DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof.

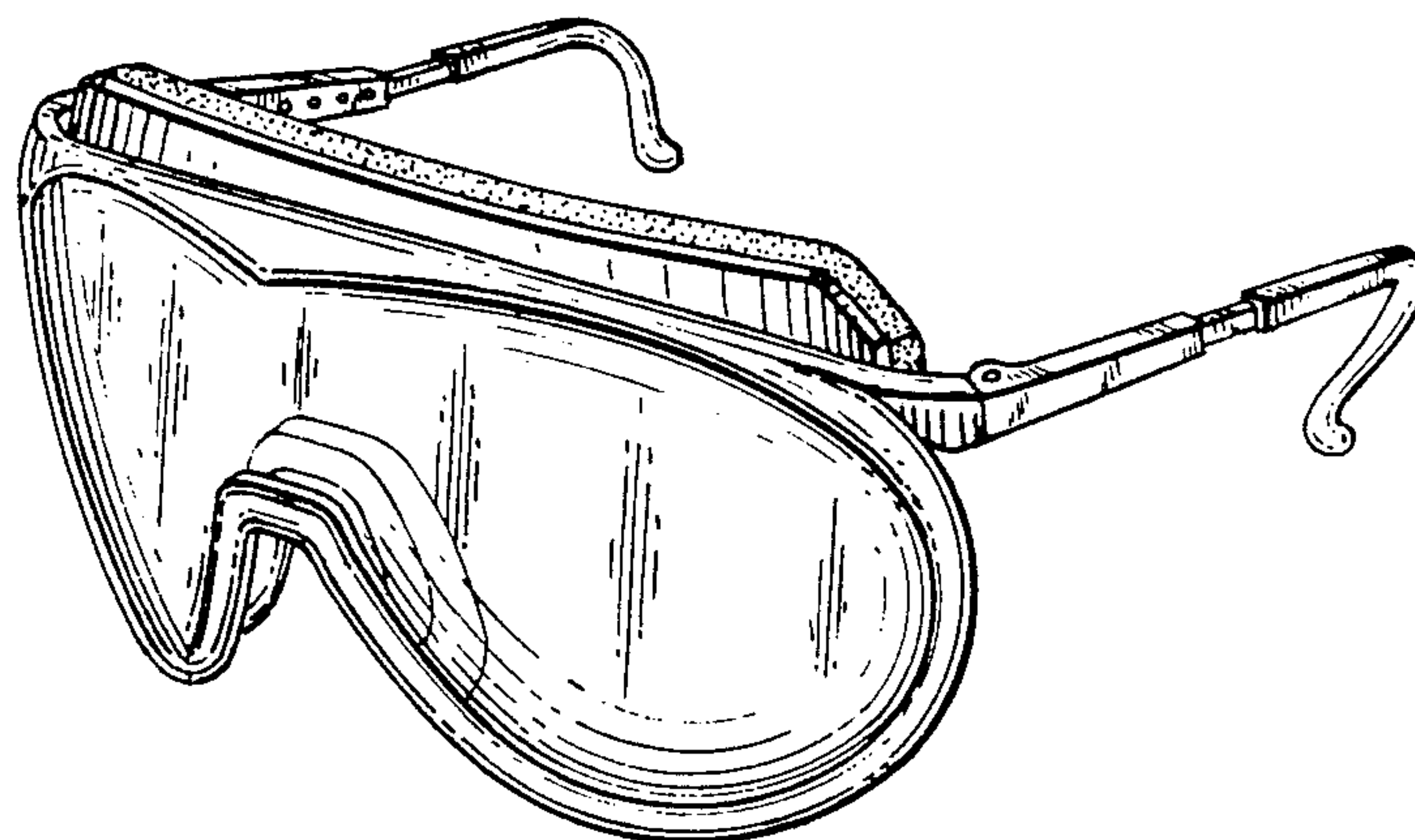

