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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a non-slip surface unit for bathtubs or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a non-slip surface unit for bathtubs or the like showing a bath mat the bottom being plain and unornamented;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1; the opposite end being a mirror image of the end shown;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the non-slip surface unit for bathtubs or the like showing bathtub treads, the bottom being the same as the top shown;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 4, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 6 is an end elevational view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 4; the opposite end being a mirror image of the end shown;

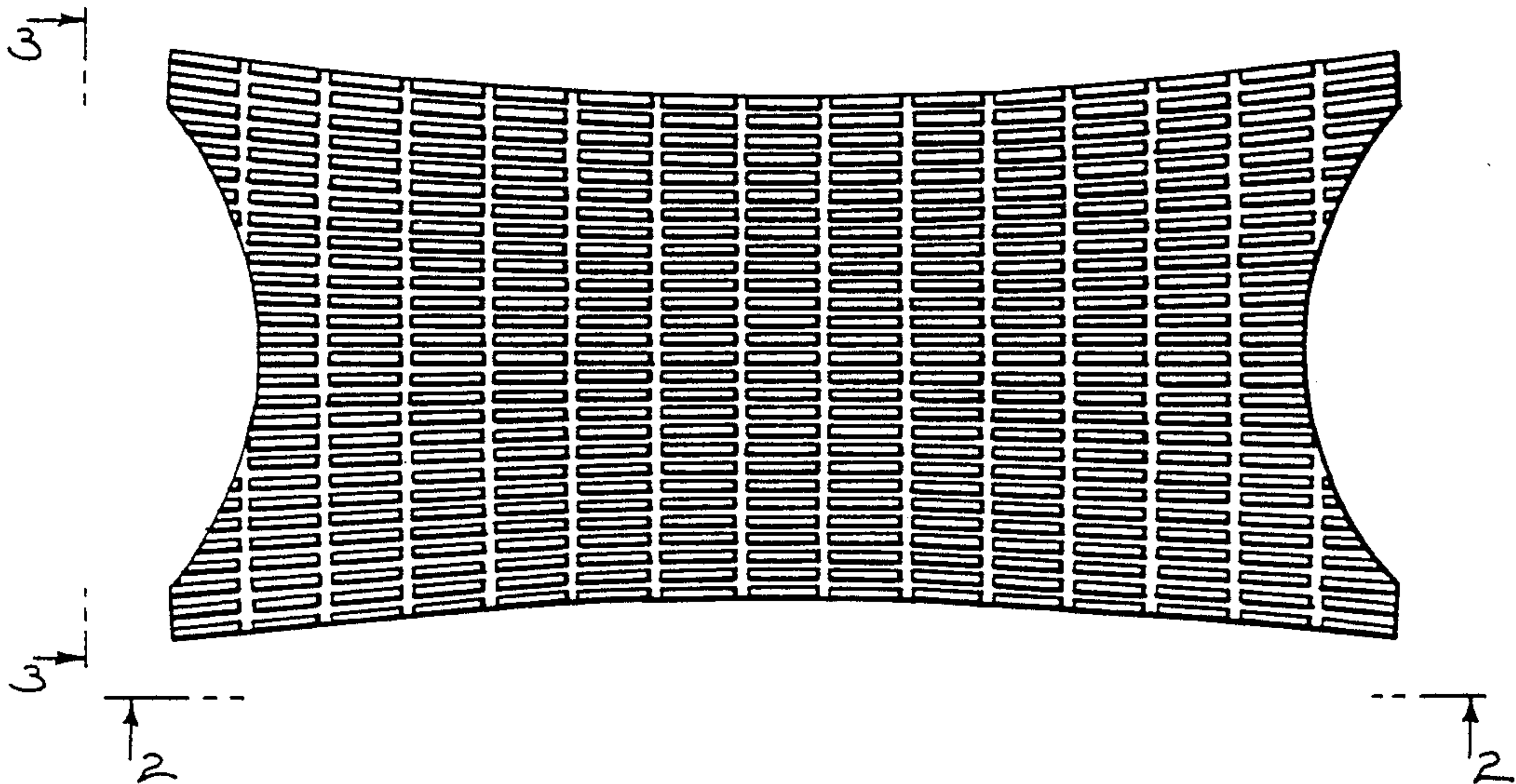


FIG. 7; the opposite end being a mirror image of the end shown;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of the non-slip surface unit for bathtubs or the like showing a bathtub floor panel, the bottom being plain and unornamented;
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view taken on line 8—8 of FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 9 is an end elevational view taken on line 9—9 of

