The ornamental design for a bathroom faucet, as shown and described.

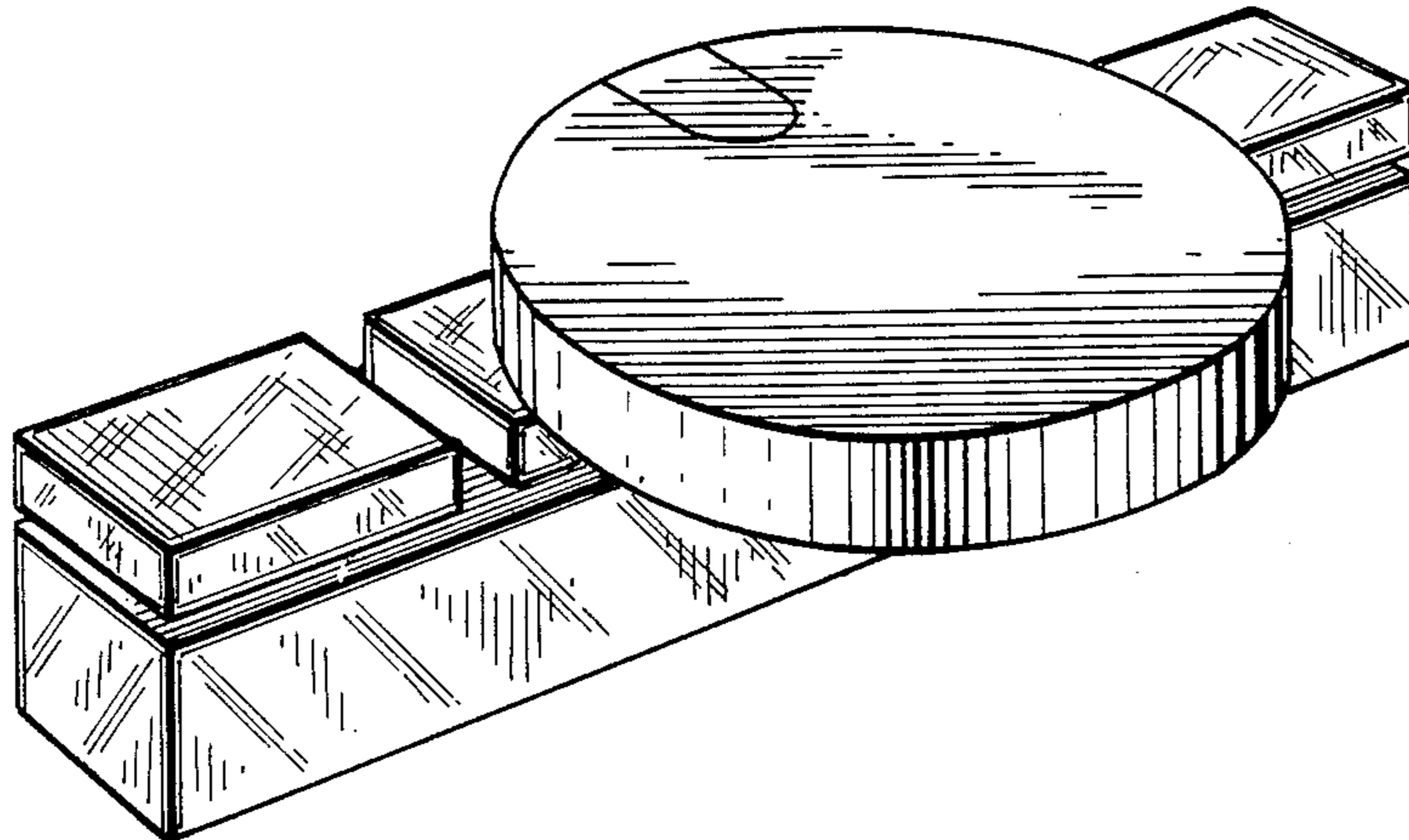
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a bathroom faucet showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown.



