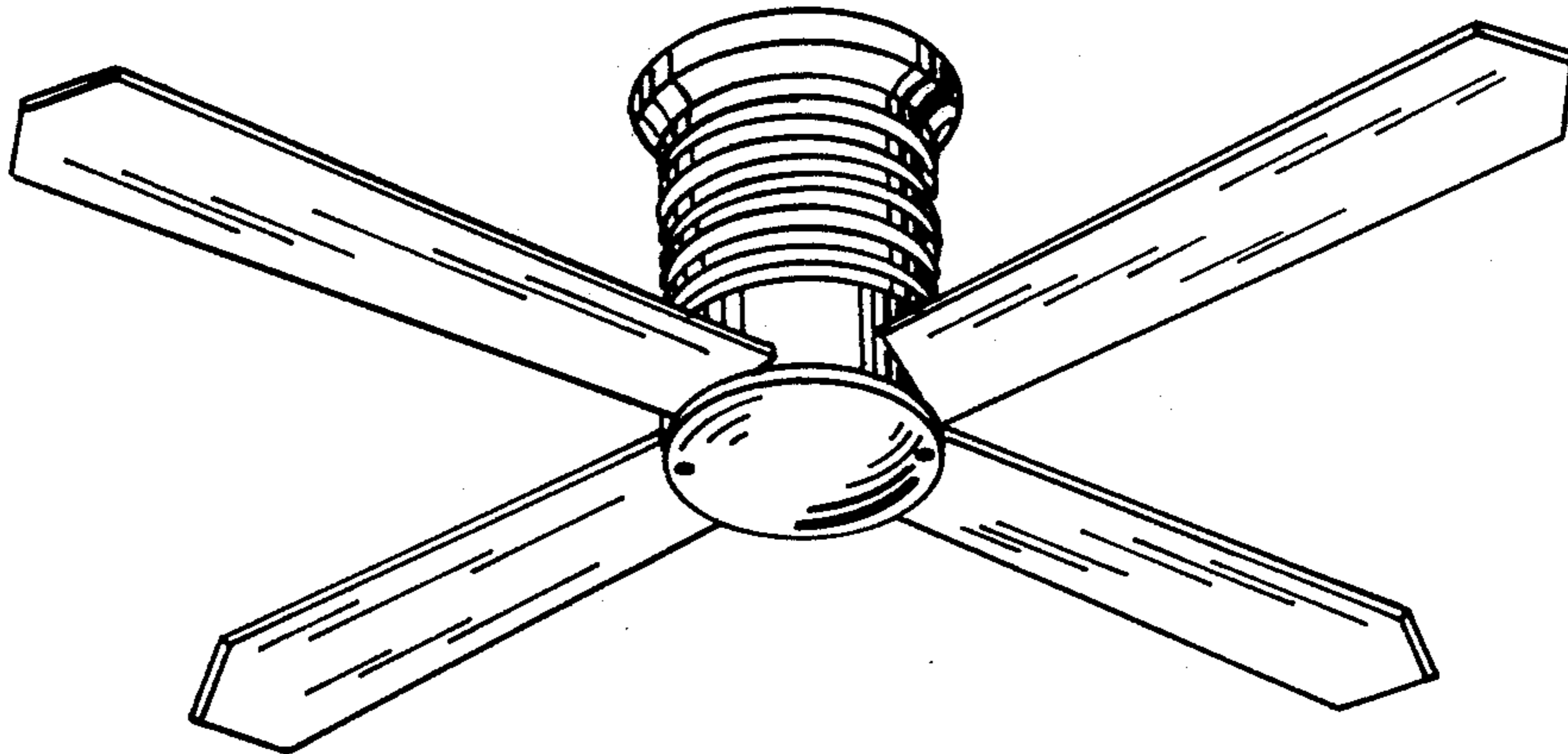

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ceiling fan showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

 FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown.



