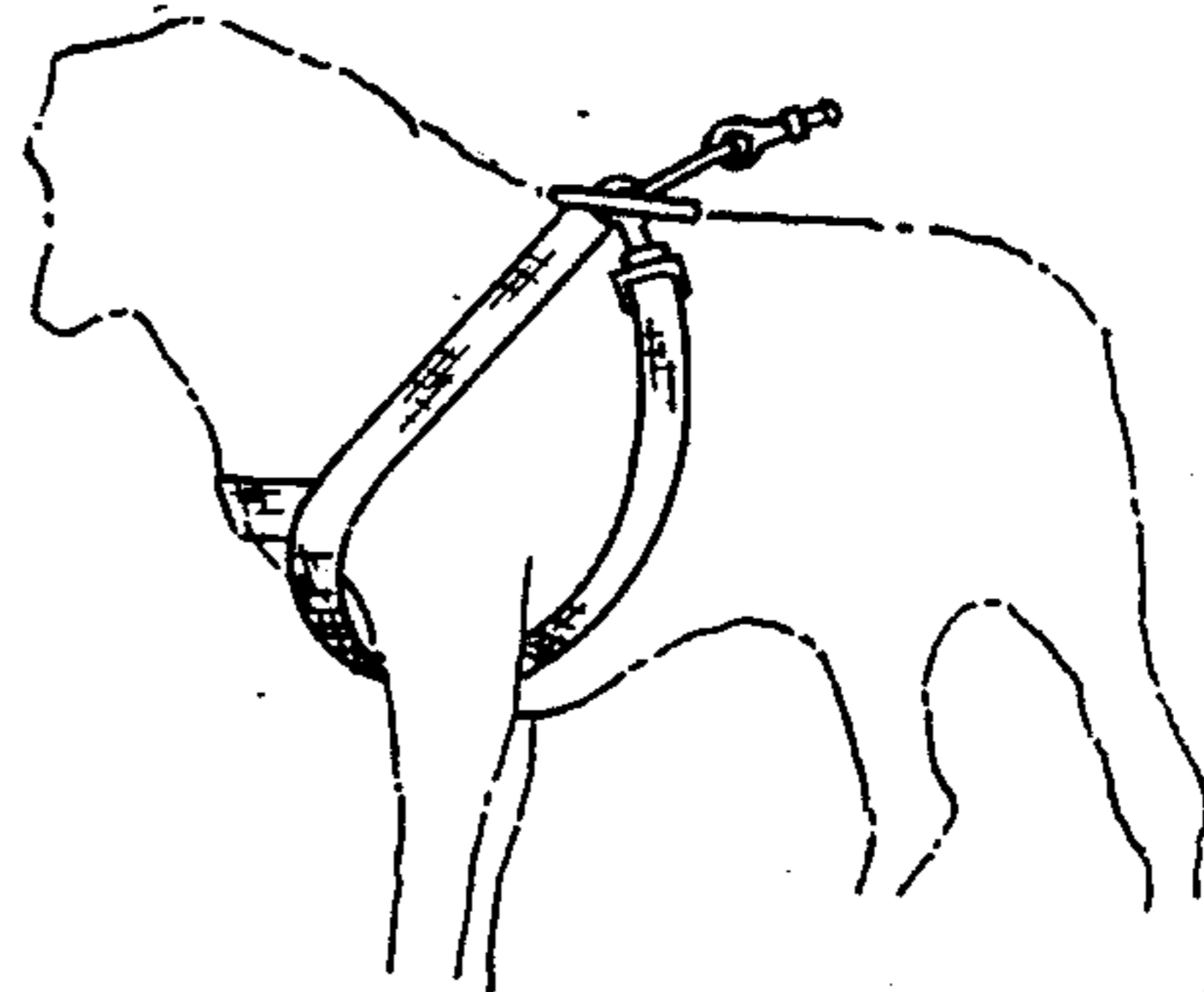
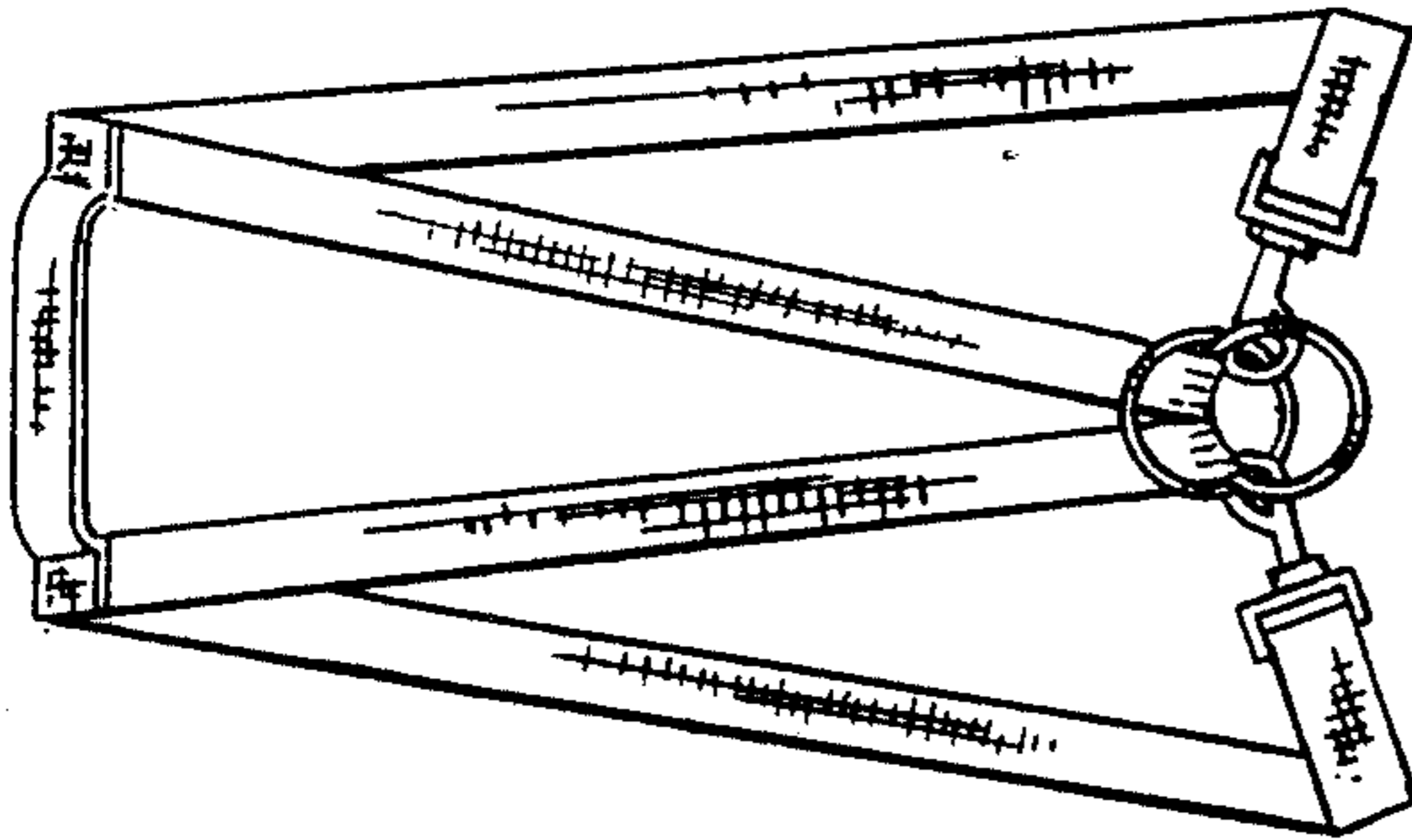

