FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a portable television receiver/monitor showing my new design;

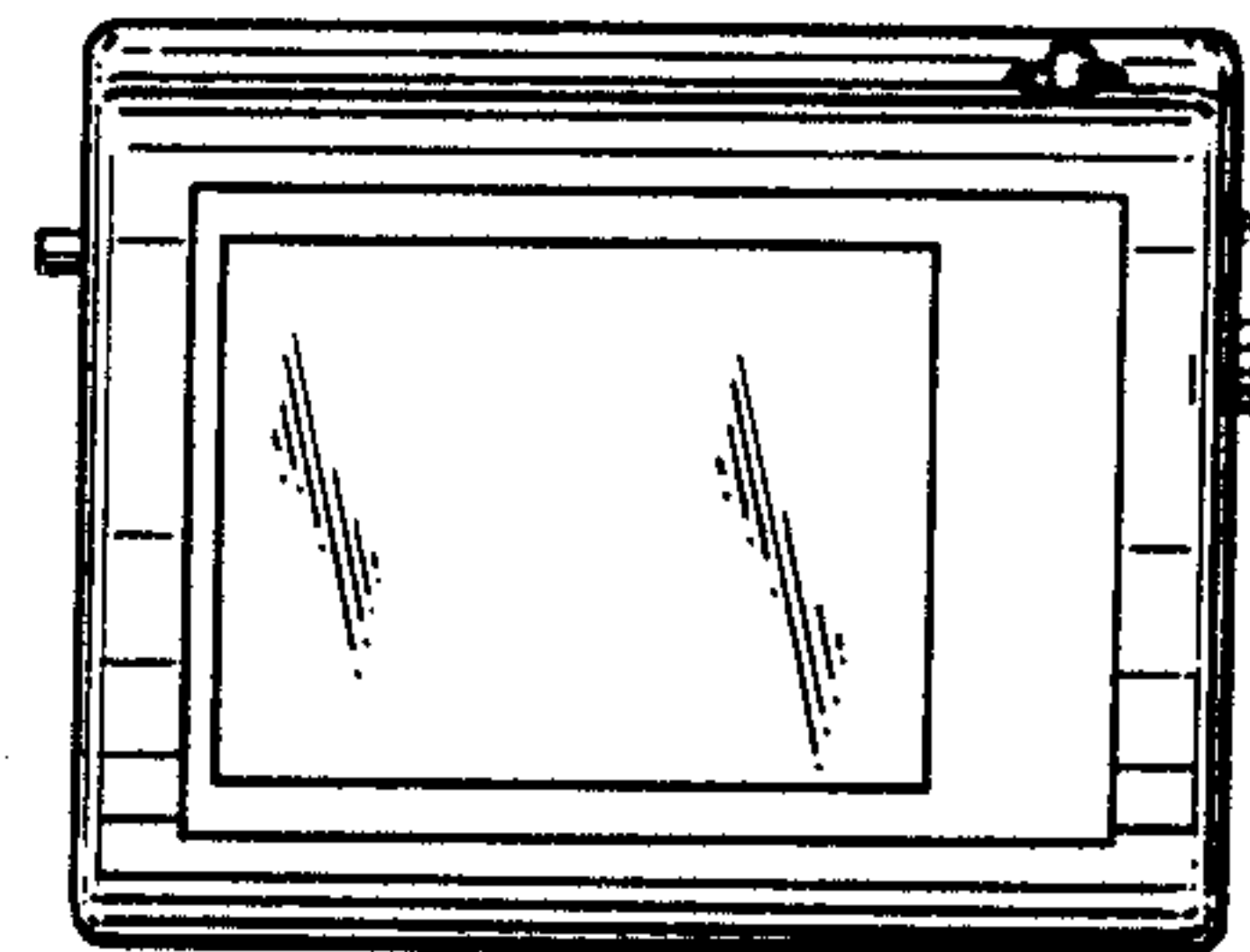
