The ornamental design for a toilet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a toilet showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The broken line representations of holes in FIGS. 1, 3, 5 and 6 are for the purpose of illustration only.

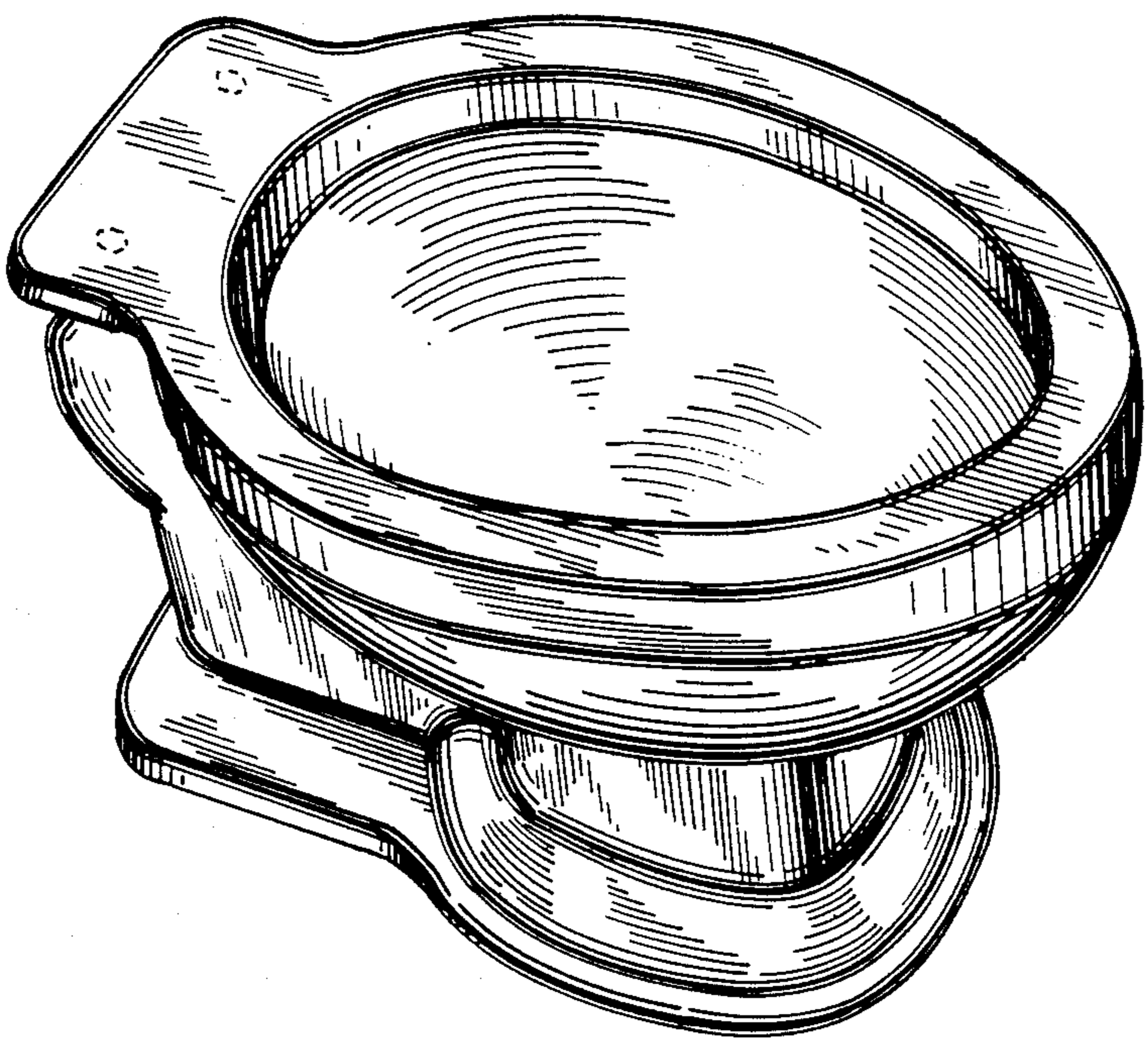

