[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a notepaper dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a notepaper dispenser showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the other side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of FIG. 6, the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 6.

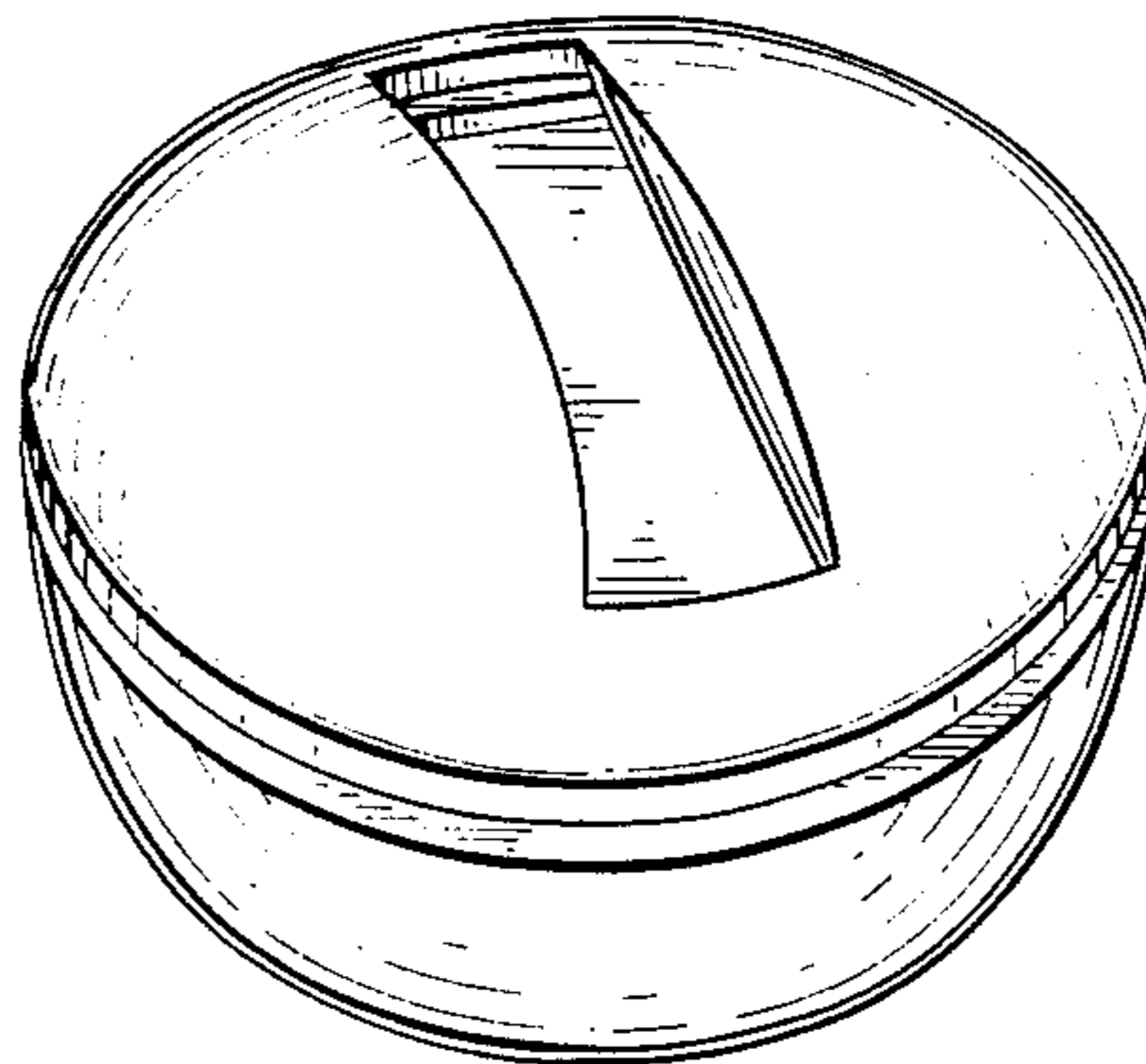