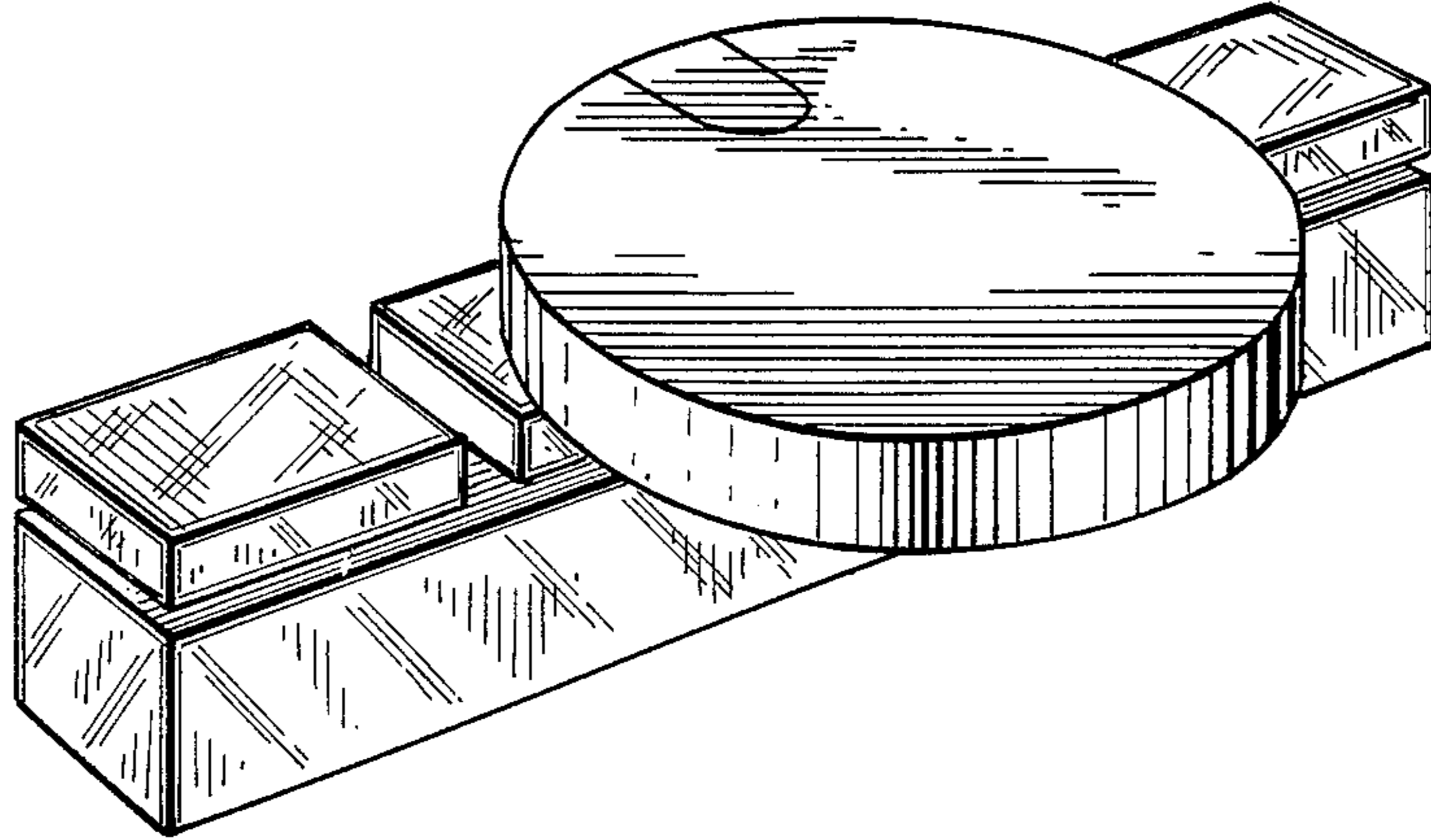

