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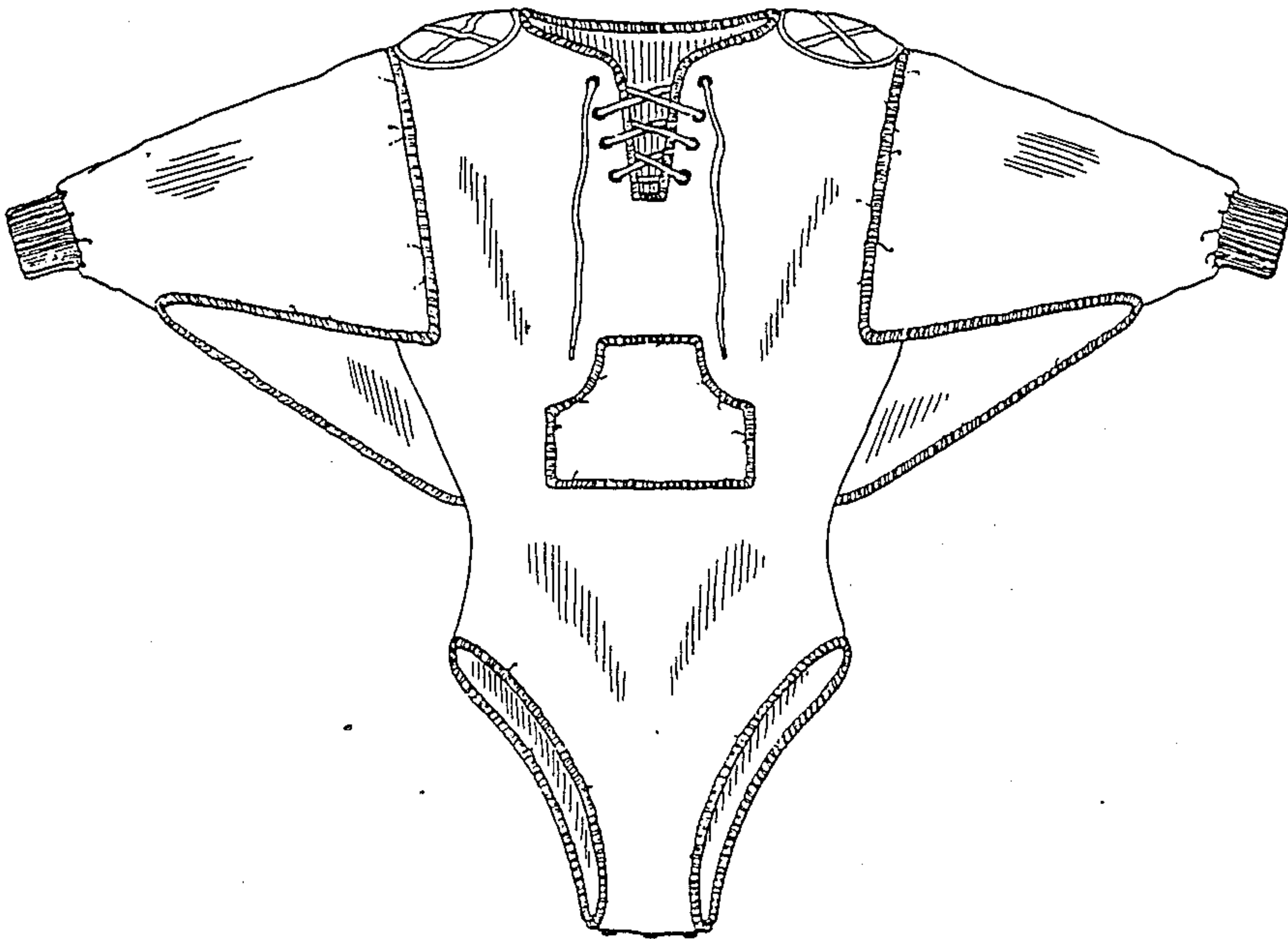

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a caped leotard
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational thereof, the sleeve being
shown raised;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the
sleeve being shown raised;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, being shown
unfastened.



