The rear elevation and the right and left side elevation views are mirror images of the front elevational view.

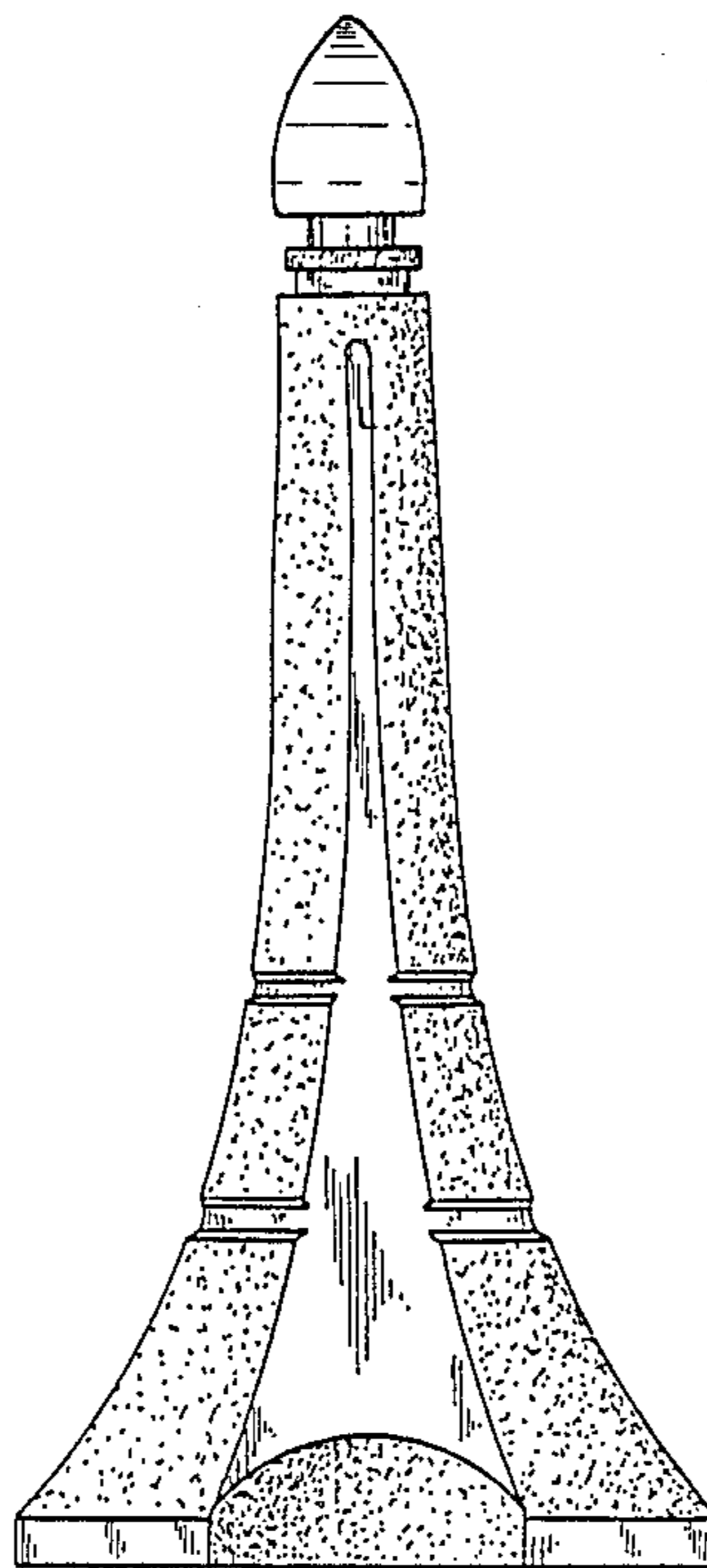

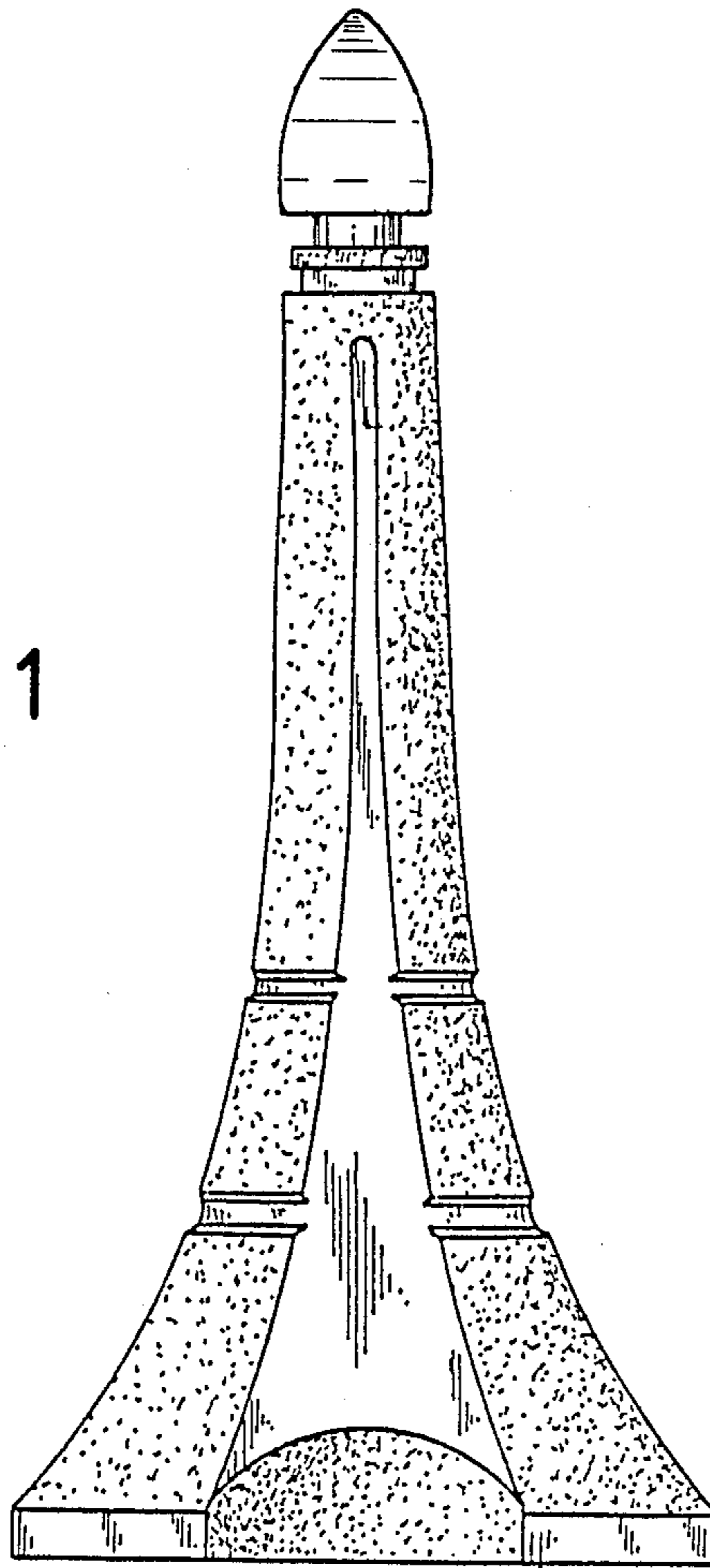