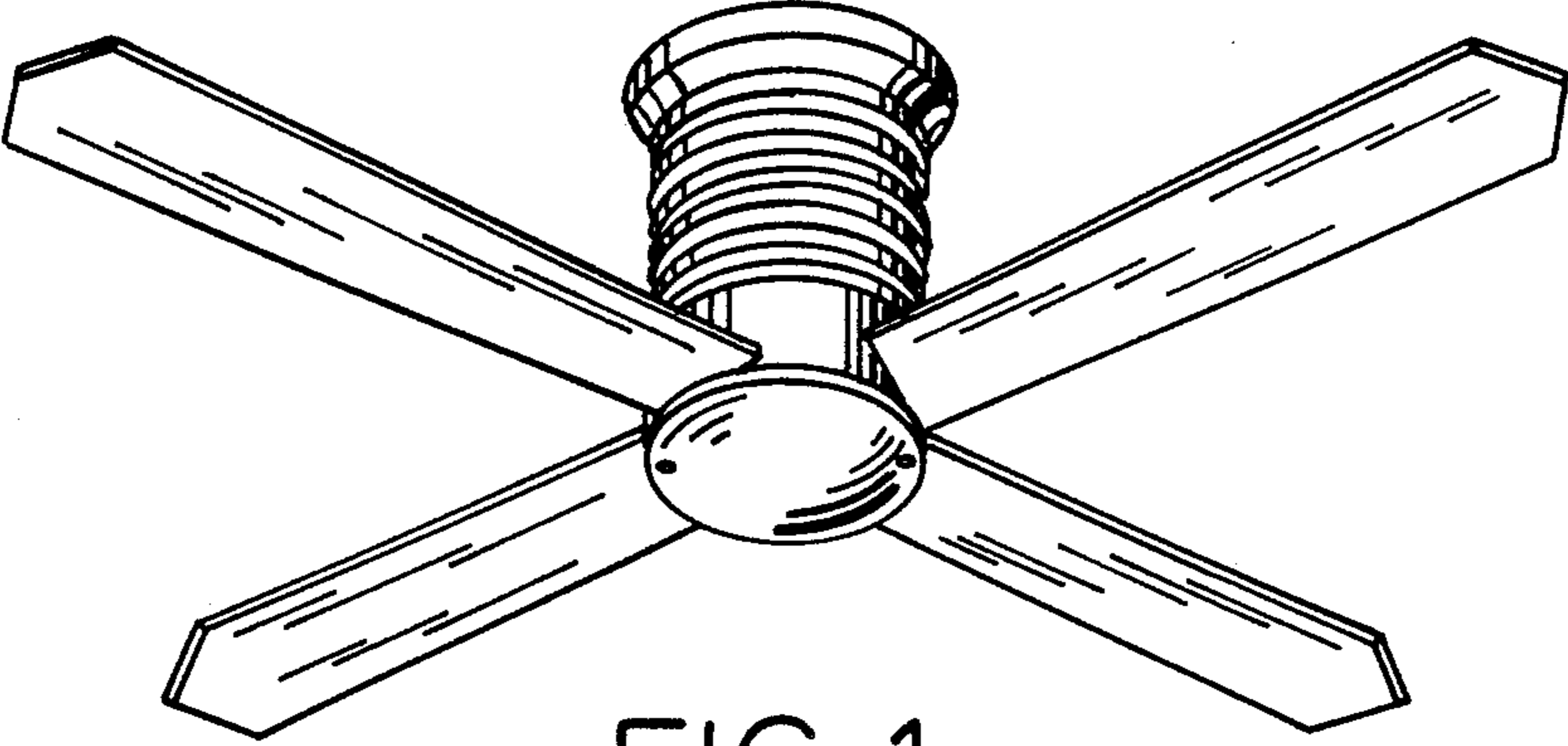

