The ornamental design for combined tape player and tuner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a combined tape player and tuner showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof, shown with the tape compartment in an open position. The broken line showing of the tape cassette is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

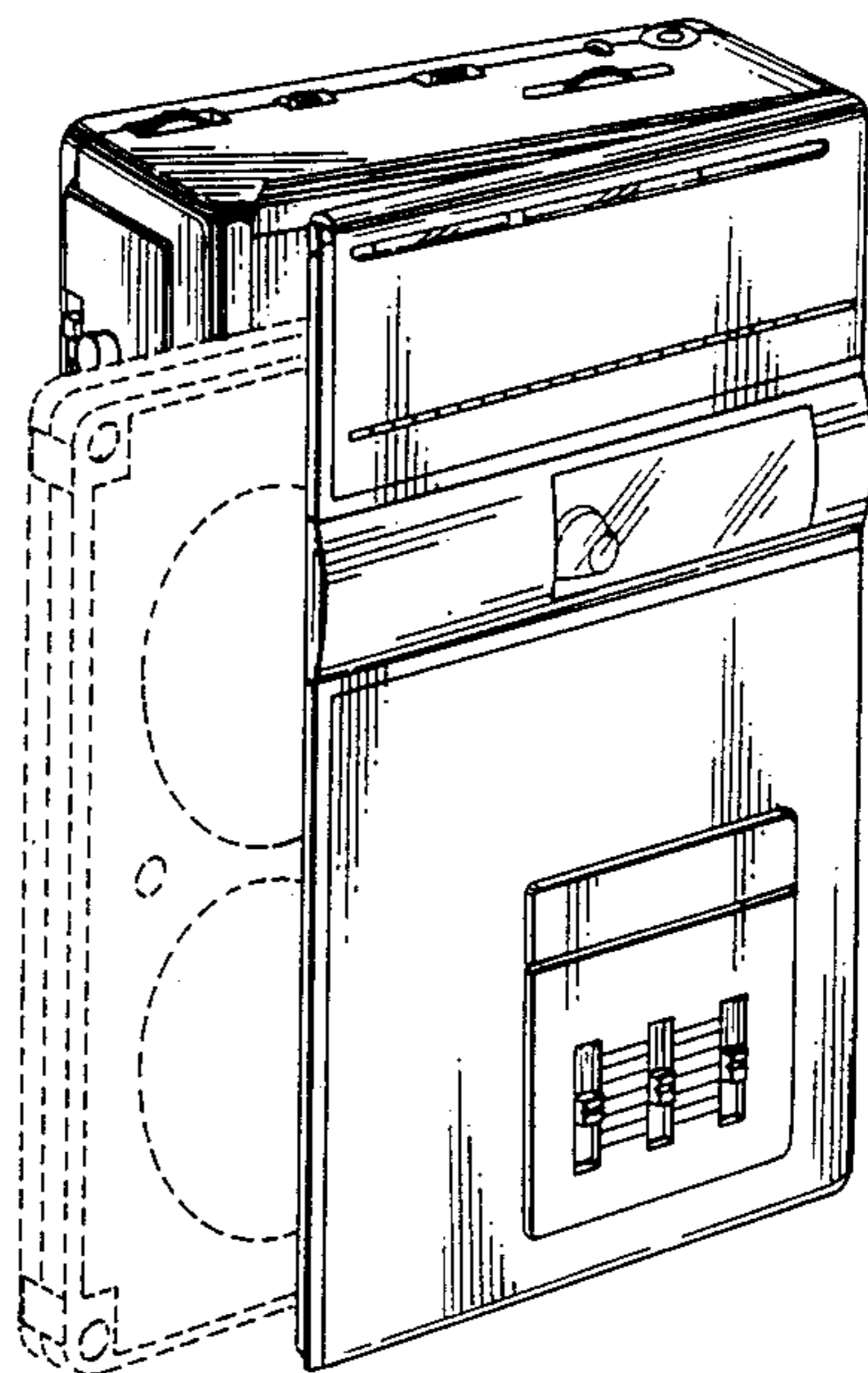
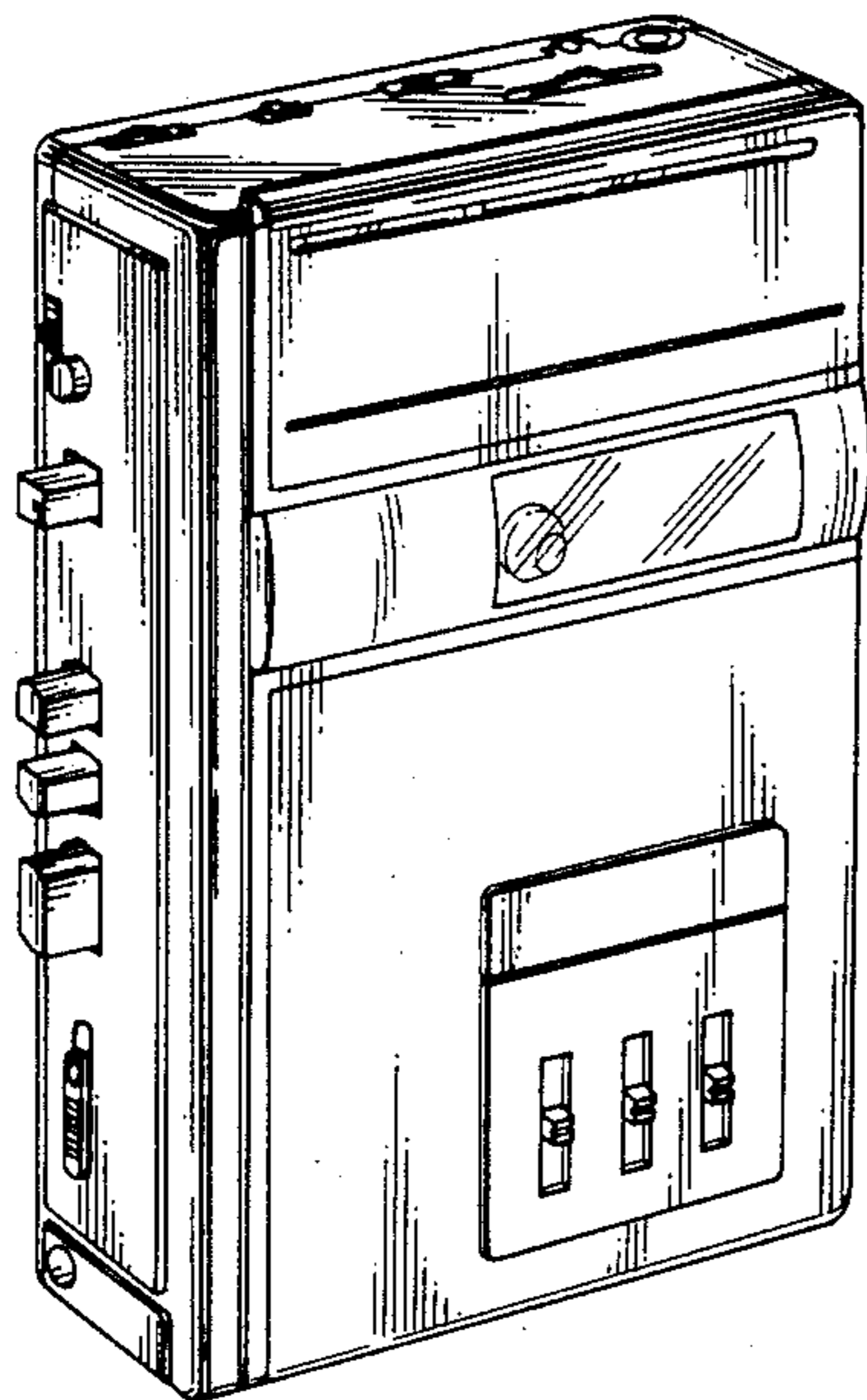