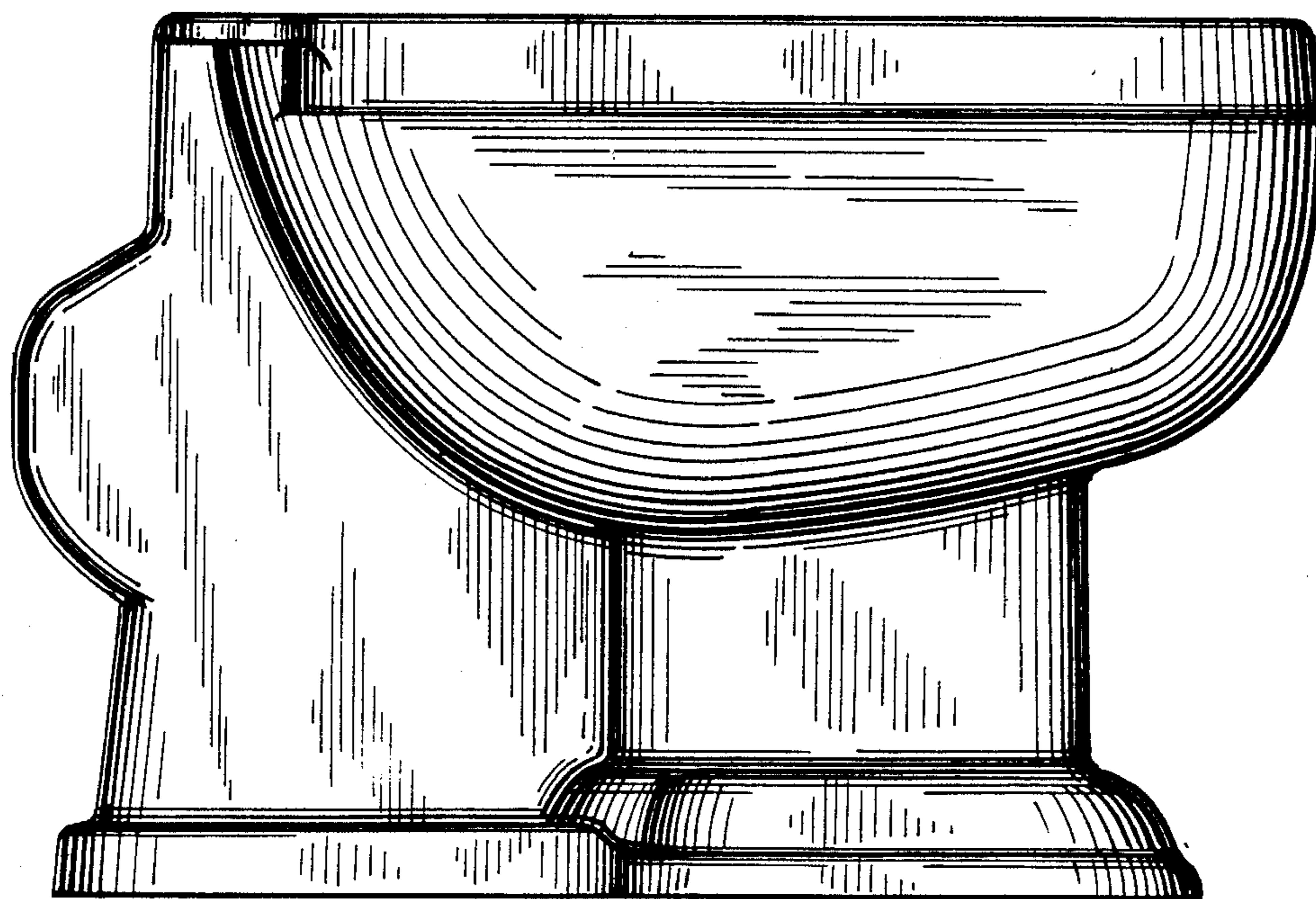
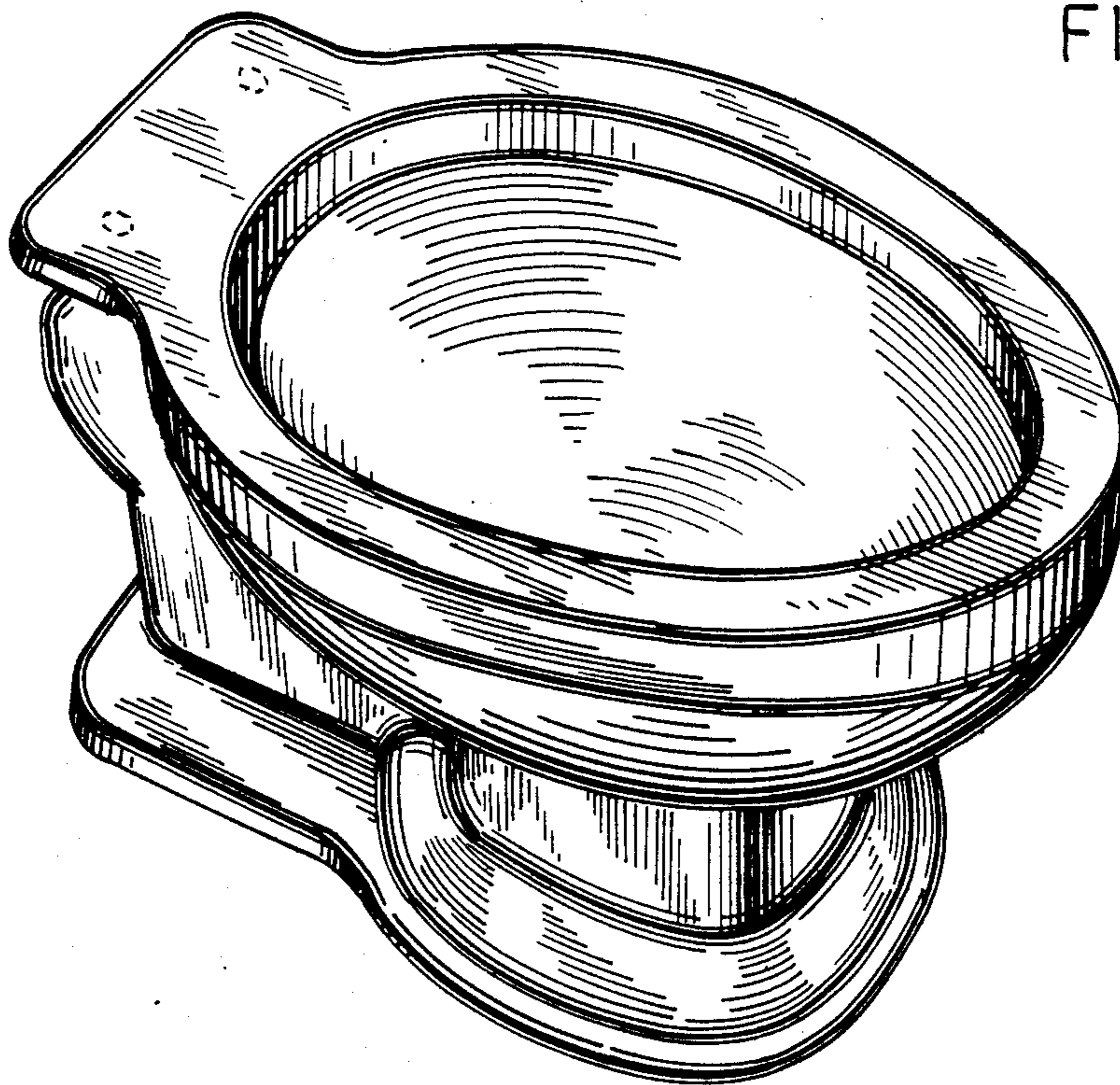