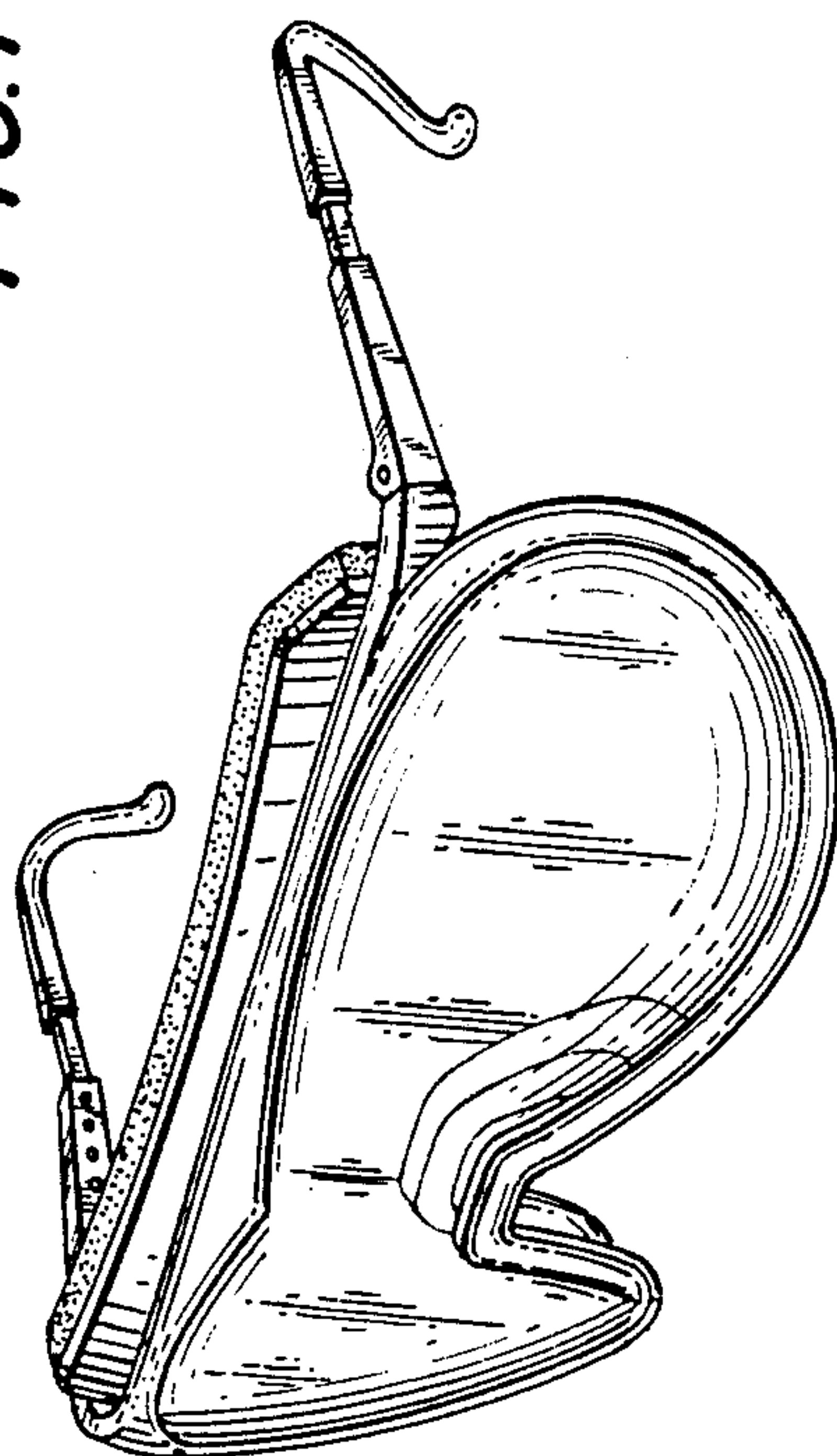

