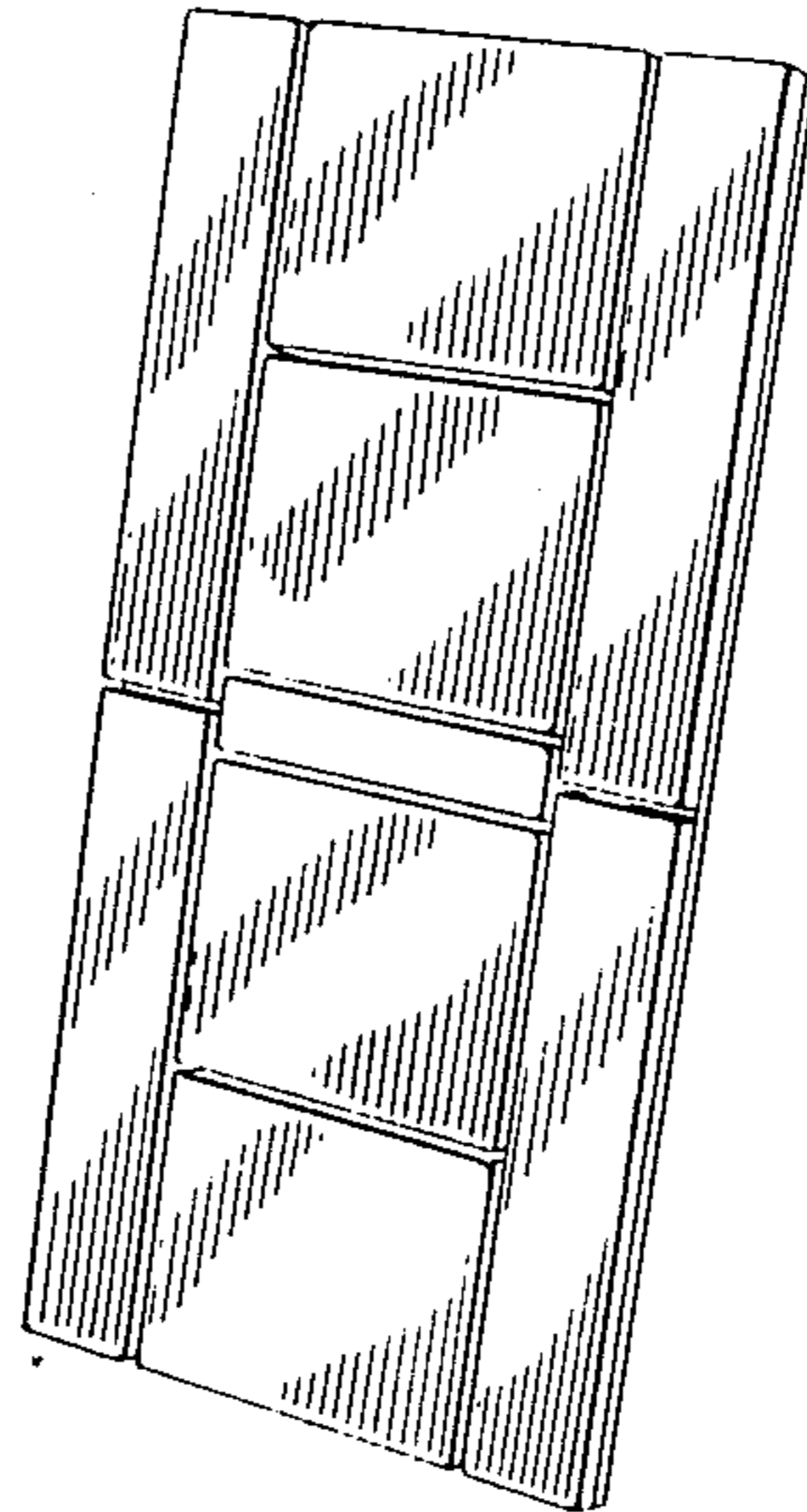

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a baseball pitching practice device showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view, the bottom view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view.



