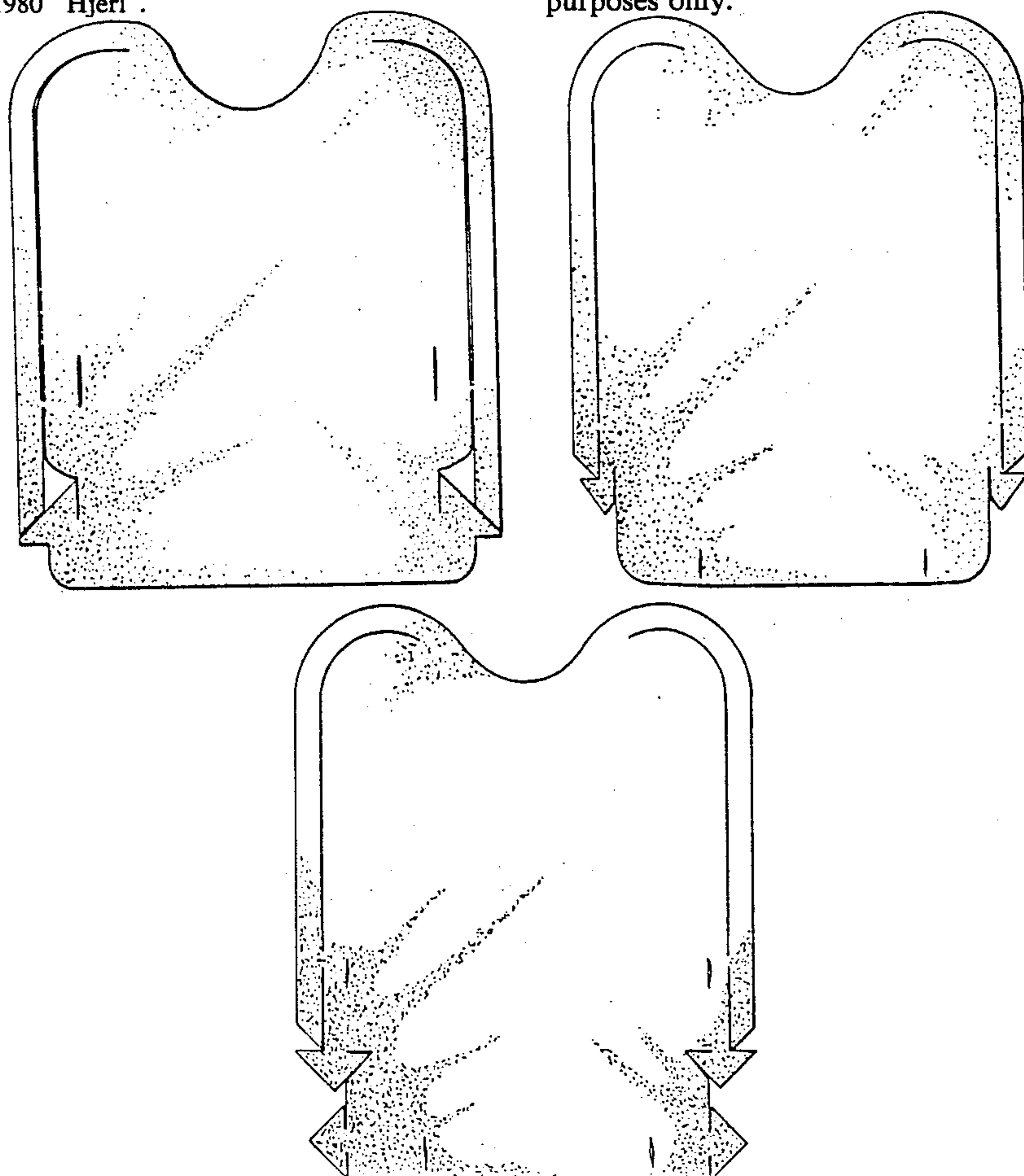
The ornamental design for a bib, as shown and described.

