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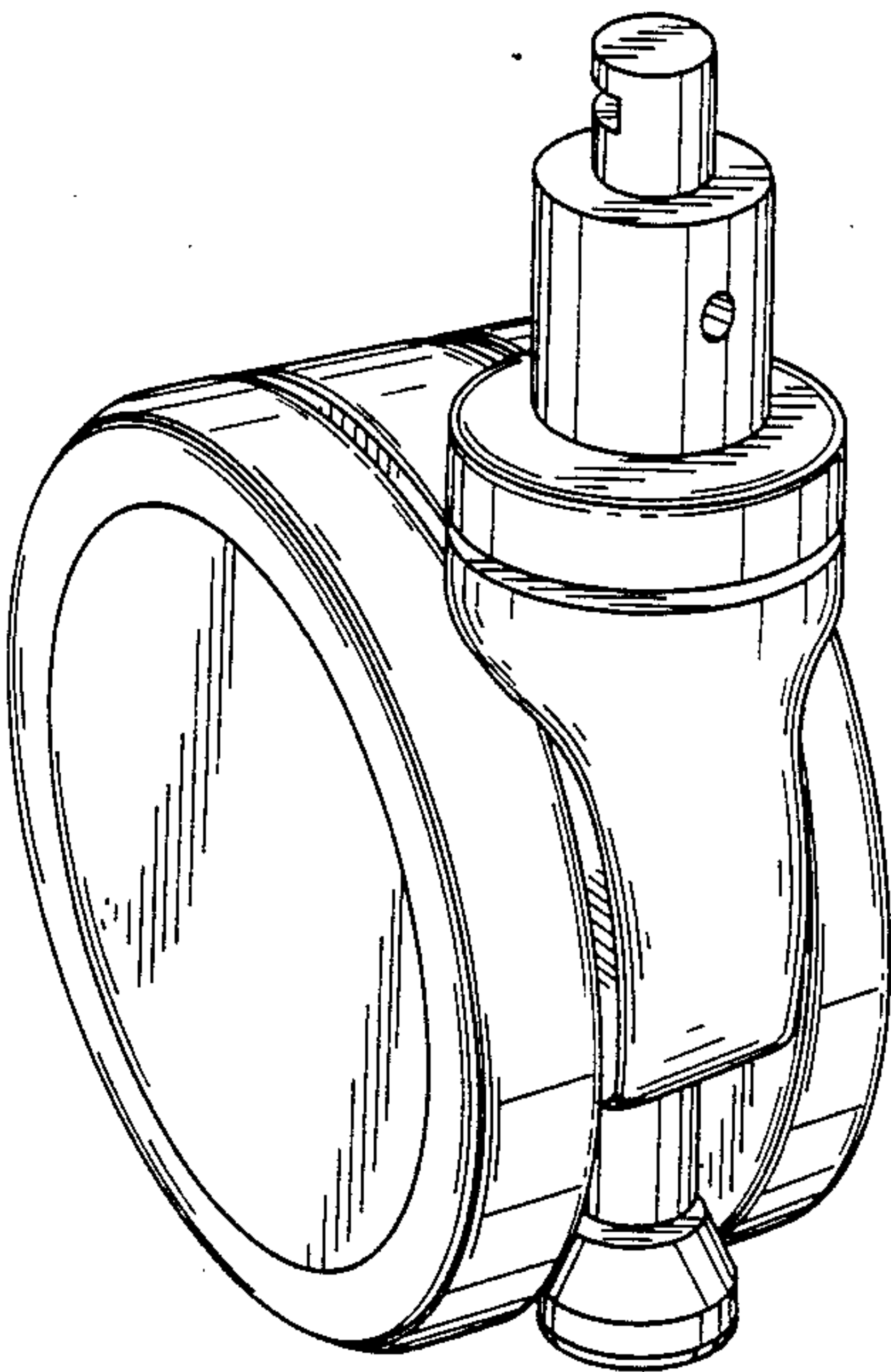
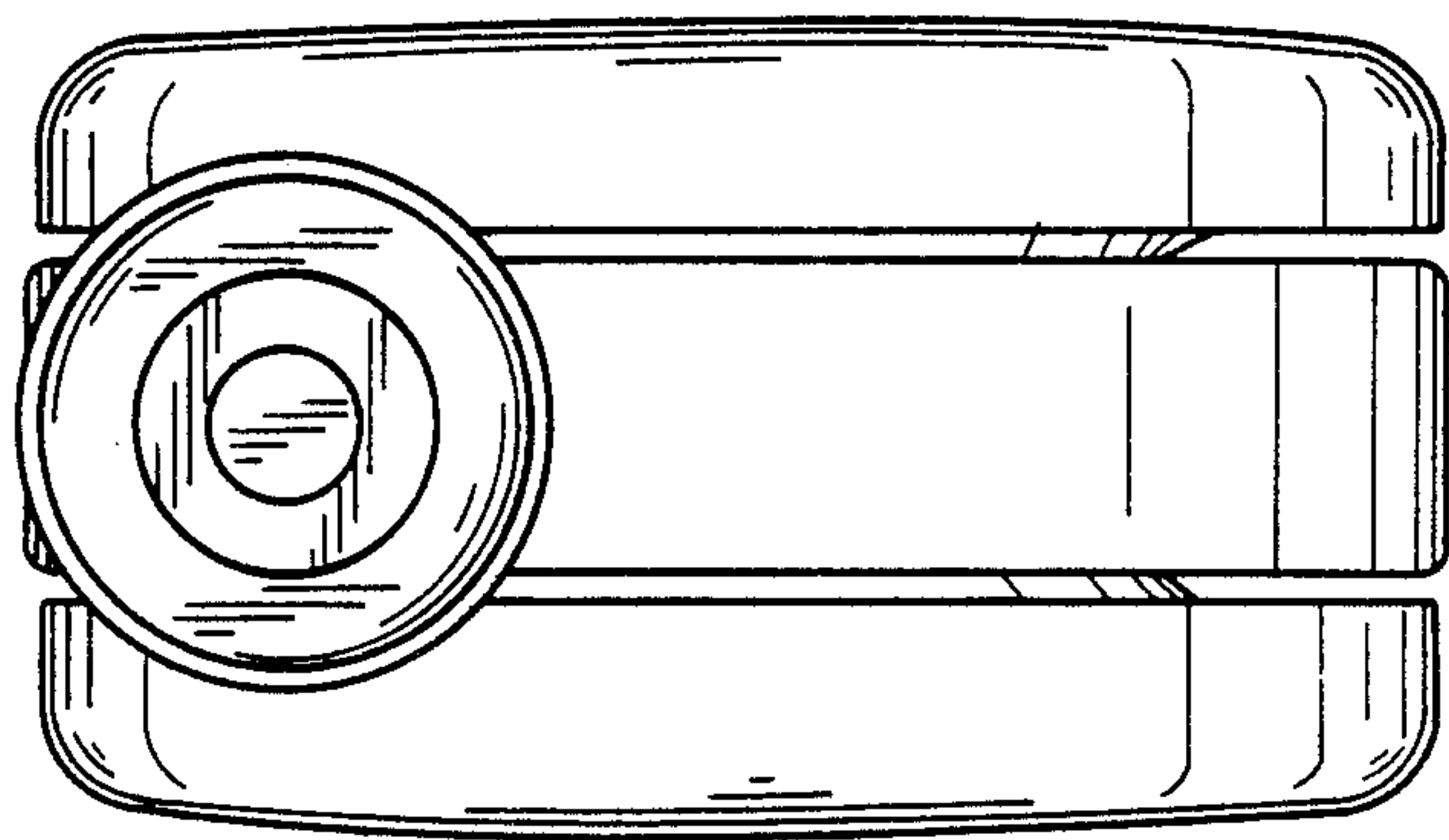

