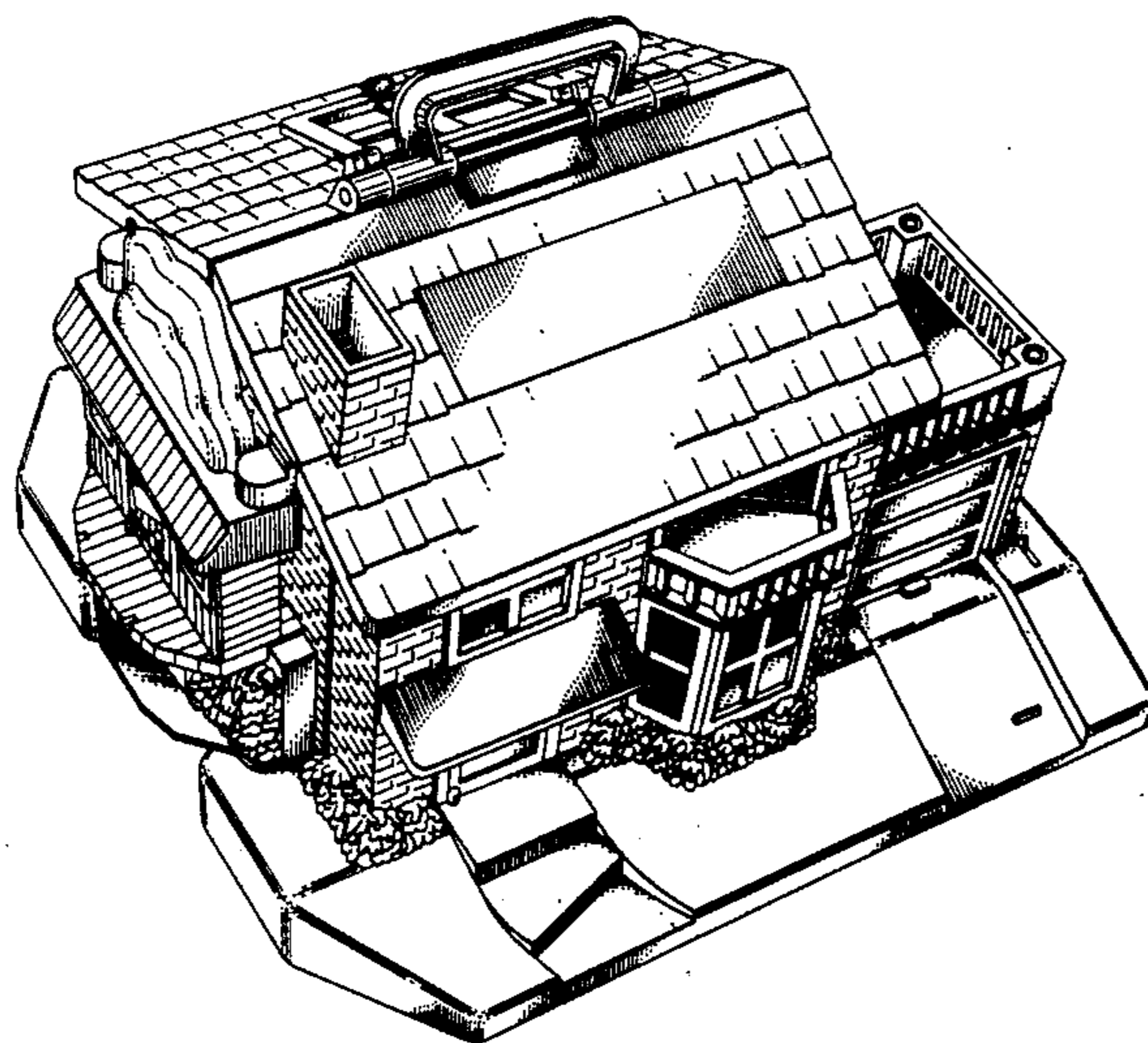

