[57] The ornamental design for a ceiling fan, as shown and described.

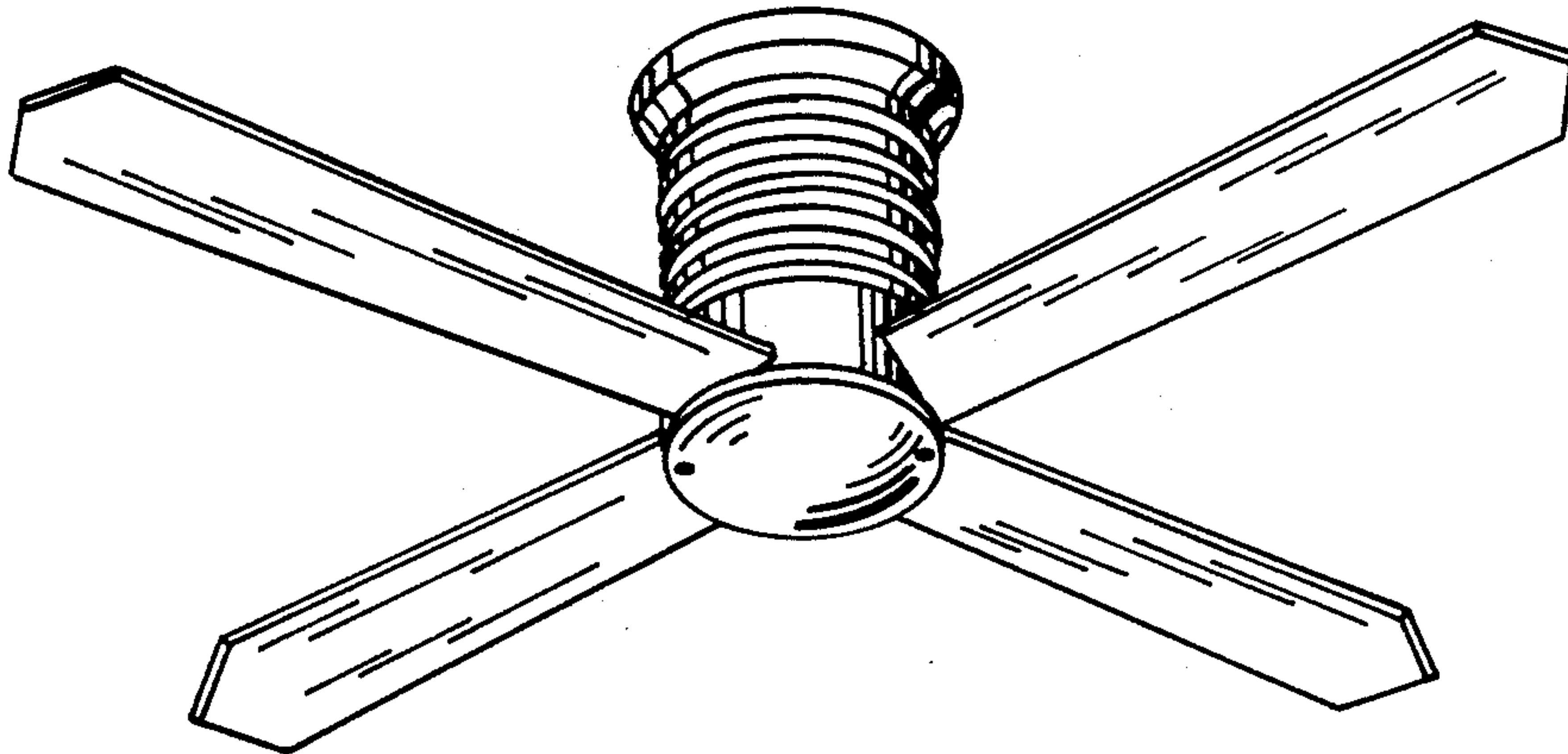
DESCRIPTION

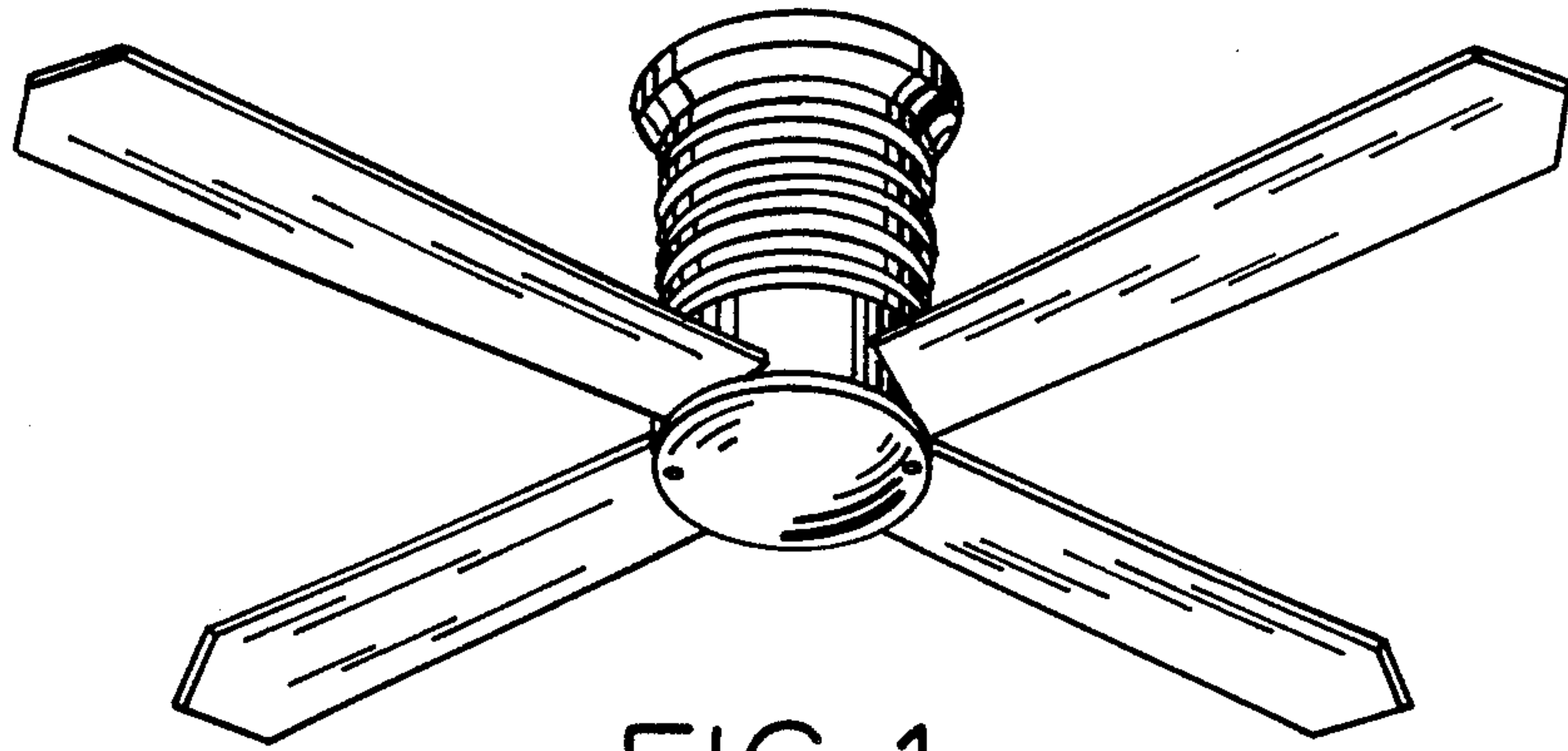

