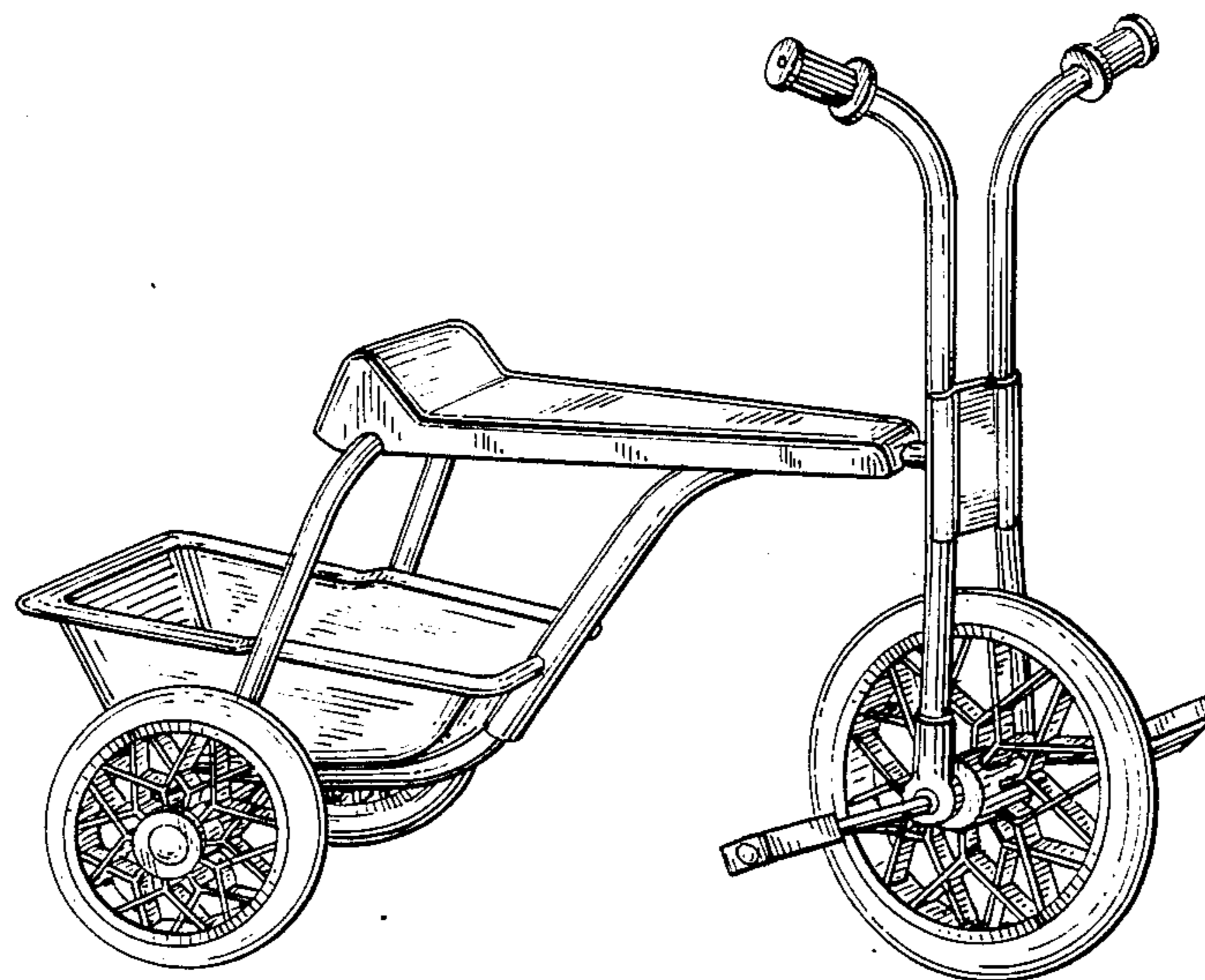