FIG. 10 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken on line 10—10 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of the non-slip surface unit for bathtubs or the like showing a bathtub floor panel, the bottom being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view taken on line 12—12

of FIG. 10, the opposite side being the same as the side shown;

FIG. 13 is an end elevational view taken on line 13—13 of FIG. 10, the opposite end being a mirror image of the end shown; and

FIG. 14 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken on line 14—14 of FIG. 10.

The fragmentary broken lines representation of the outline of a bathtub in FIGS. 7 and 11 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.

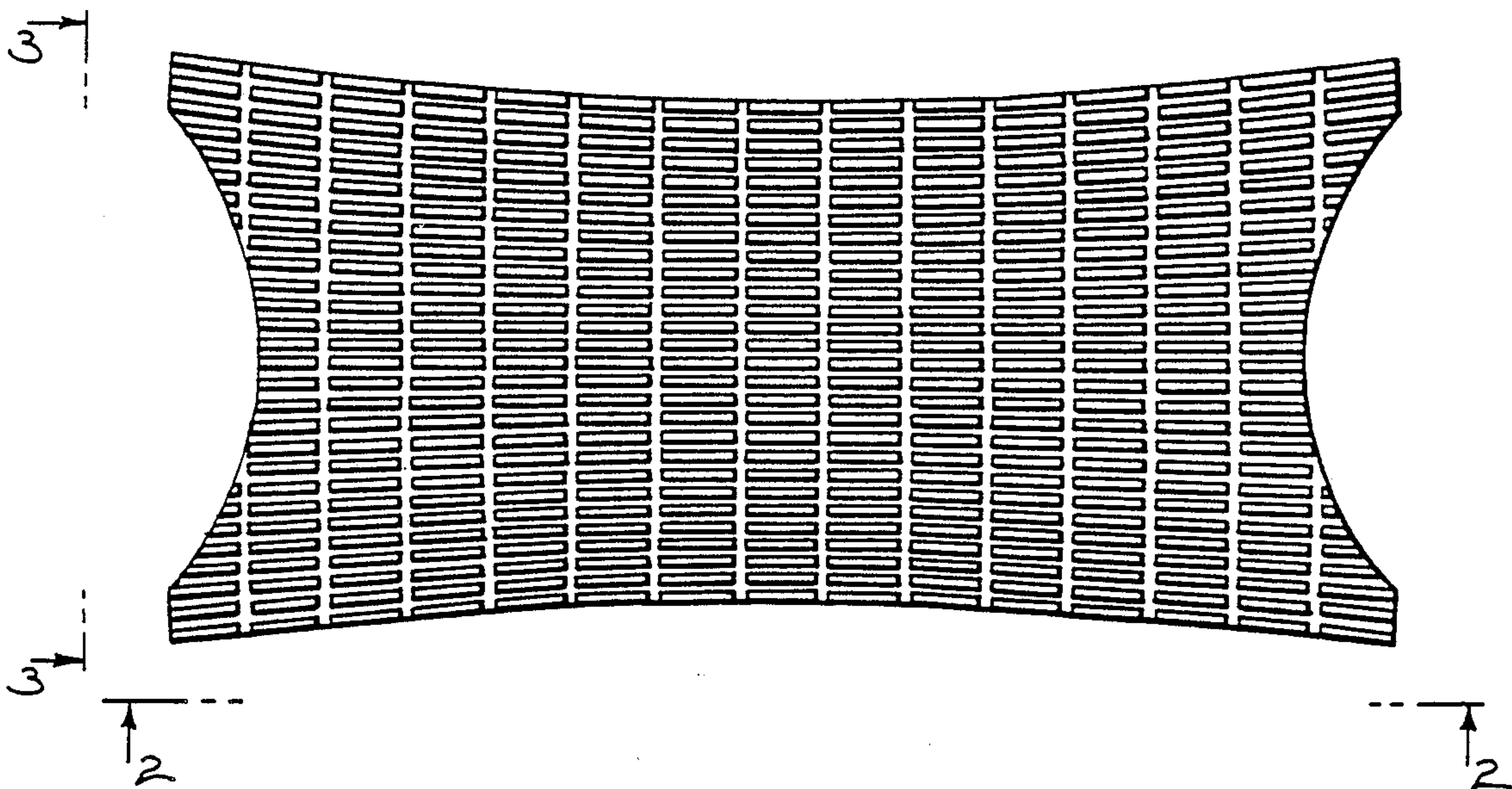

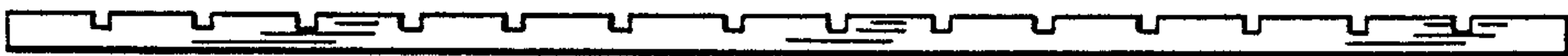
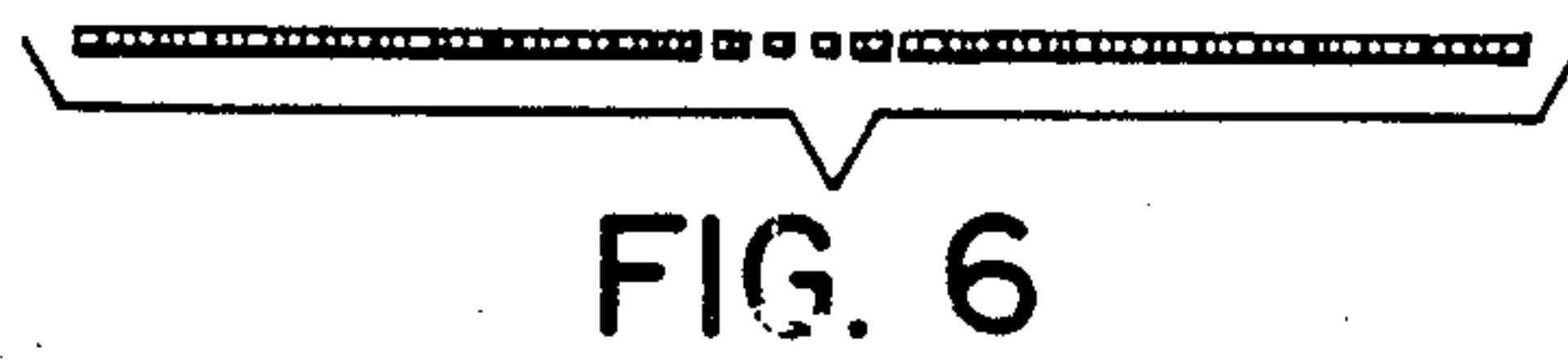
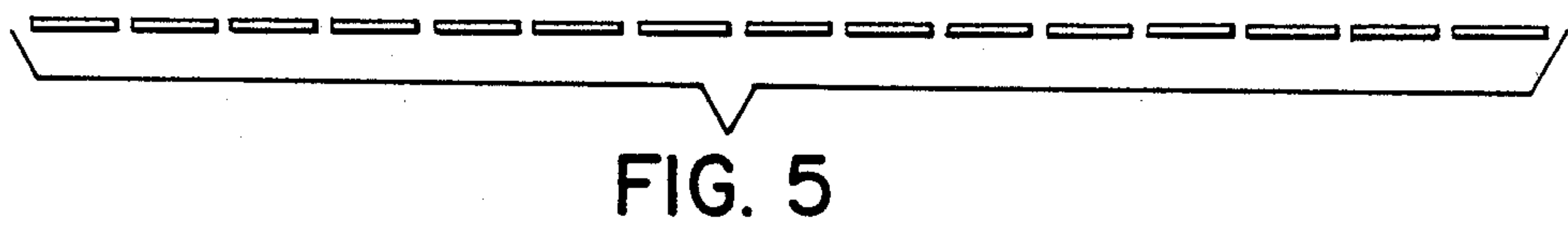
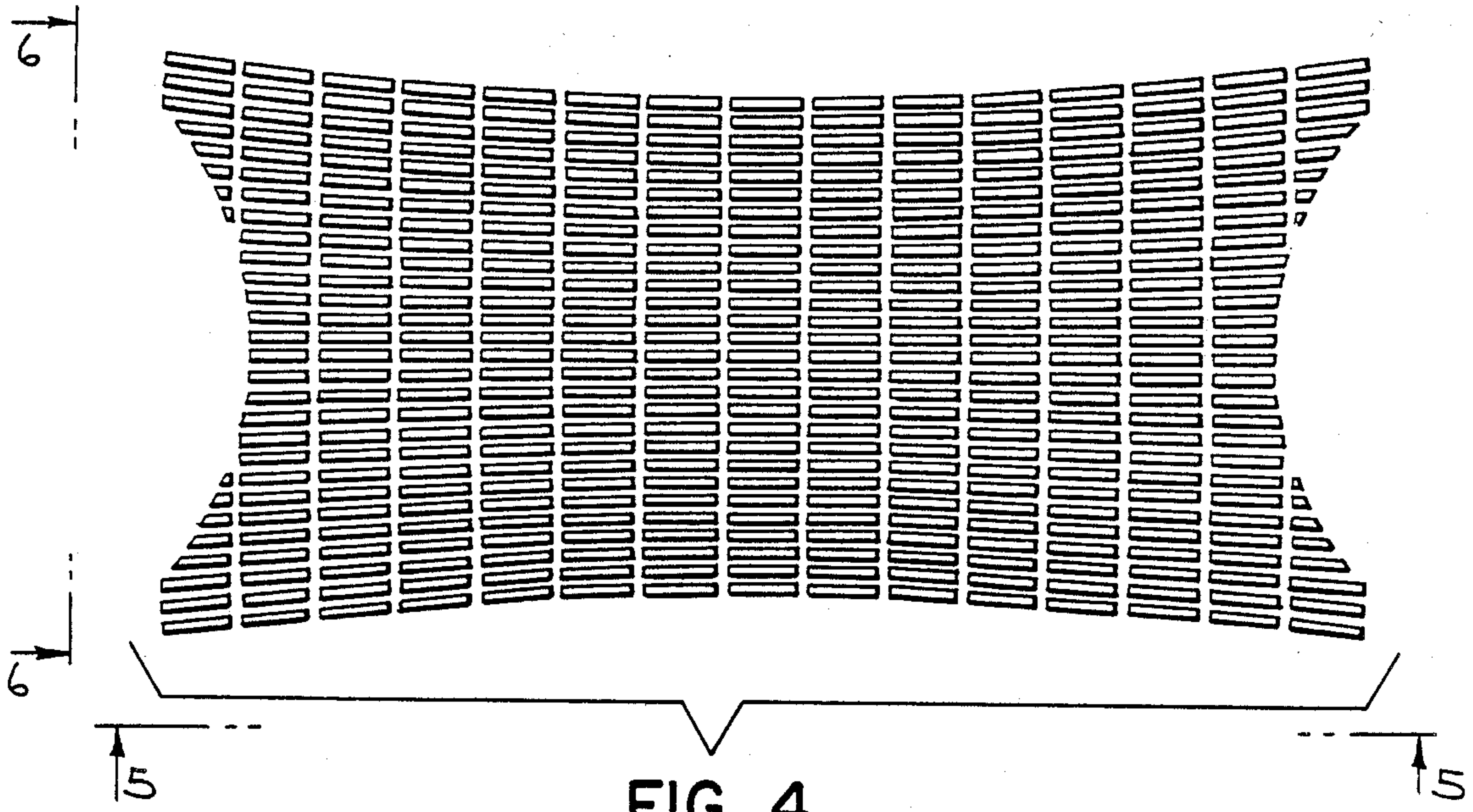