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined toy house and garage showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



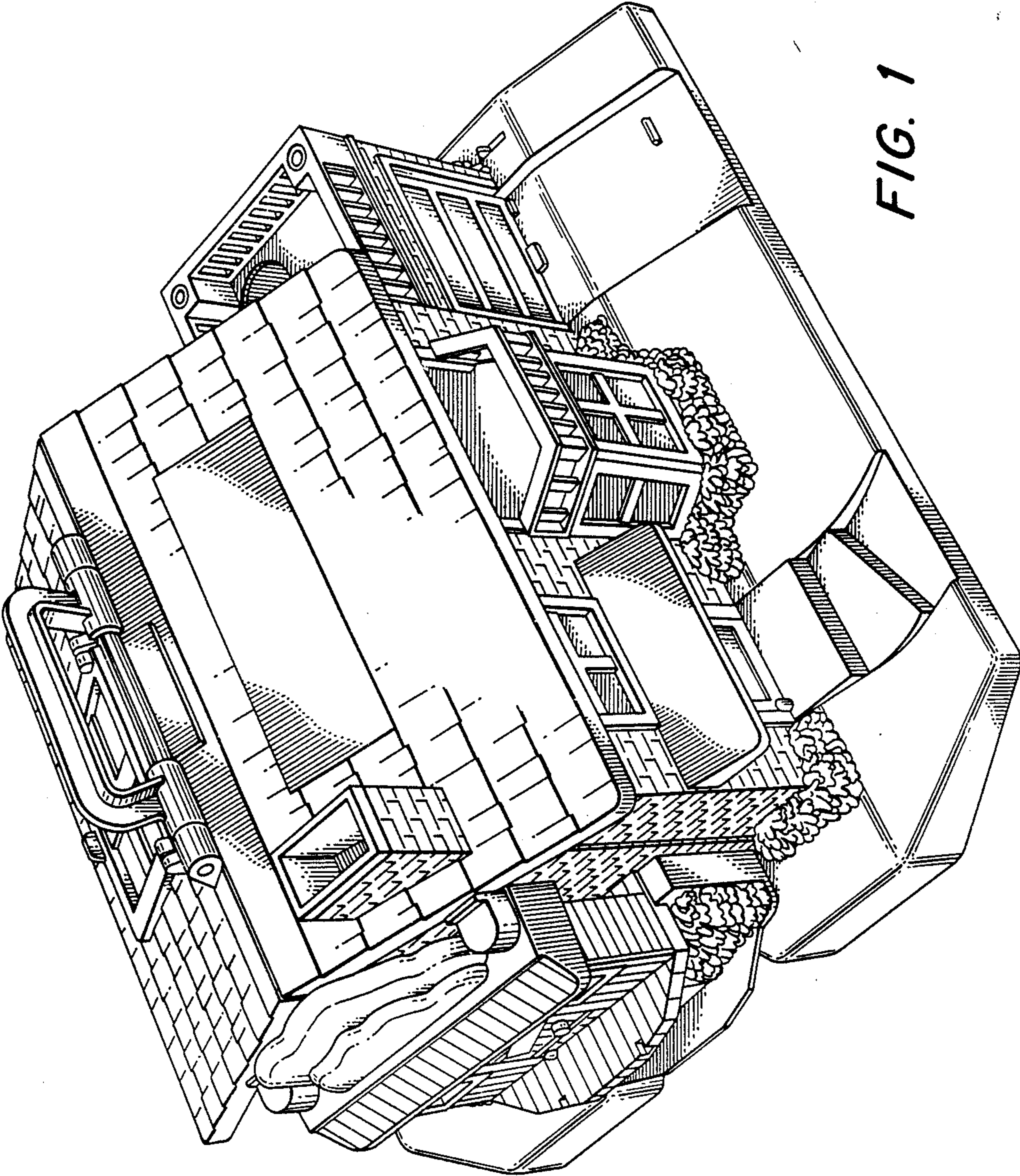

