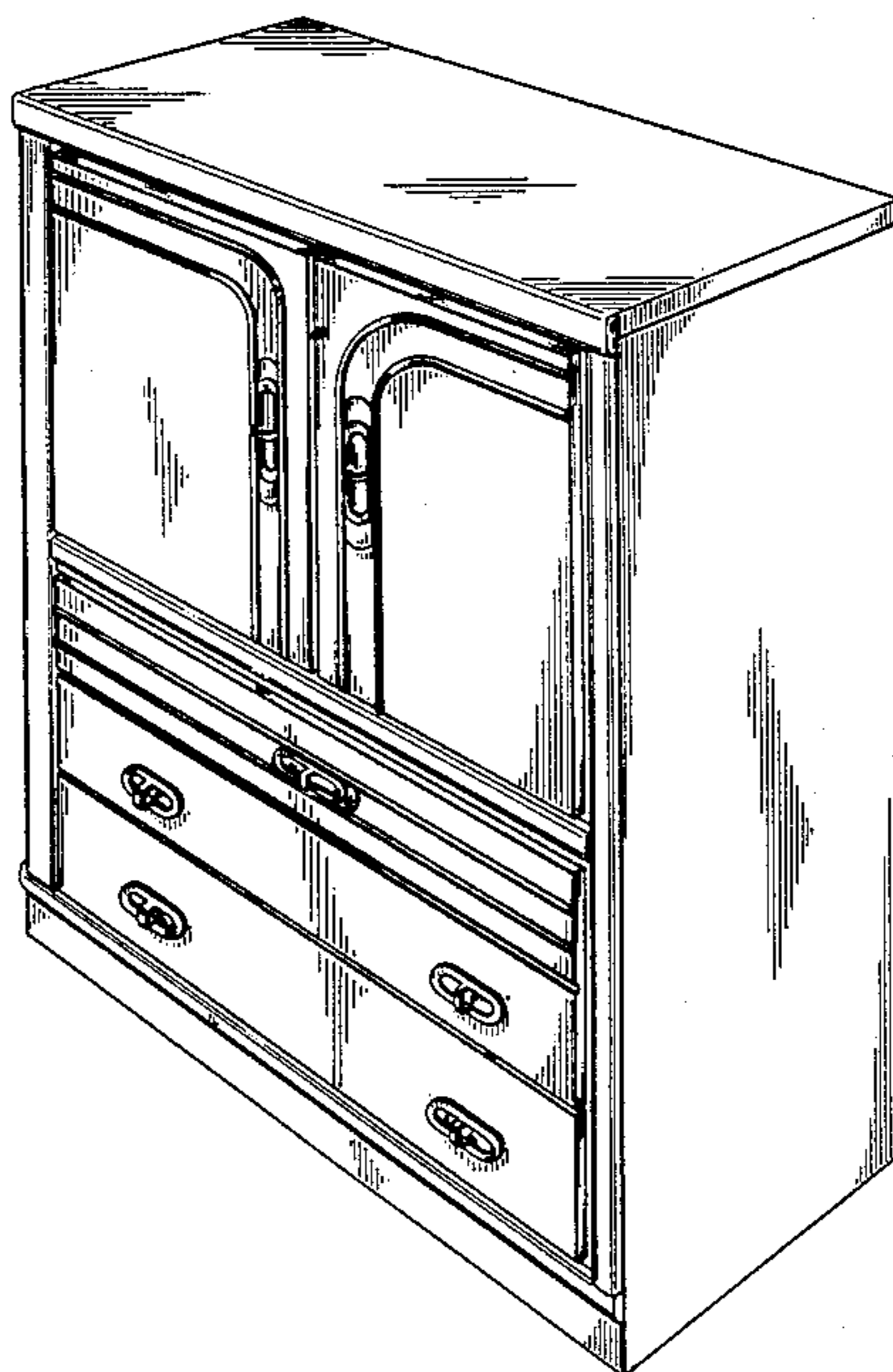

The ornamental design for a door chest, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door chest showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof.
The rear elevation thereof being plain and unornamented.



