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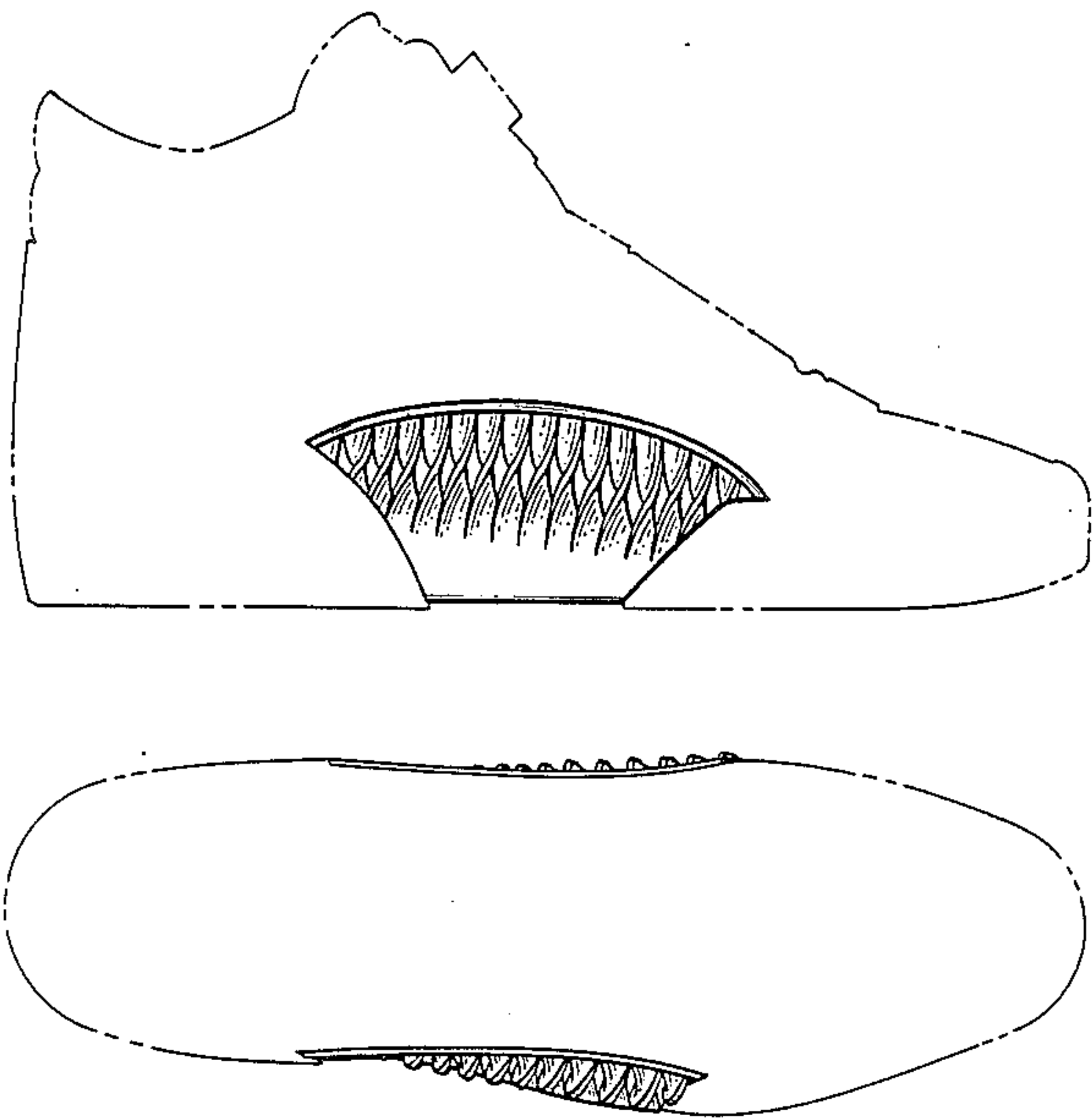
