[57] CLAIM

The design of a toilet training chair for children, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a toilet training chair for children showing my new design, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 5.

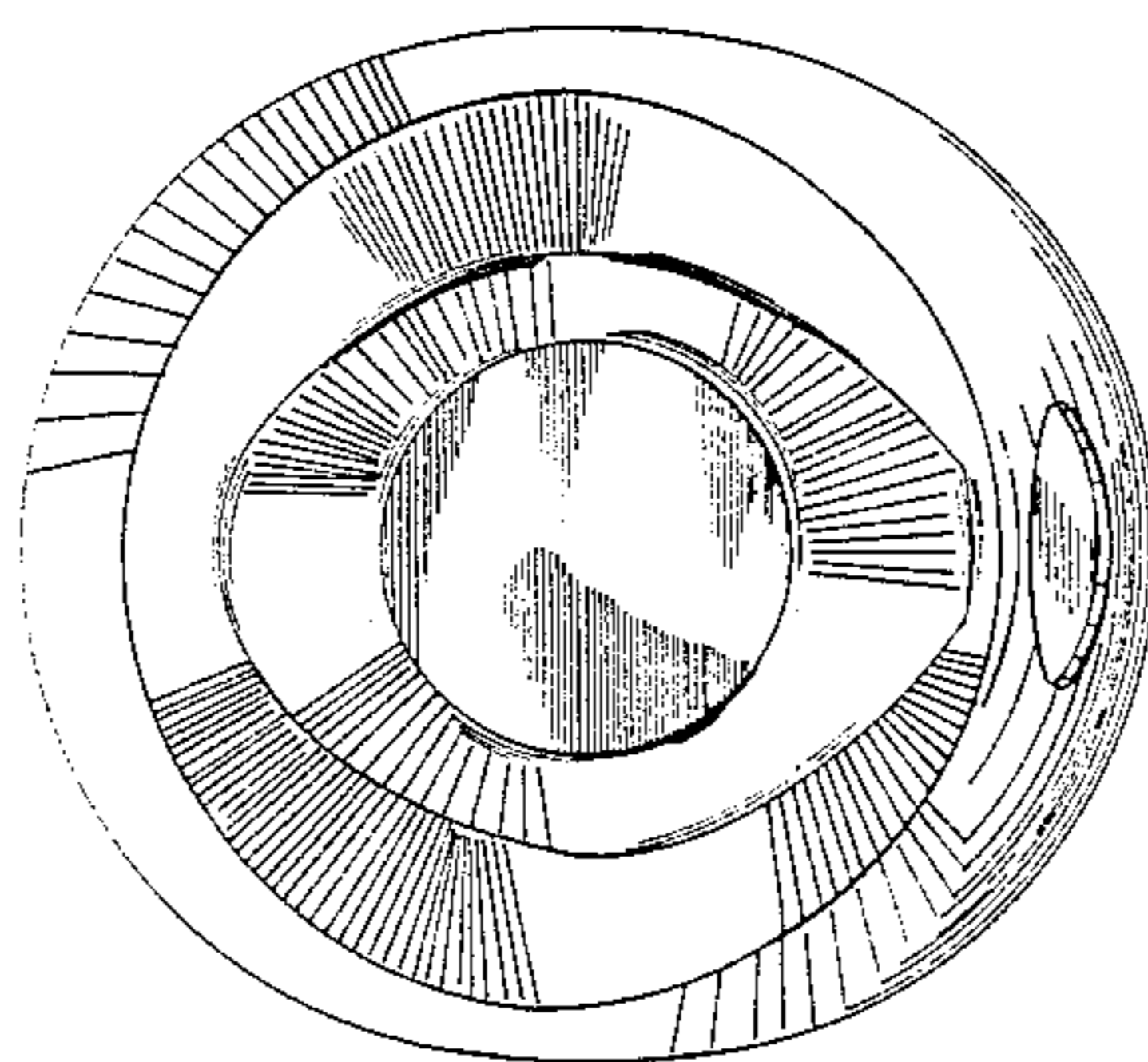
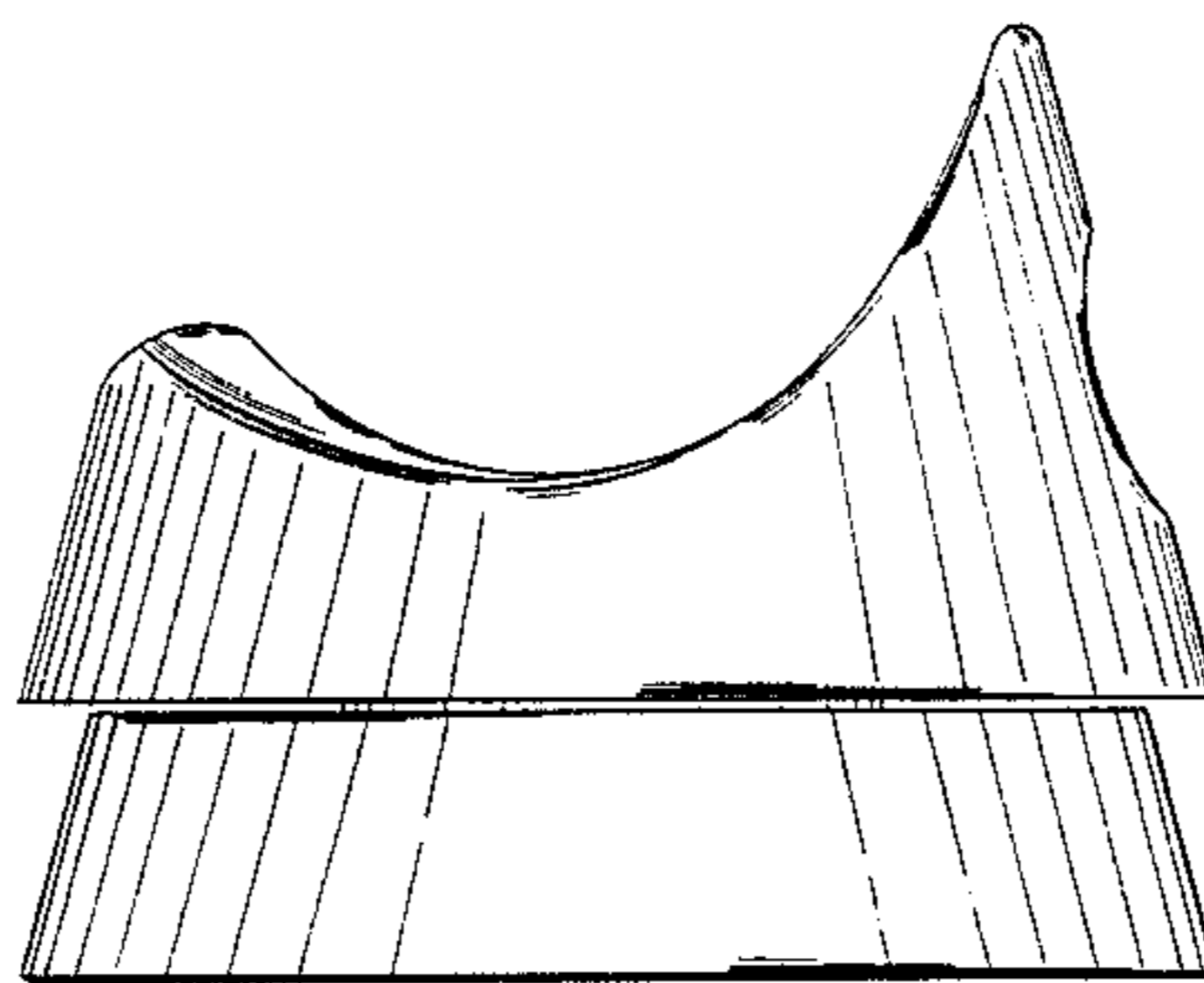