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tricycle showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



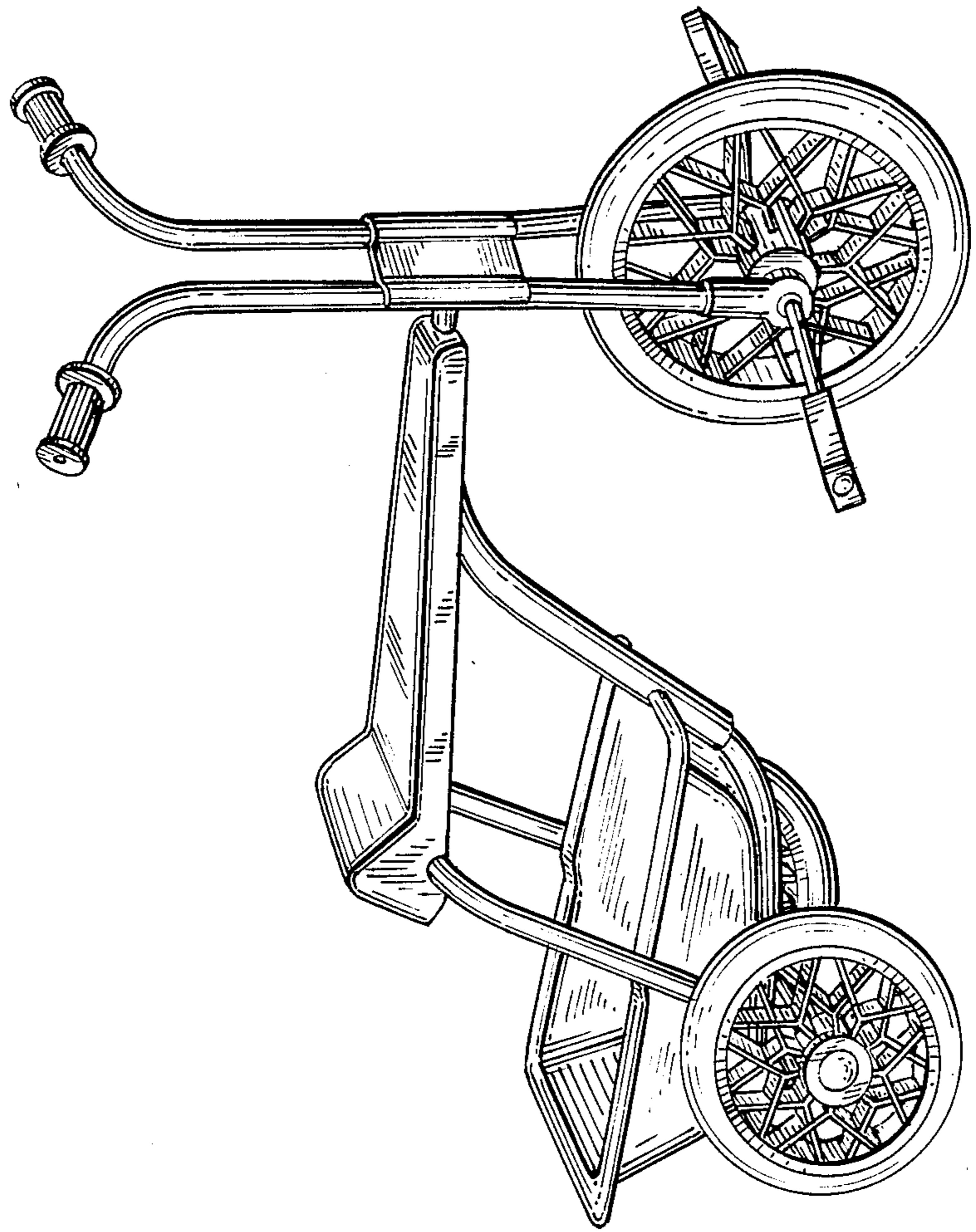

