The ornamental design for spectacles with apertured frame or similar article, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of spectacles with apertured frame or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

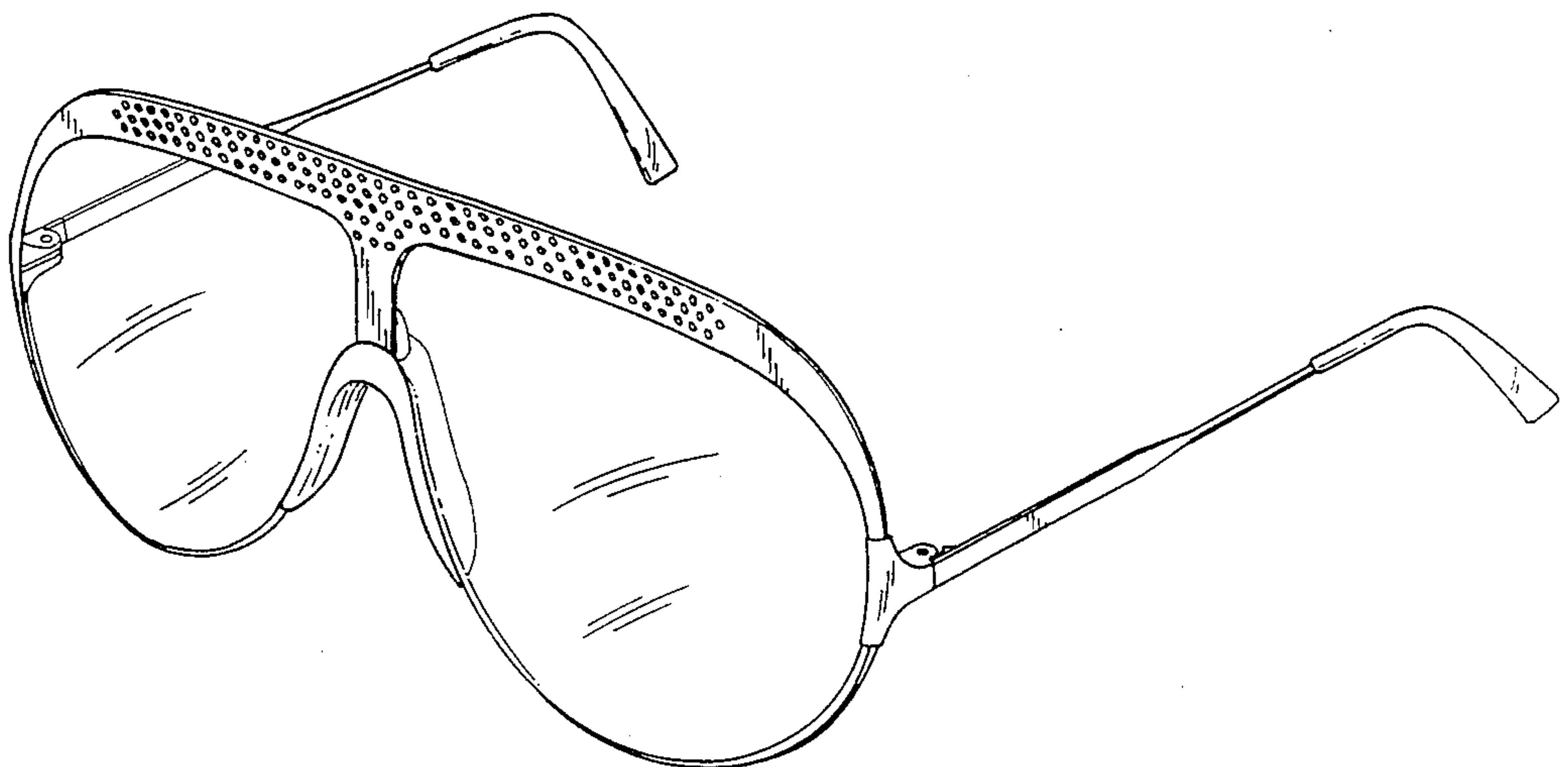
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 appearing in FIG. 2 and looking in the direction of the arrows.