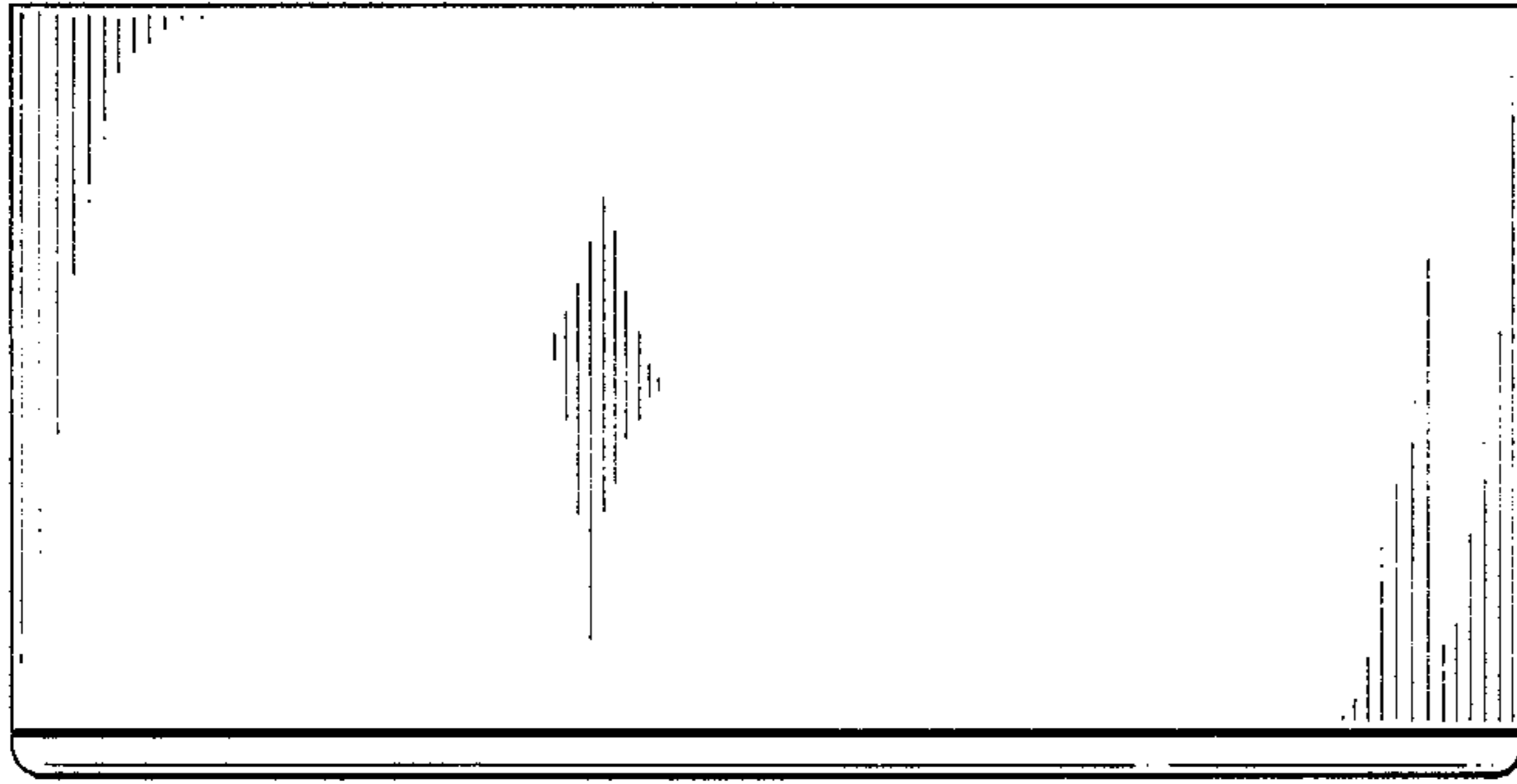