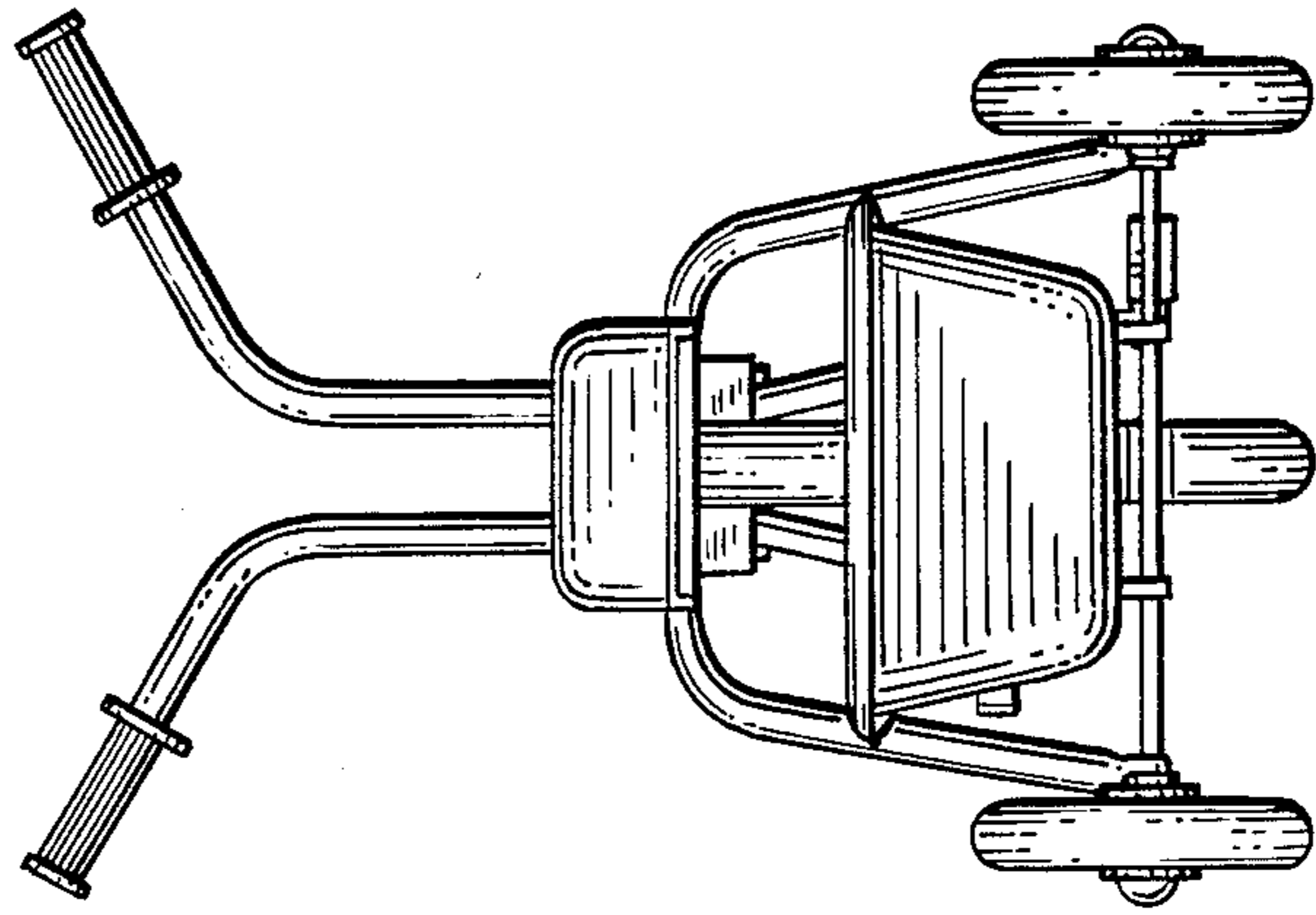
