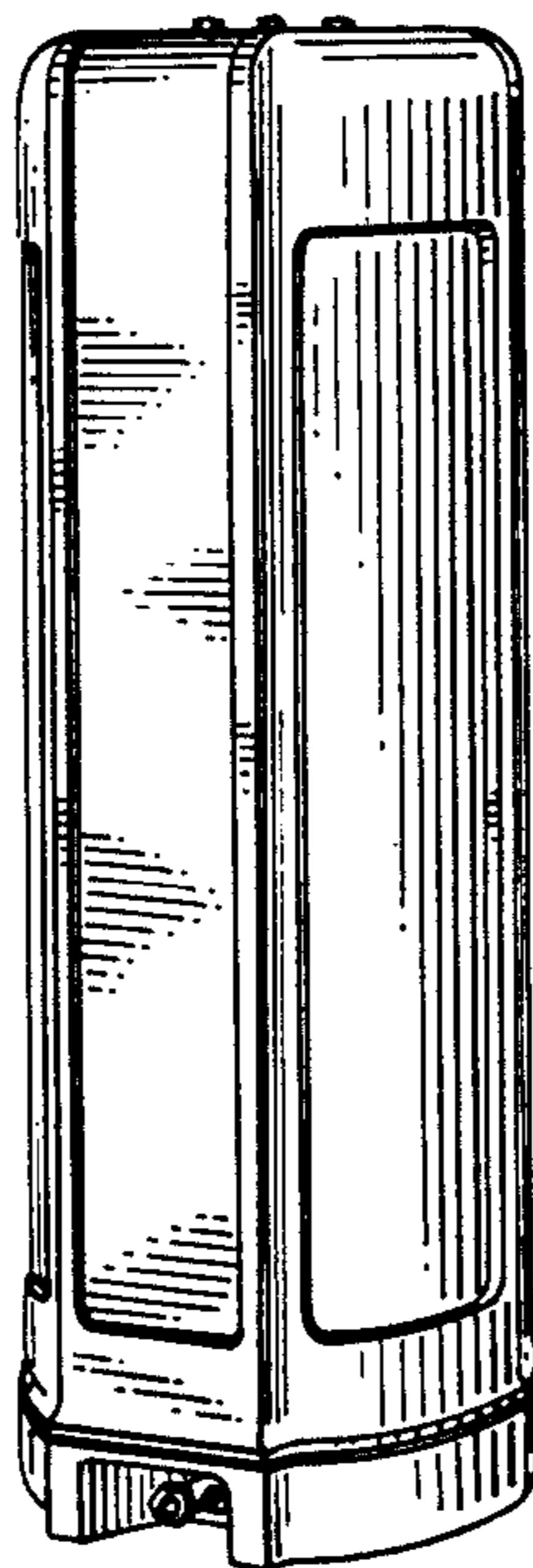

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of