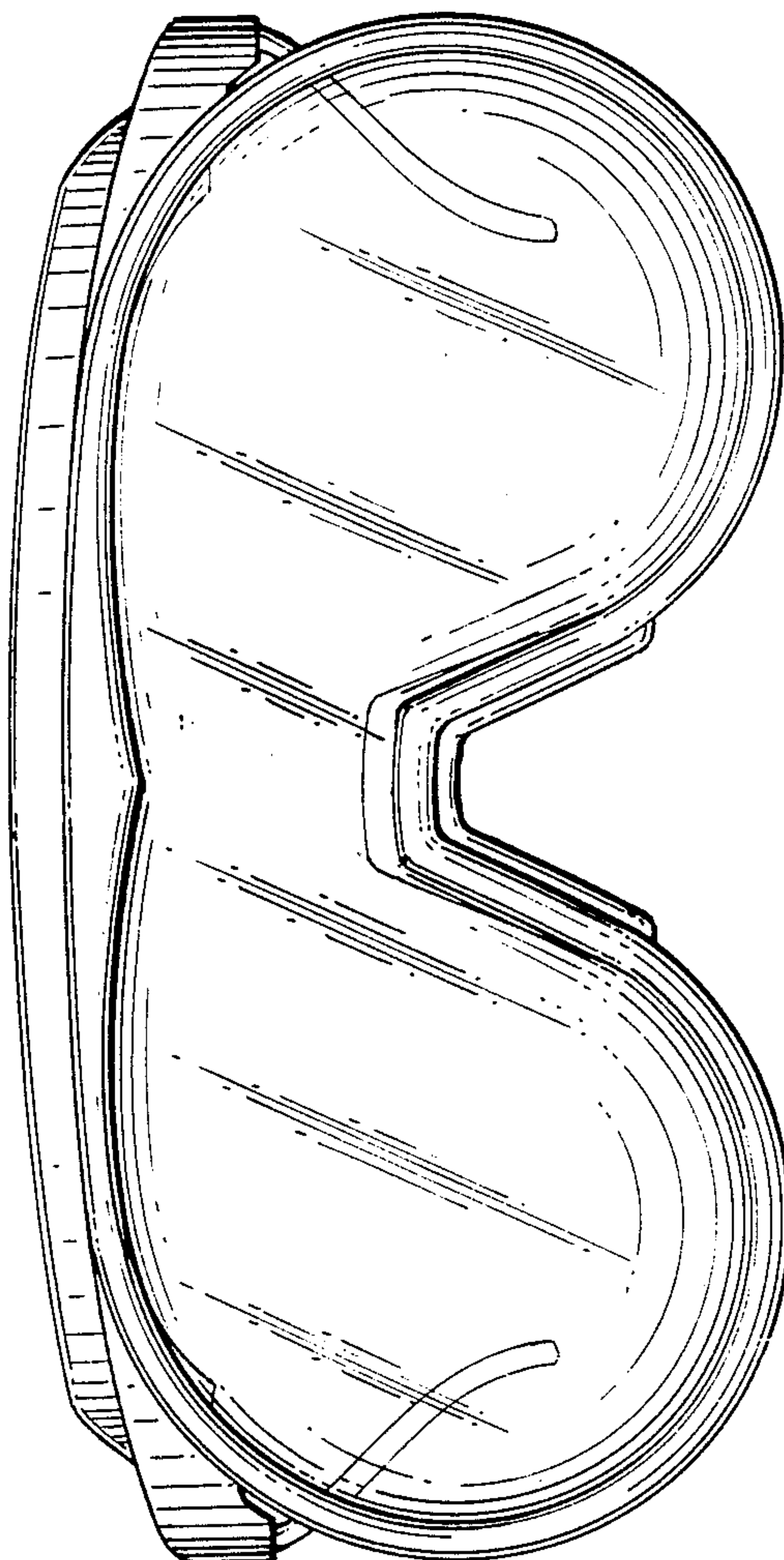

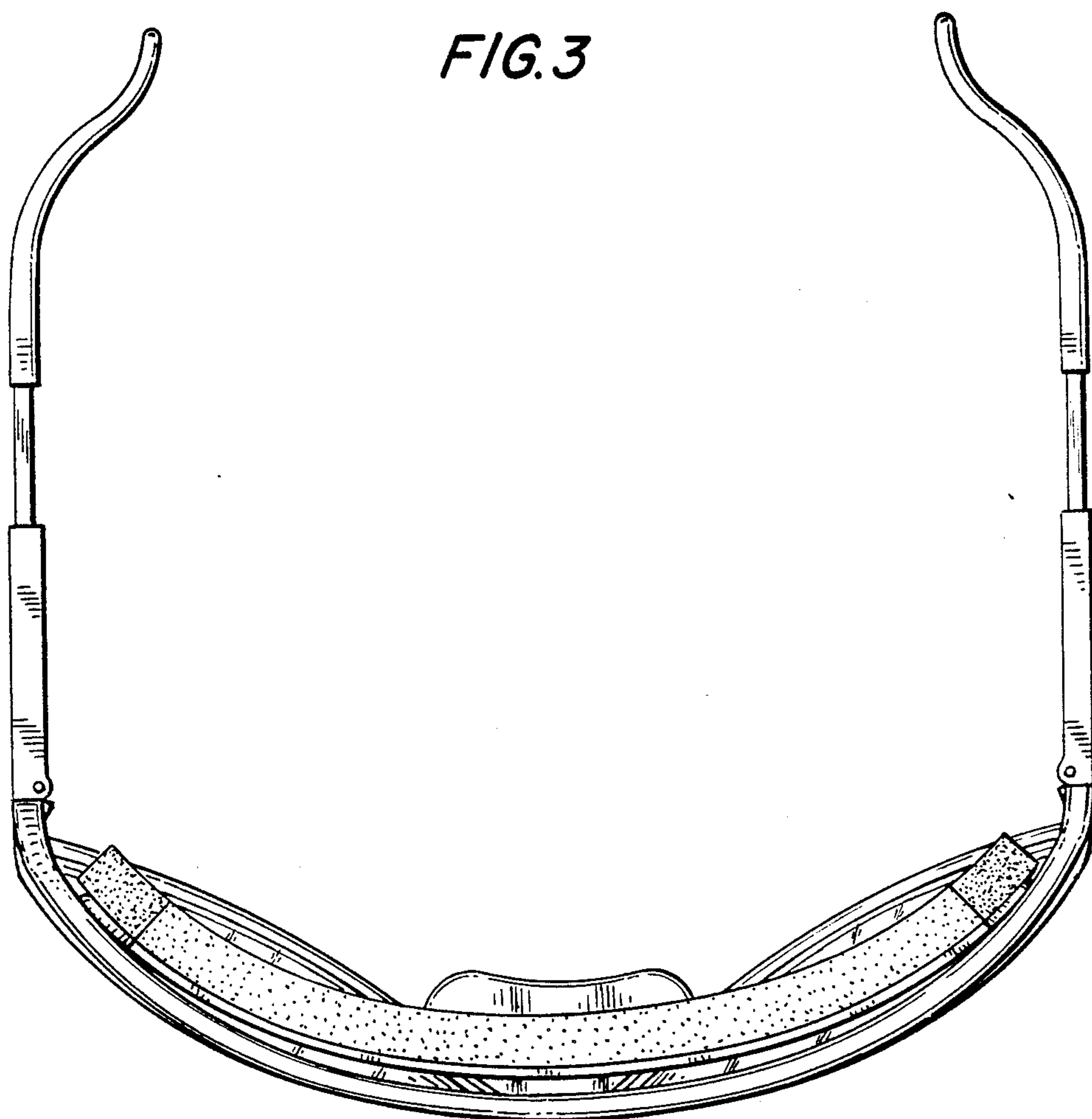