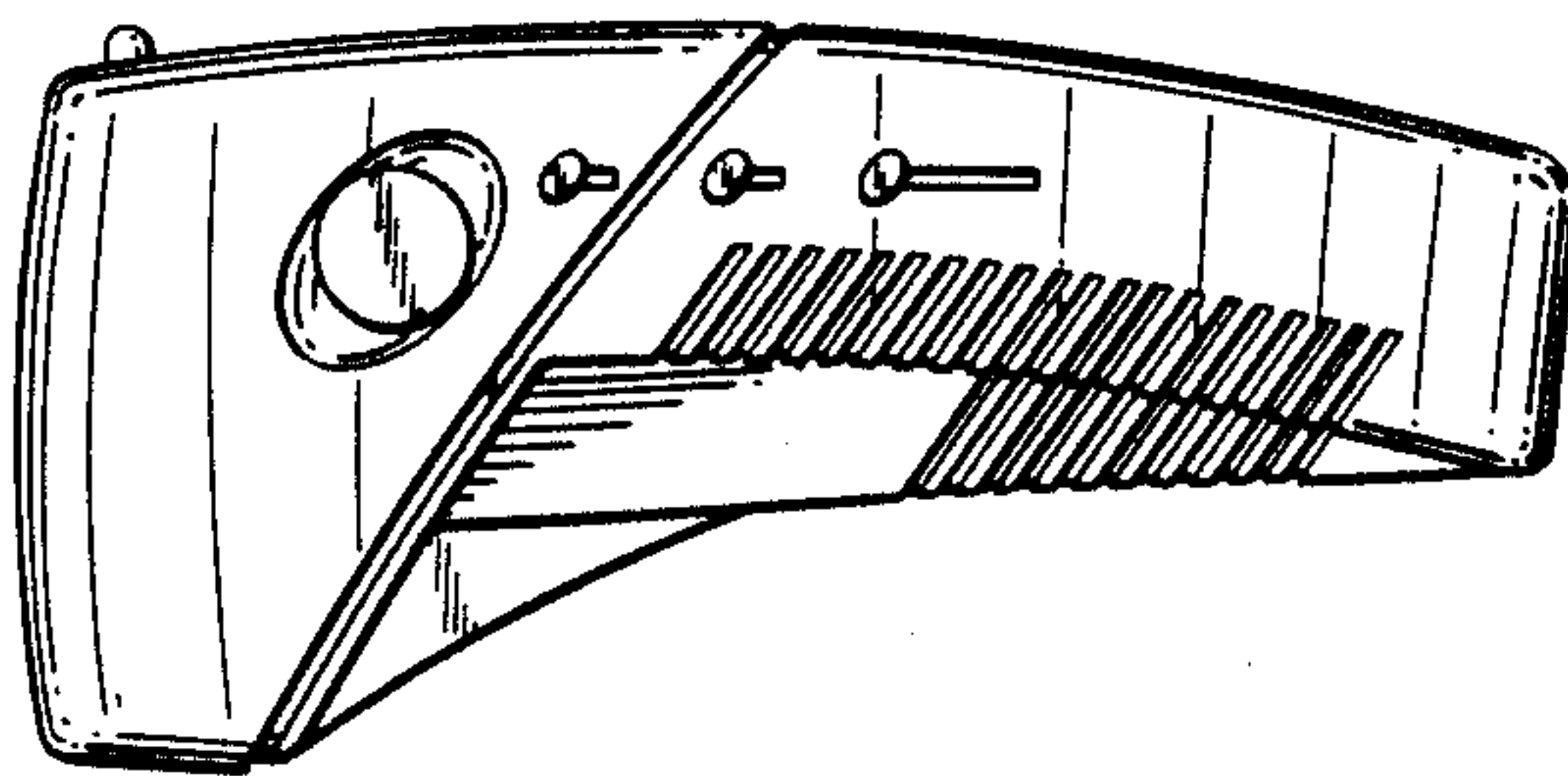