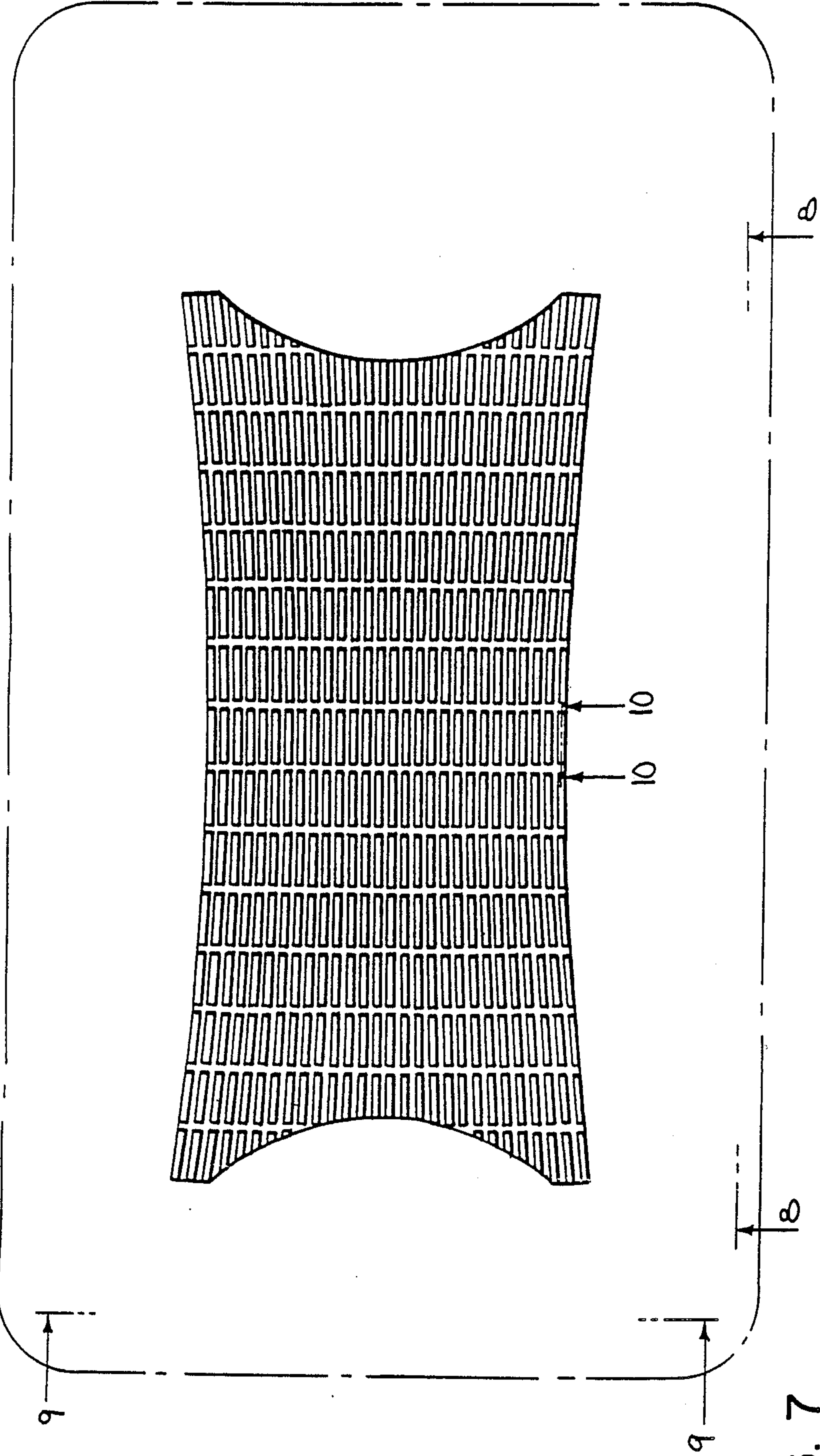

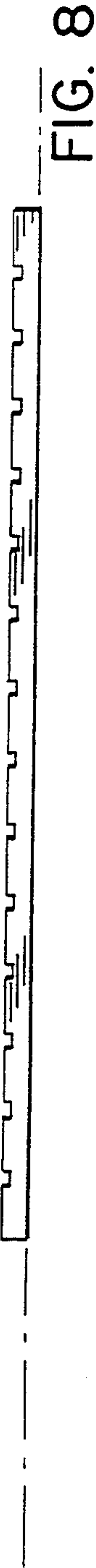