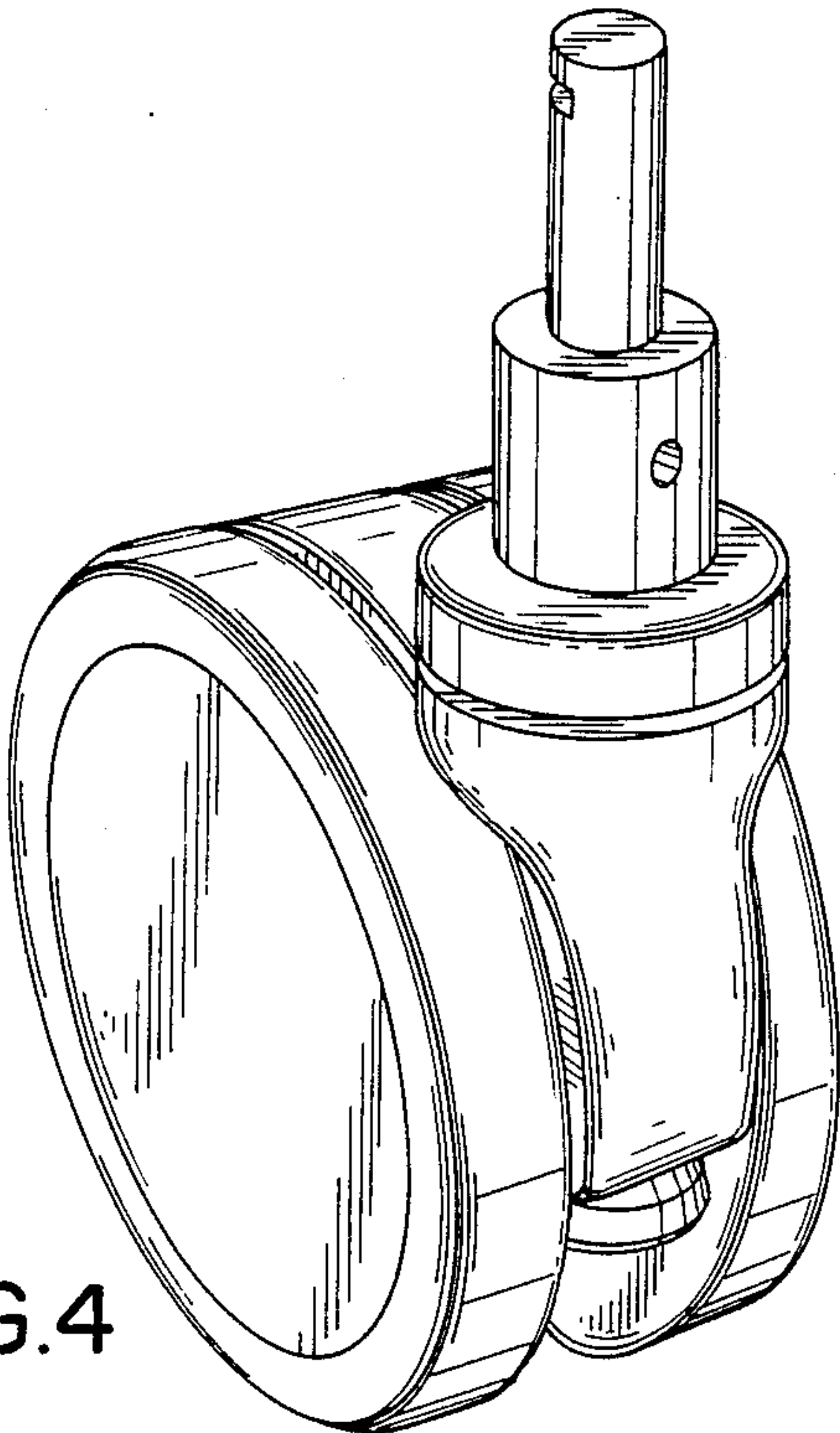
