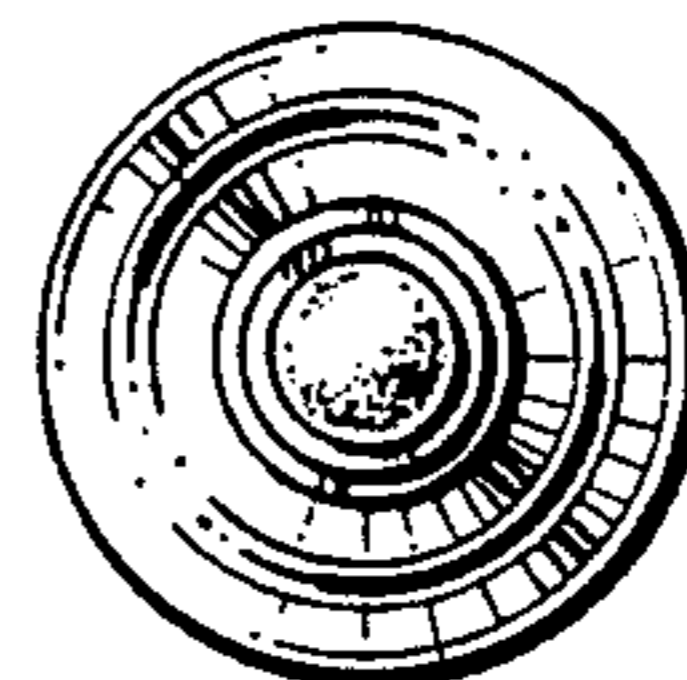