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof, rotated 180 degrees from FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



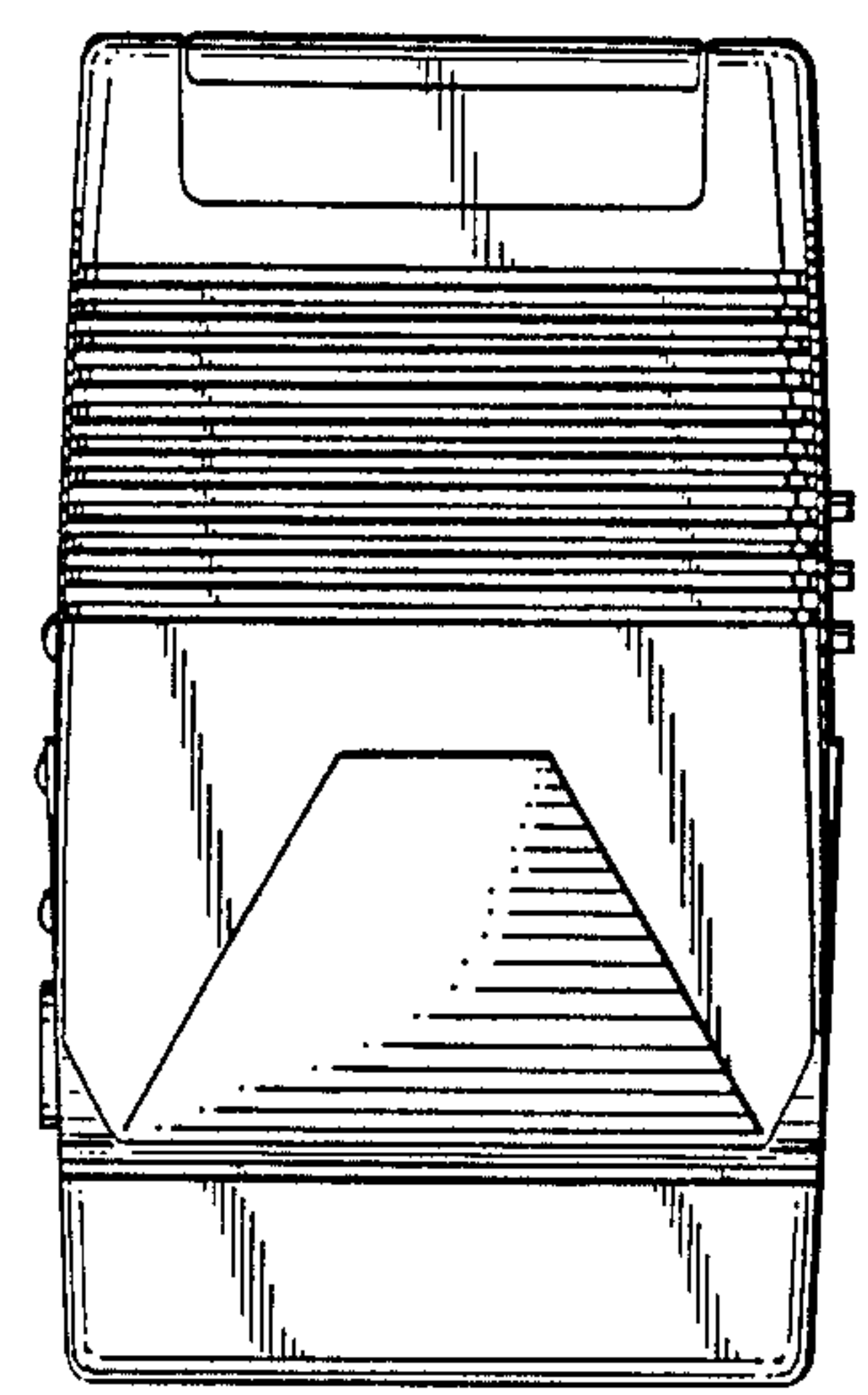

