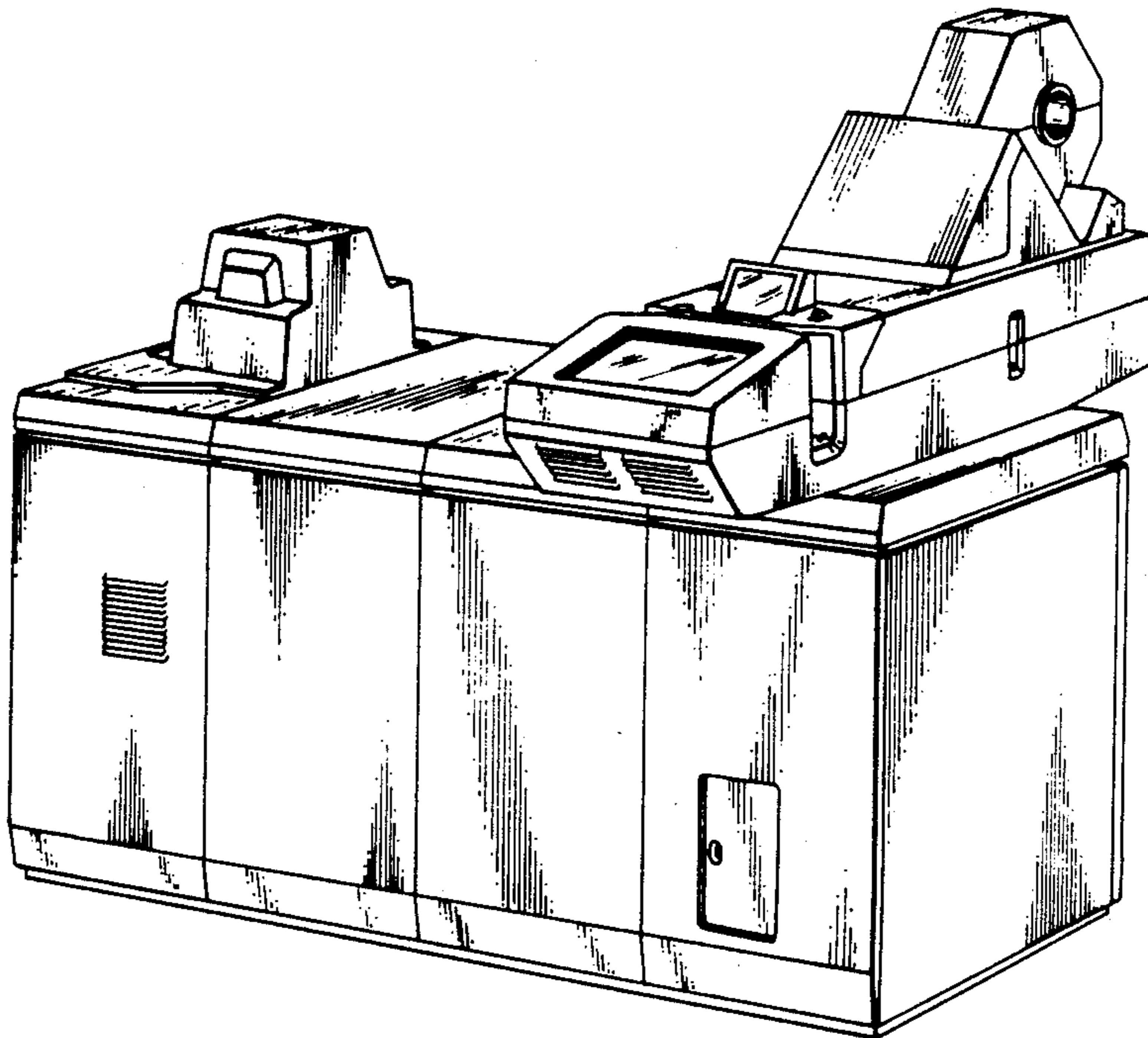

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a combined photographic printer and film processor showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a top, rear perspective view thereof.



