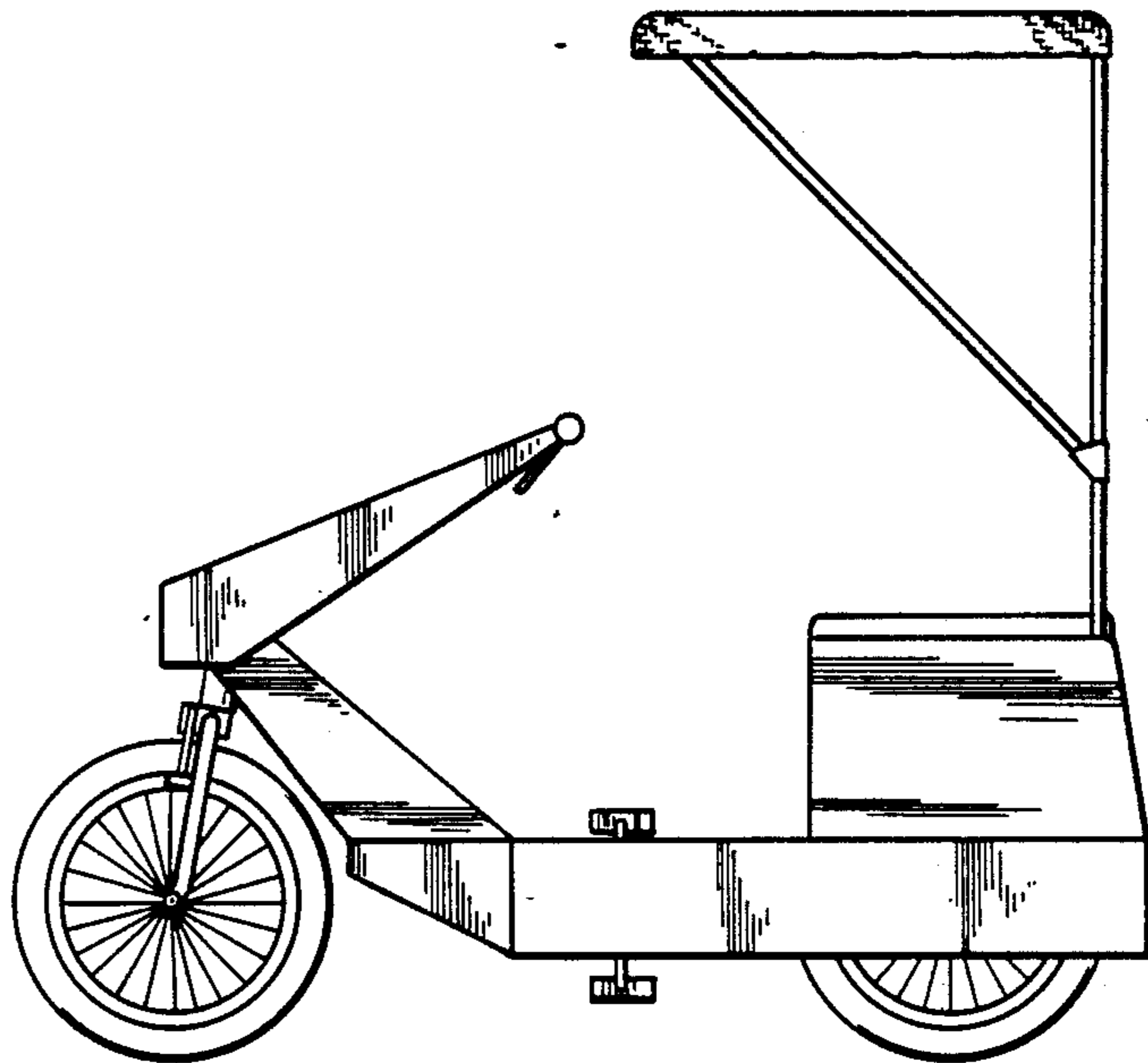
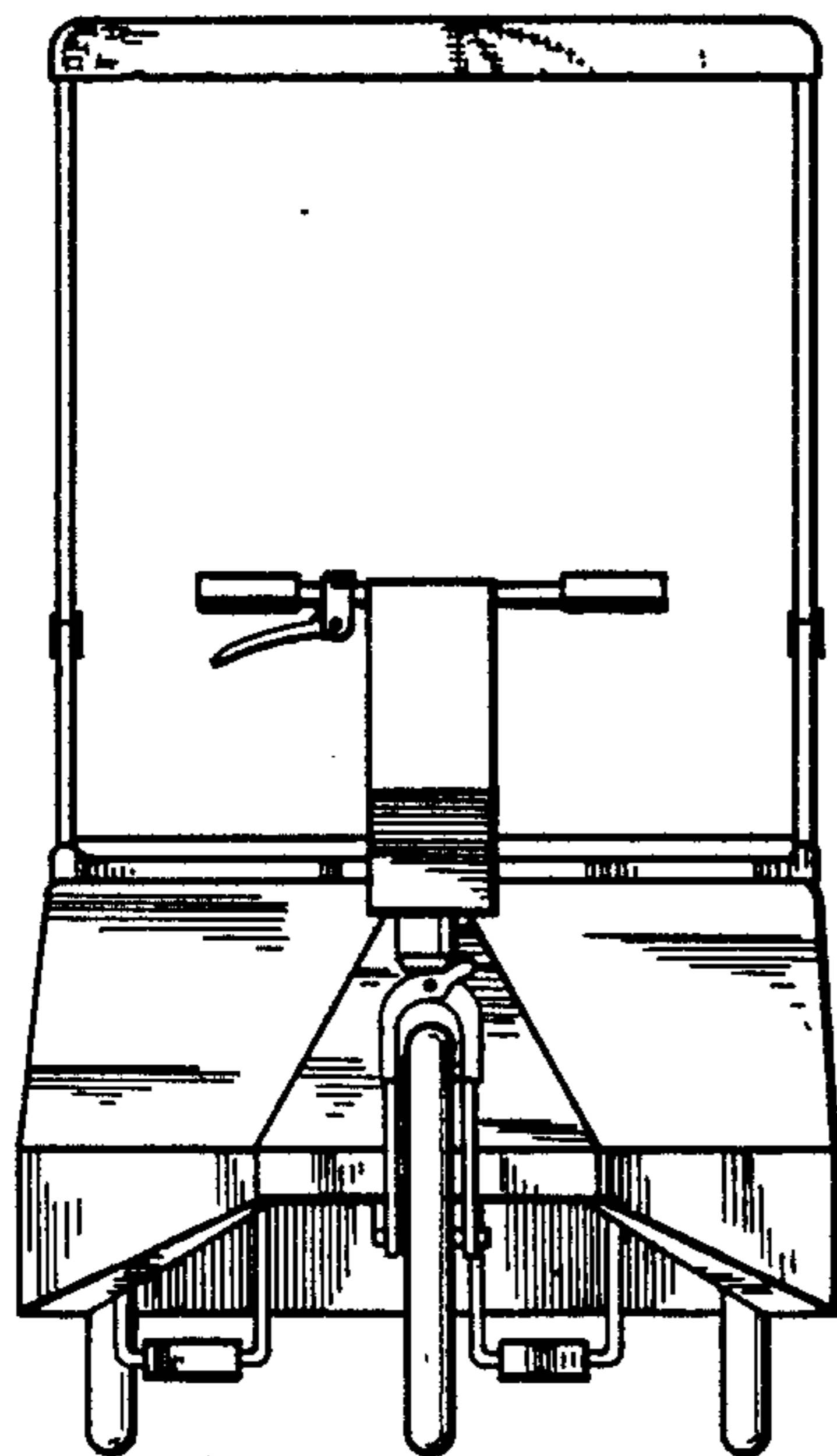

The ornamental design for a tricycle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a tricycle showing our new design.  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof.  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof.  
