FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a character indicia encoding desk for mail showing my new design;

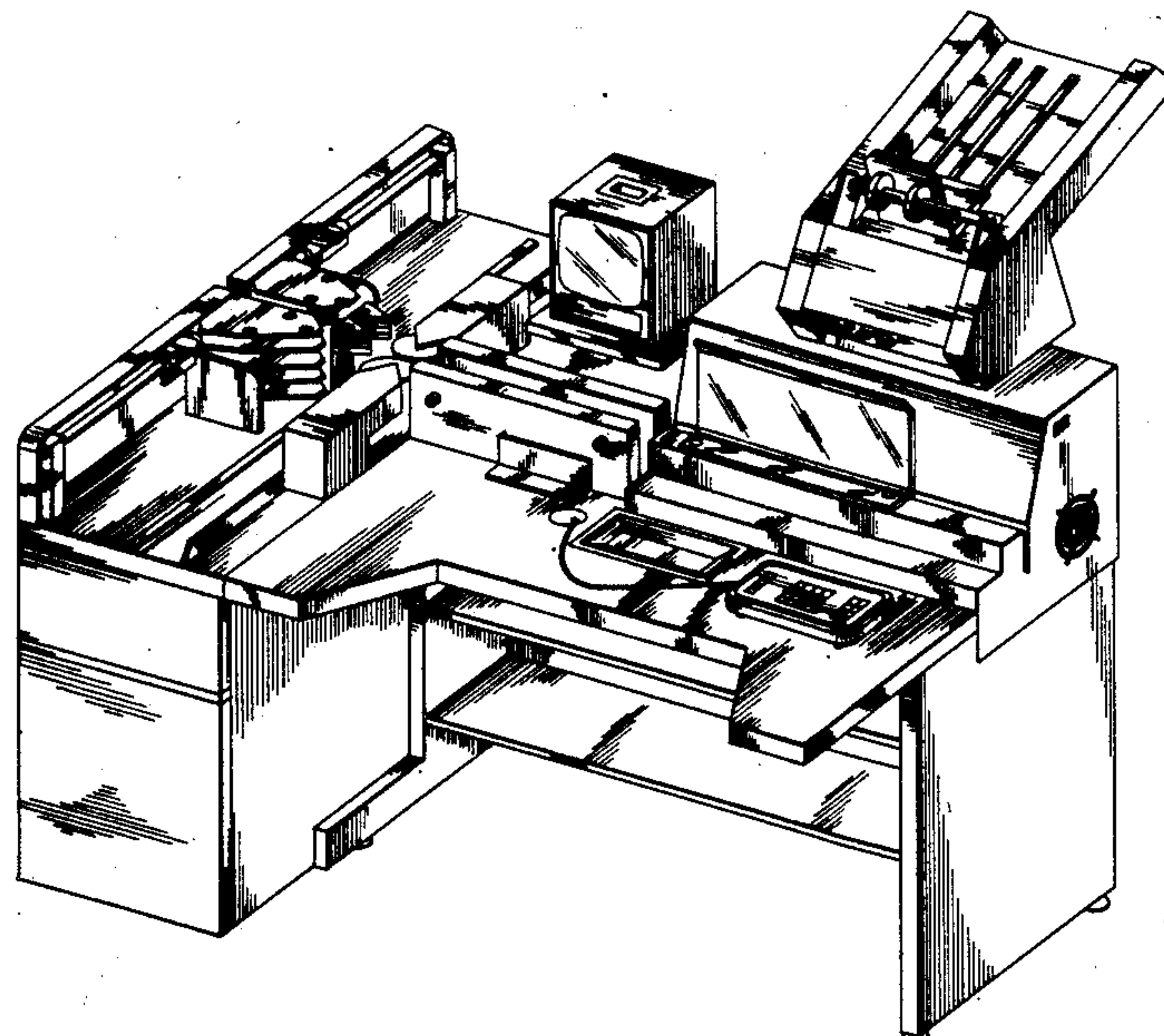
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.