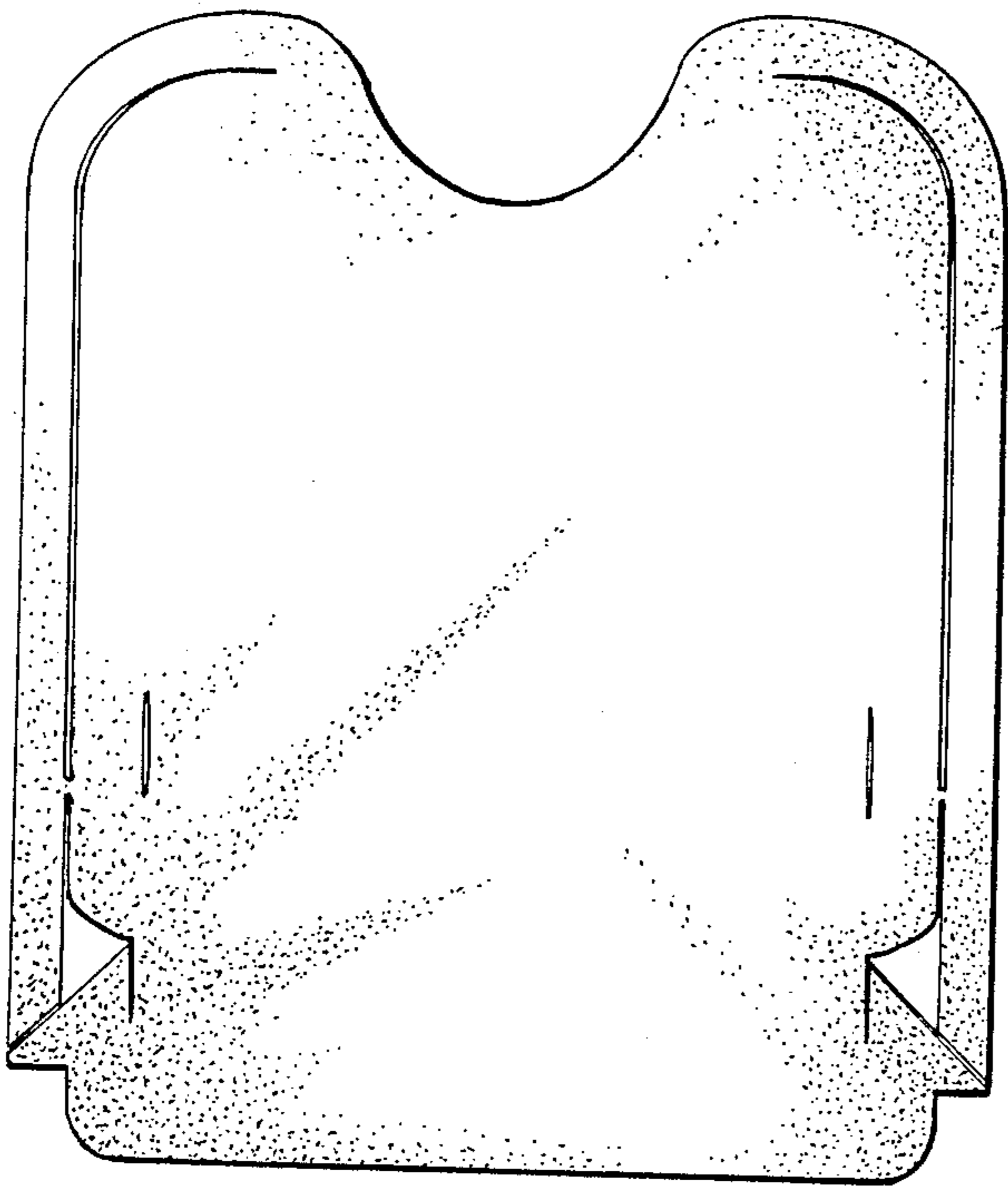