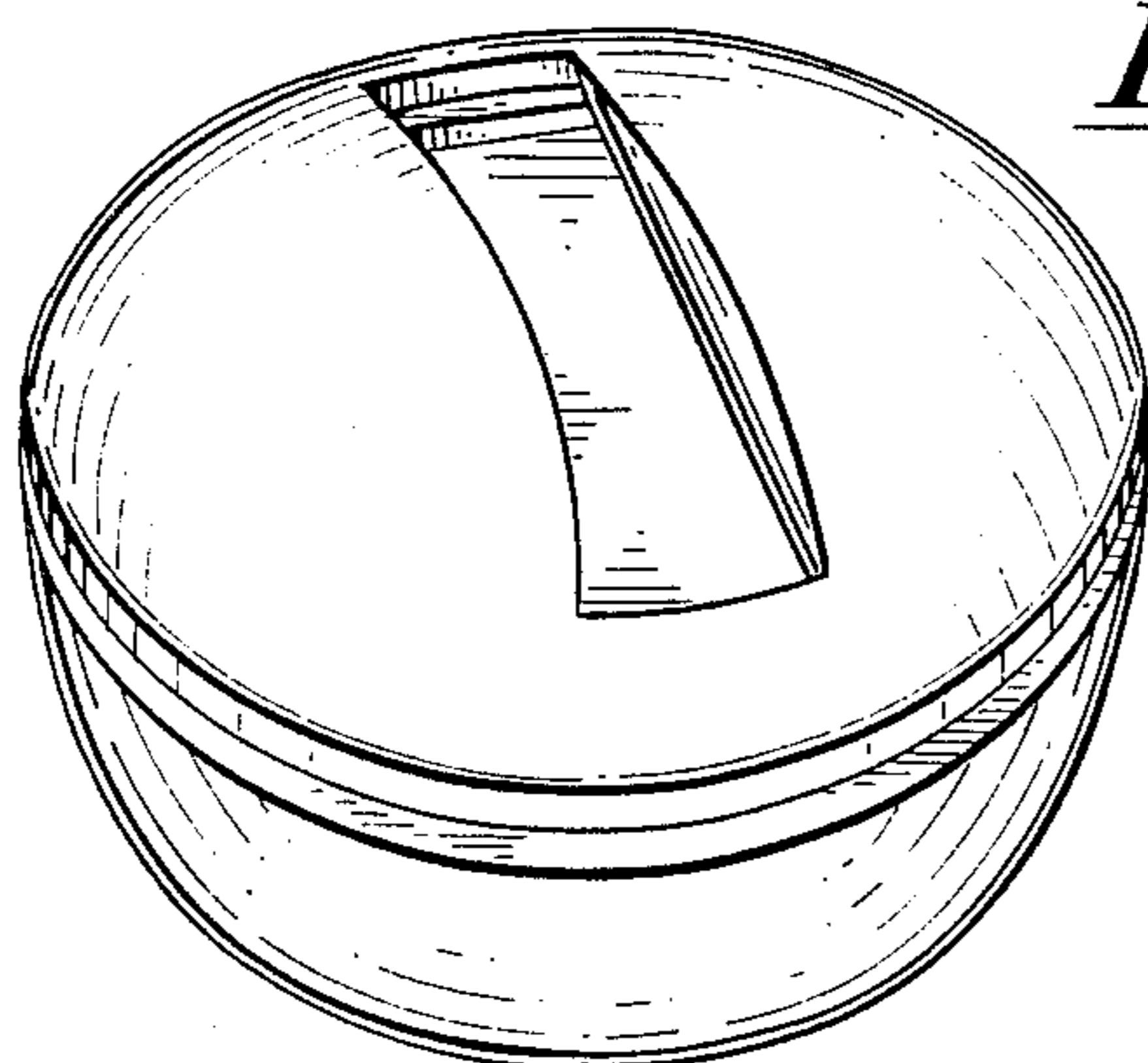

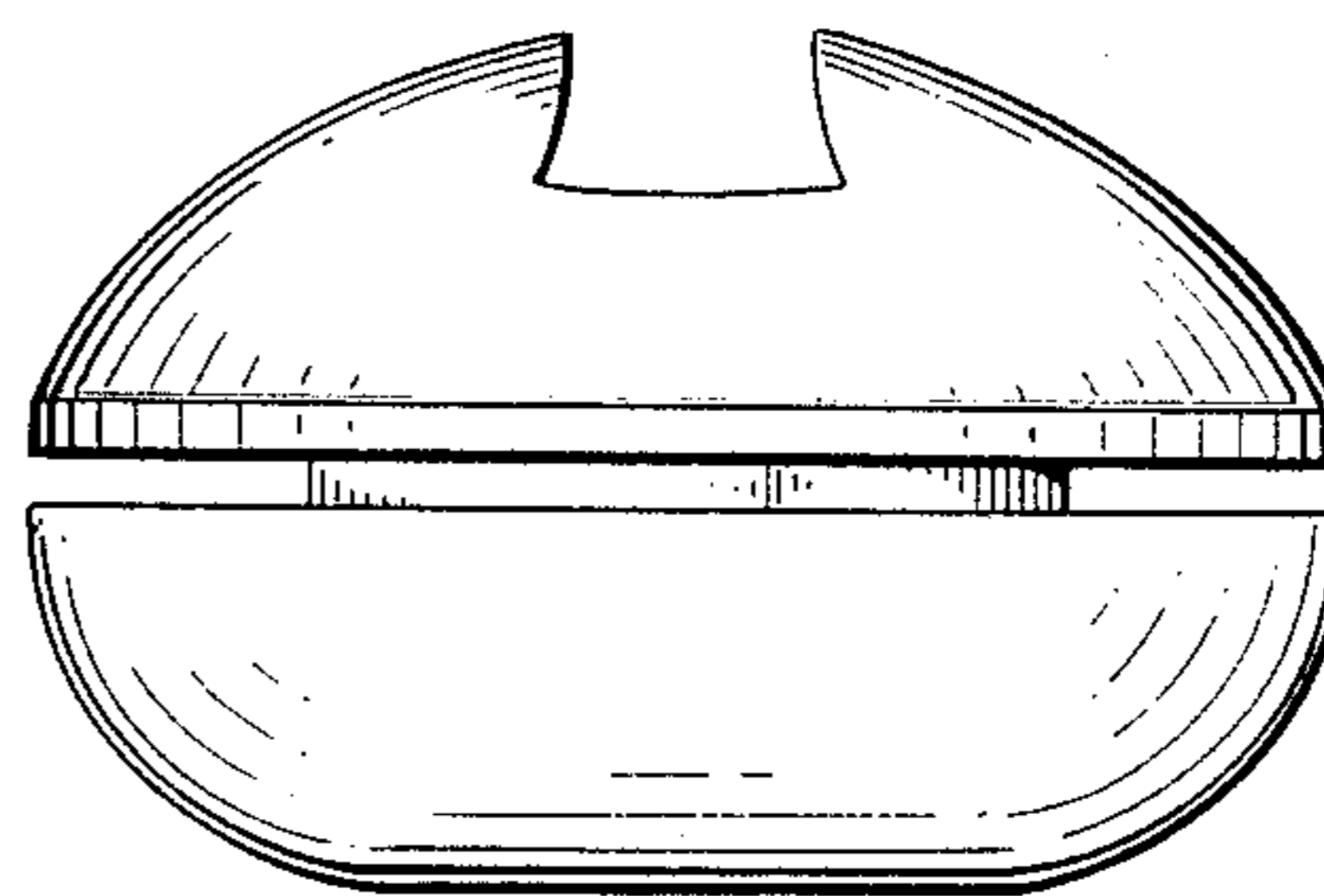