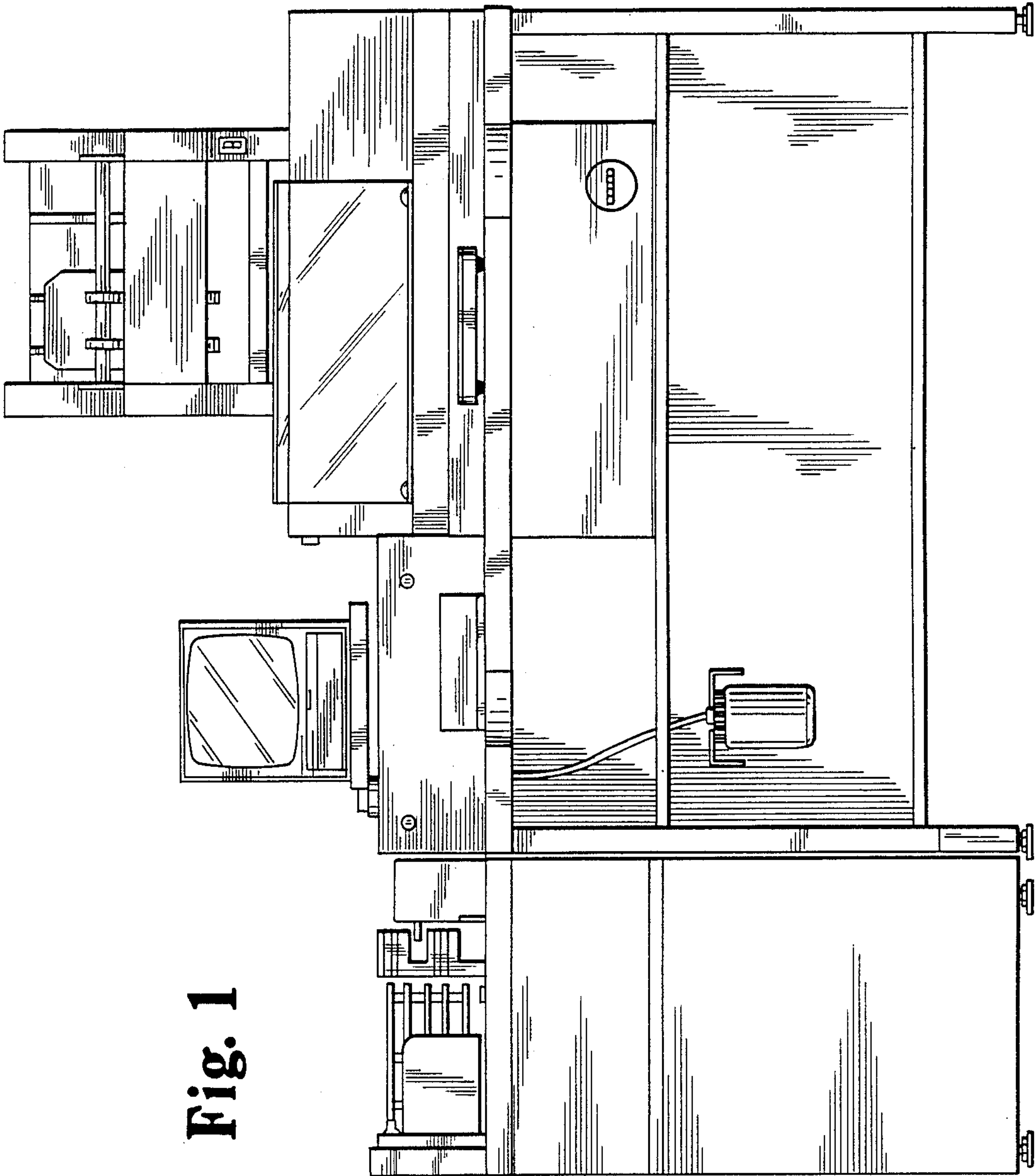
