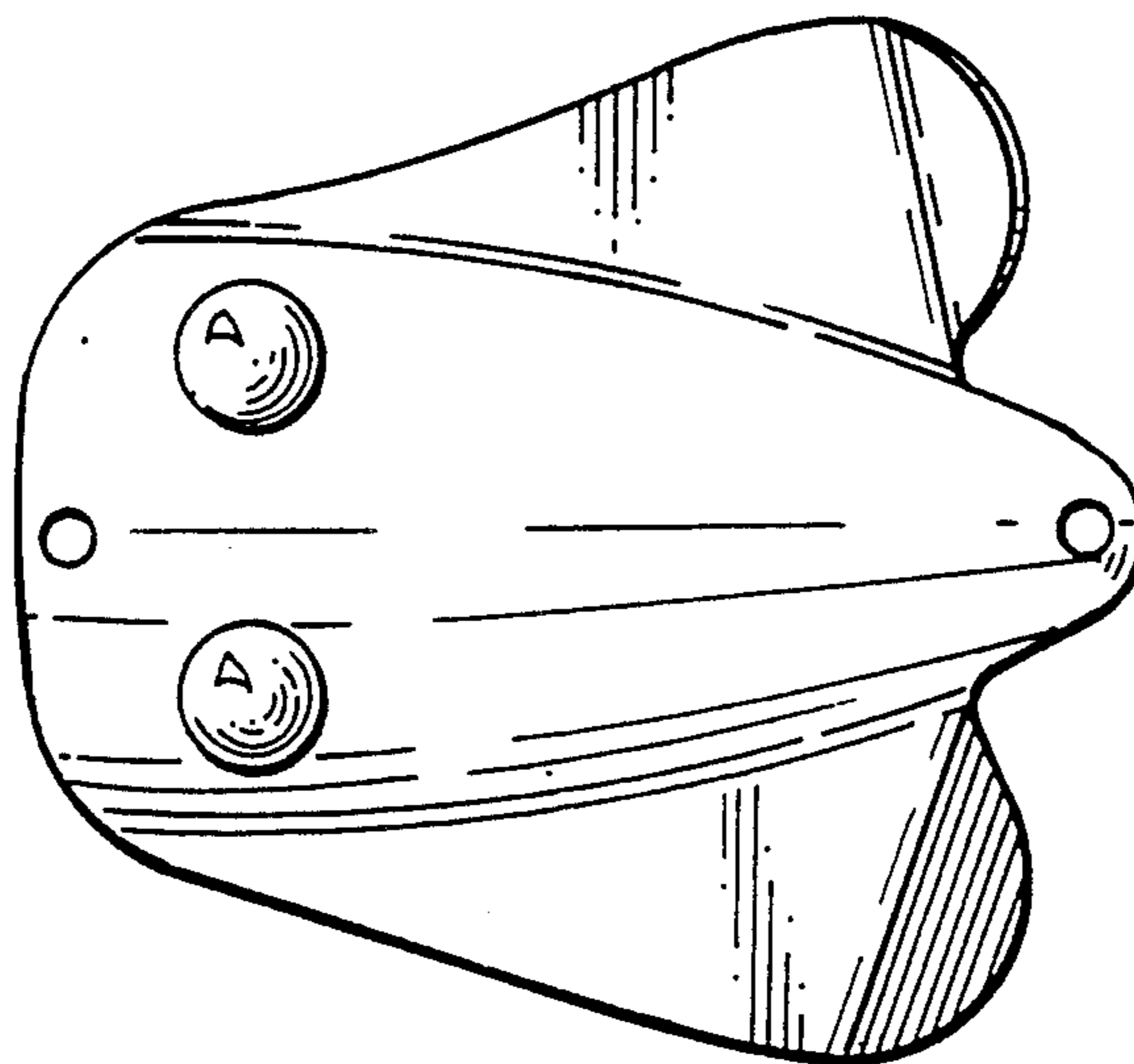

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fishing lure, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a fish lure;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof.