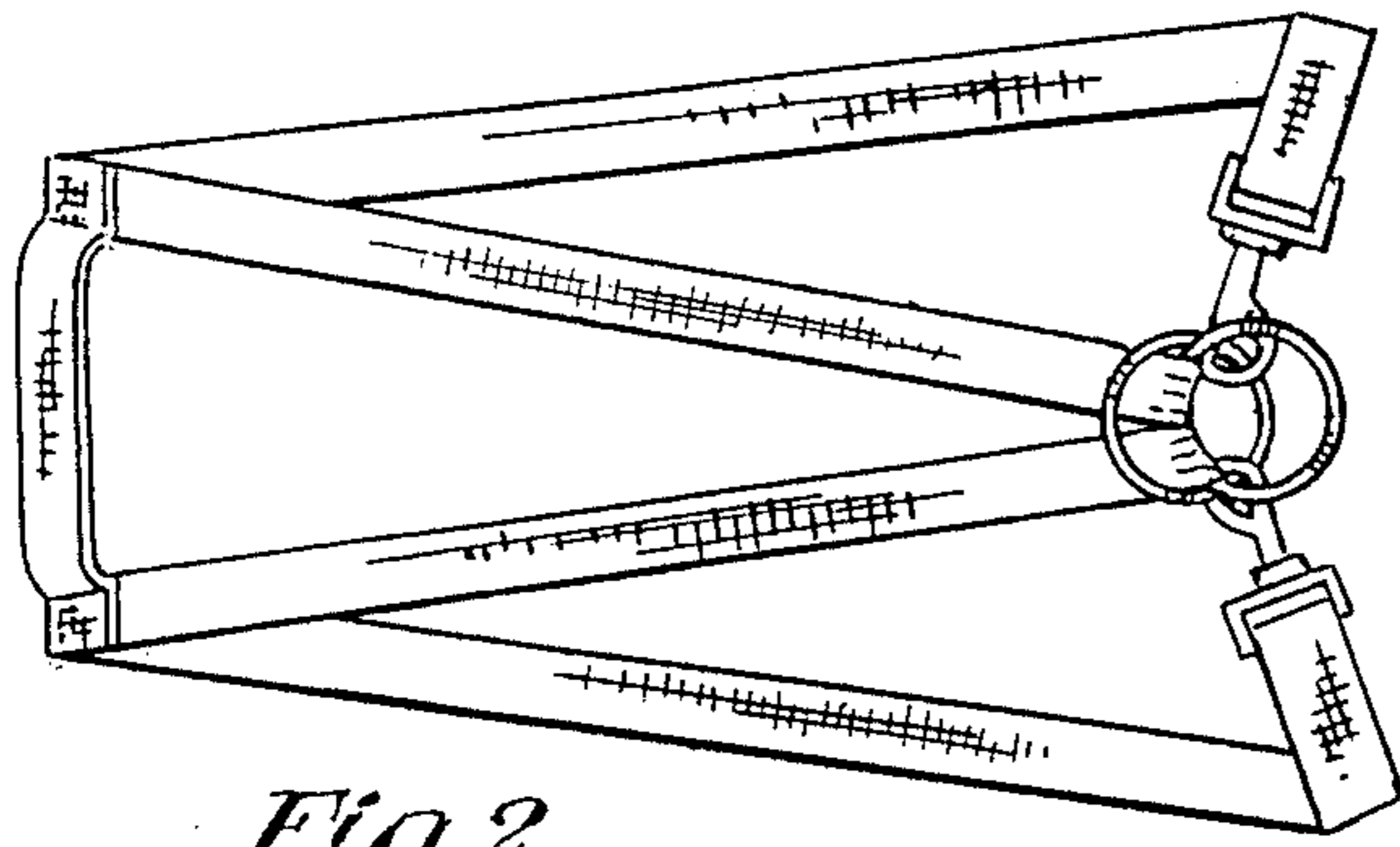
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dog handler, as shown and described.