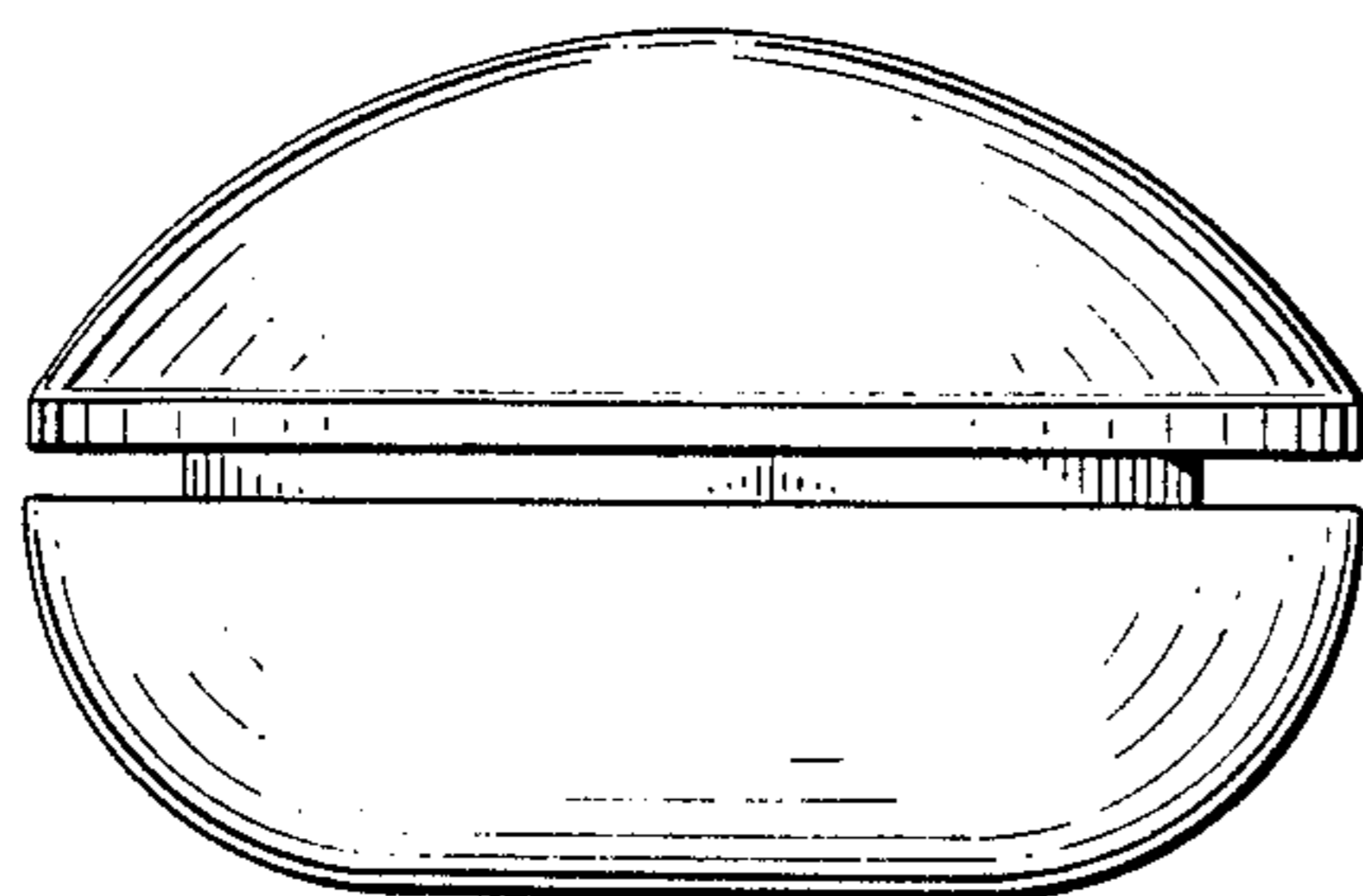

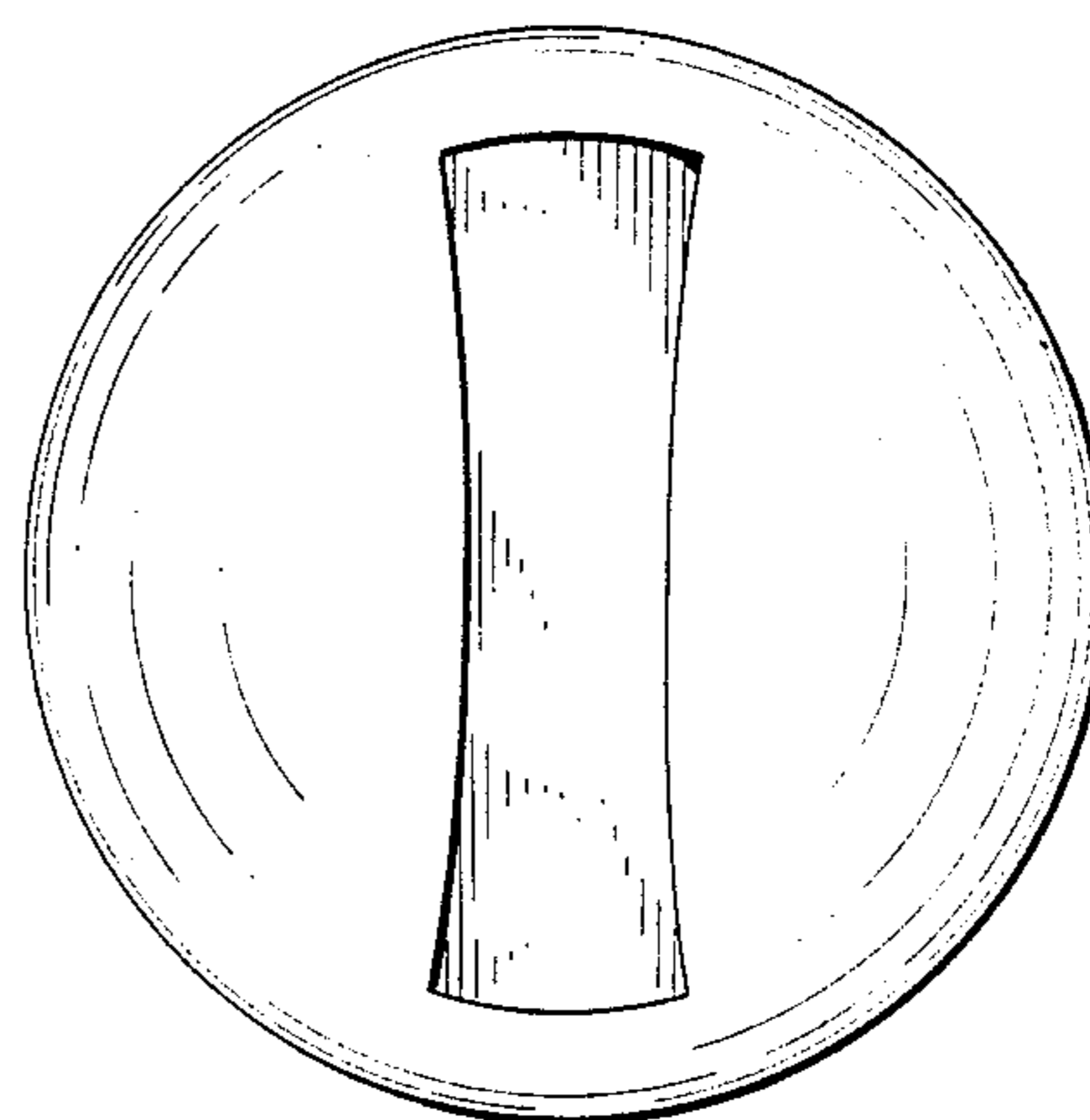

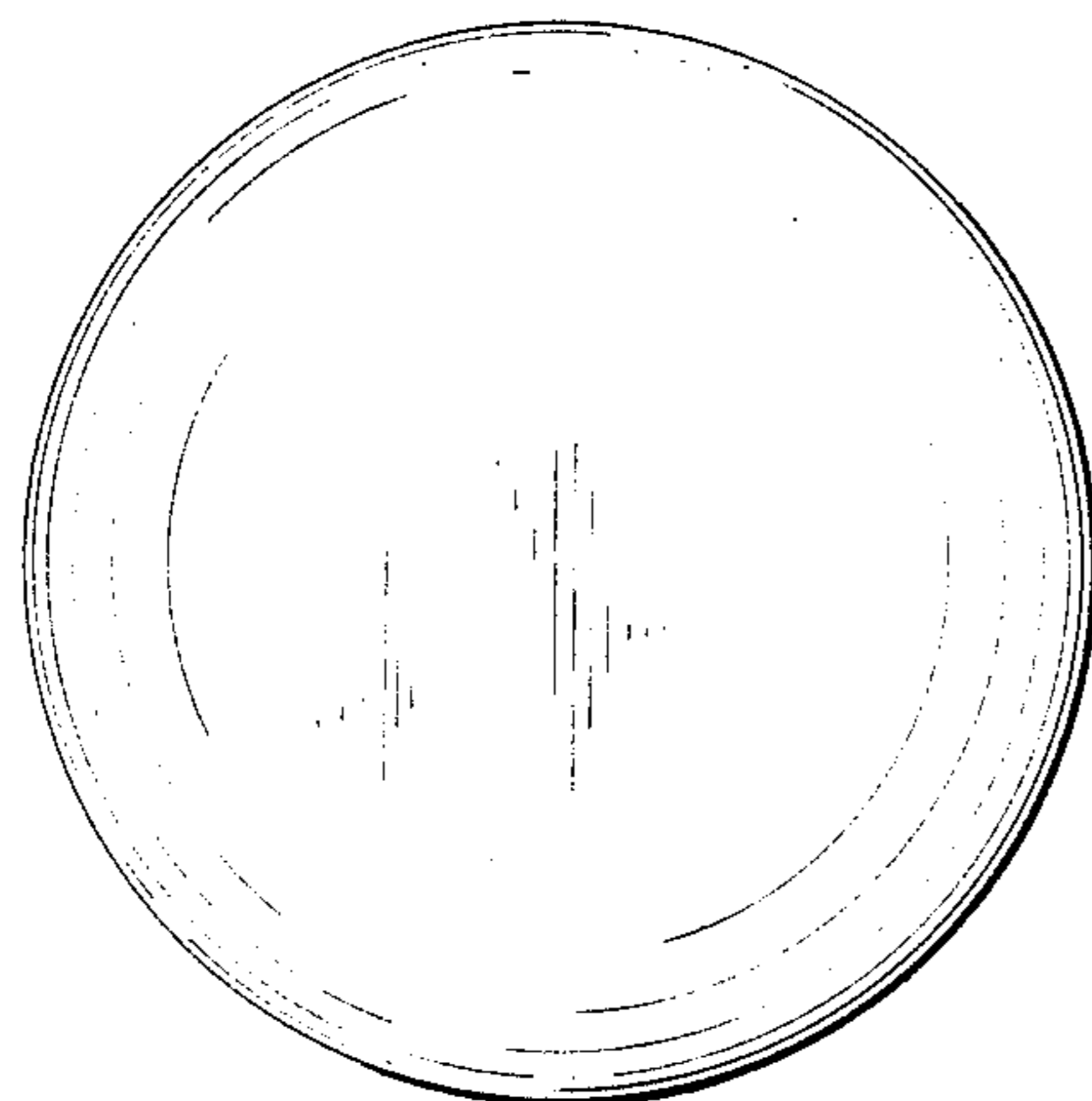

