FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

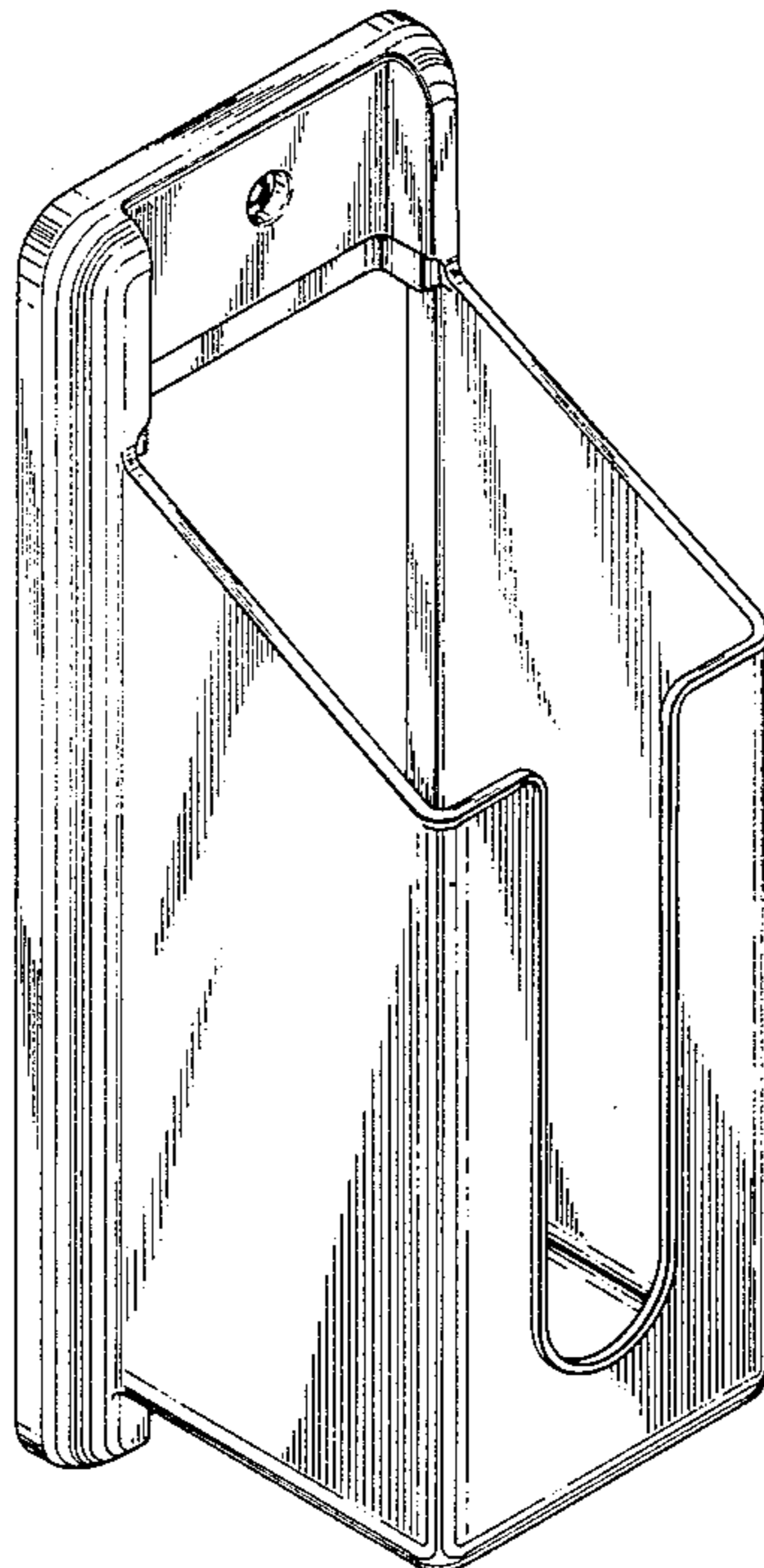
FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 7–7 of FIG. 2.