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an element of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an element of a shoe upper showing the new design. The broken line showing of a shoe is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed invention.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



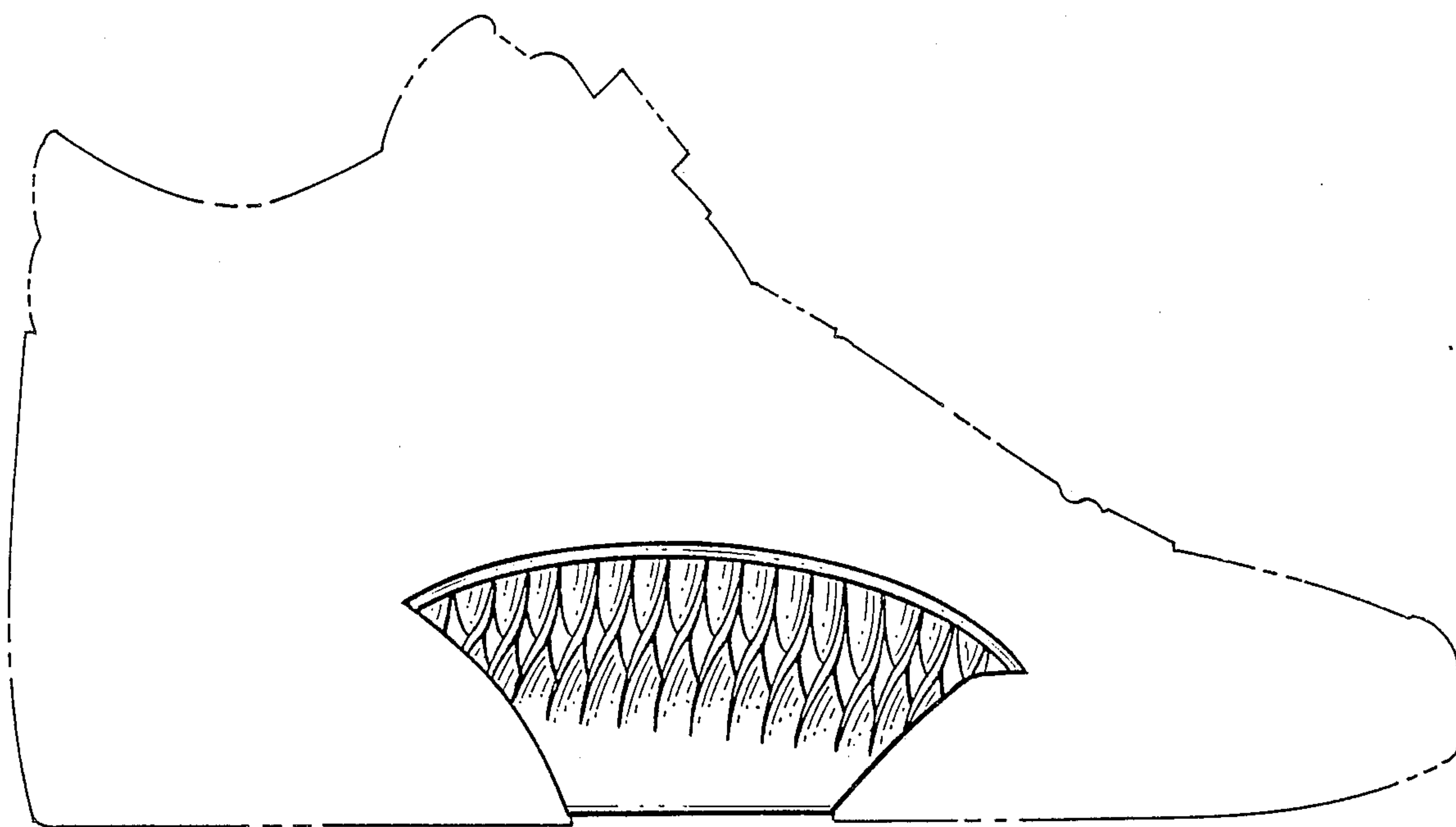