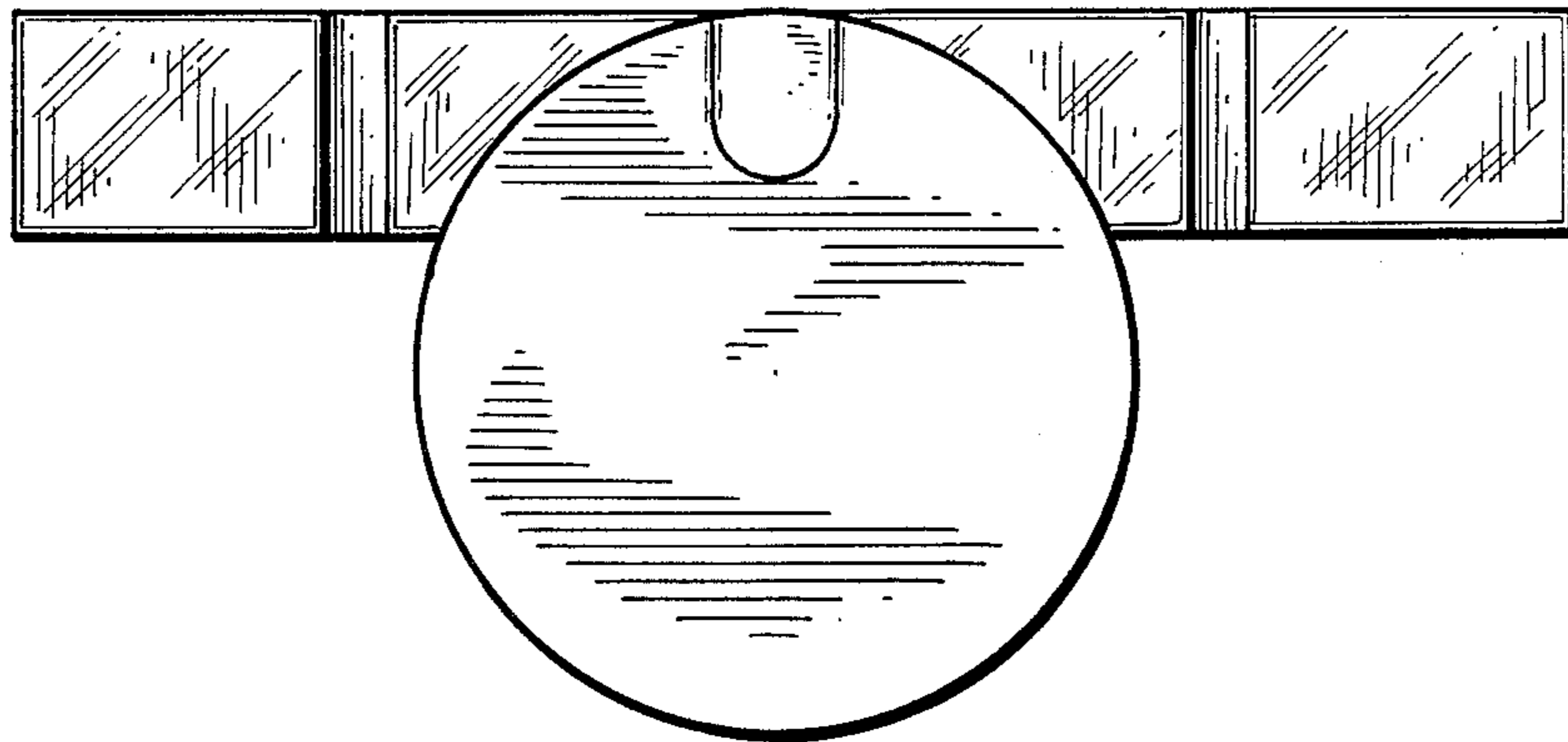

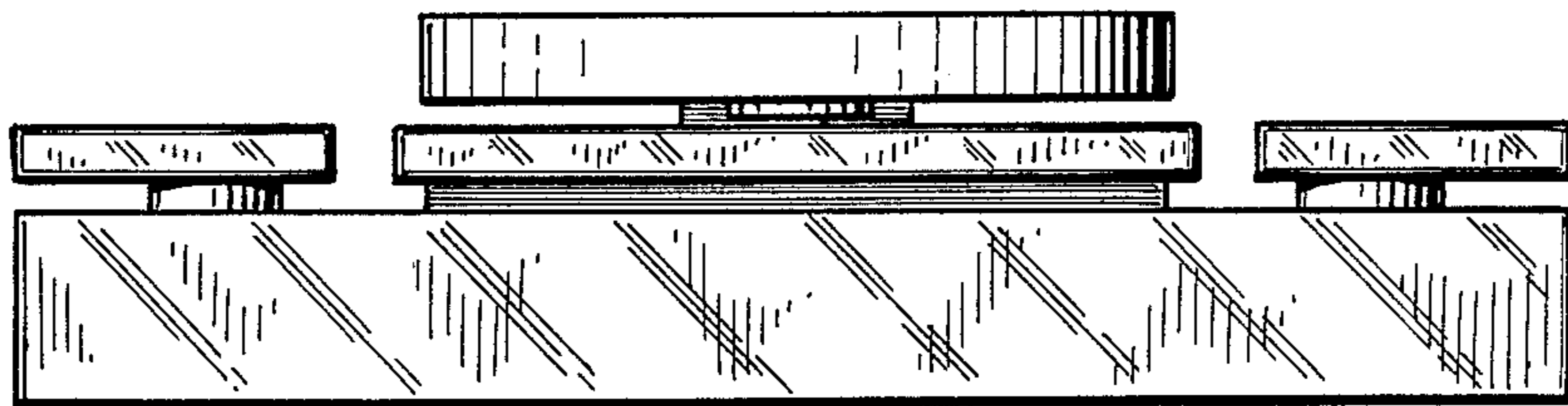