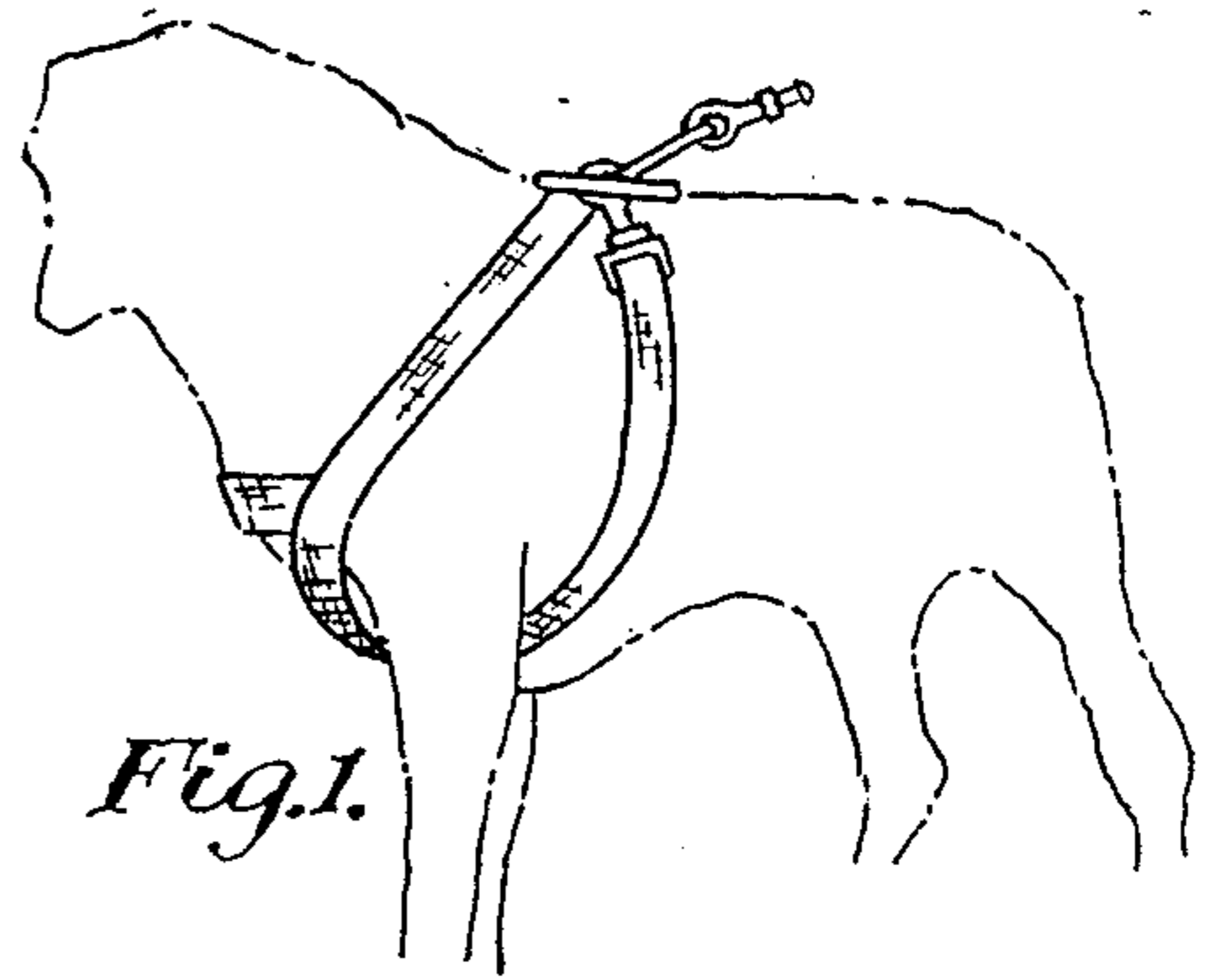