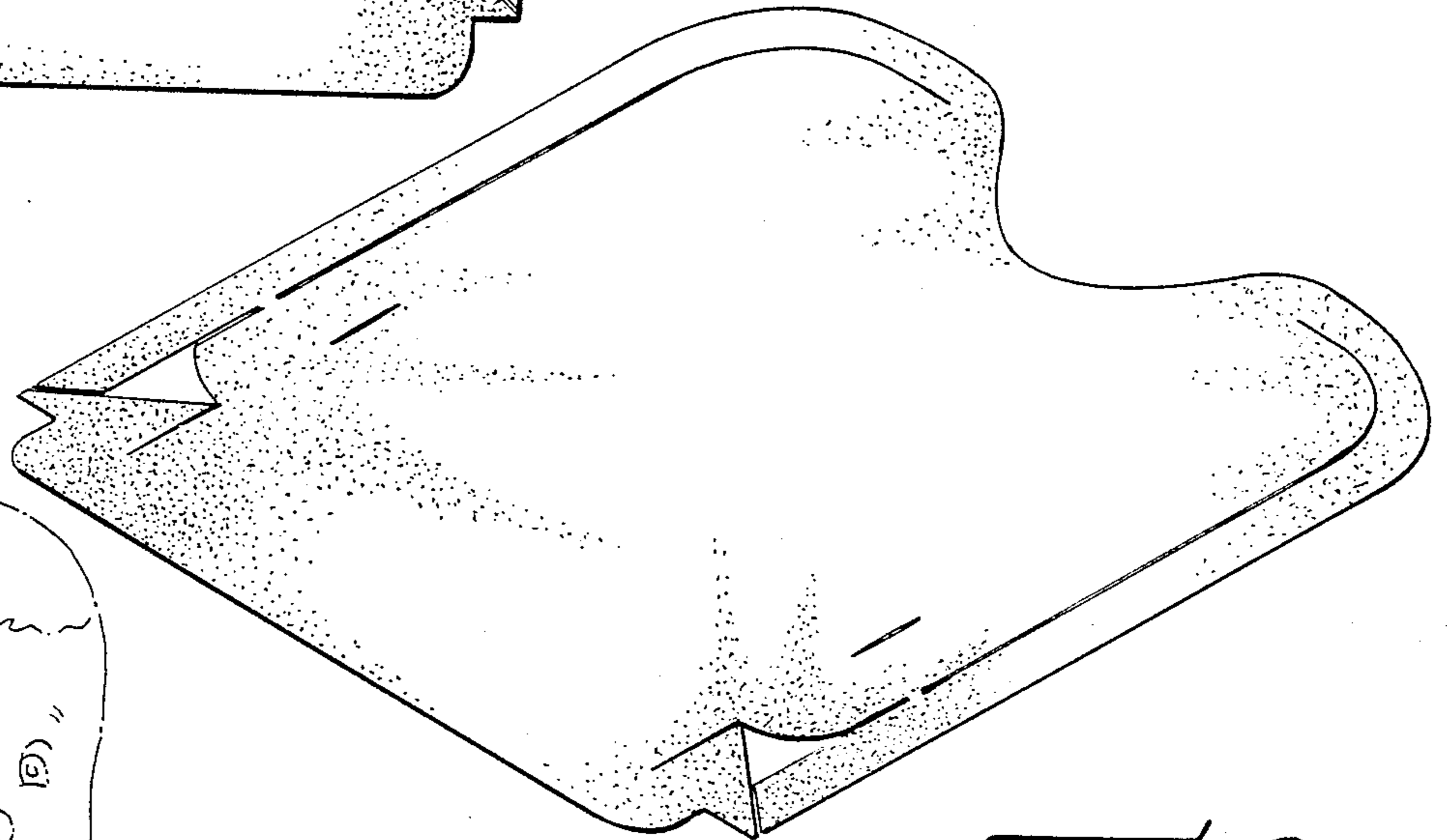