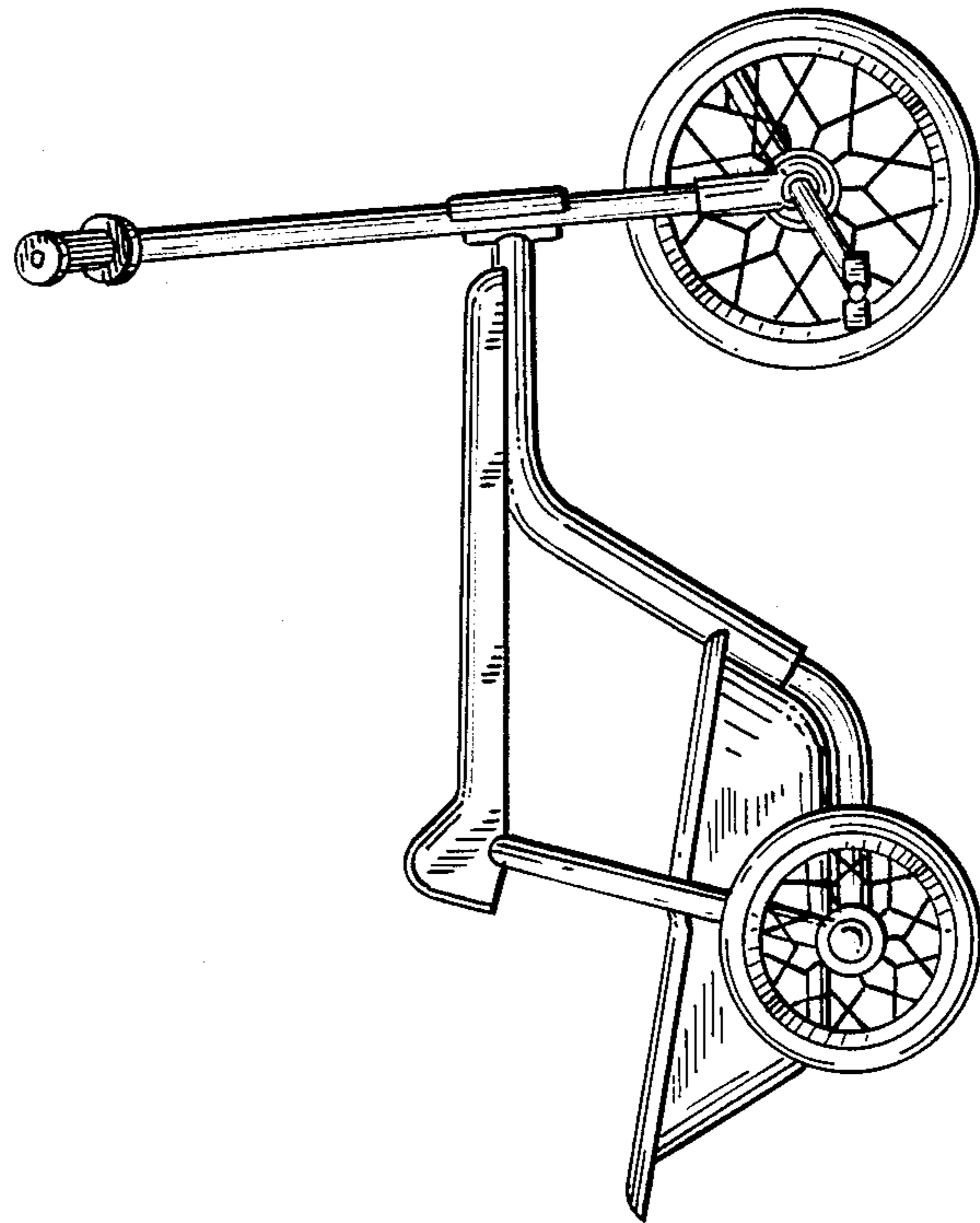

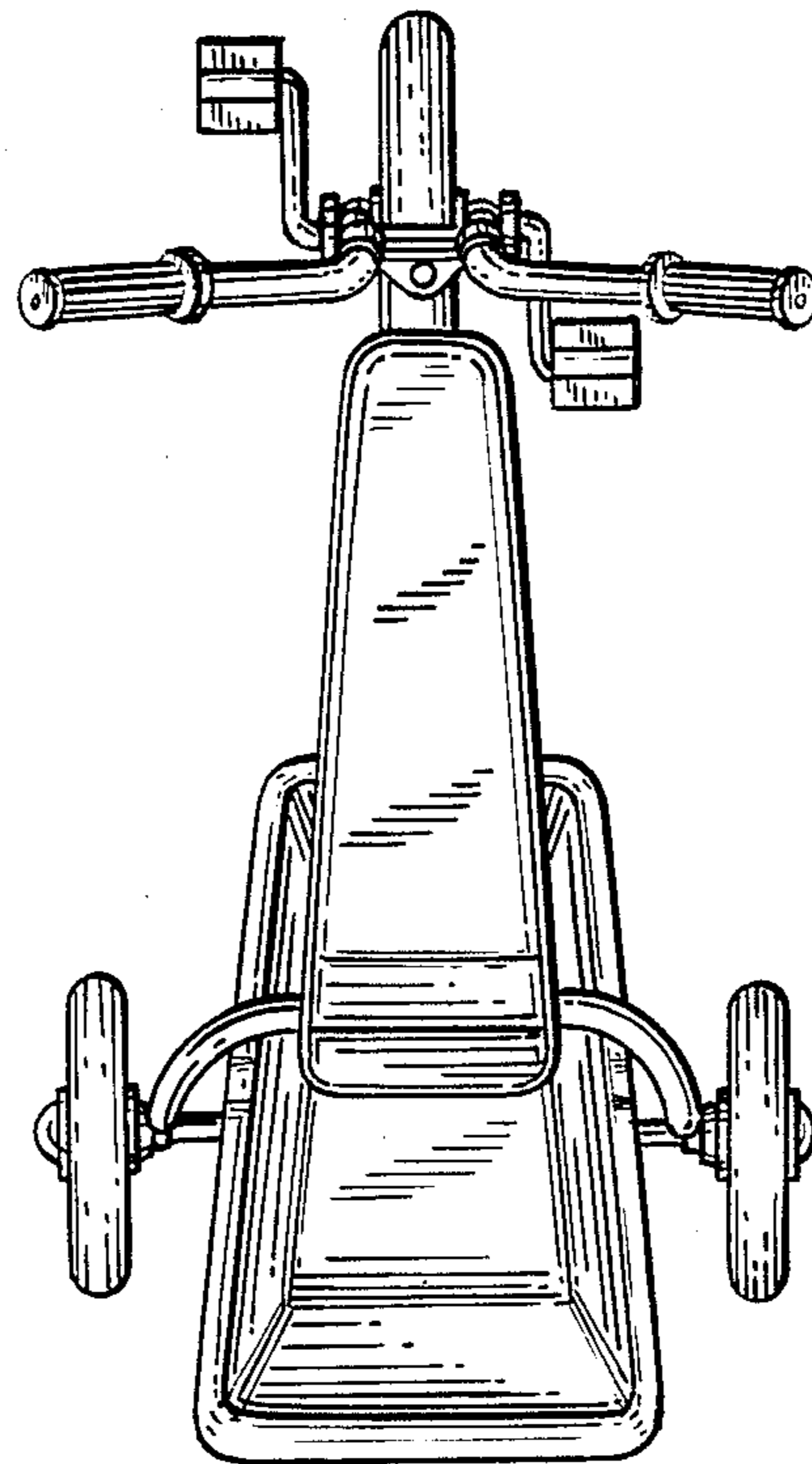

