DESCRIPTION

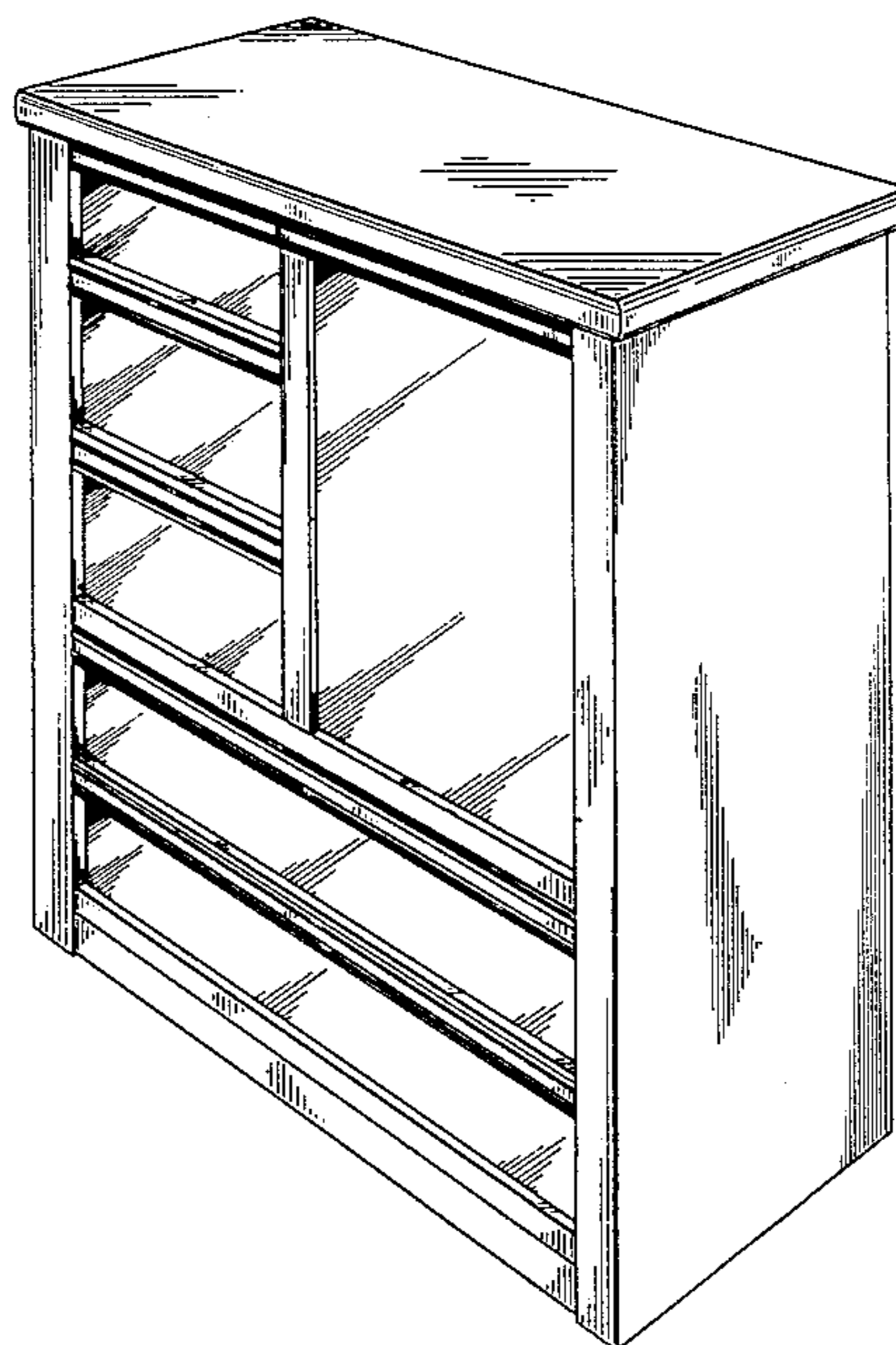
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door chest showing our new design;

The rear elevation thereof being plain and unornamented.