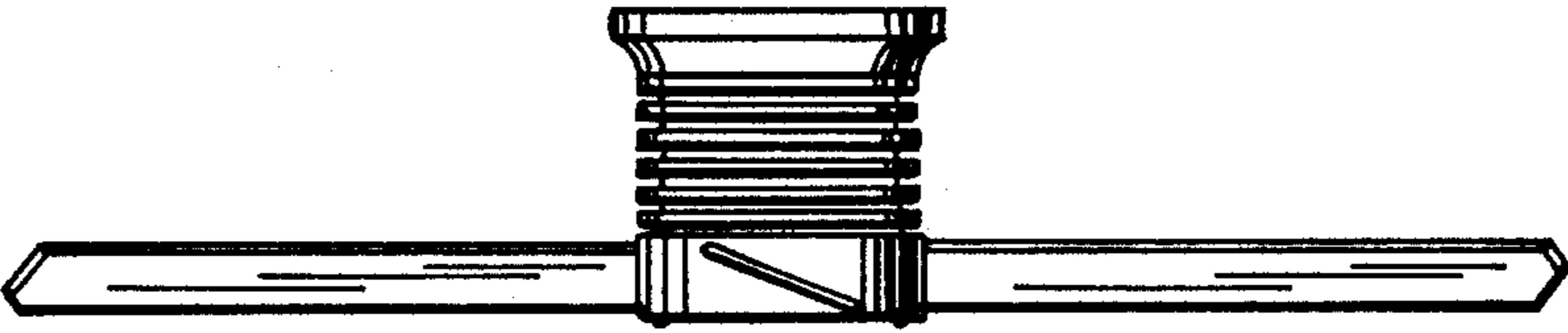

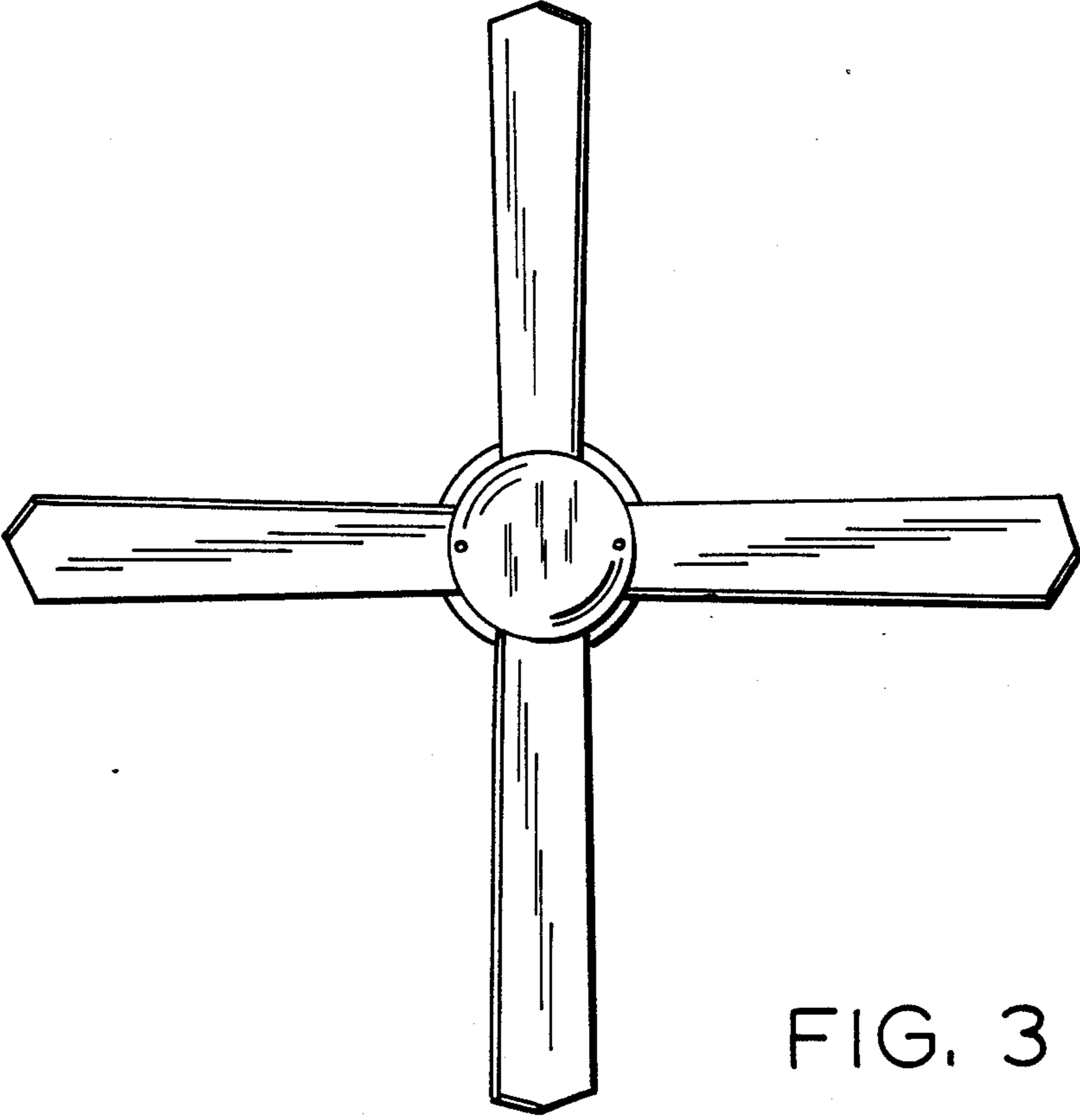