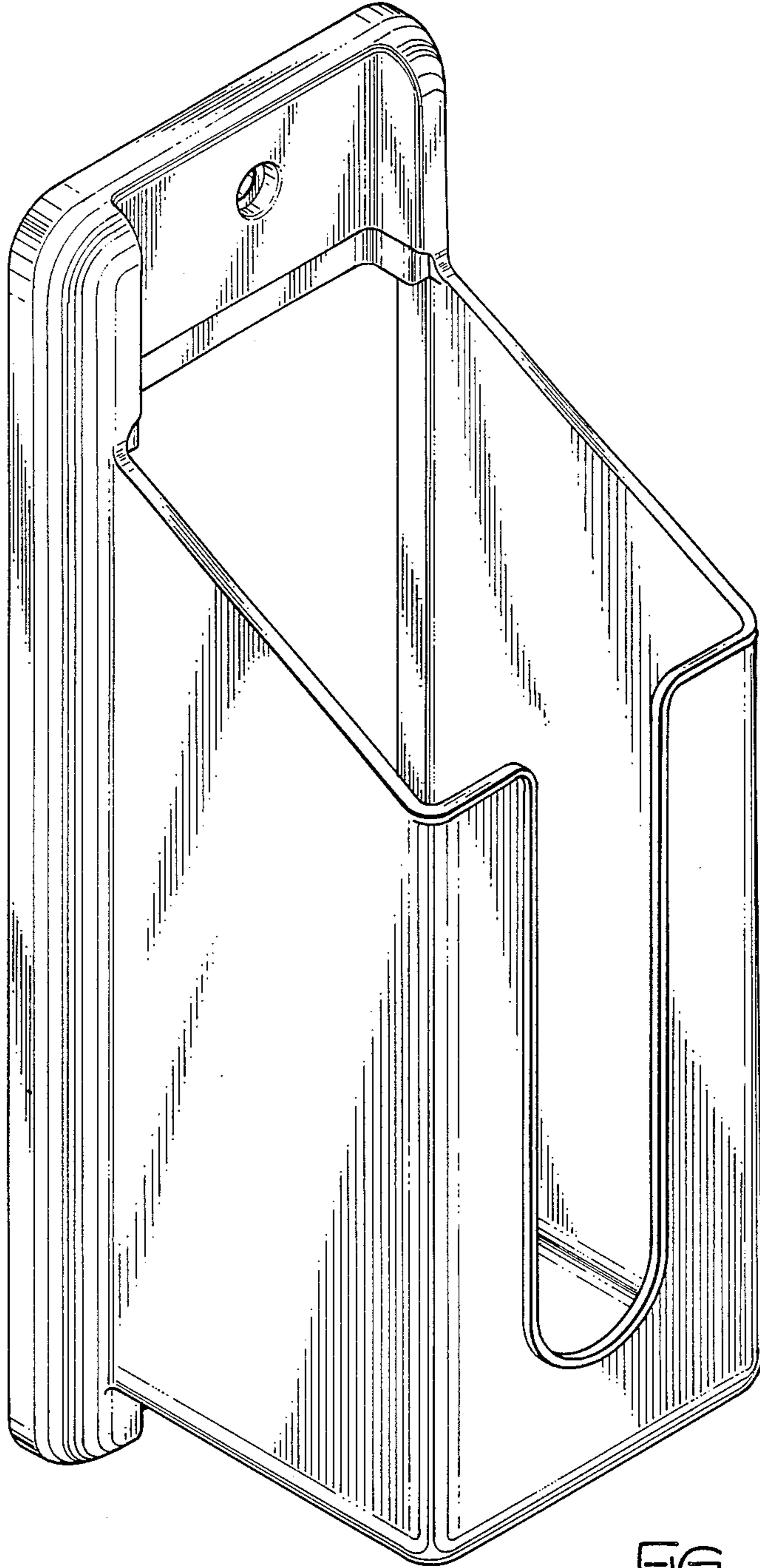