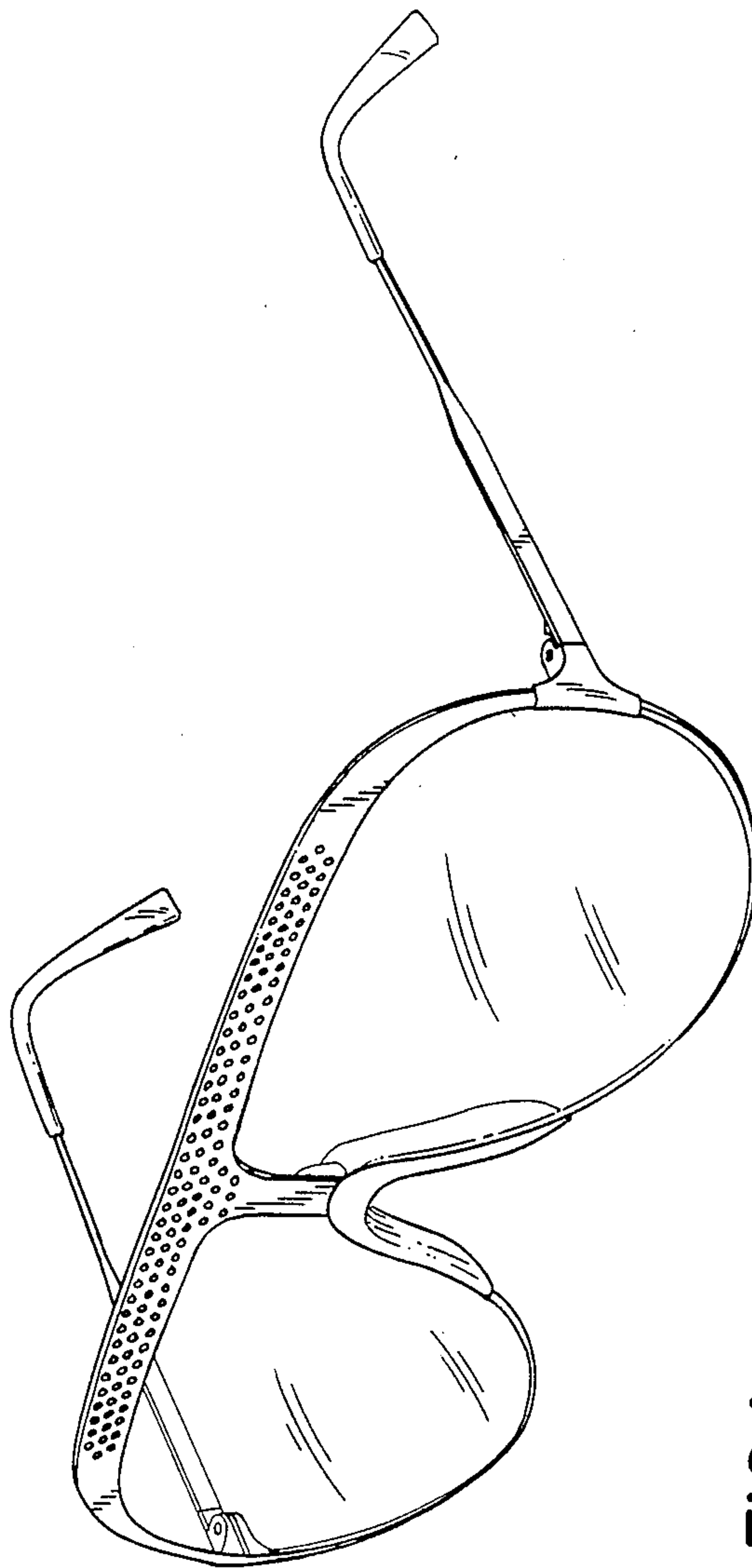