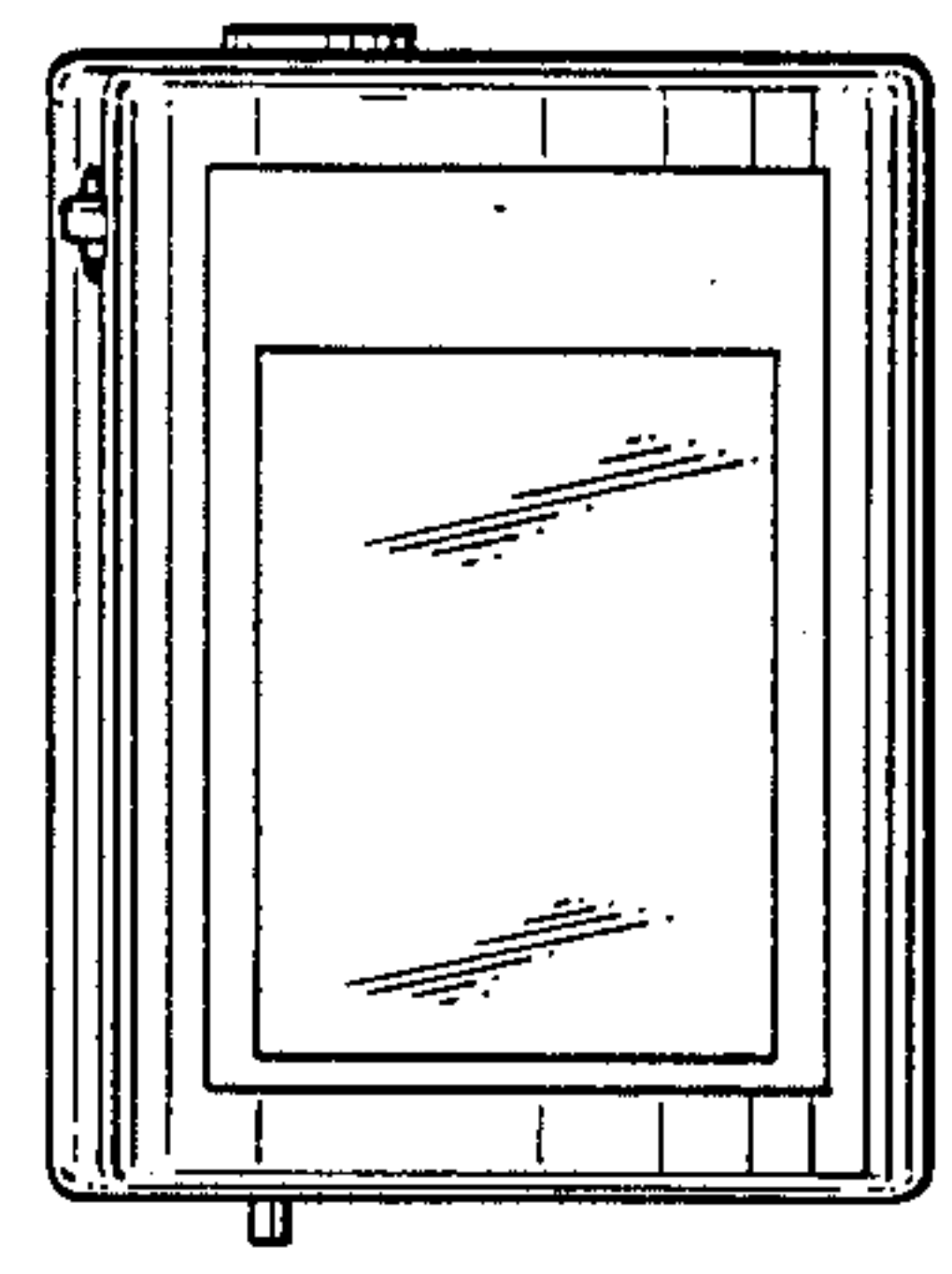