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

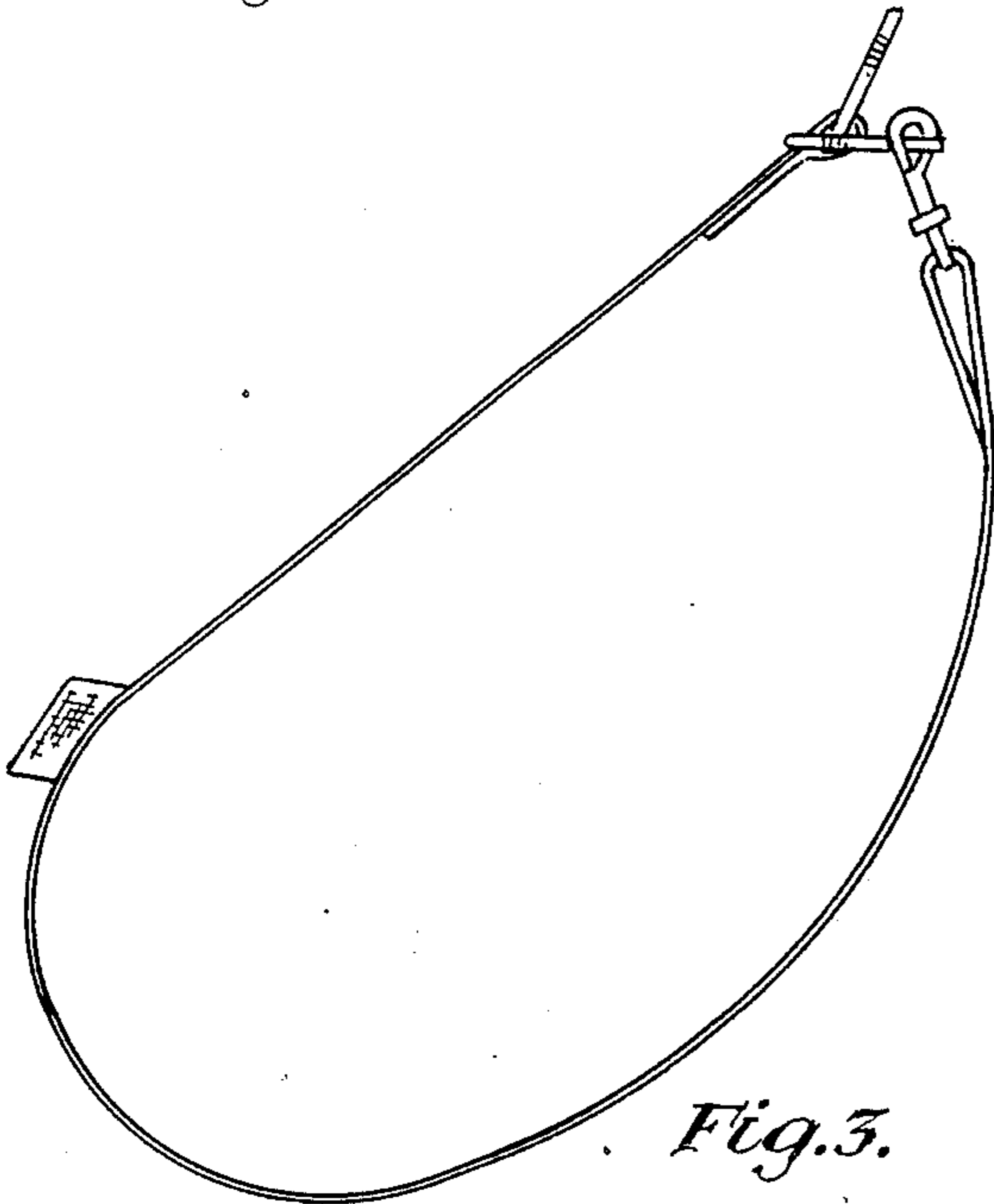