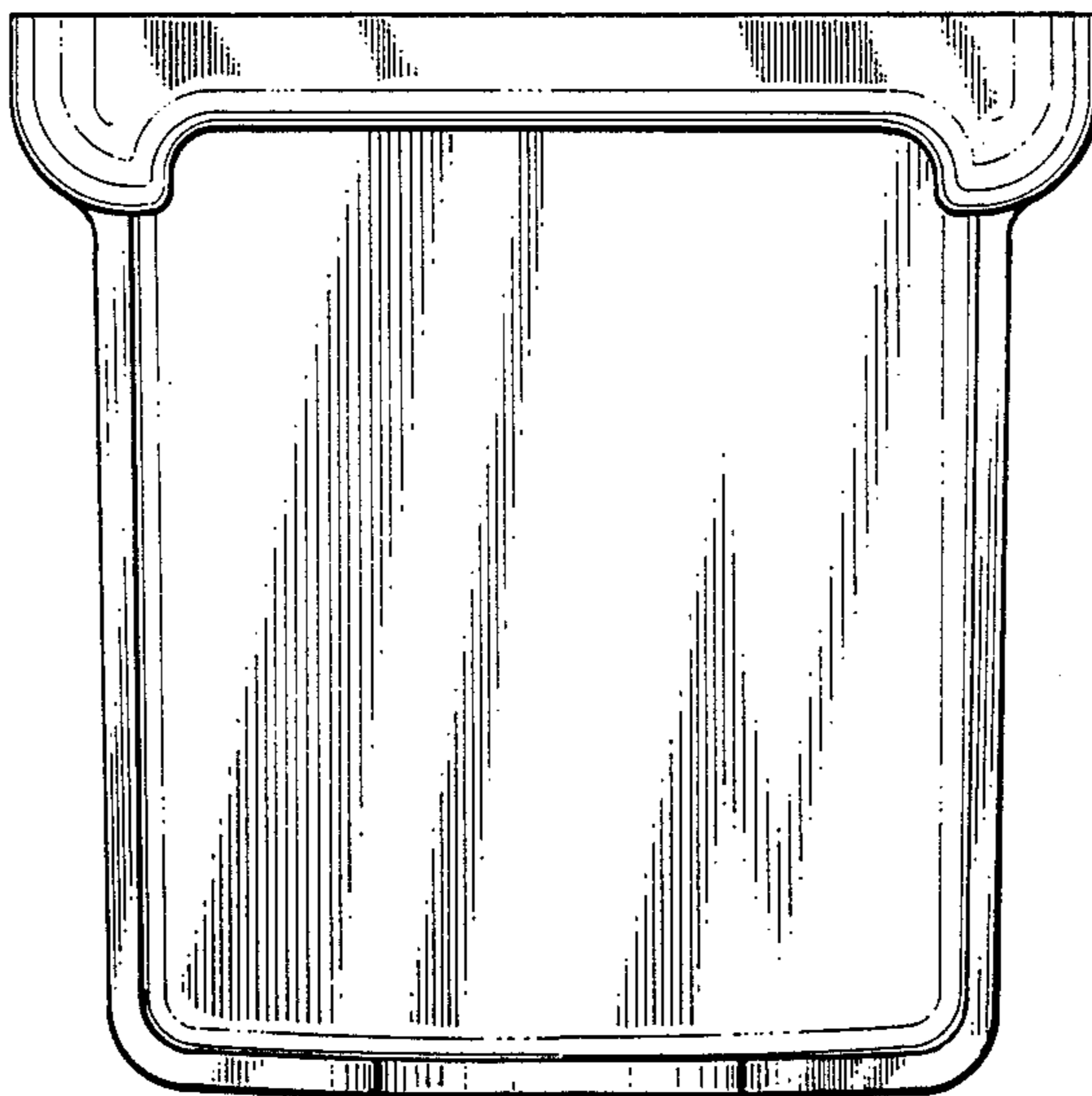