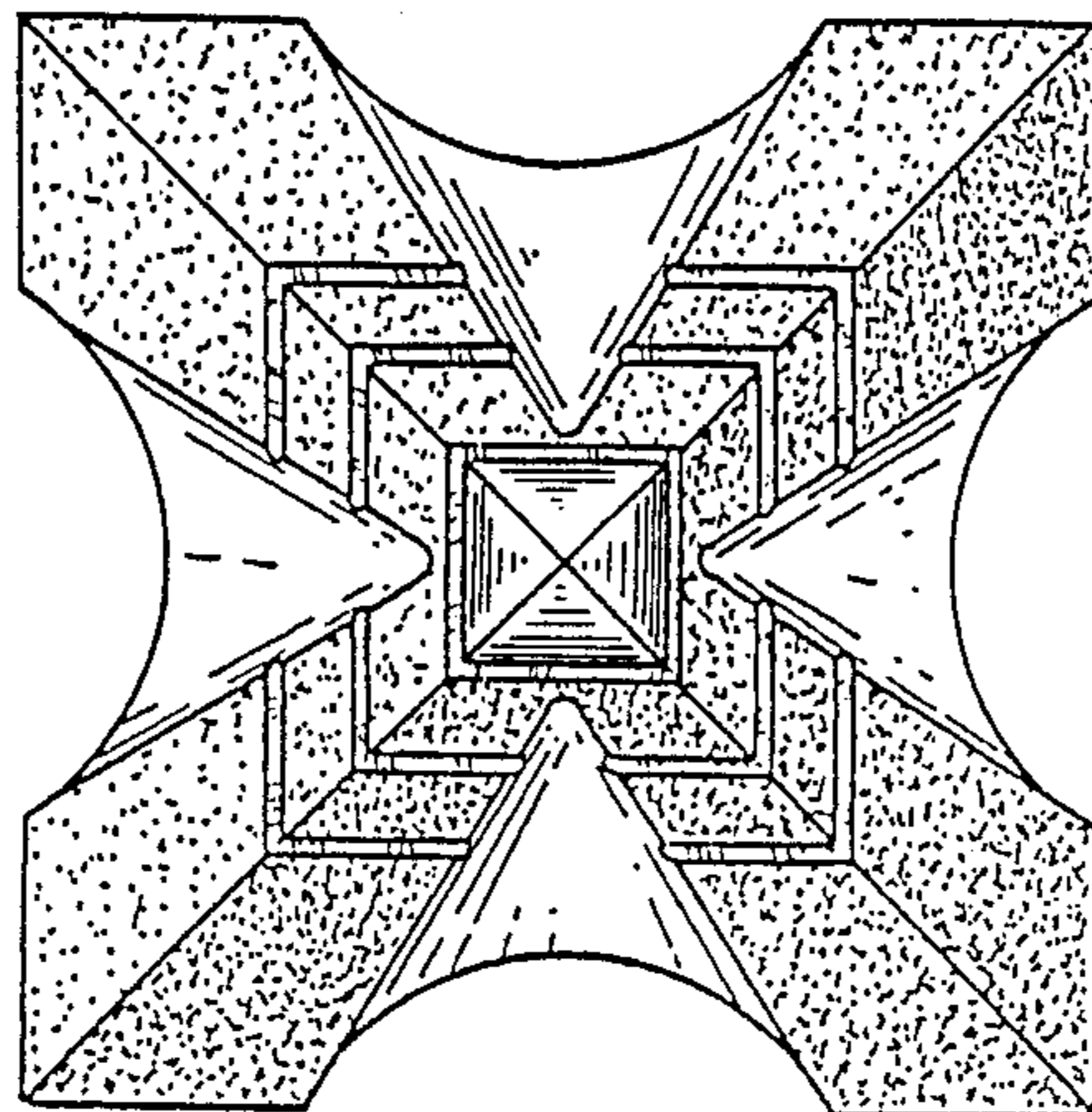

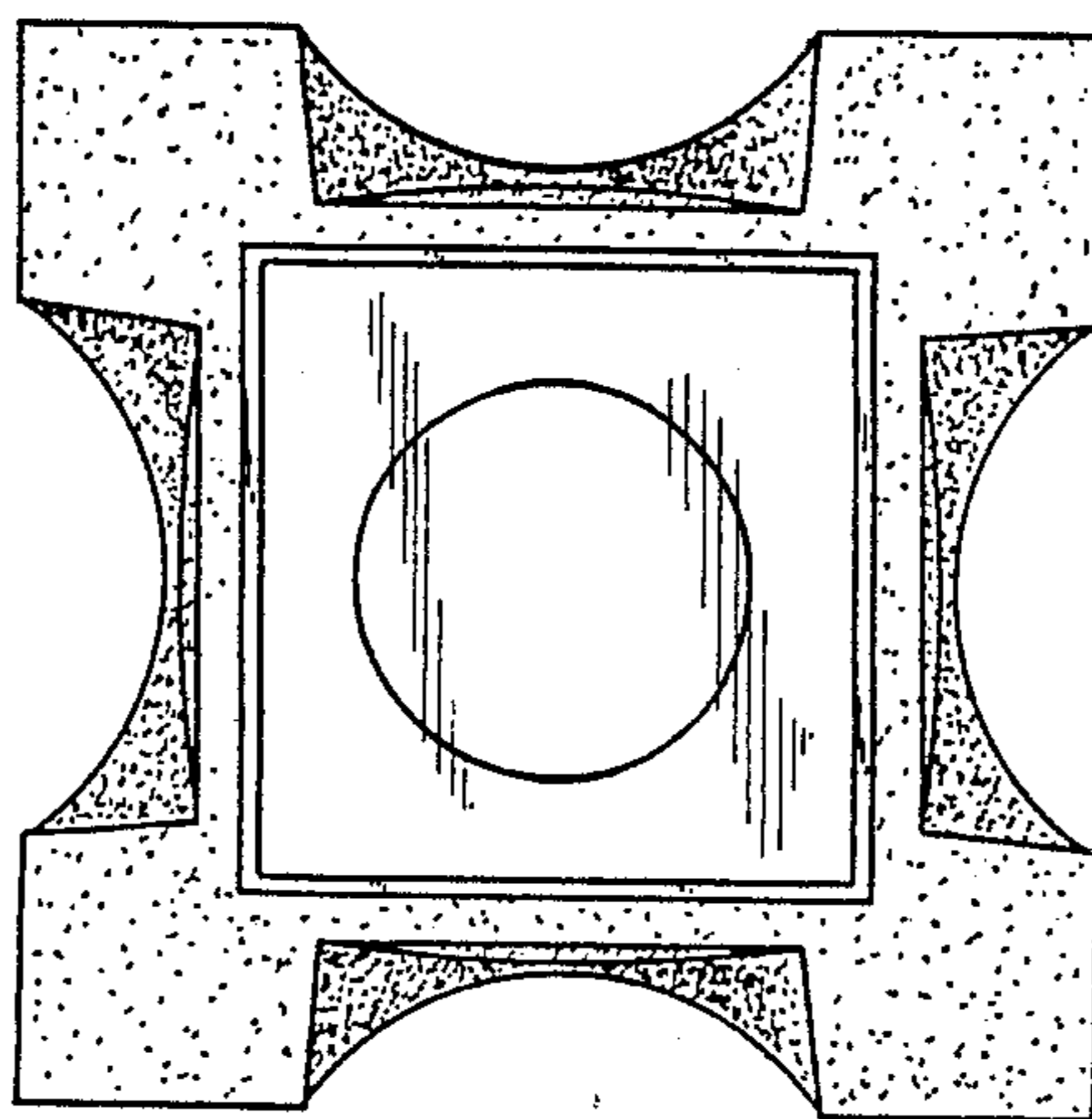
