FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

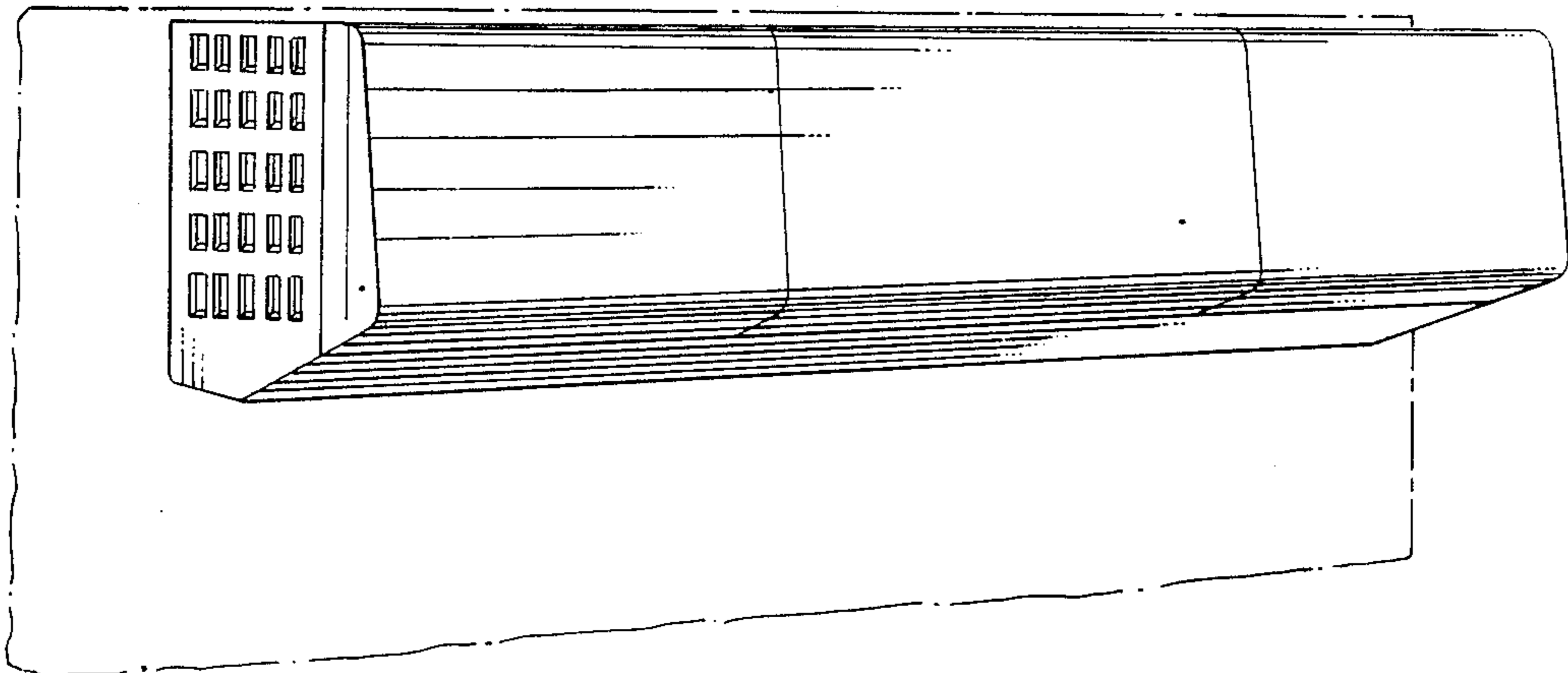

The fragmentary broken line representation of the front of a truck in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only, and forms no part of the claimed design.