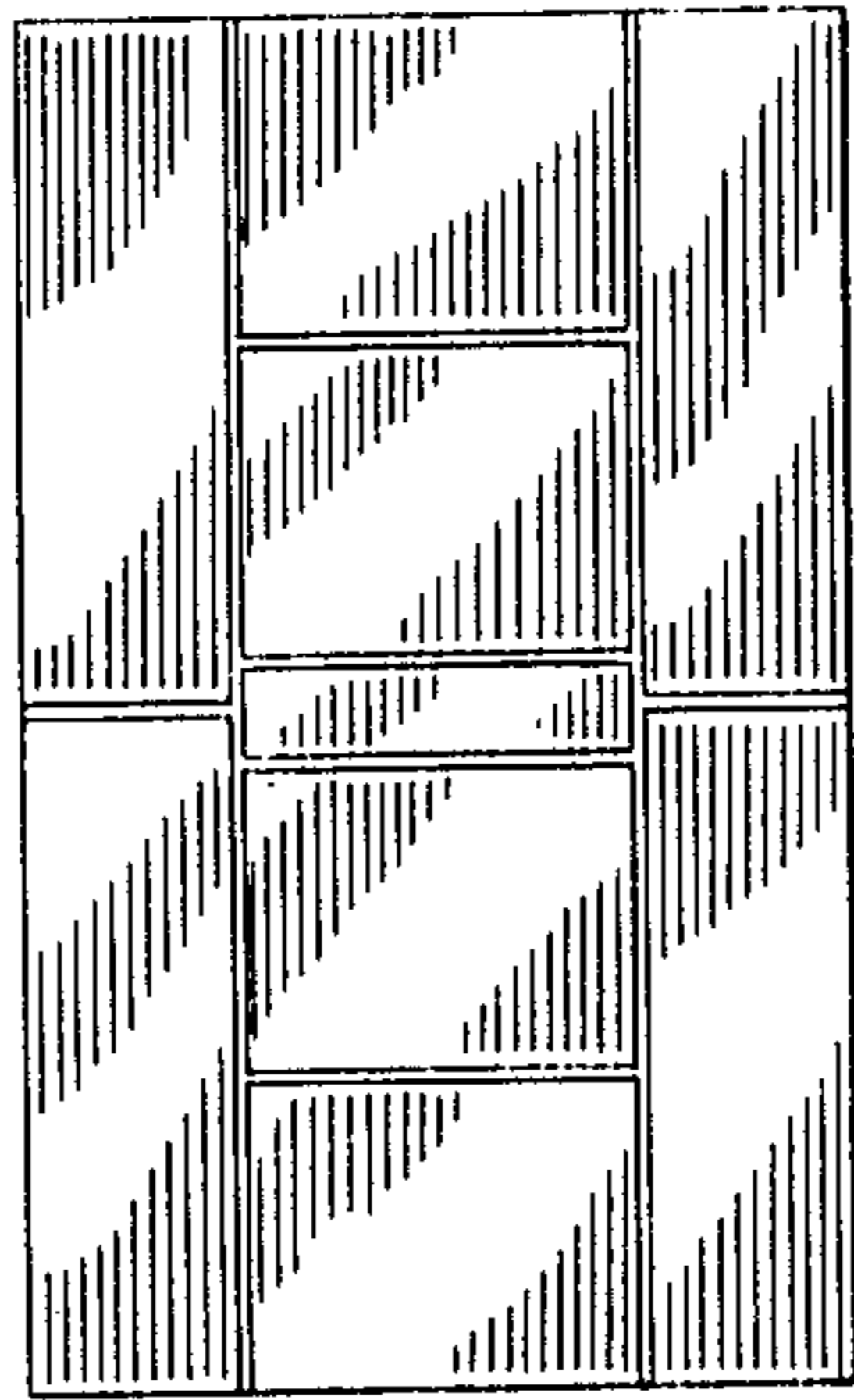