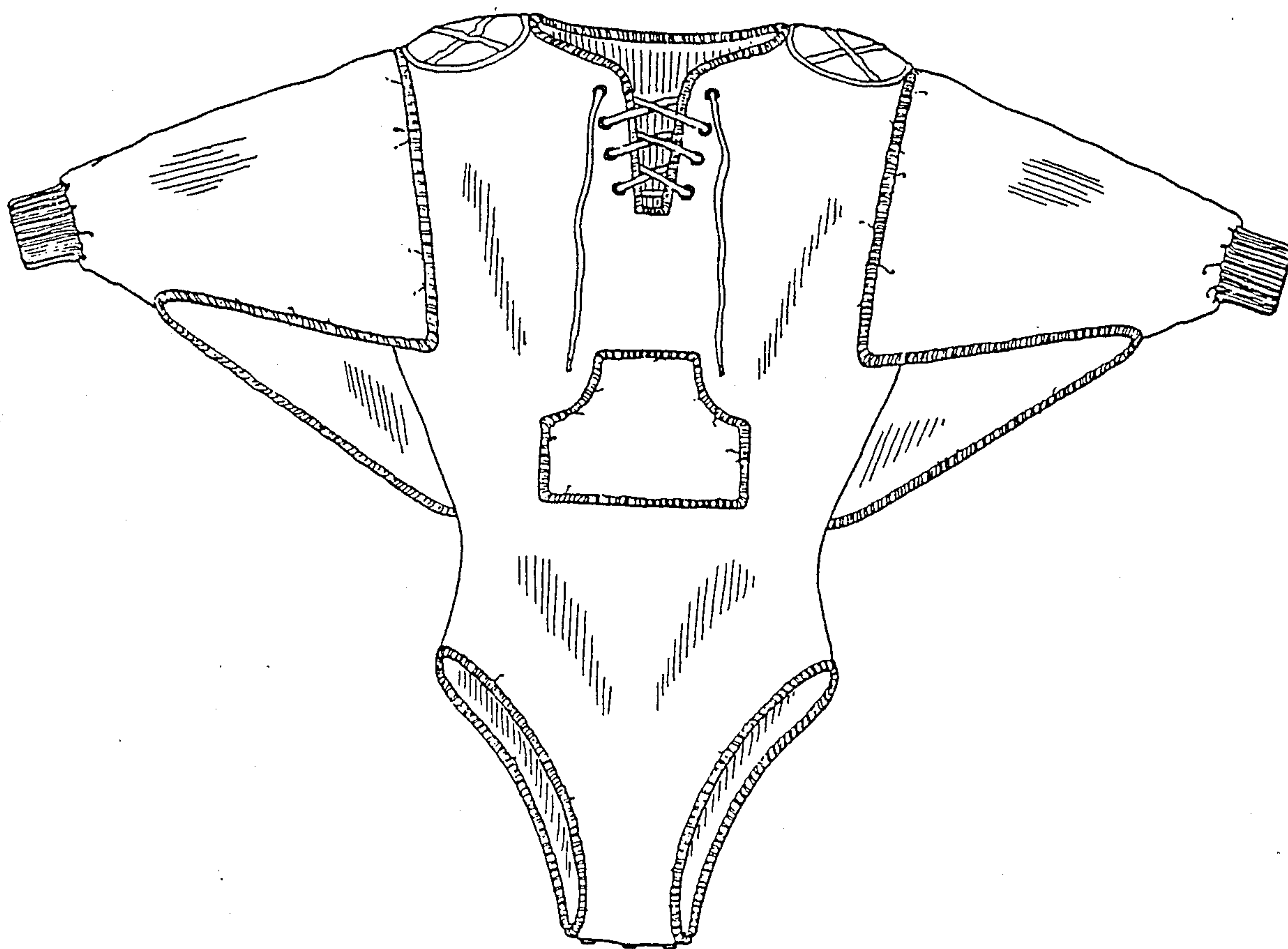