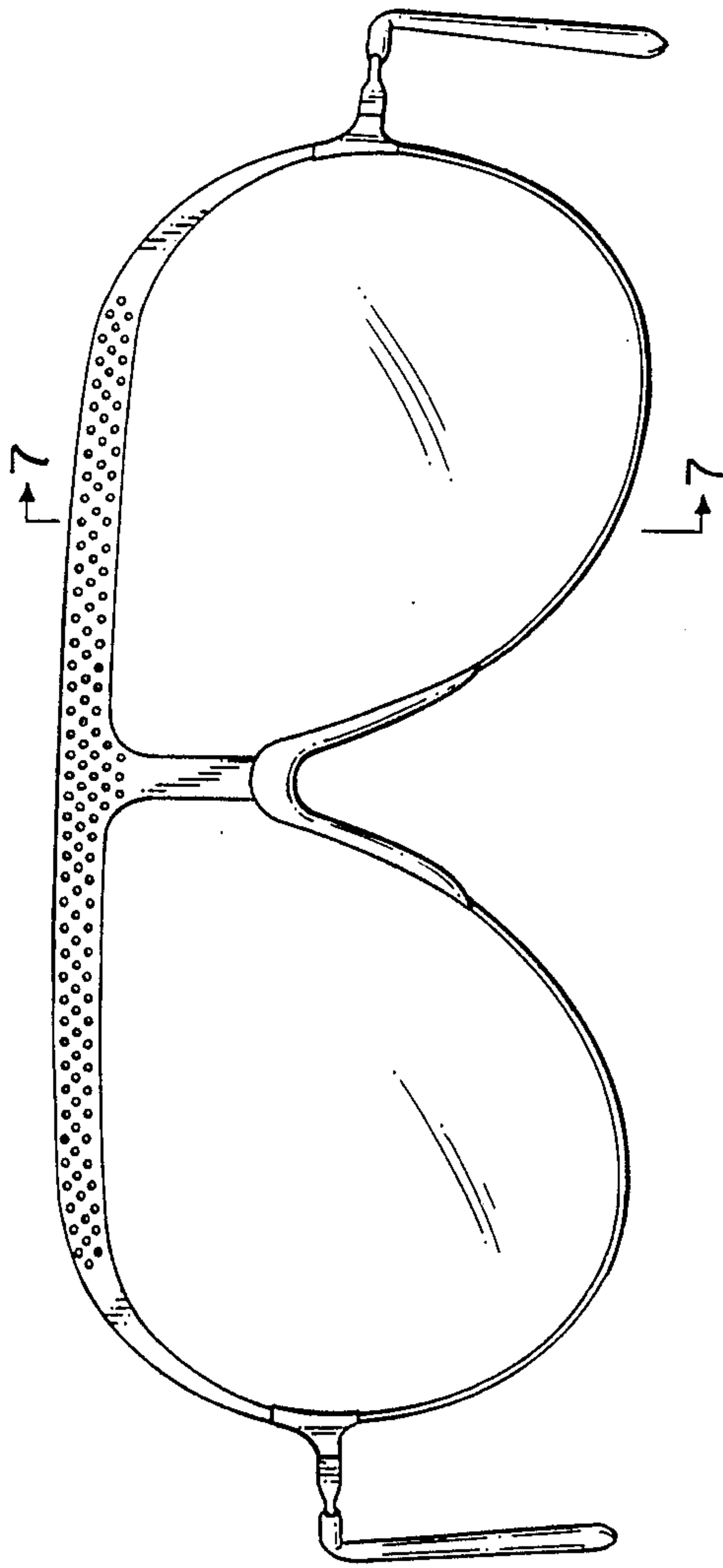