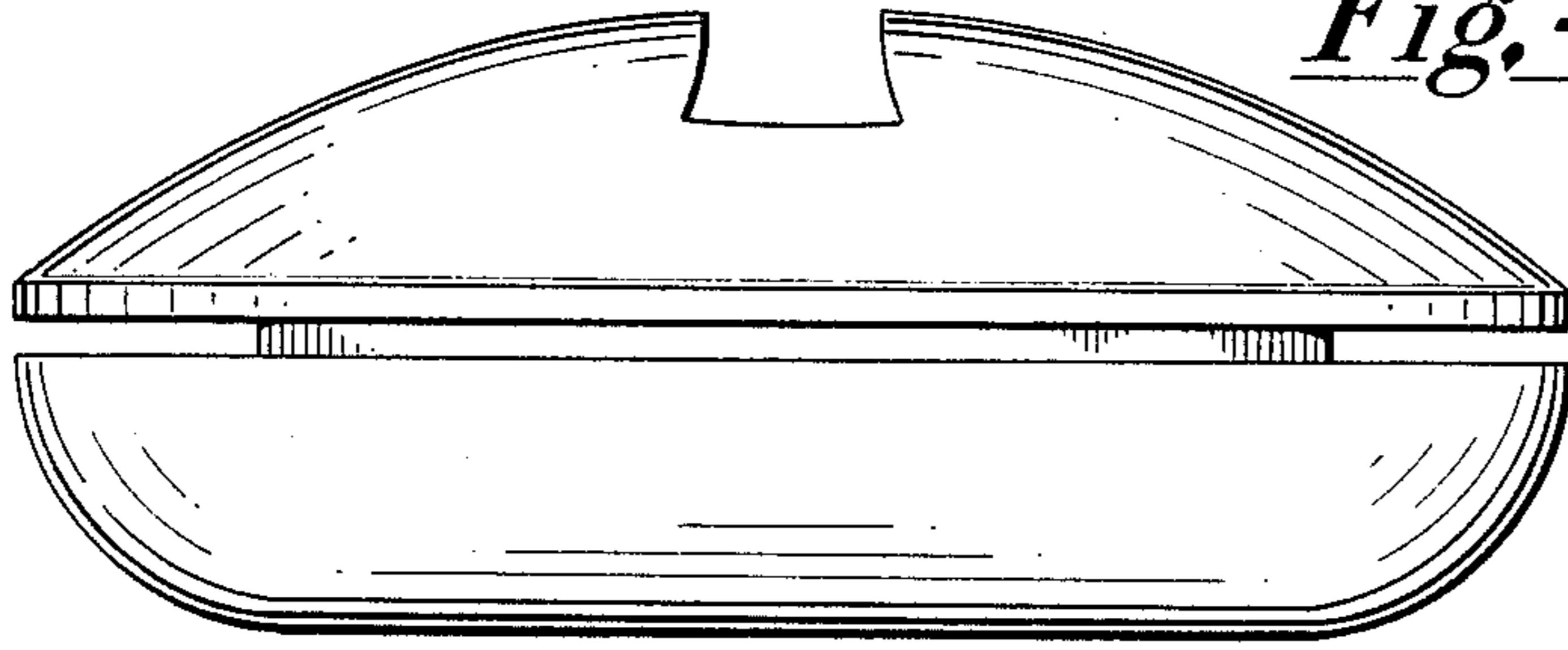

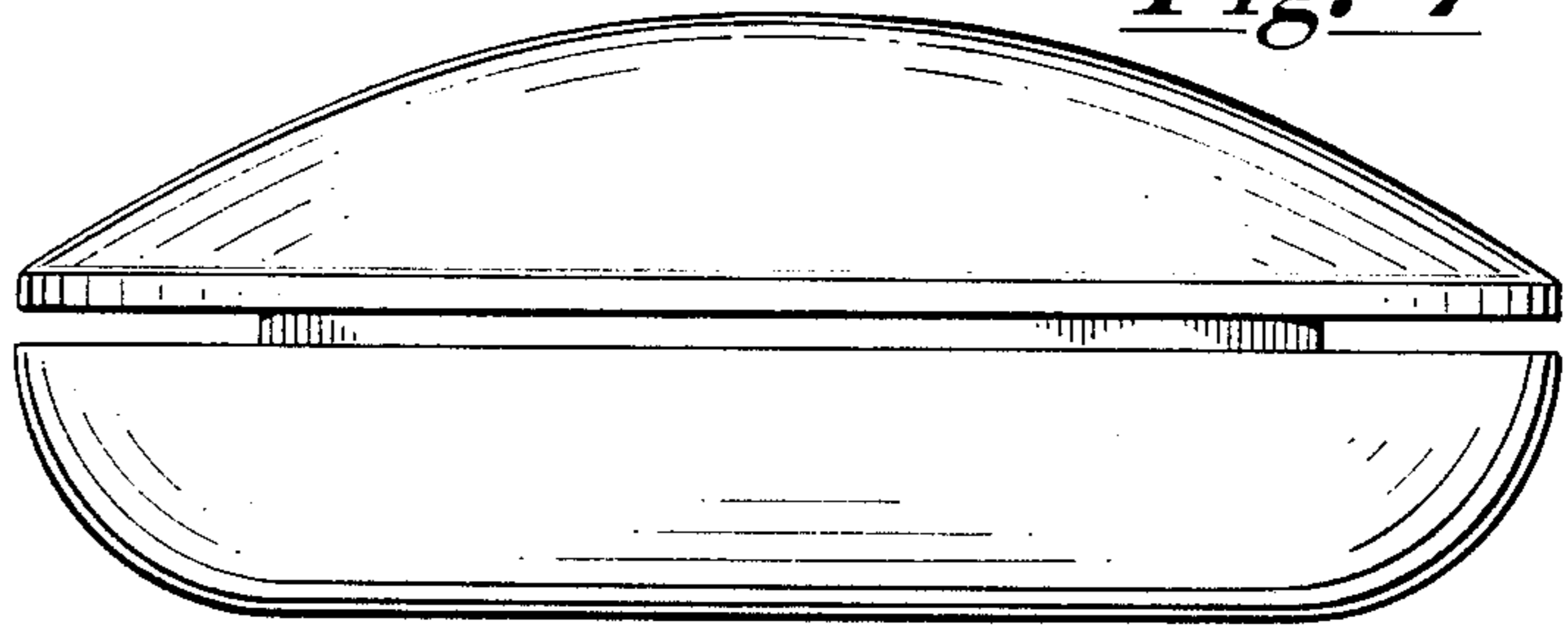