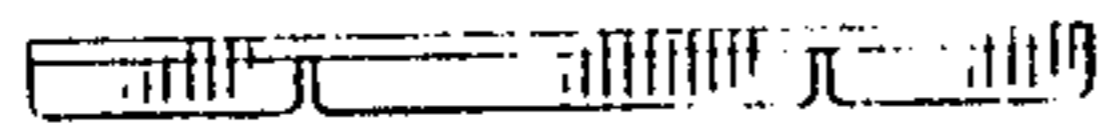

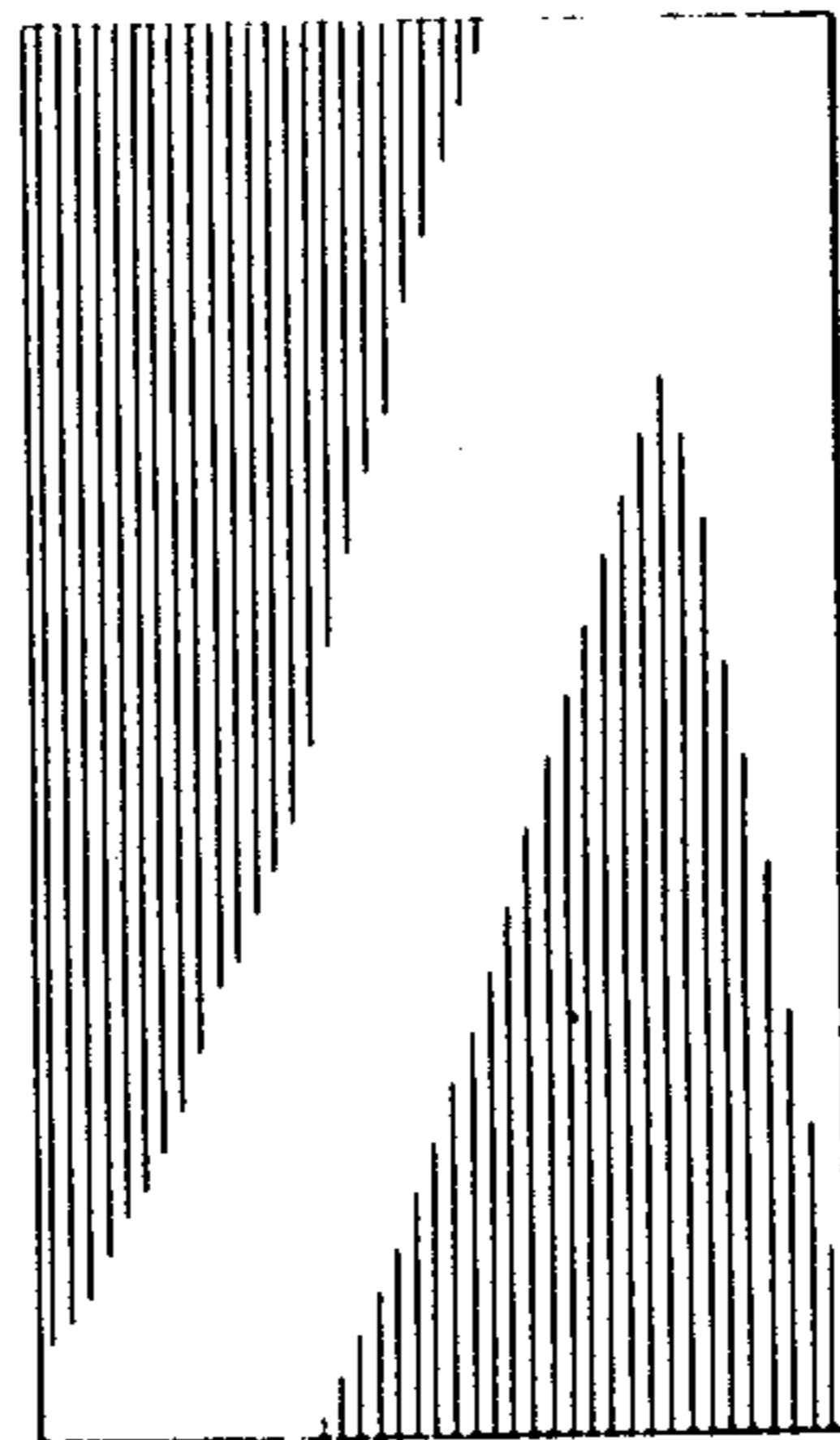