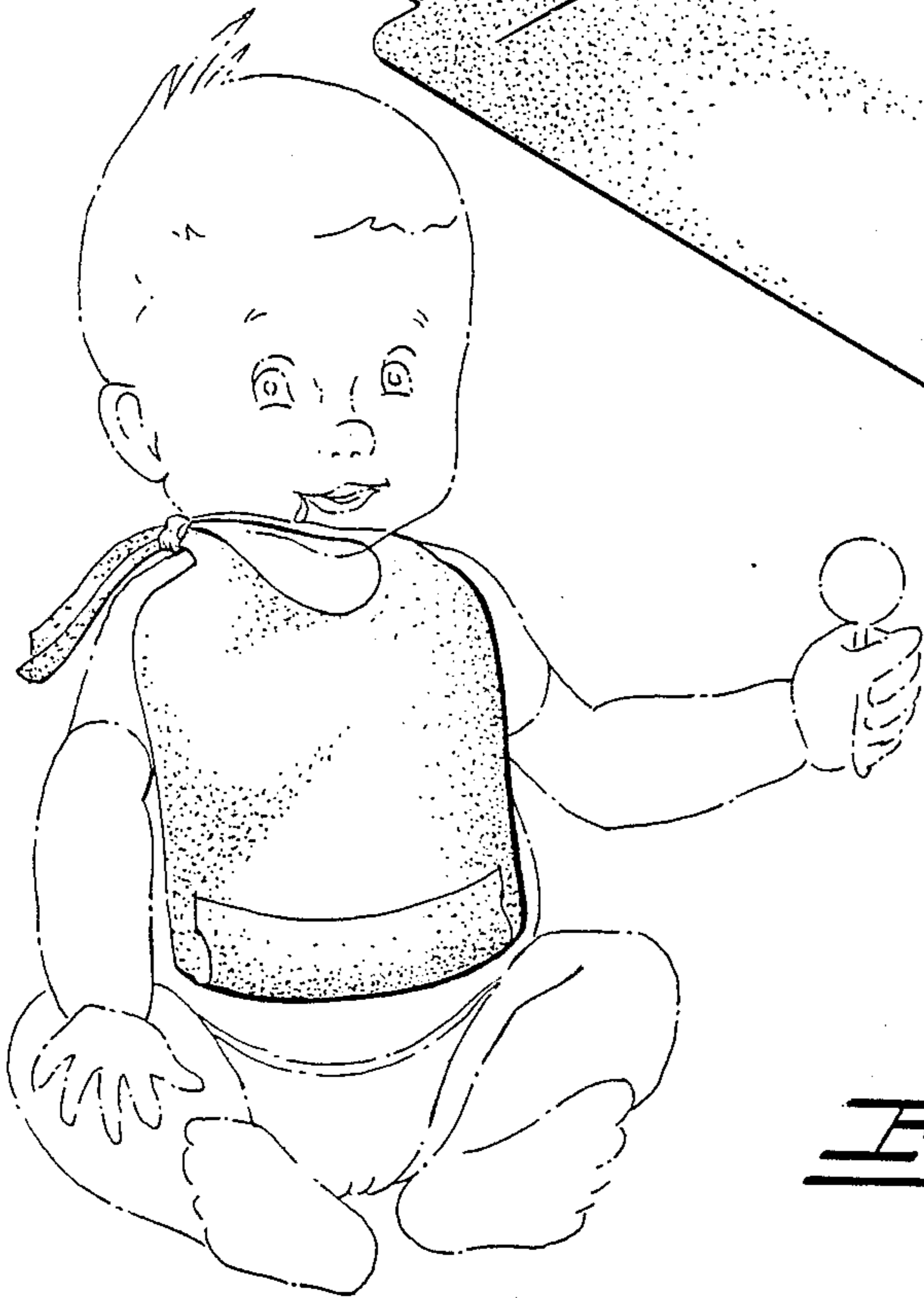