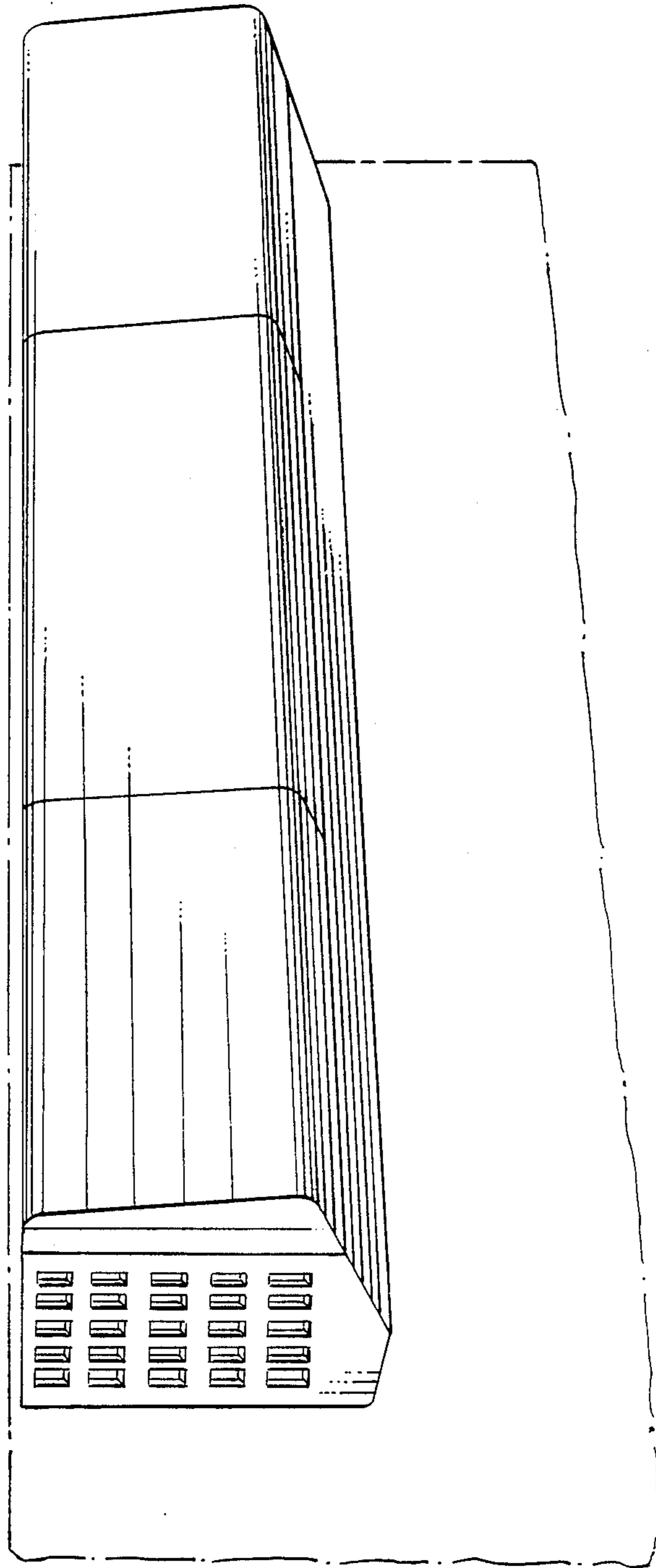