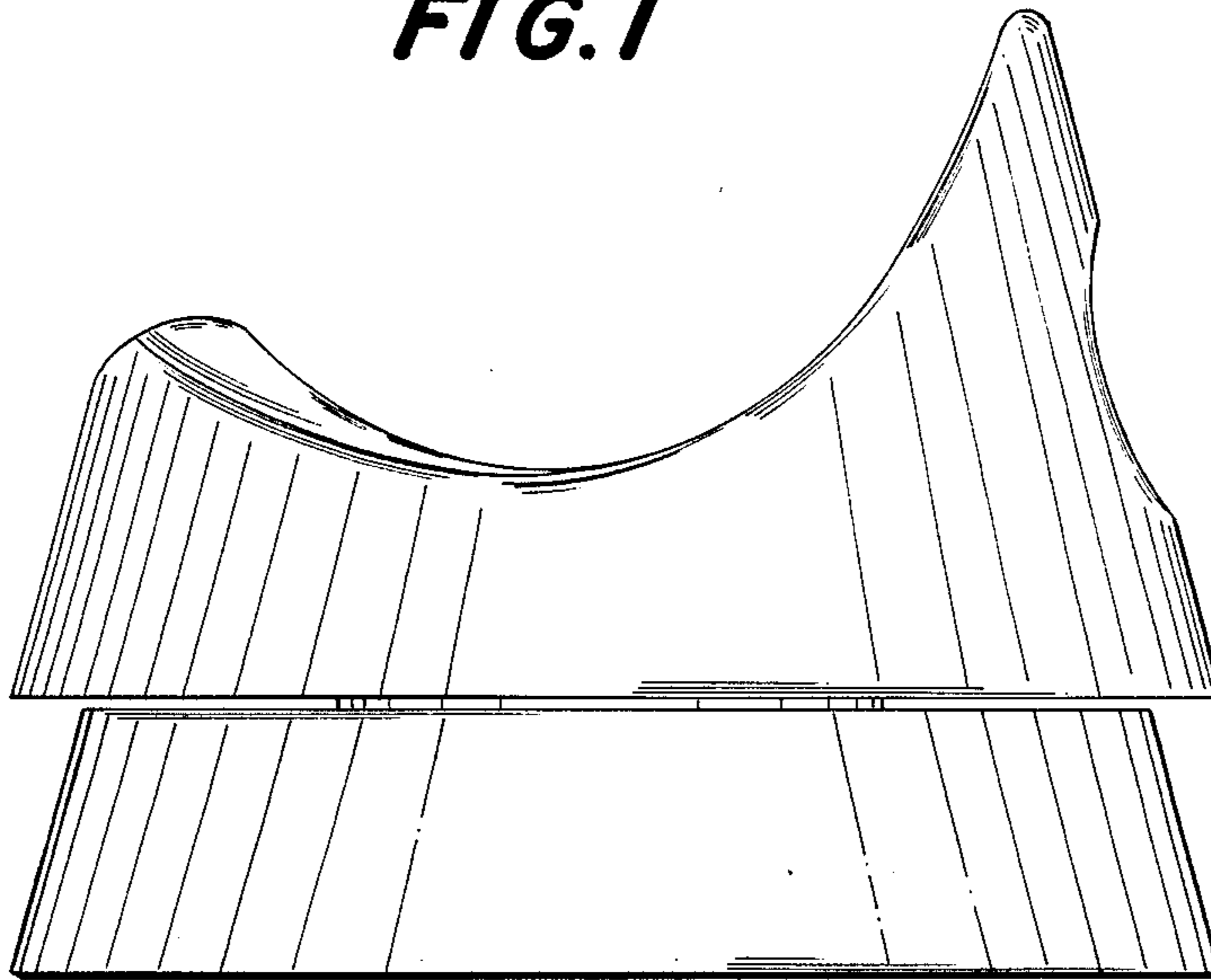