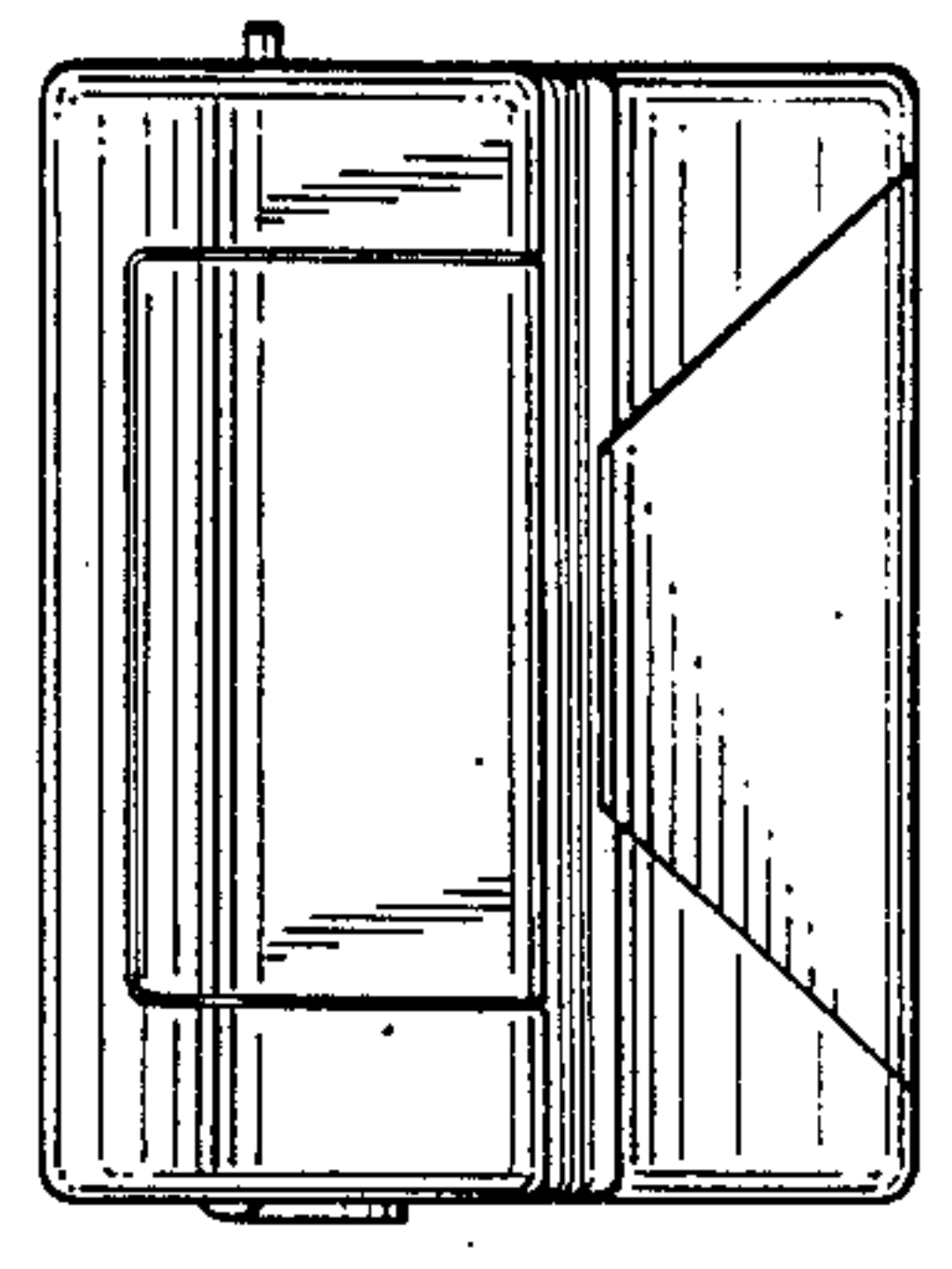

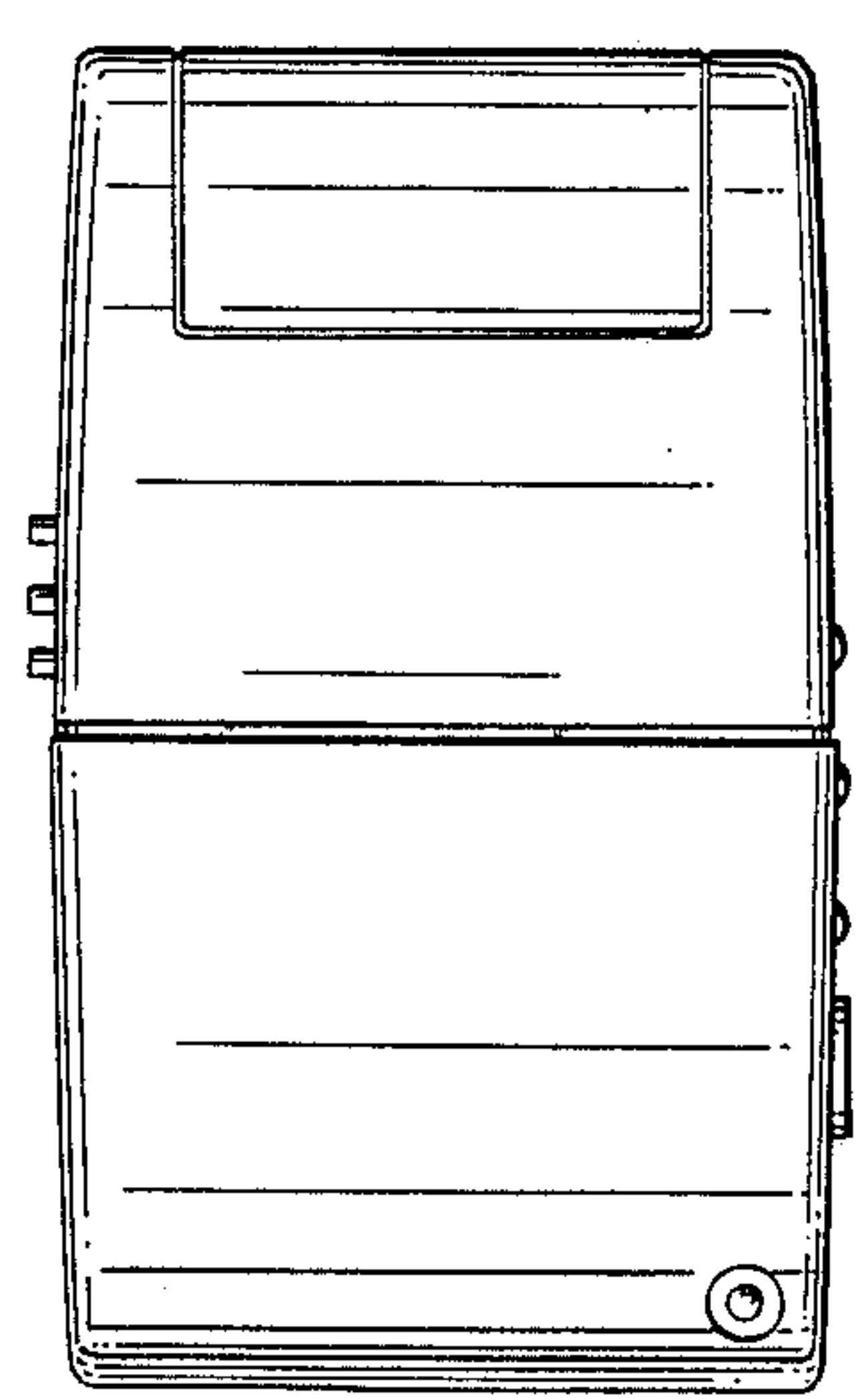