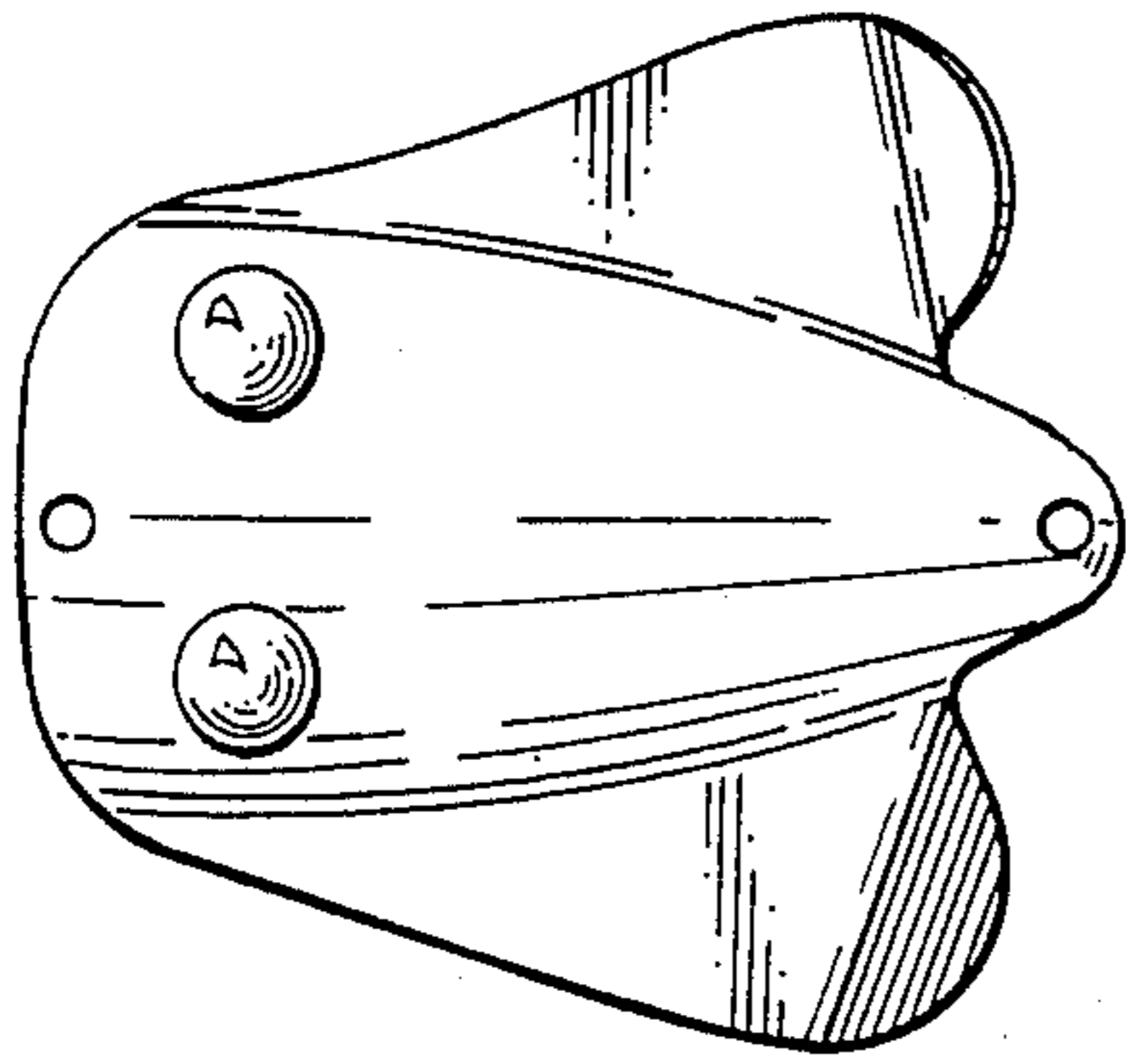