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof with the seat compartment in open condition.  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
 FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of a tricycle showing a second embodiment of our new design.  
 FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 7.  
 FIG. 9 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 7.

 FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7.



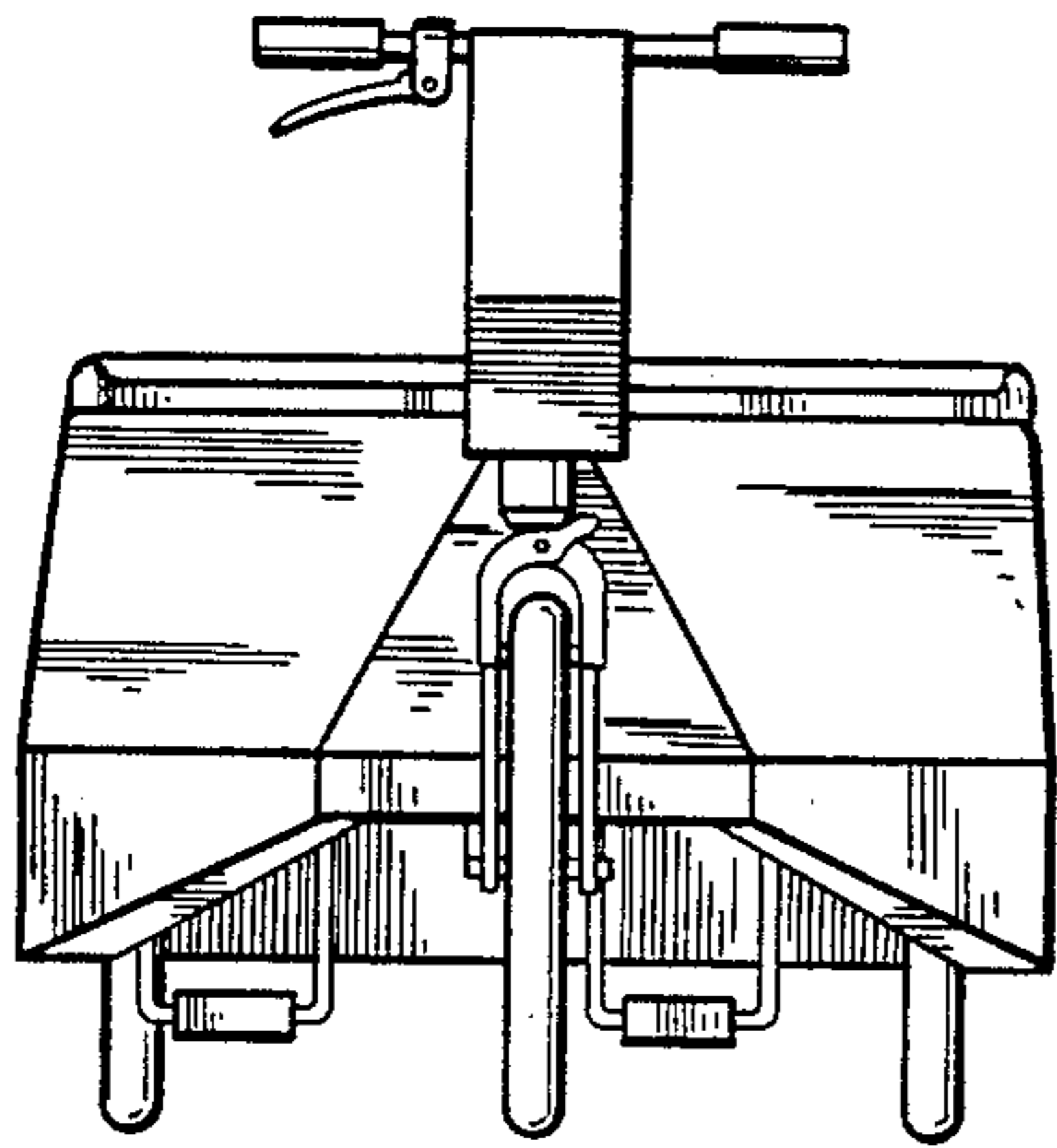

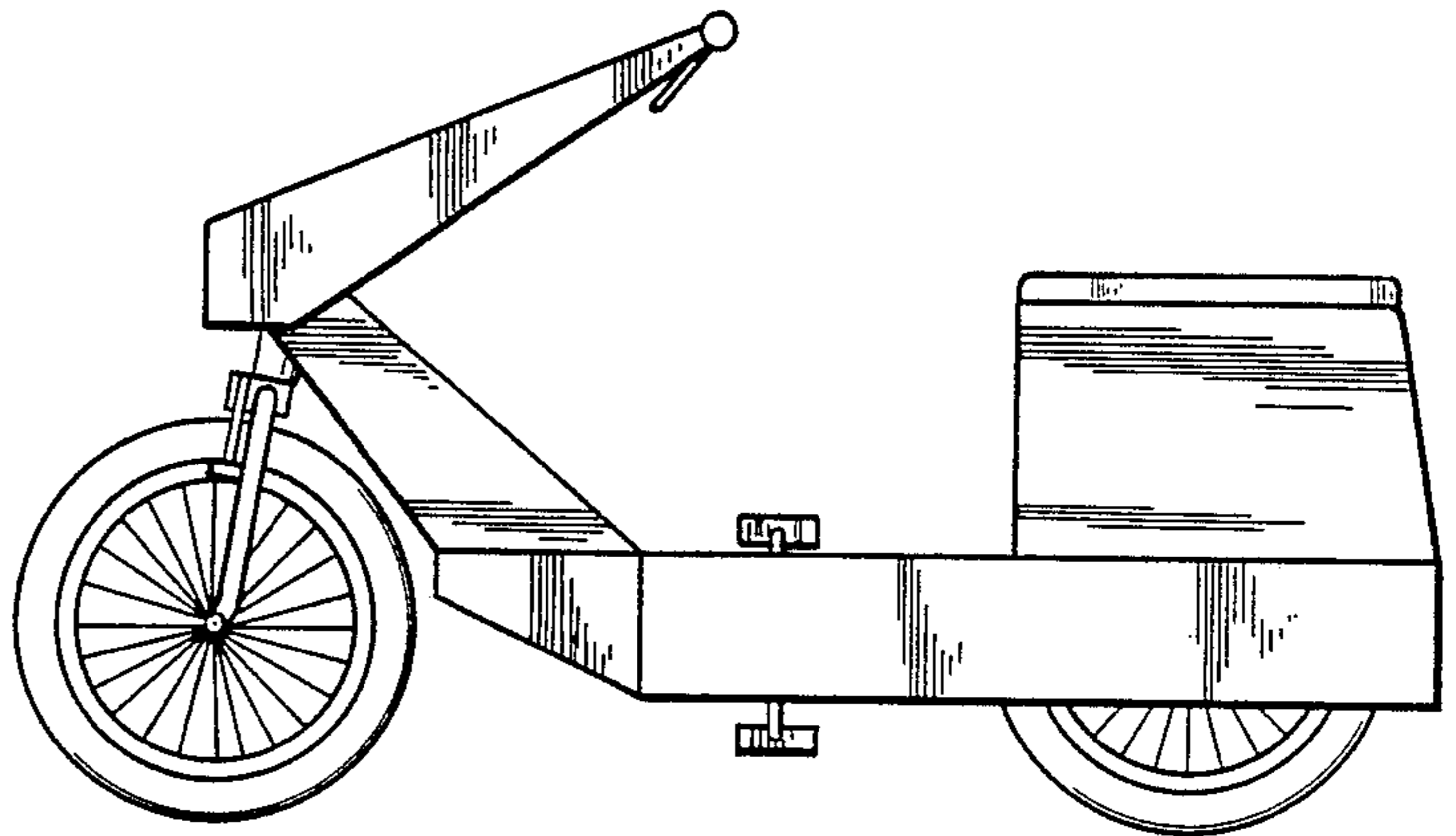