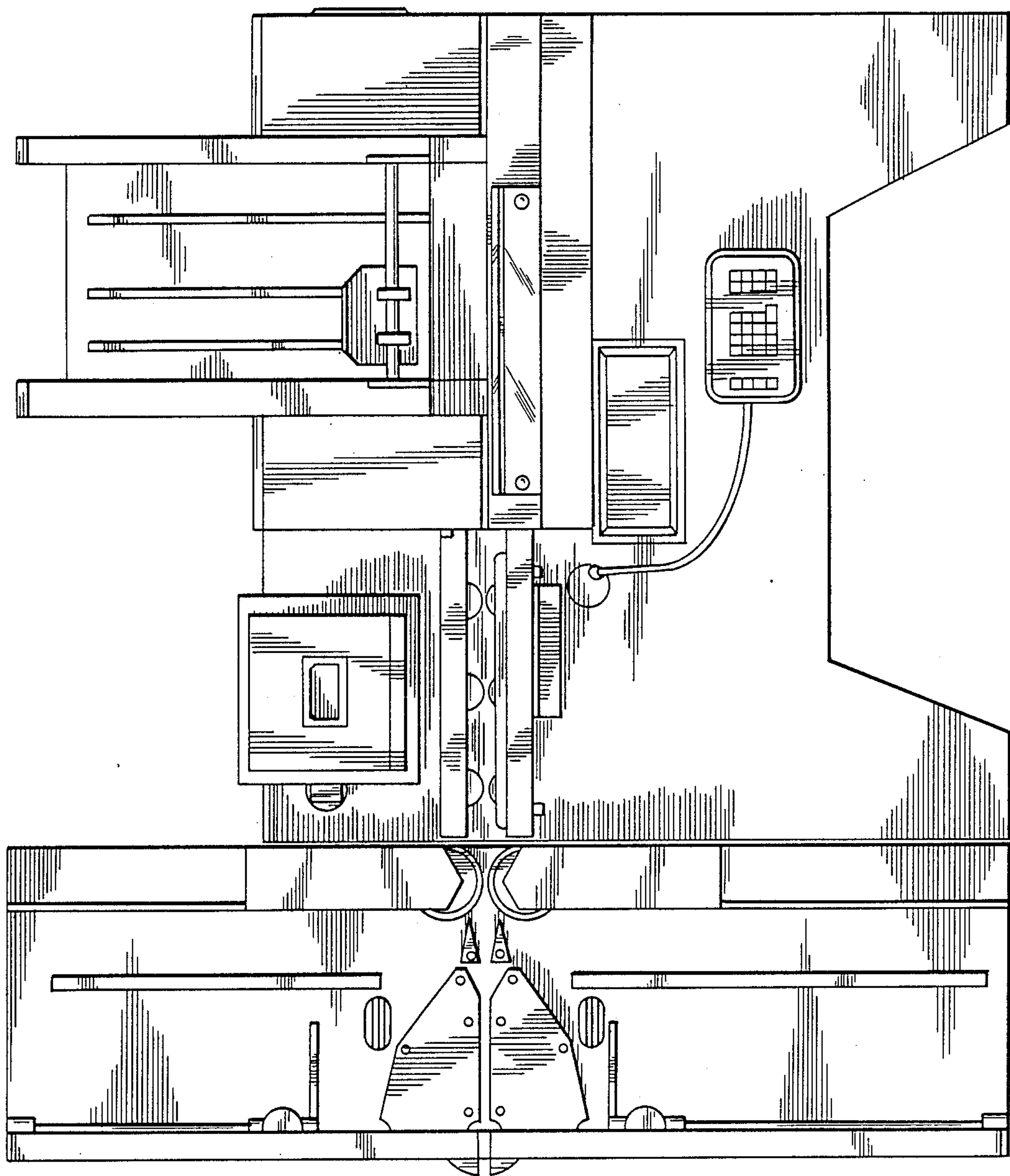

