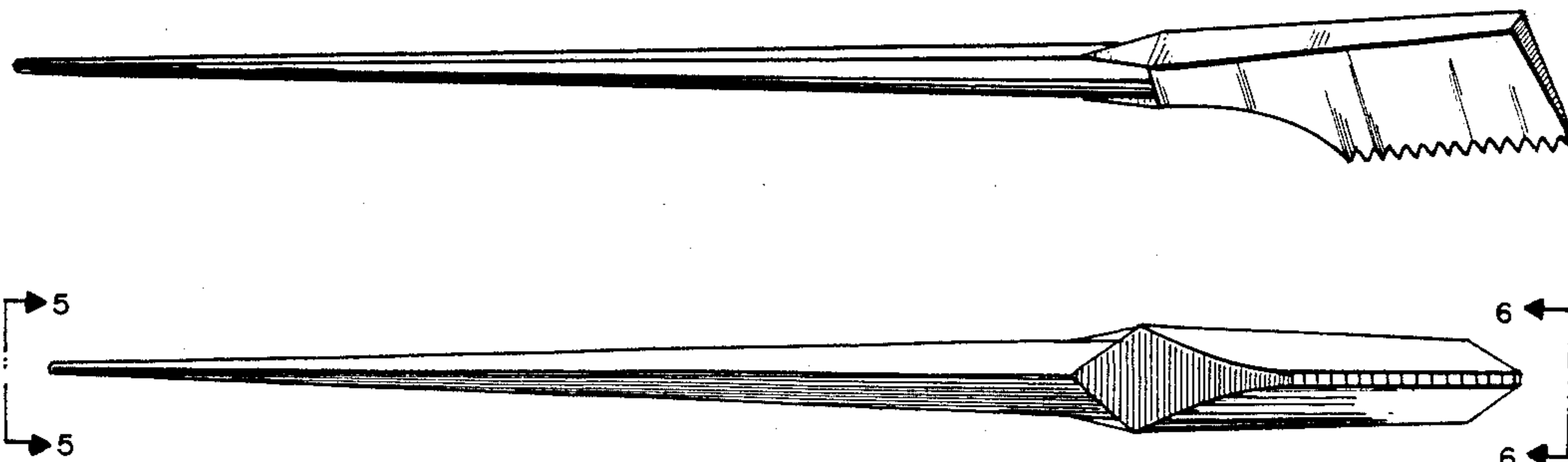

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a chop stick knife showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is a top perspective view;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 4; and
 FIG. 6 is an end elevational view taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 4.



