[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a partition for a camera bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a partition for a camera bag showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is another top, front and left side perspective view thereof.

The broken line representation of a camera and the fragmentary broken line representation of a camera bag are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

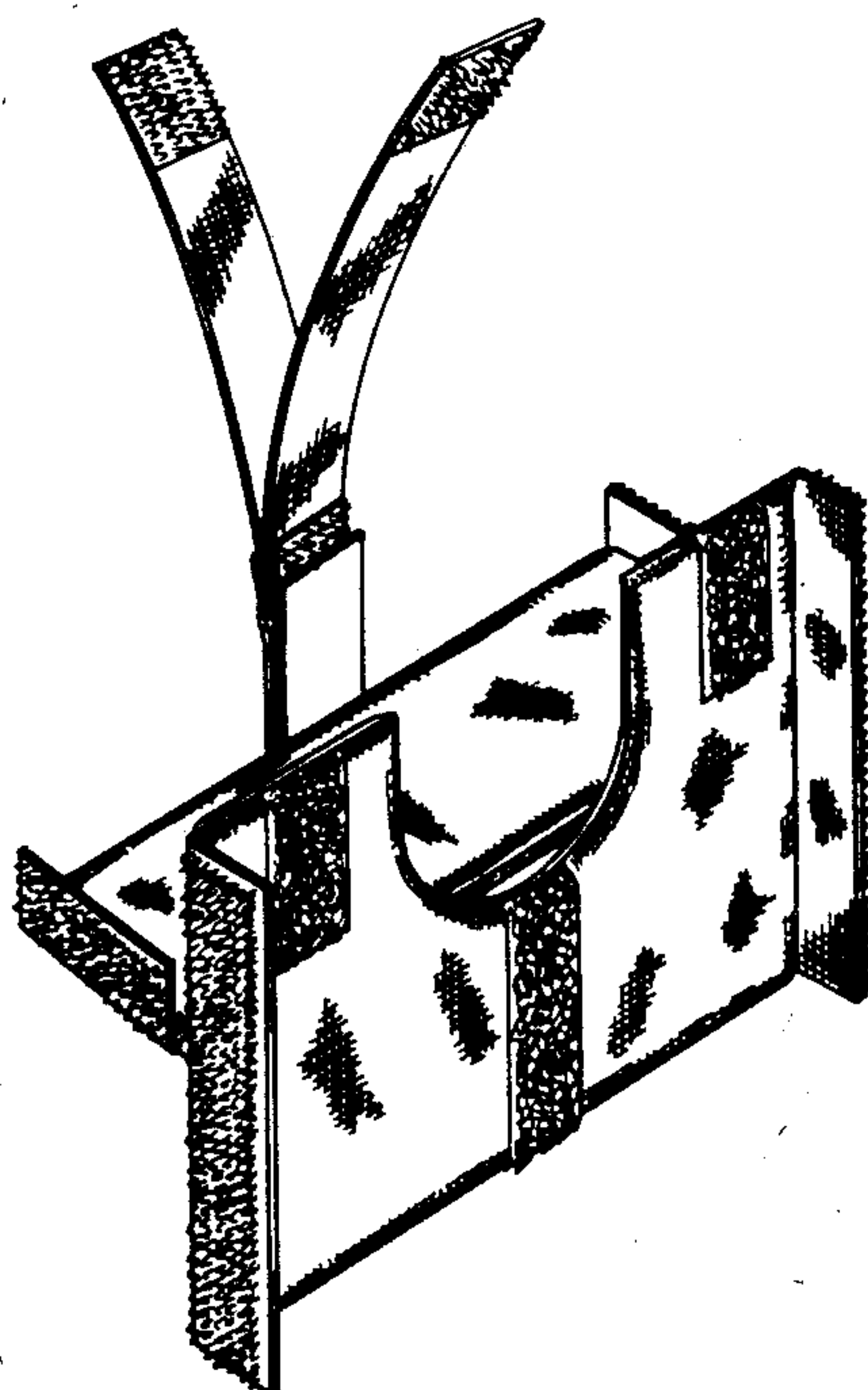

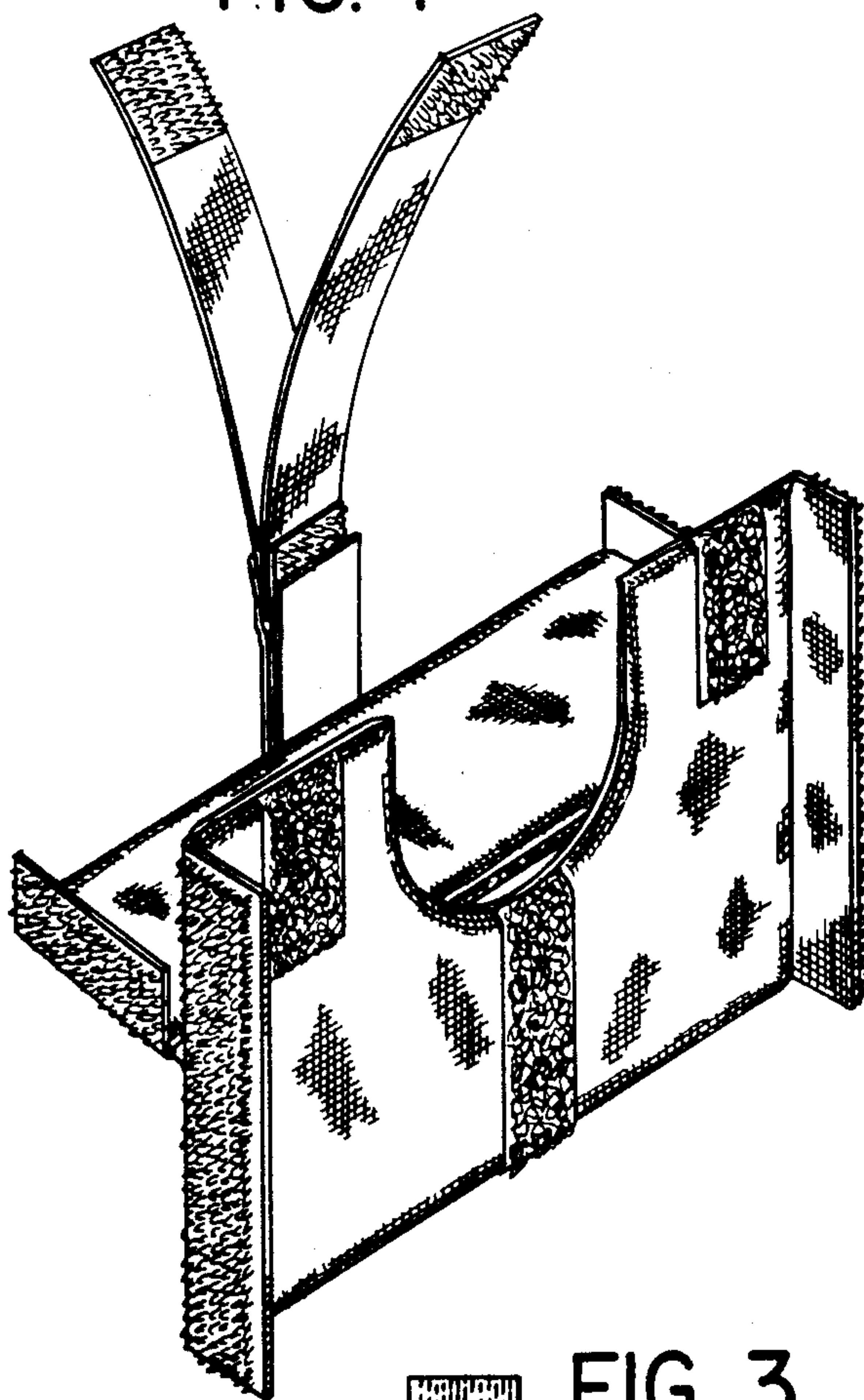