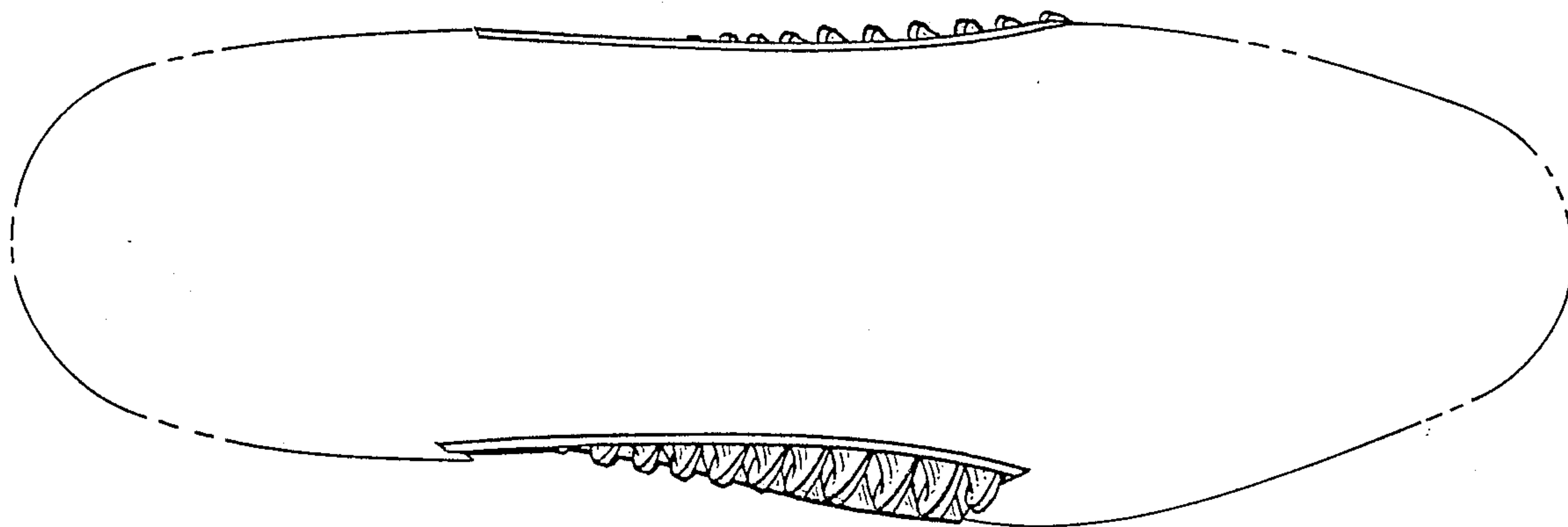

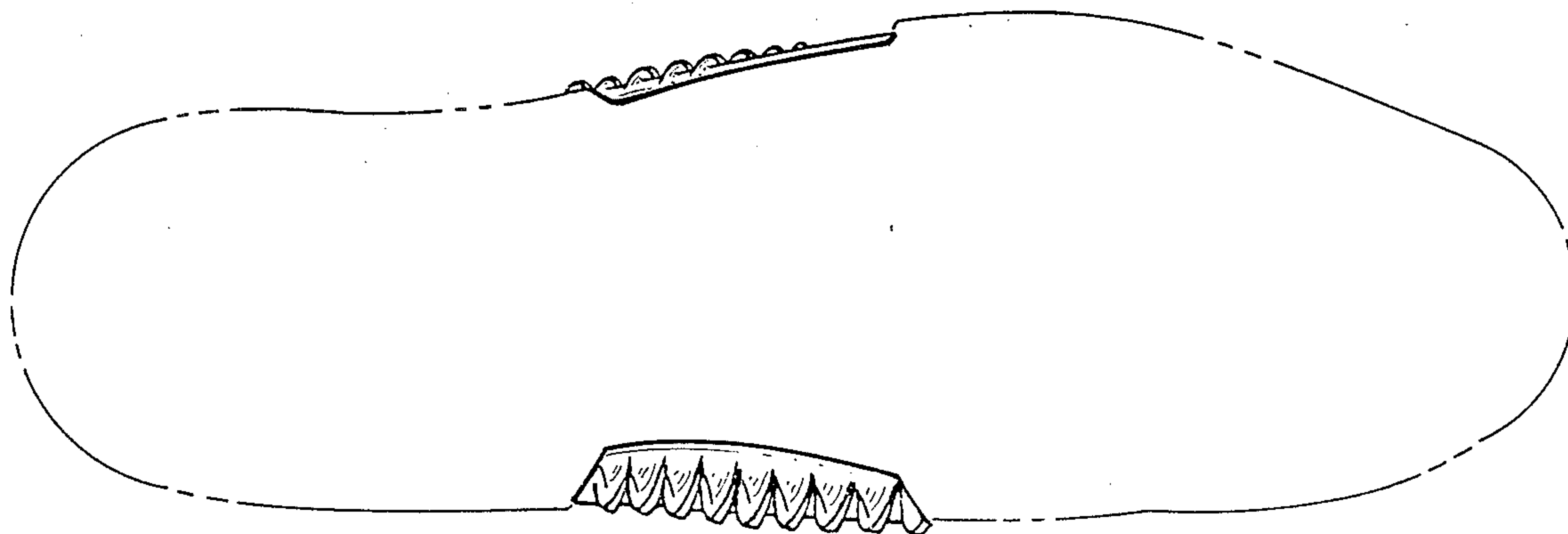