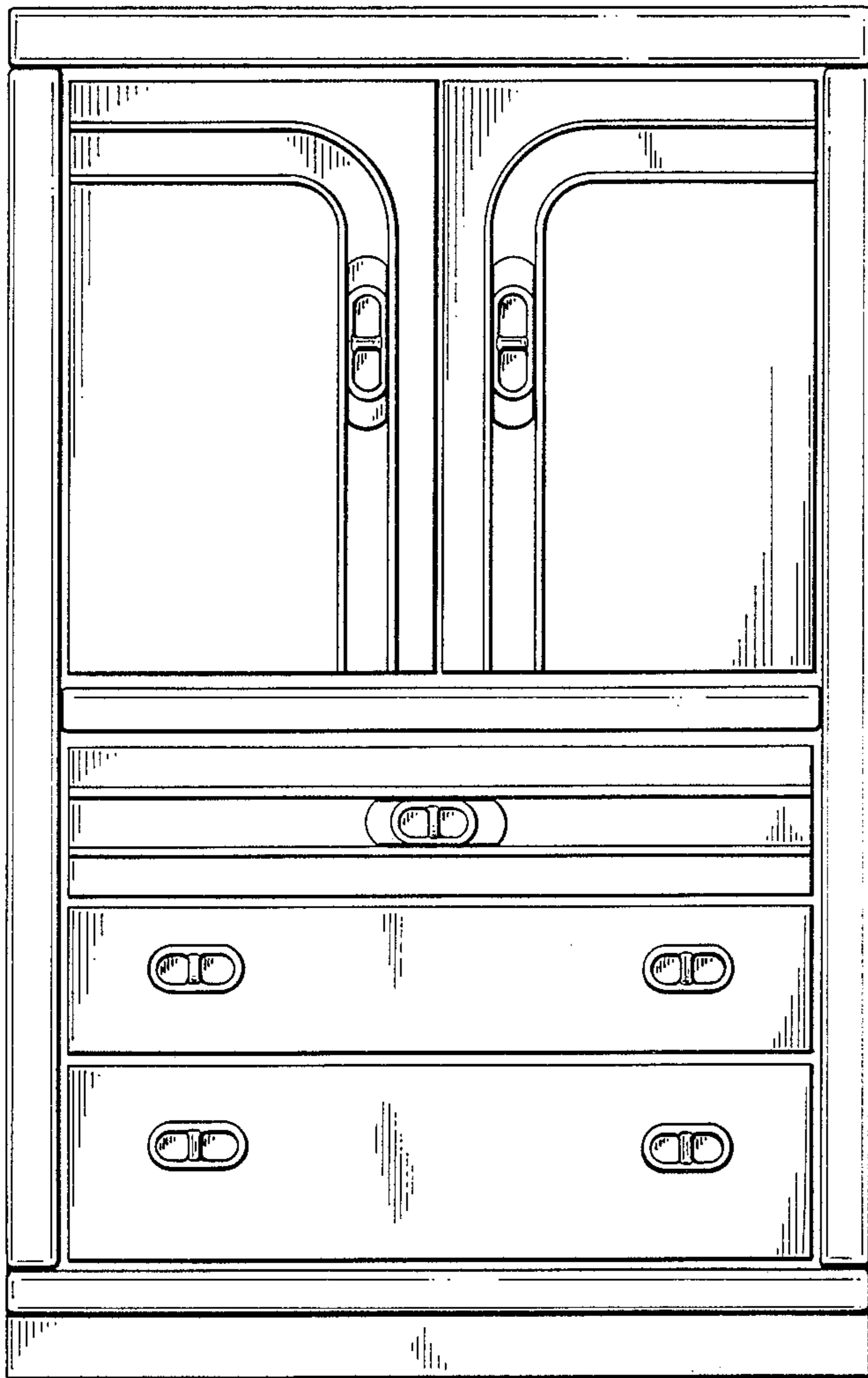

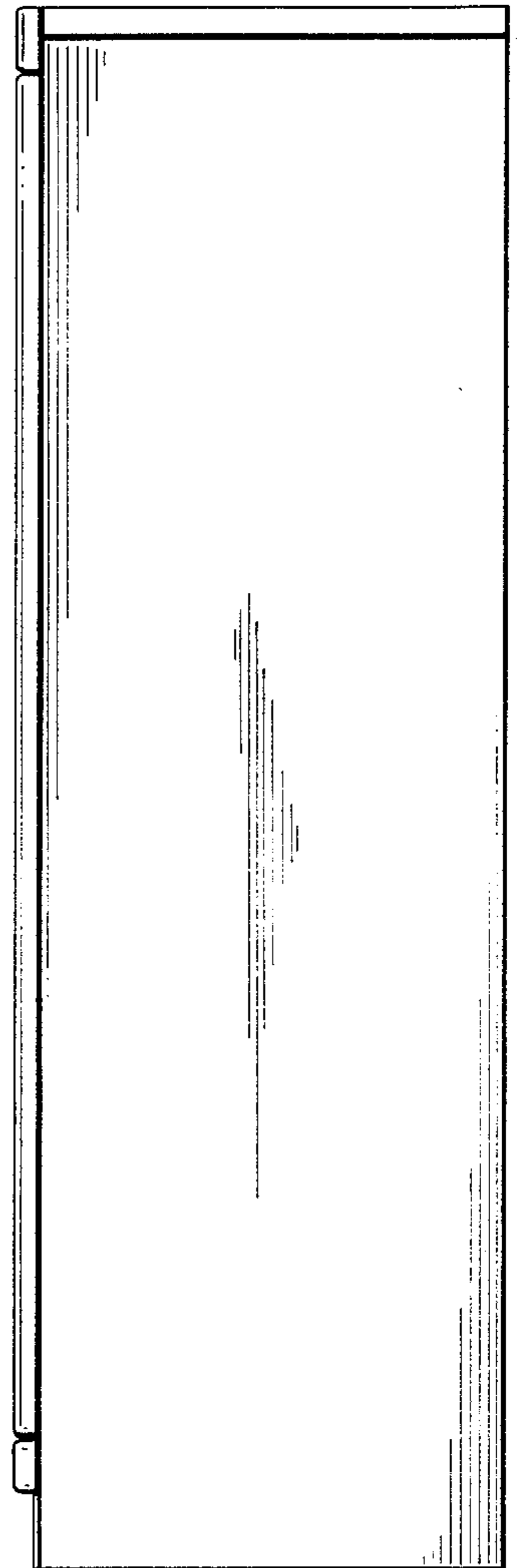

