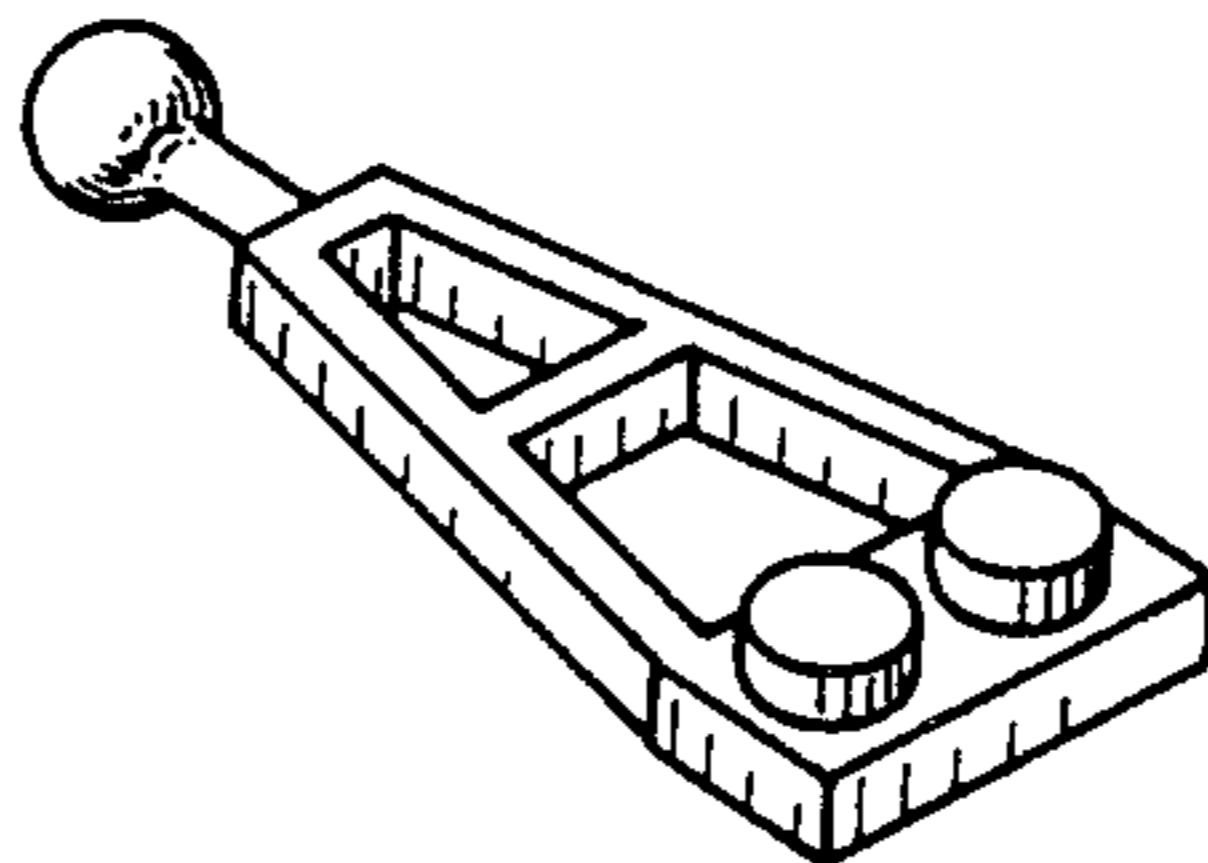
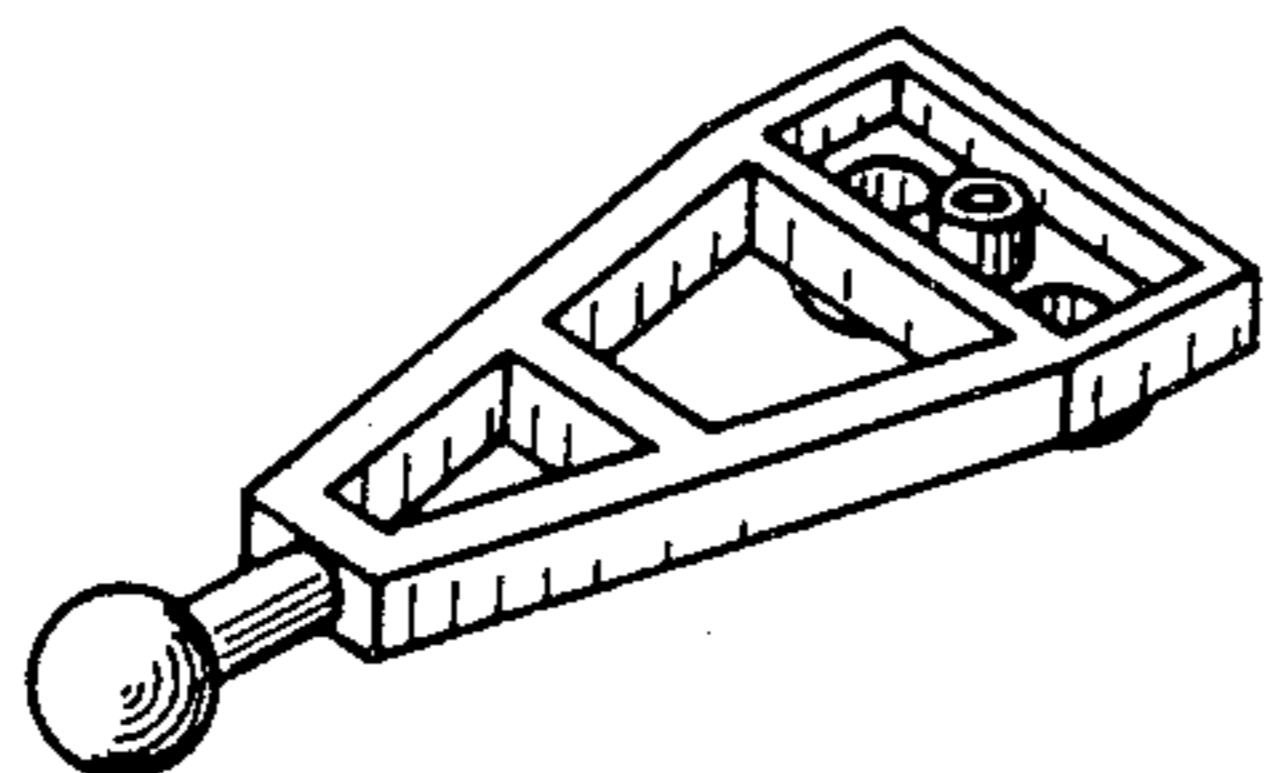

The ornamental