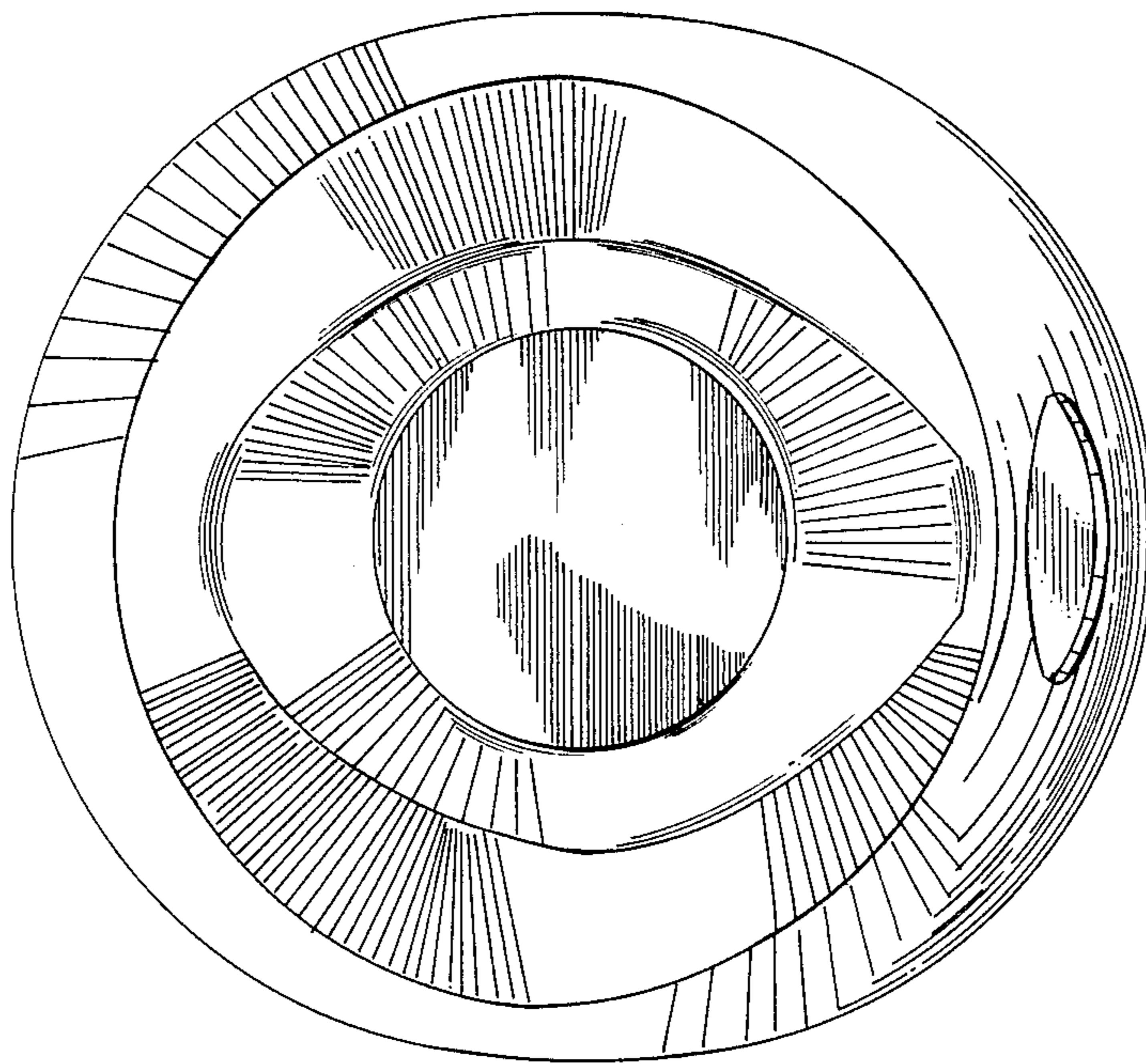

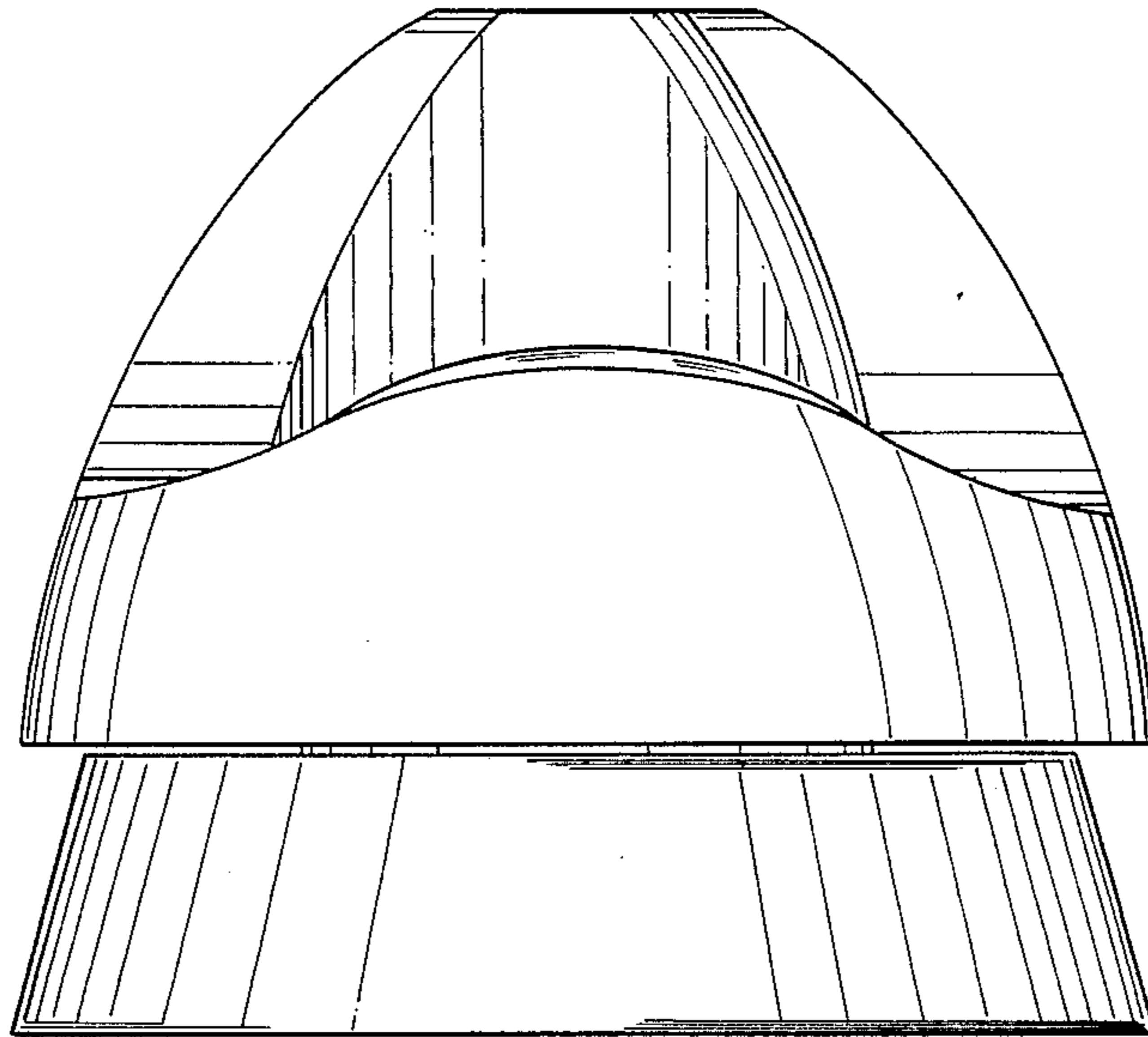