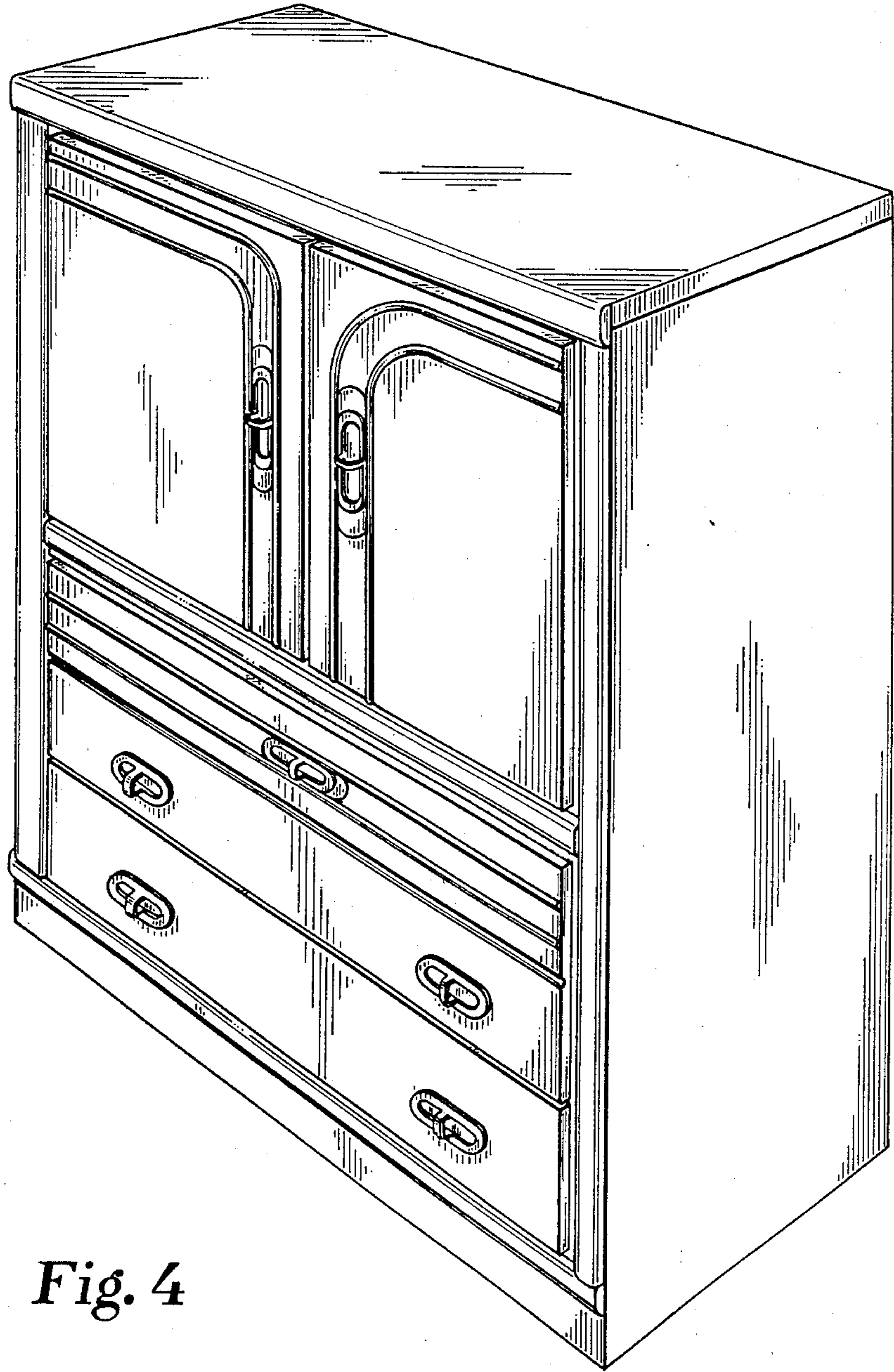
