[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a boat hatch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a boat hatch showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged perspective view thereof, showing the hatch in open condition;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged perspective view of a second embodiment of the hatch, shown in an open condition, the sole difference from the first embodiment residing in the absence of shock absorbing hinges;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged perspective view of a third embodiment of the hatch, shown in an open condition, the sole difference from the first embodiment residing in the absence of hatch "dogs".

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1 thru 9 of the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