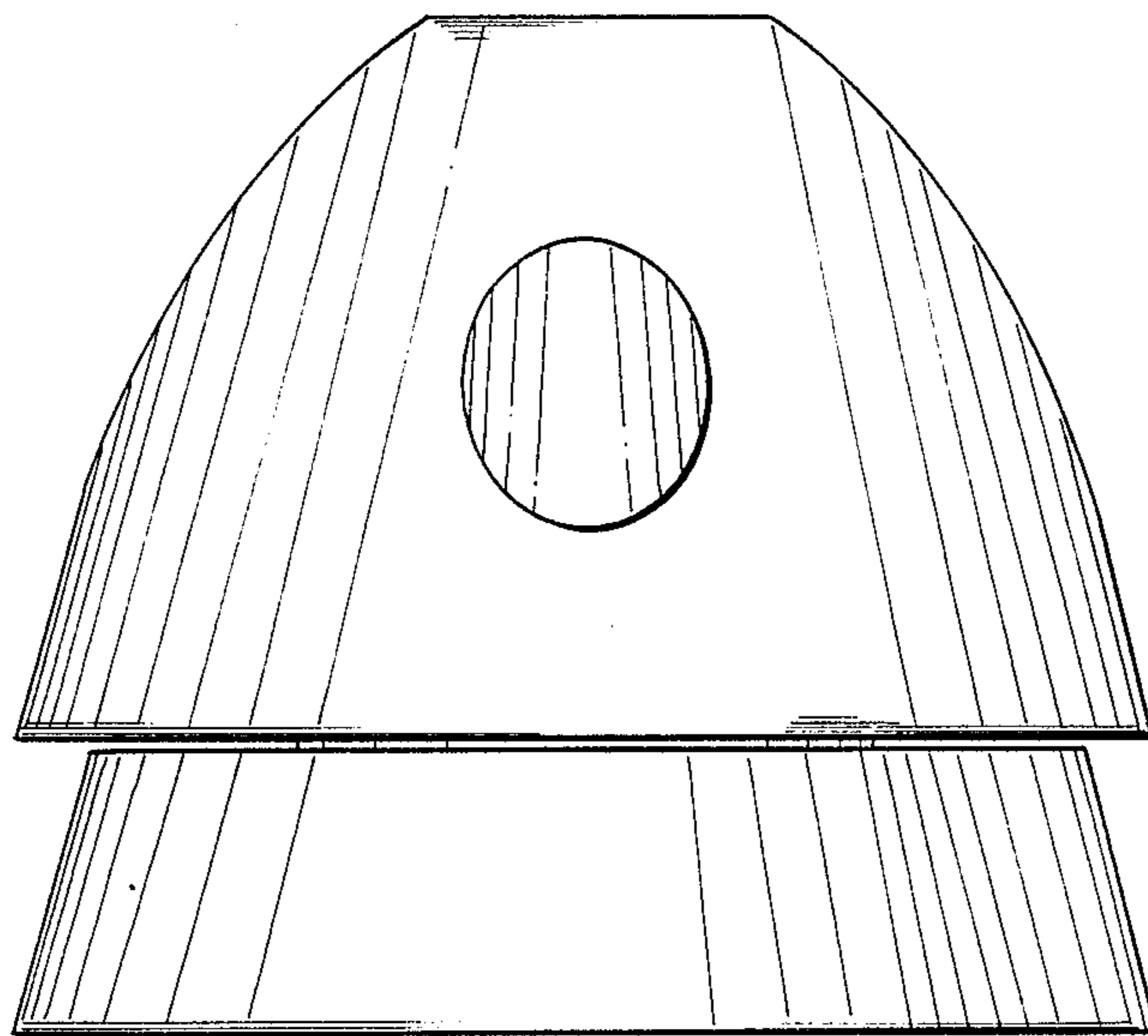

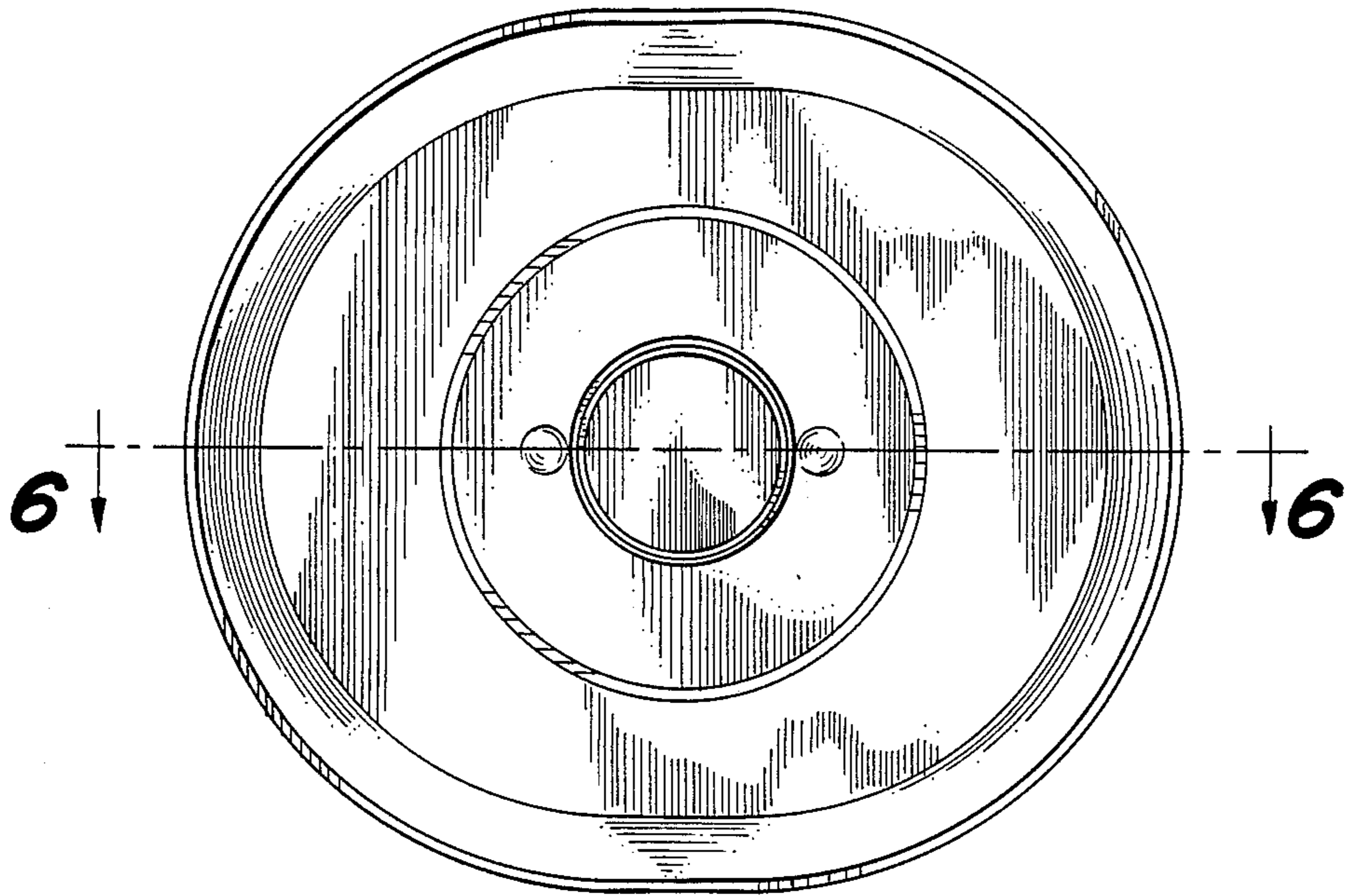