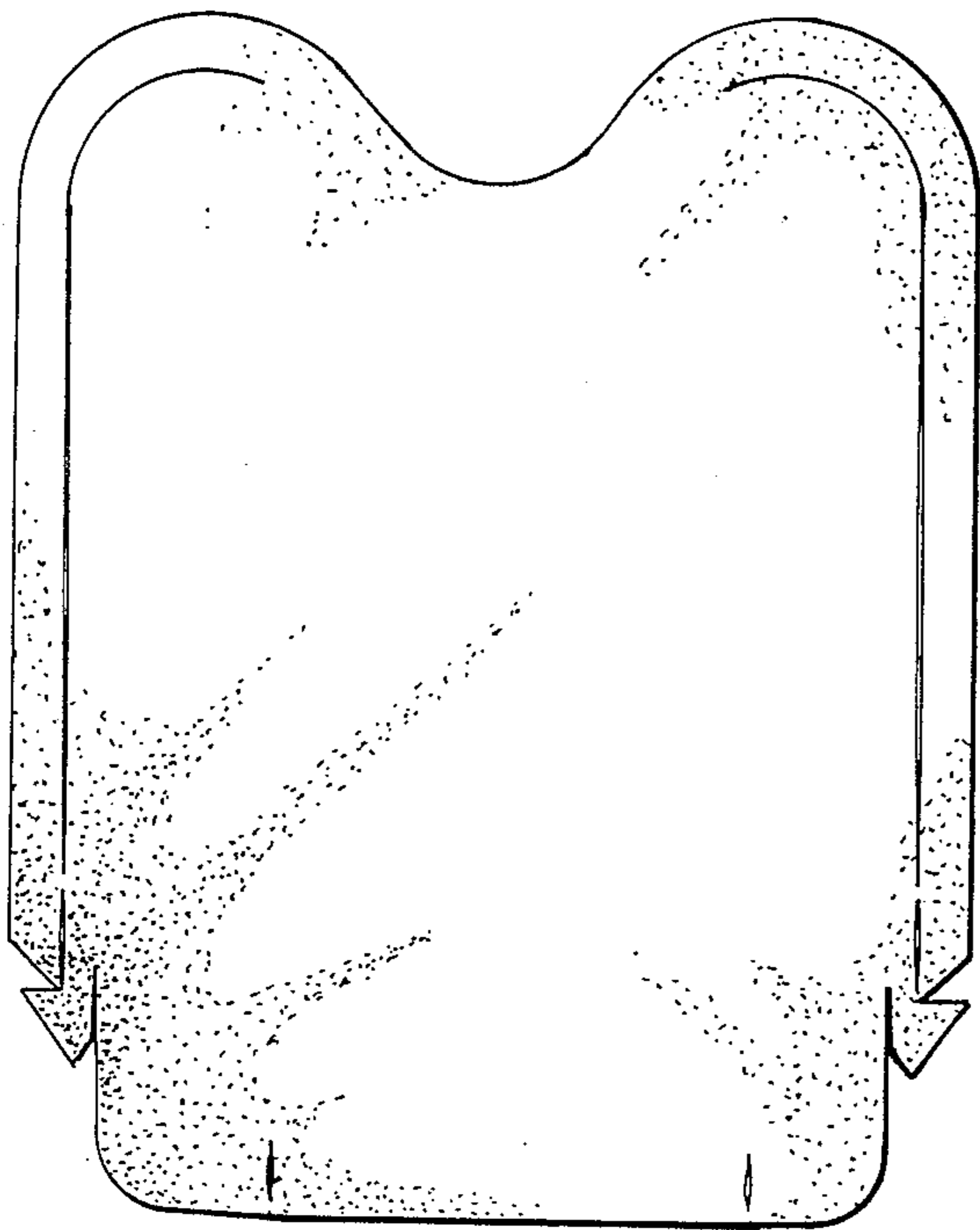