a water heater showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof.



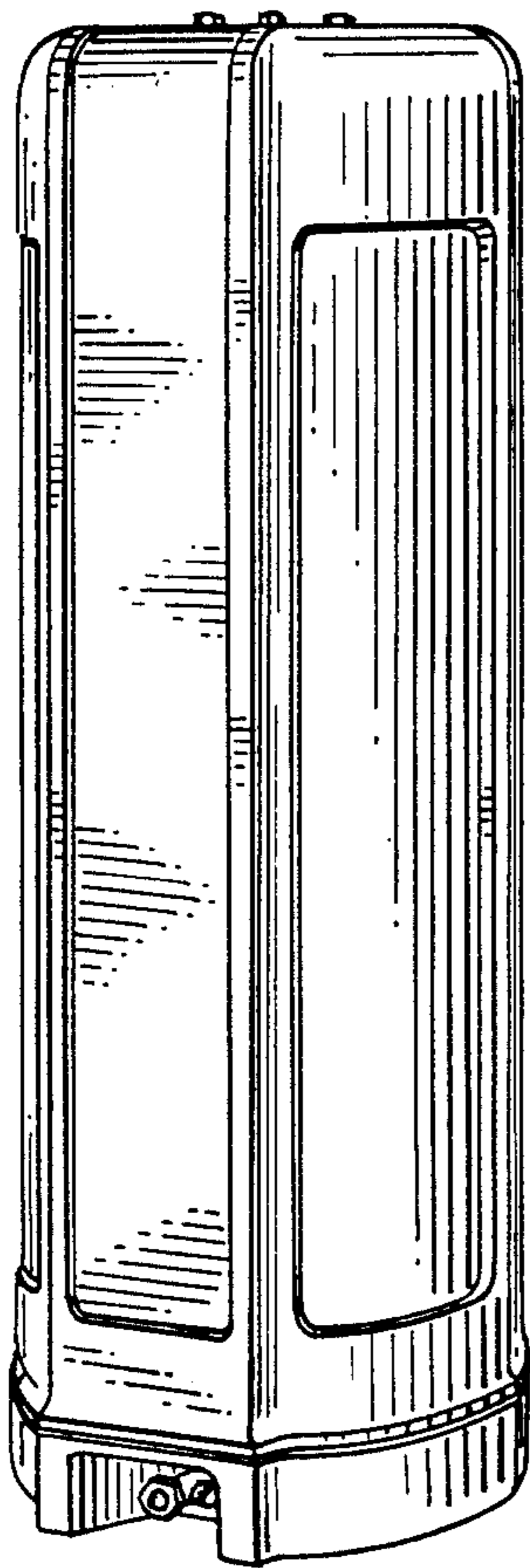

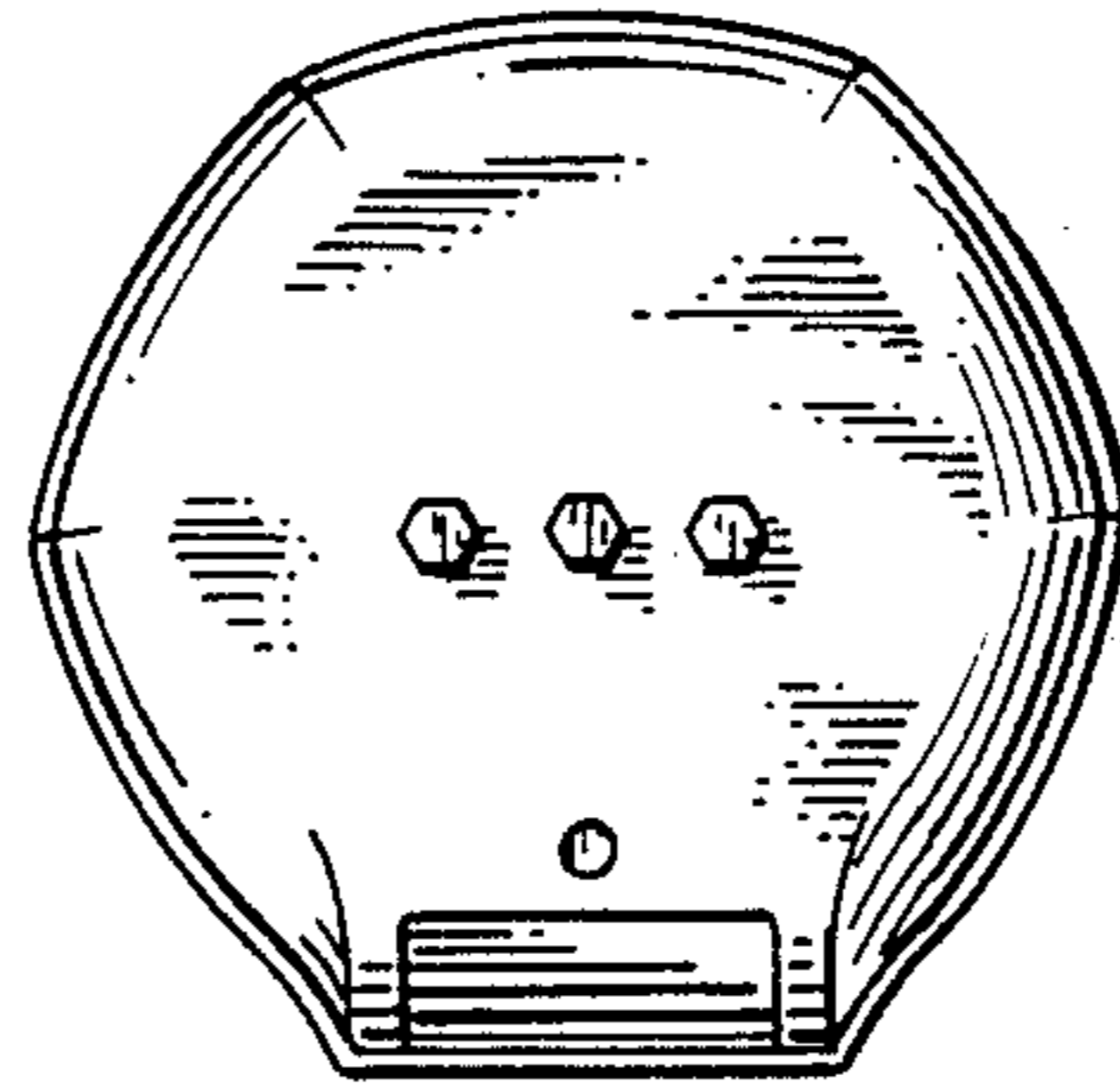

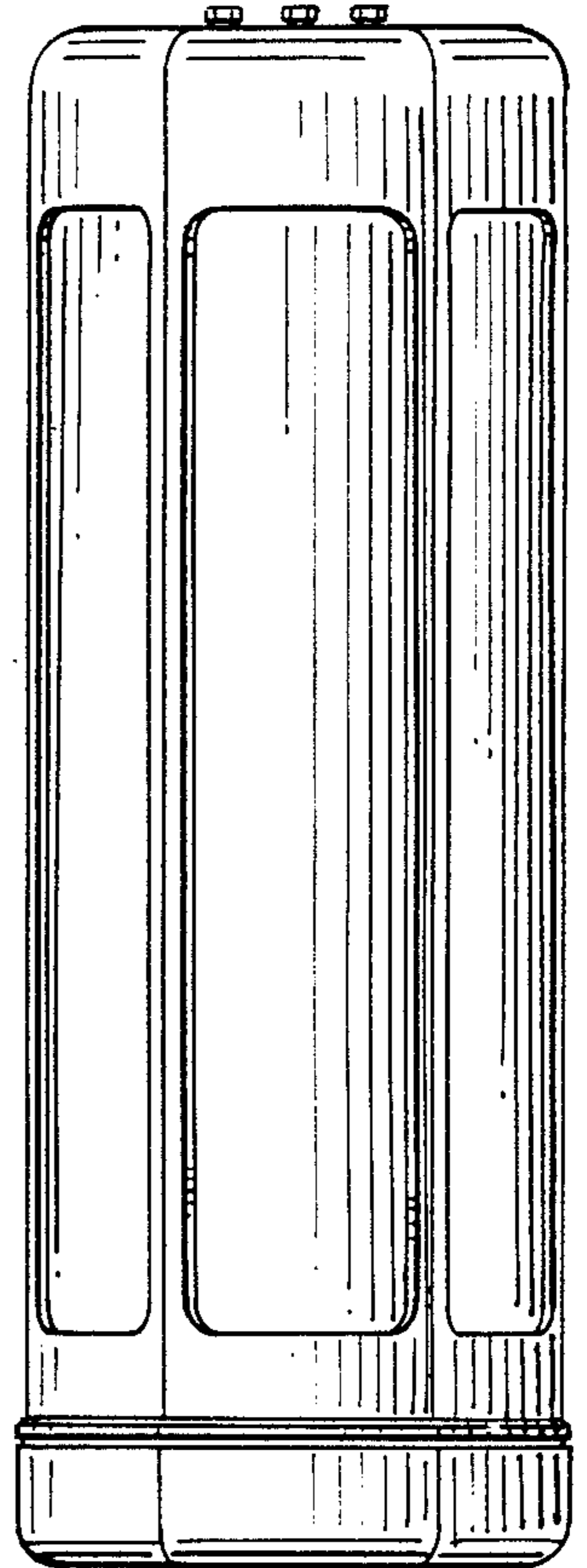