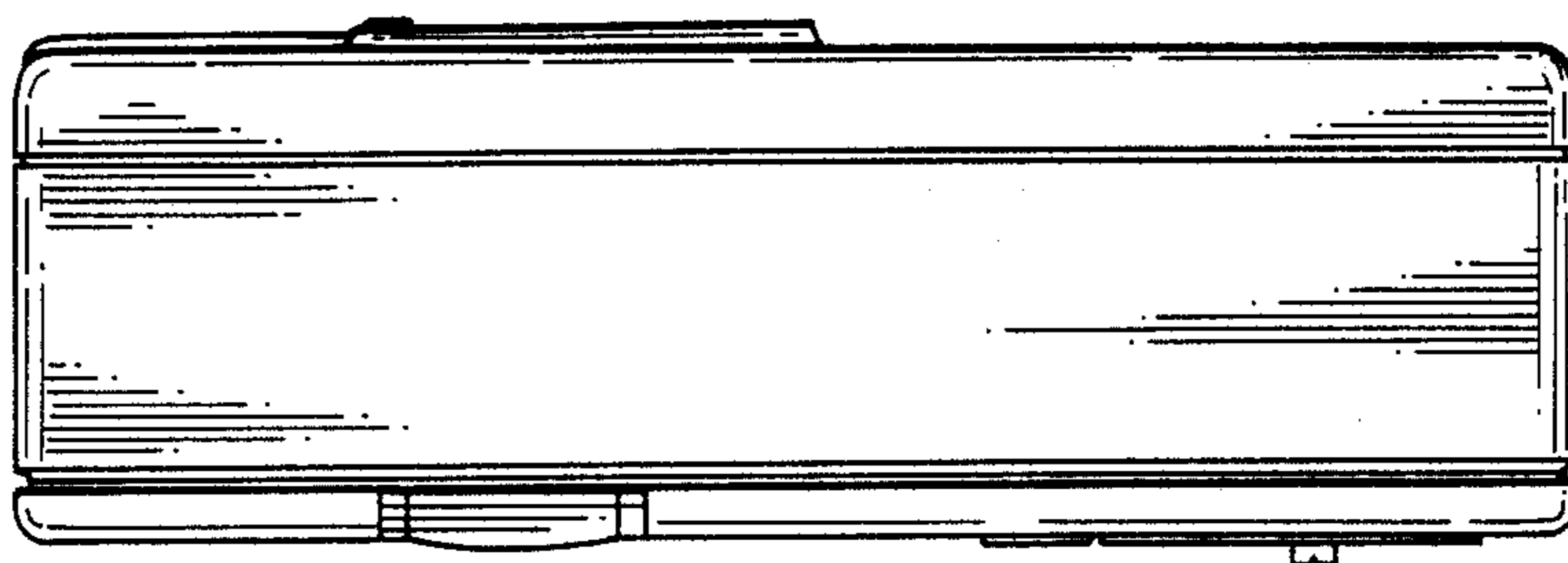

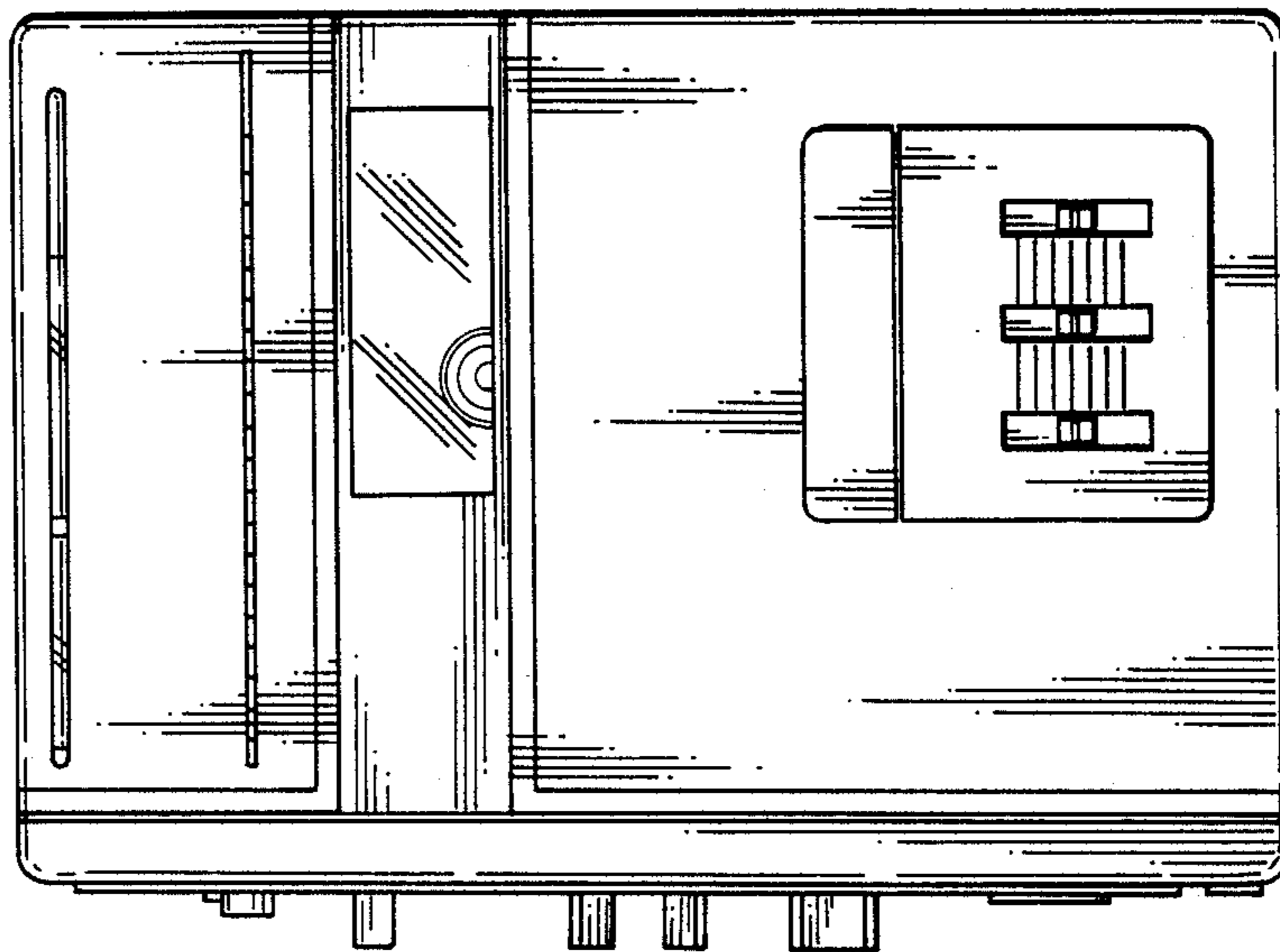

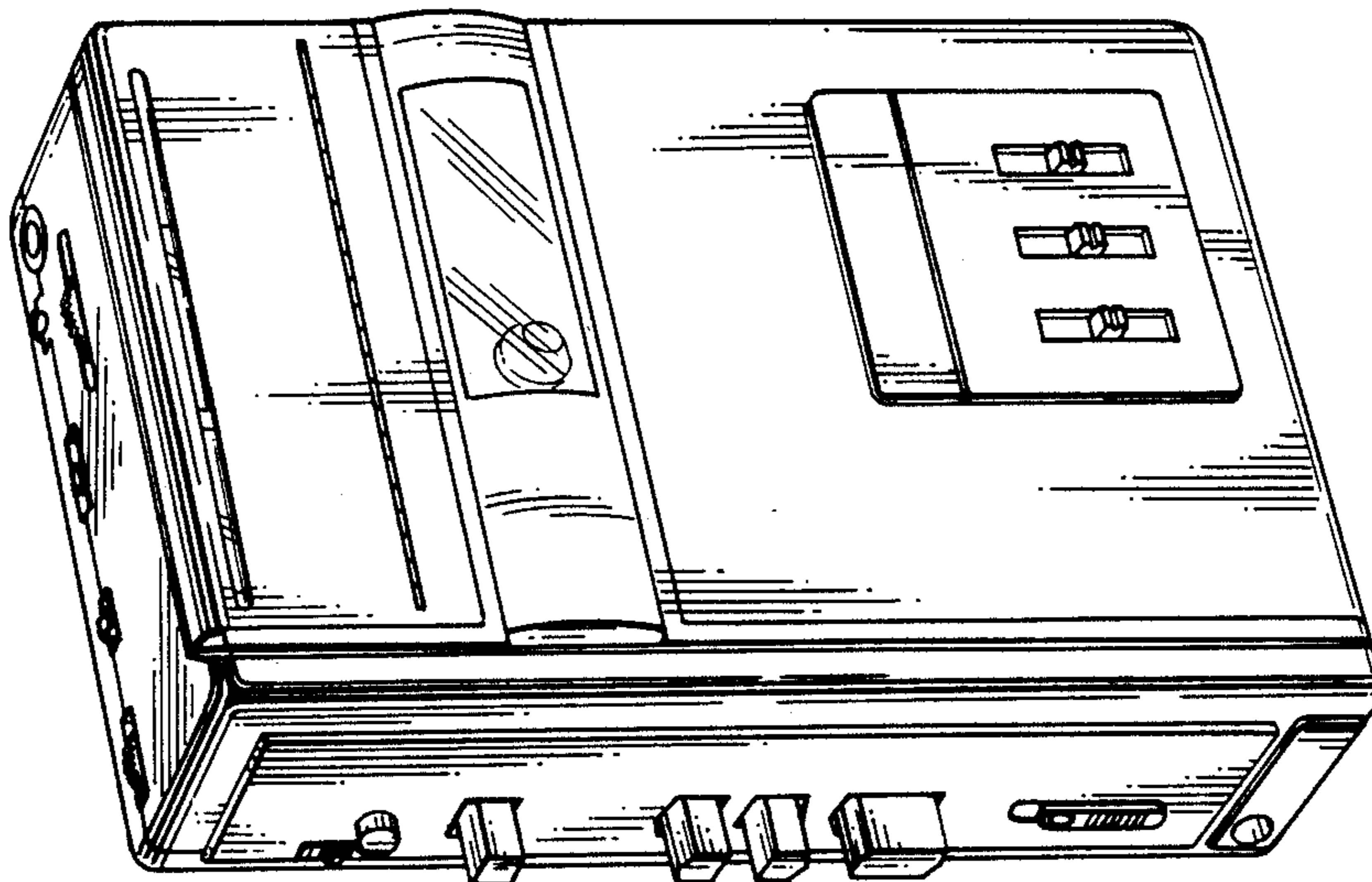