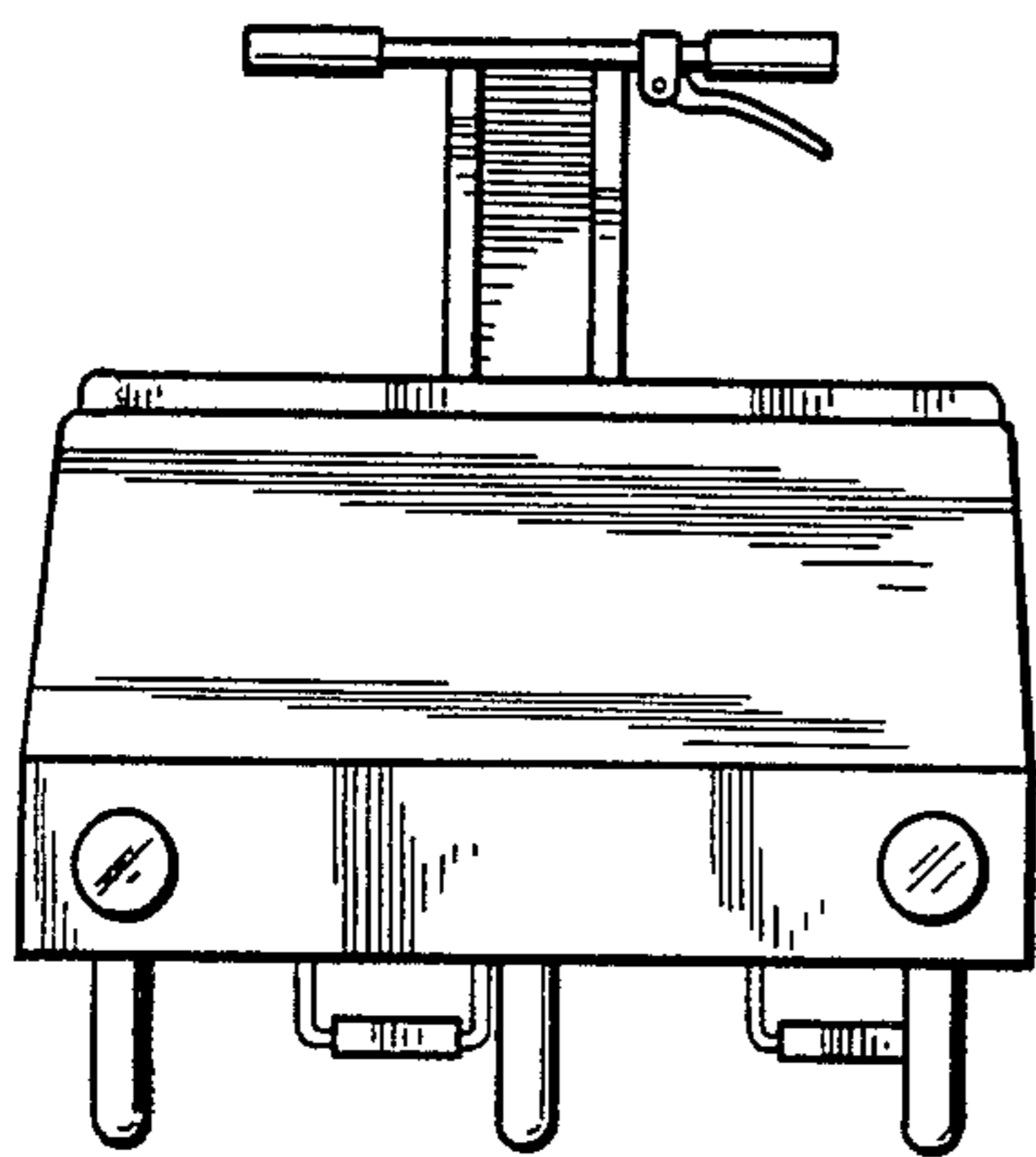

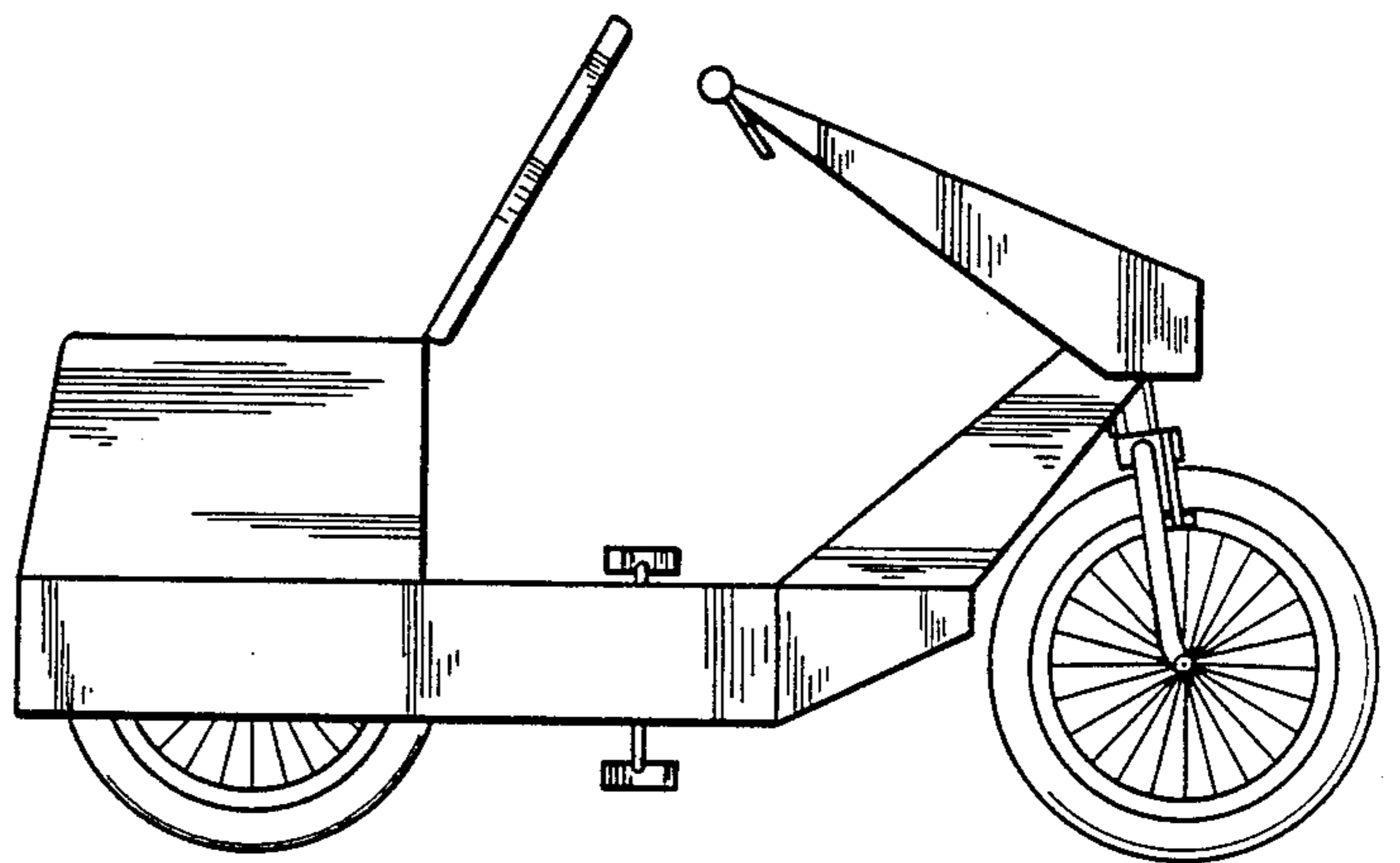

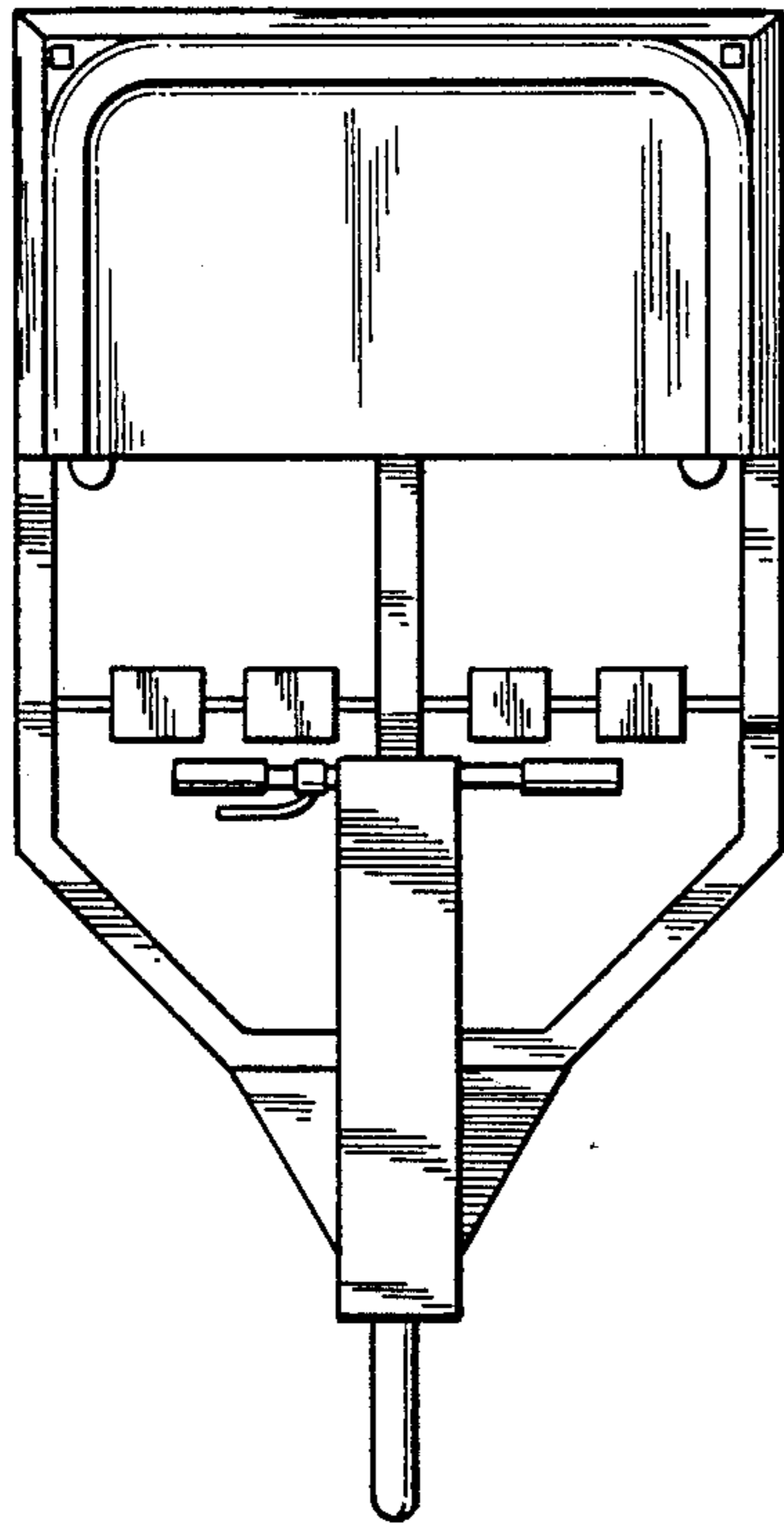