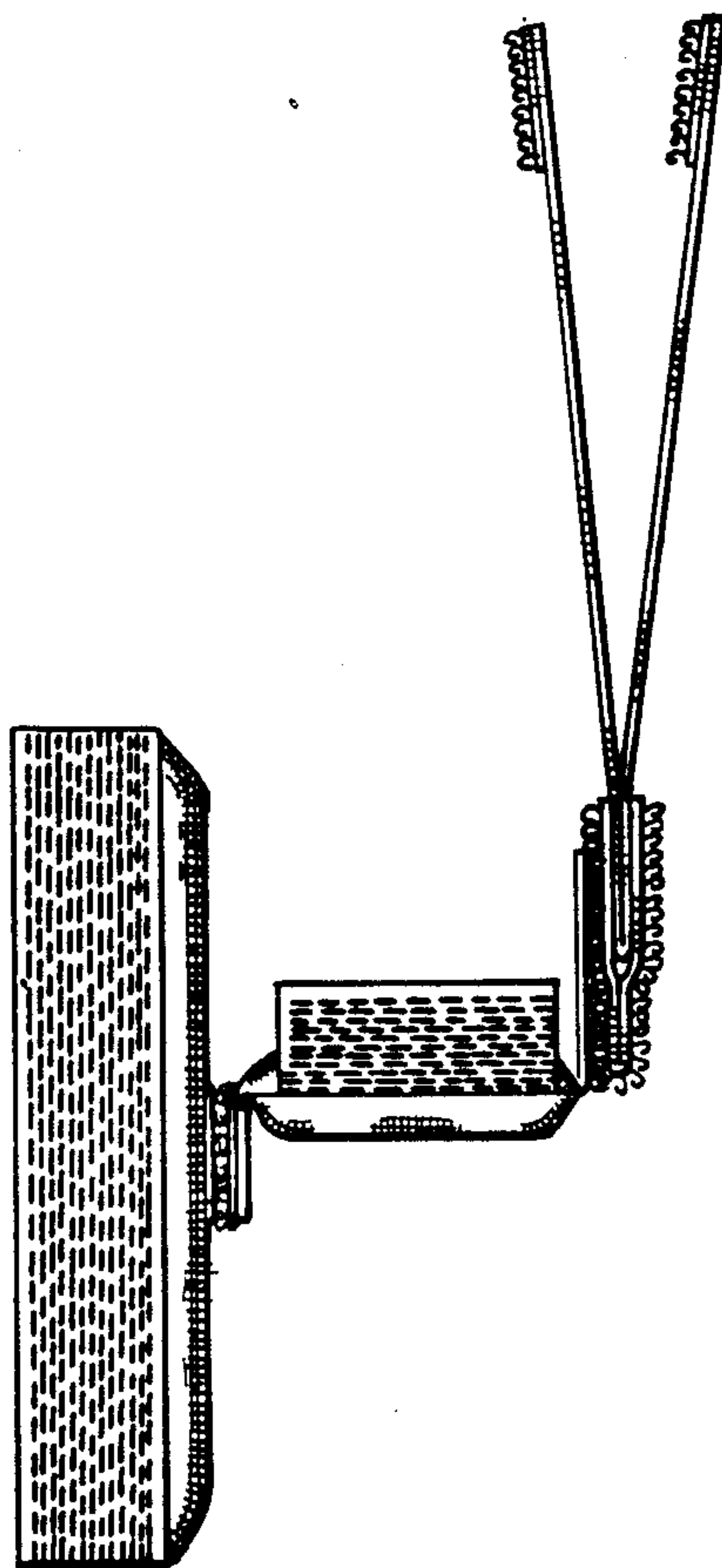

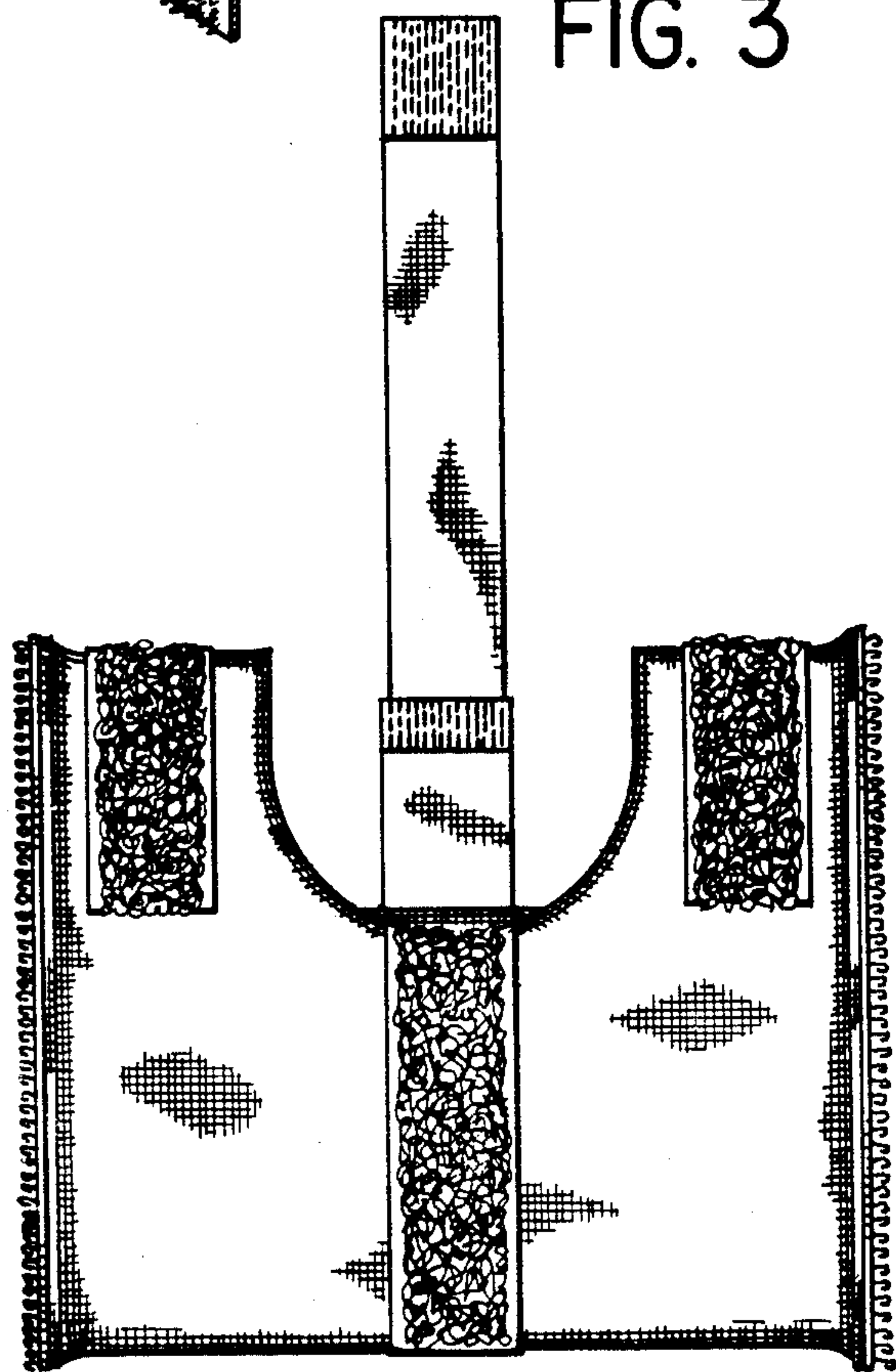