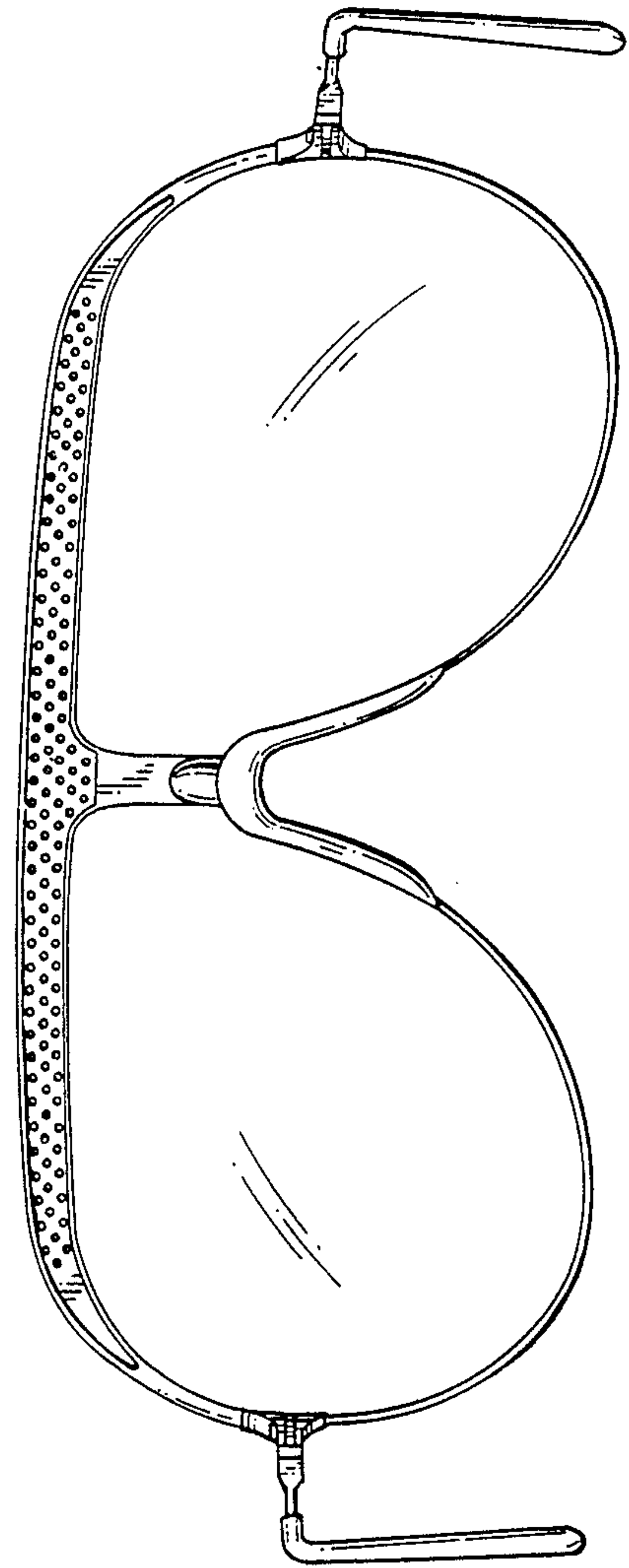