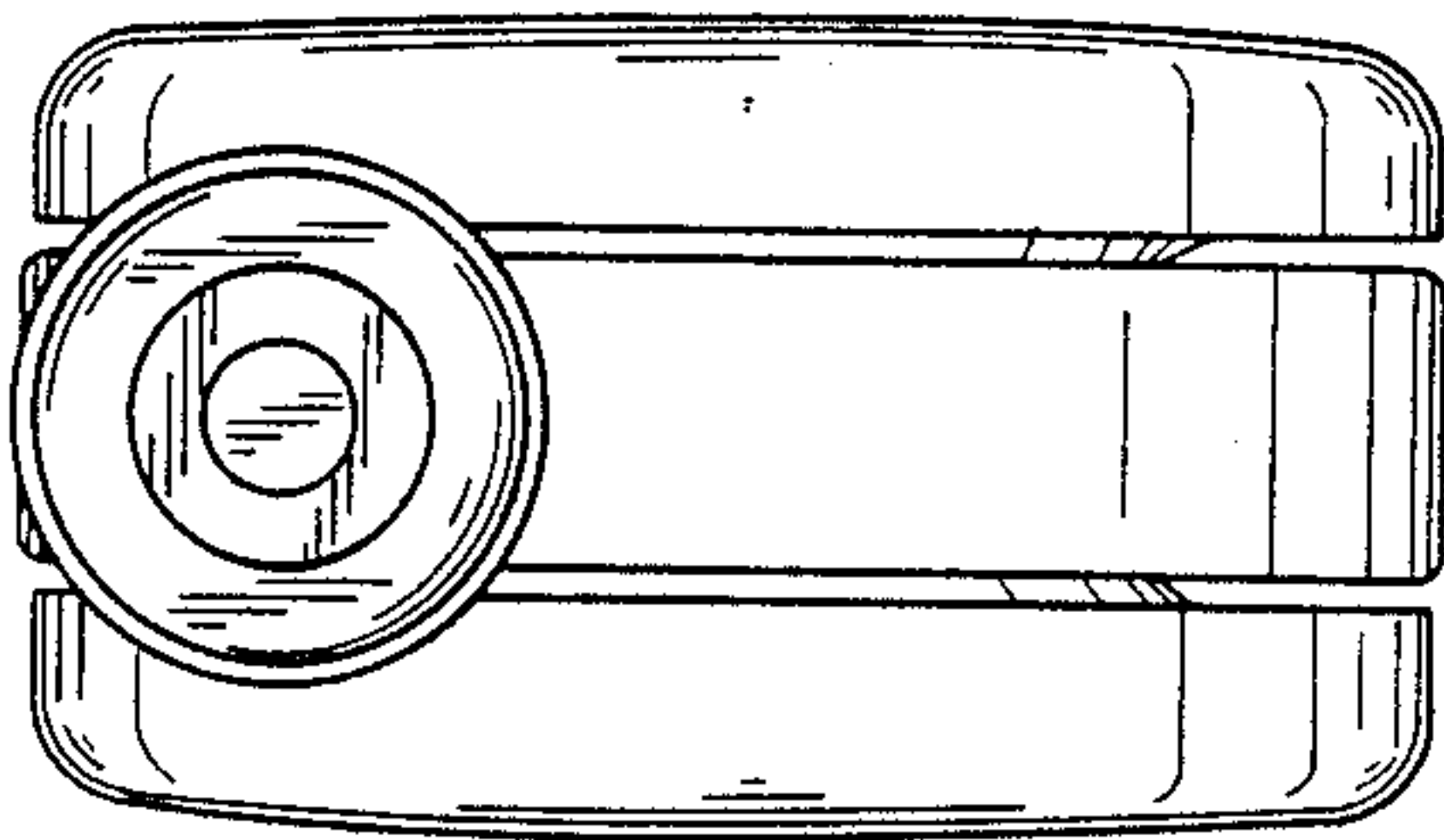
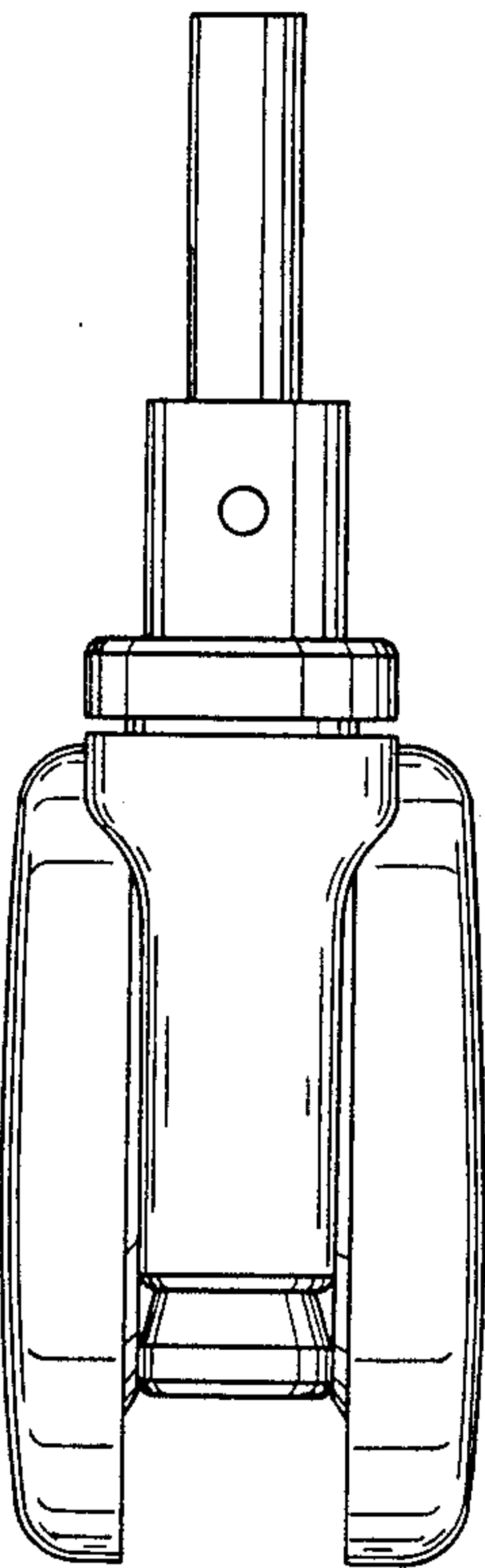