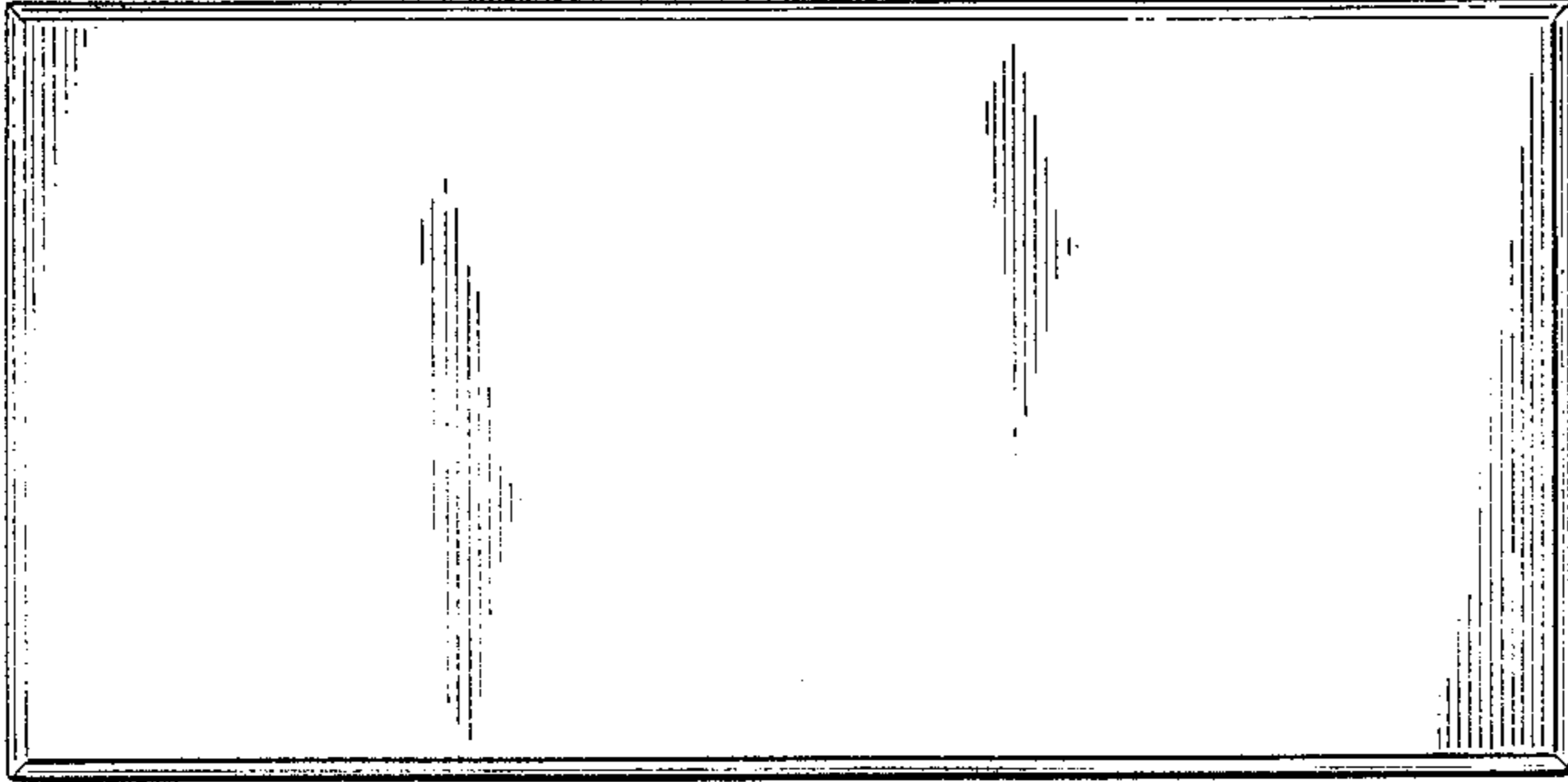