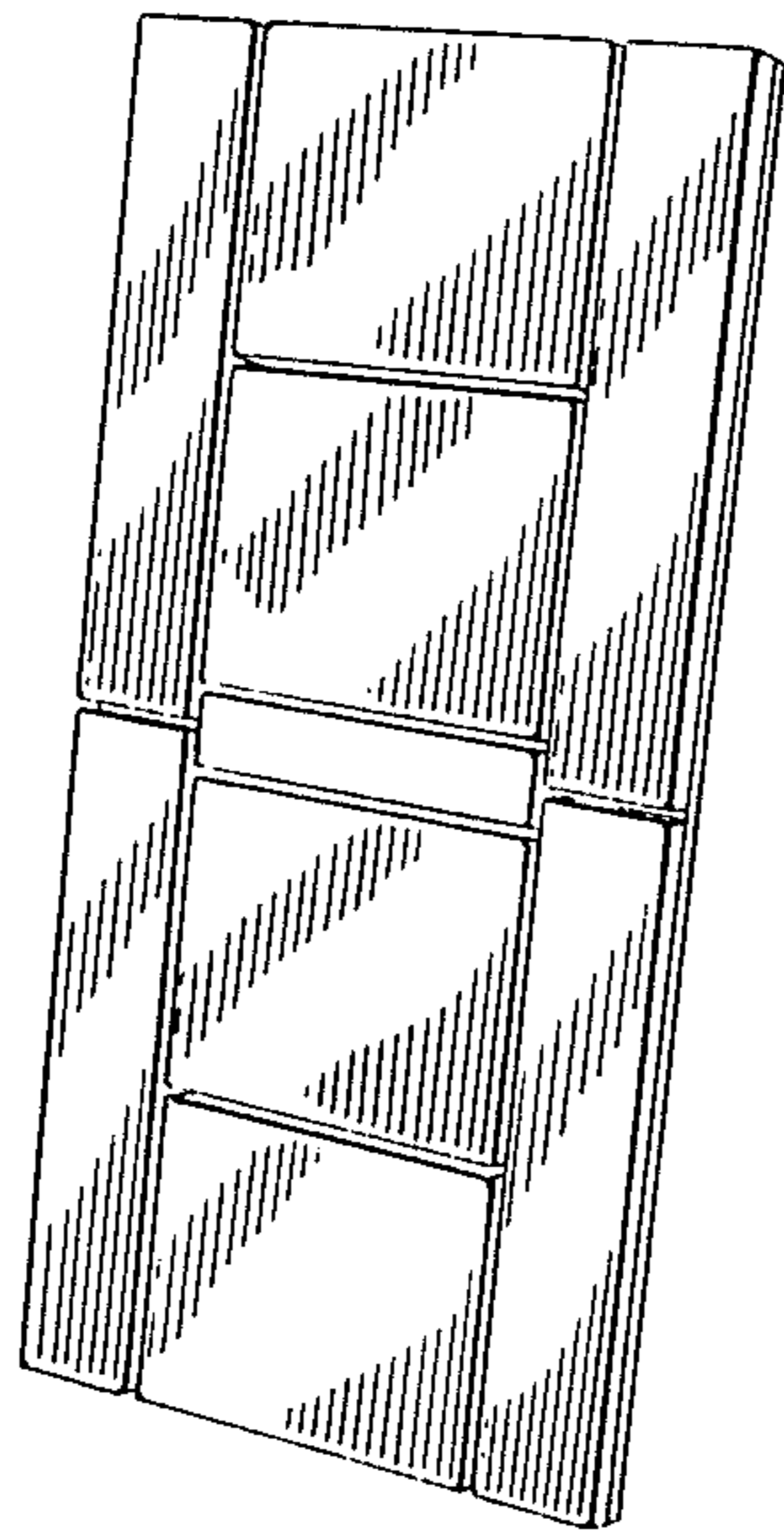