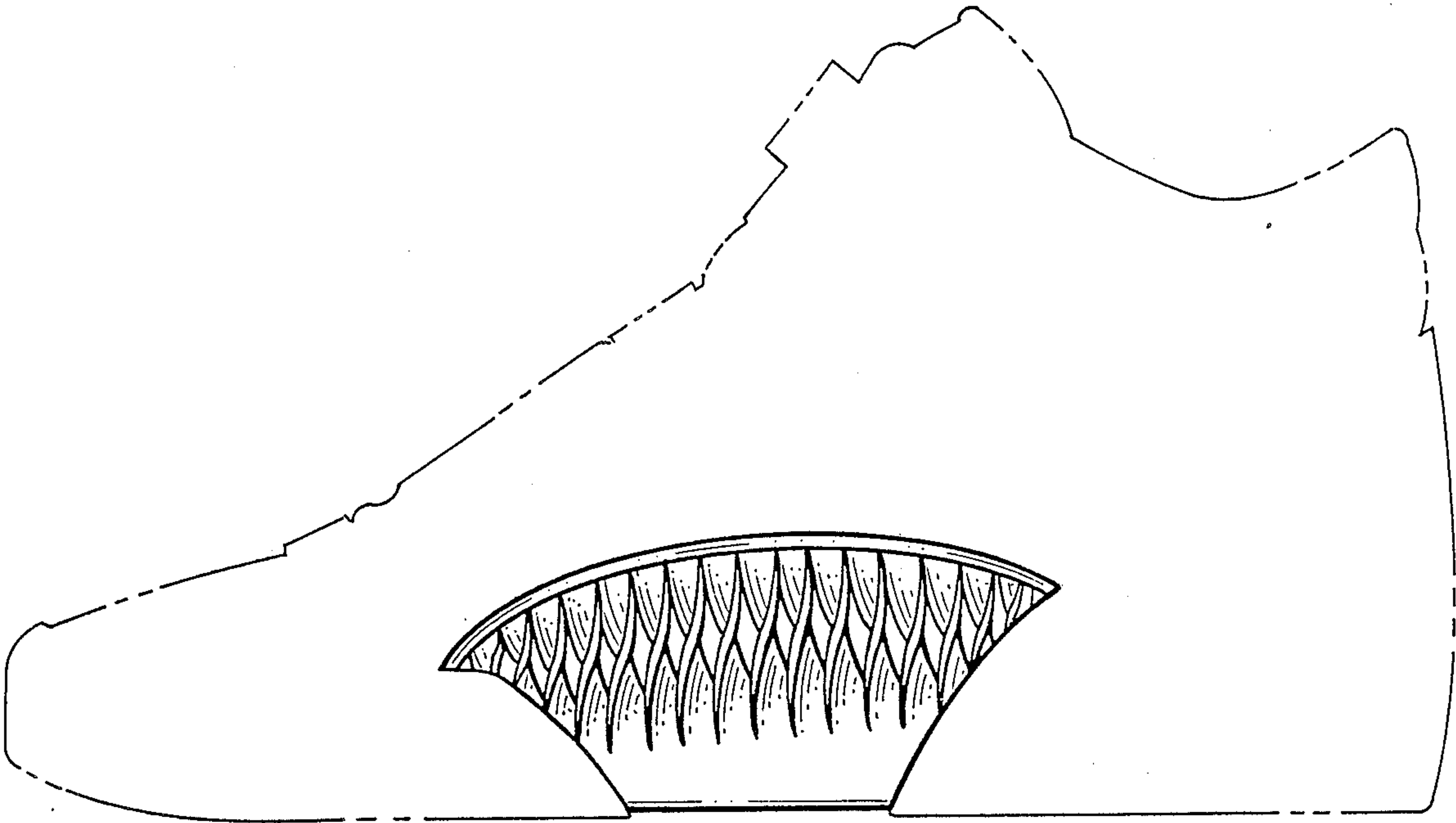

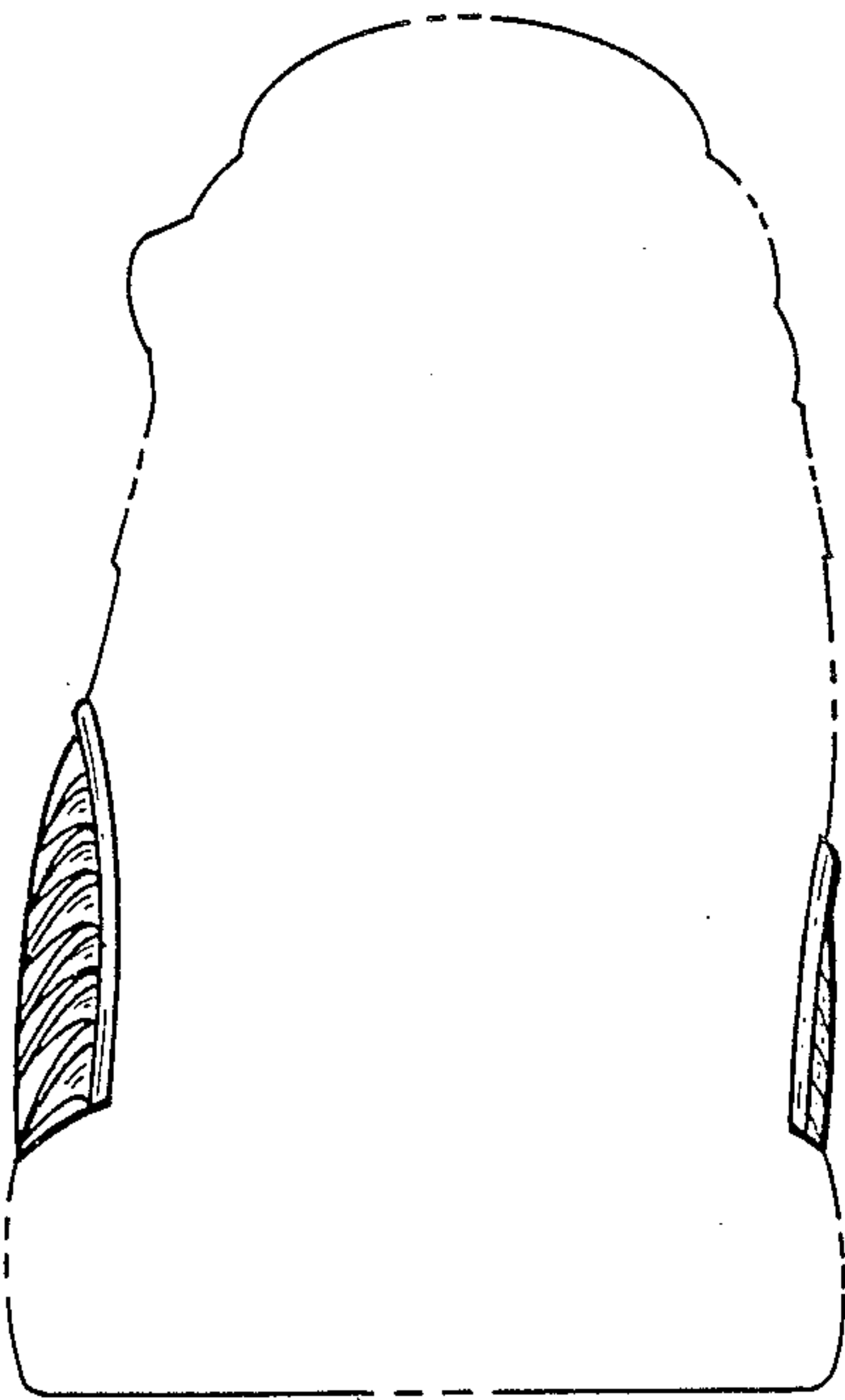

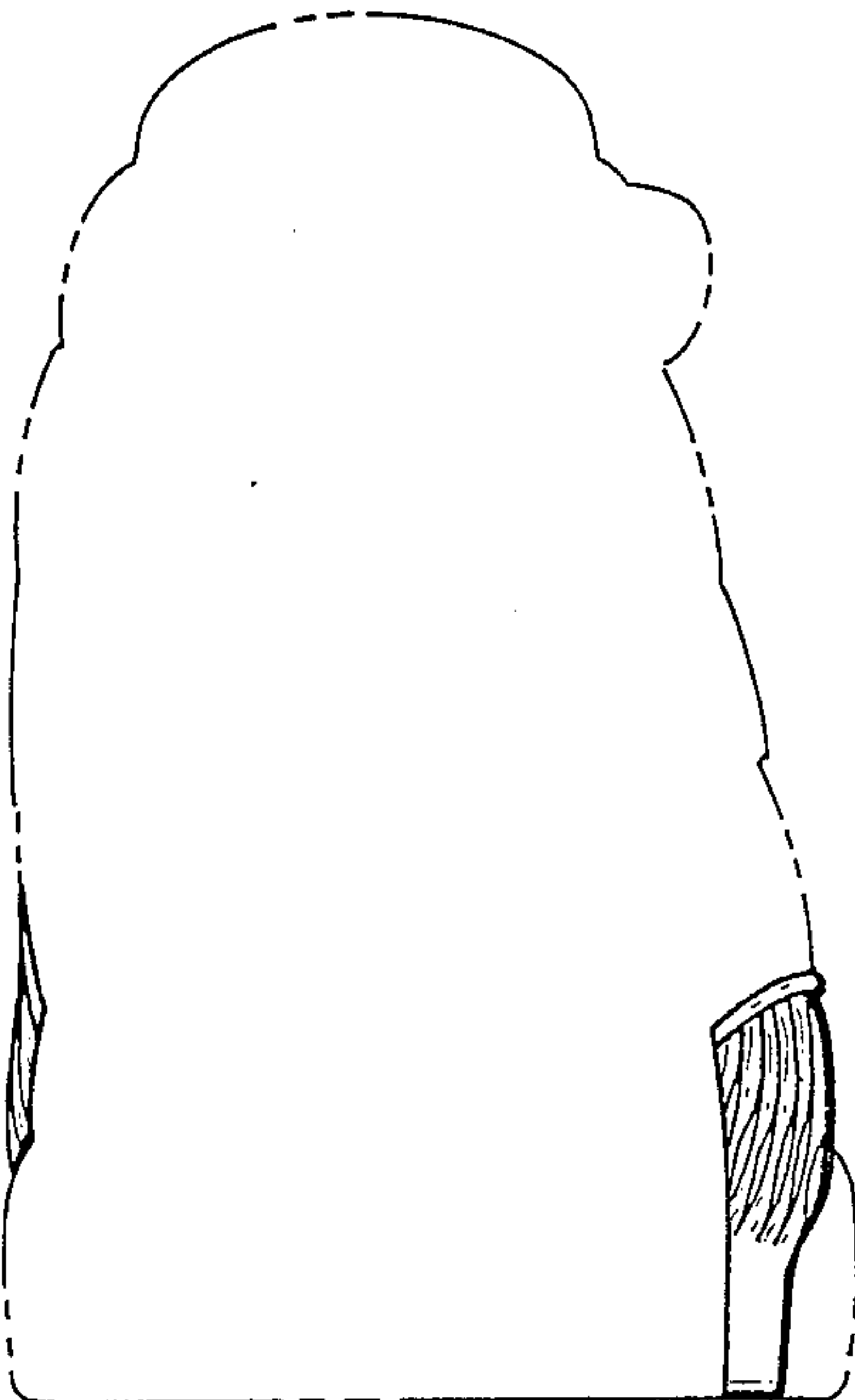