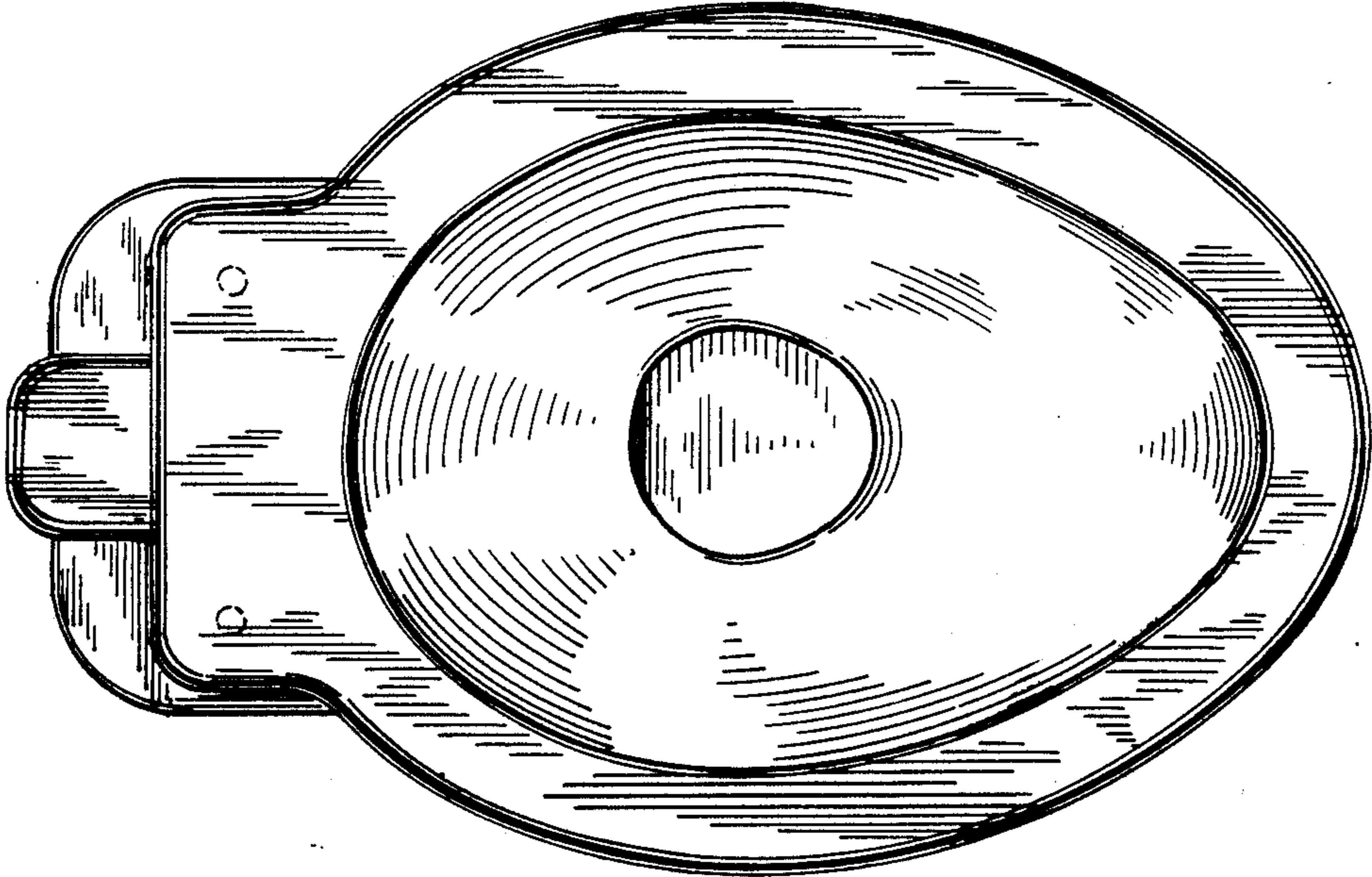

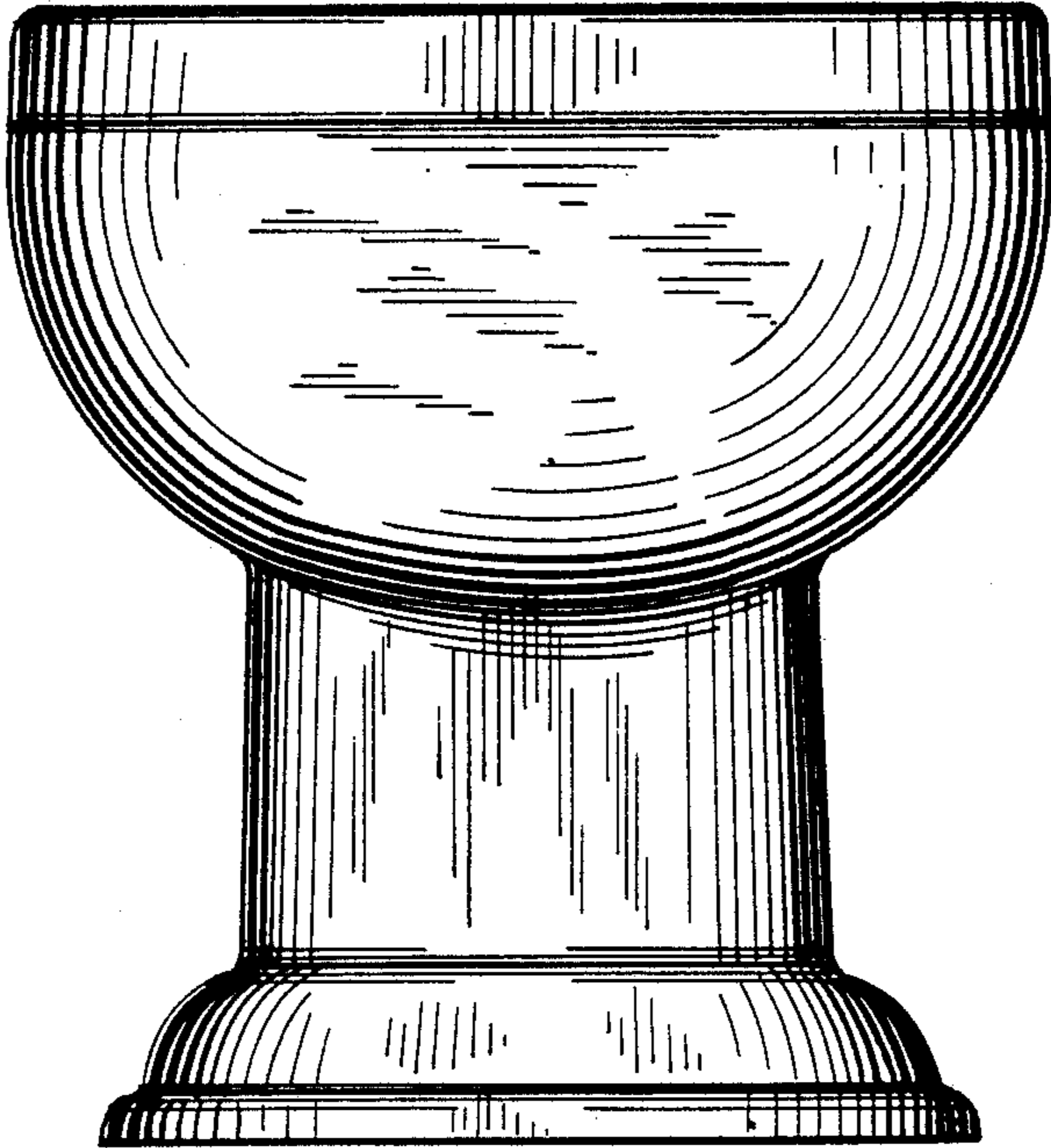