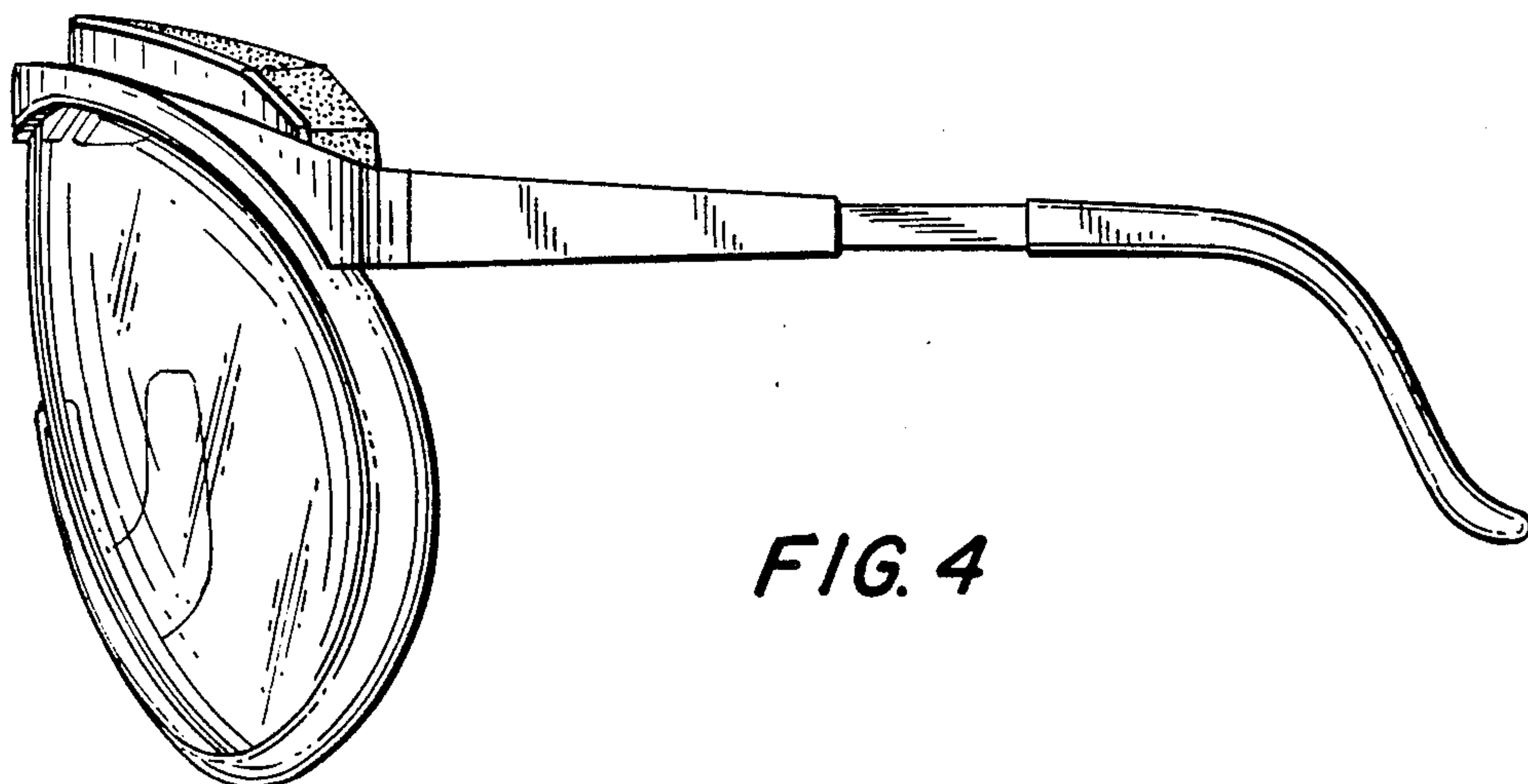

