arrows.

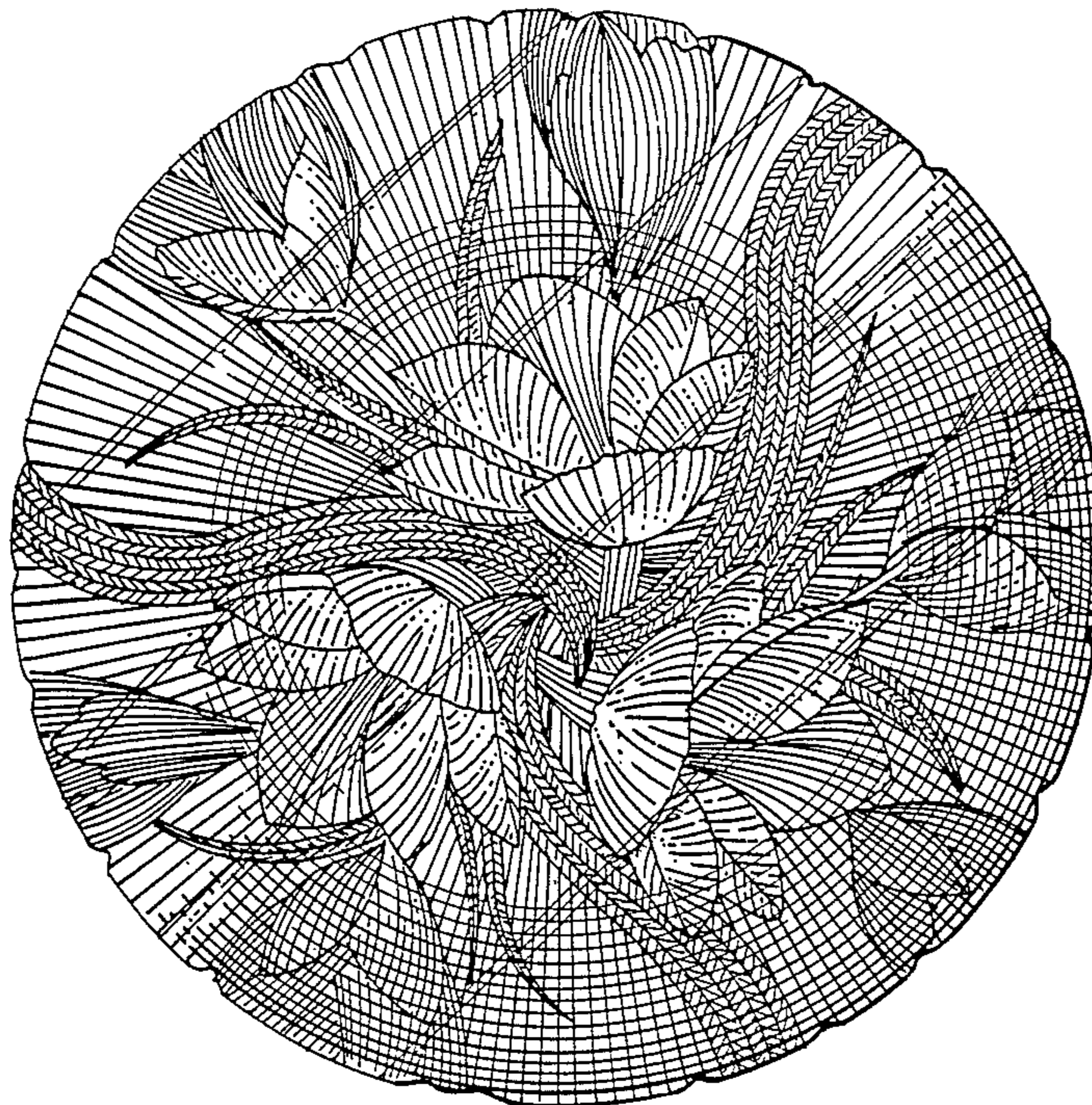