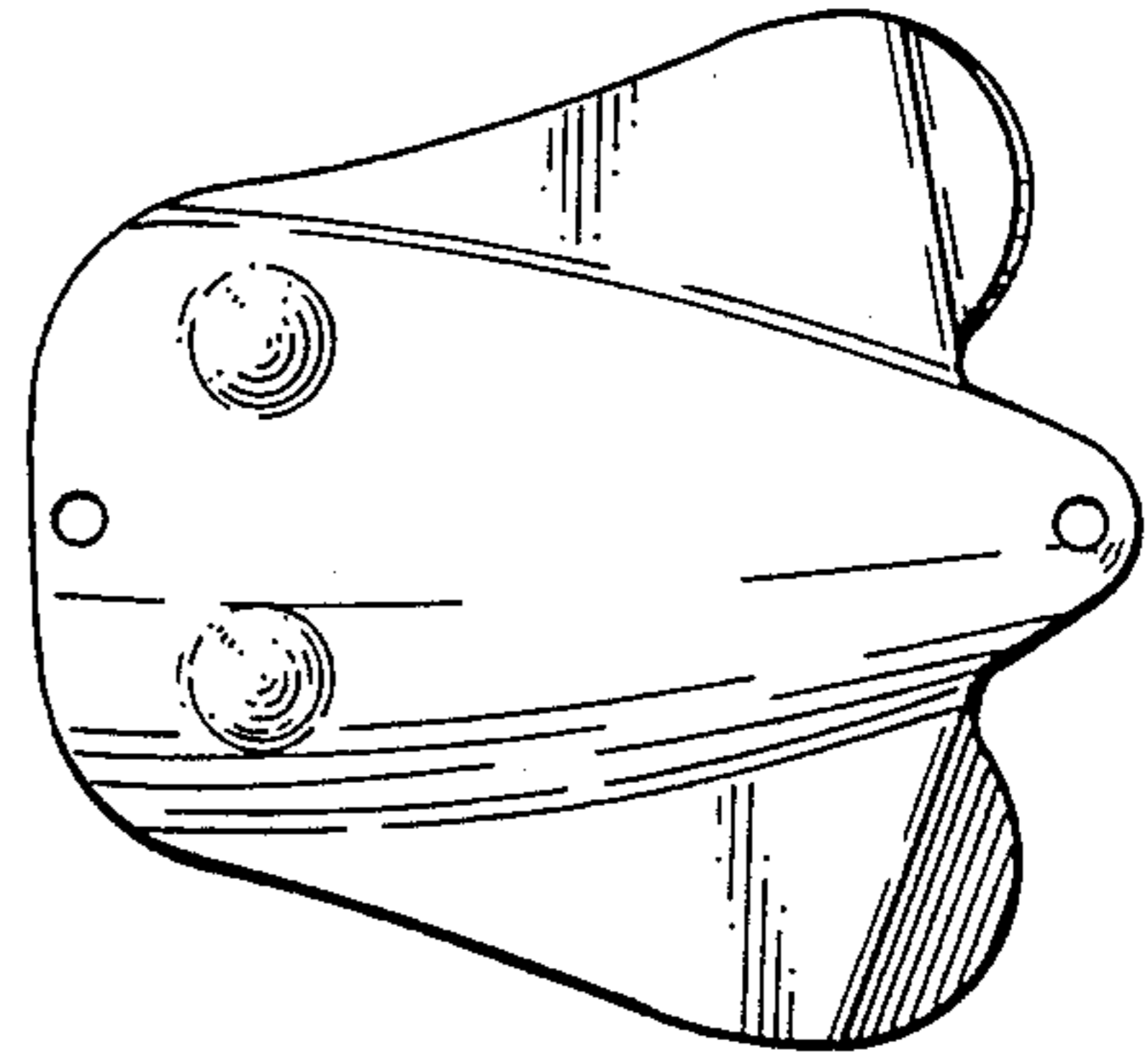

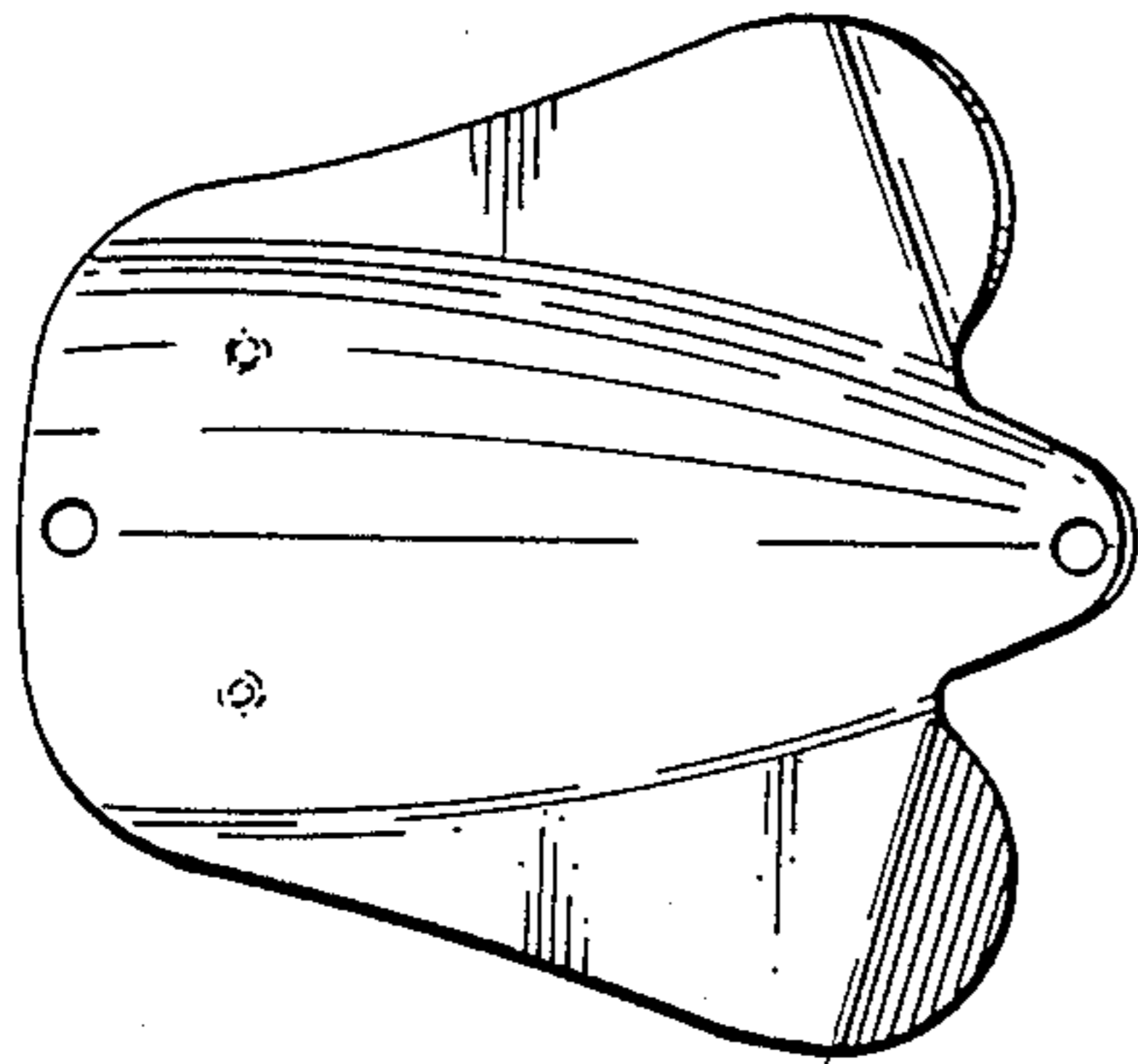