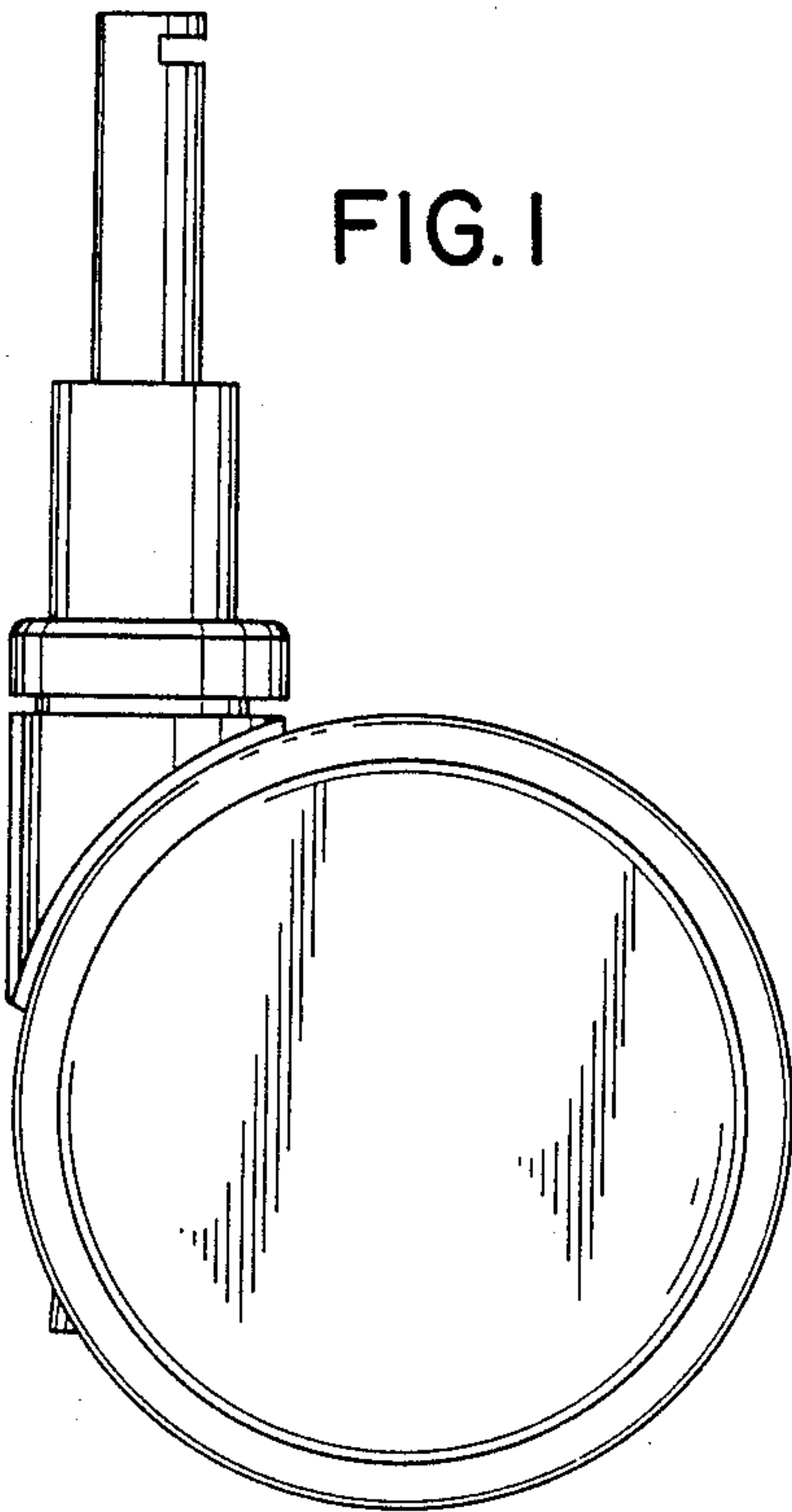