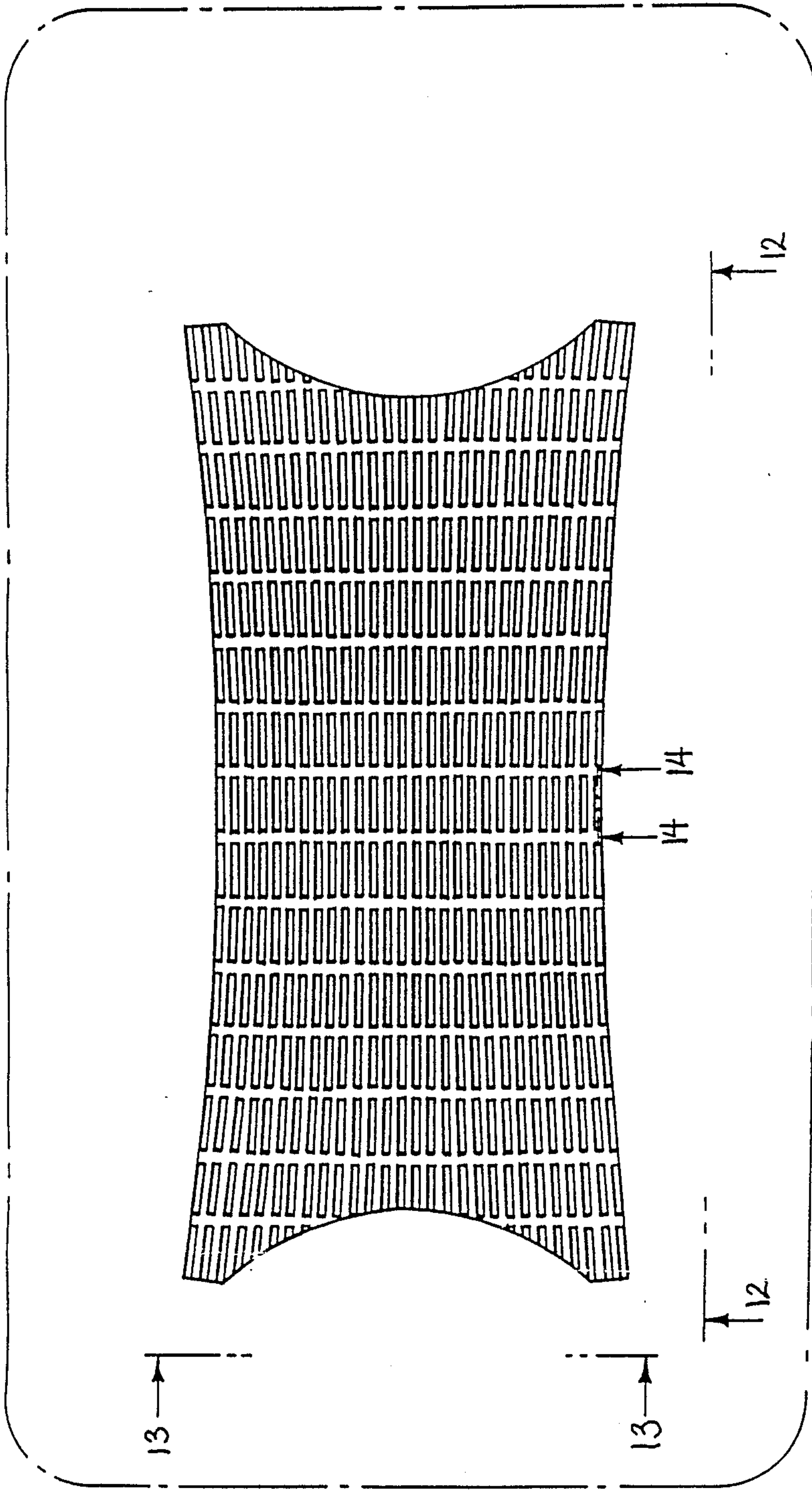

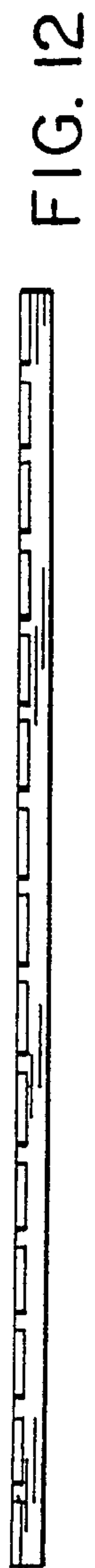