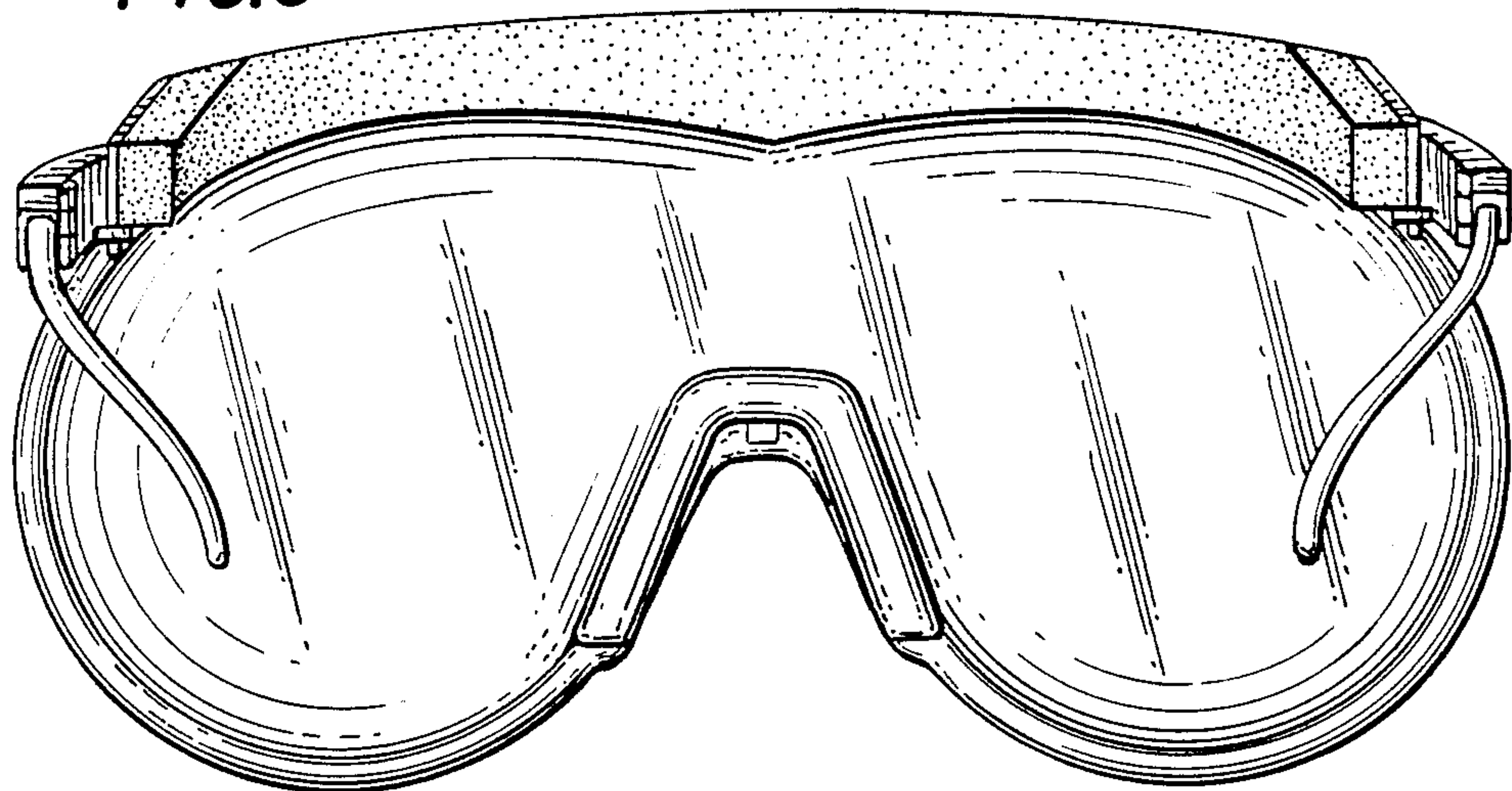