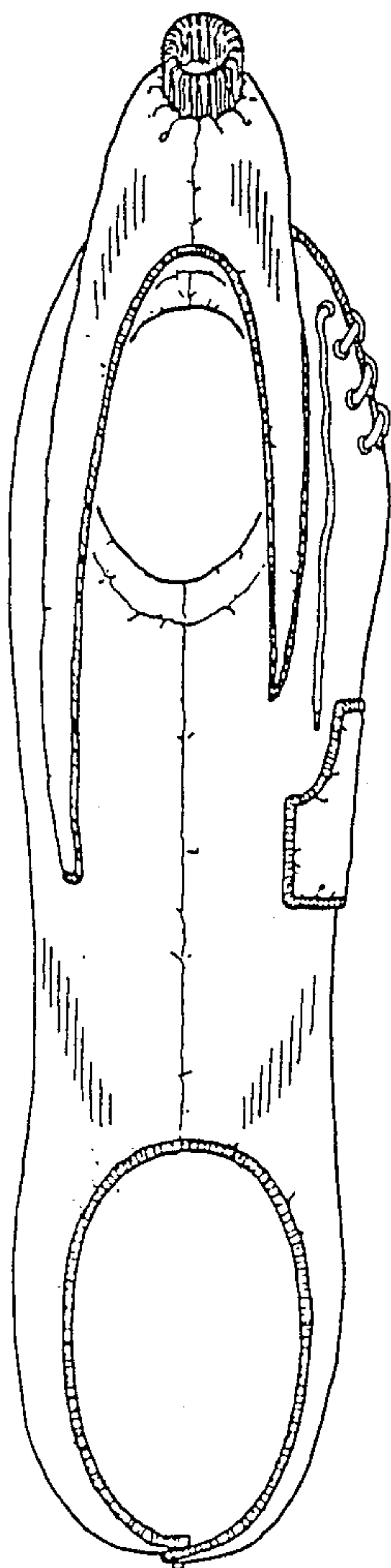

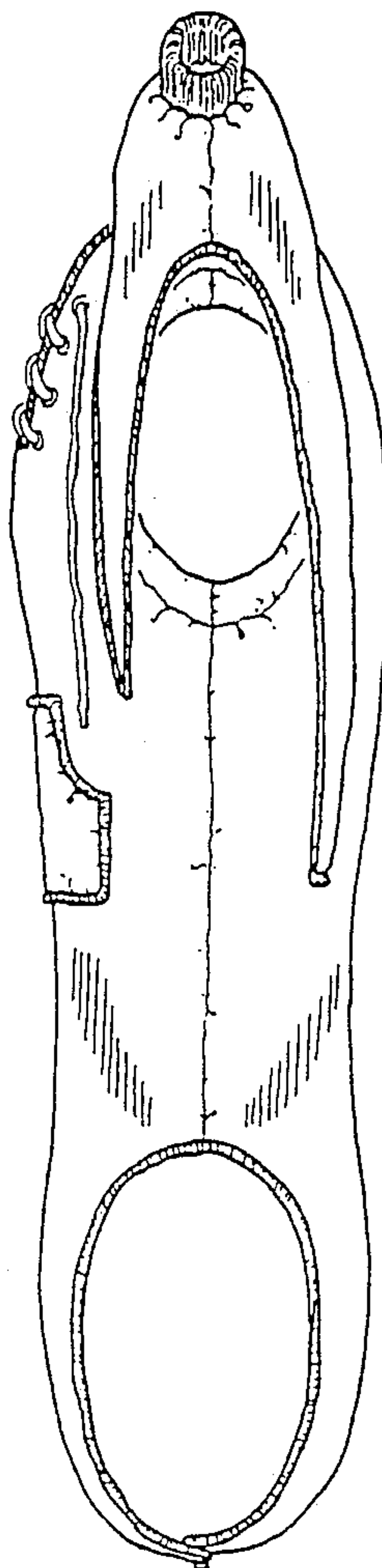