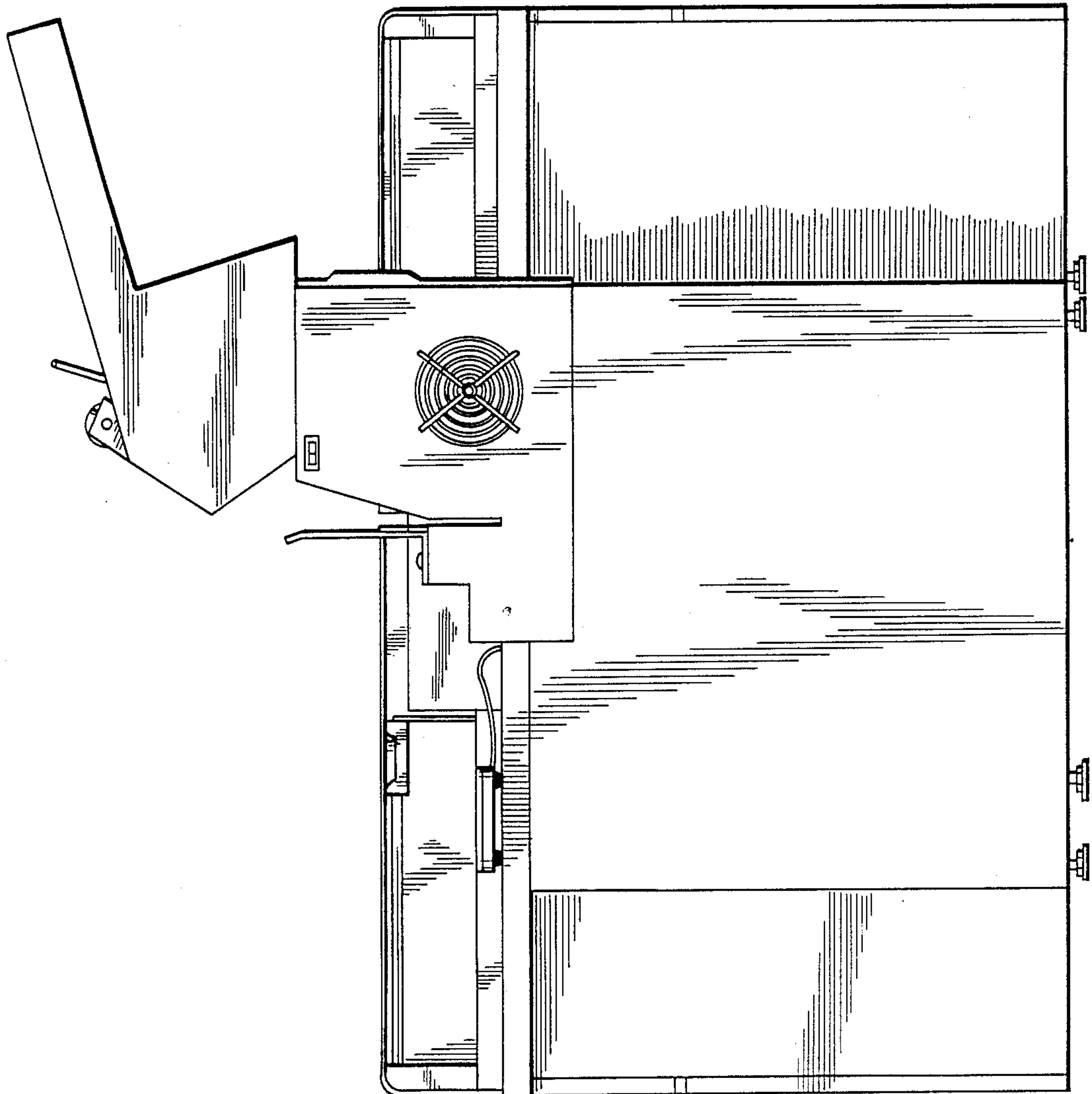