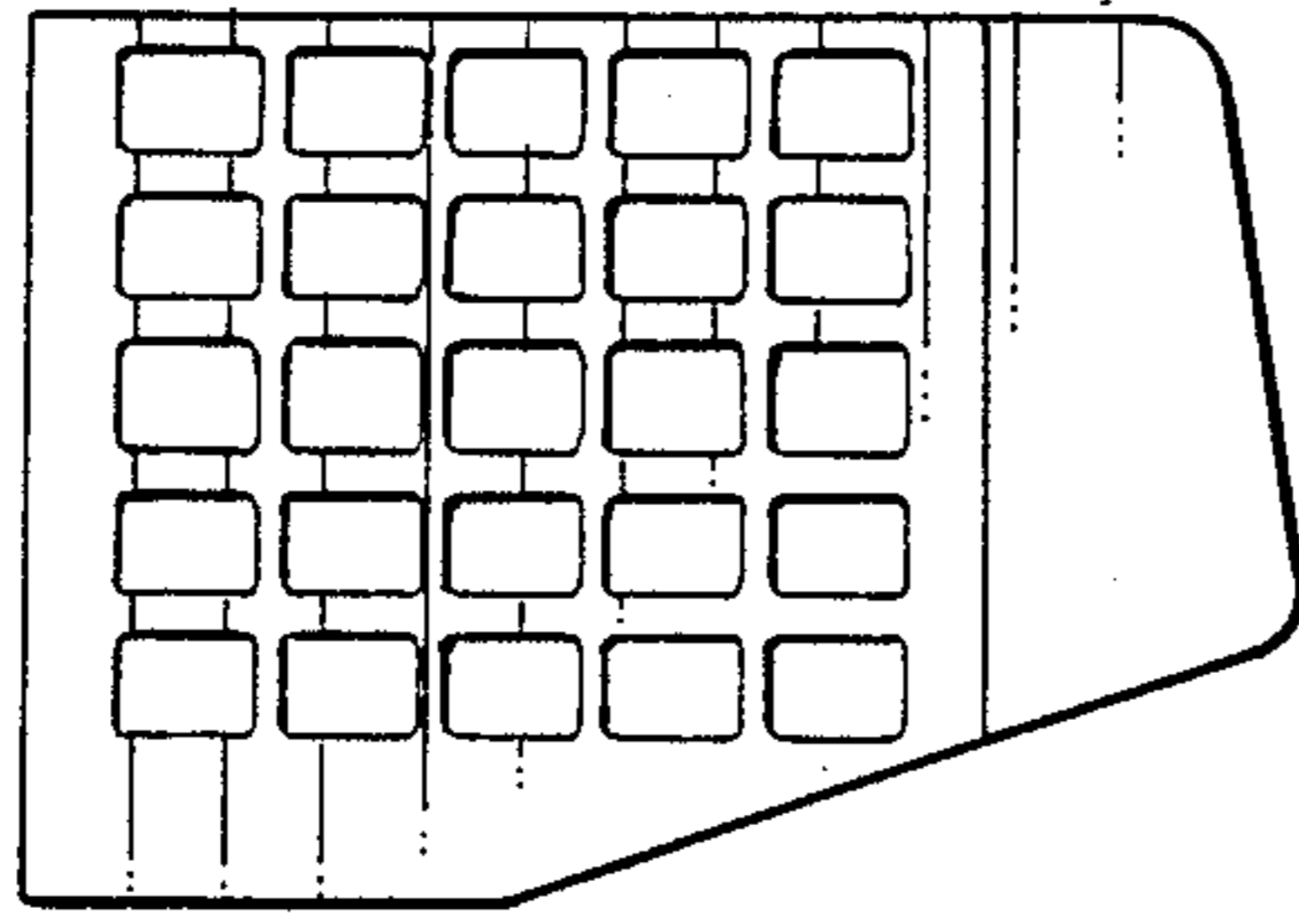

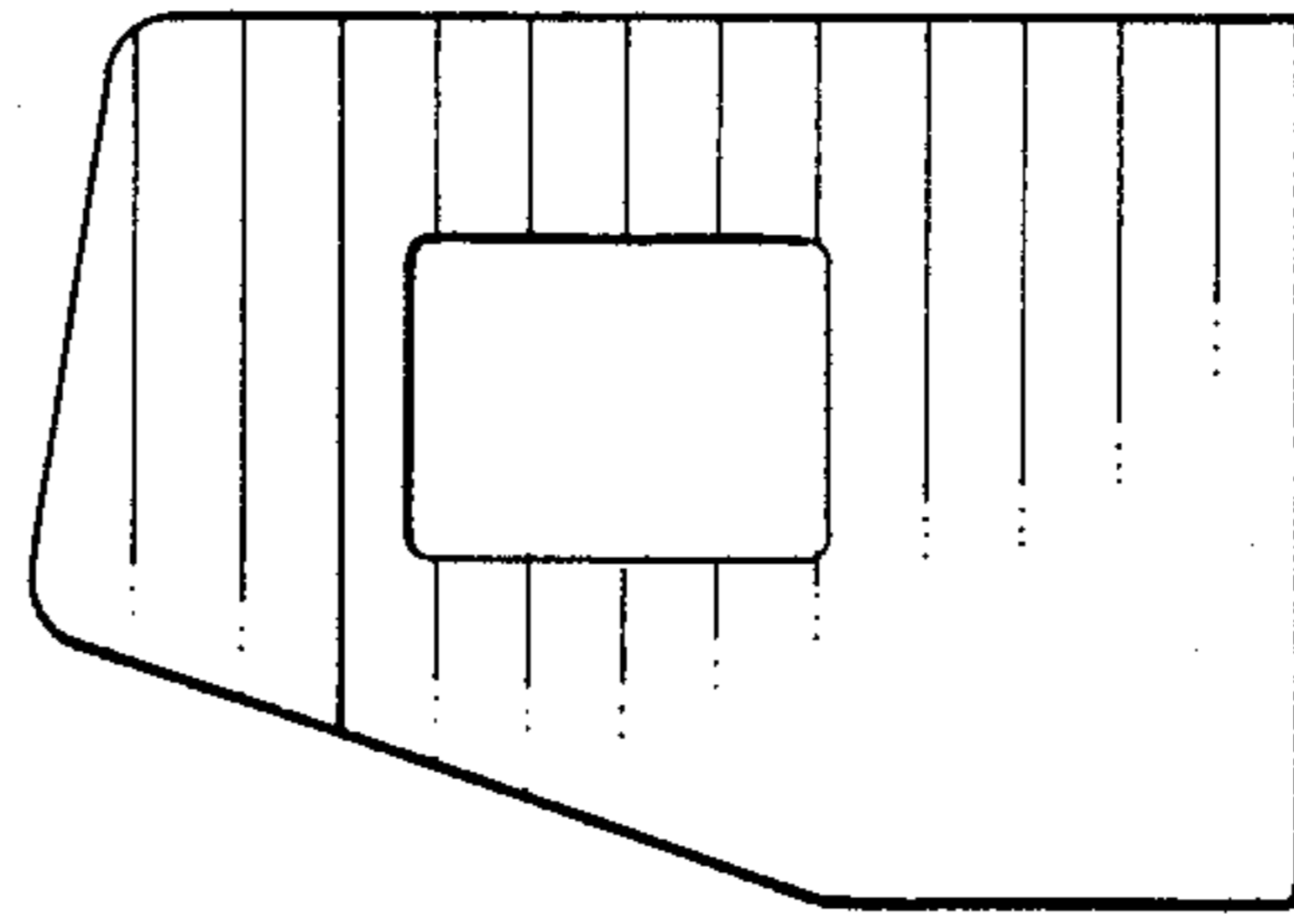