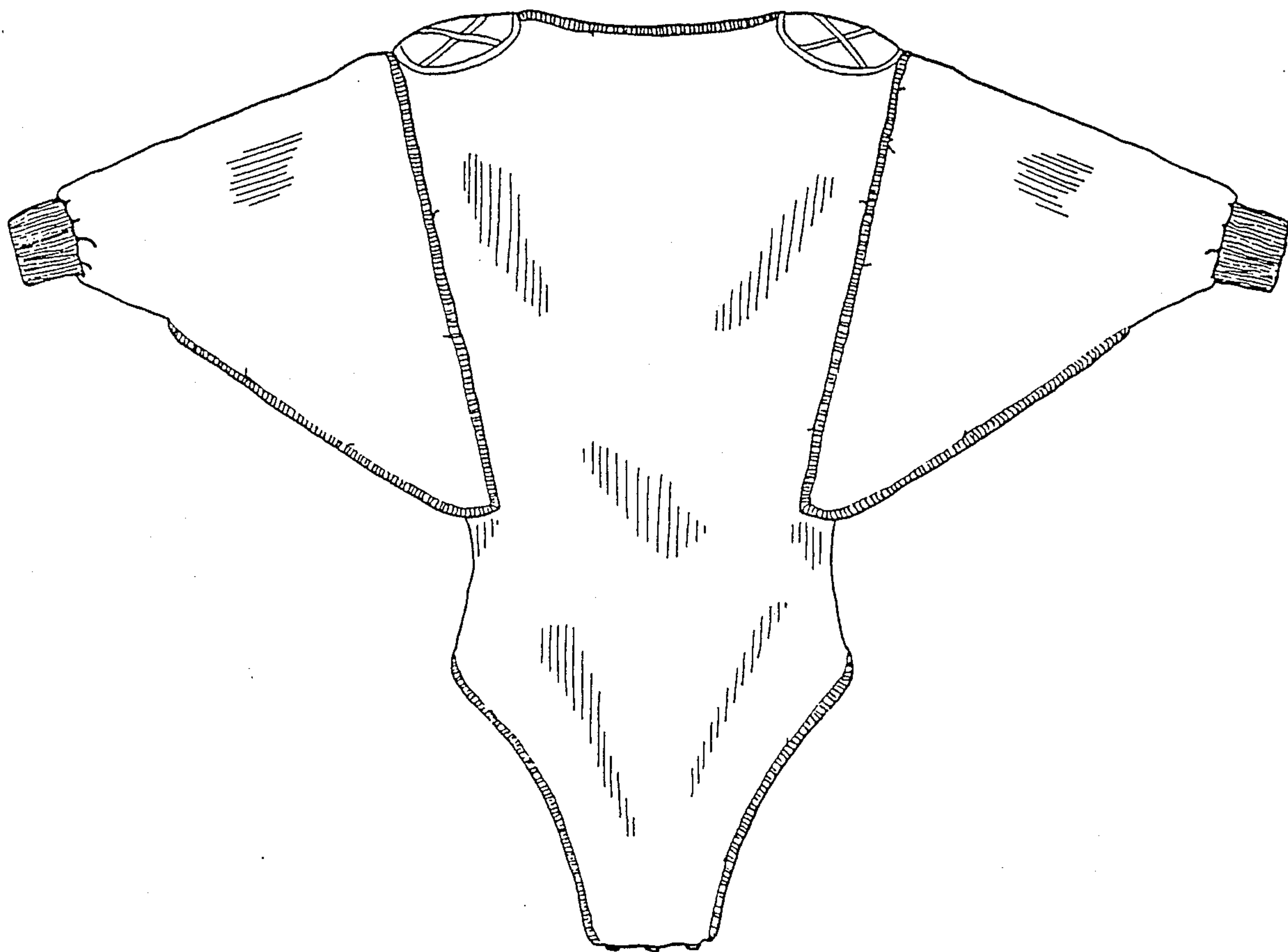