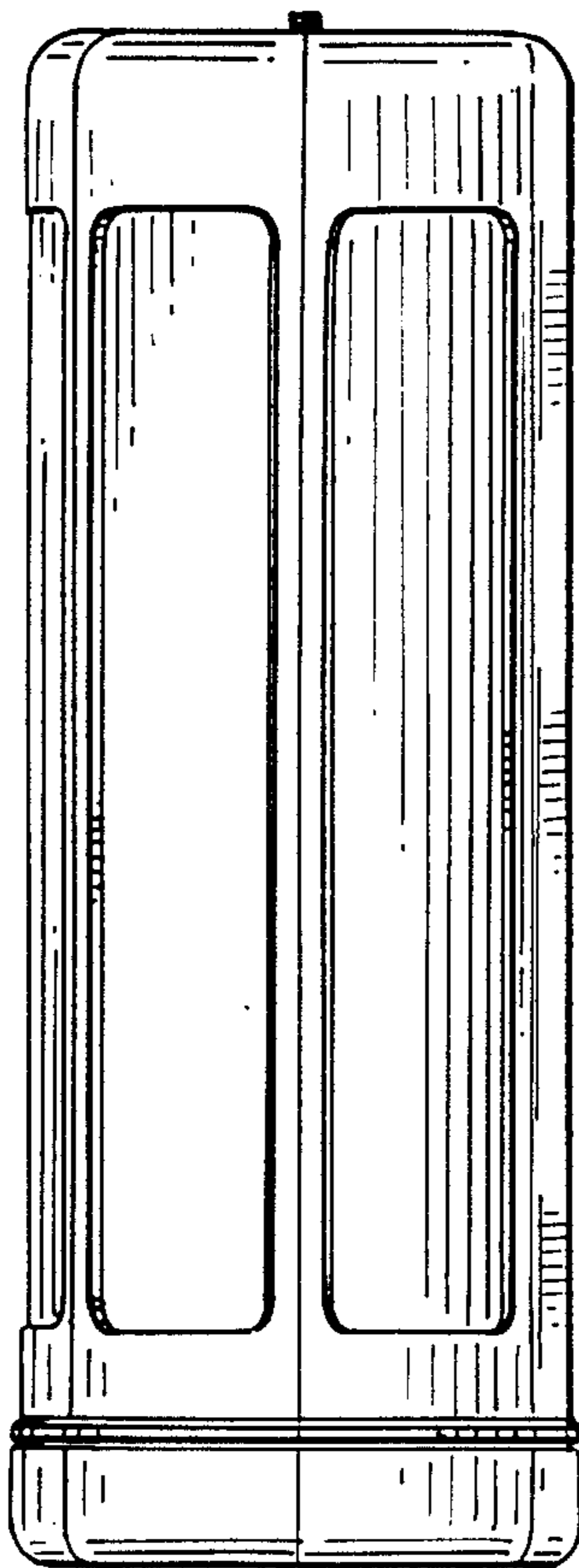

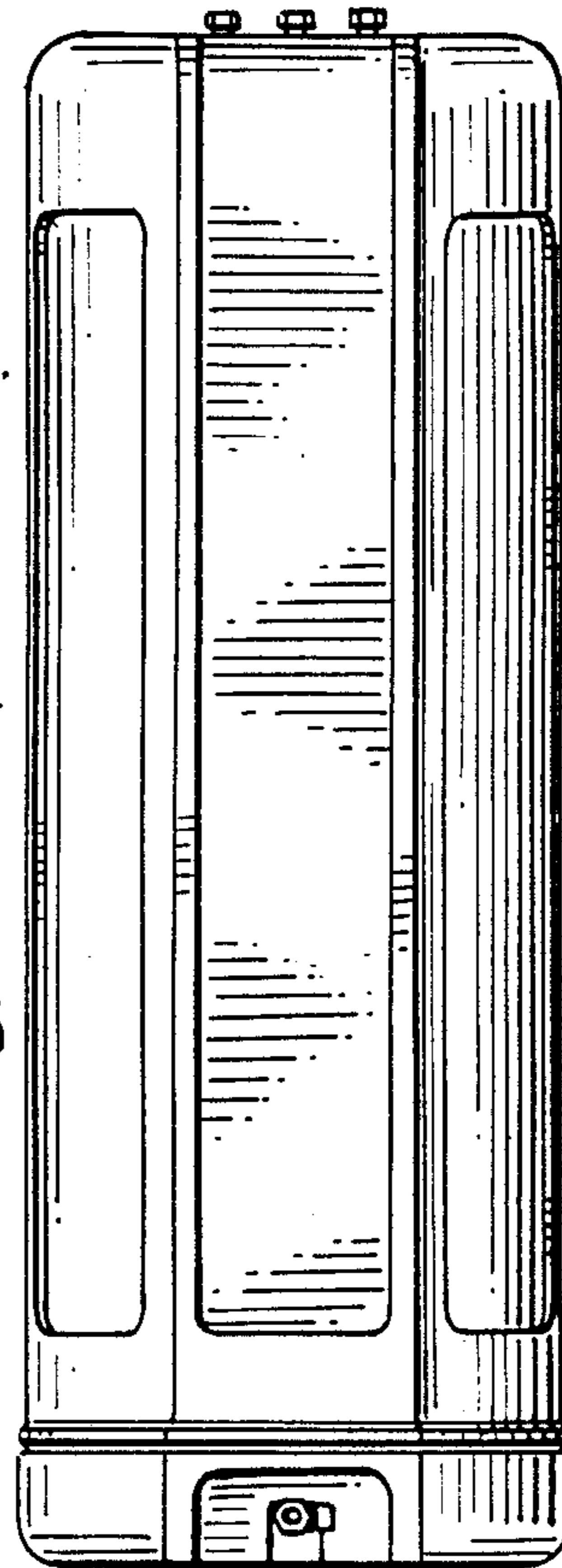