design for a toy trailer hitch element, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy trailer hitch element showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.



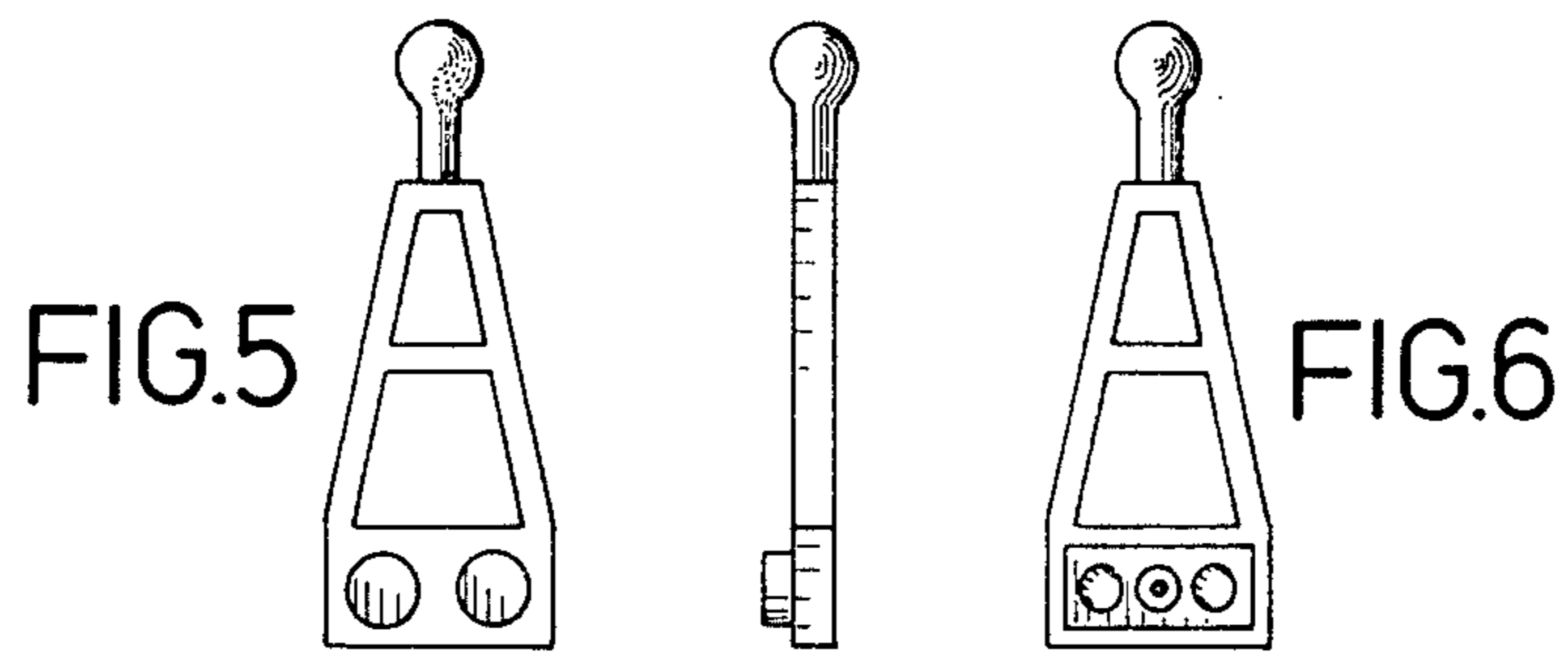