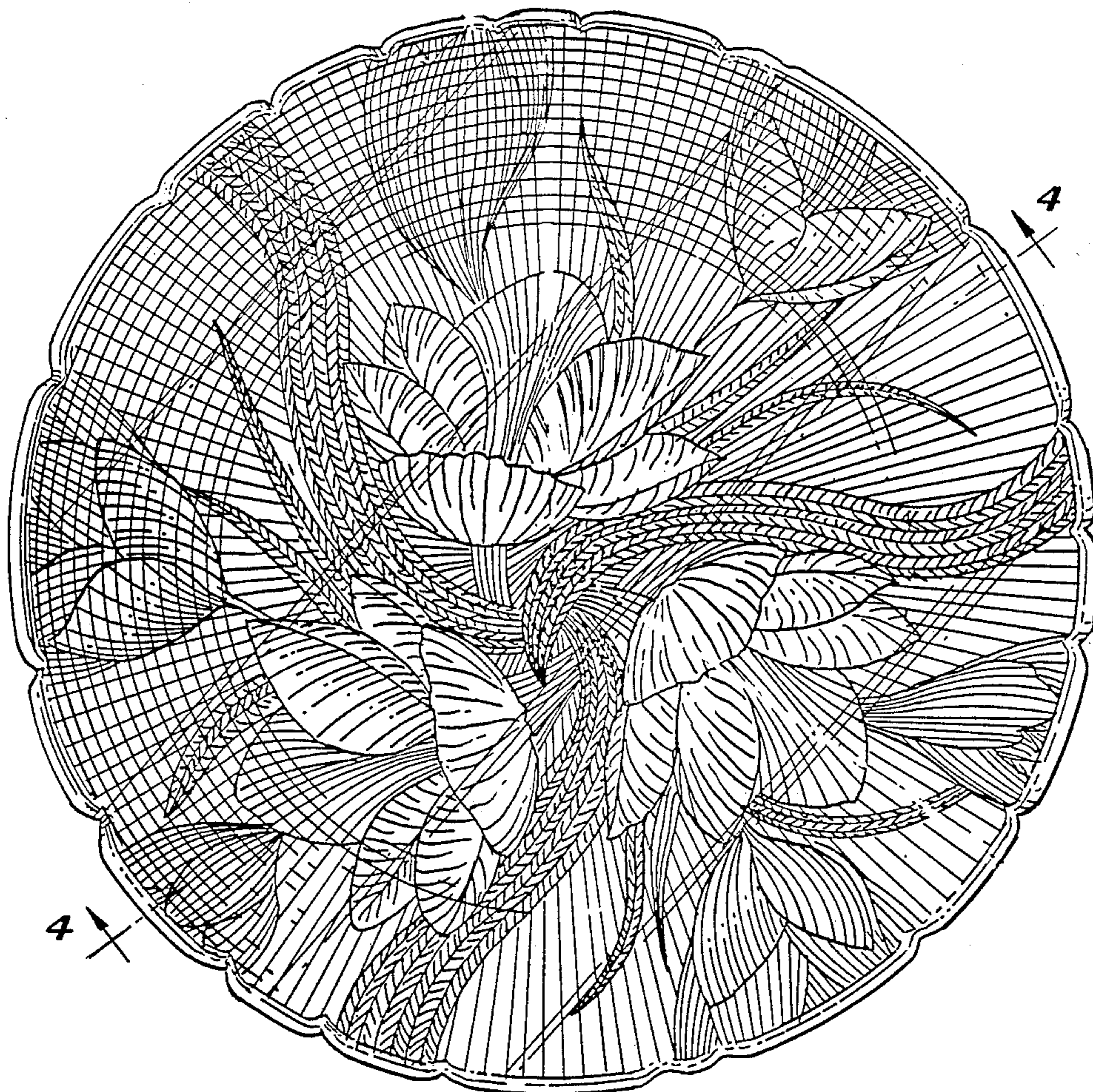

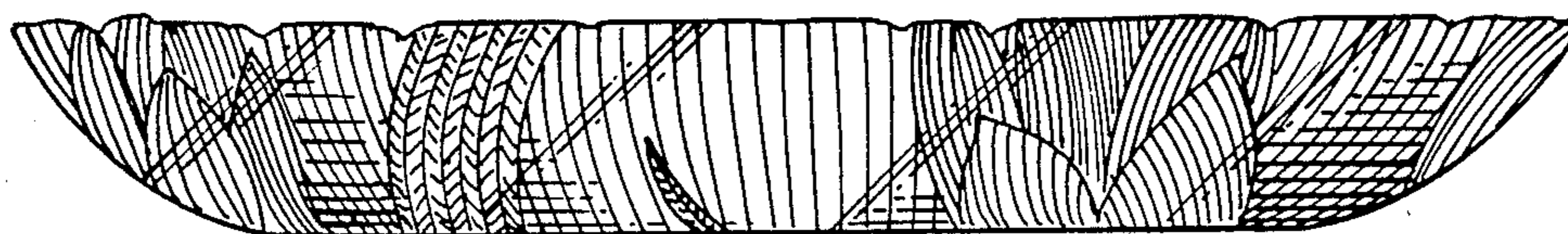