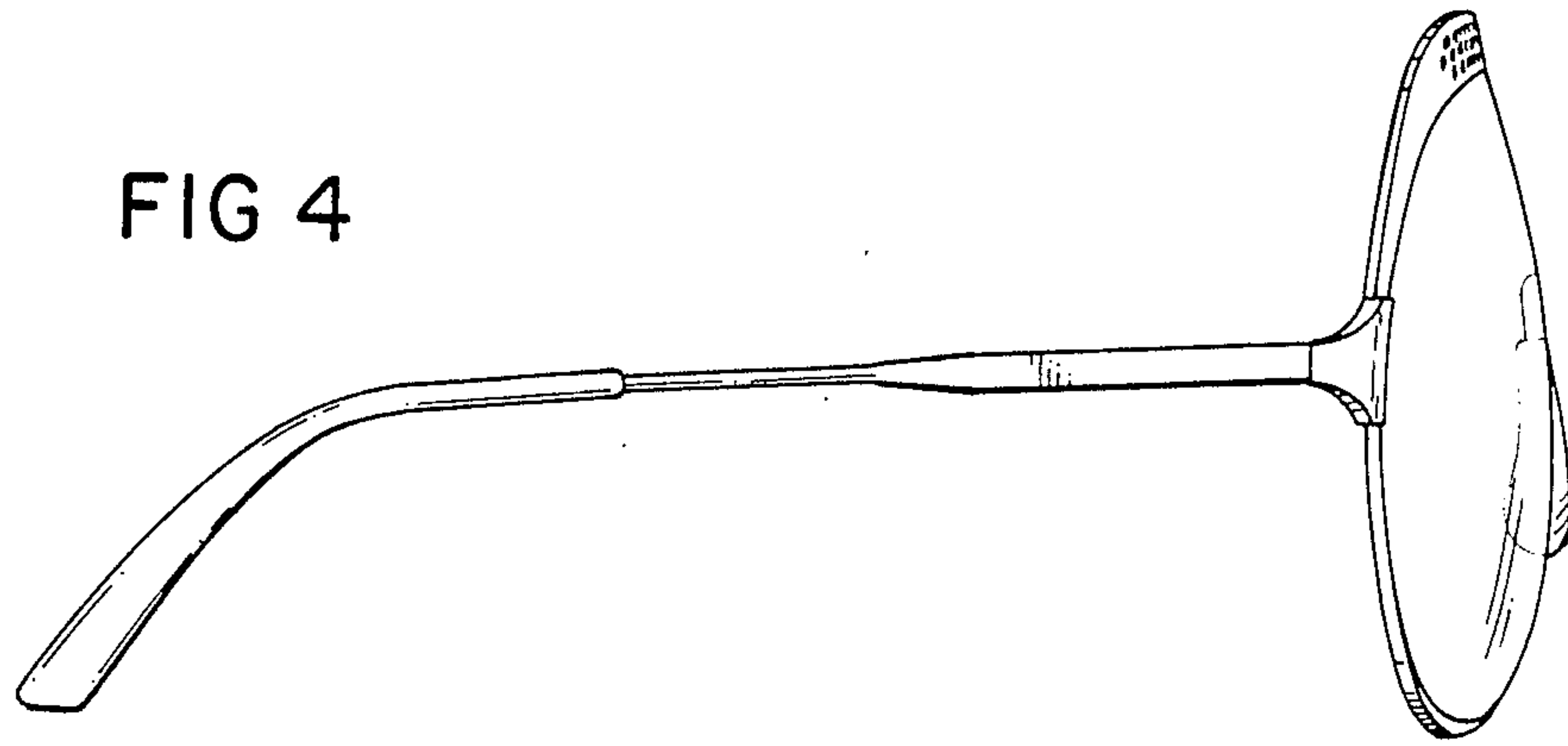
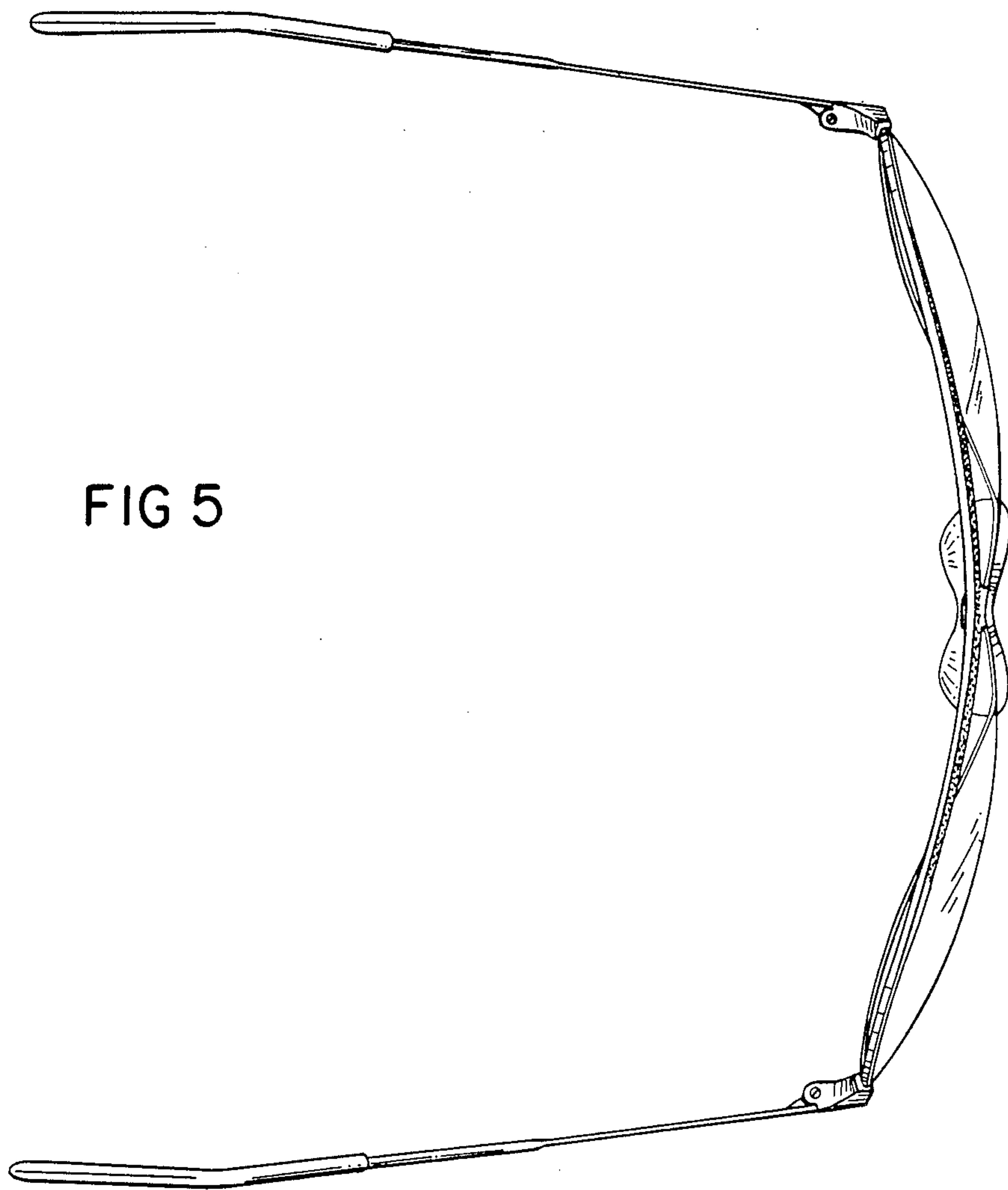