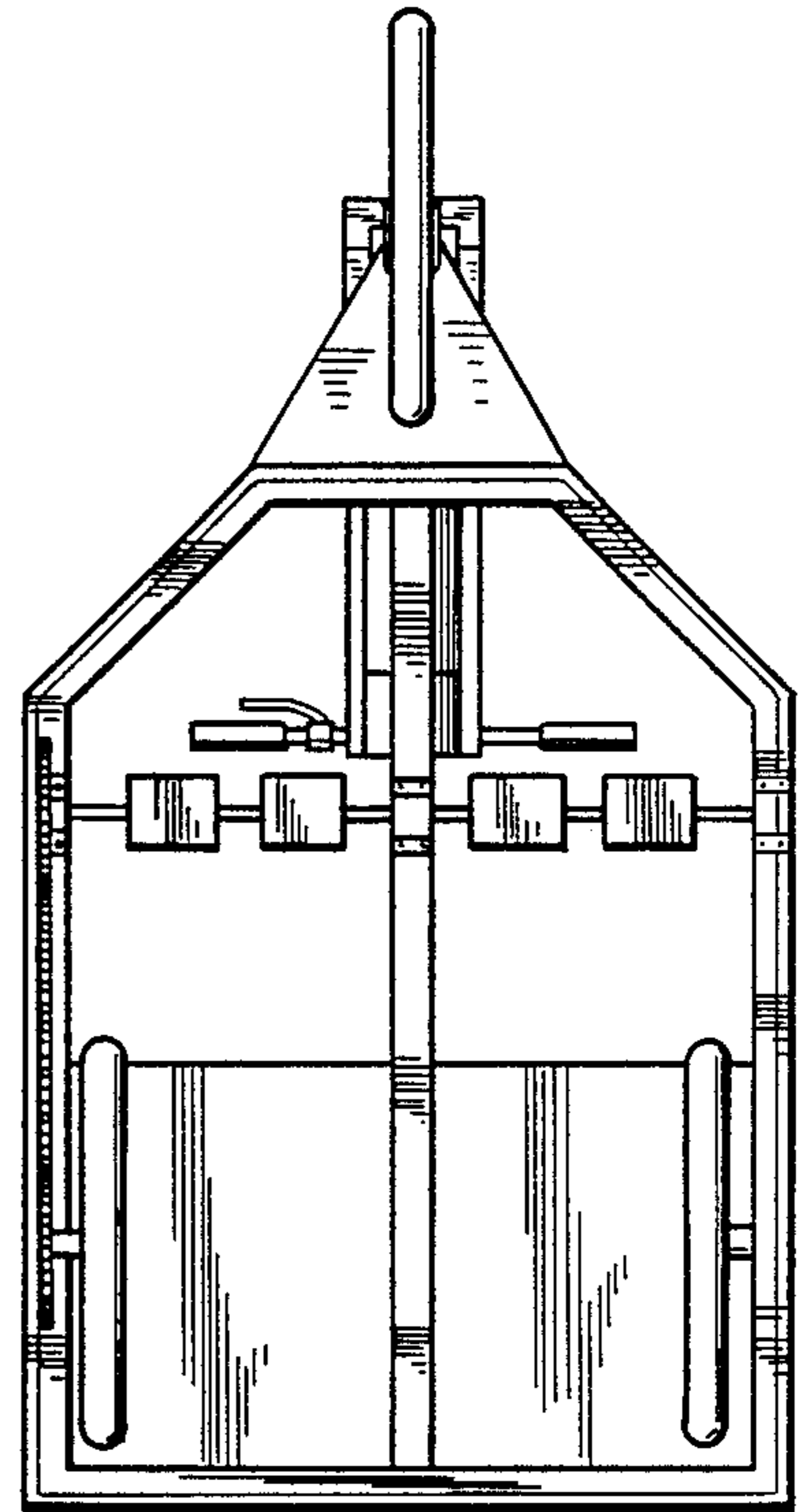

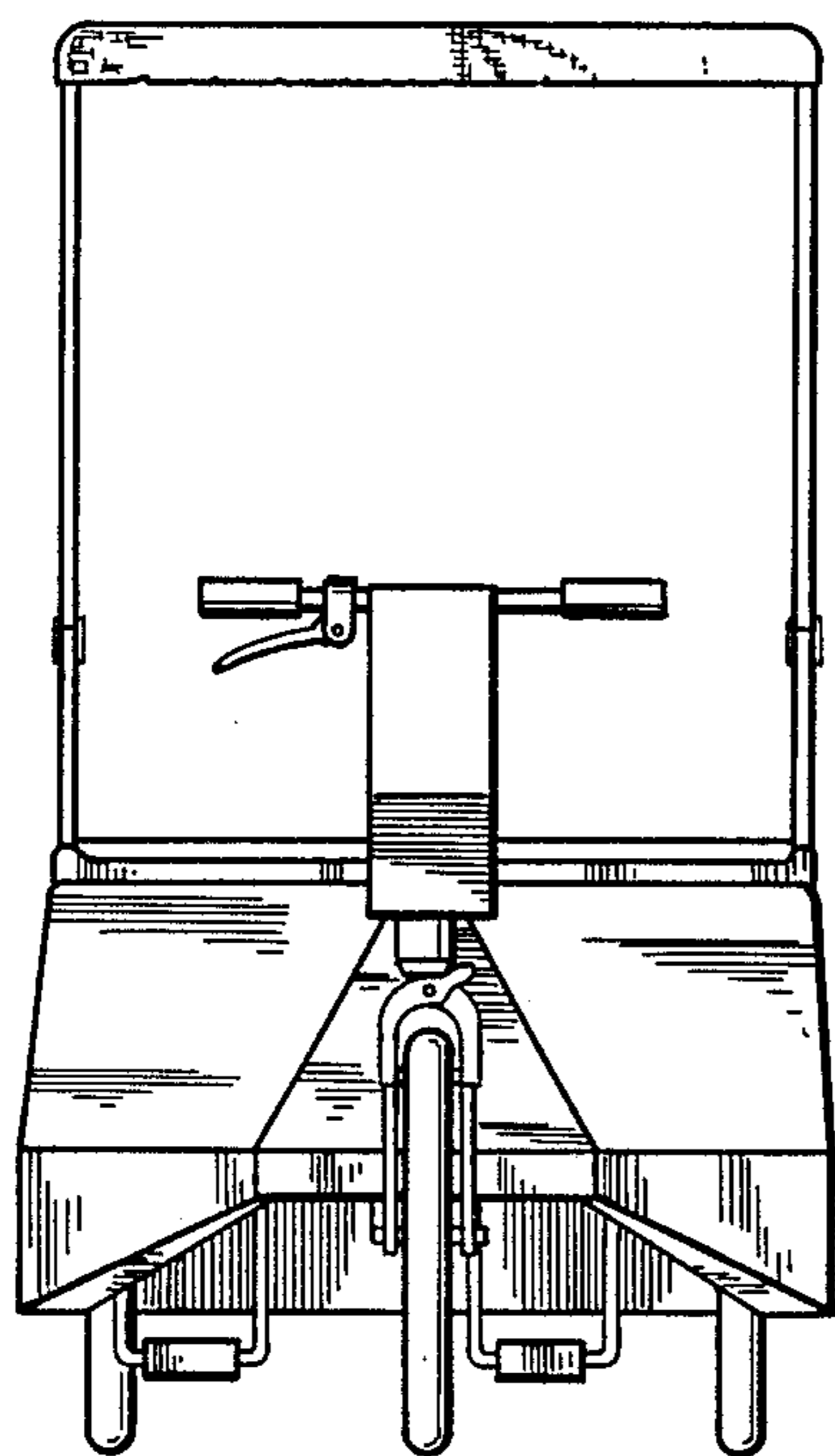

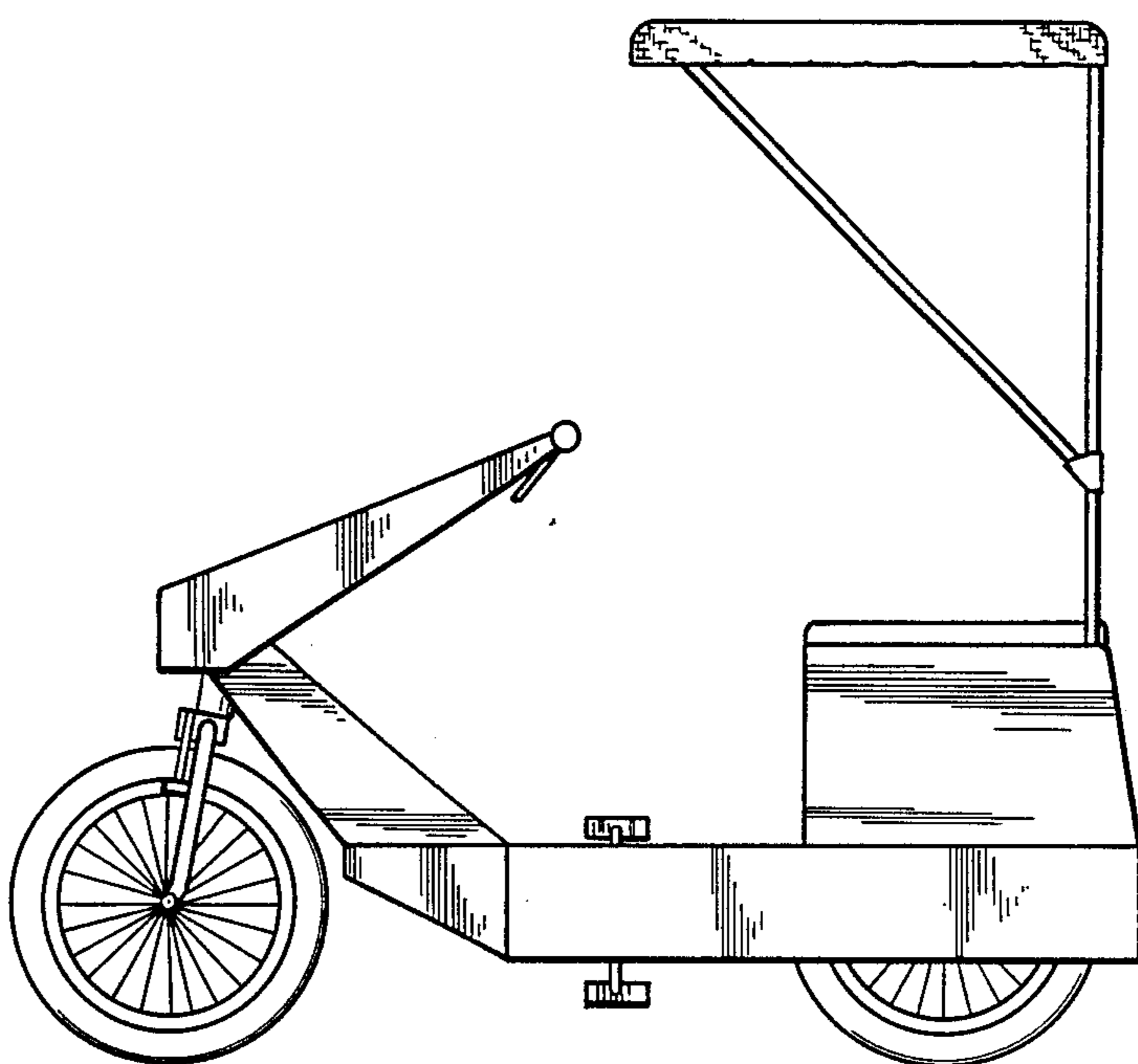

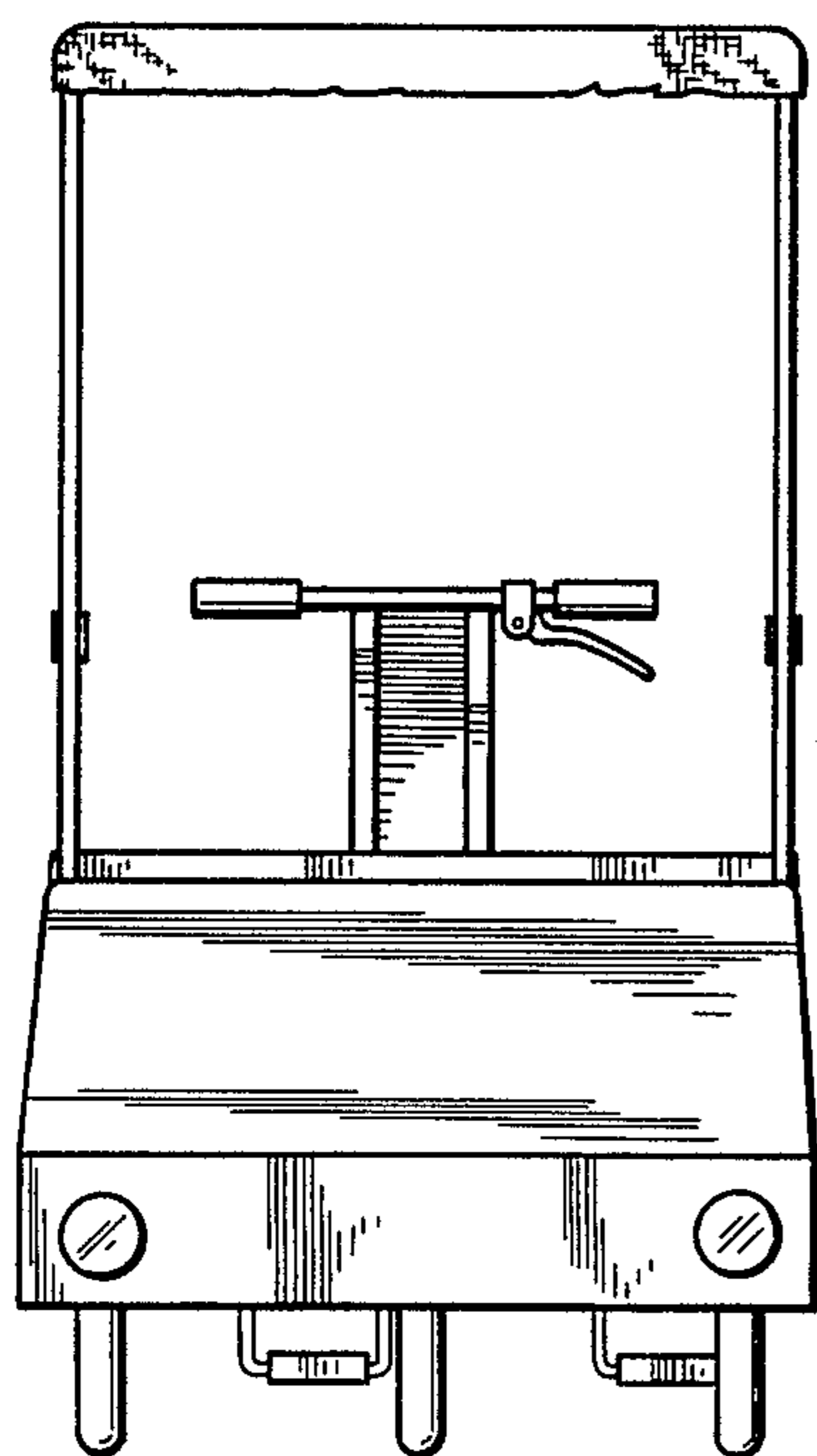