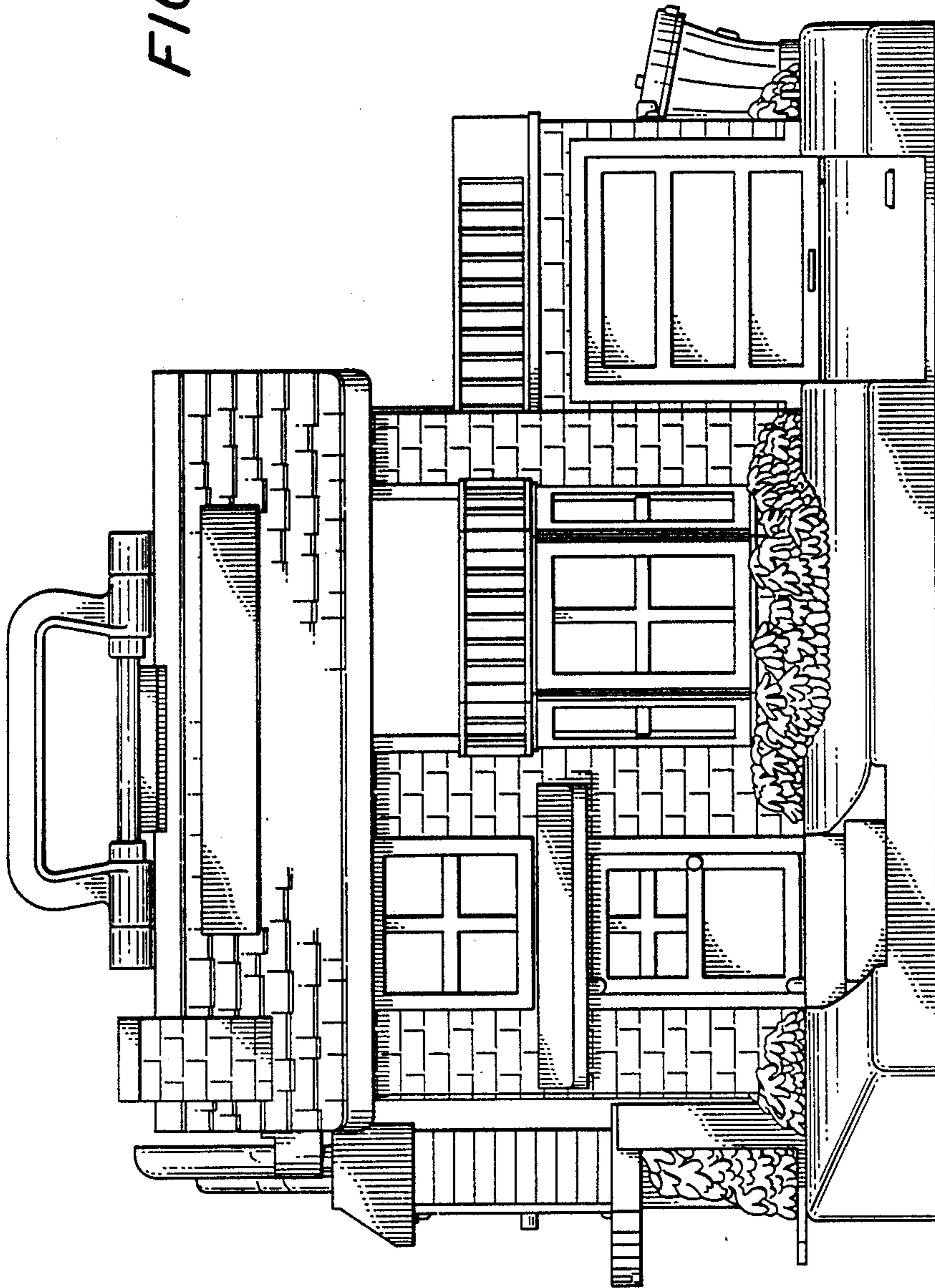
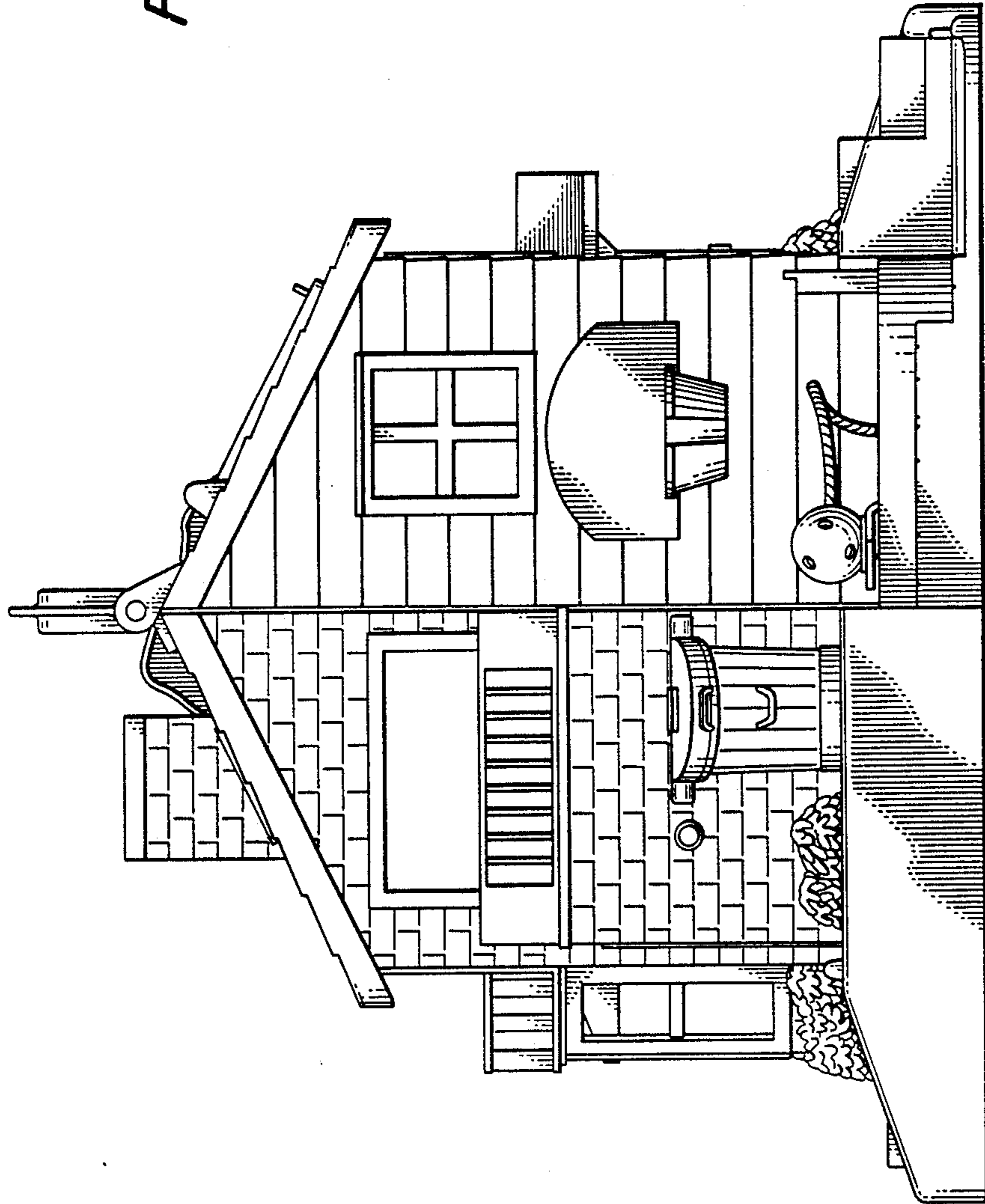