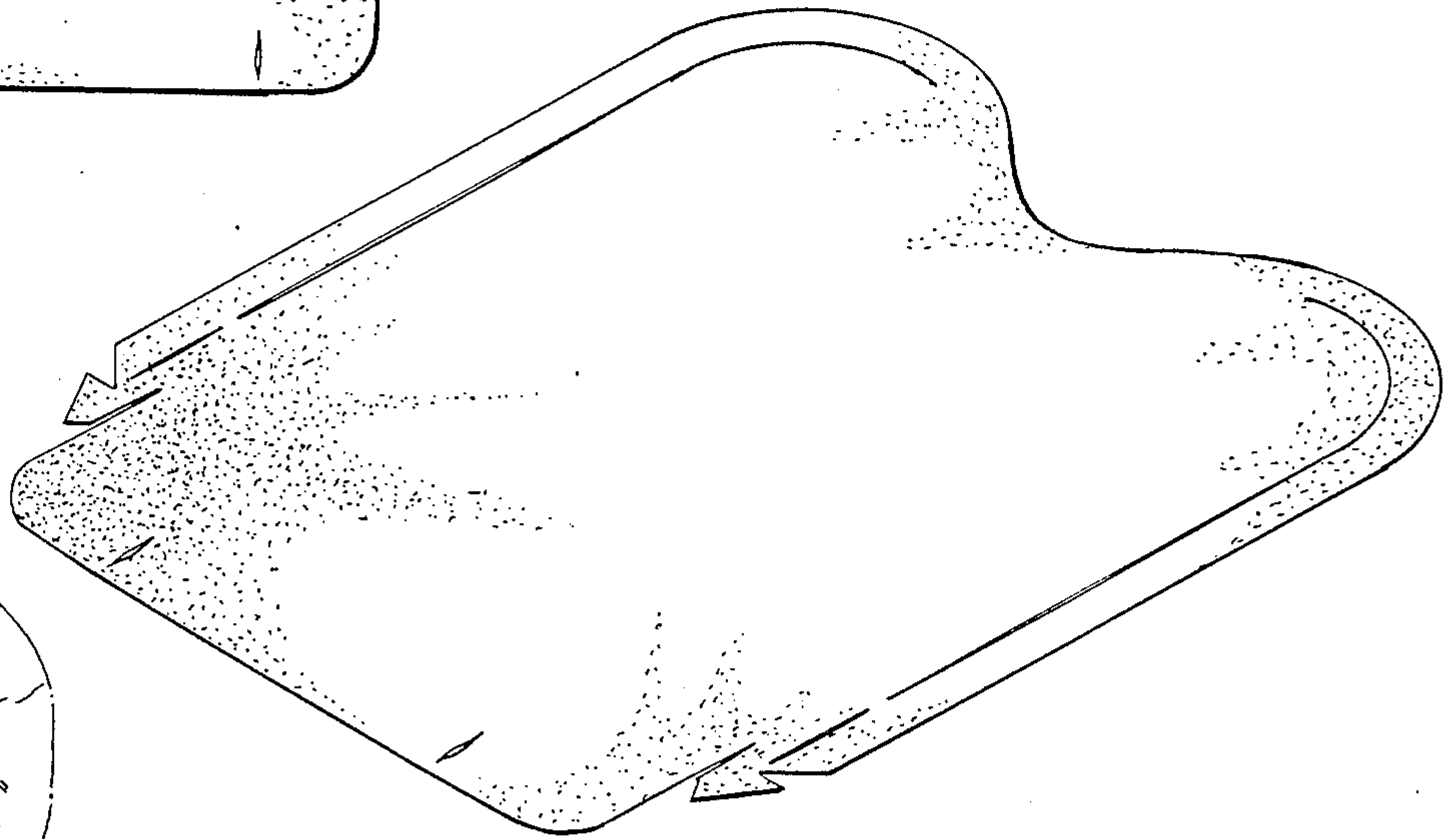