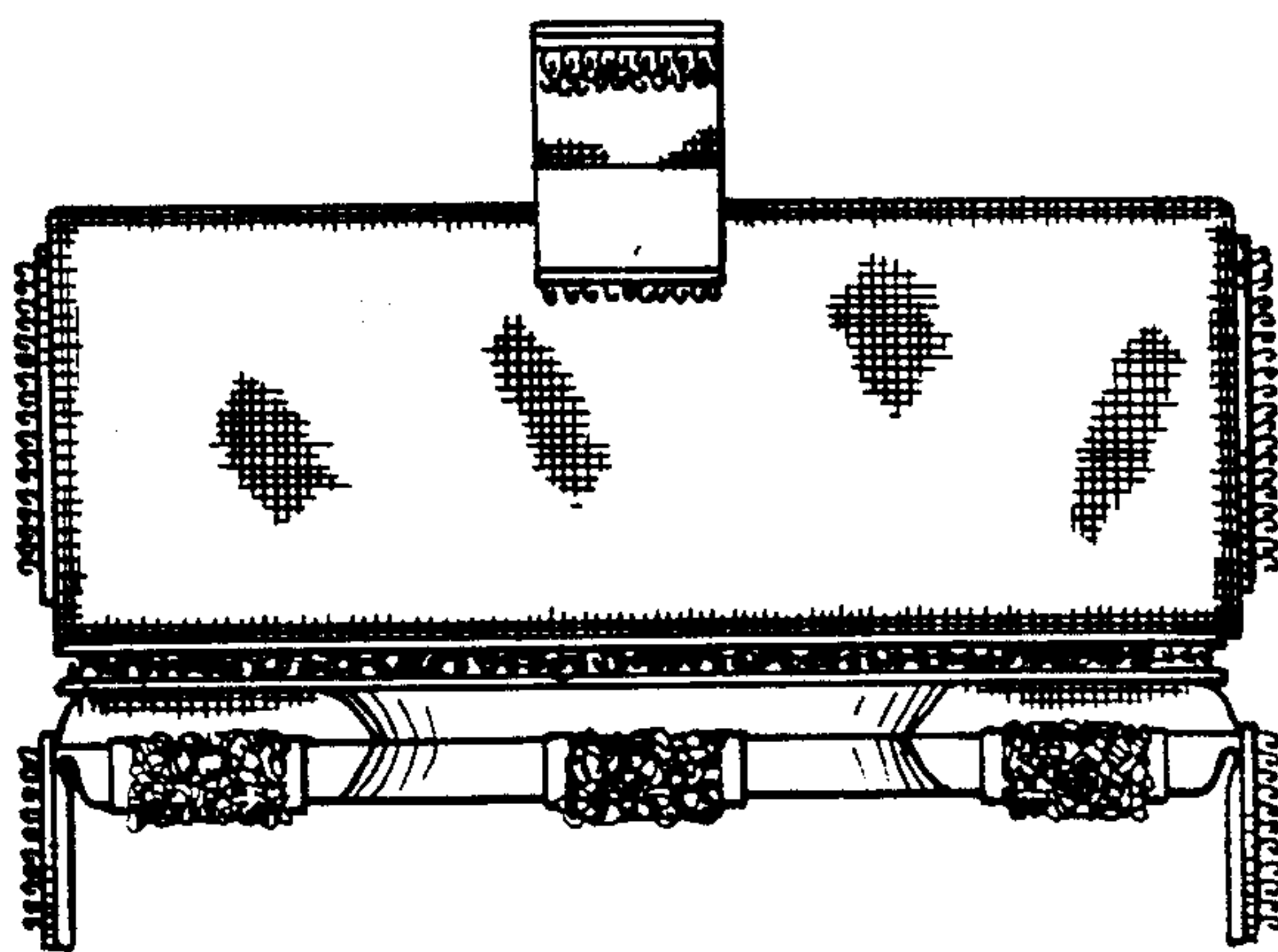

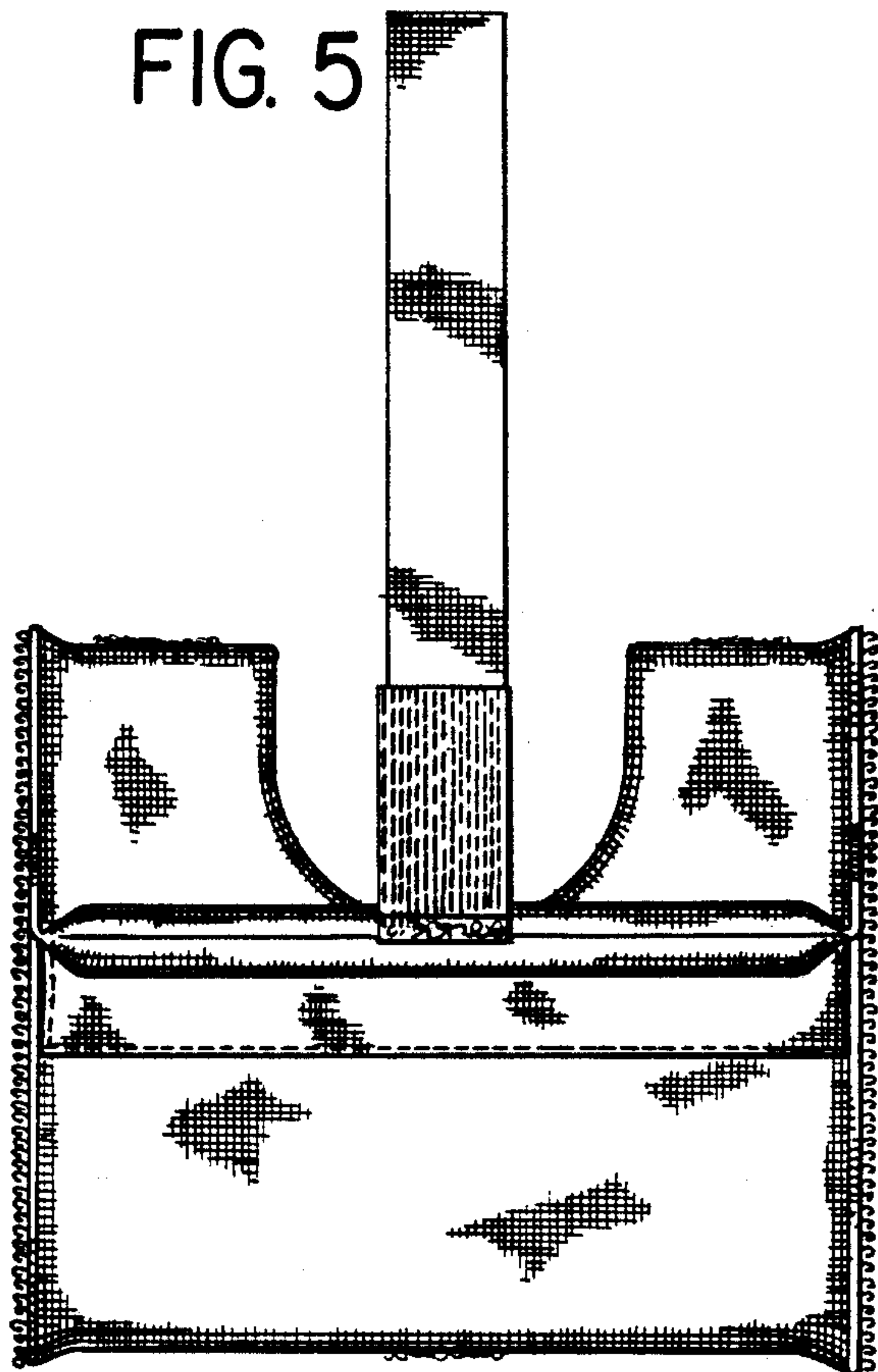

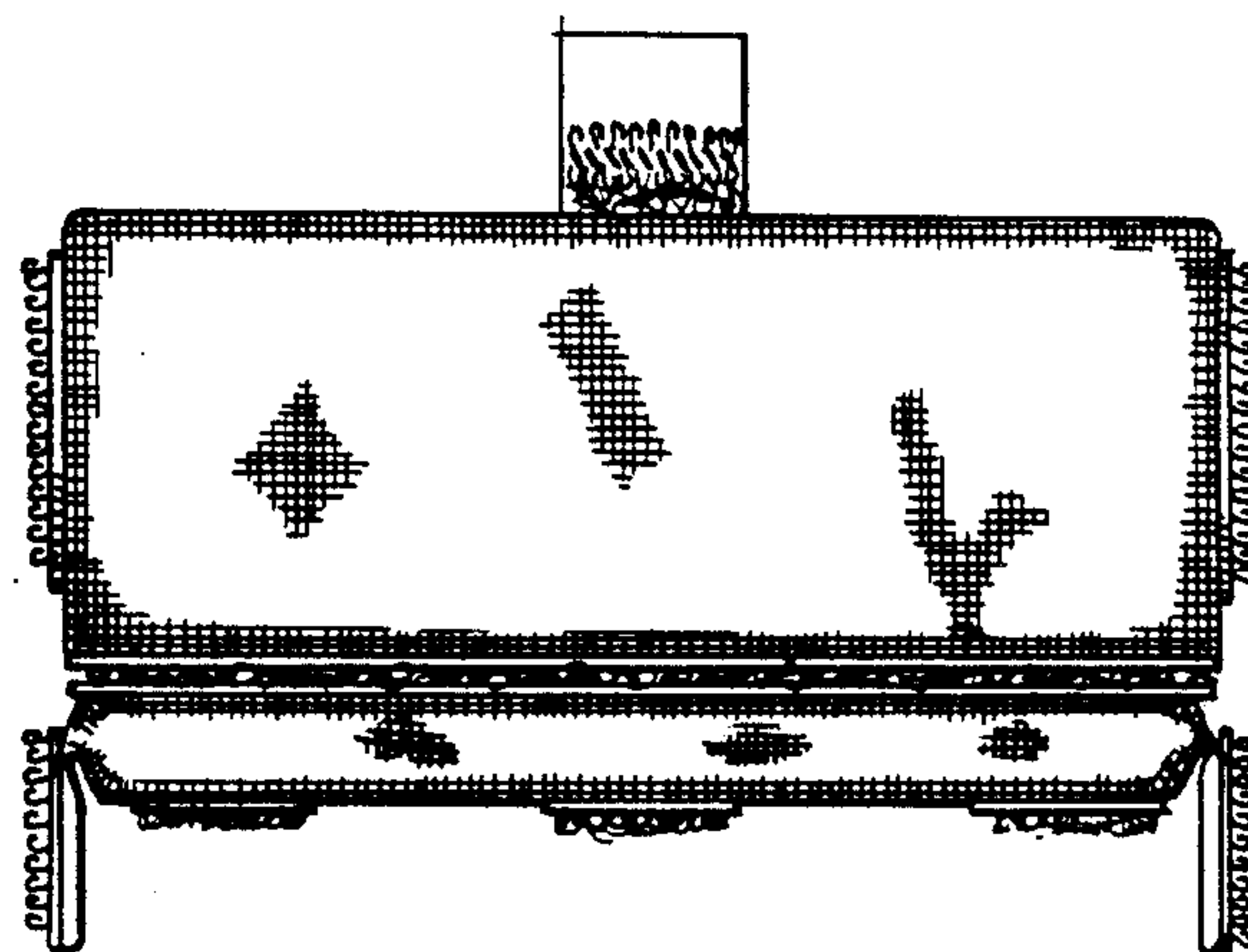