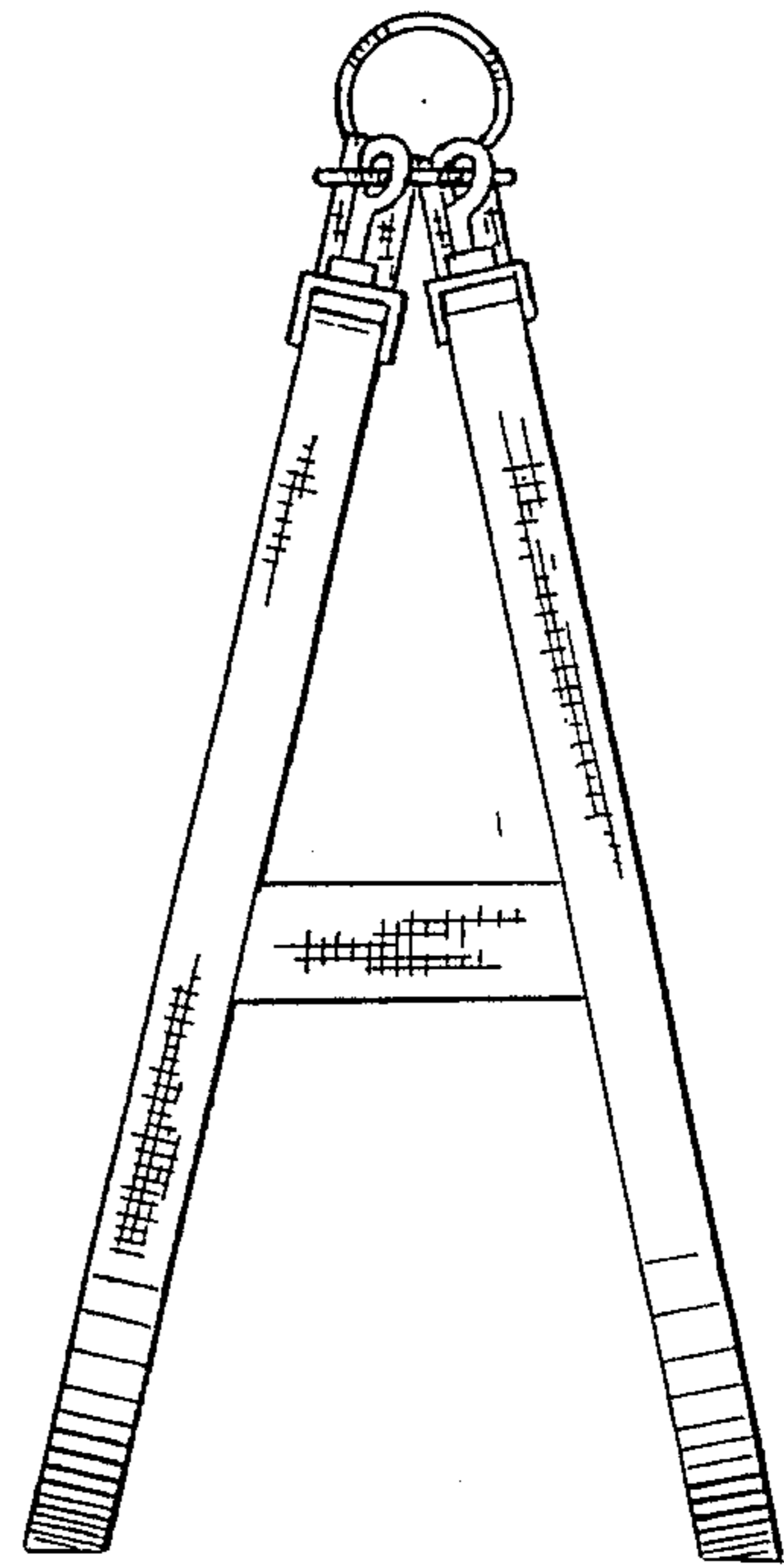

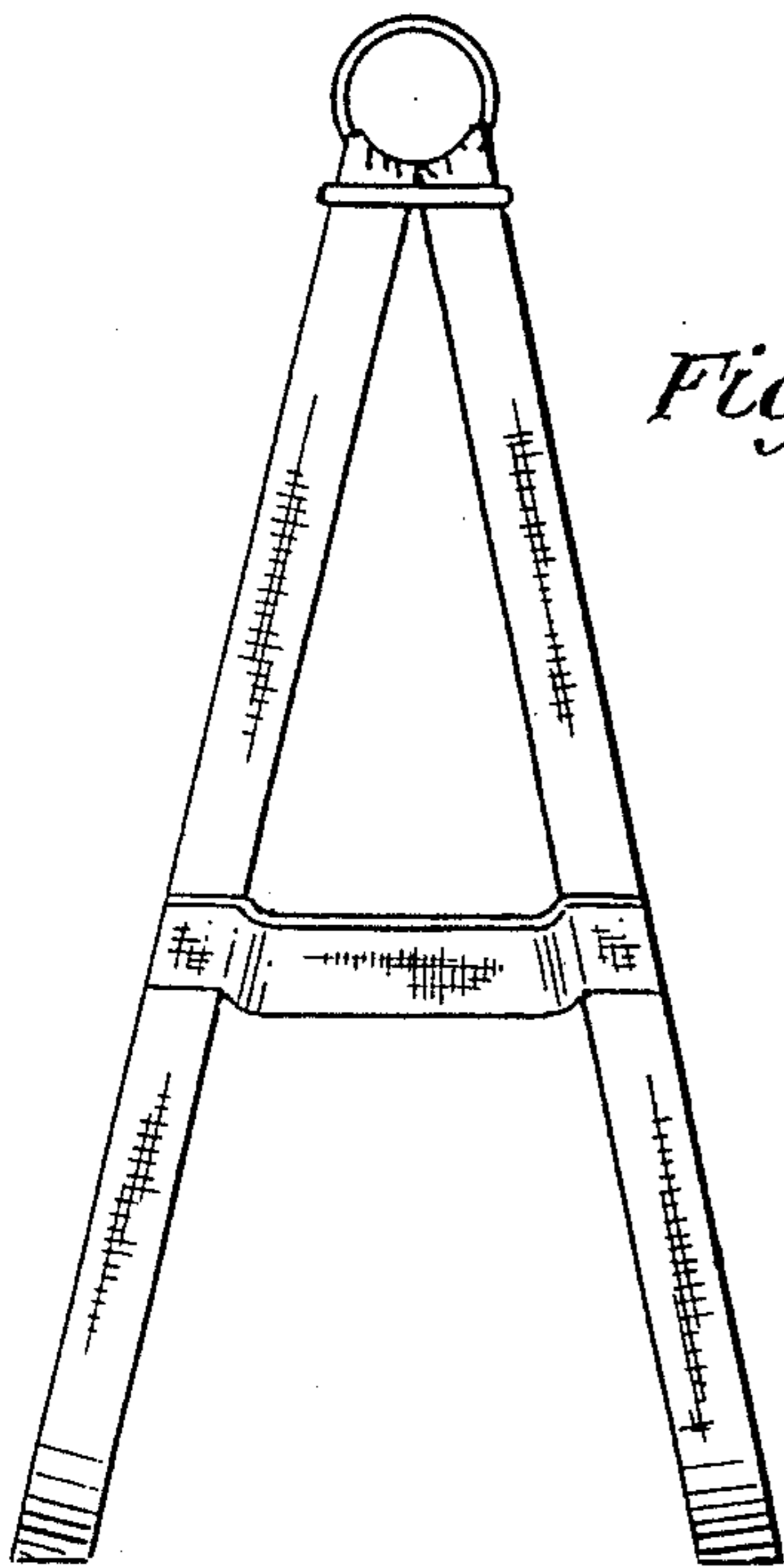