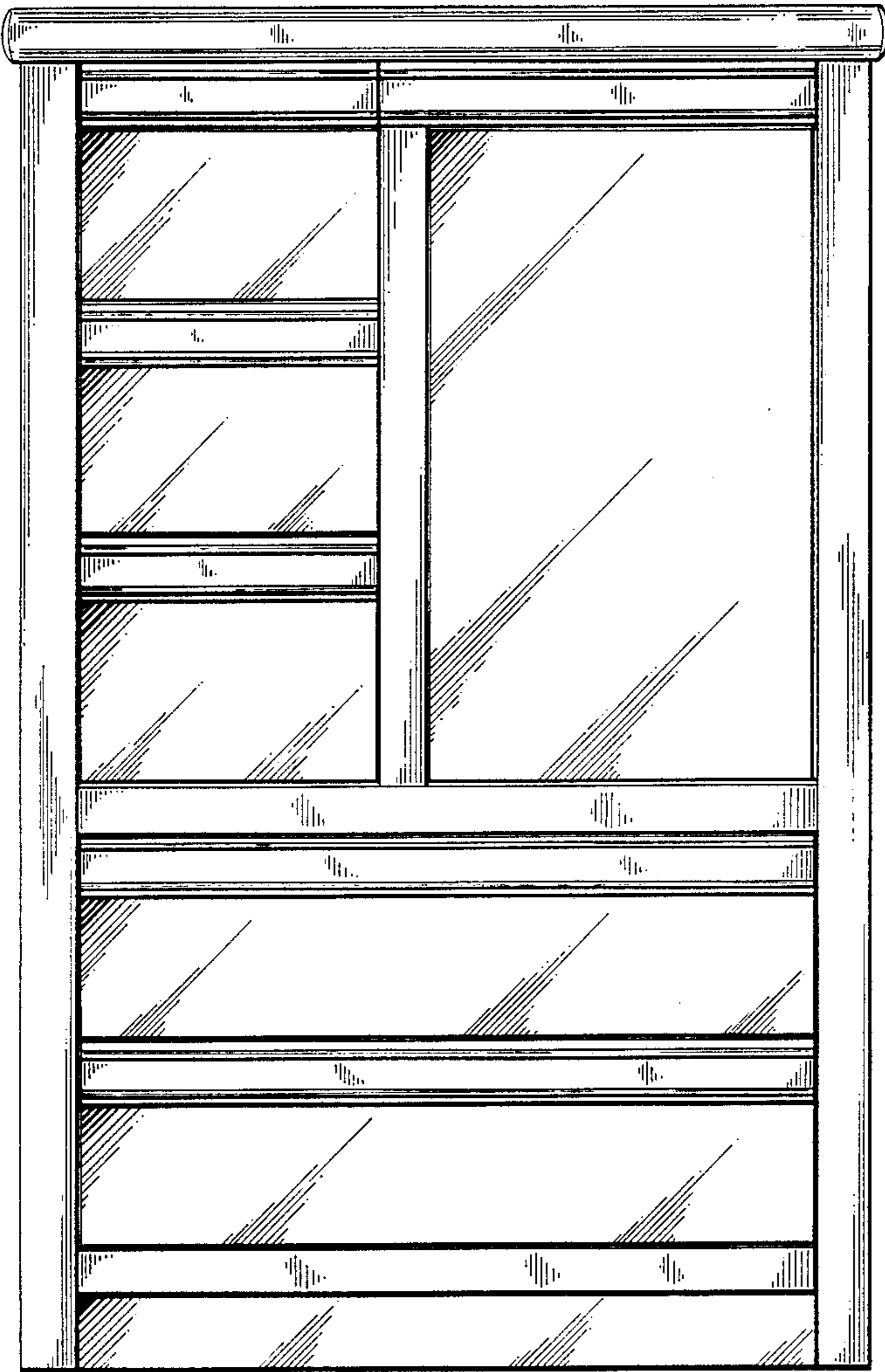

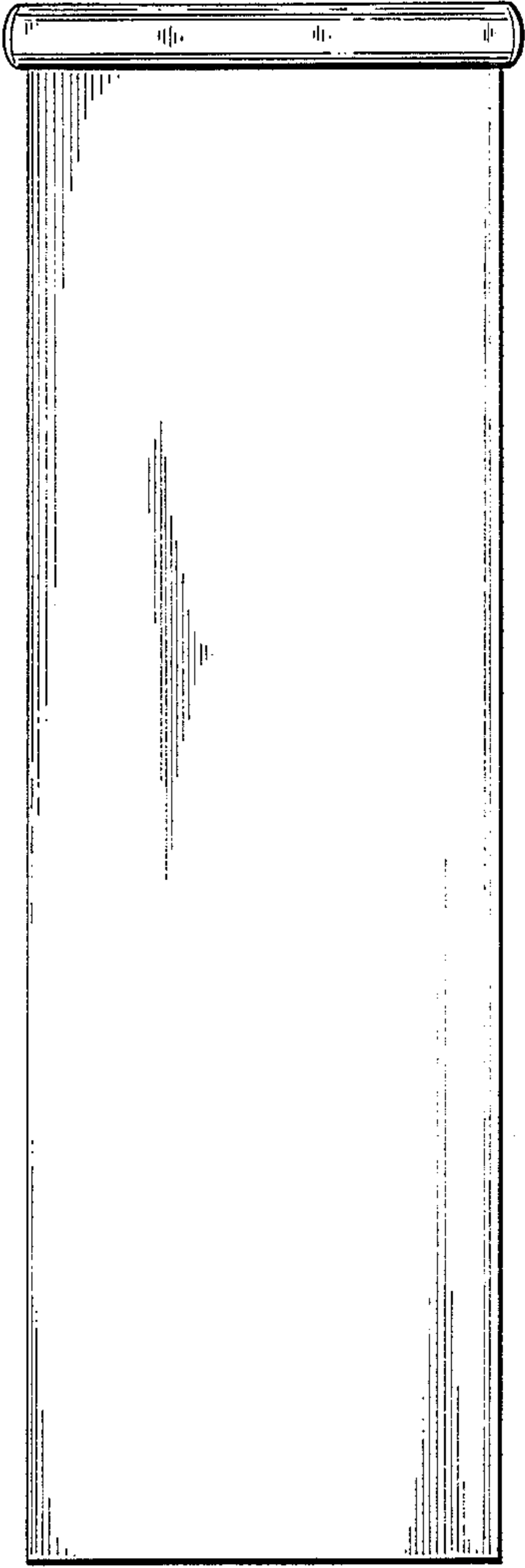