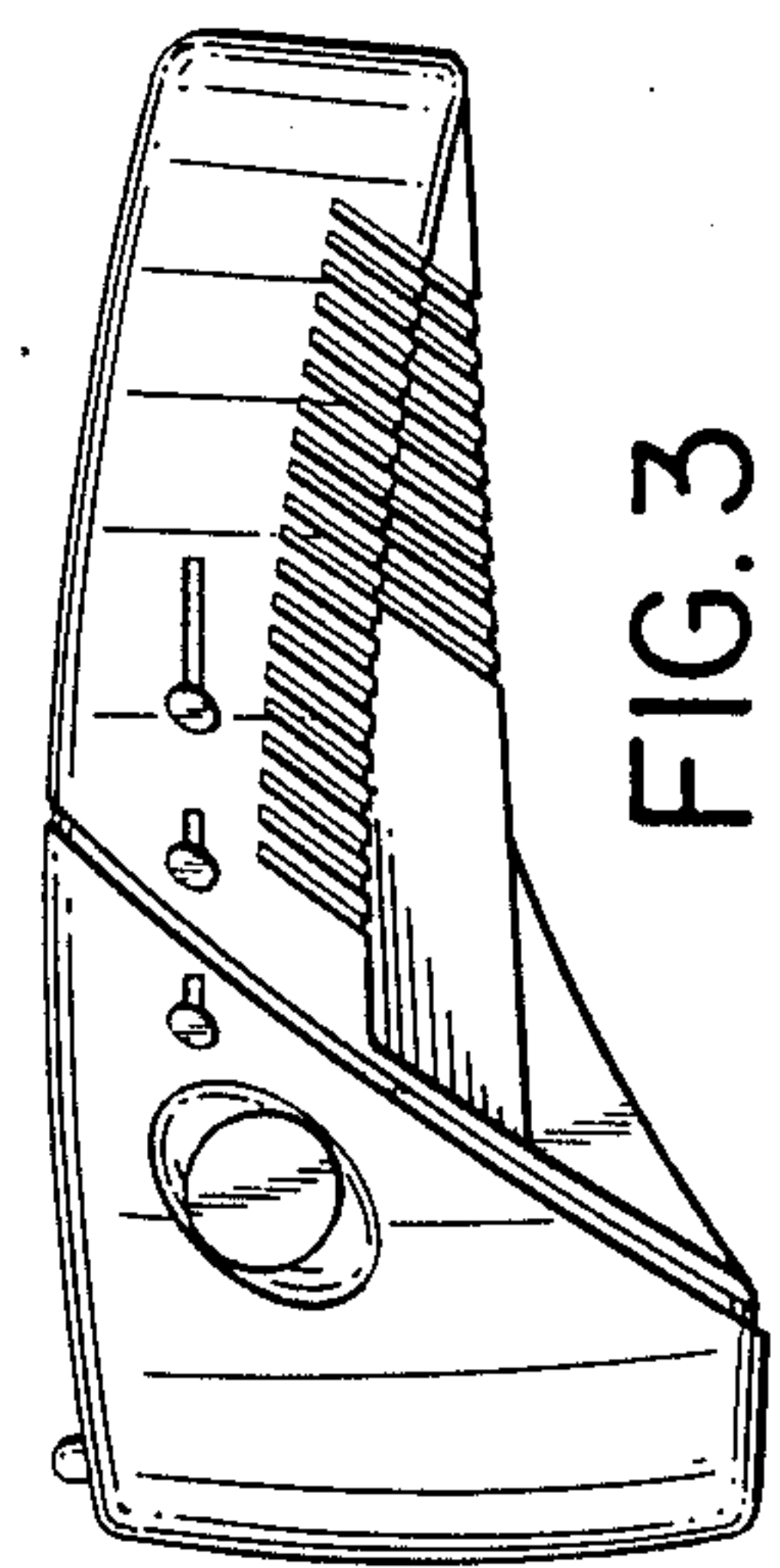

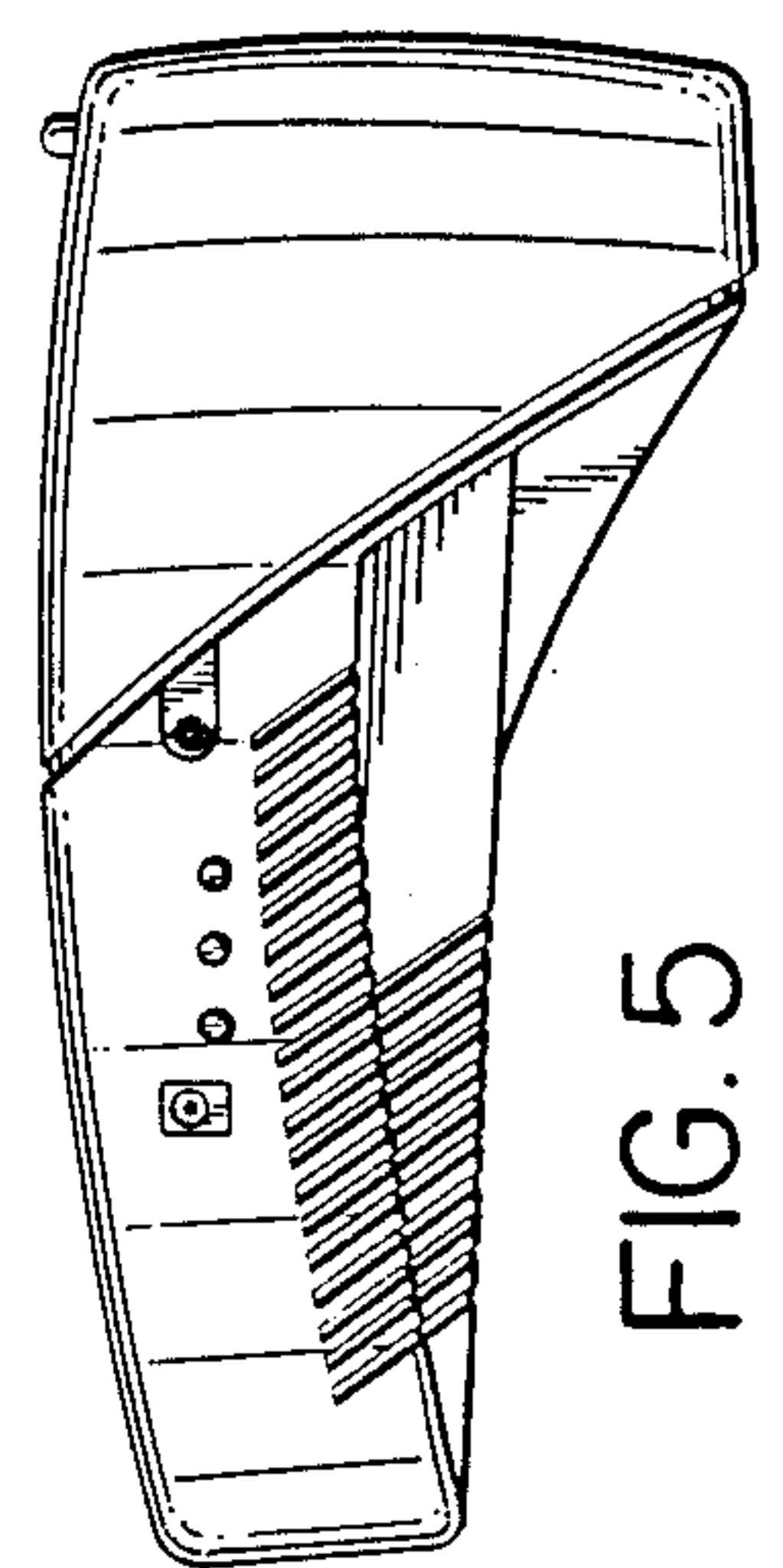