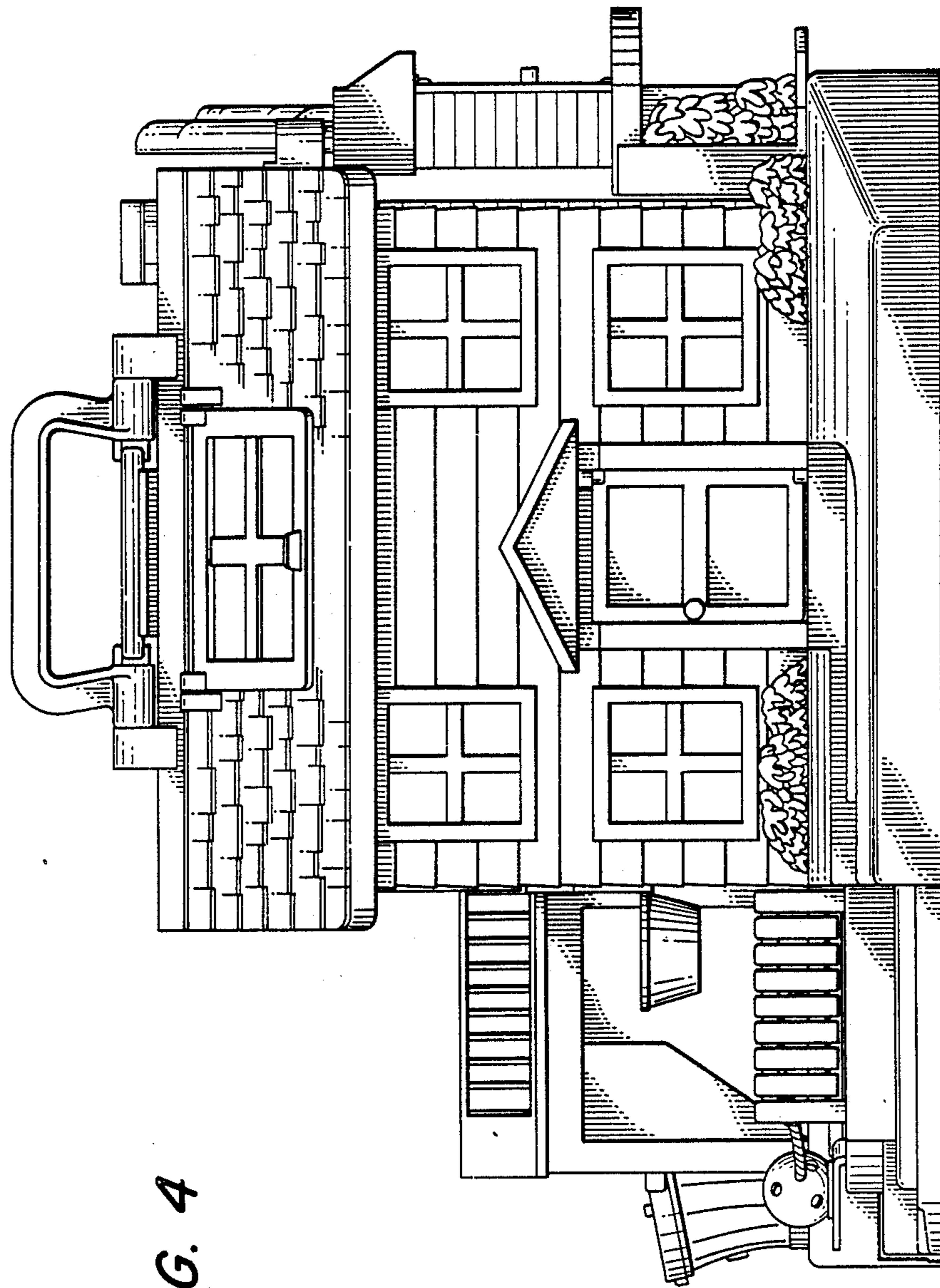