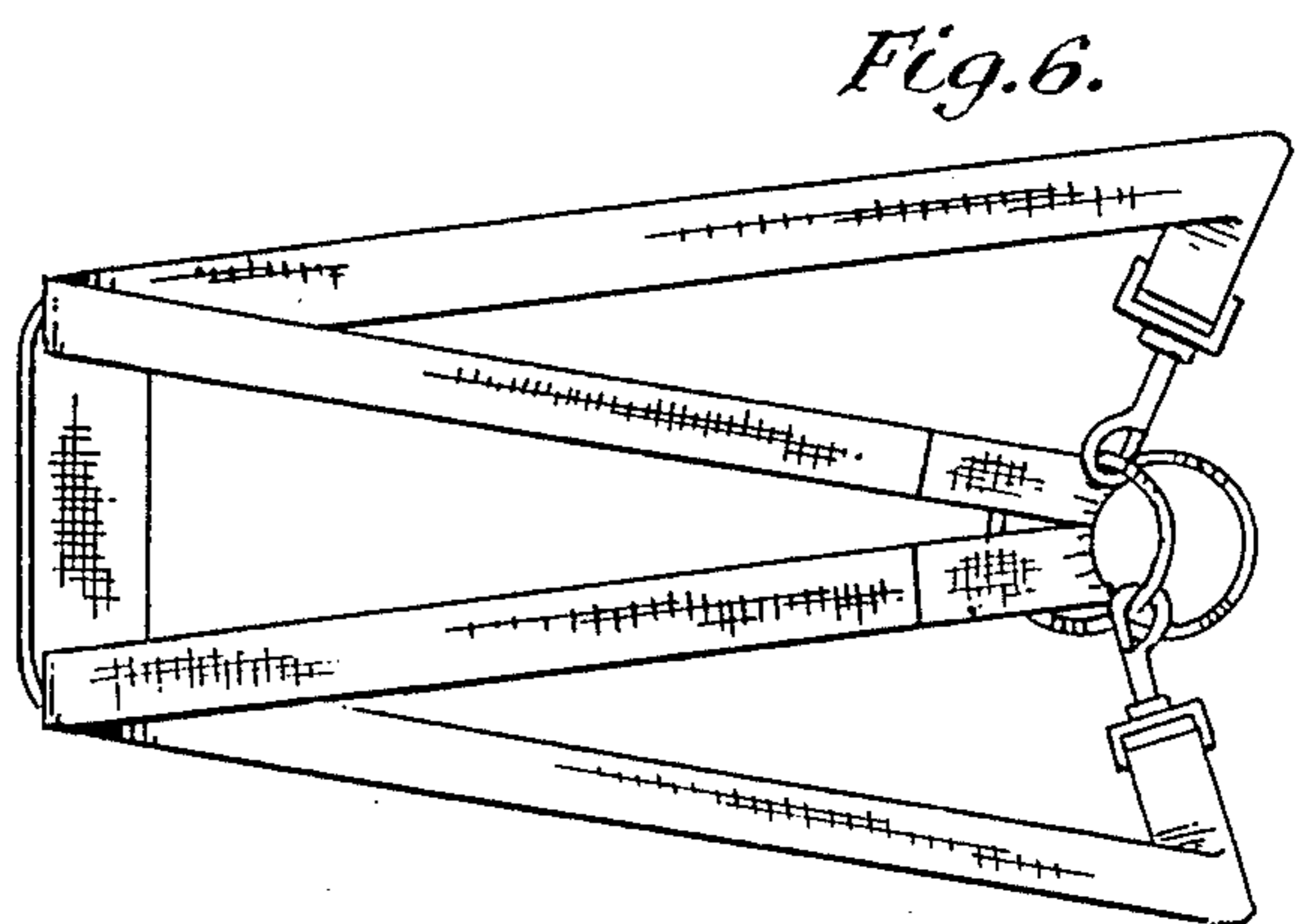