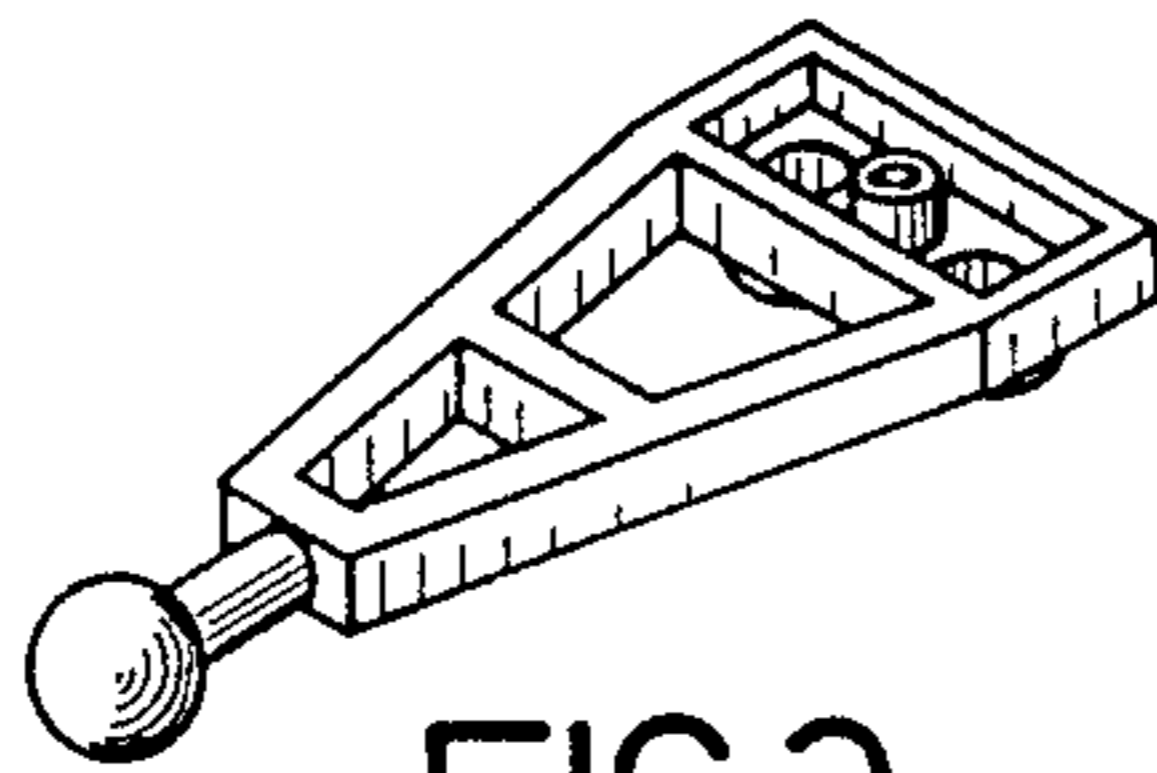

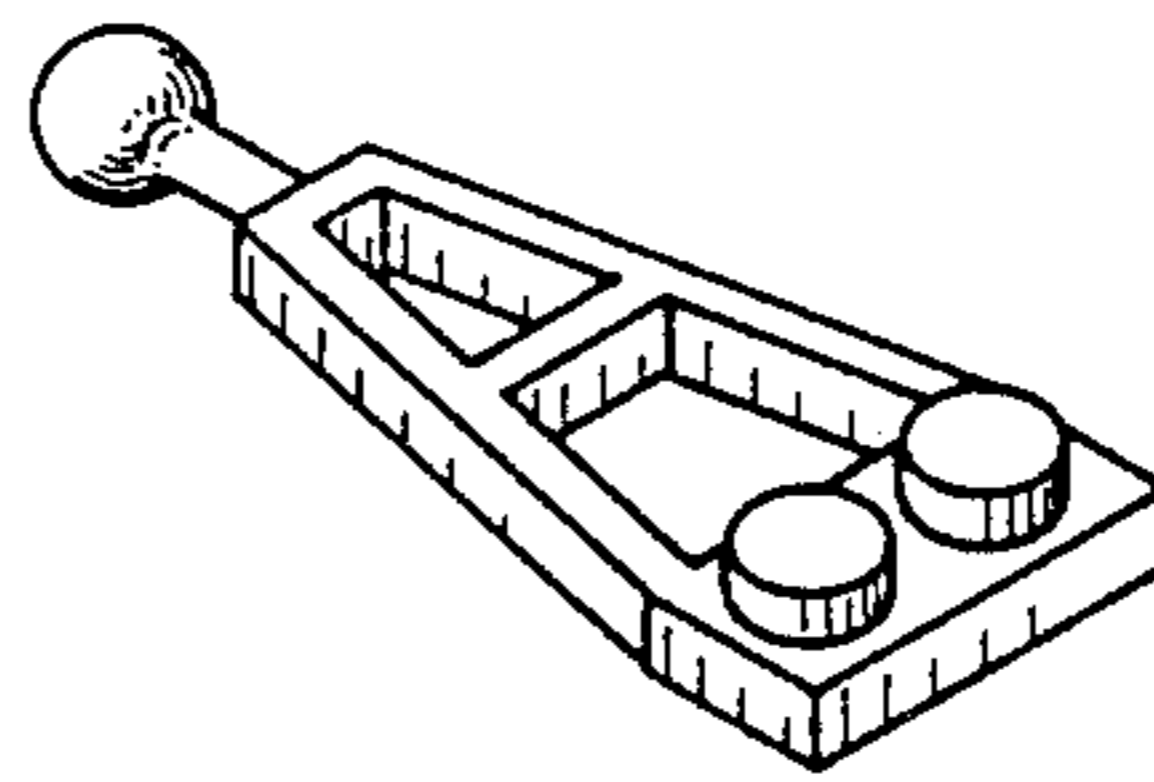