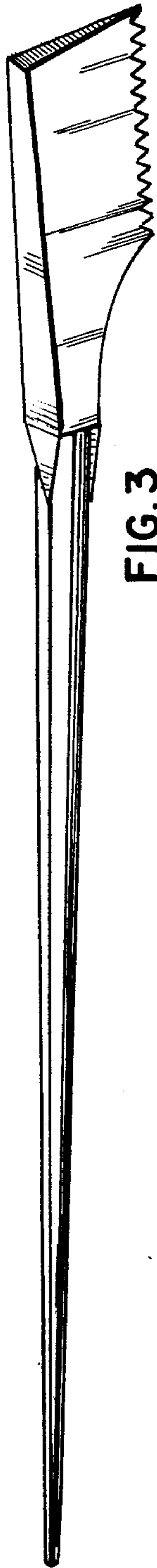

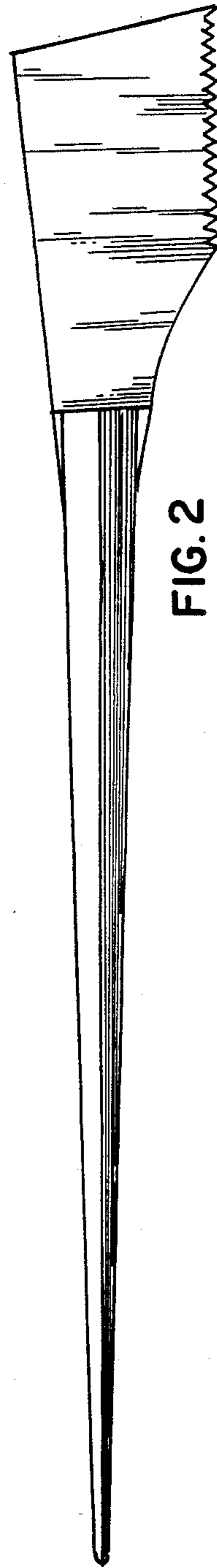

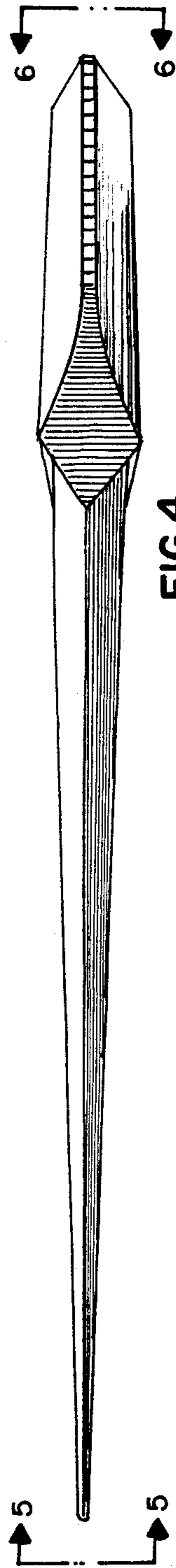

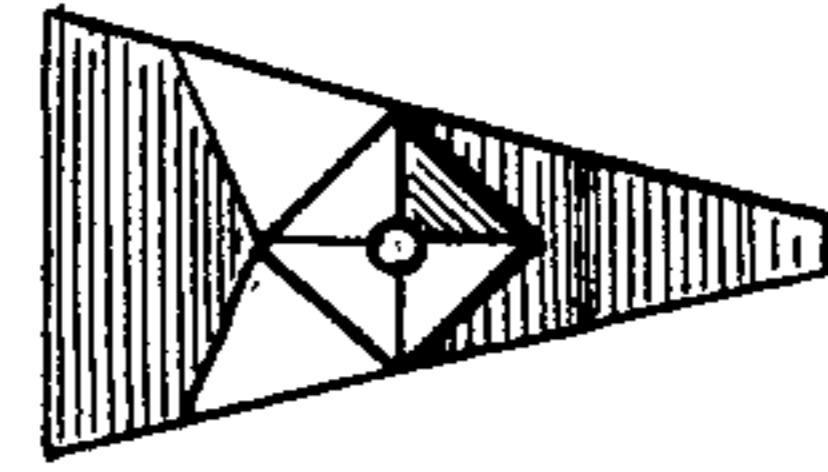

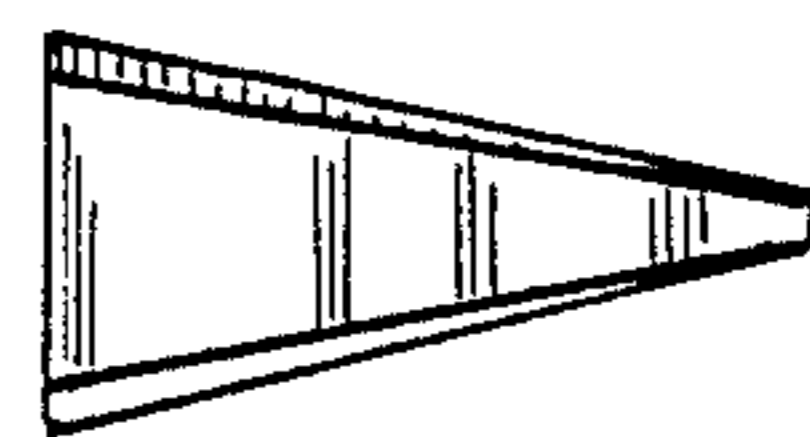