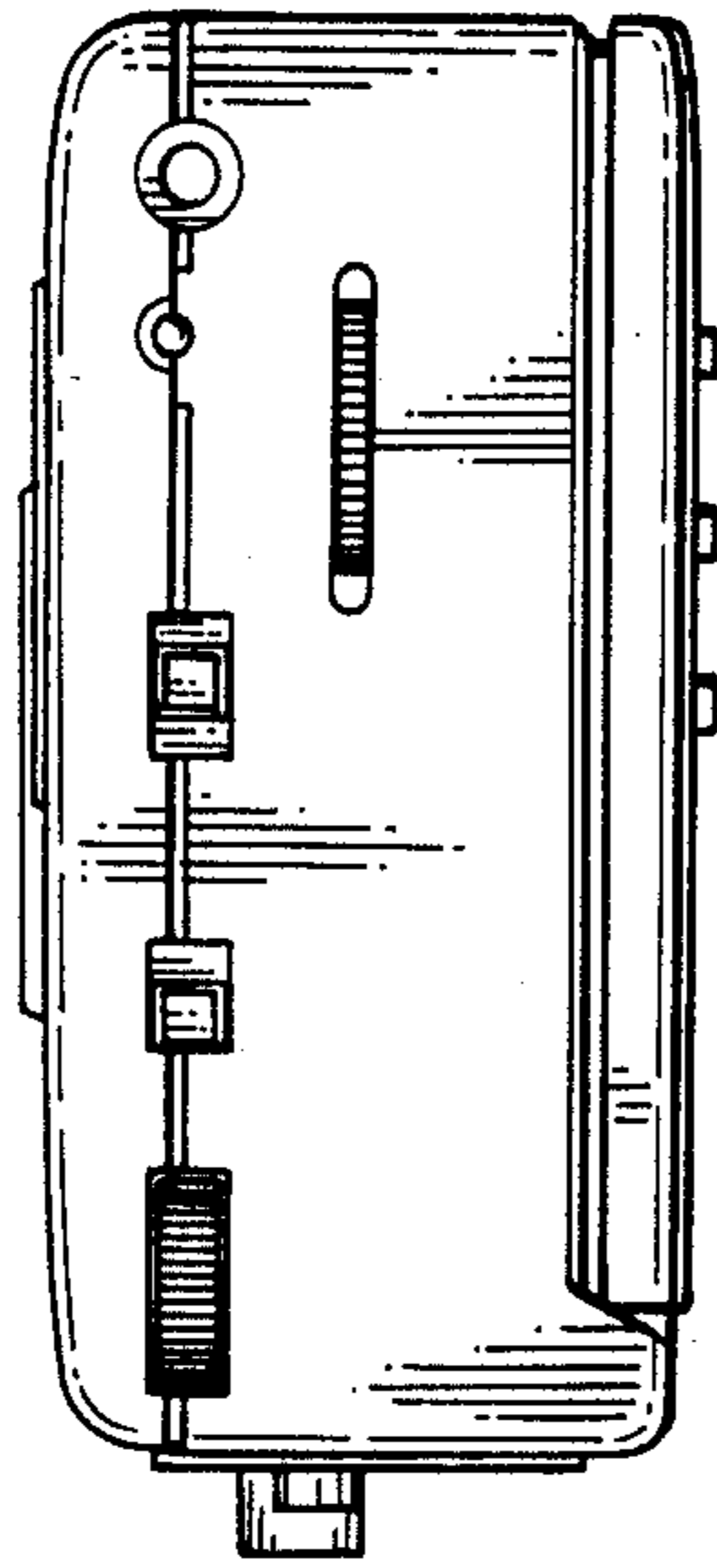

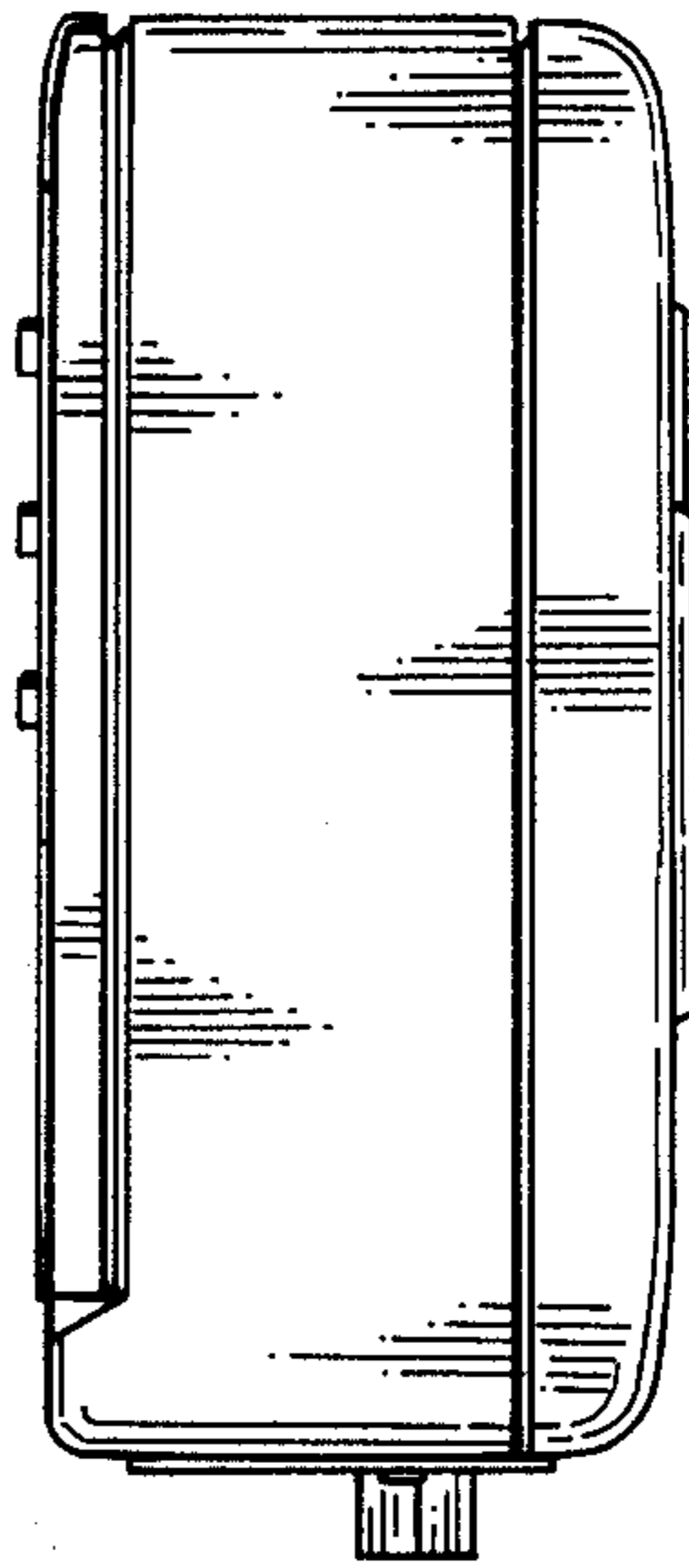