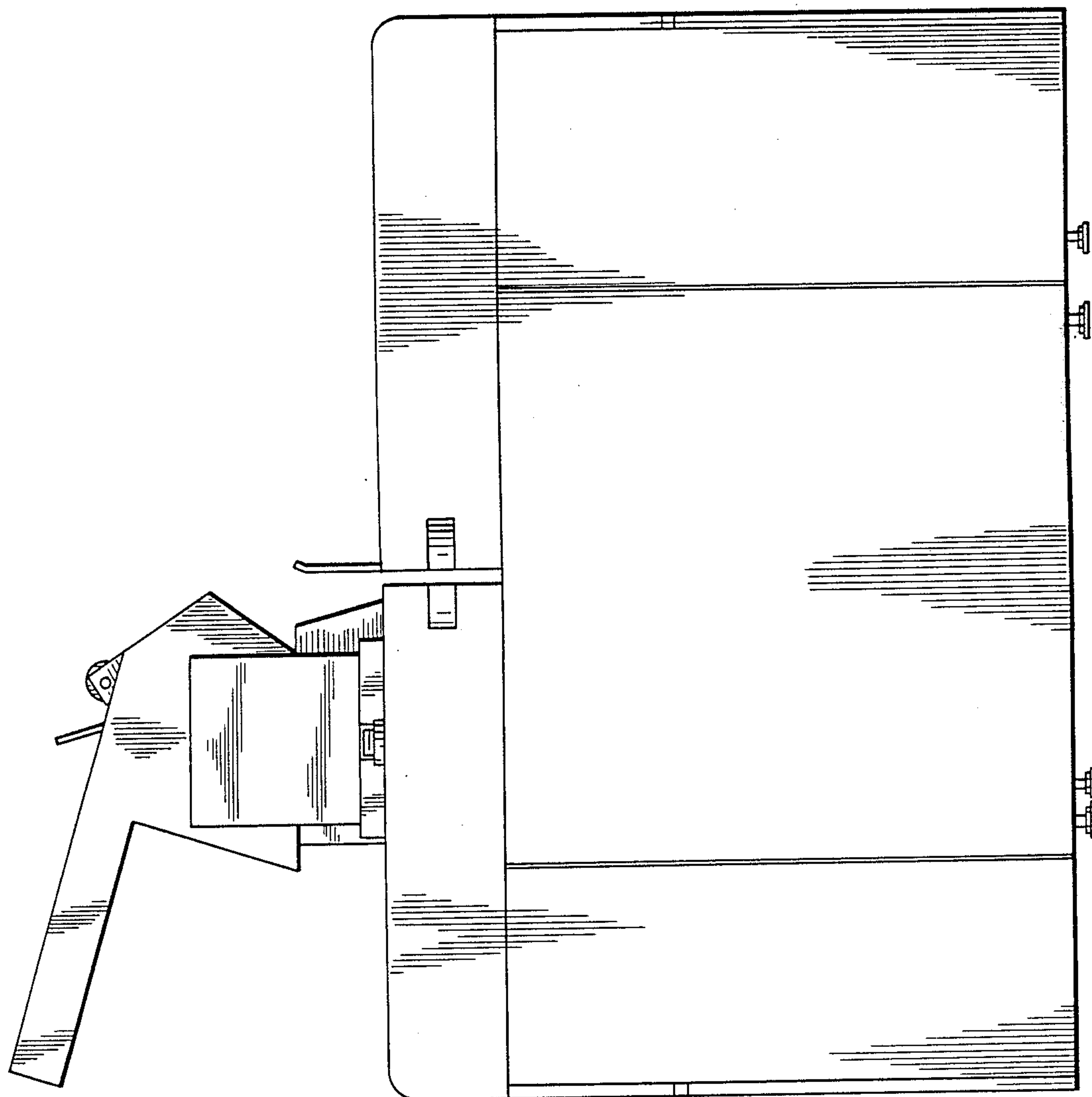