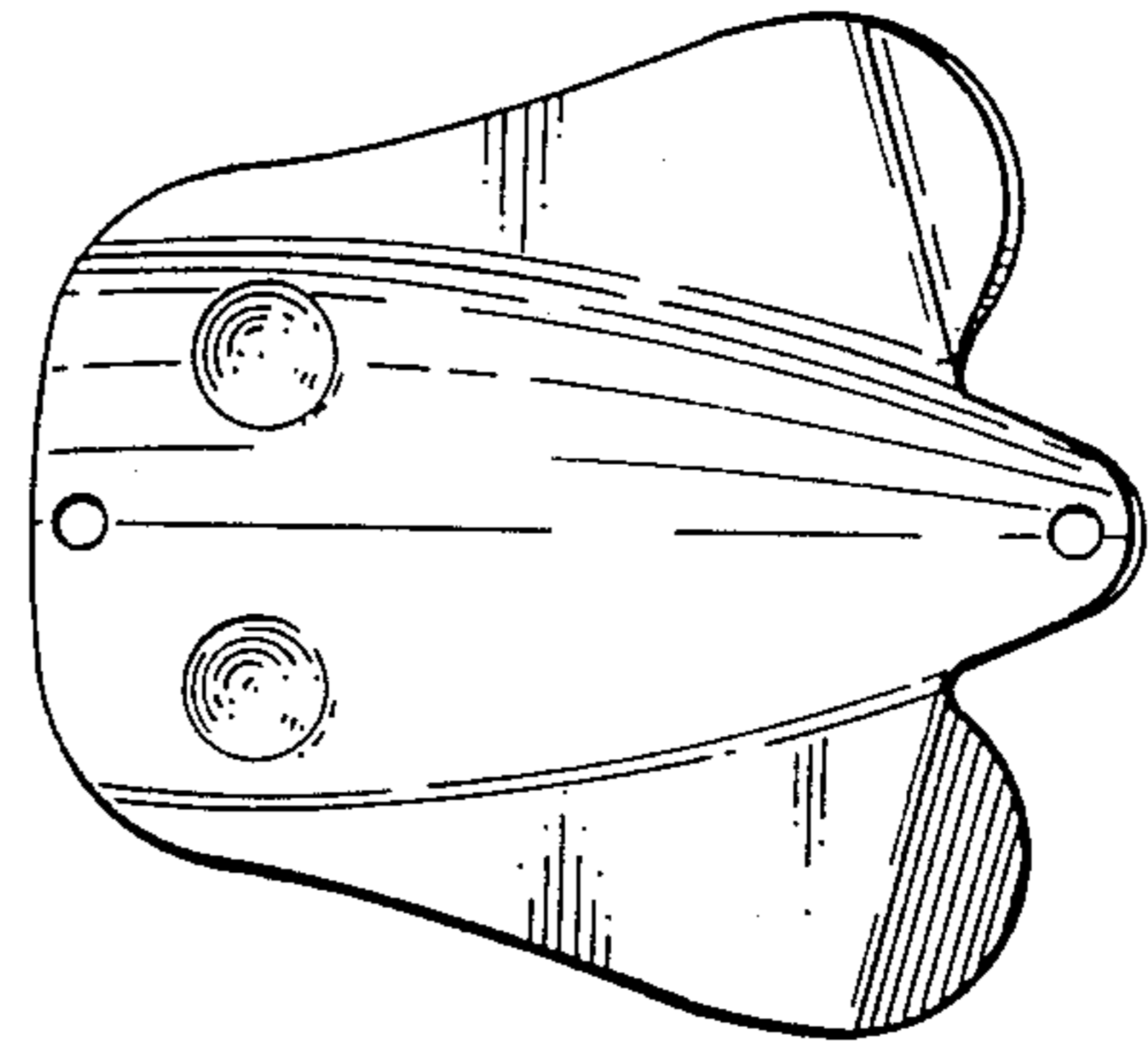