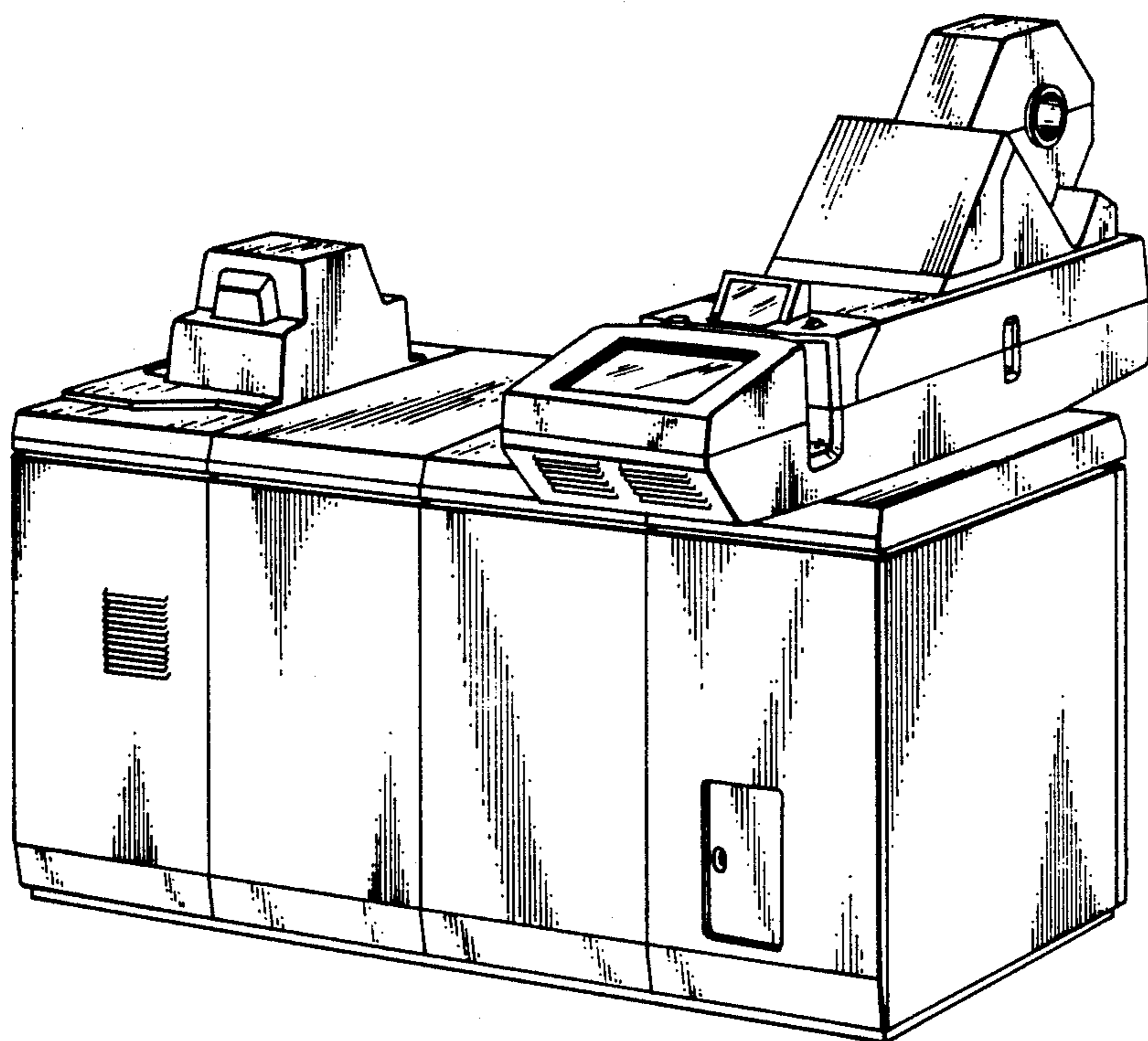