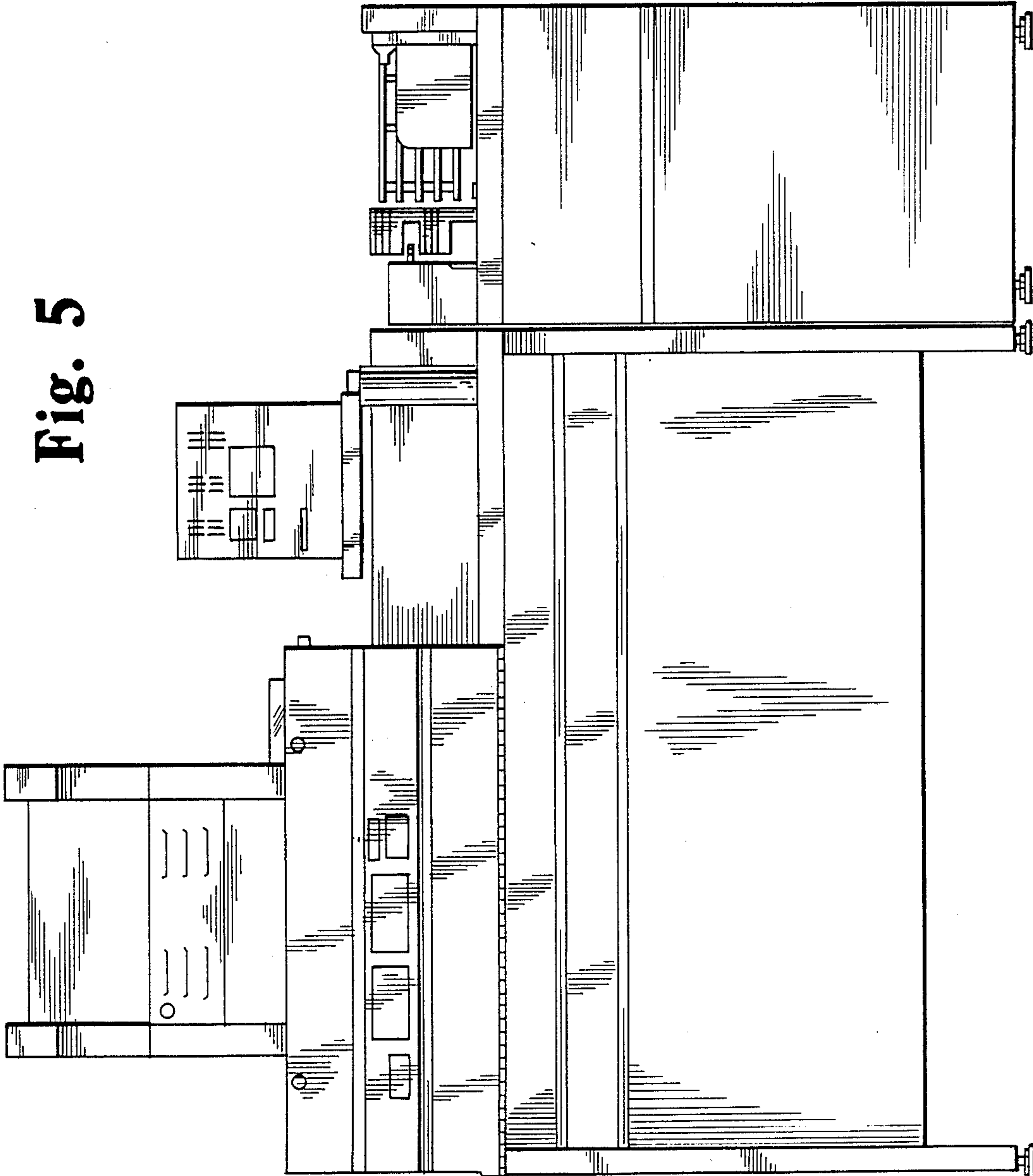