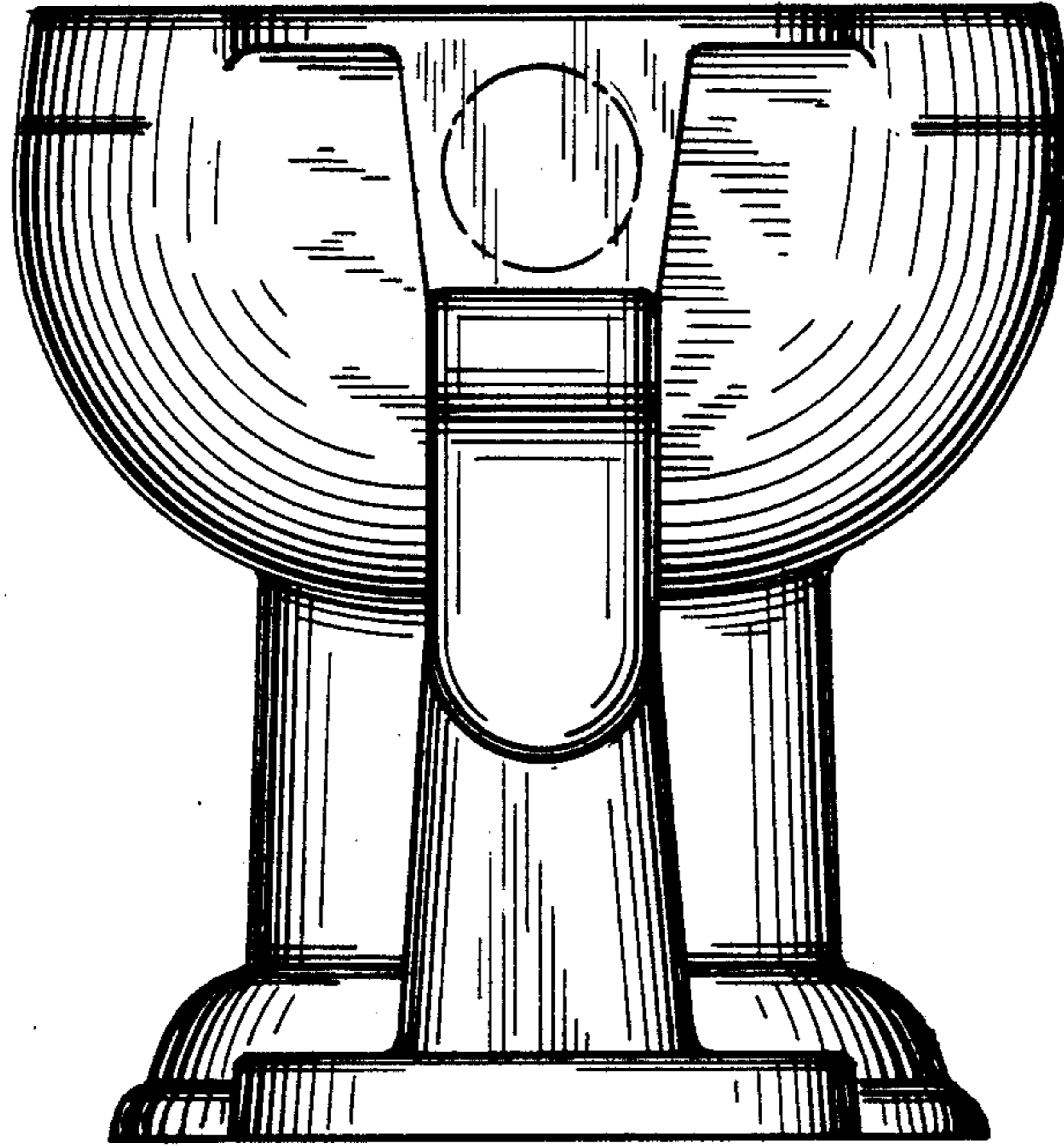

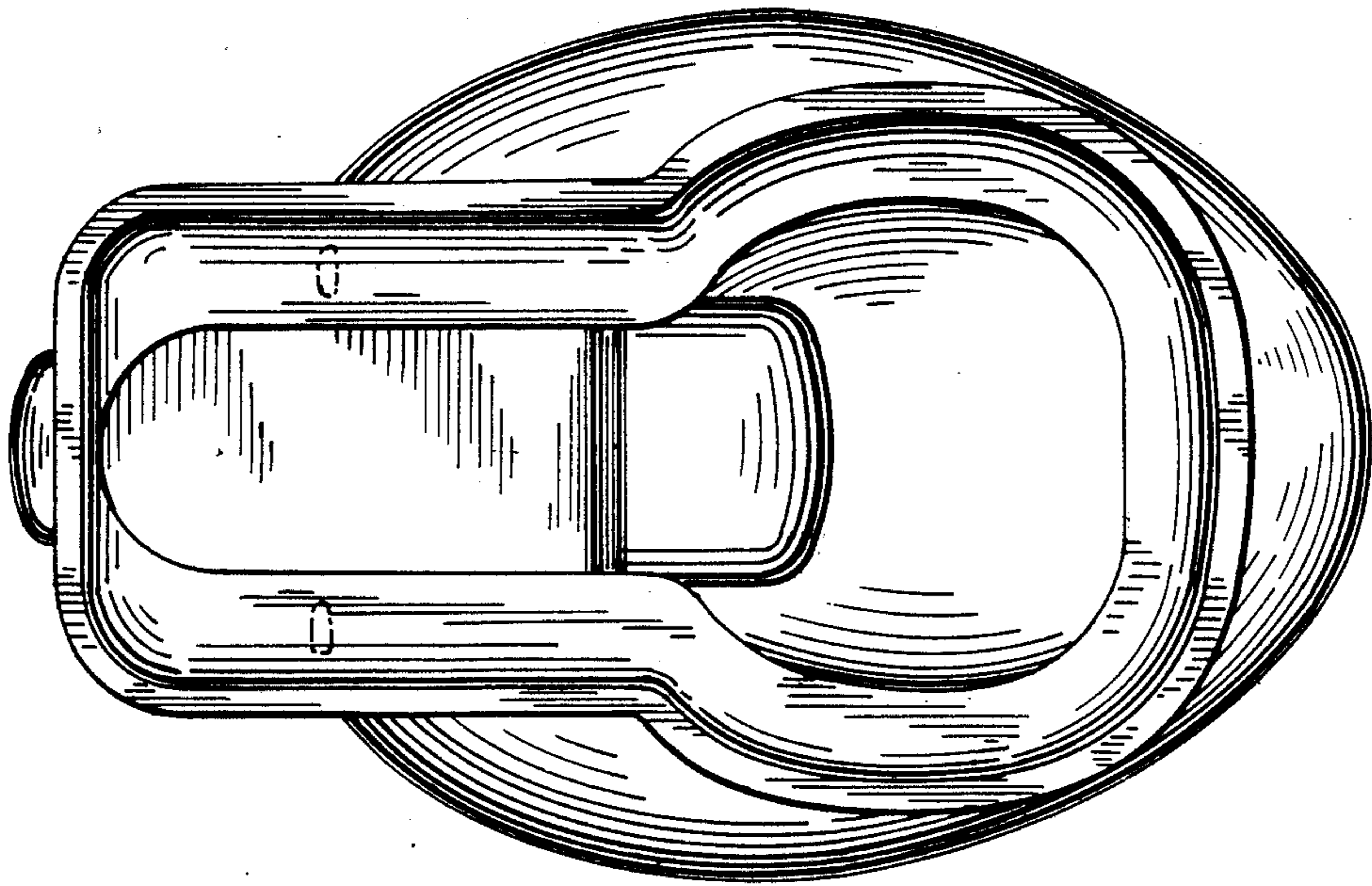