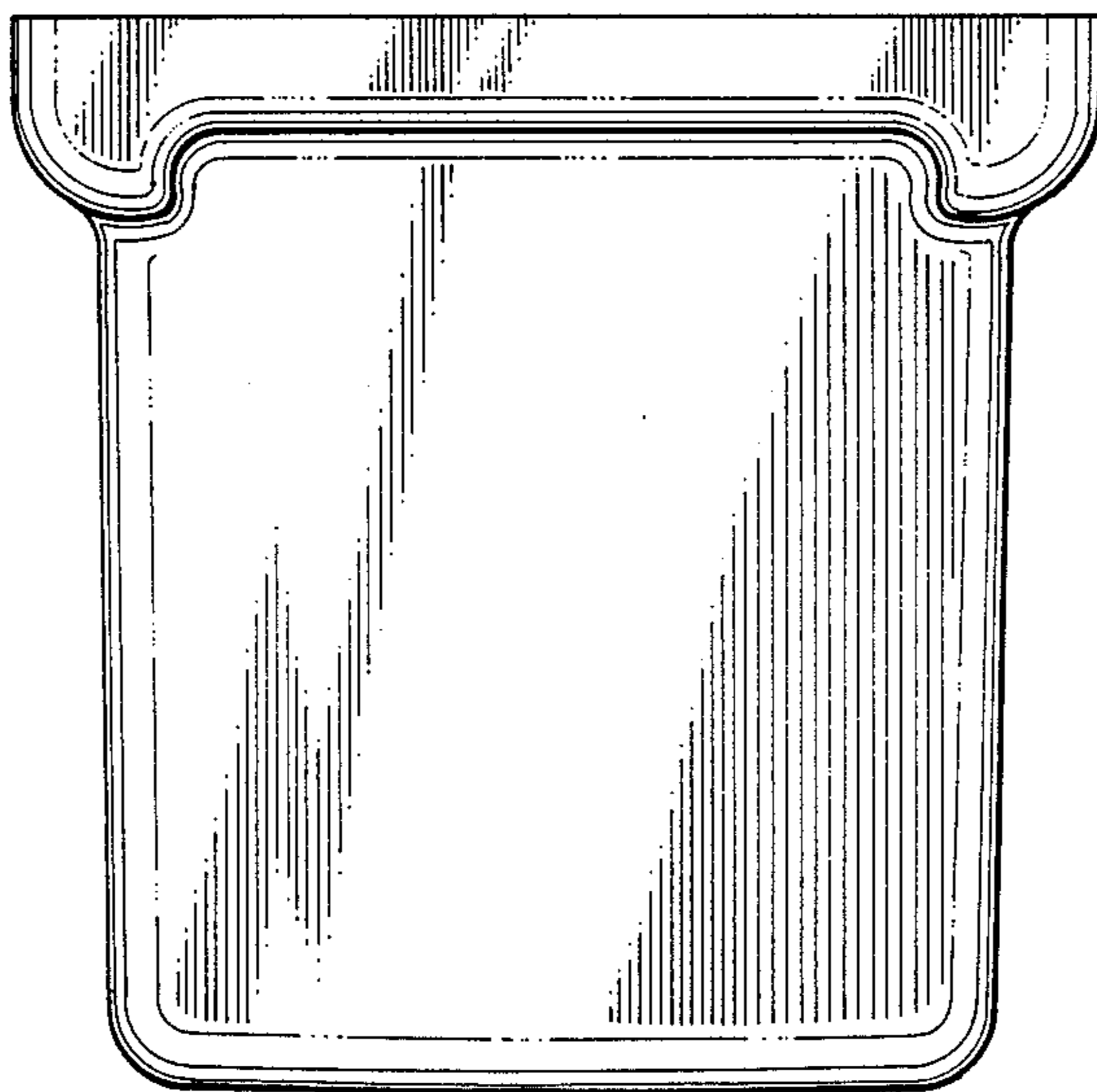

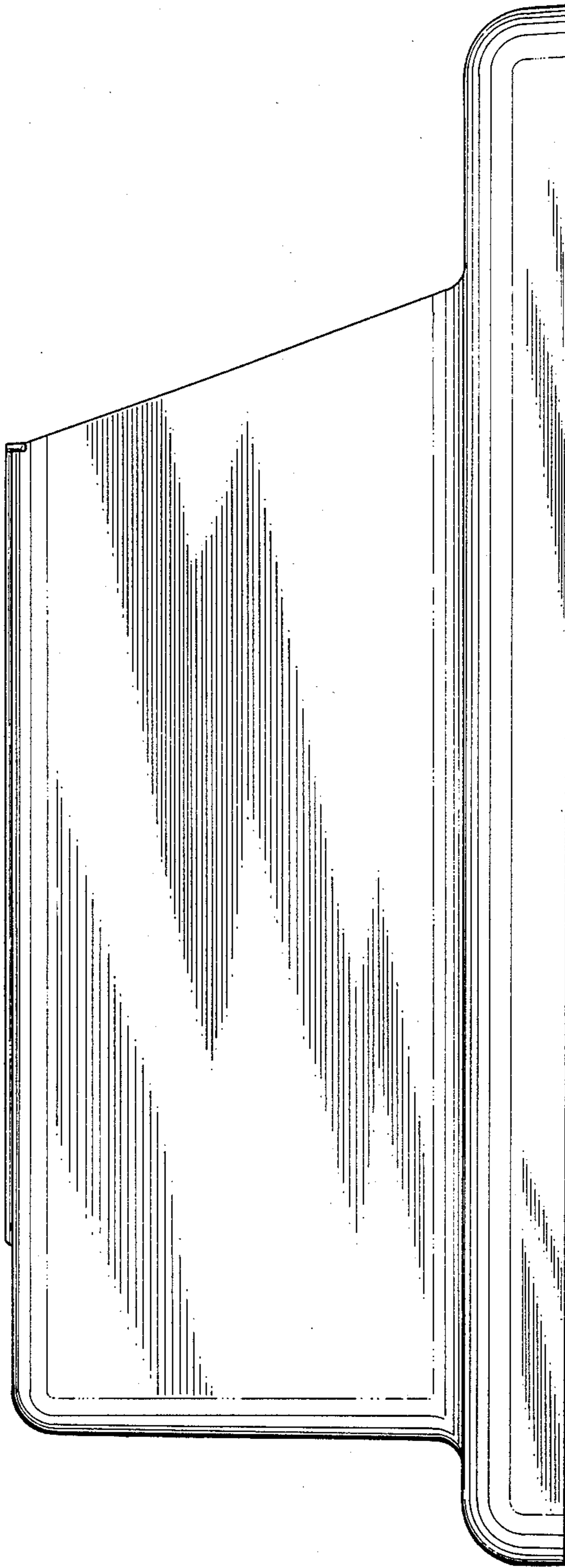