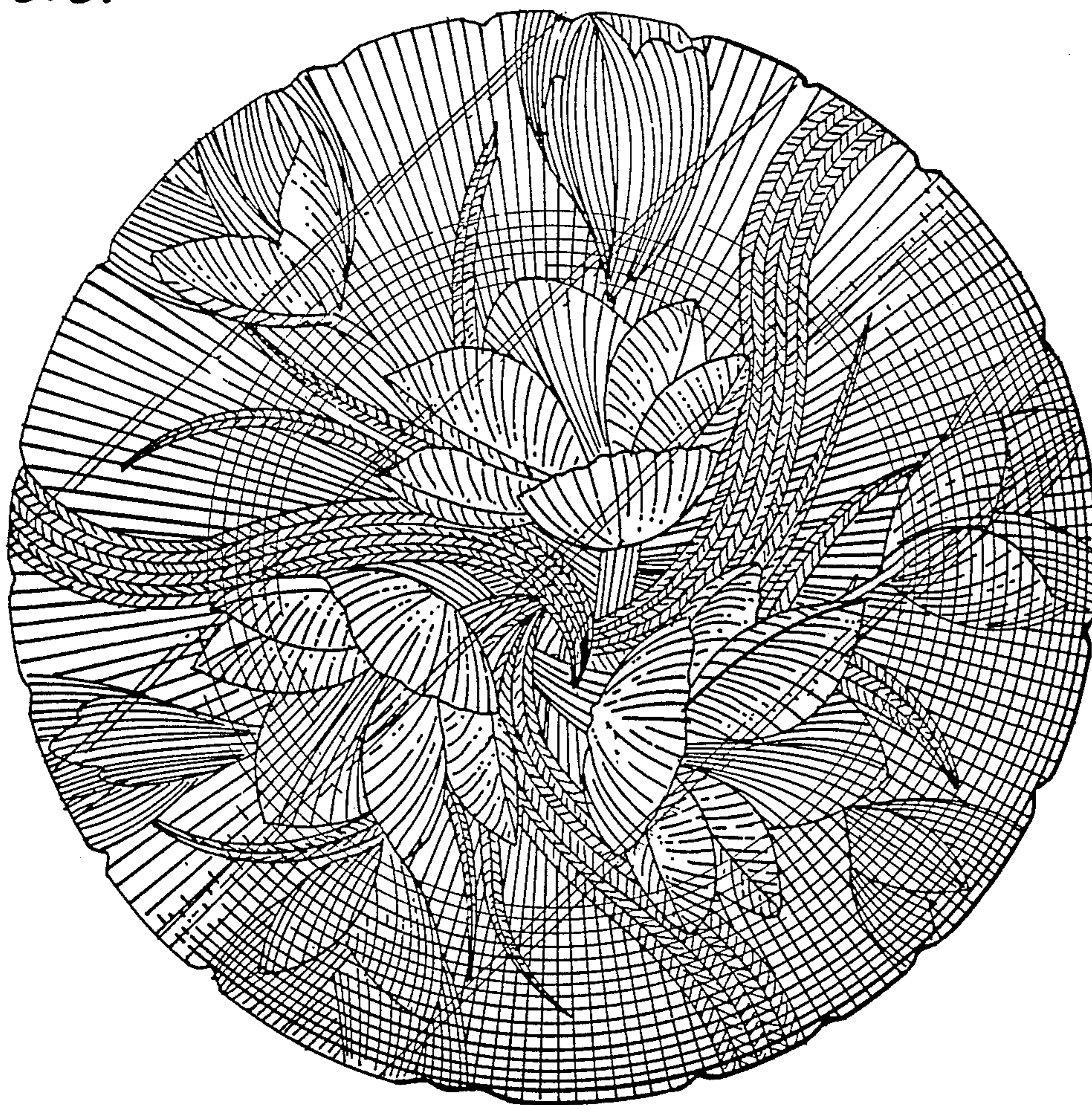