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the castor in the alternative condition.





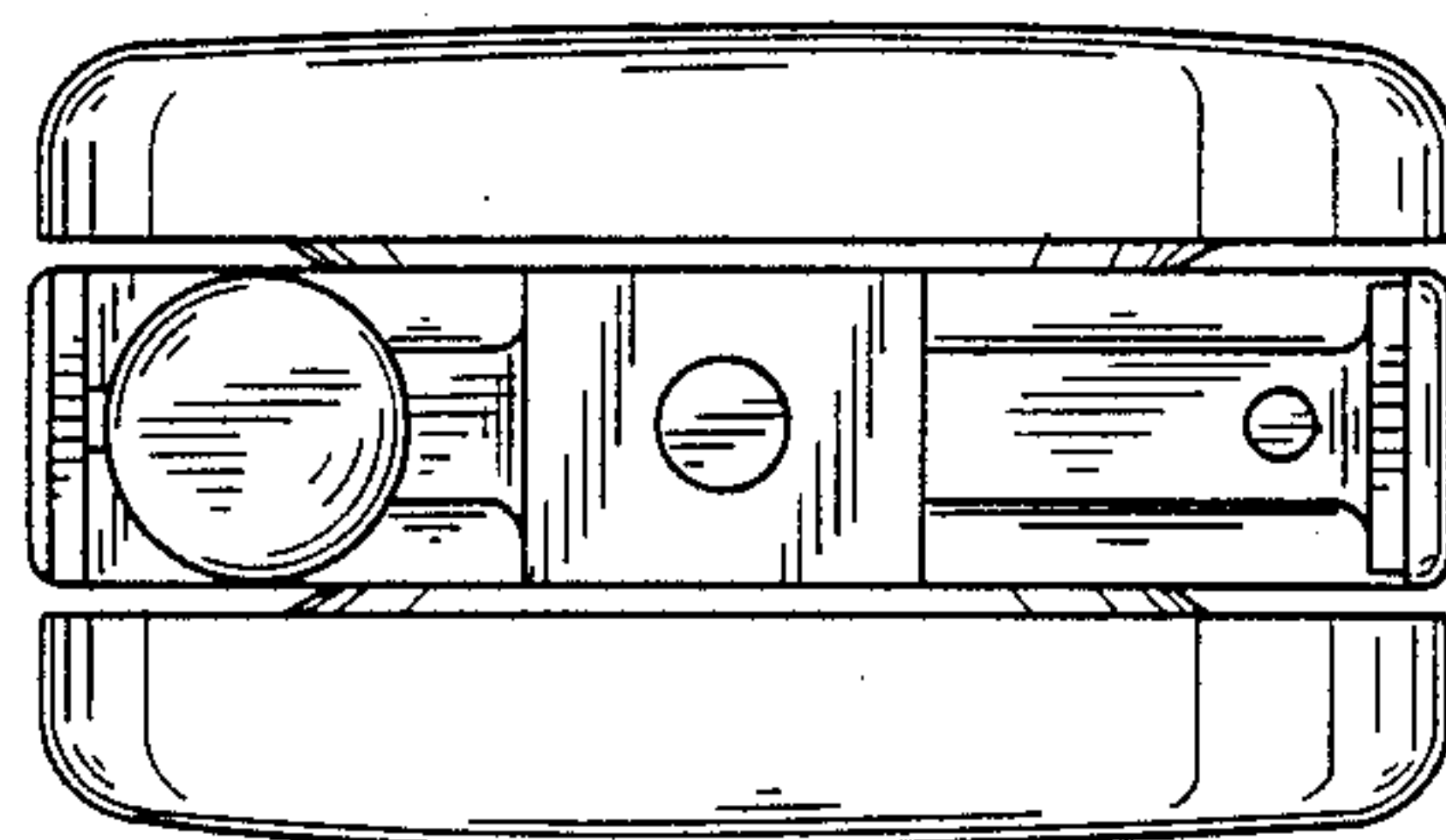