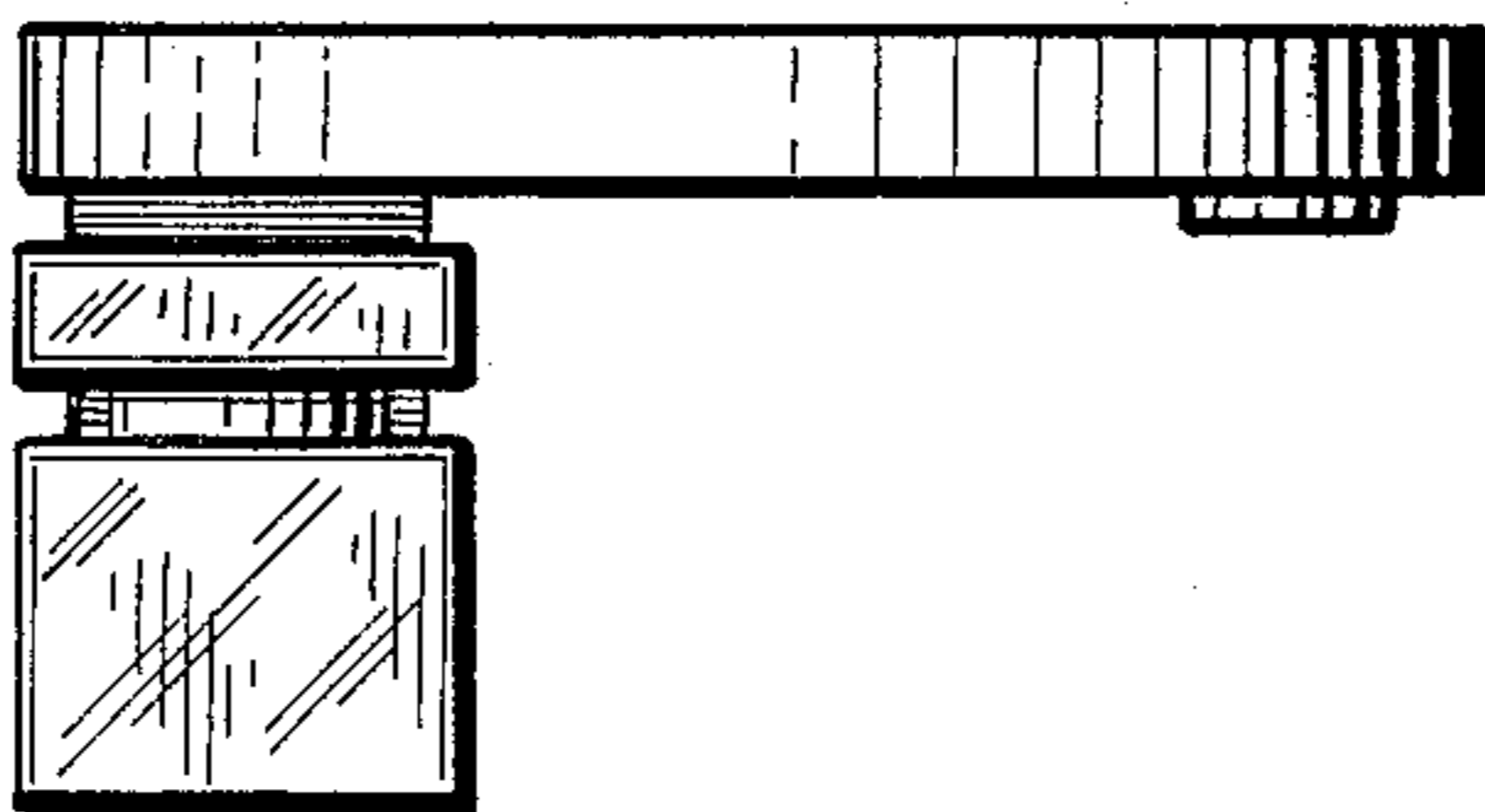