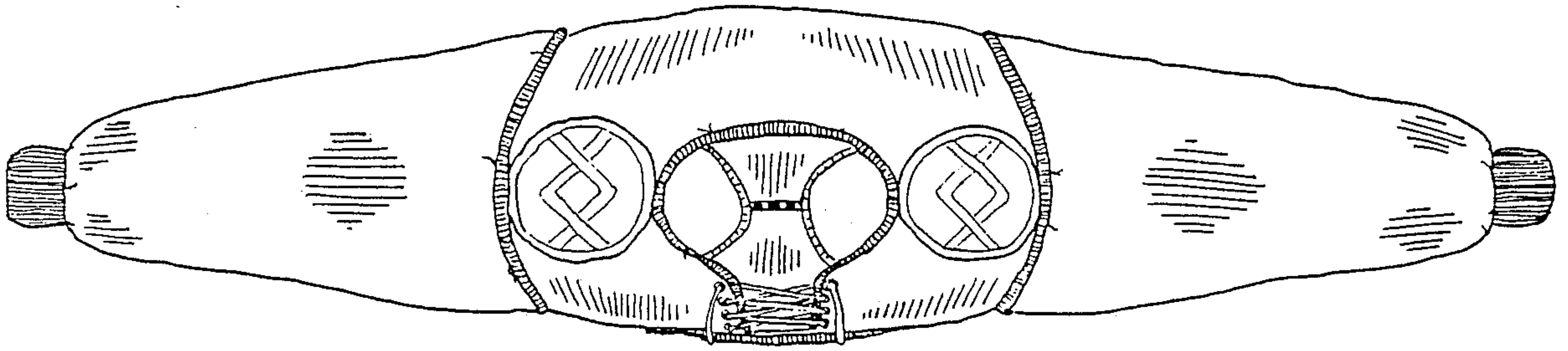

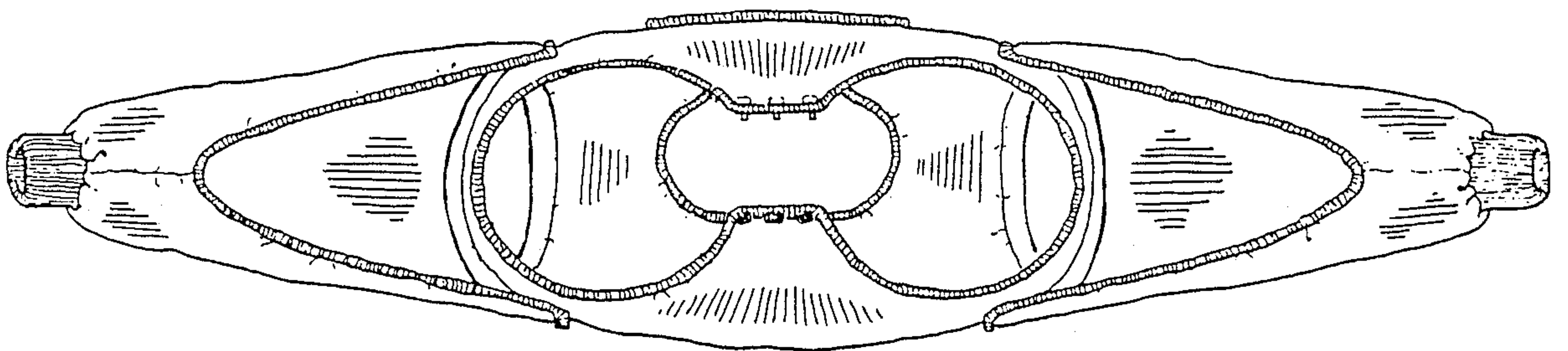