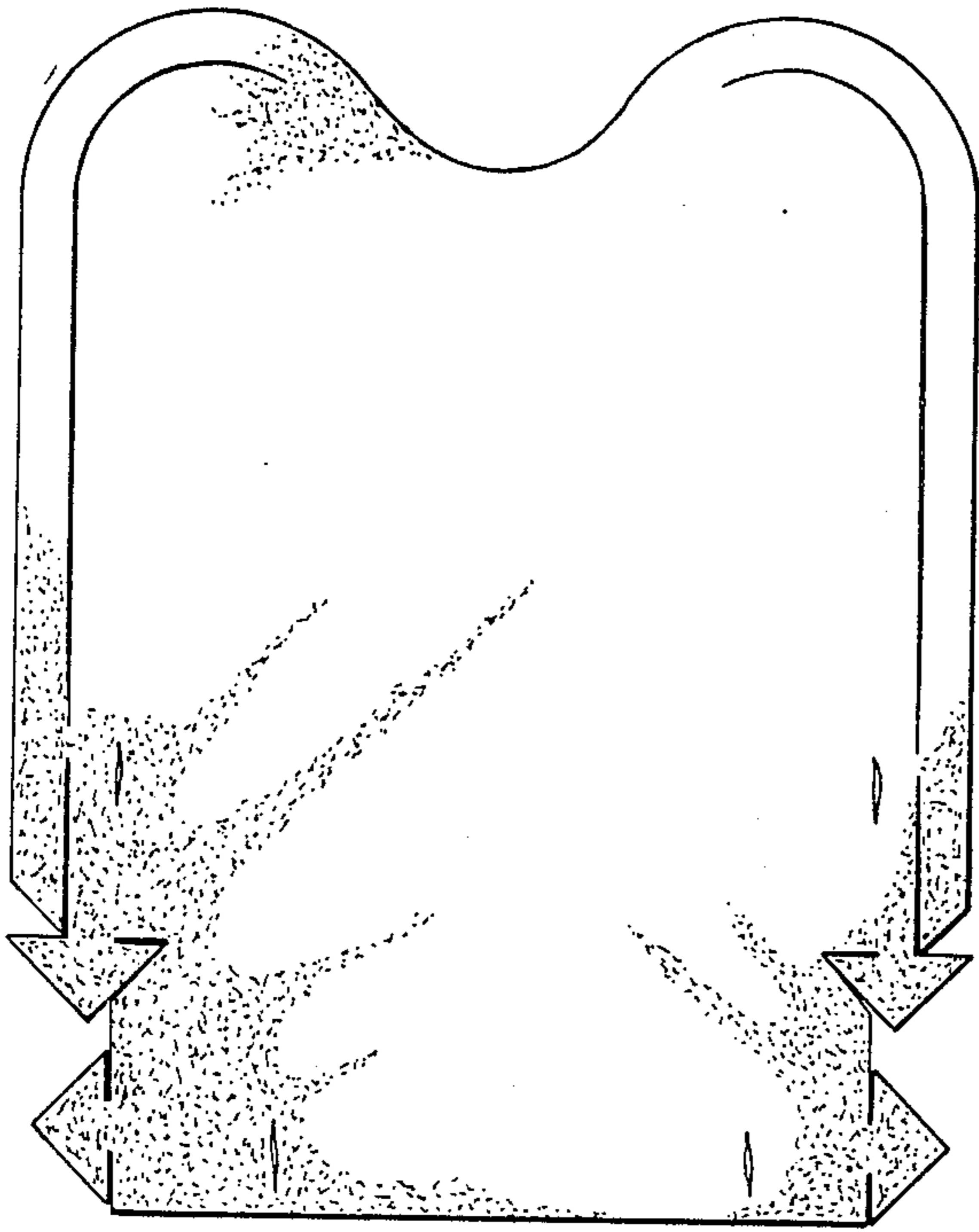