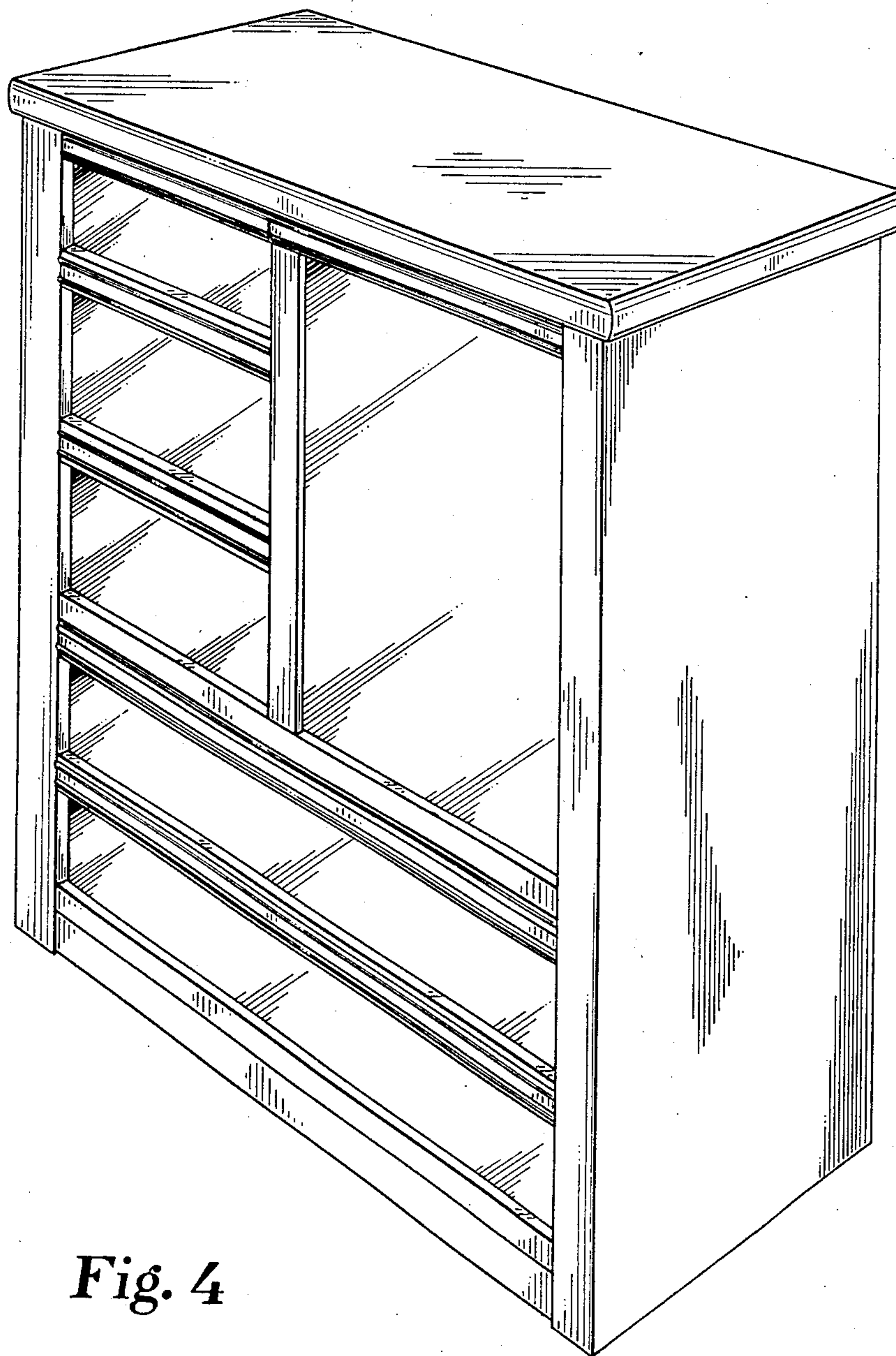