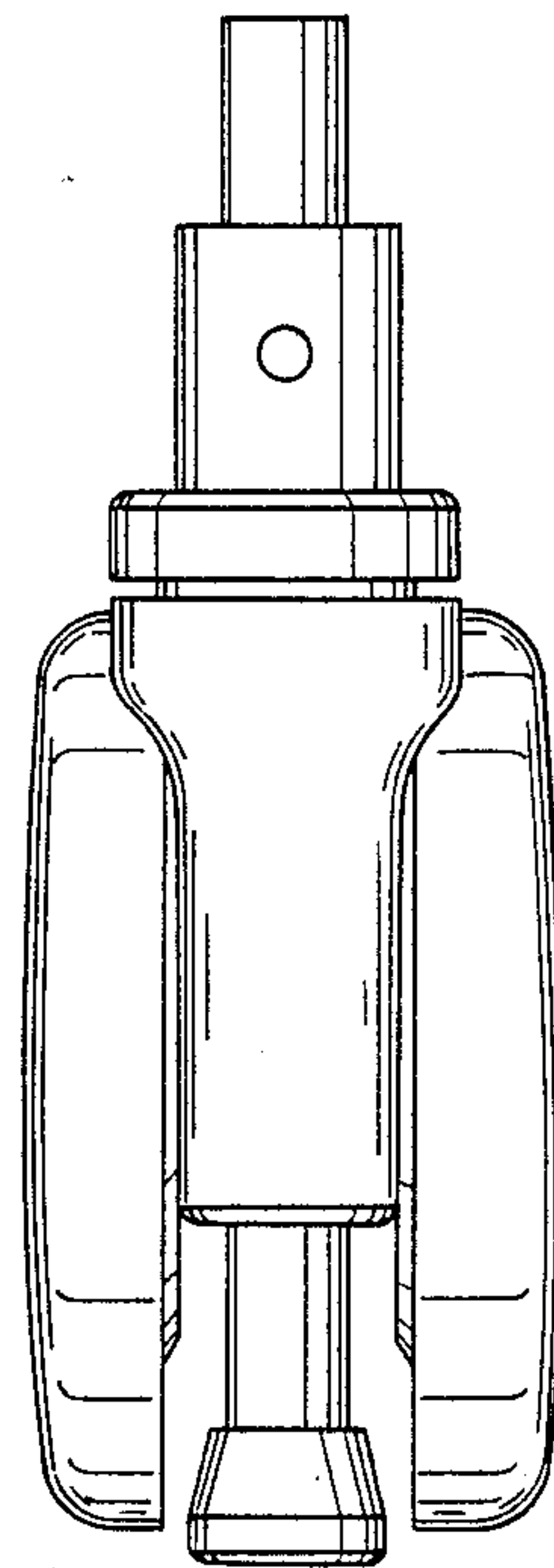
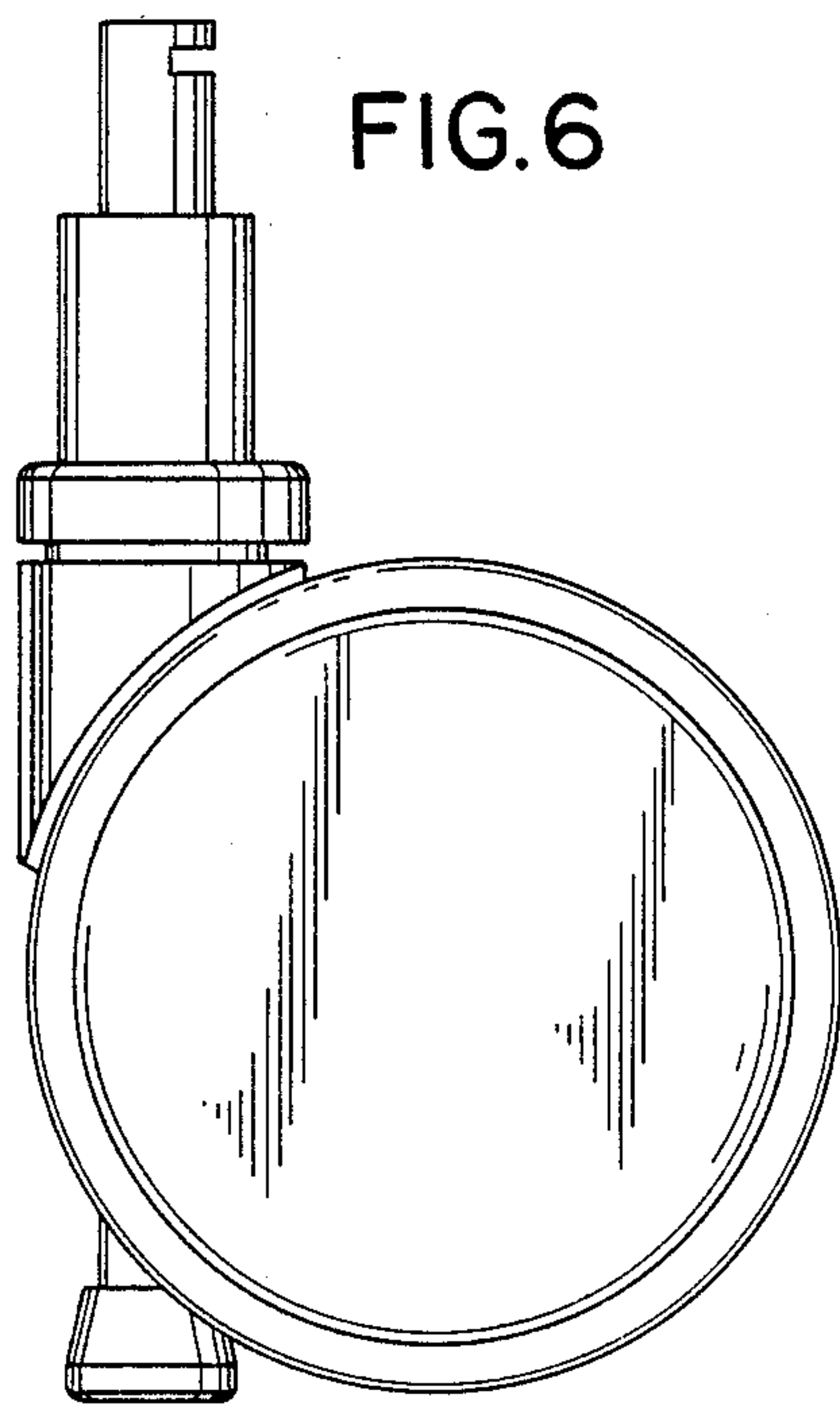