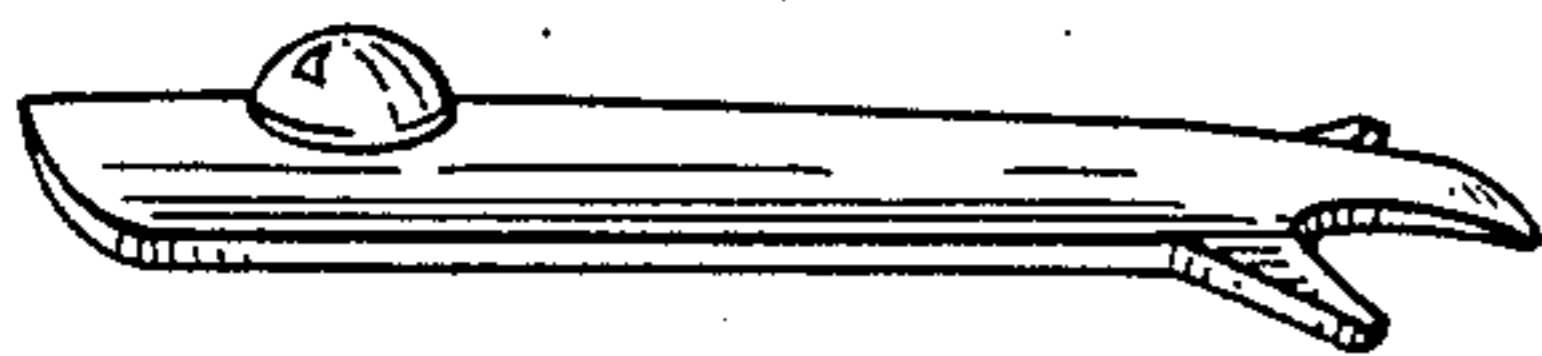

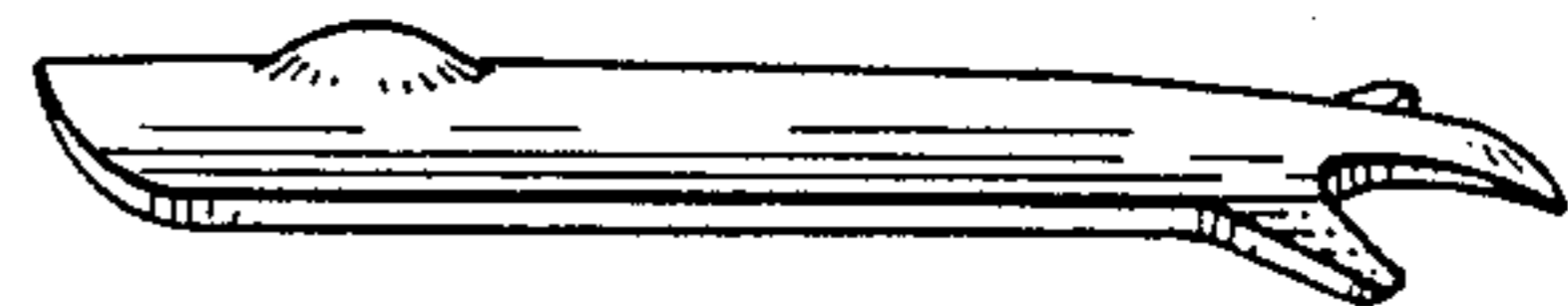