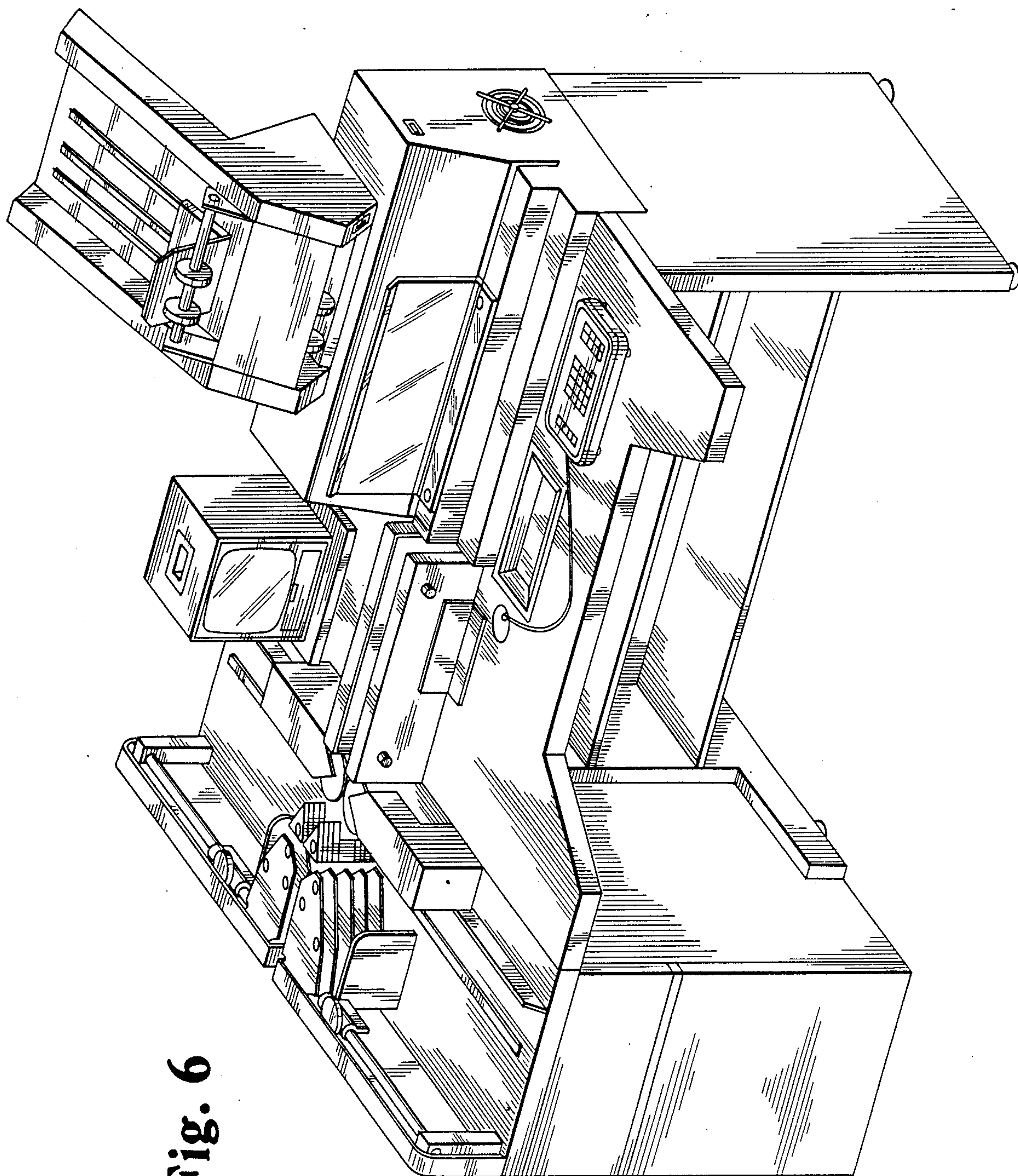