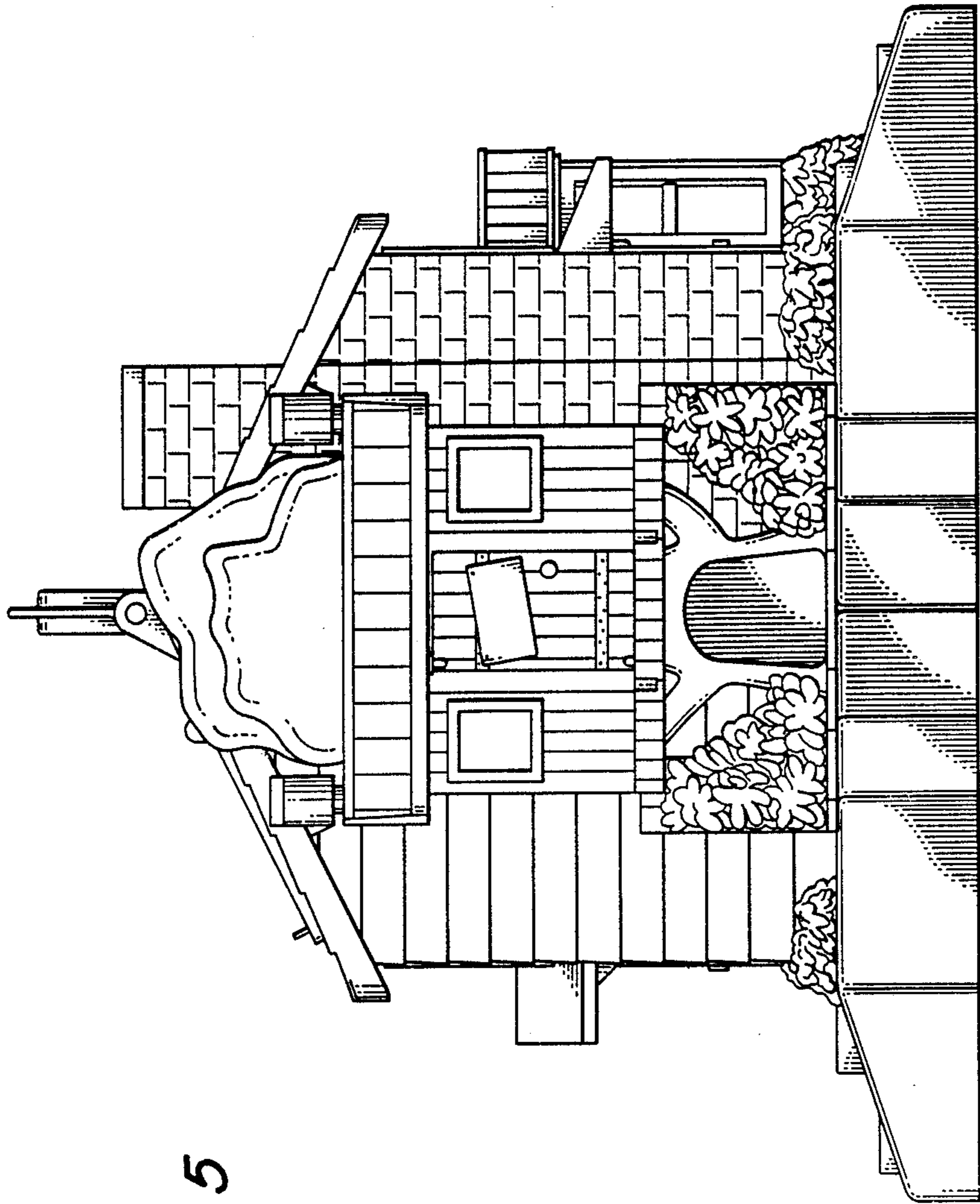

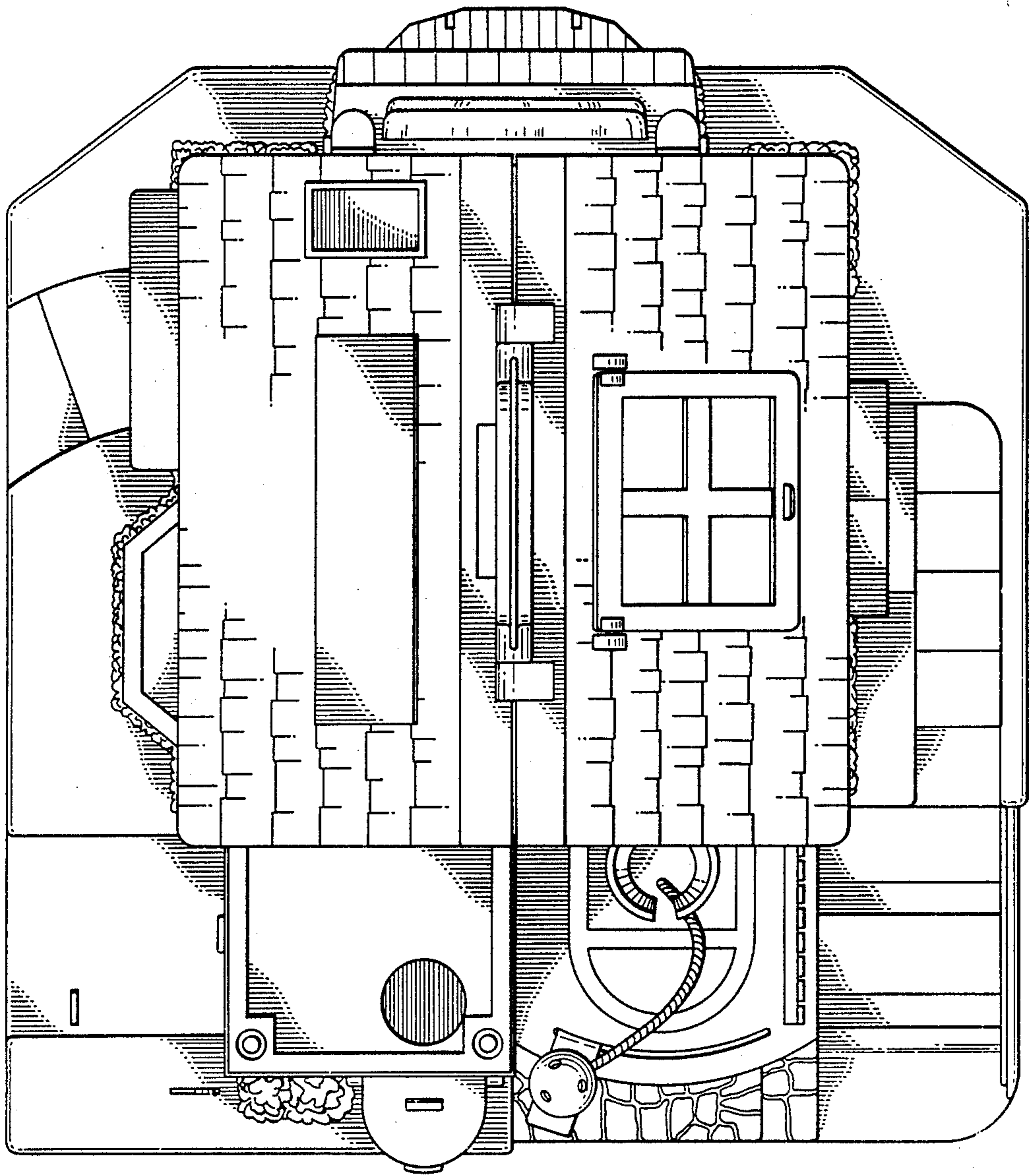