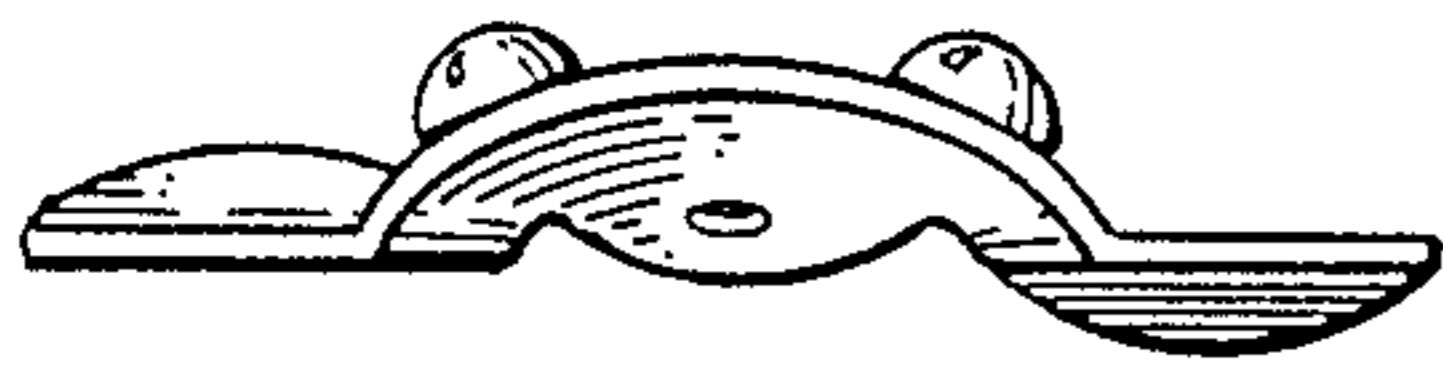