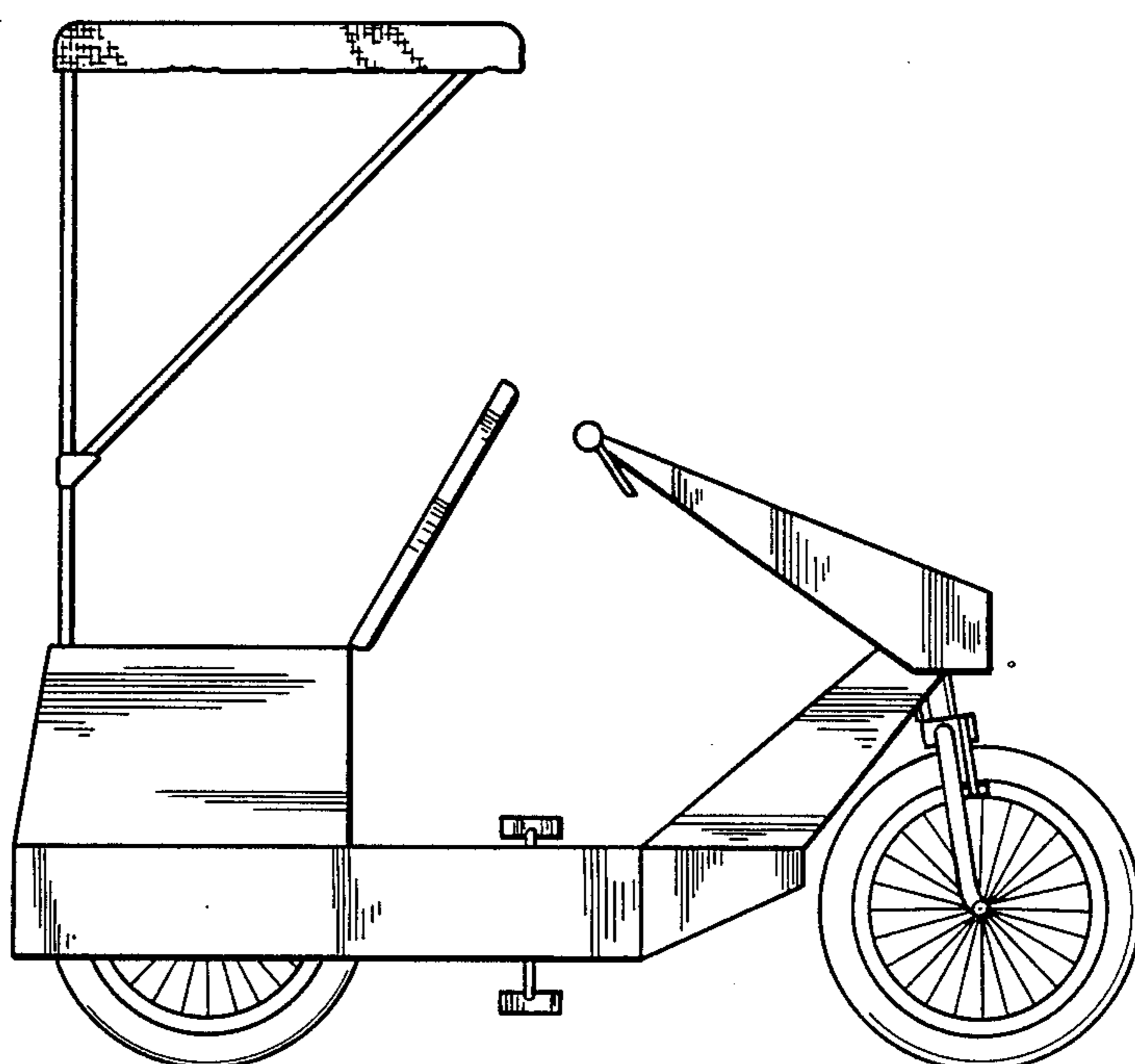

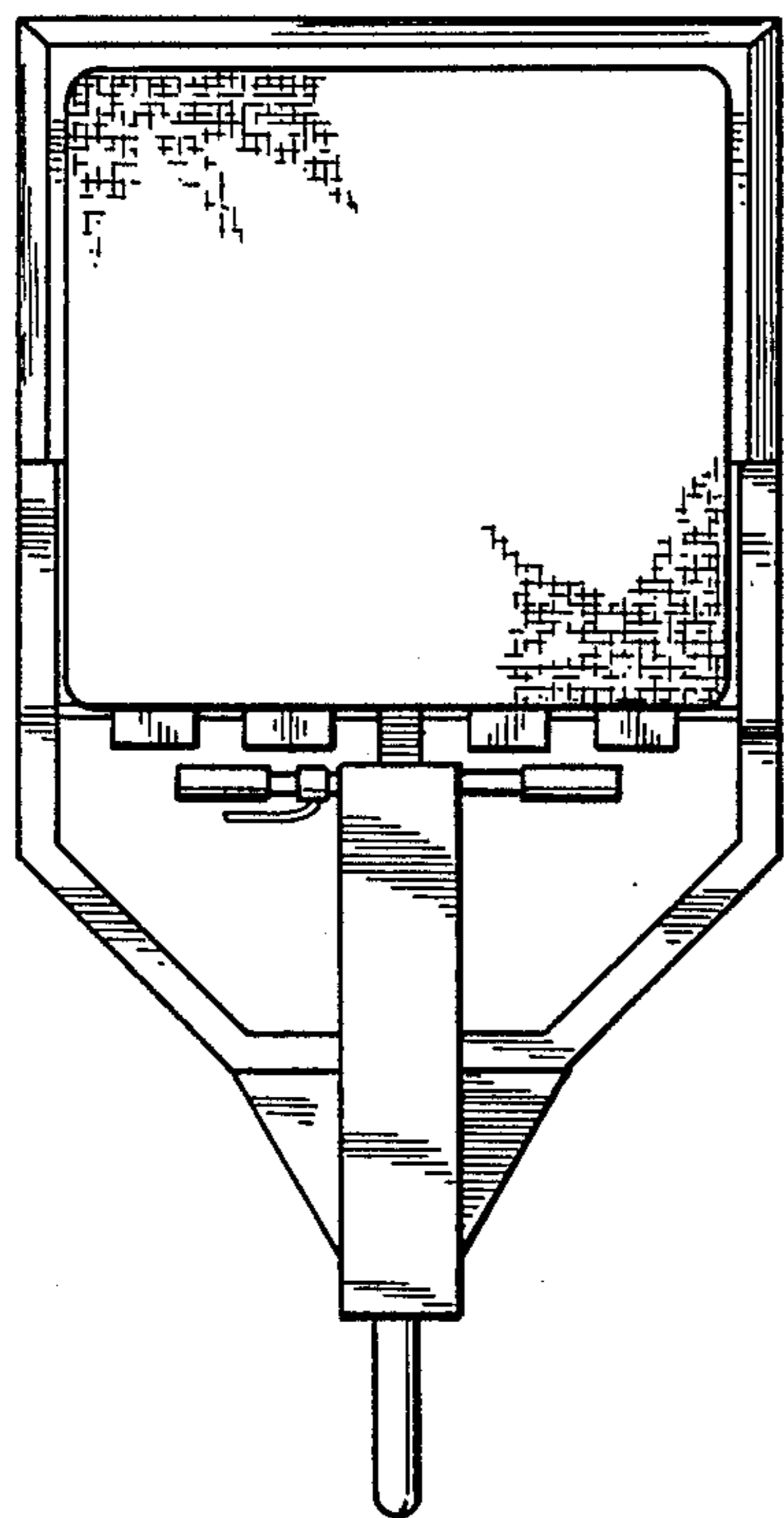

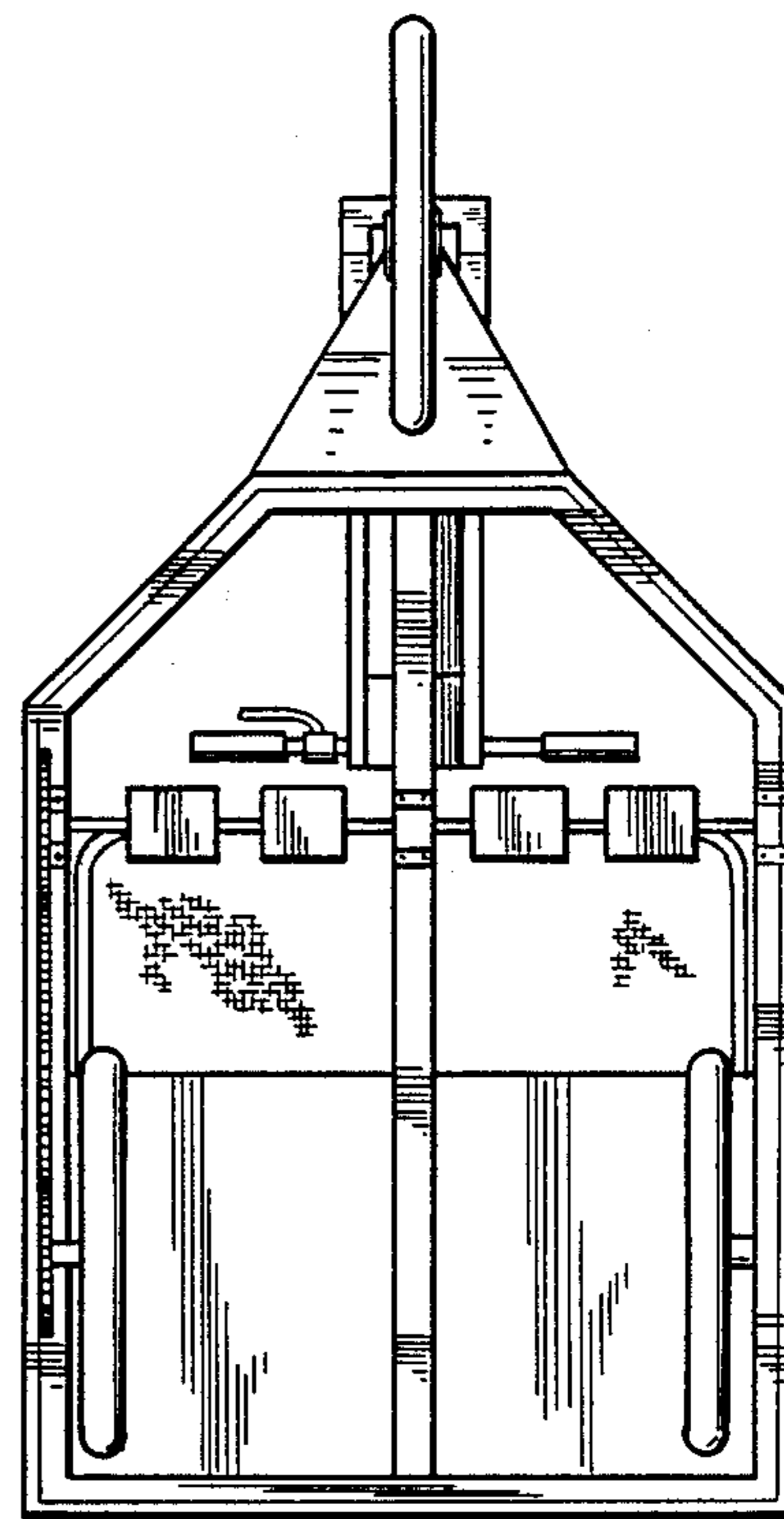