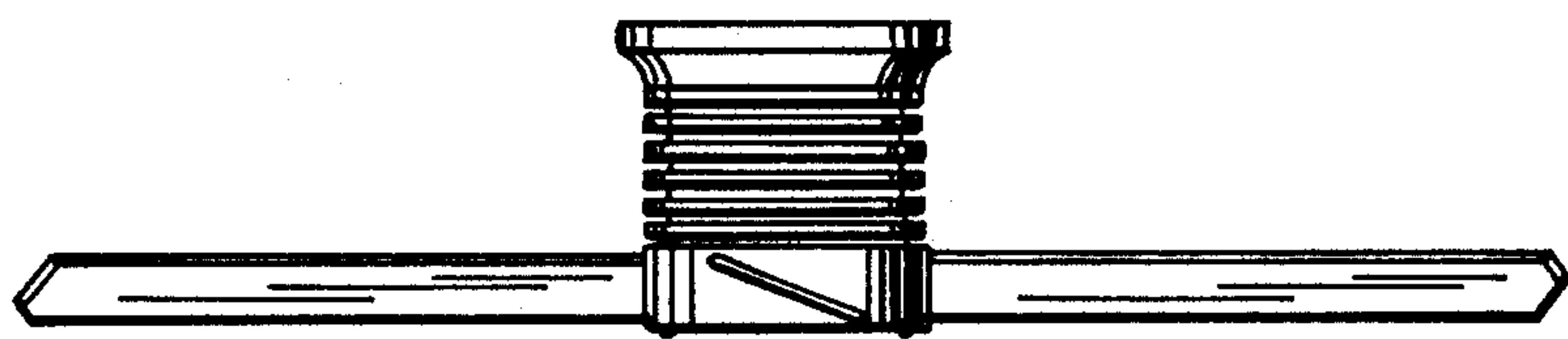