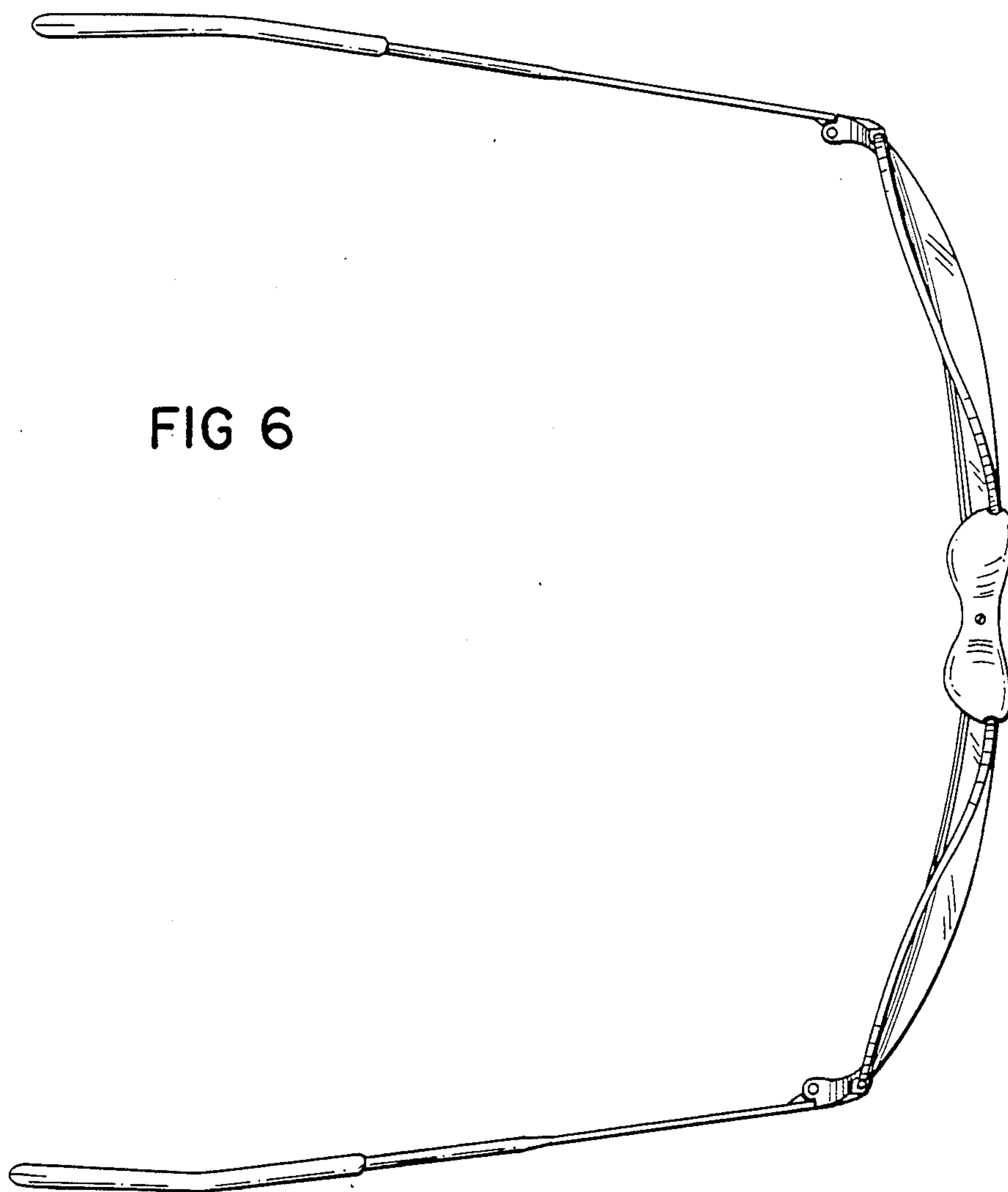