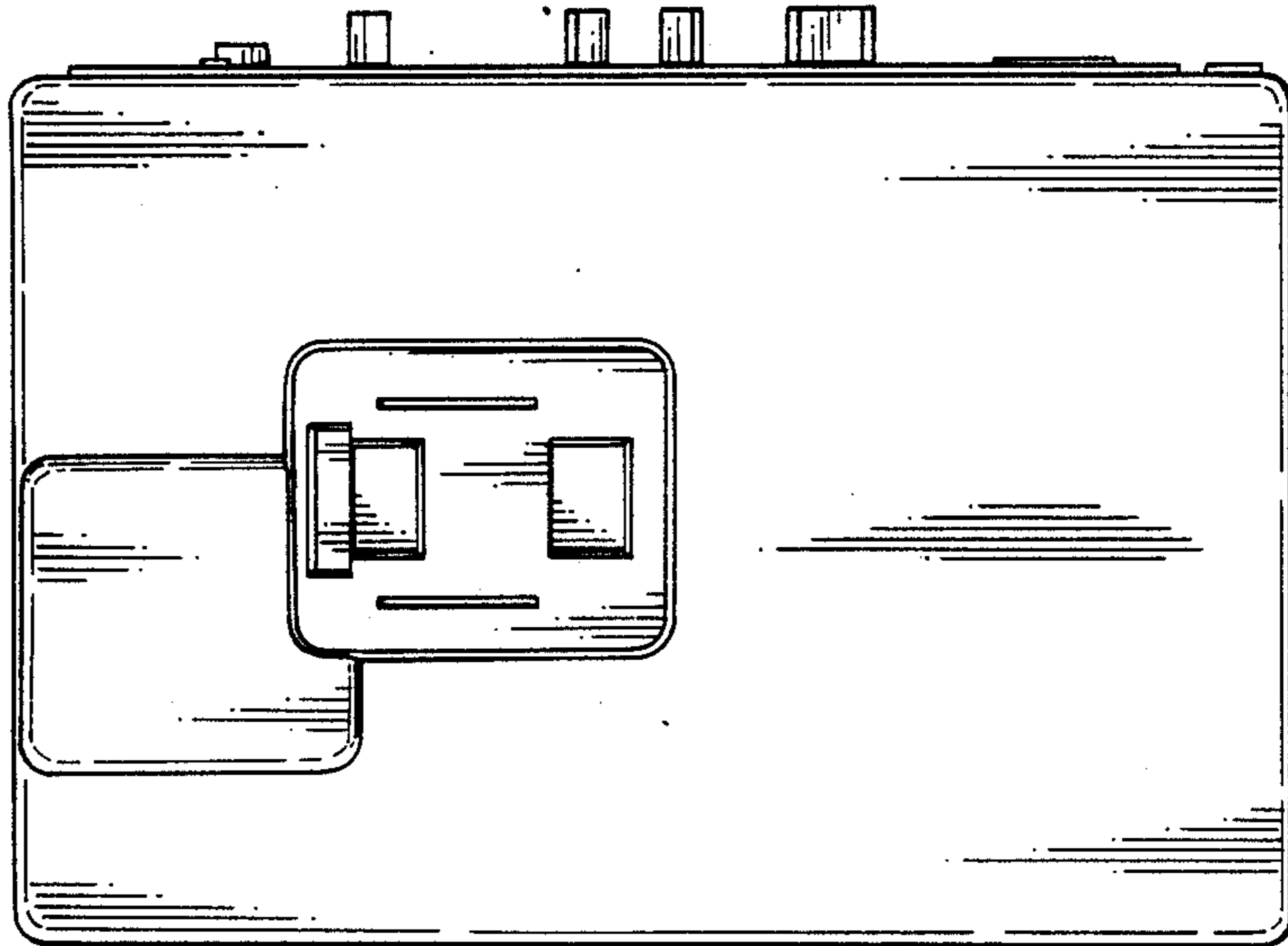

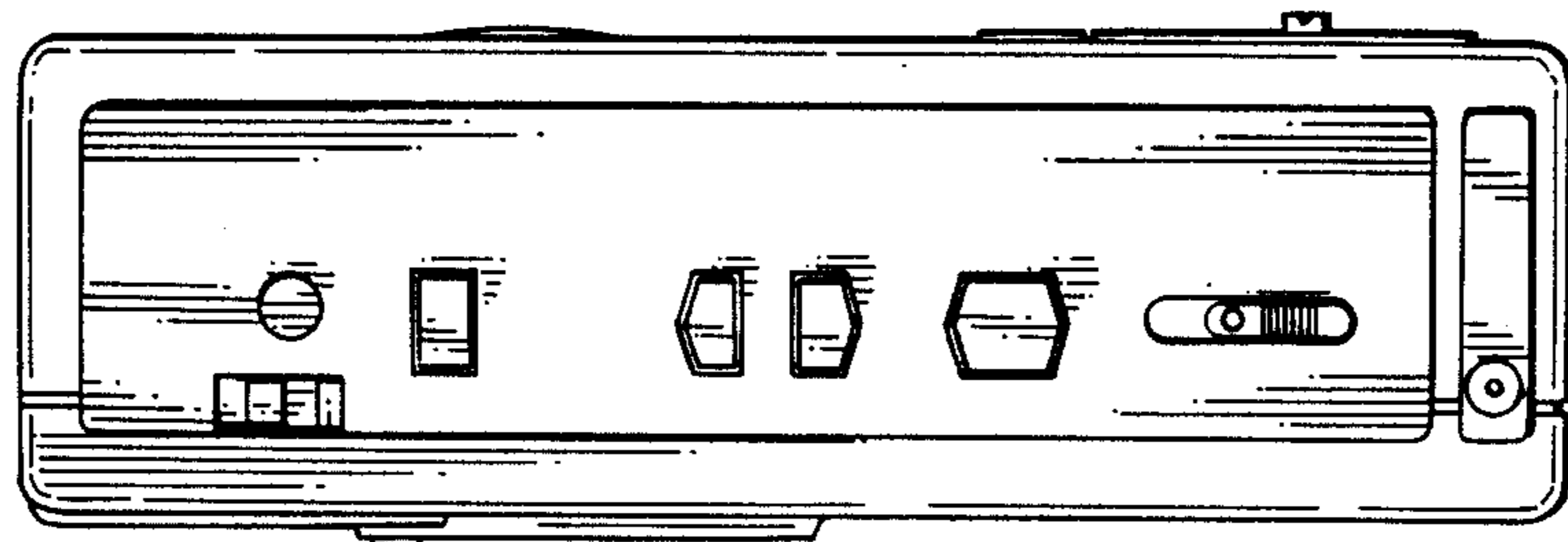