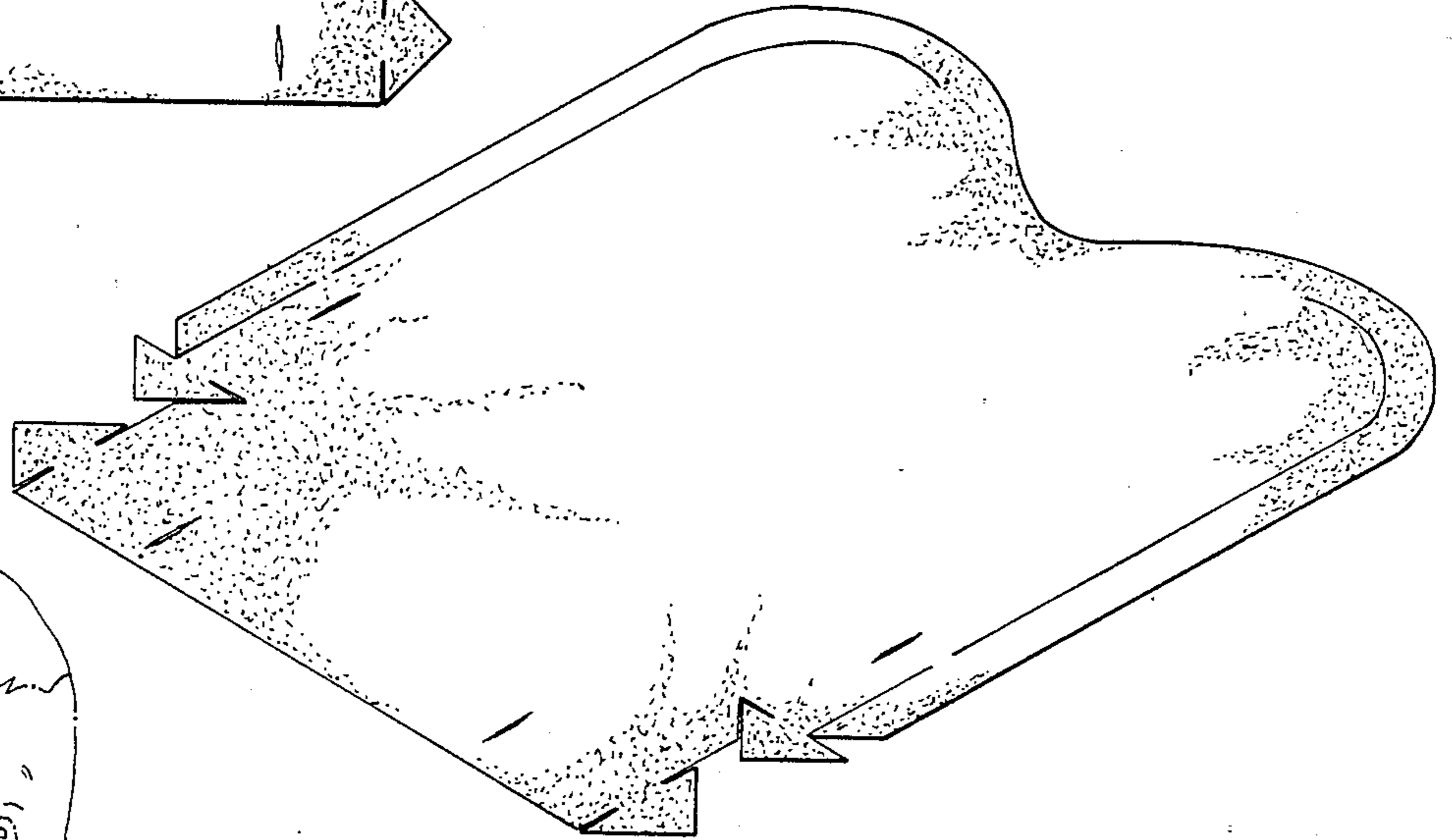