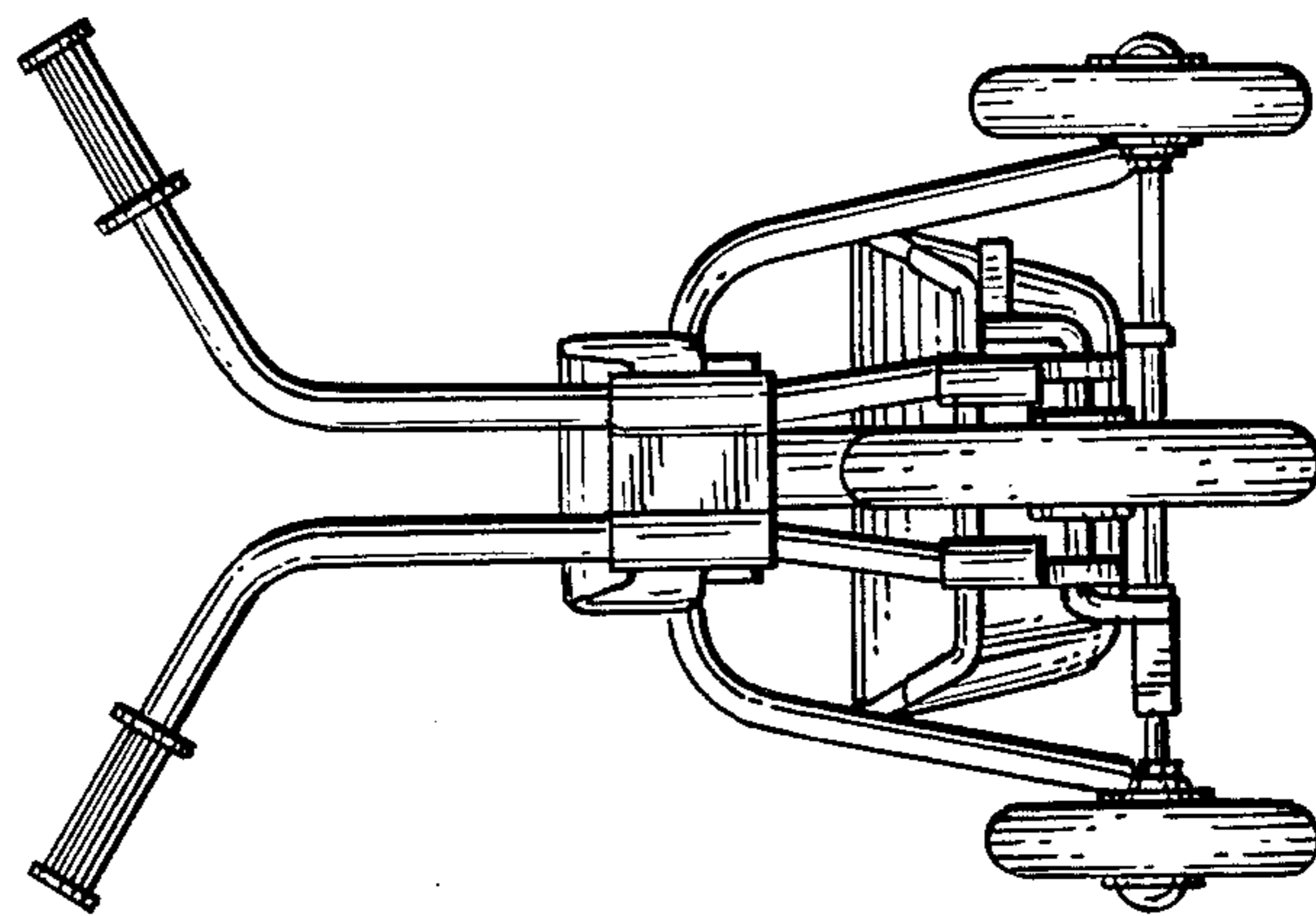