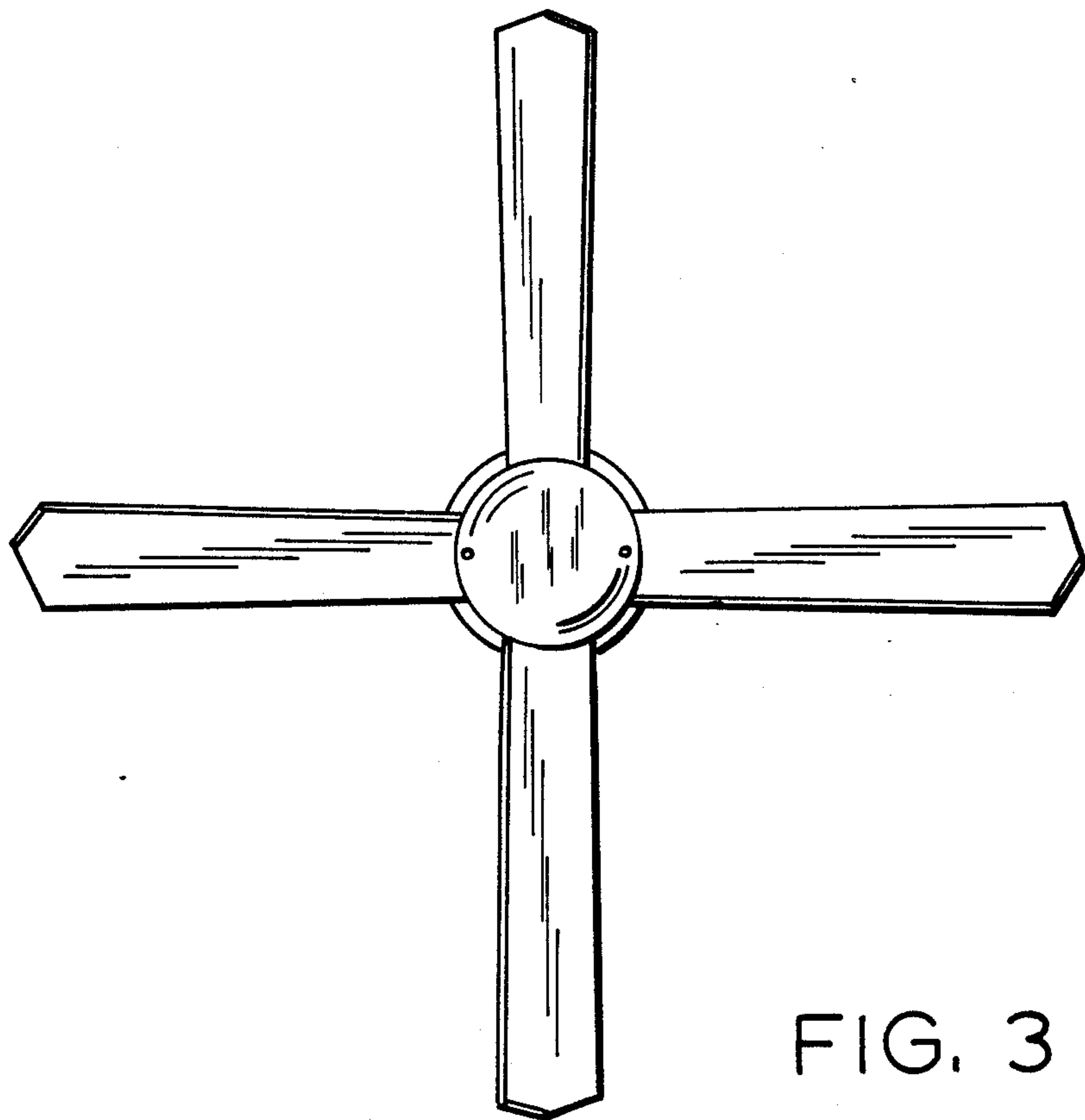

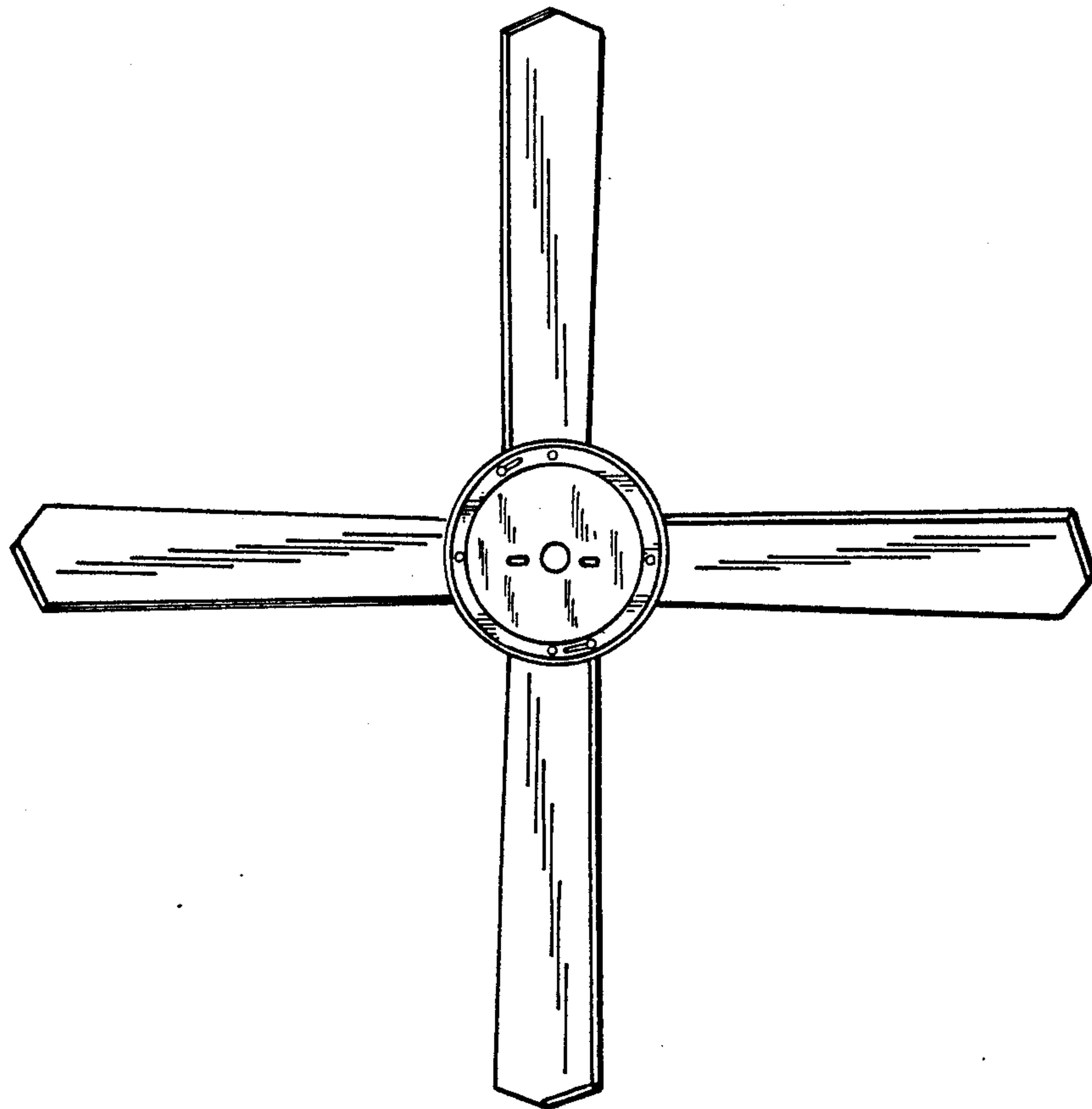