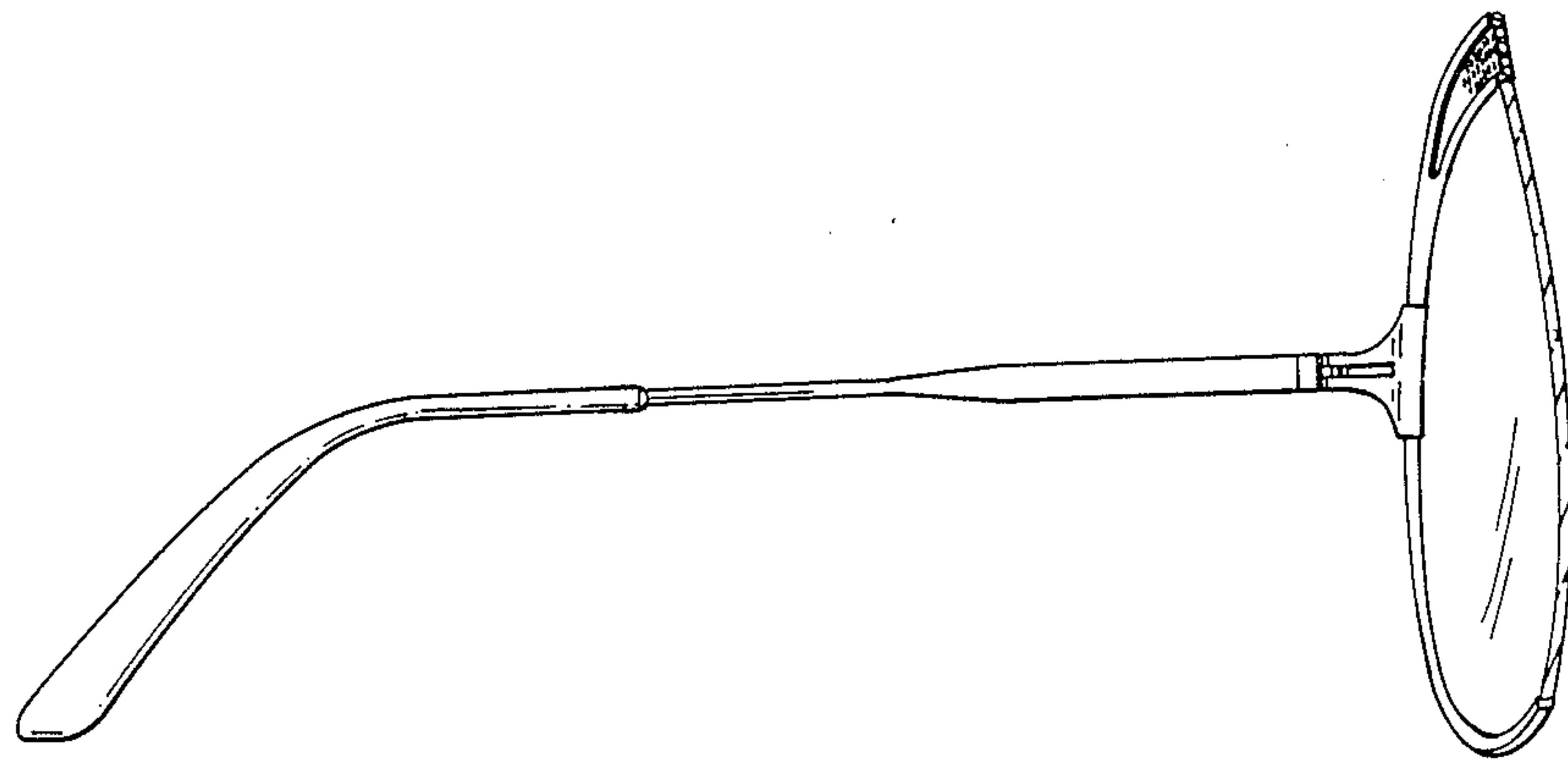