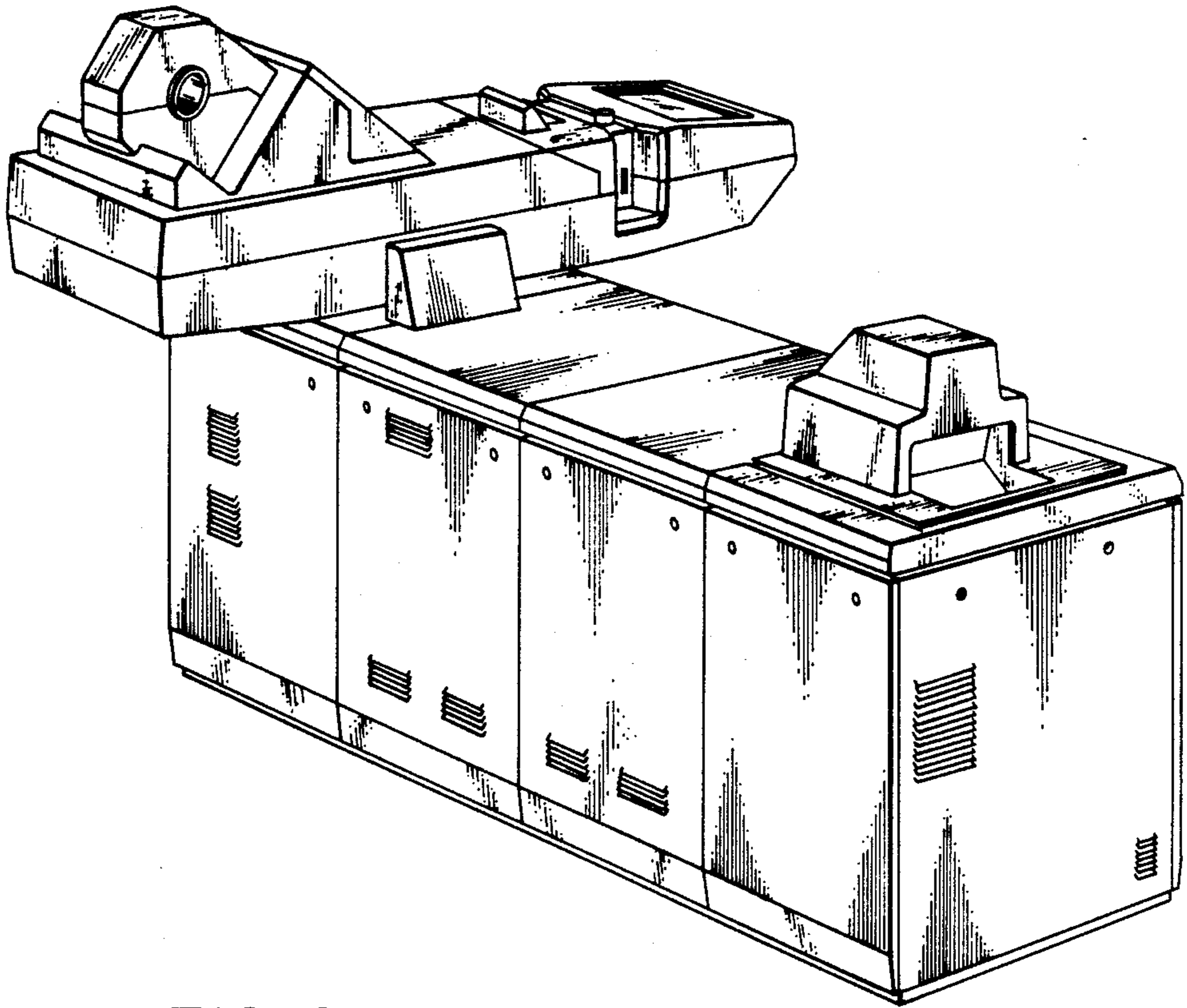