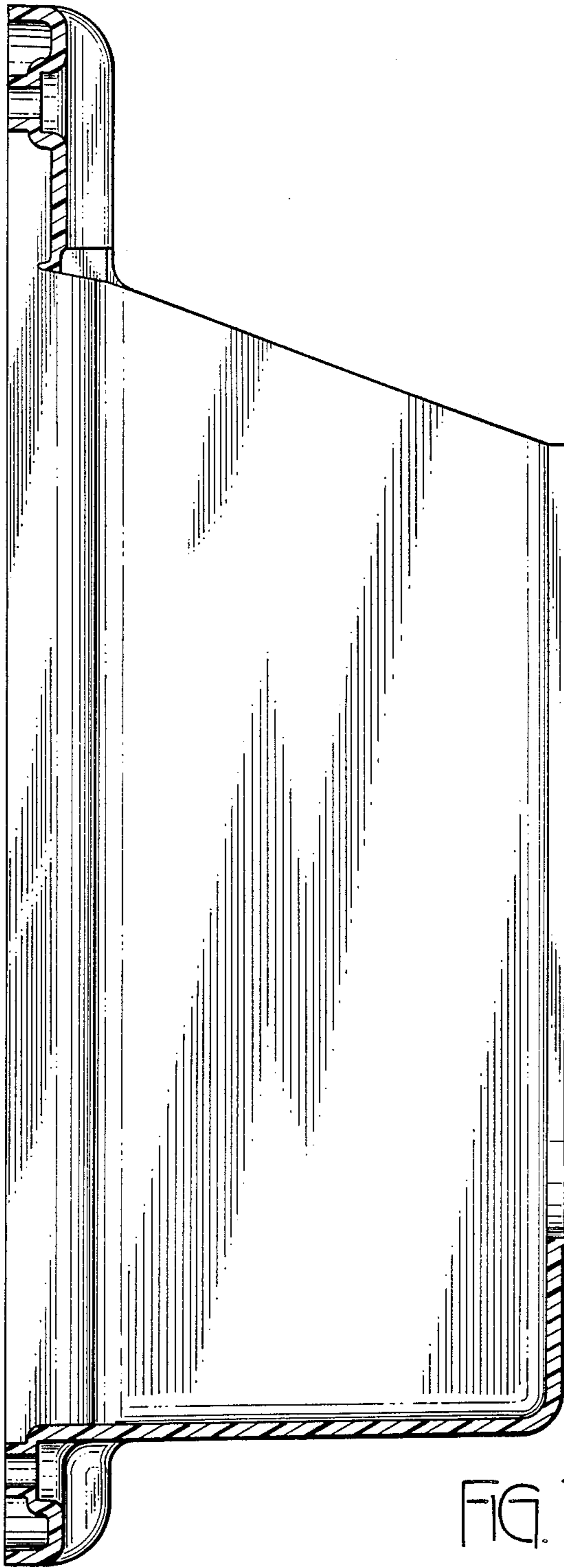