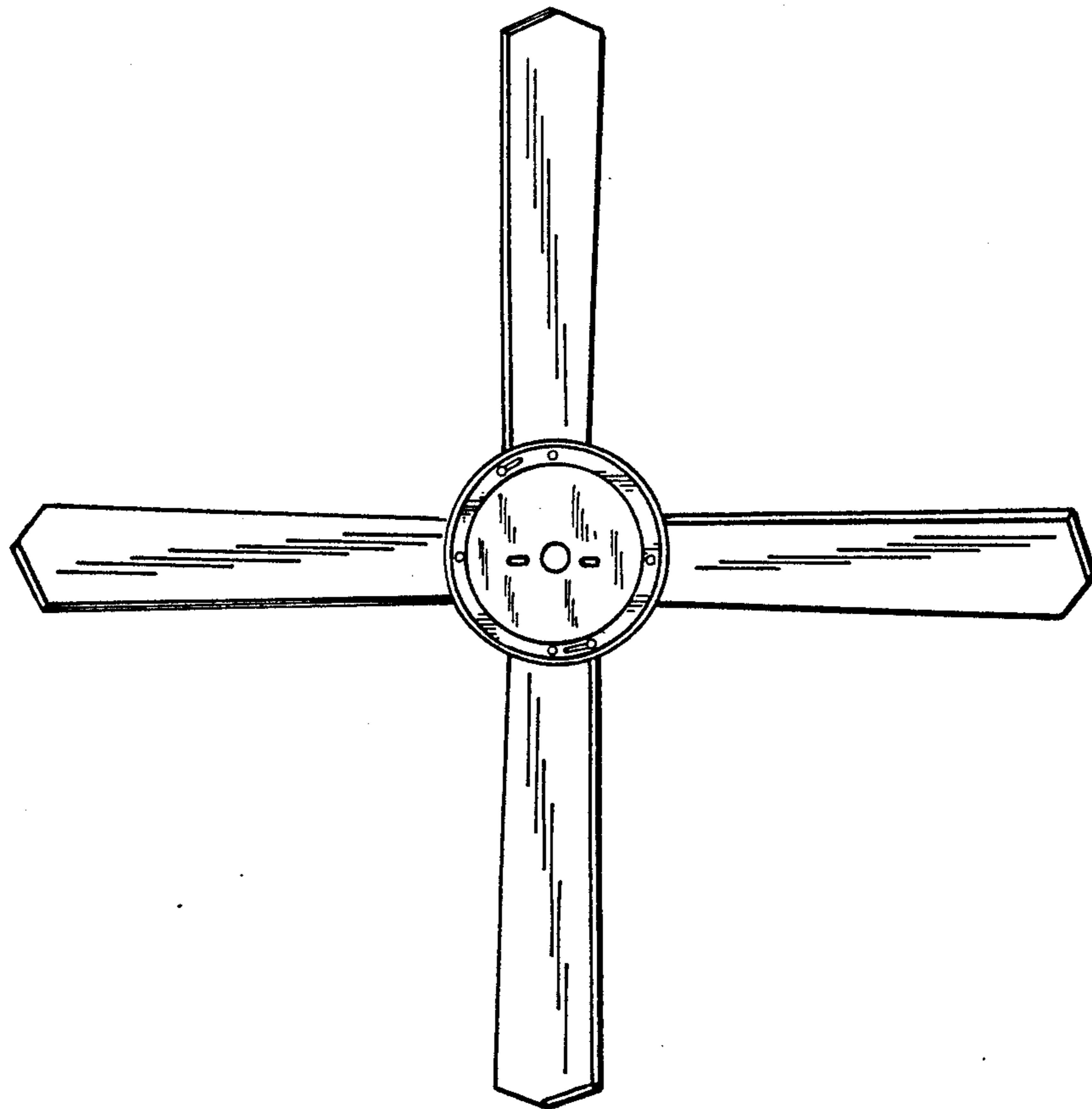