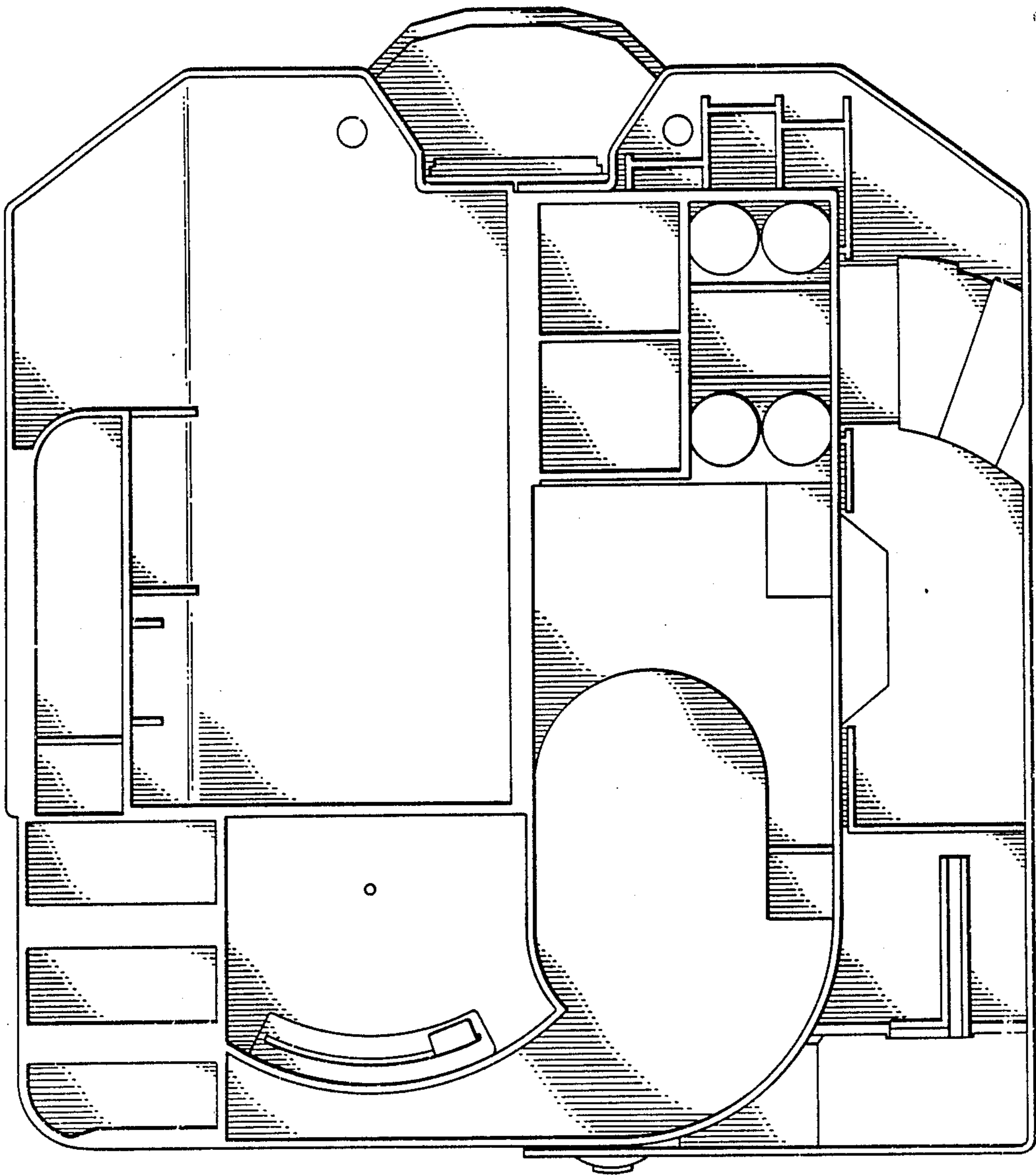
